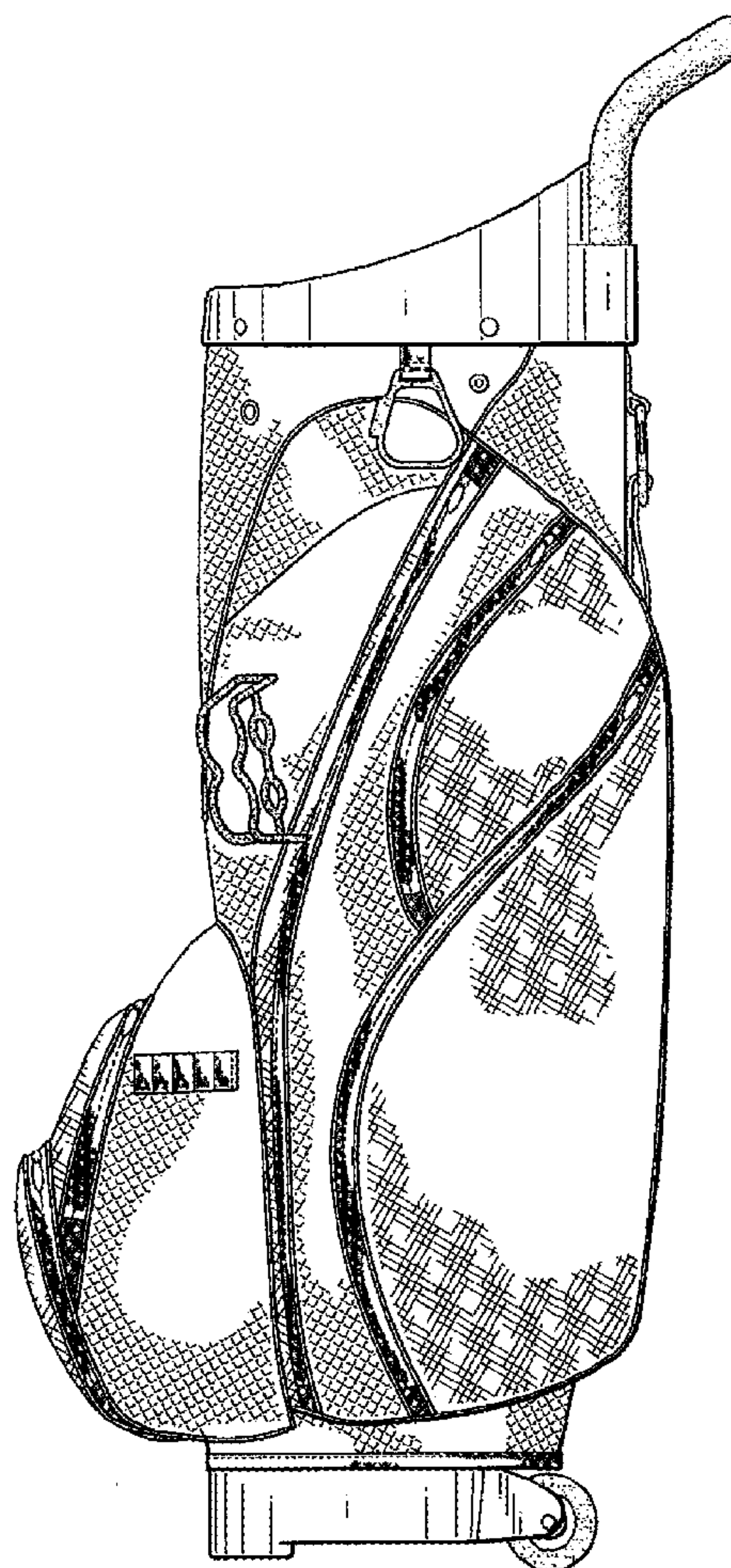
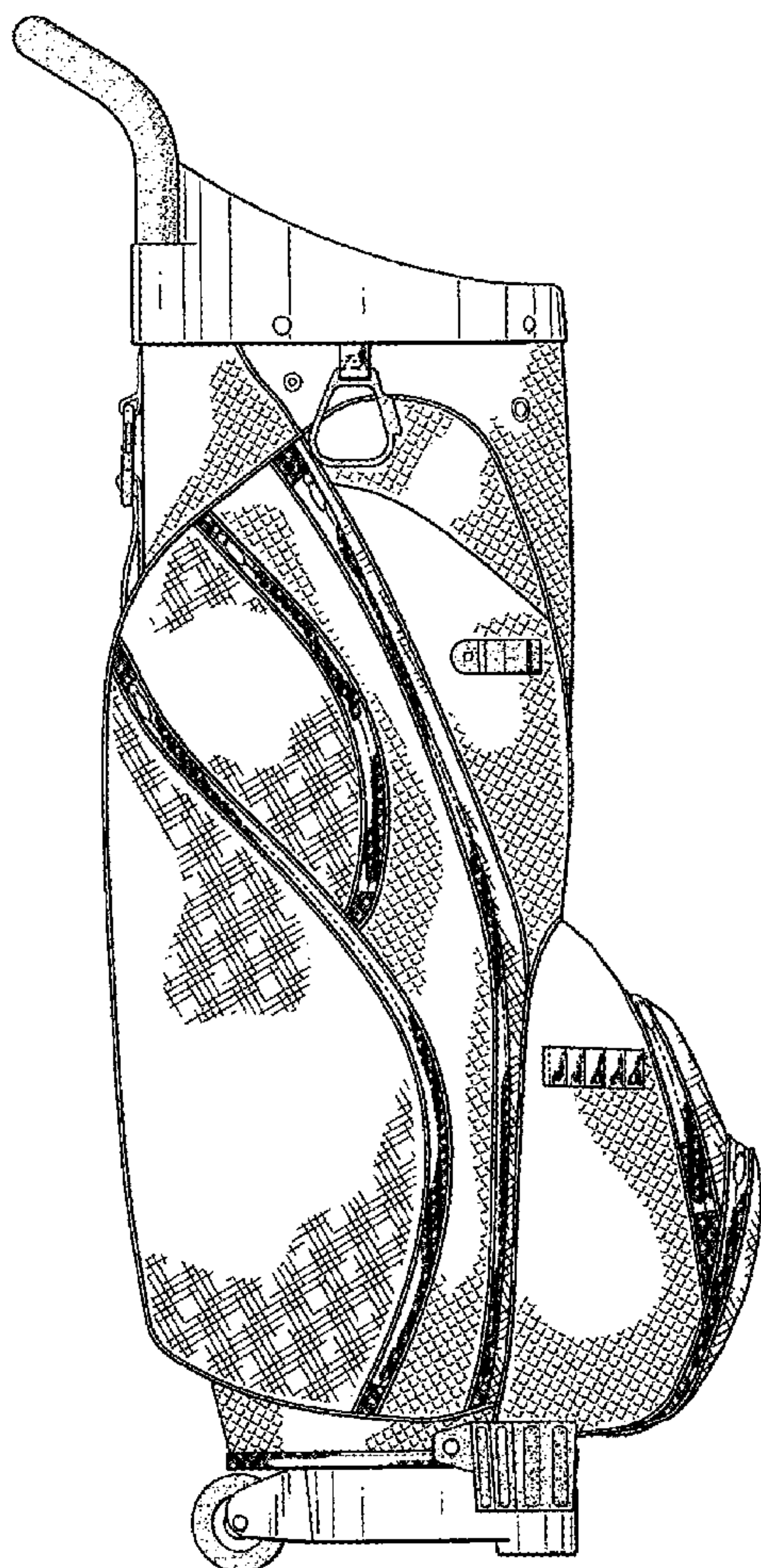
The ornamental design for a golf bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an environmental perspective view of a golf bag showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

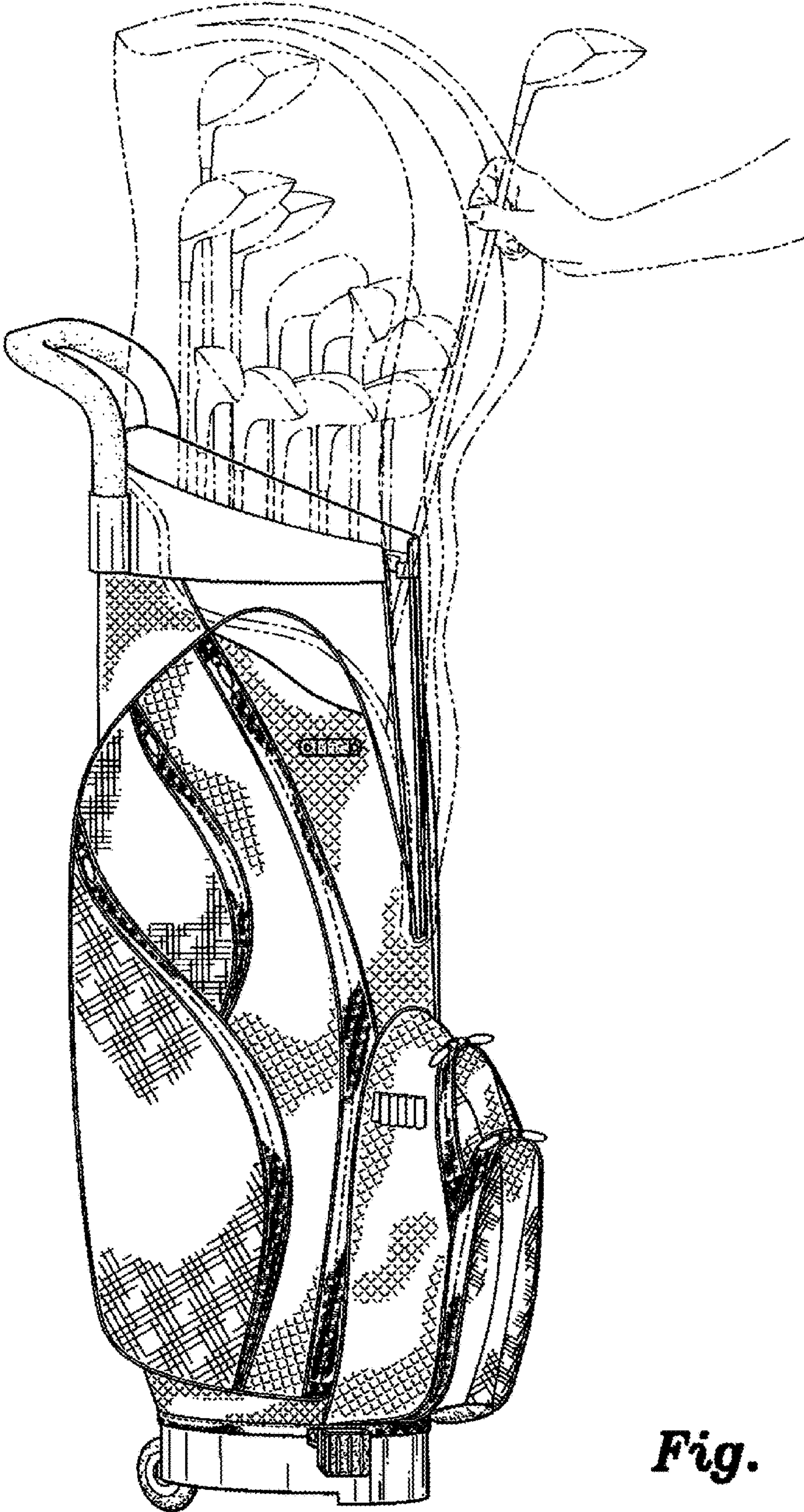

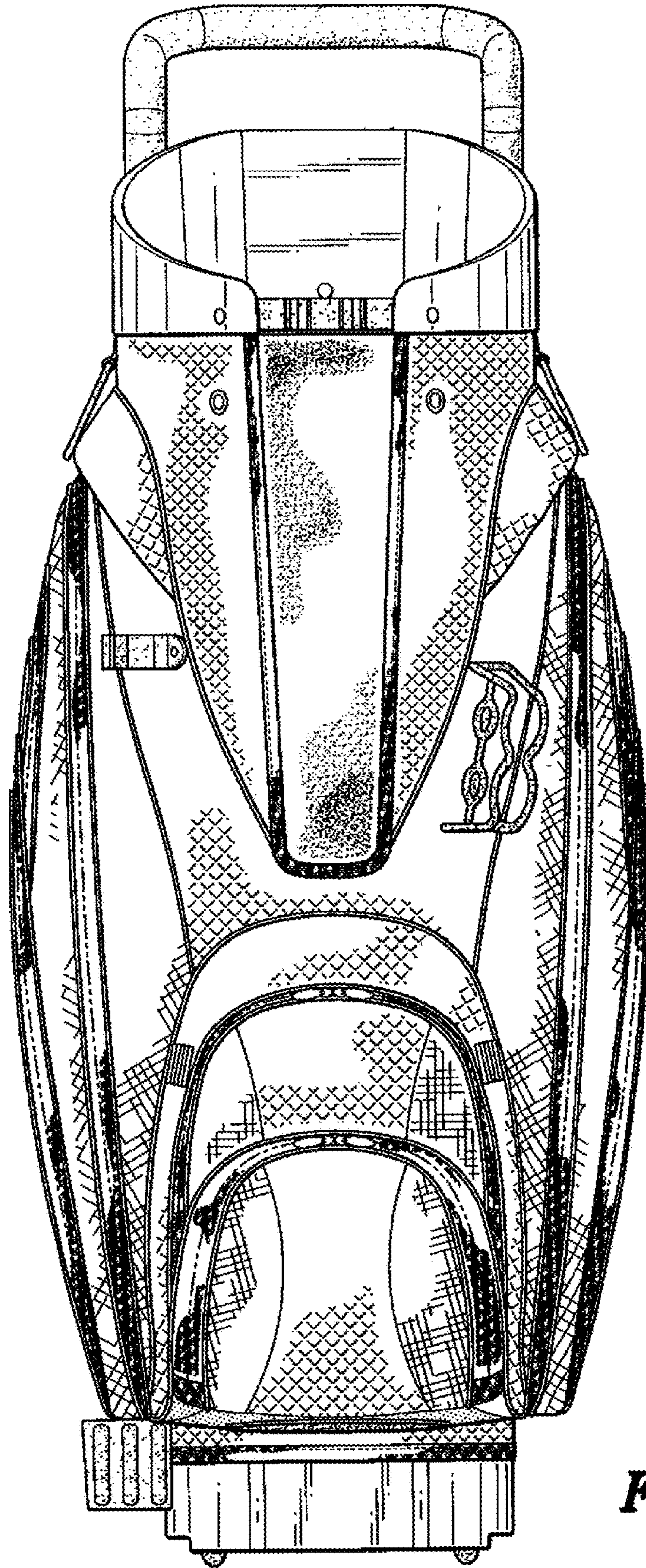

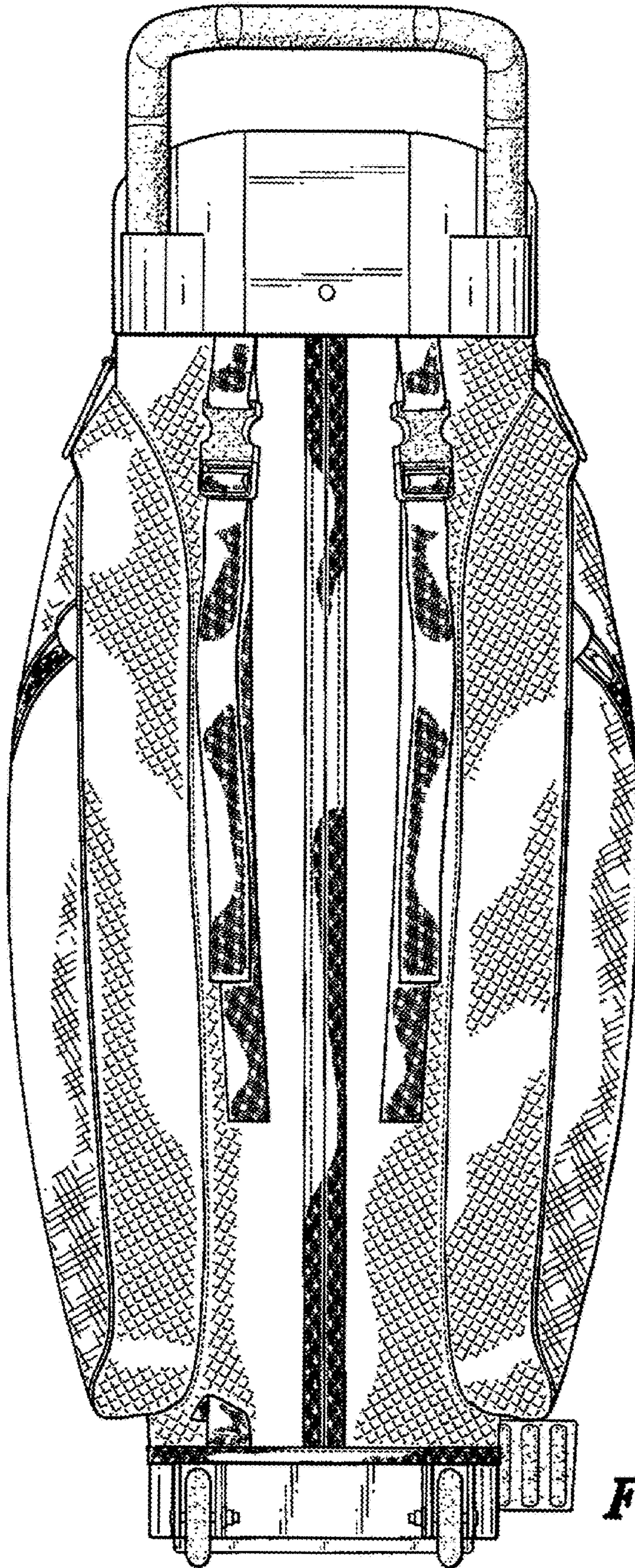

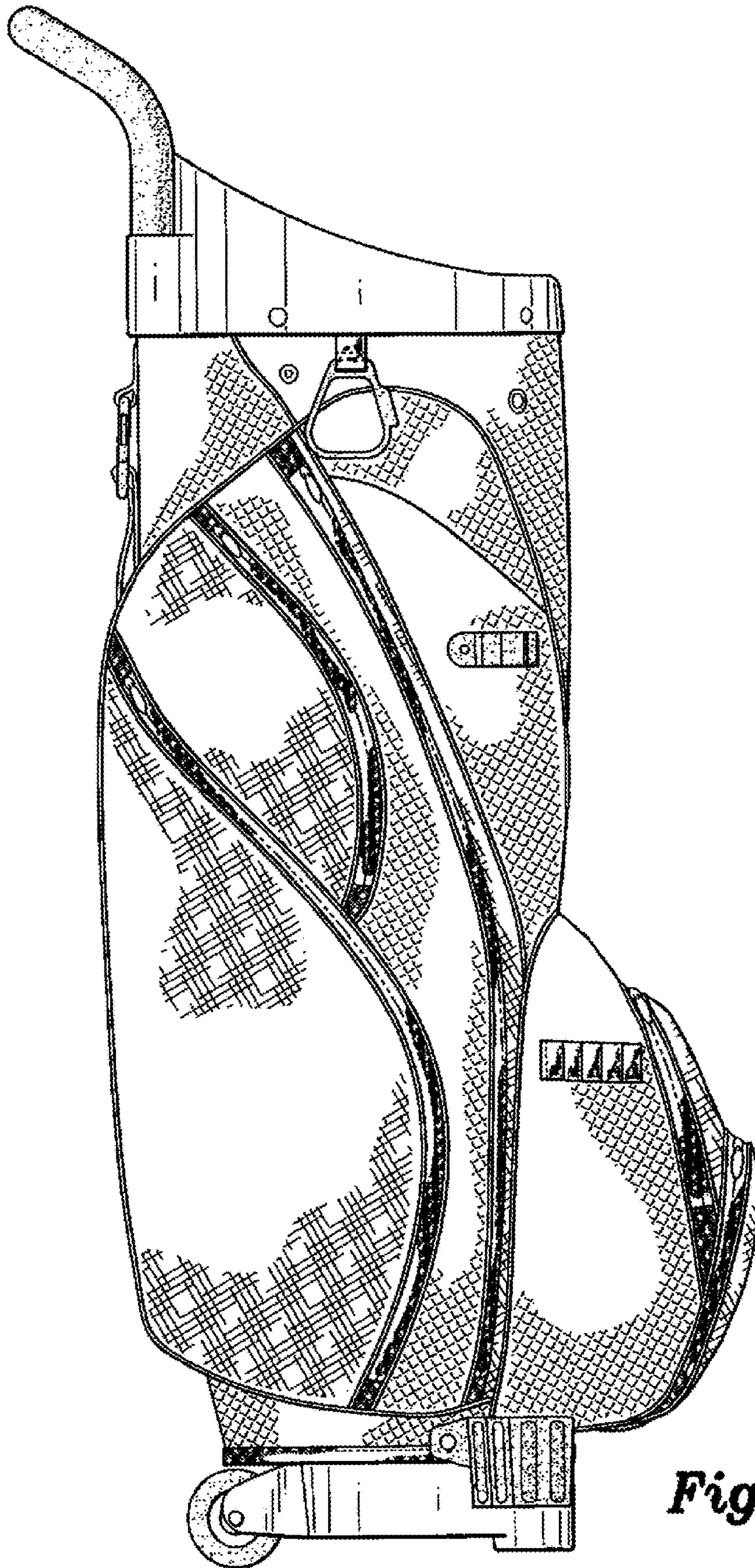

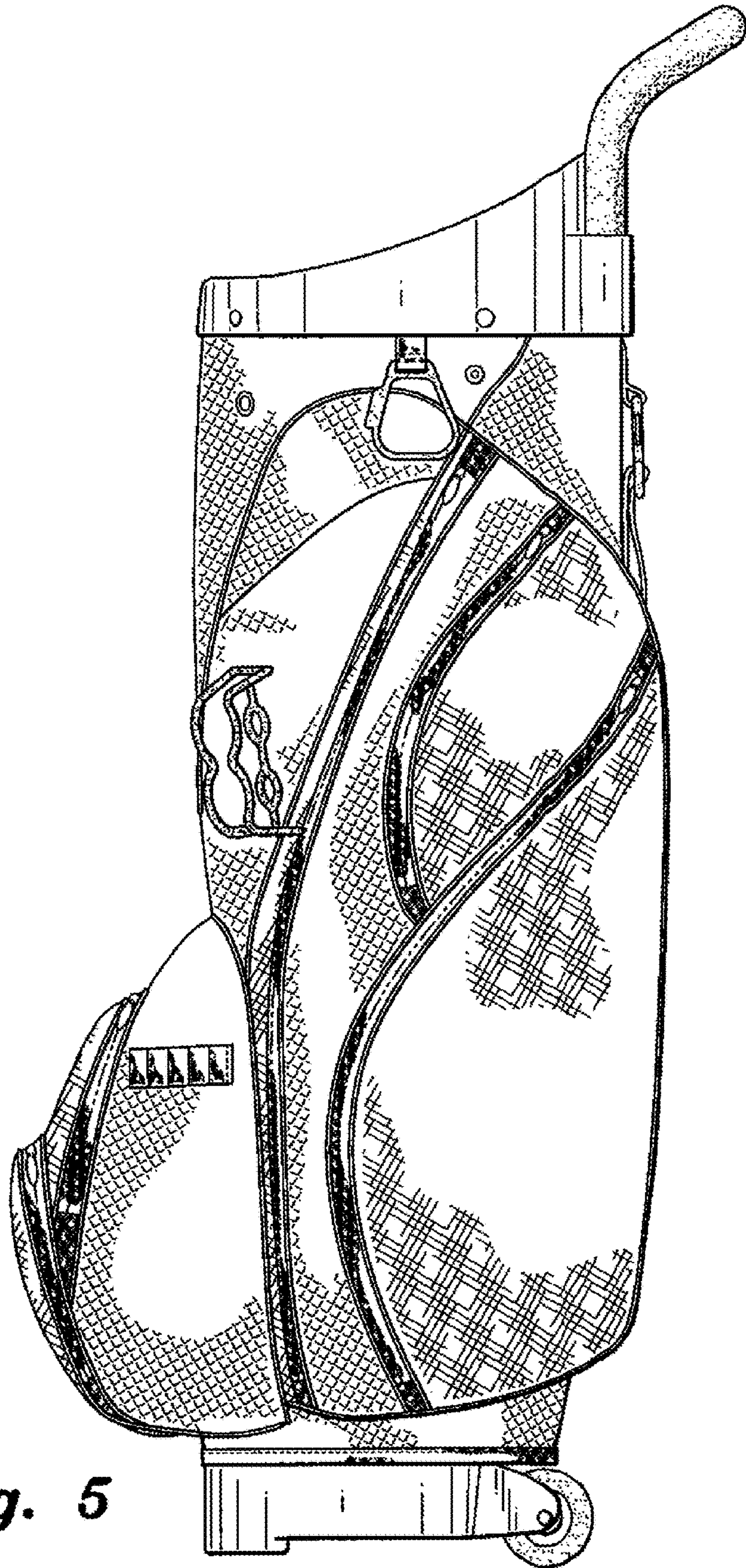

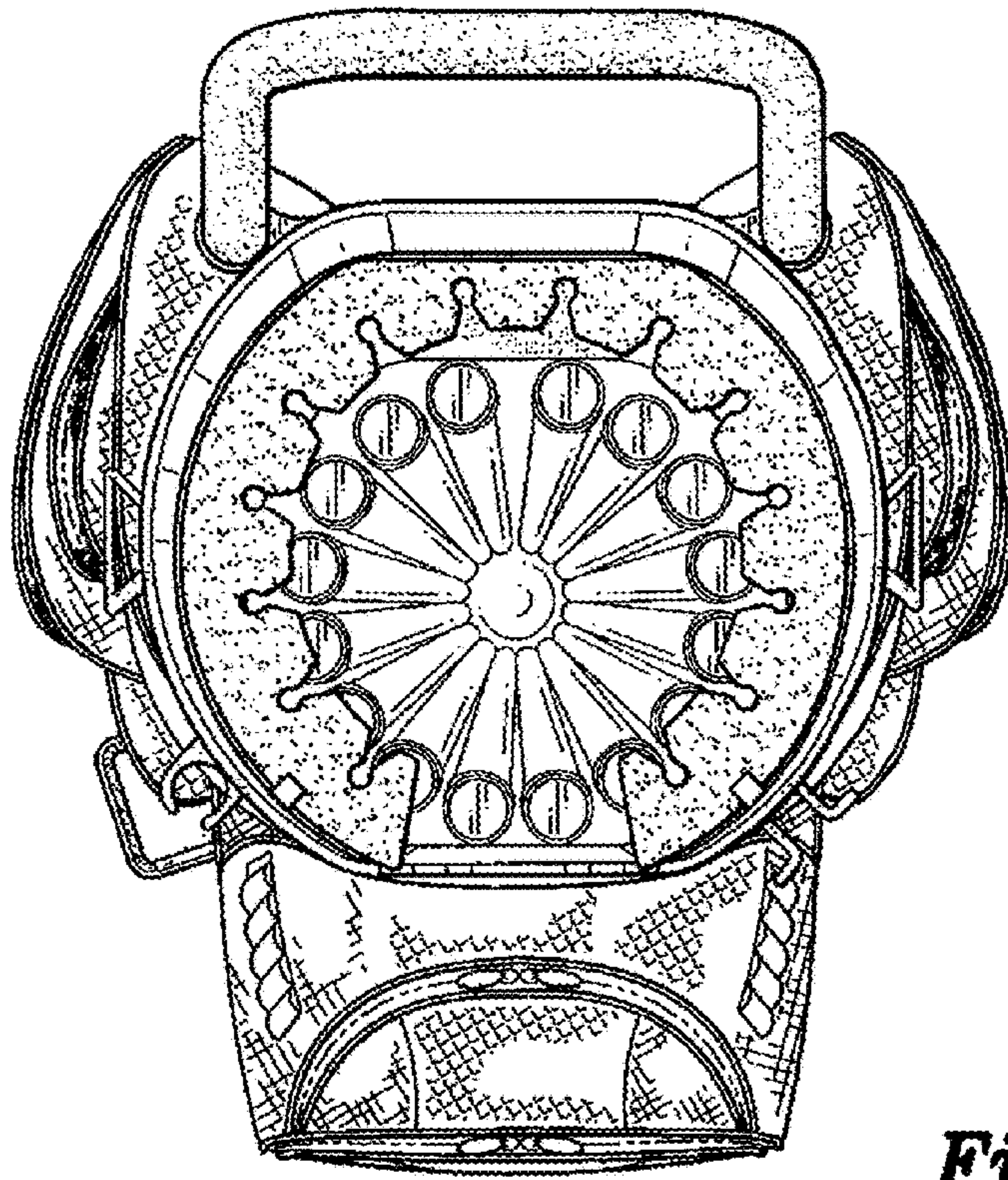

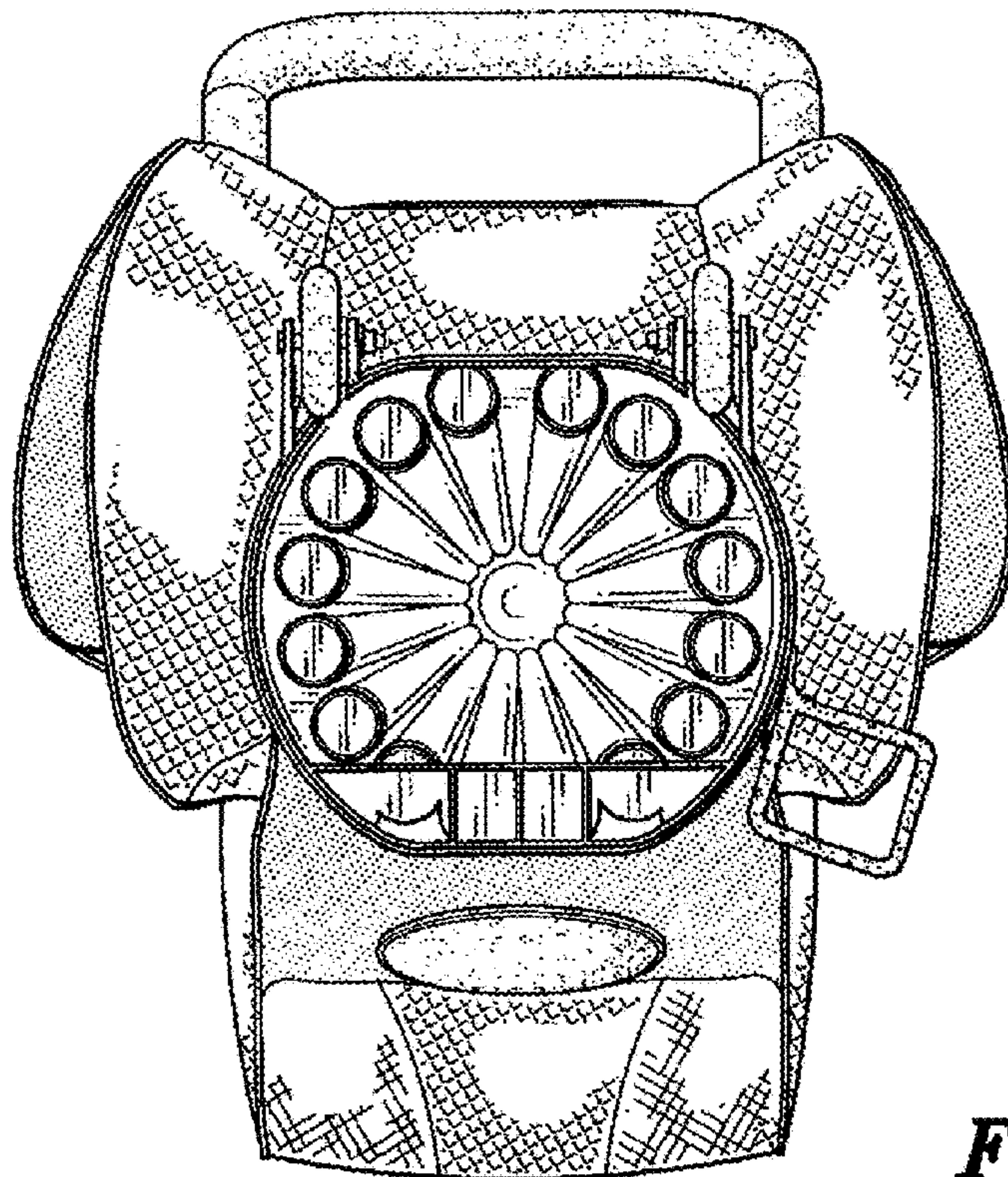
