(57) **CLAIM**

What is claimed is the ornamental design for a jewelry case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a jewelry case, showing the new design with doors and drawers thereof each in an open position;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the drawers removed for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof, the drawers removed for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof, showing the new design with doors and drawers thereof each in a closed position;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken generally along lines 10-10 of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken generally along lines 11-11 of FIG. 8;

FIG. 12 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of a bottom drawer thereof;

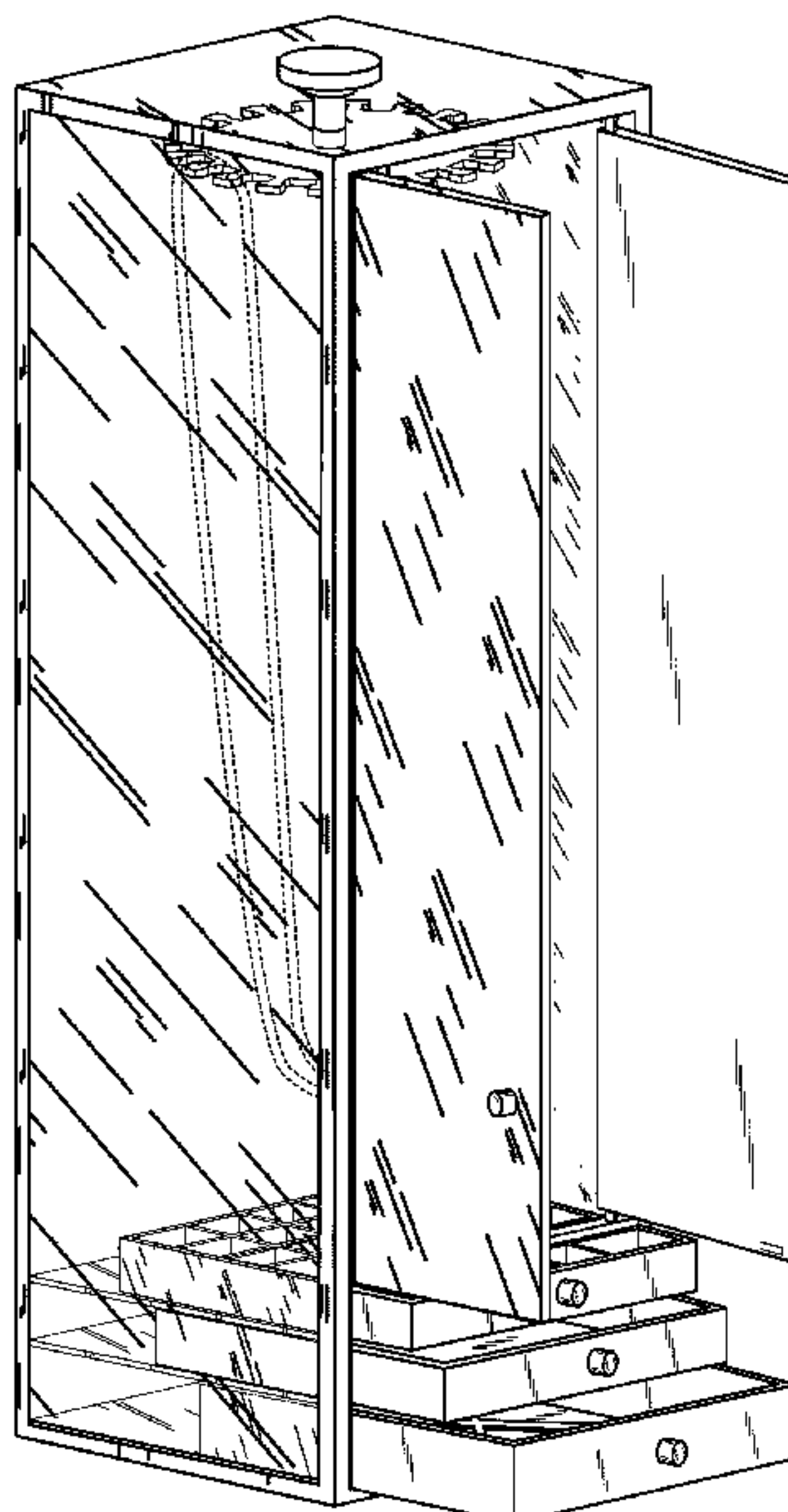
FIG. 14 is a top plan view of the bottom drawer;

FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view of a top drawer of the design; and,

FIG. 16 is a top plan view of the top drawer.

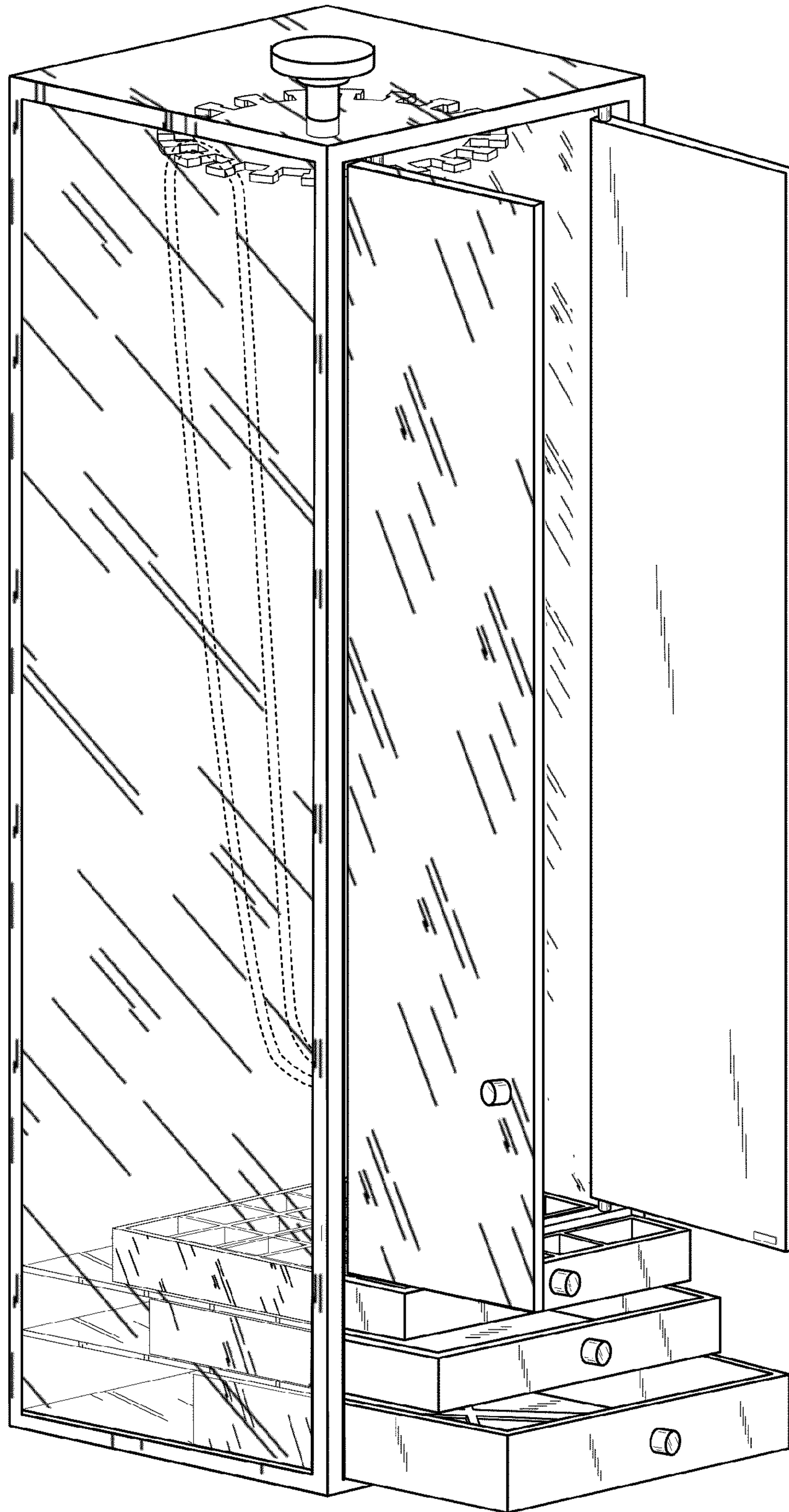

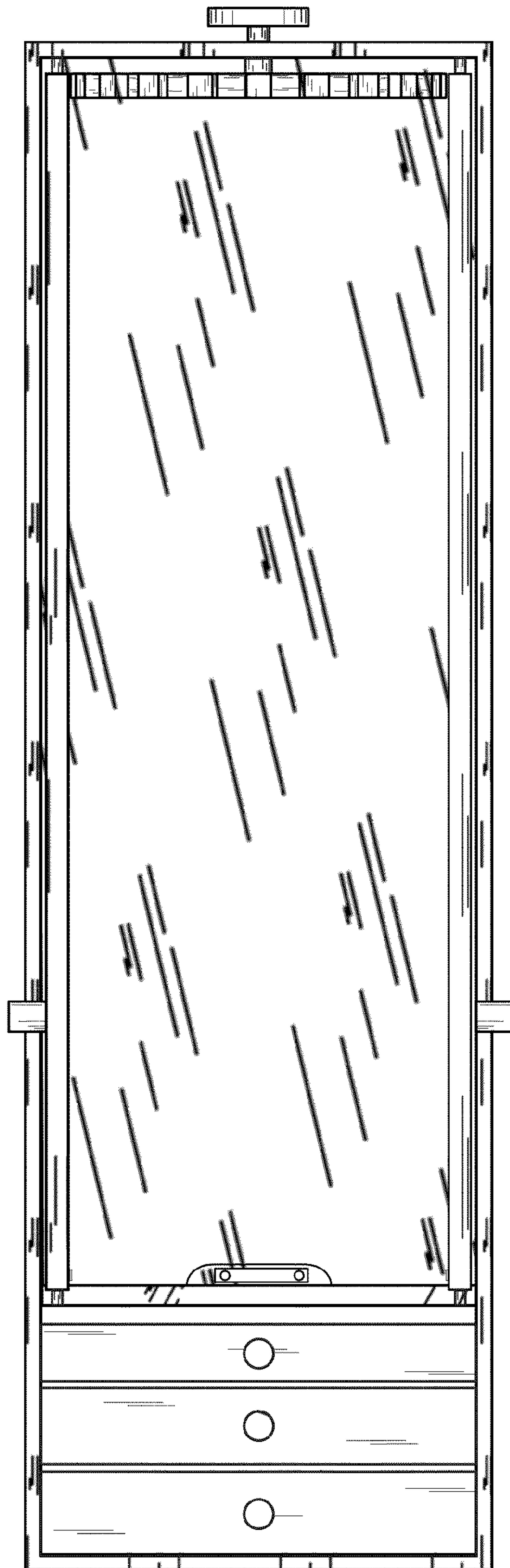

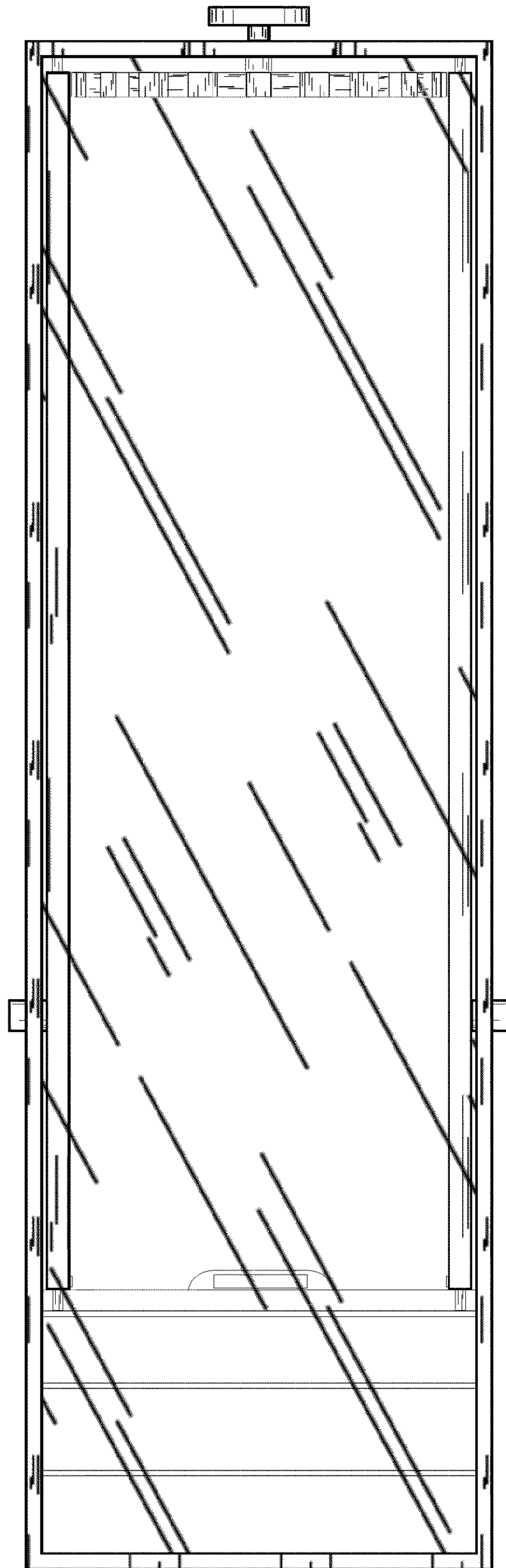

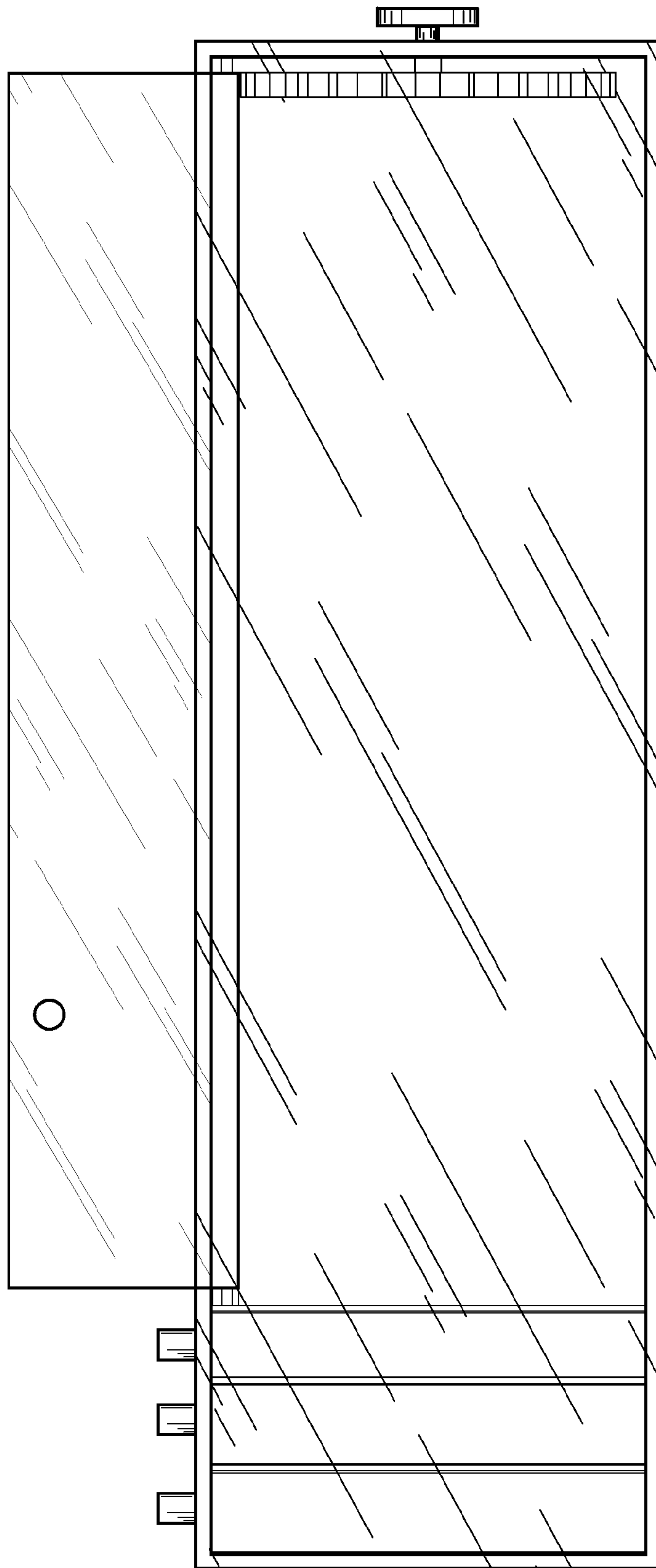

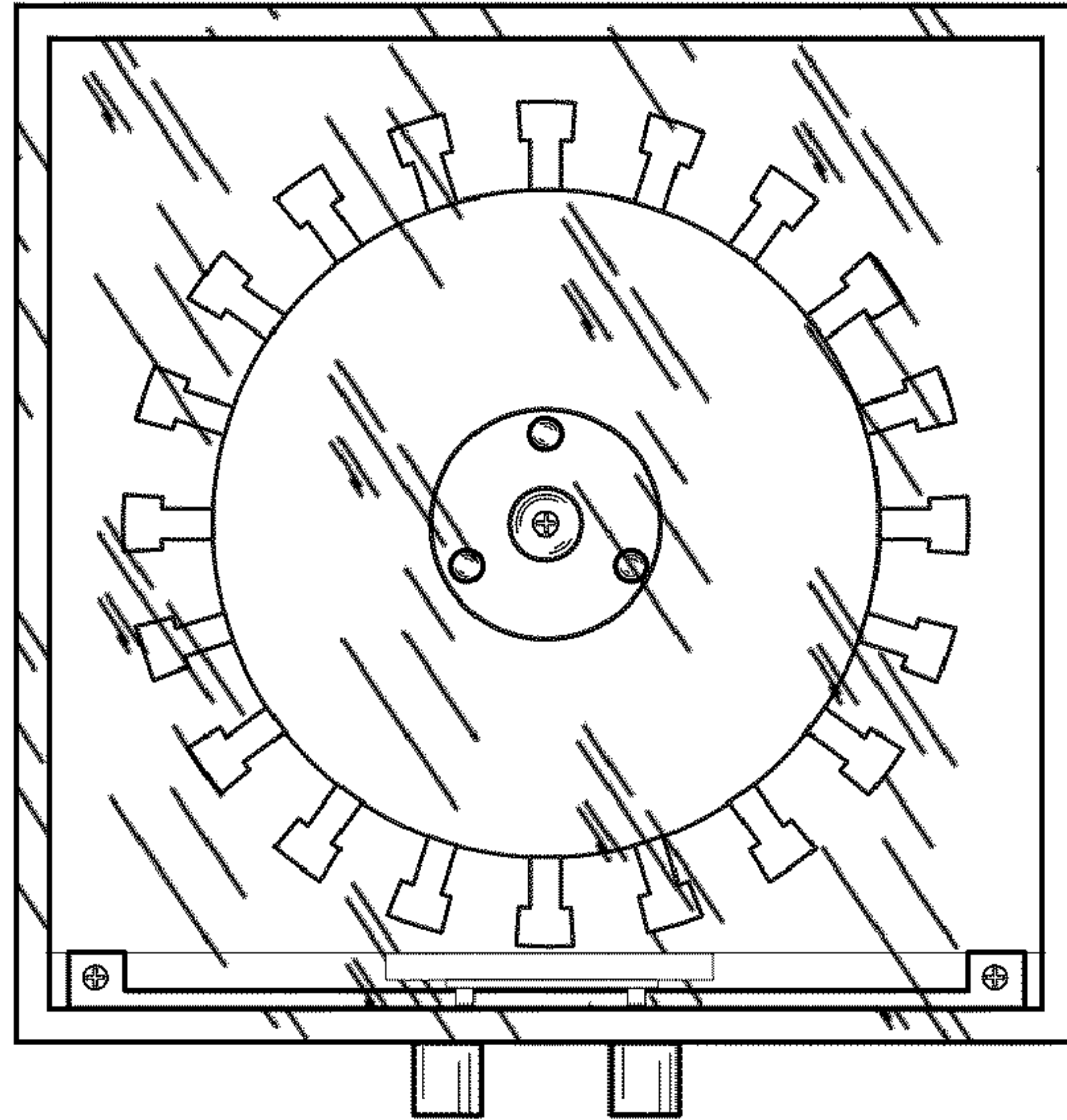

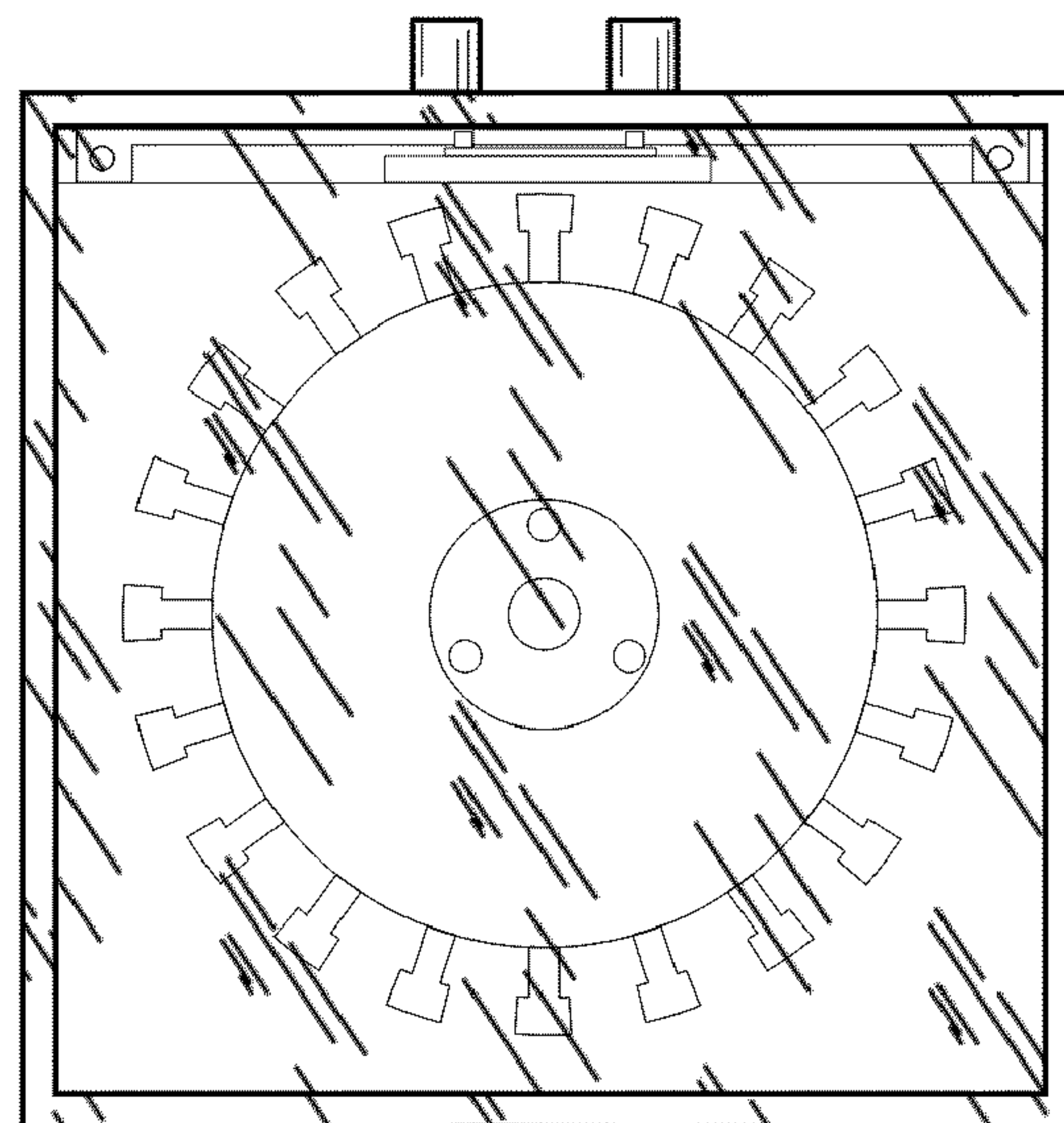

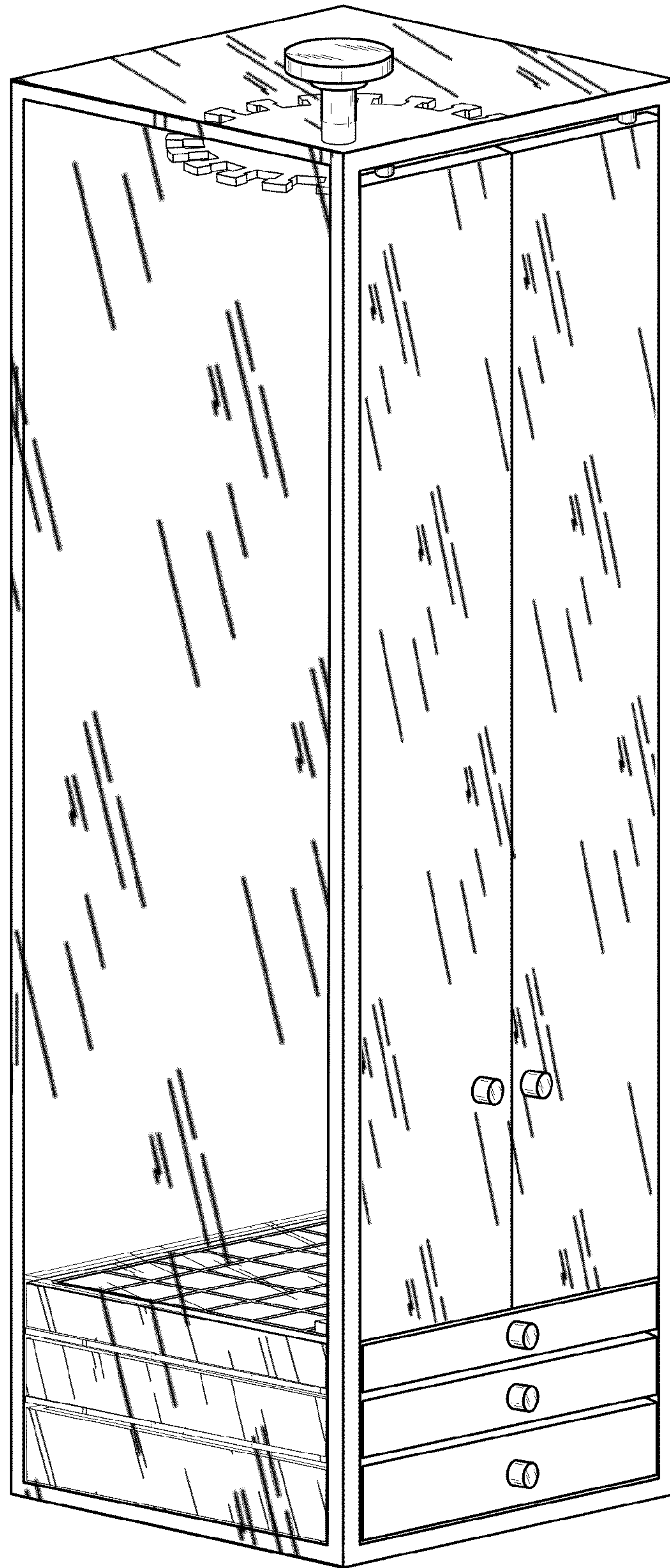

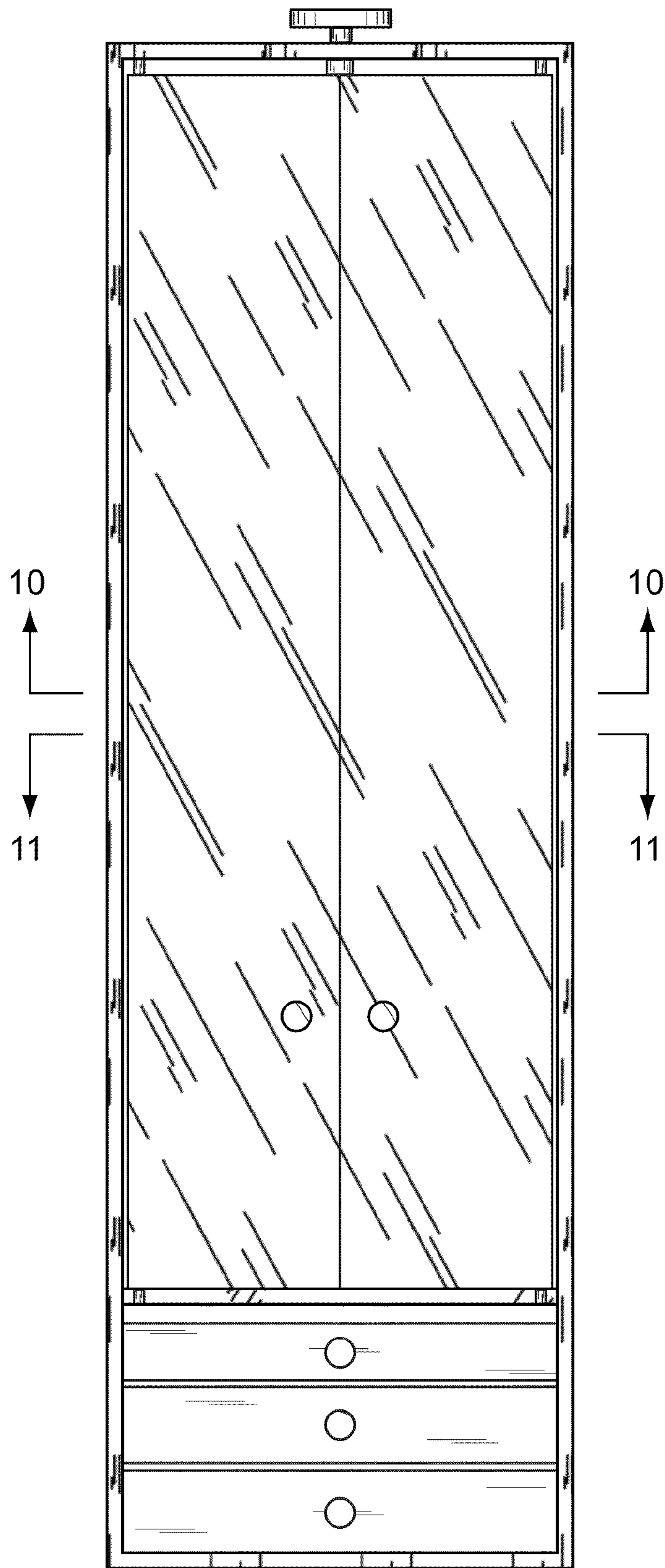

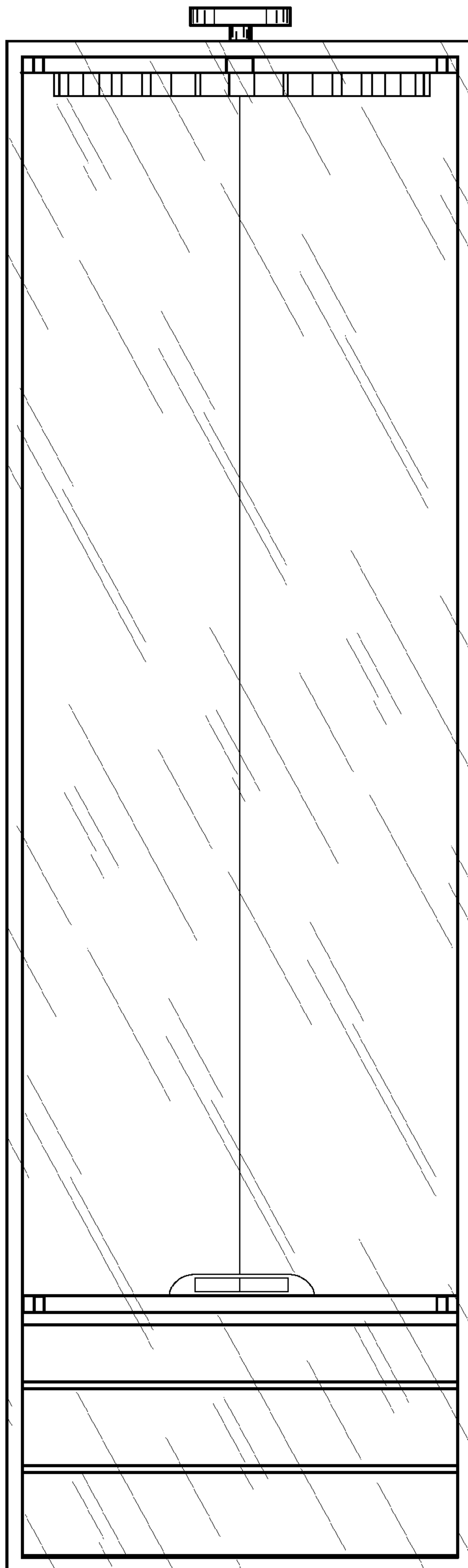

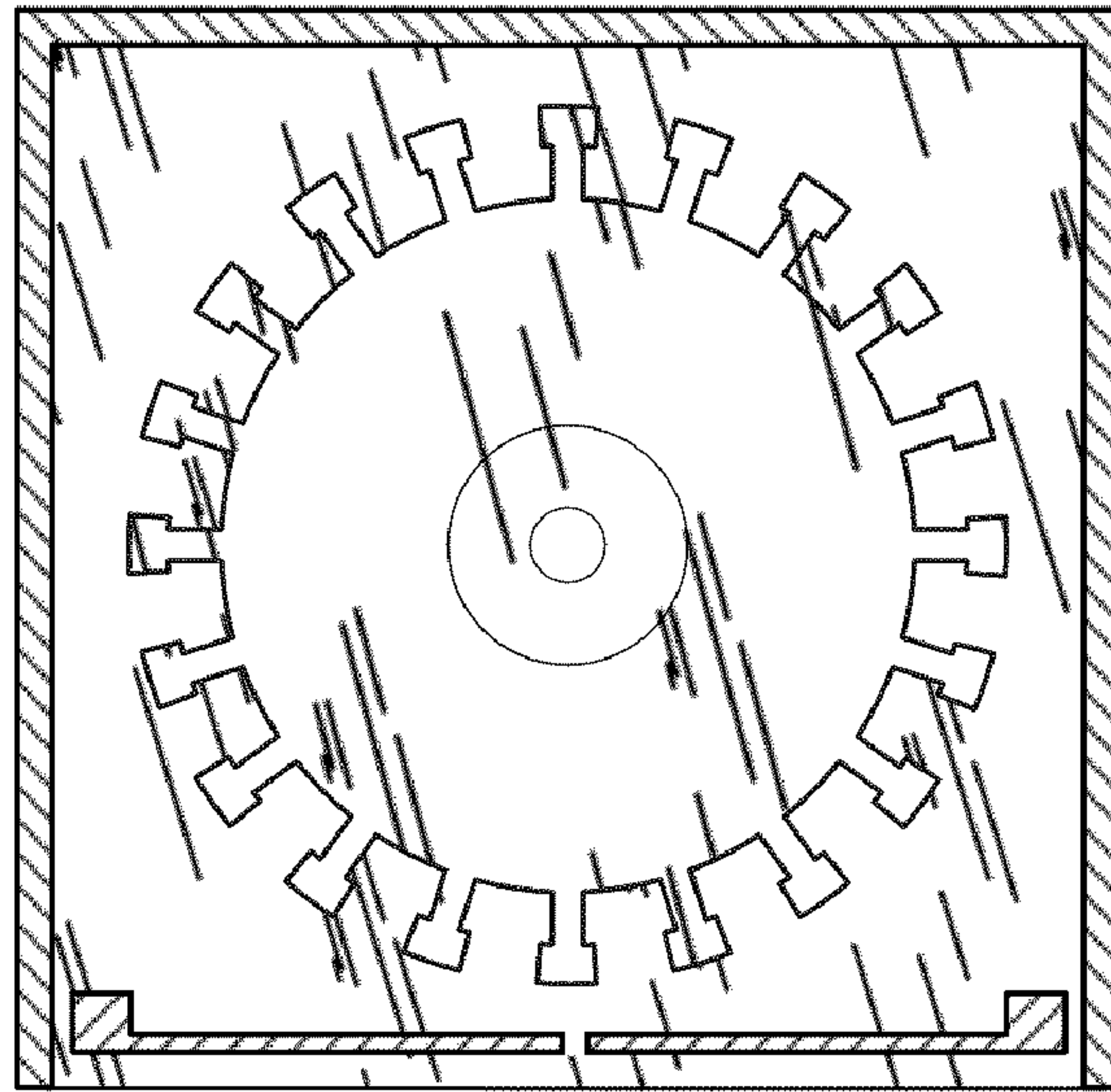

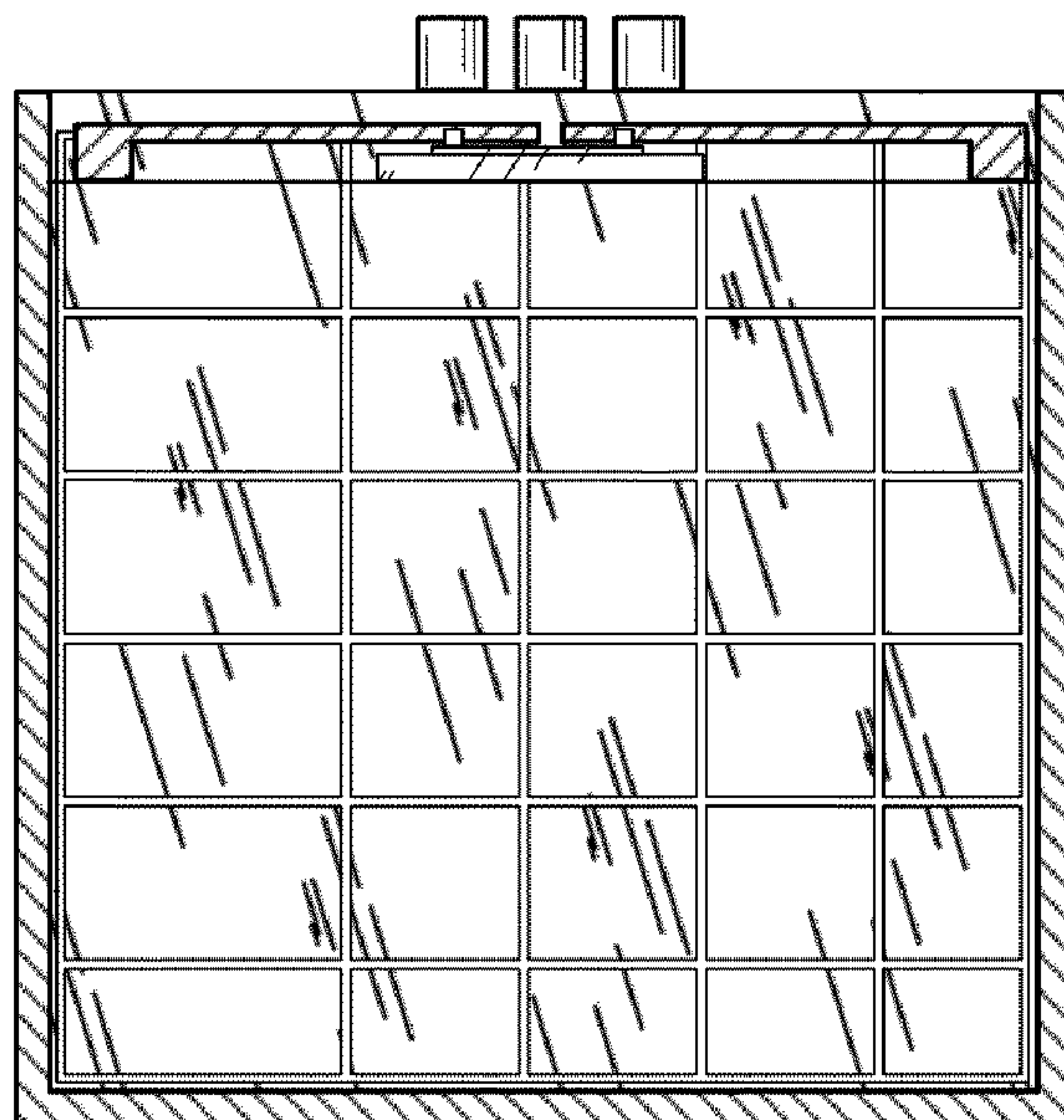

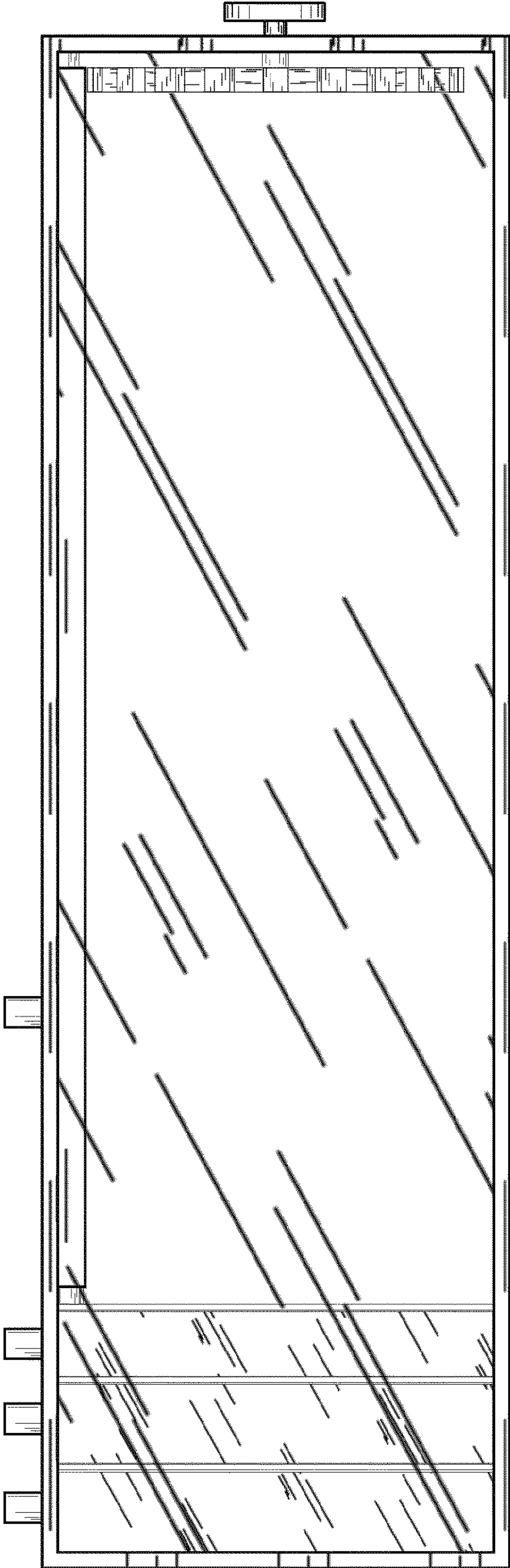

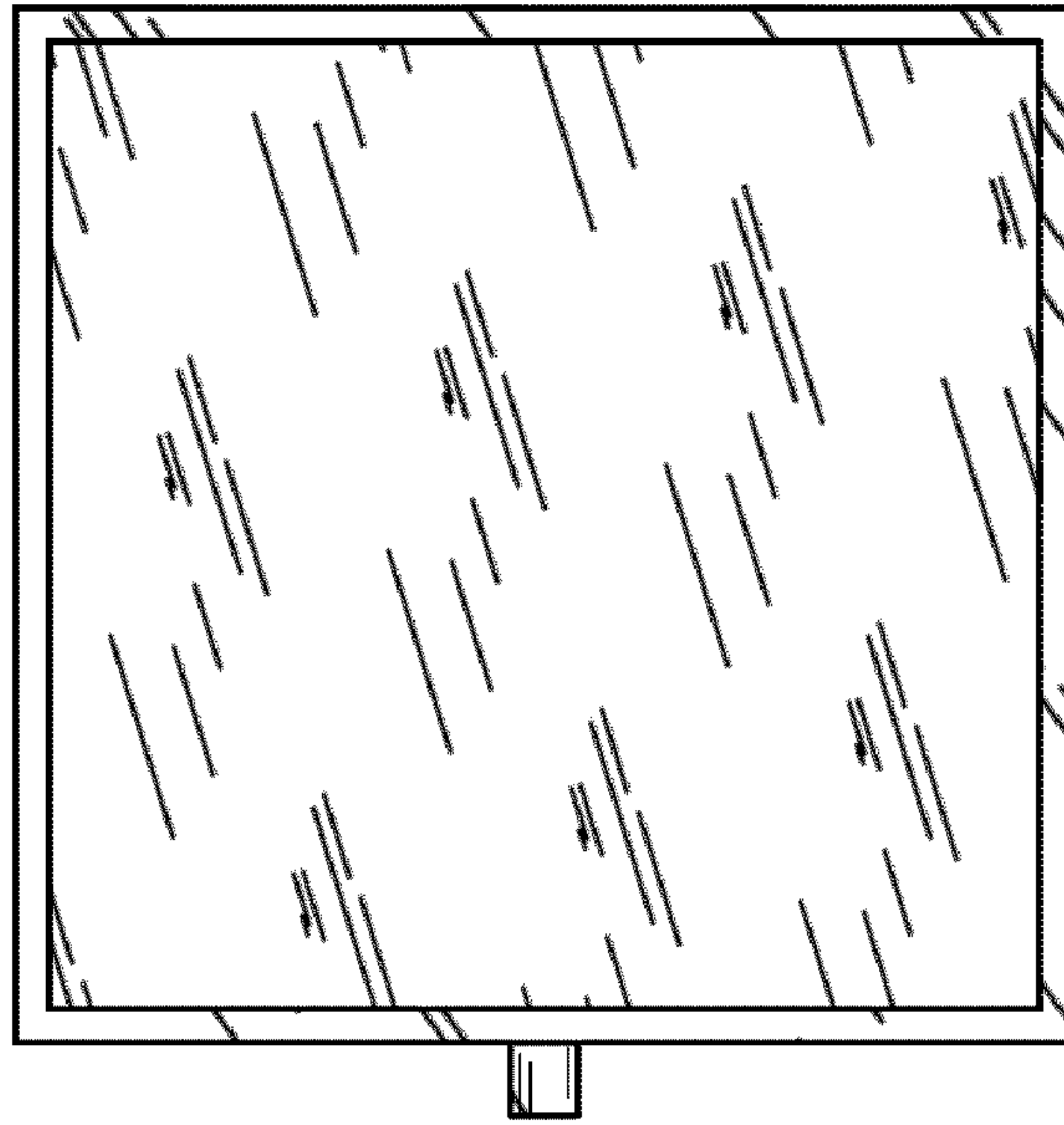

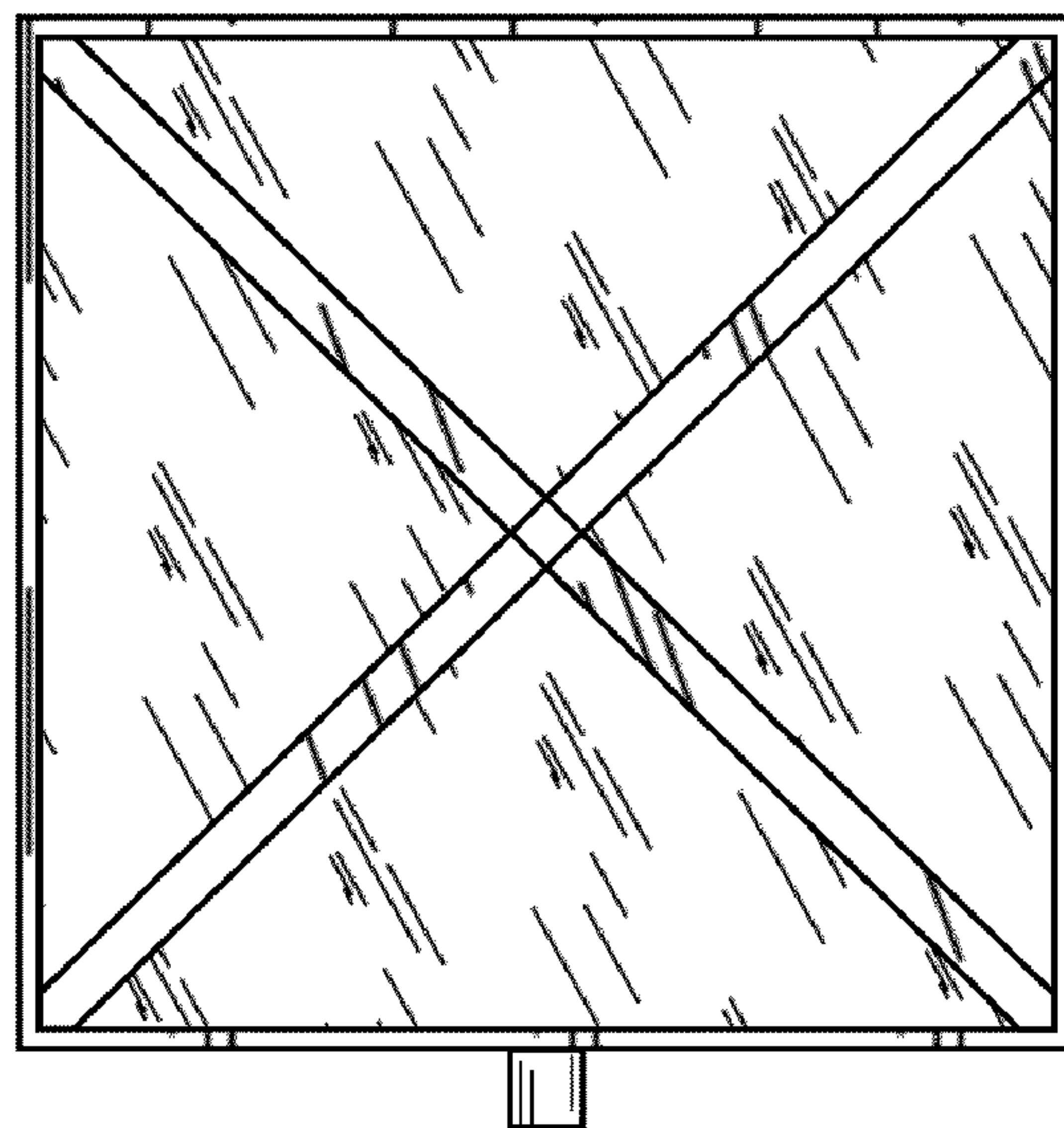

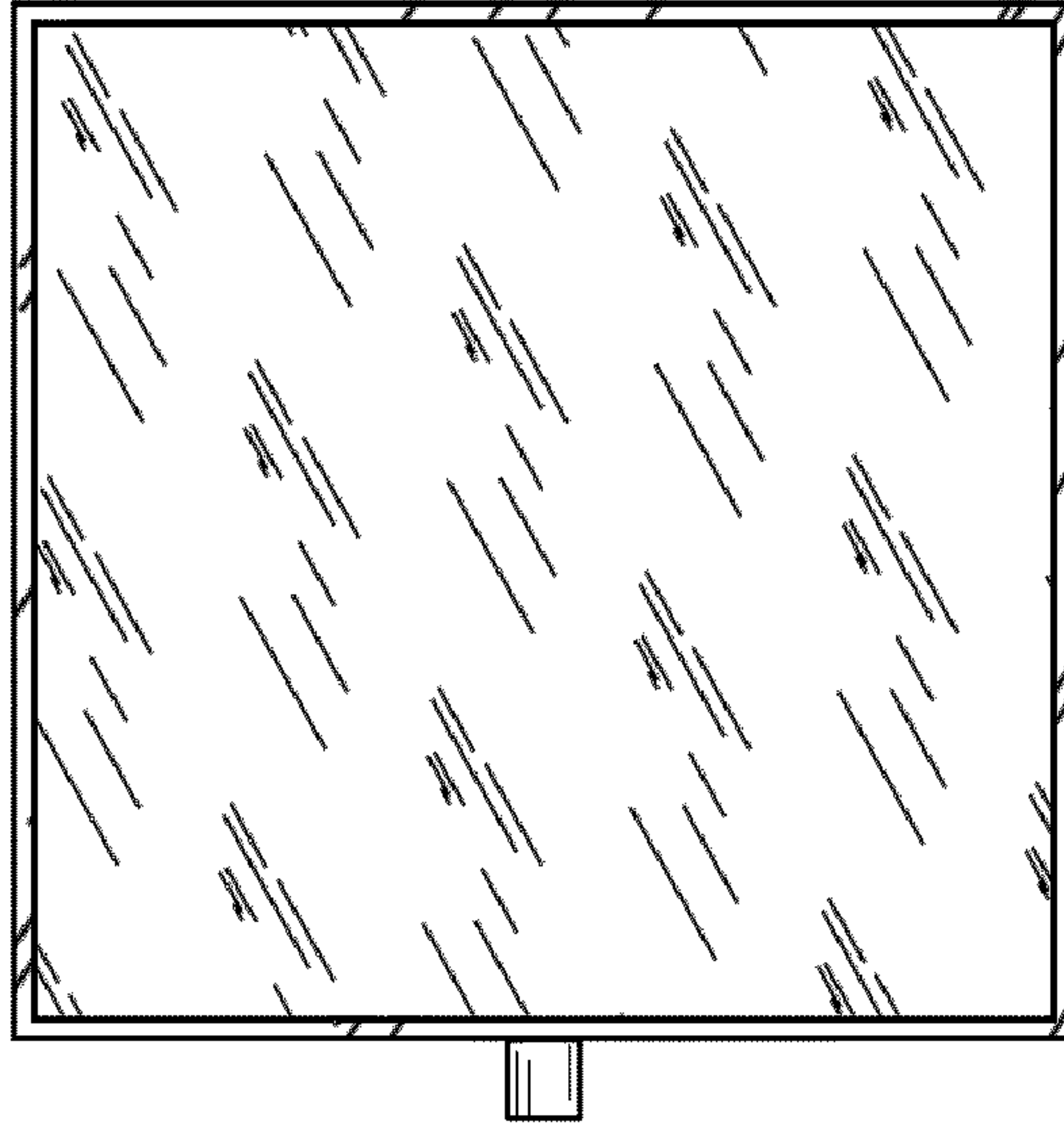

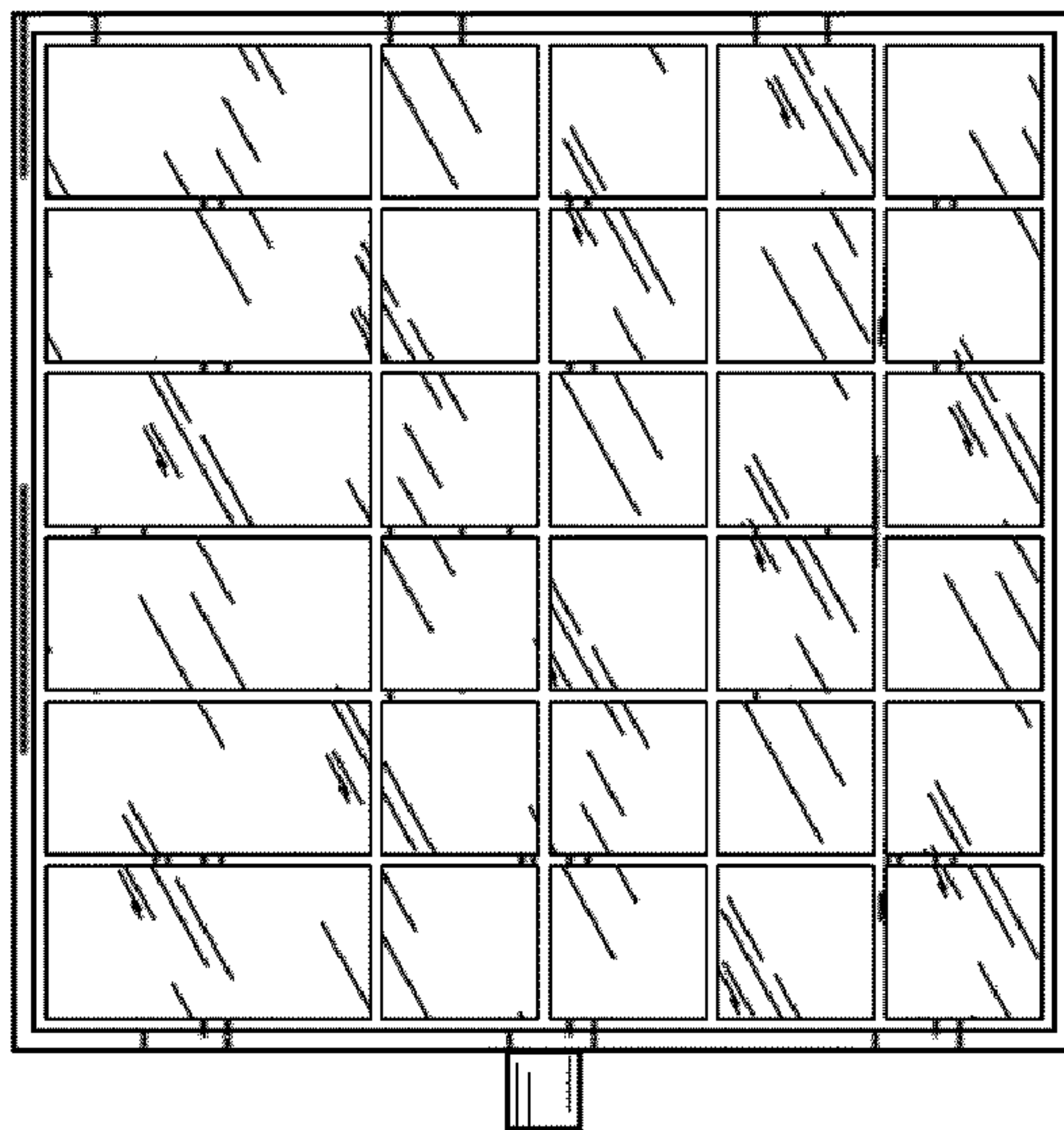
