The ornamental design for a stud with grooves for a fashion article, as shown and described.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

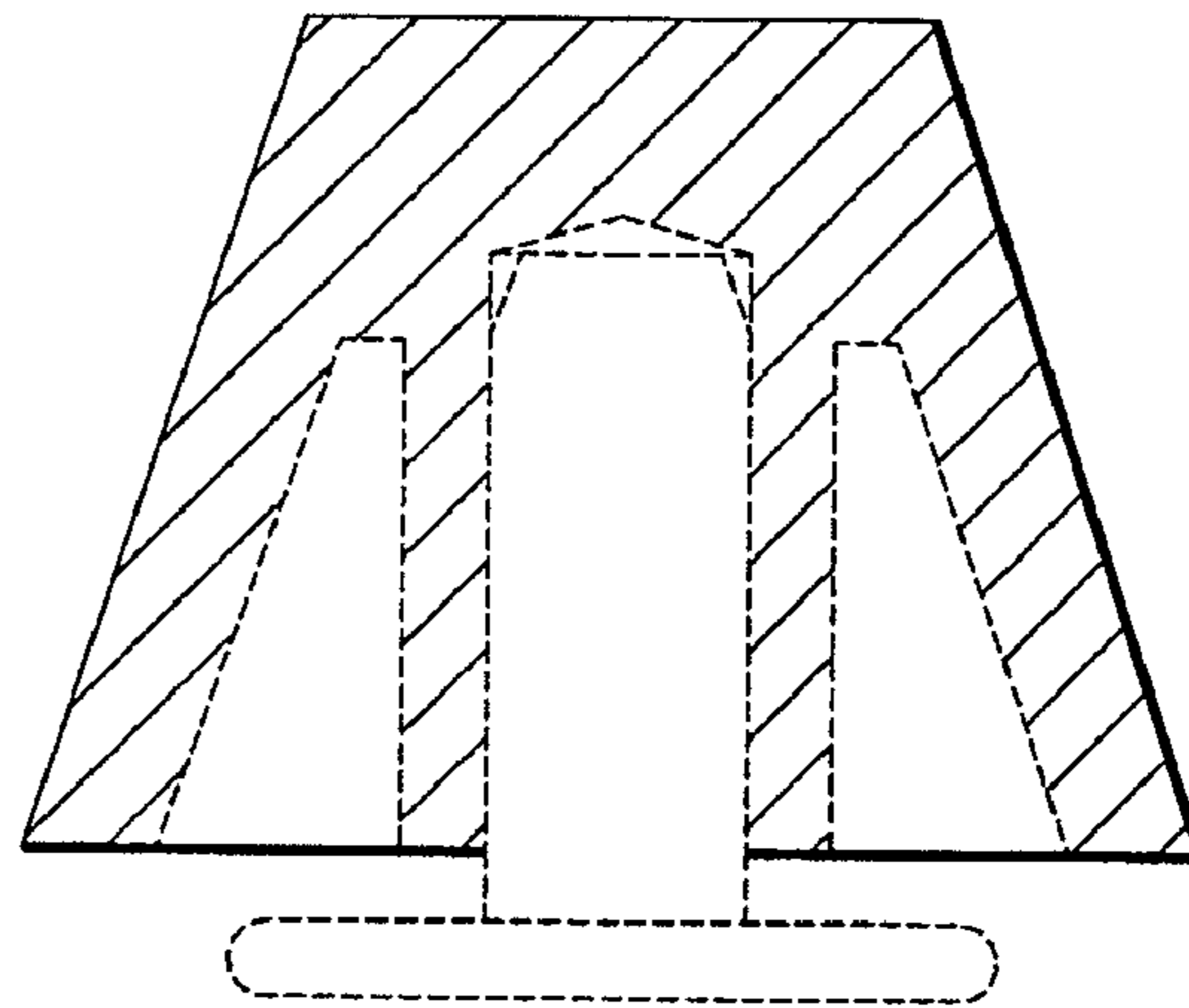
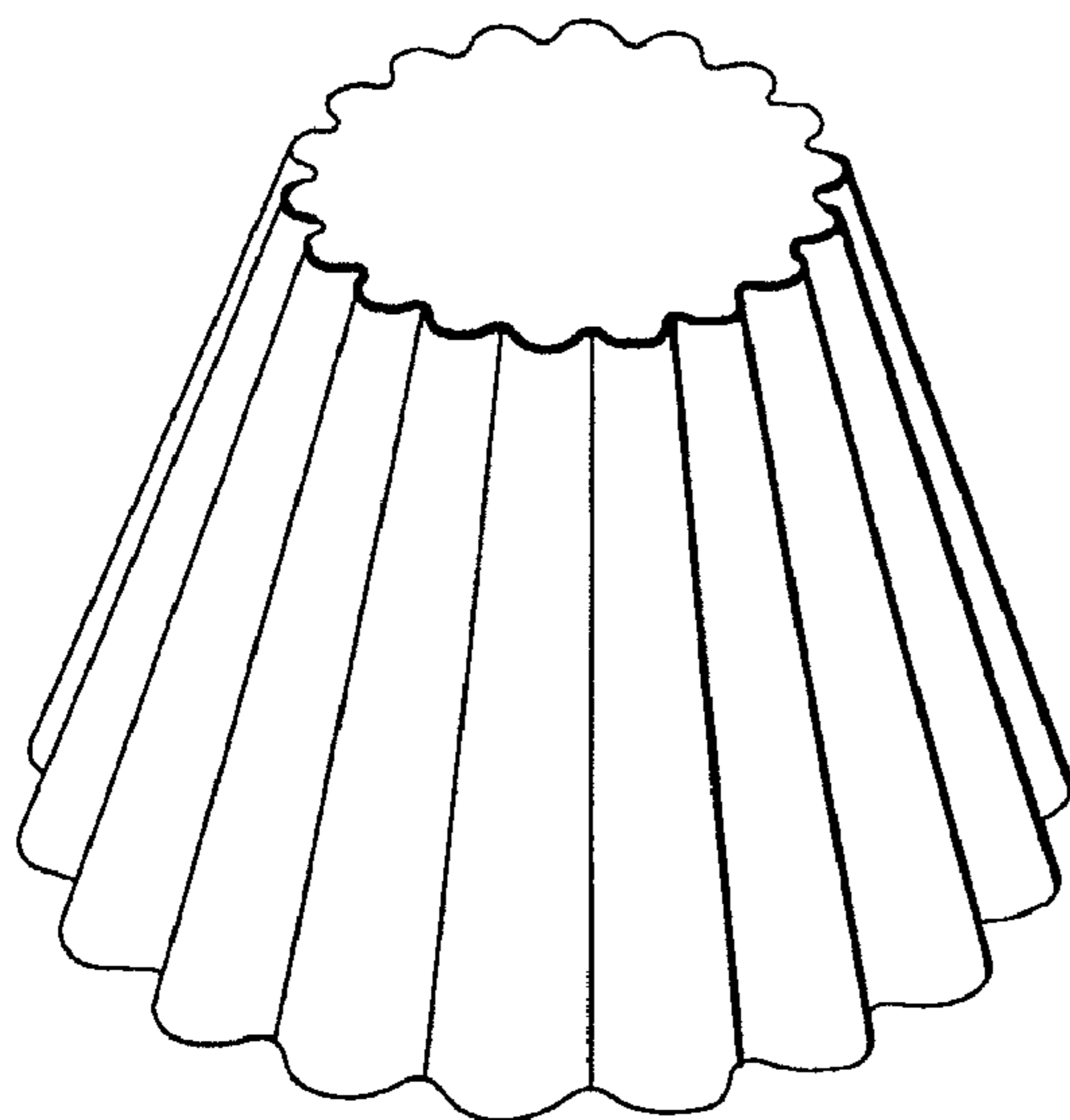
FIG. 3 is a elevational view thereof;

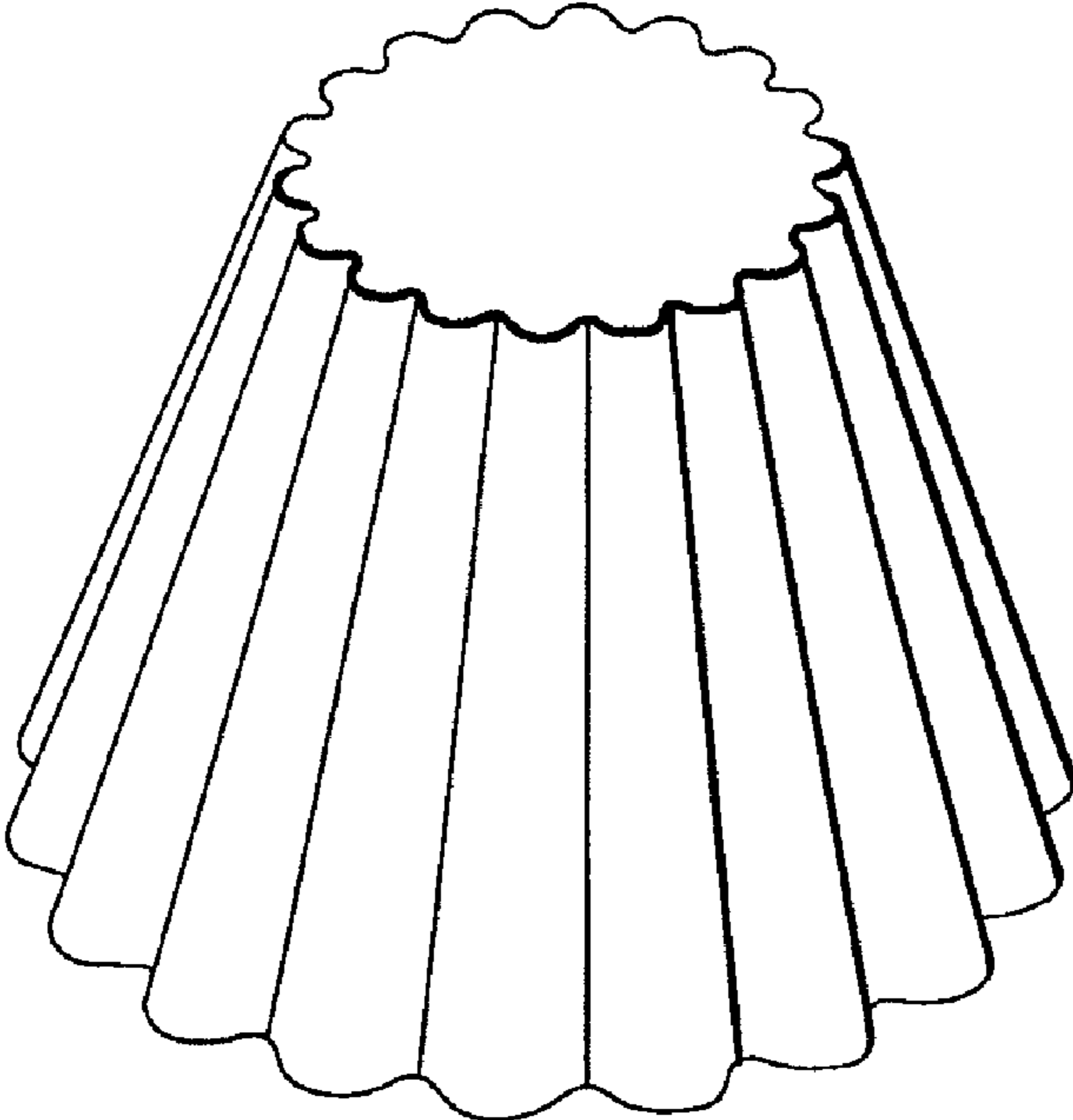

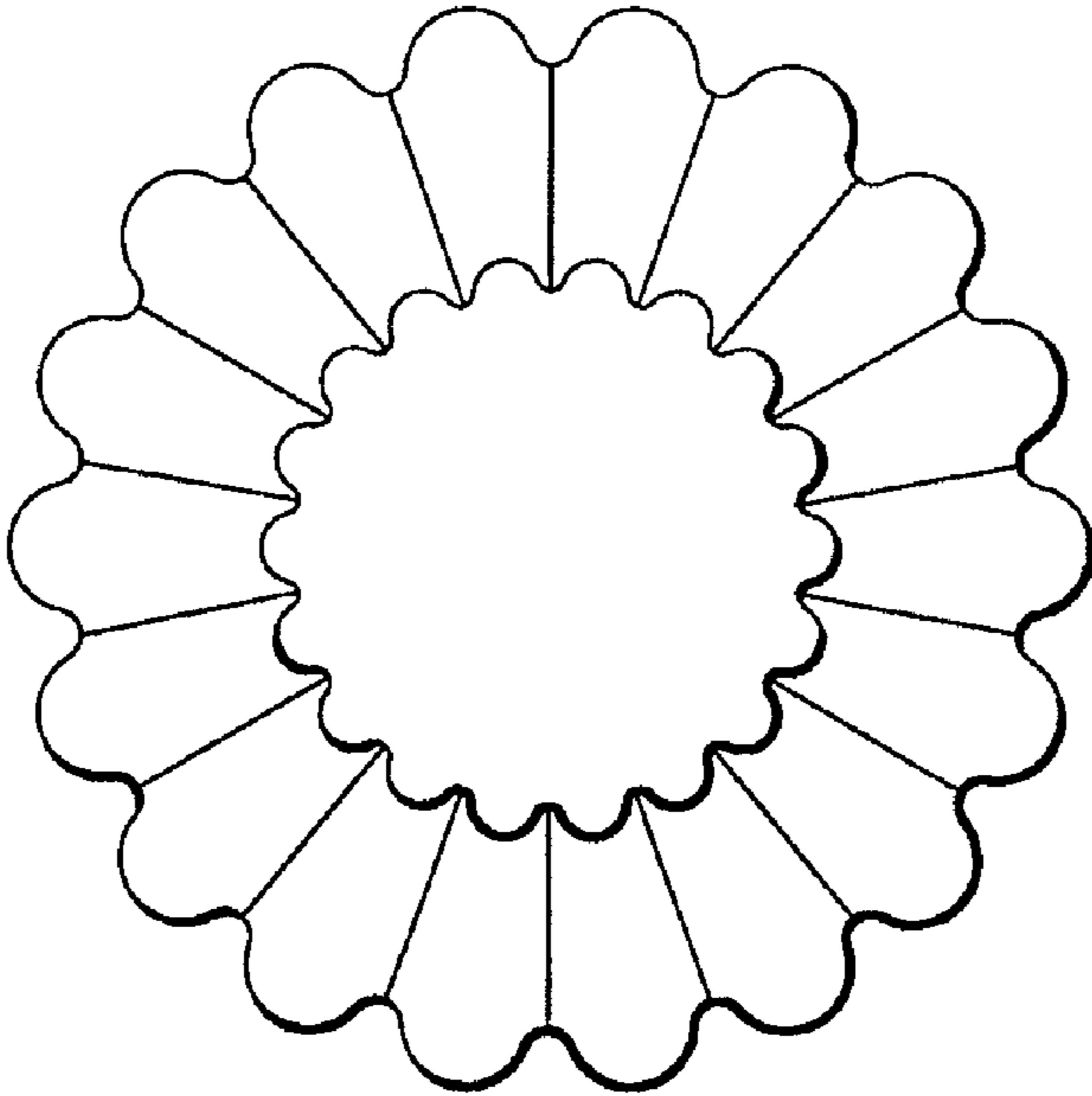

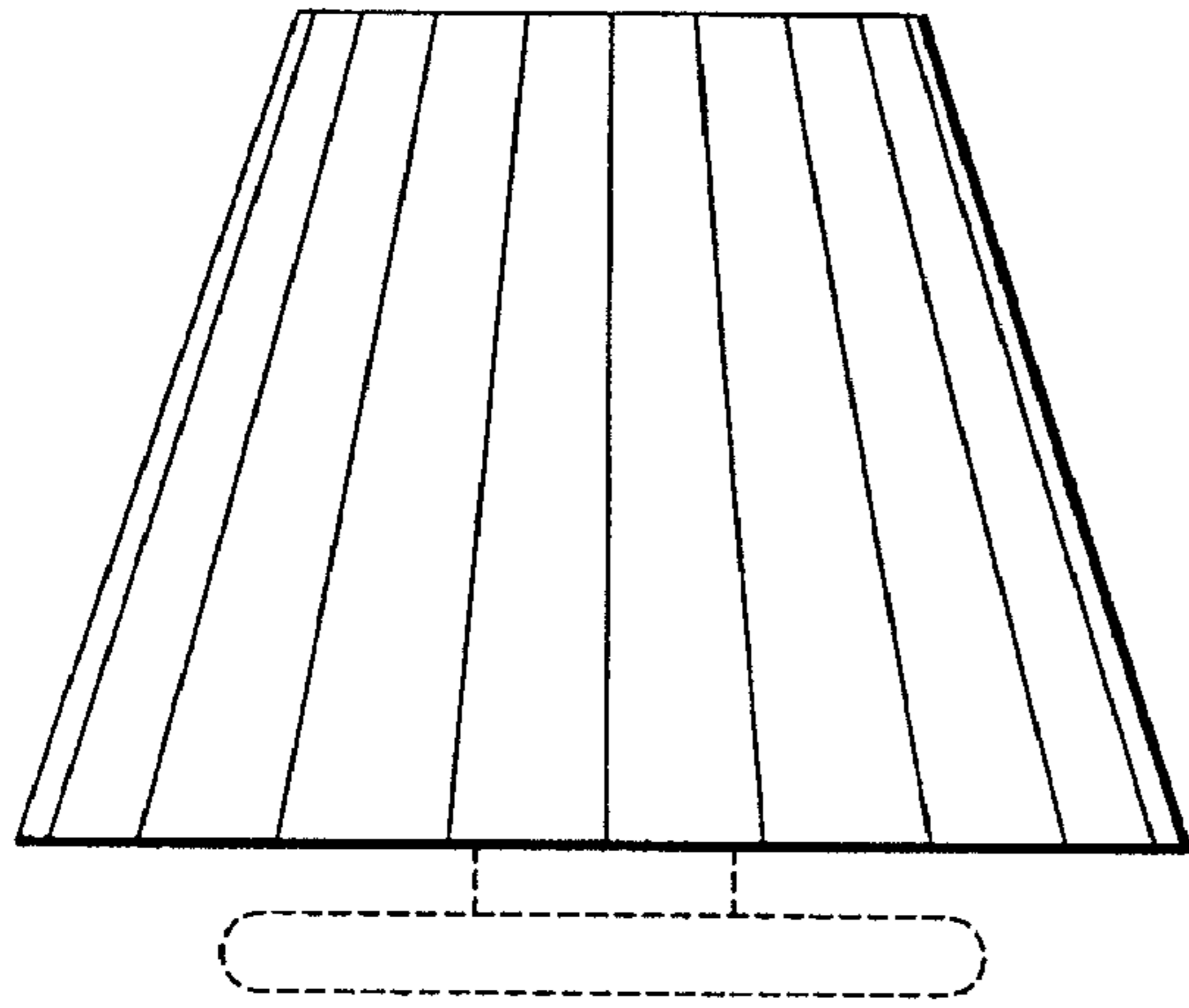

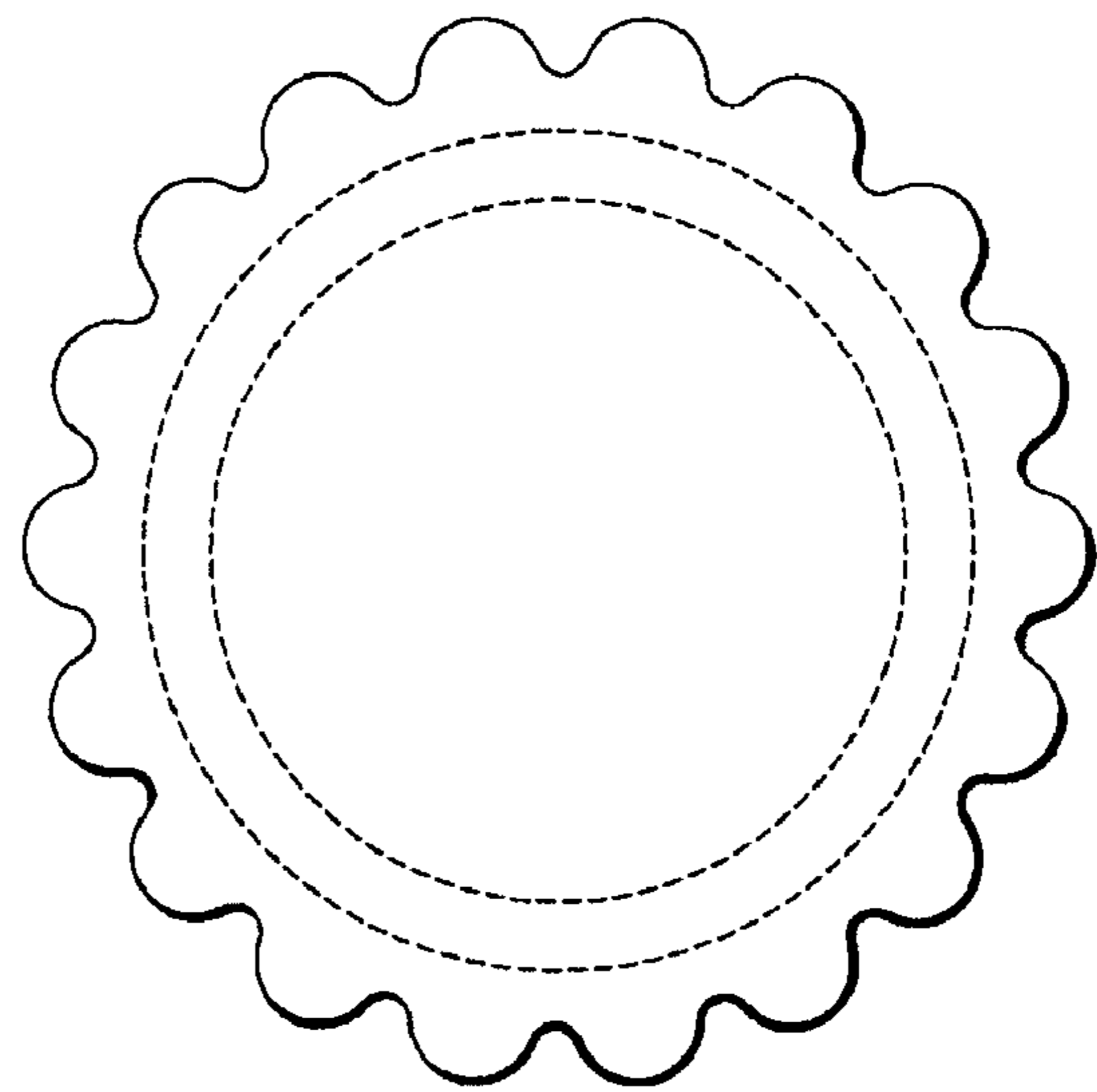

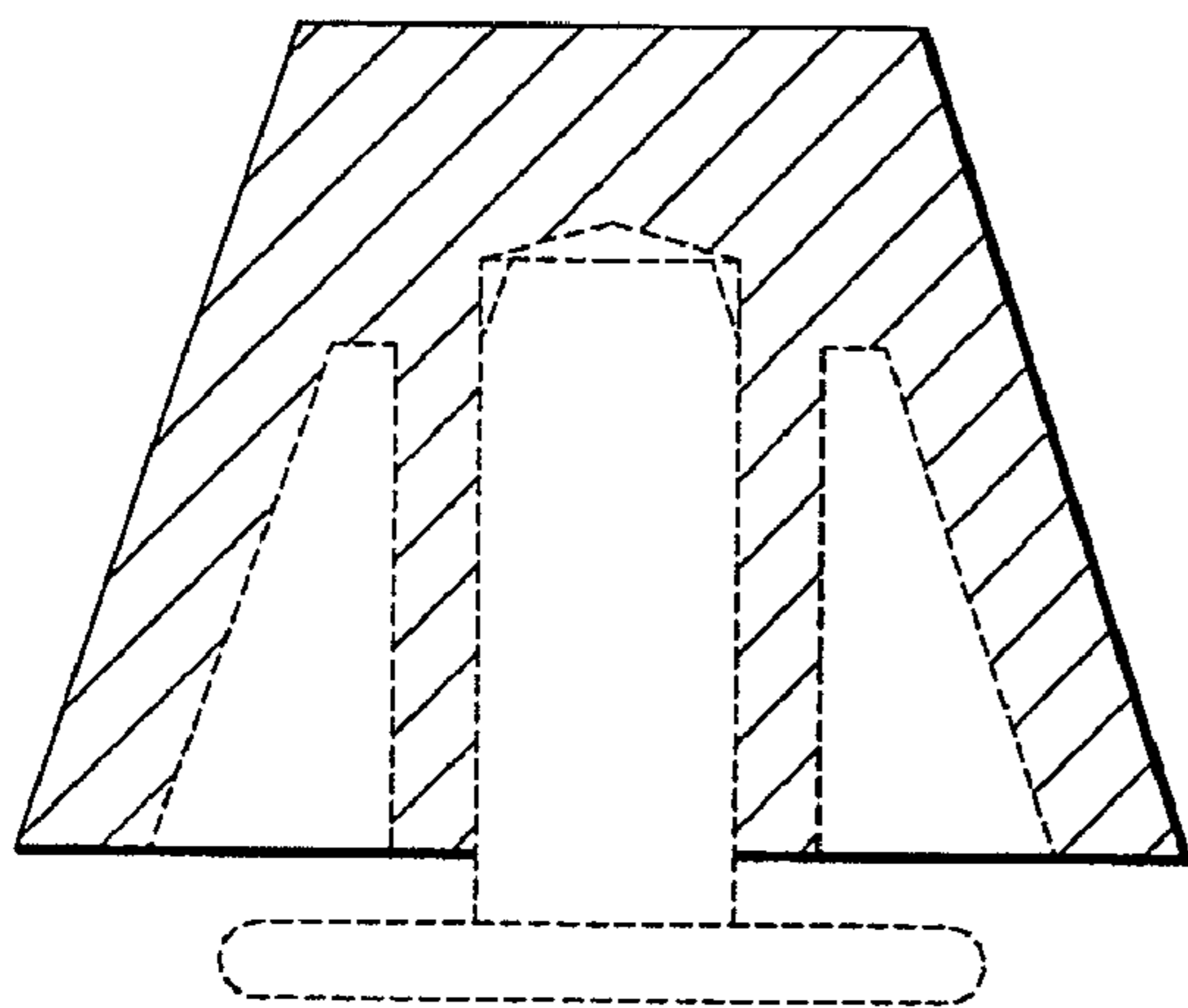
