(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a truck and trailer container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a truck and trailer container showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary perspective view of the front thereof;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken at portion 6 of FIG. 1,

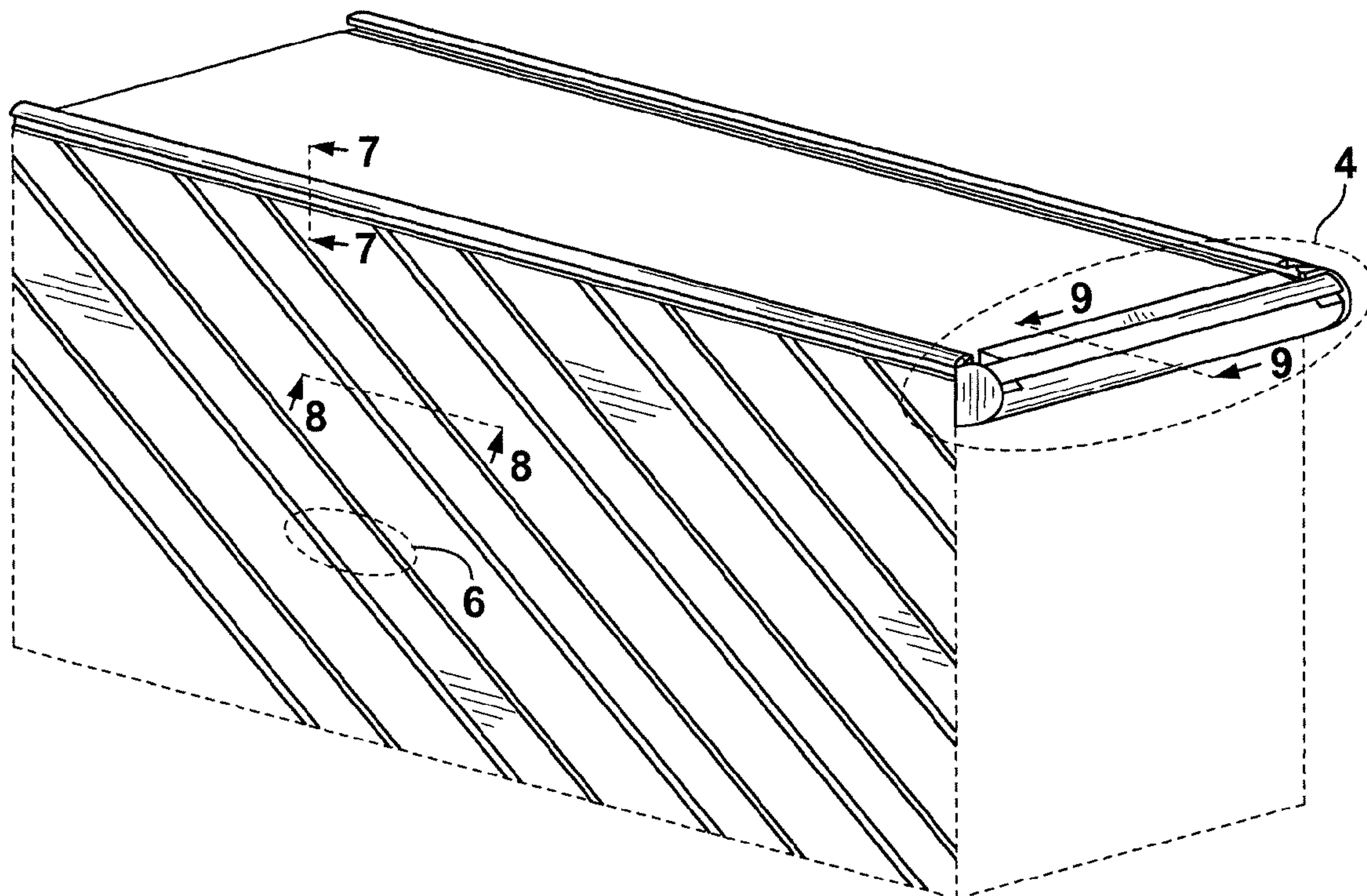
FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken along line 7-7 of FIG. 1;

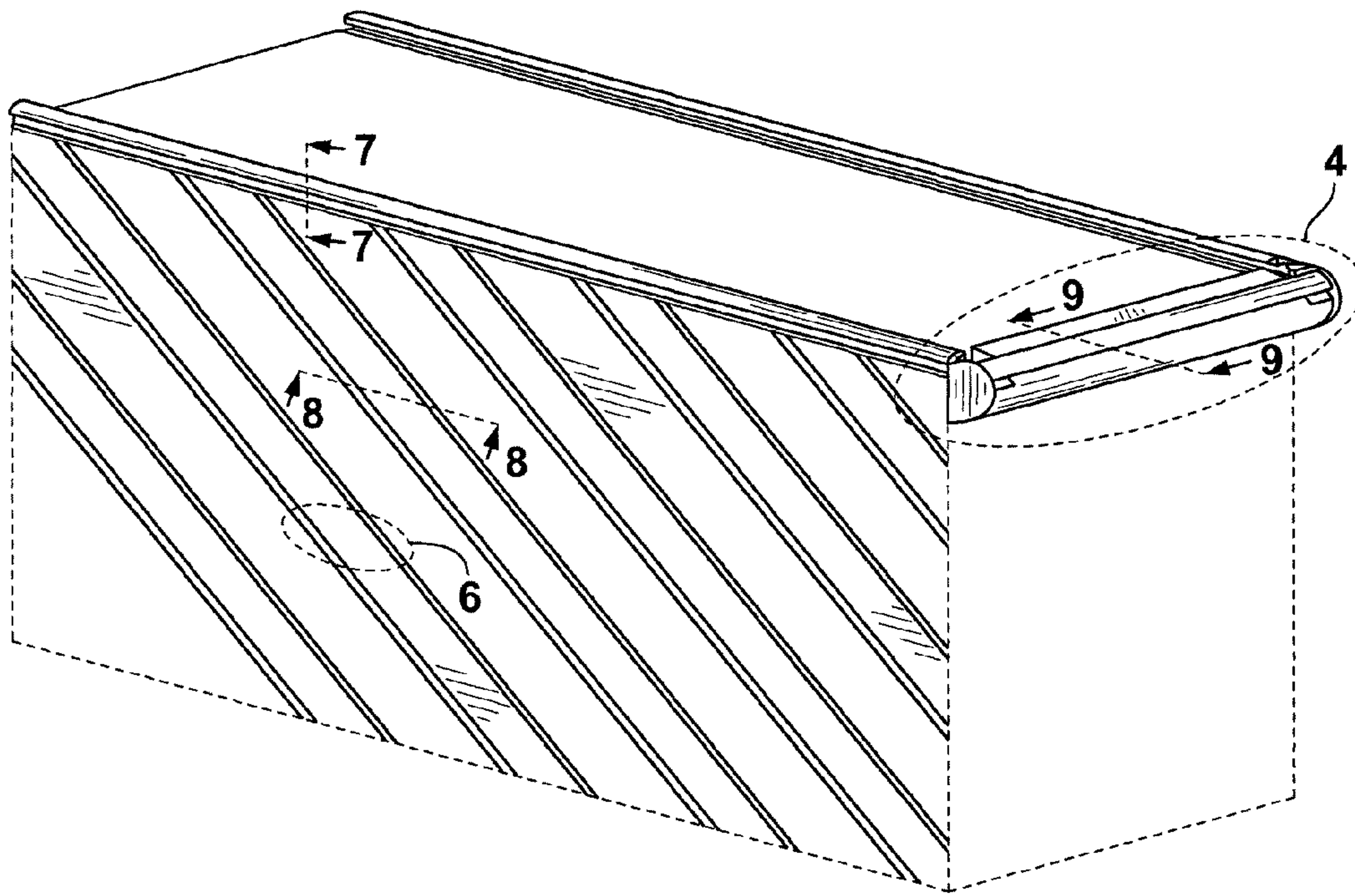

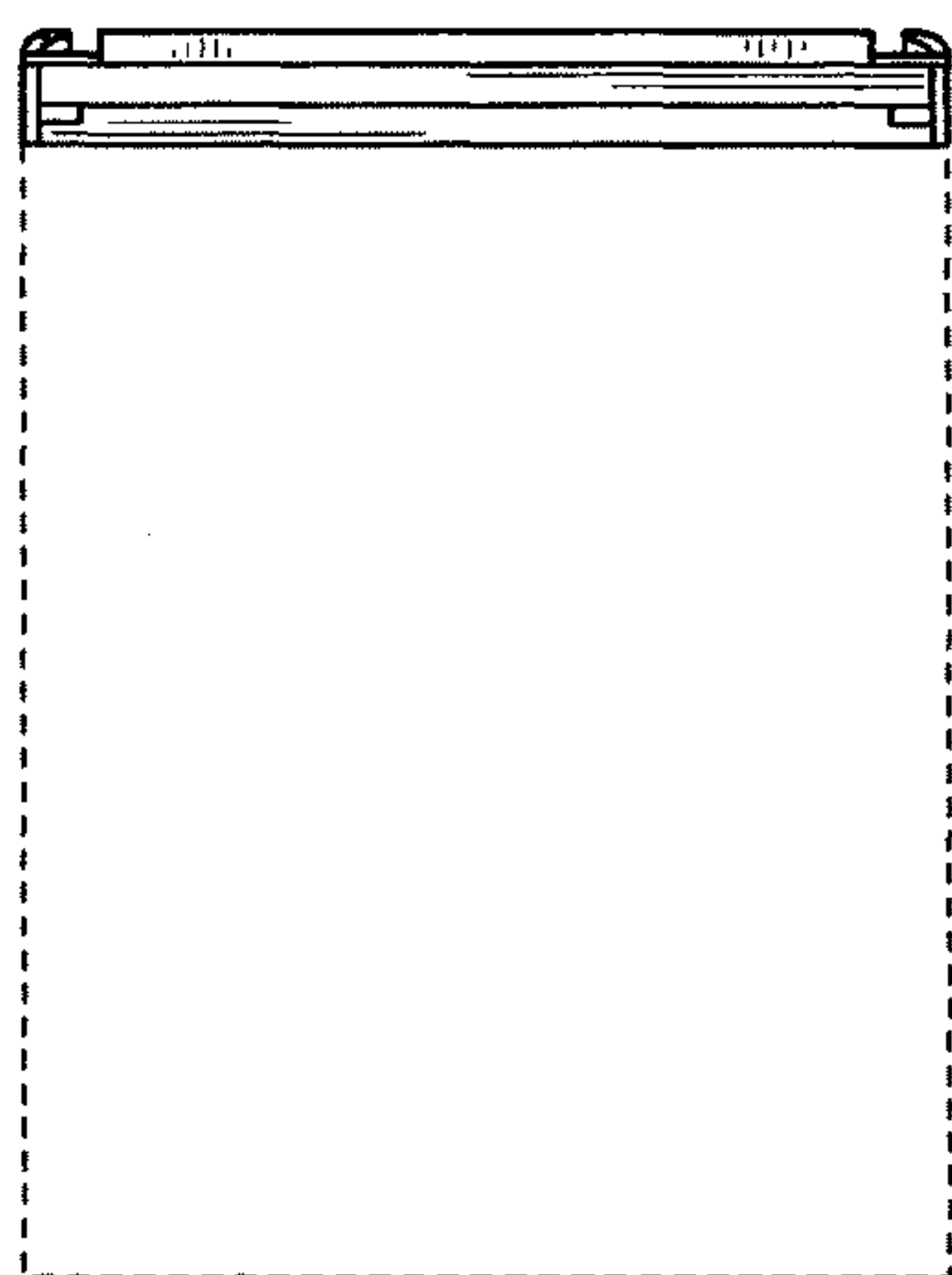

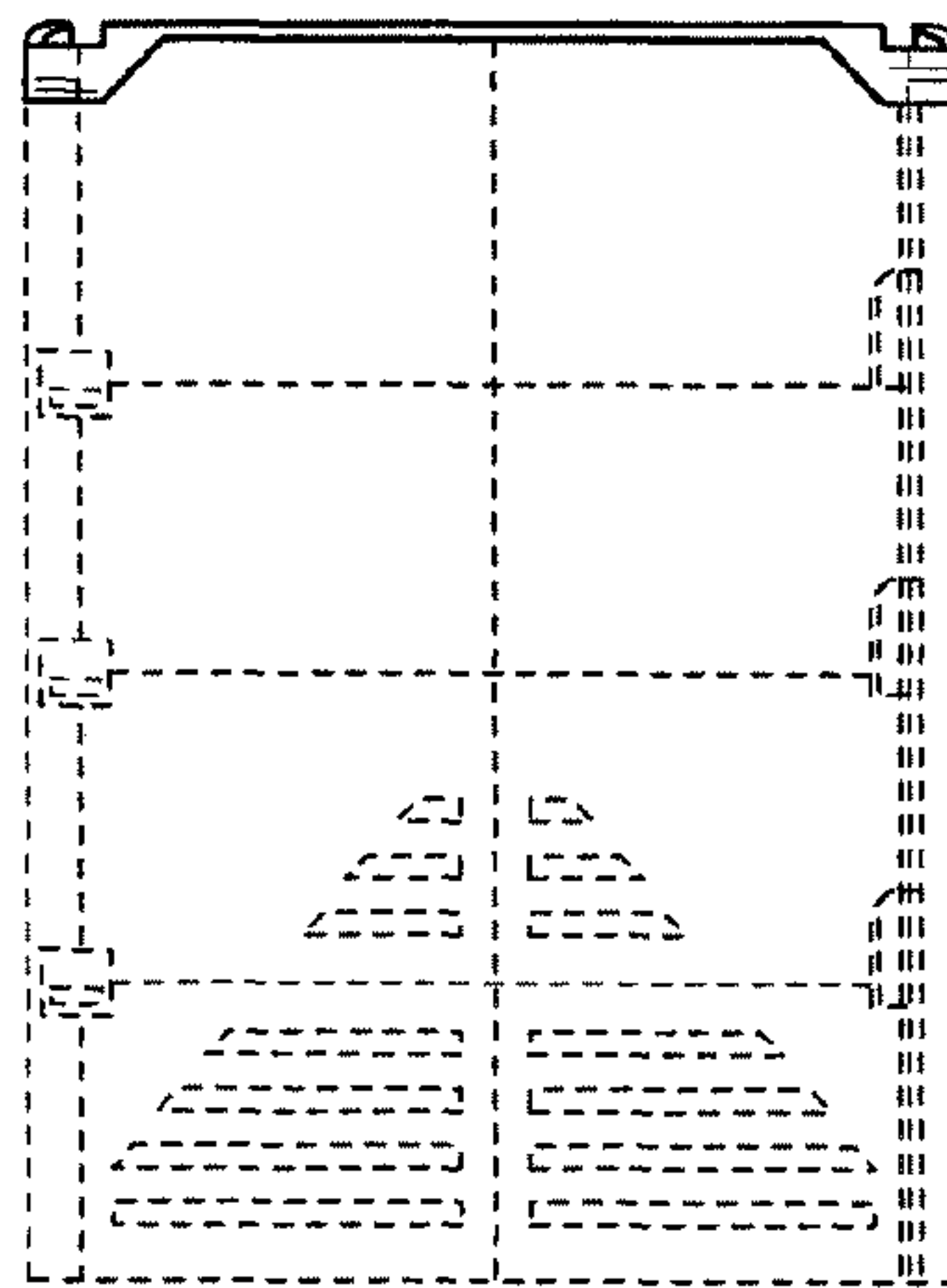

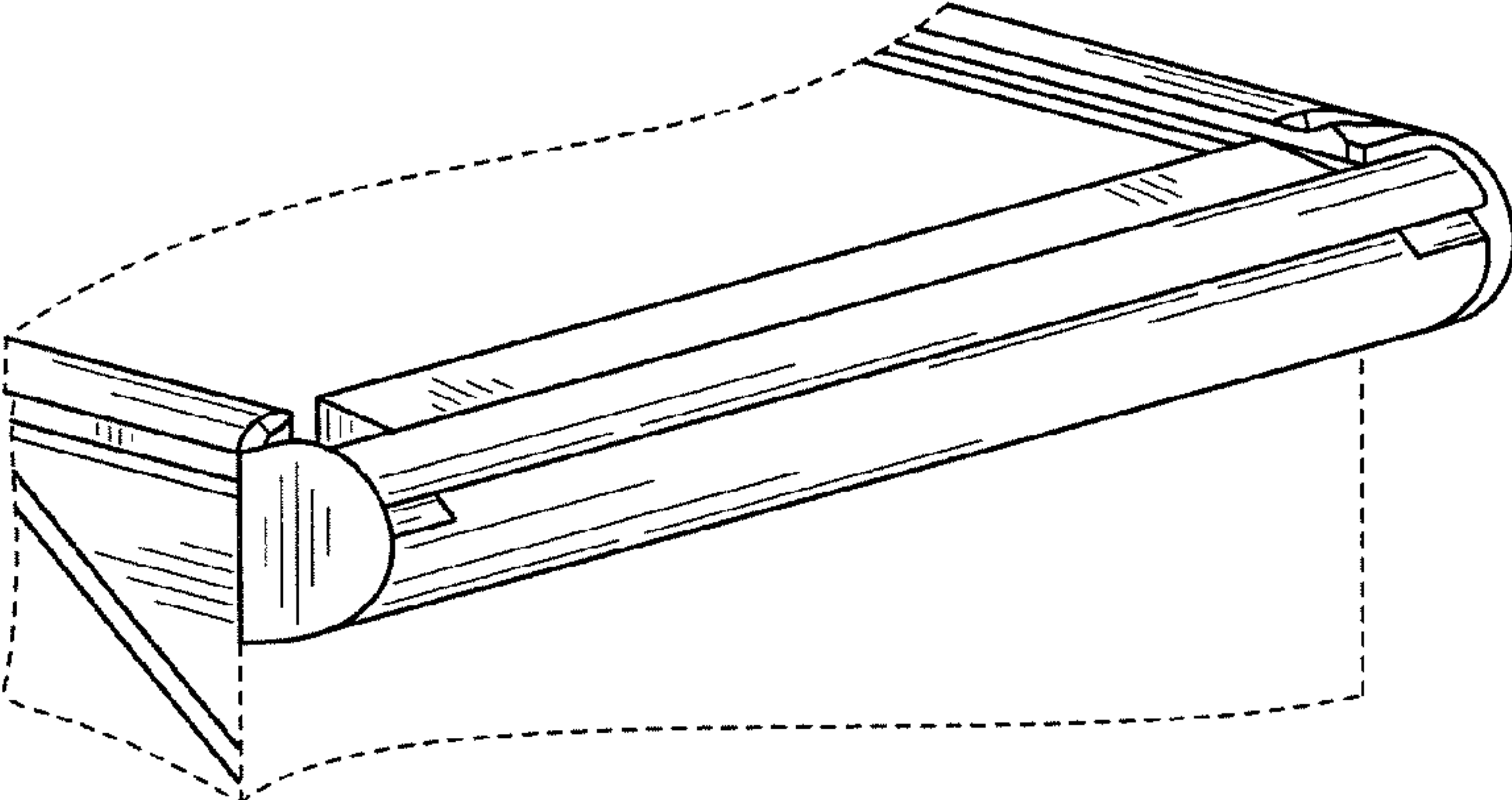

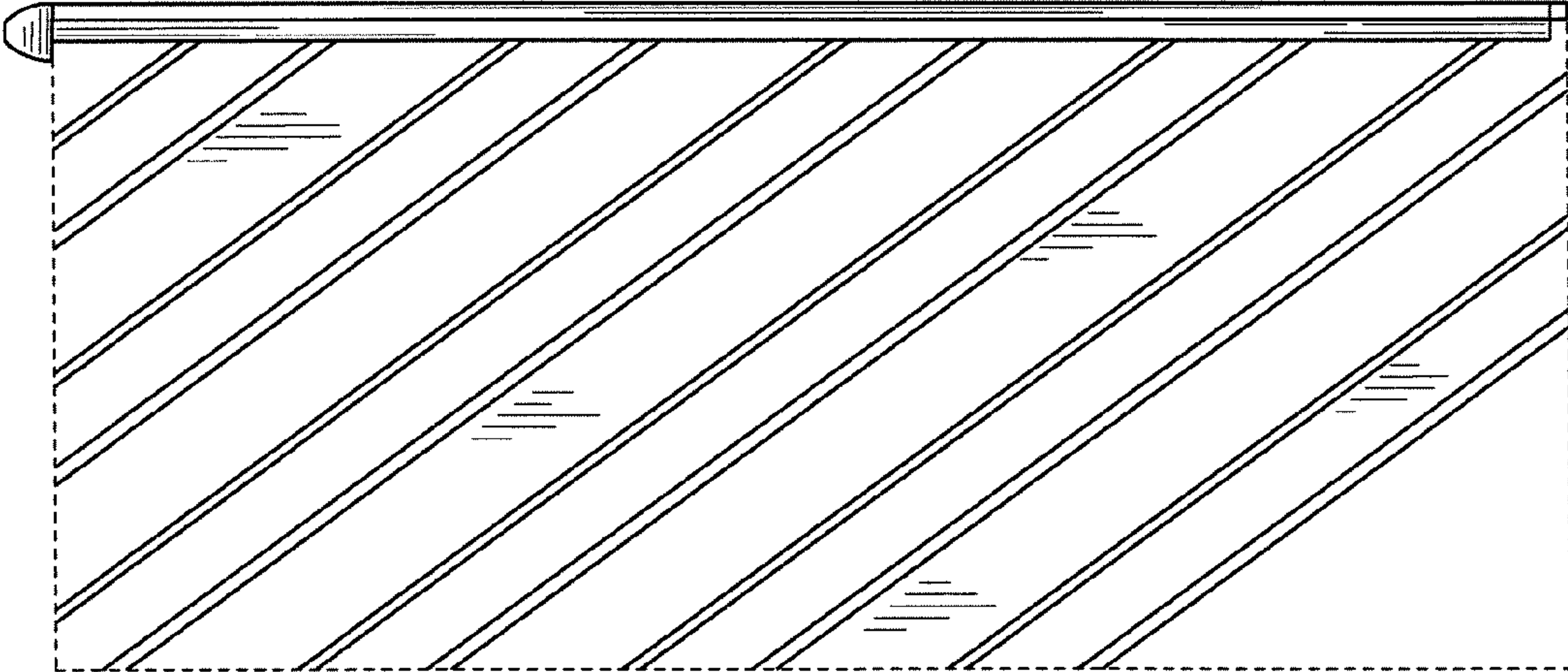

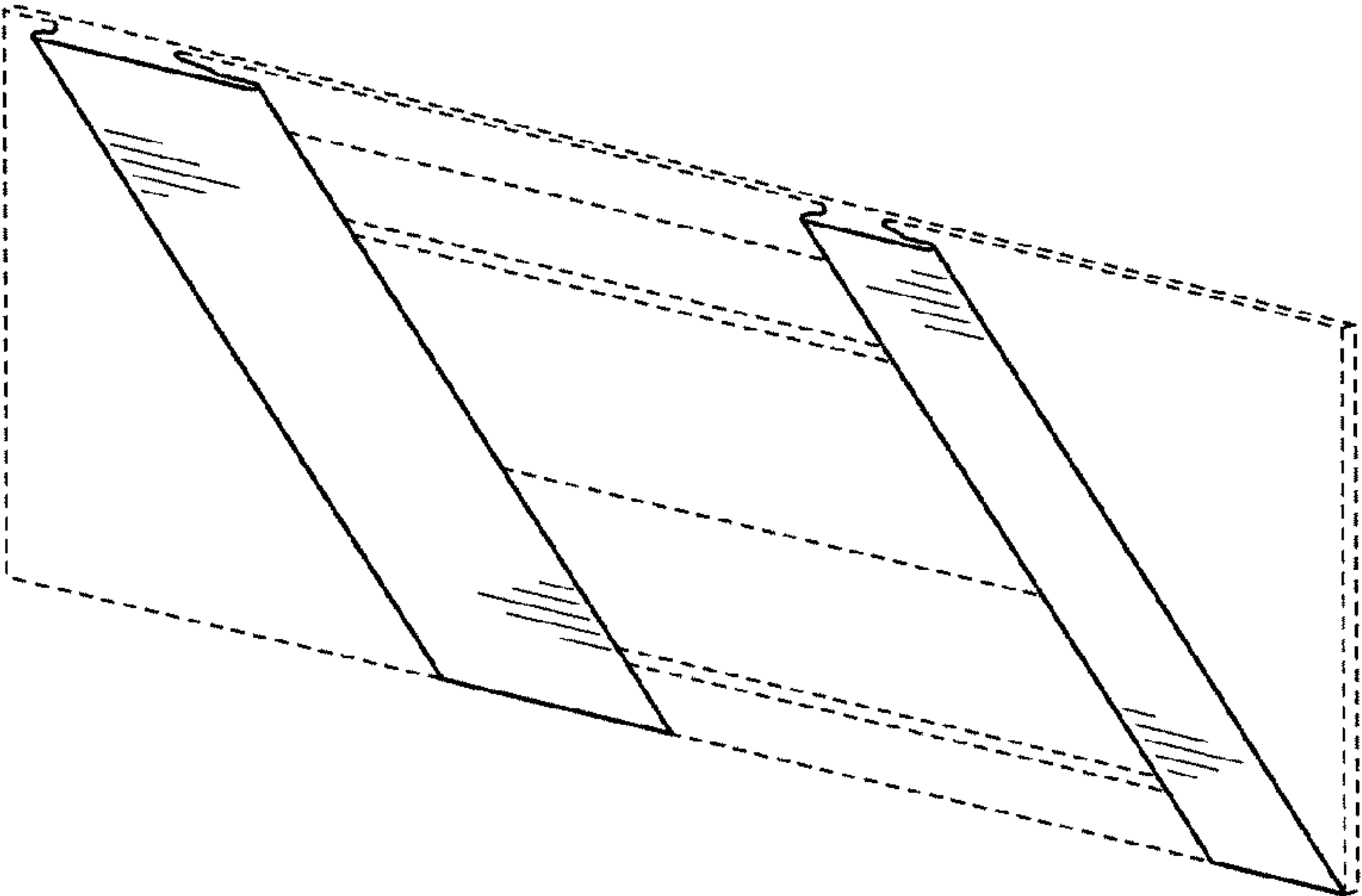

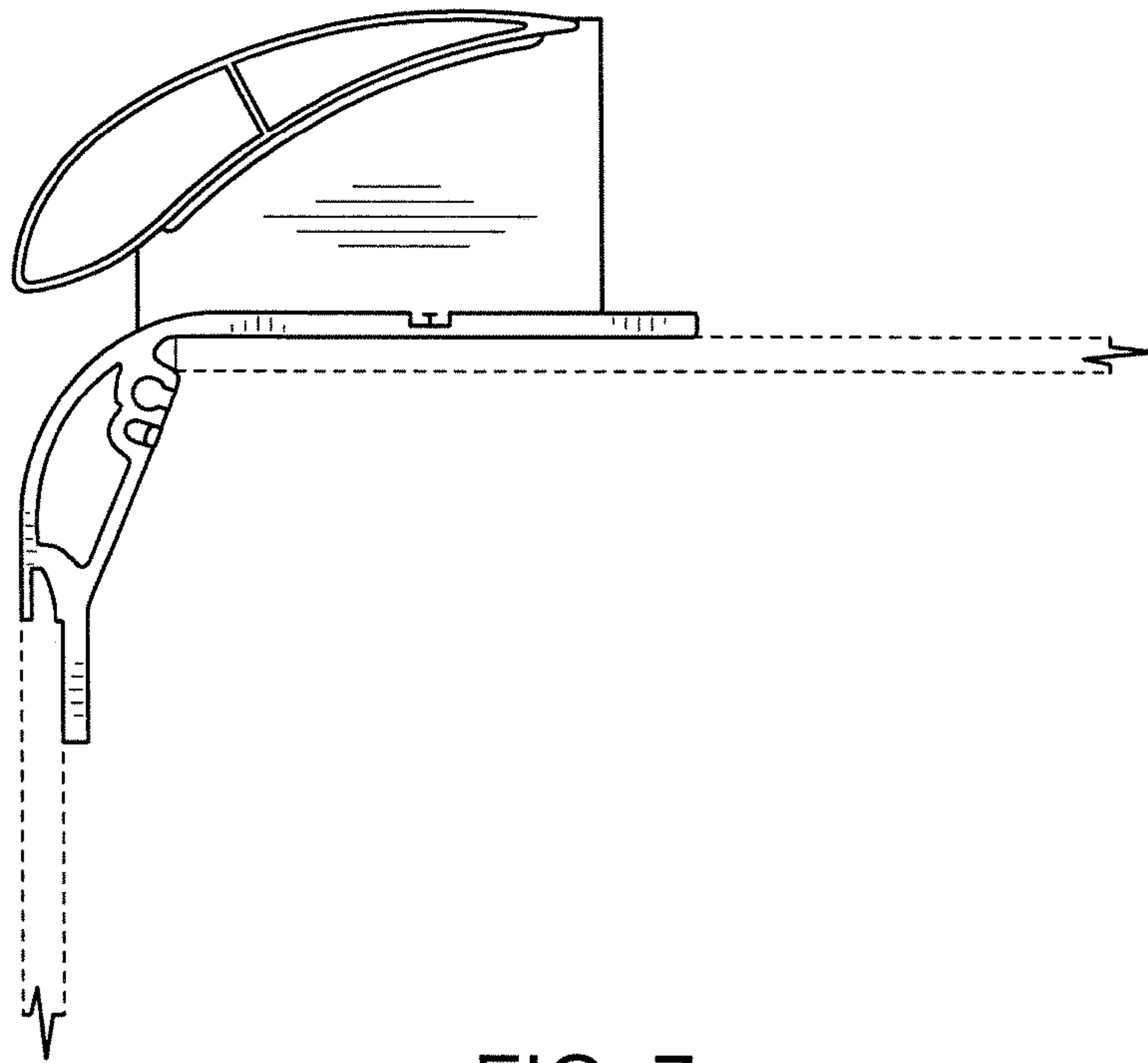

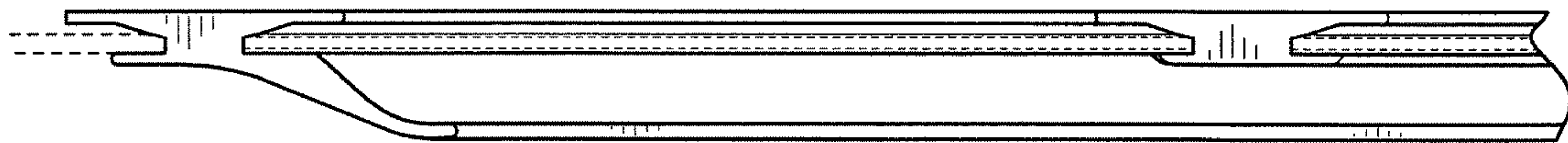

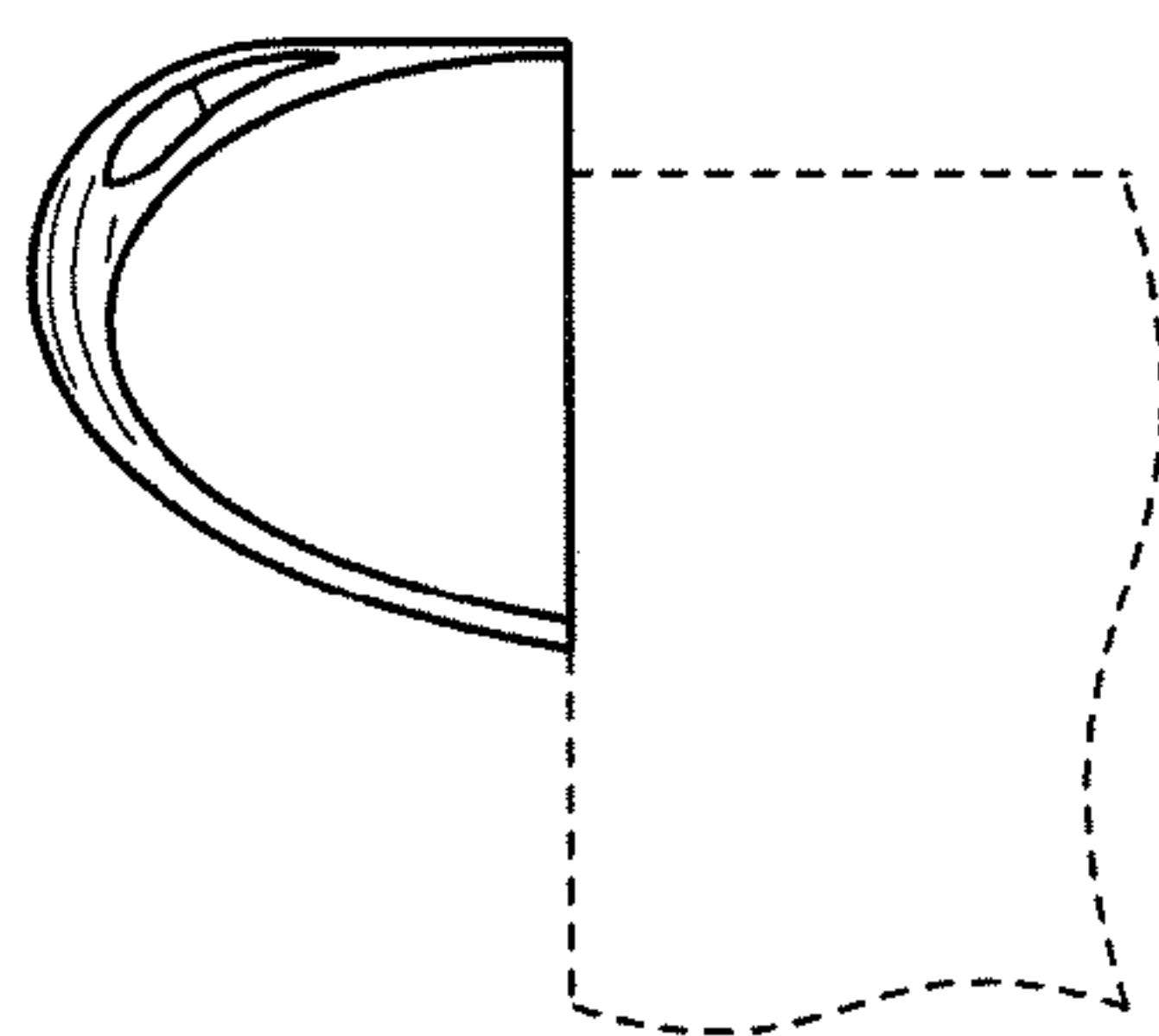
