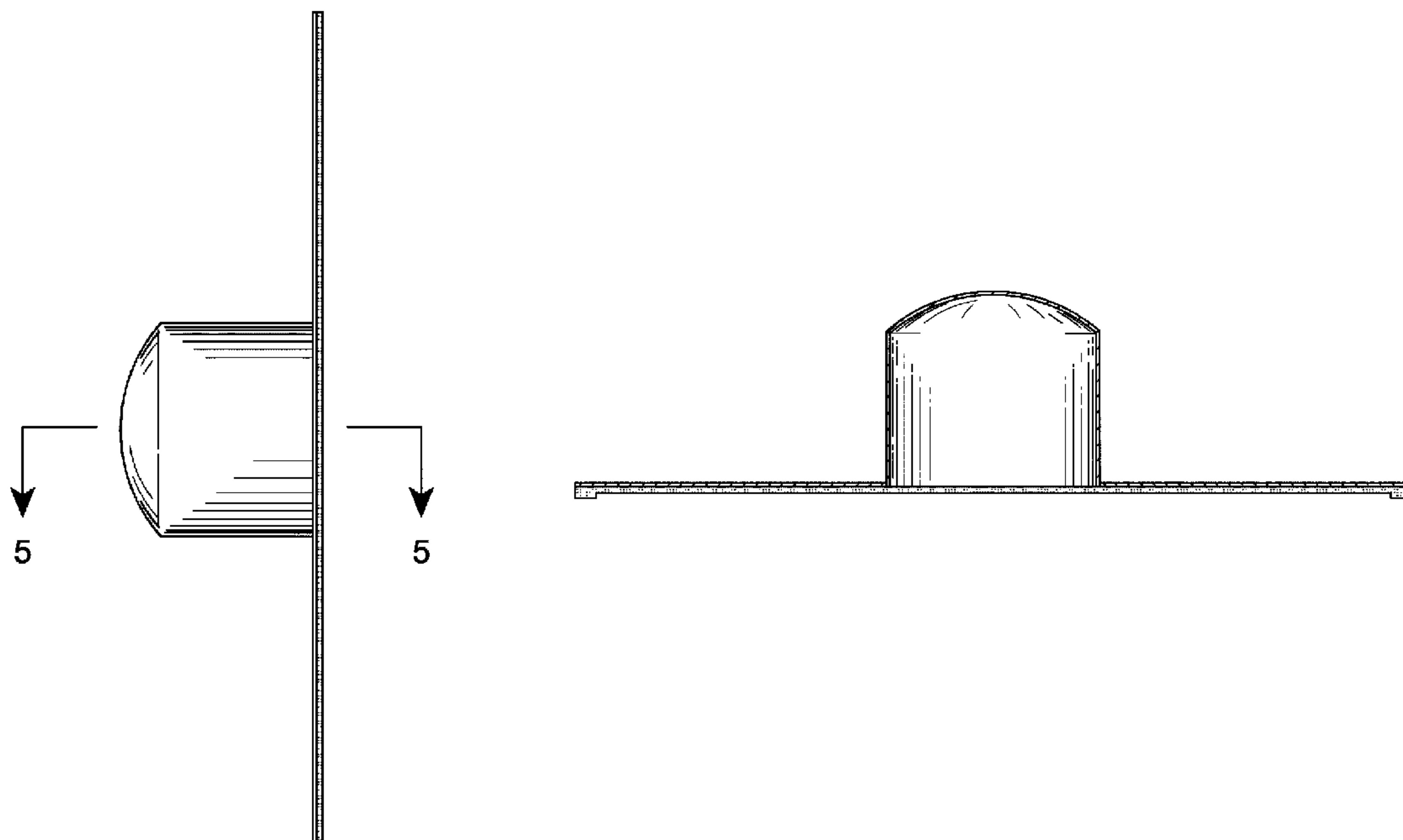
The ornamental design for a wheelshield, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a wheelshield, showing the new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view, left-side elevational view, and right-side elevational view all being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken generally along lines 5-5 of FIG. 2; FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof; FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of FIG. 6, the rear elevational view, left-side elevational view, and right-side elevational view all being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 6; FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 6; and, FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view taken generally along lines 10-10 of FIG. 7.

It is understood that the shading of the second embodiment represents transparency.

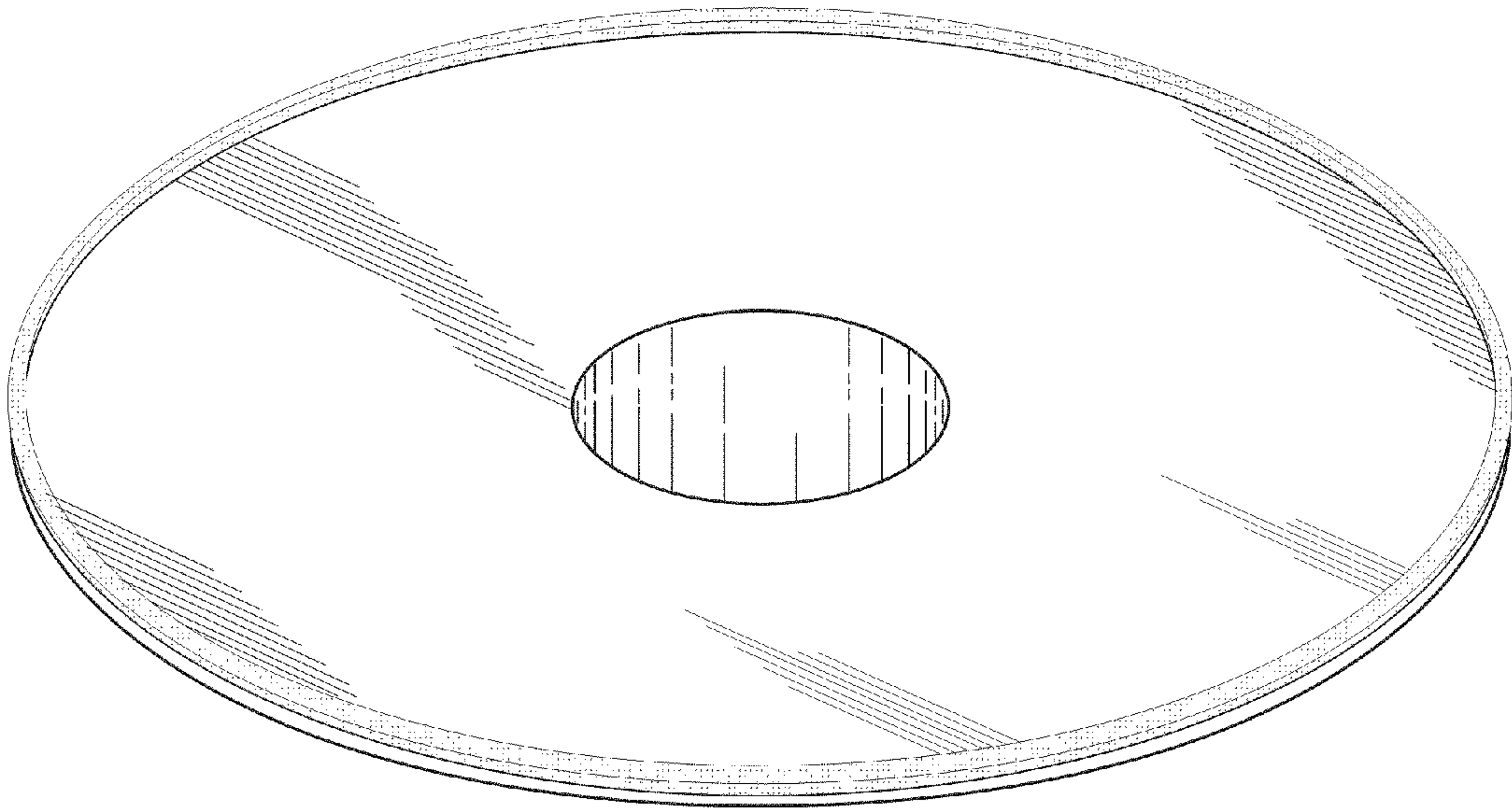

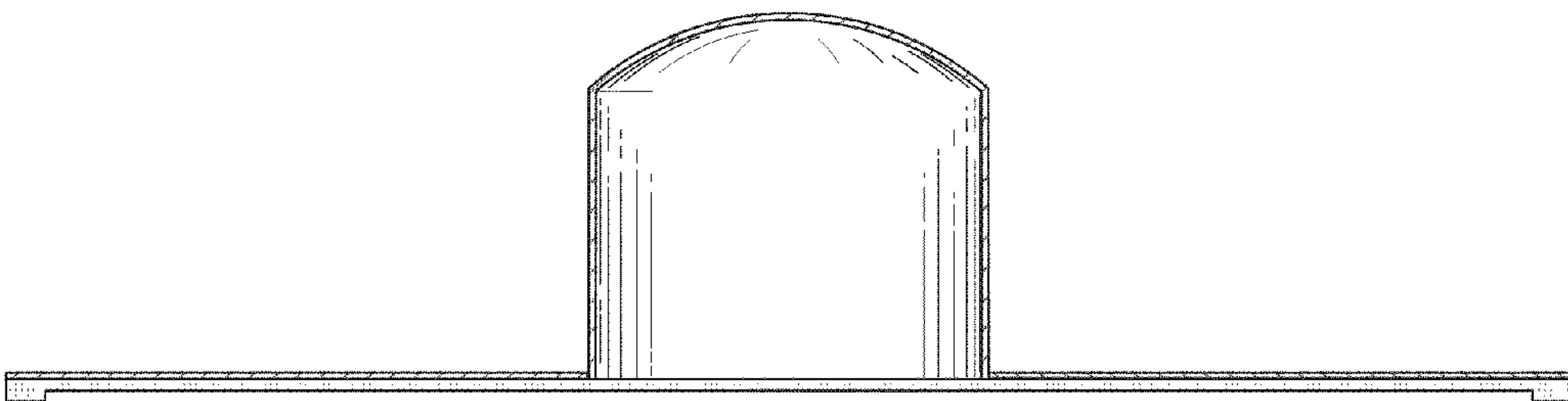

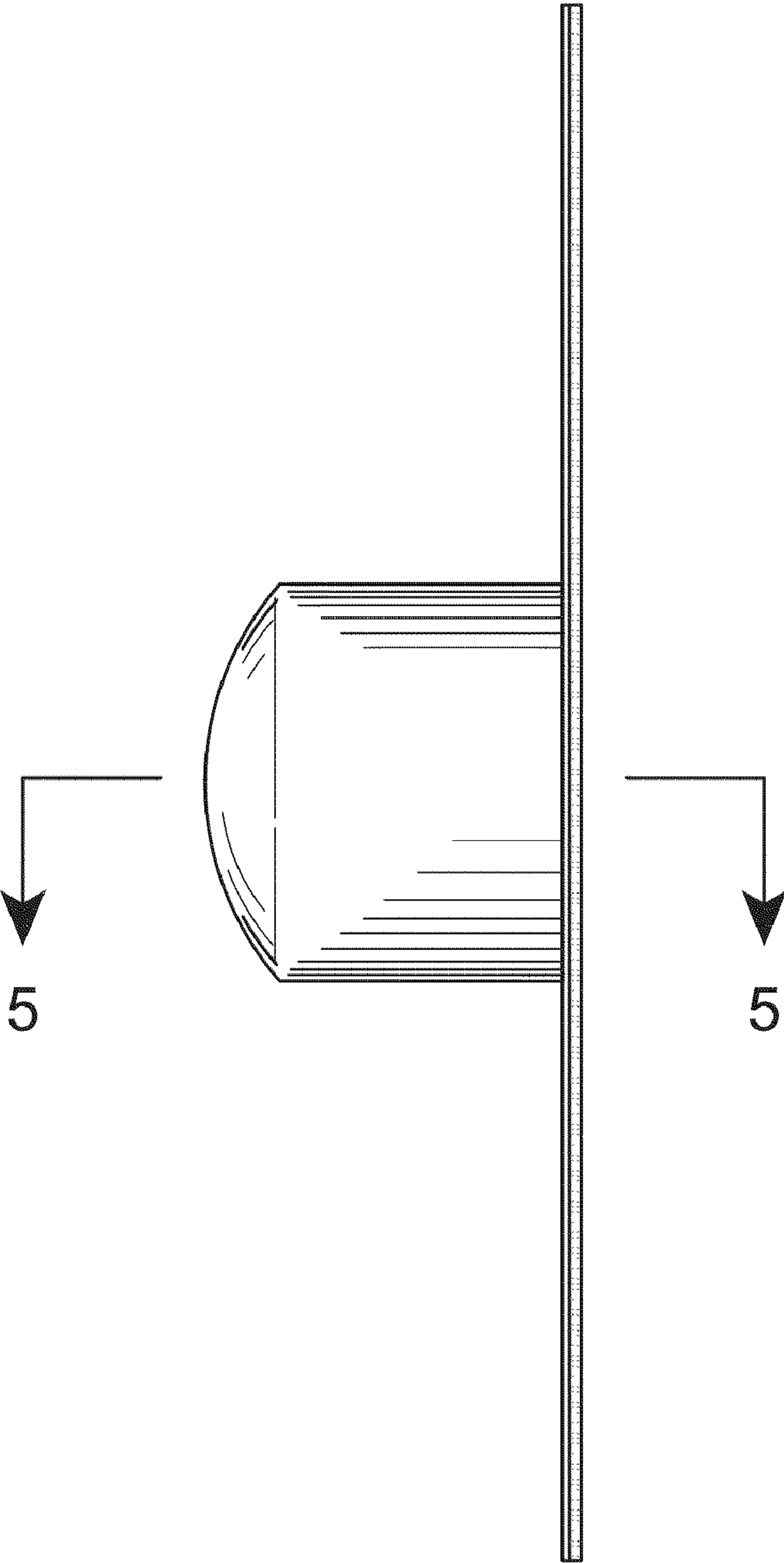

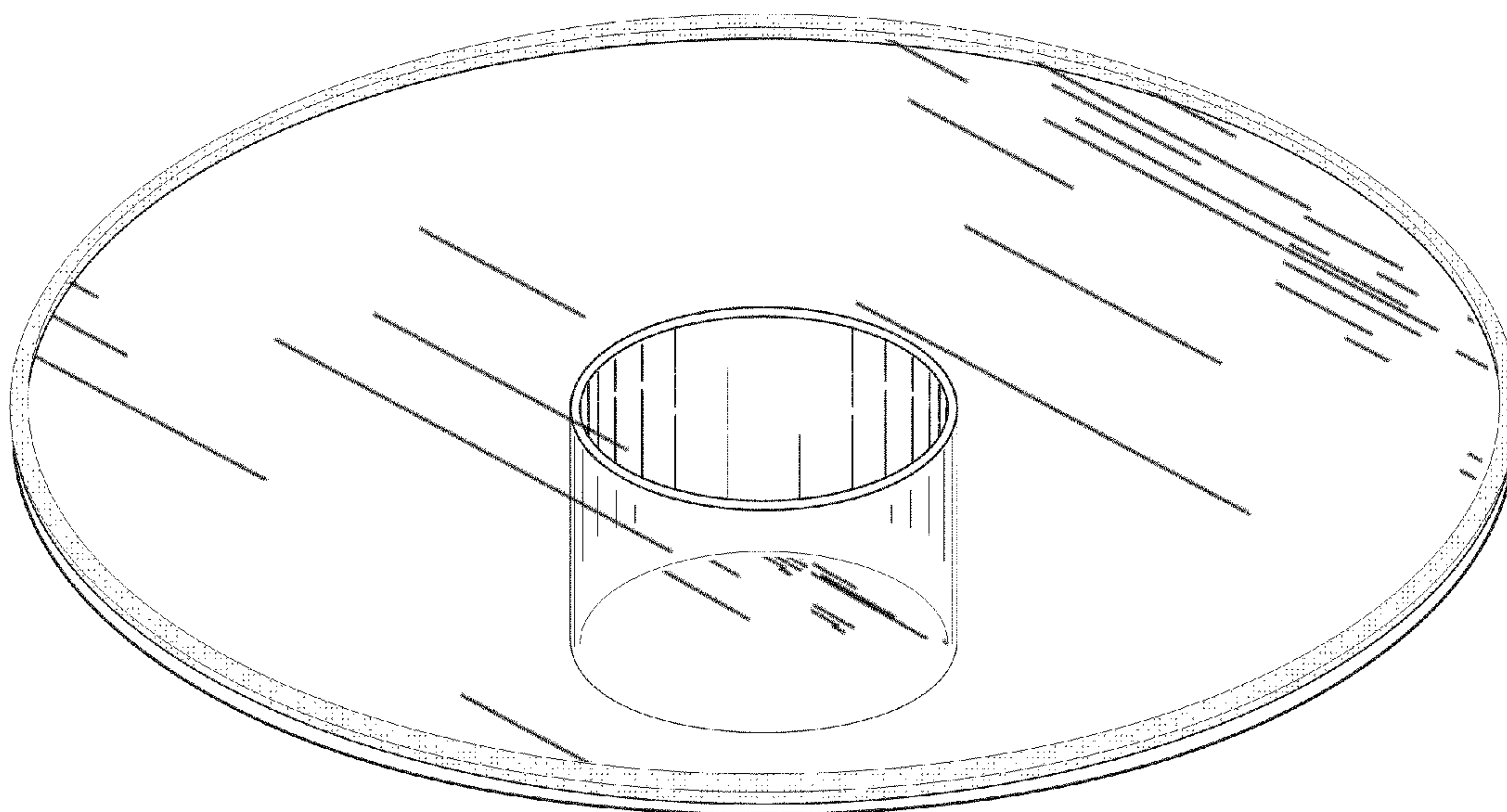

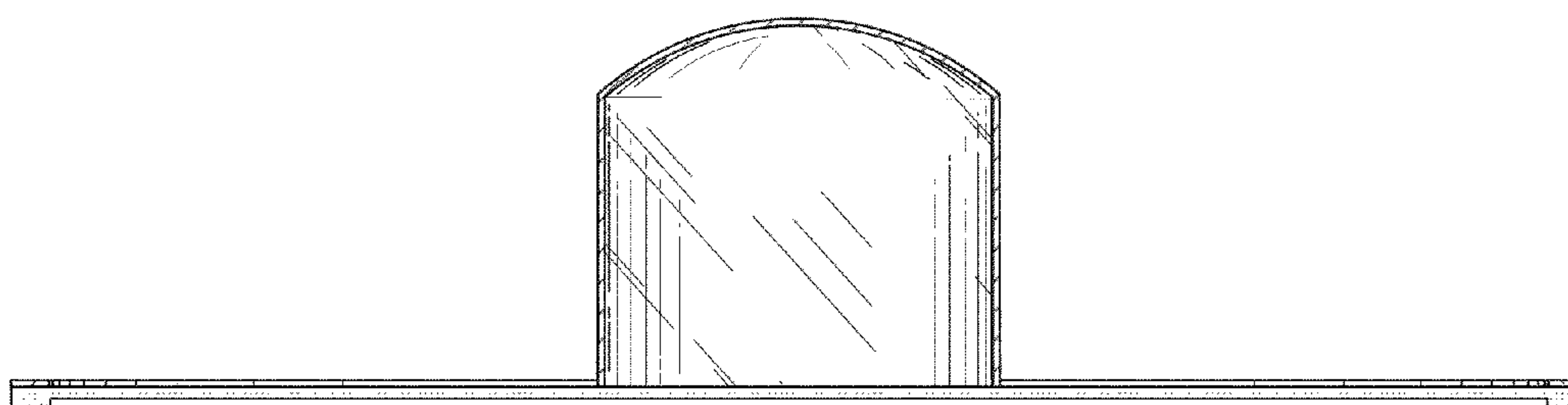

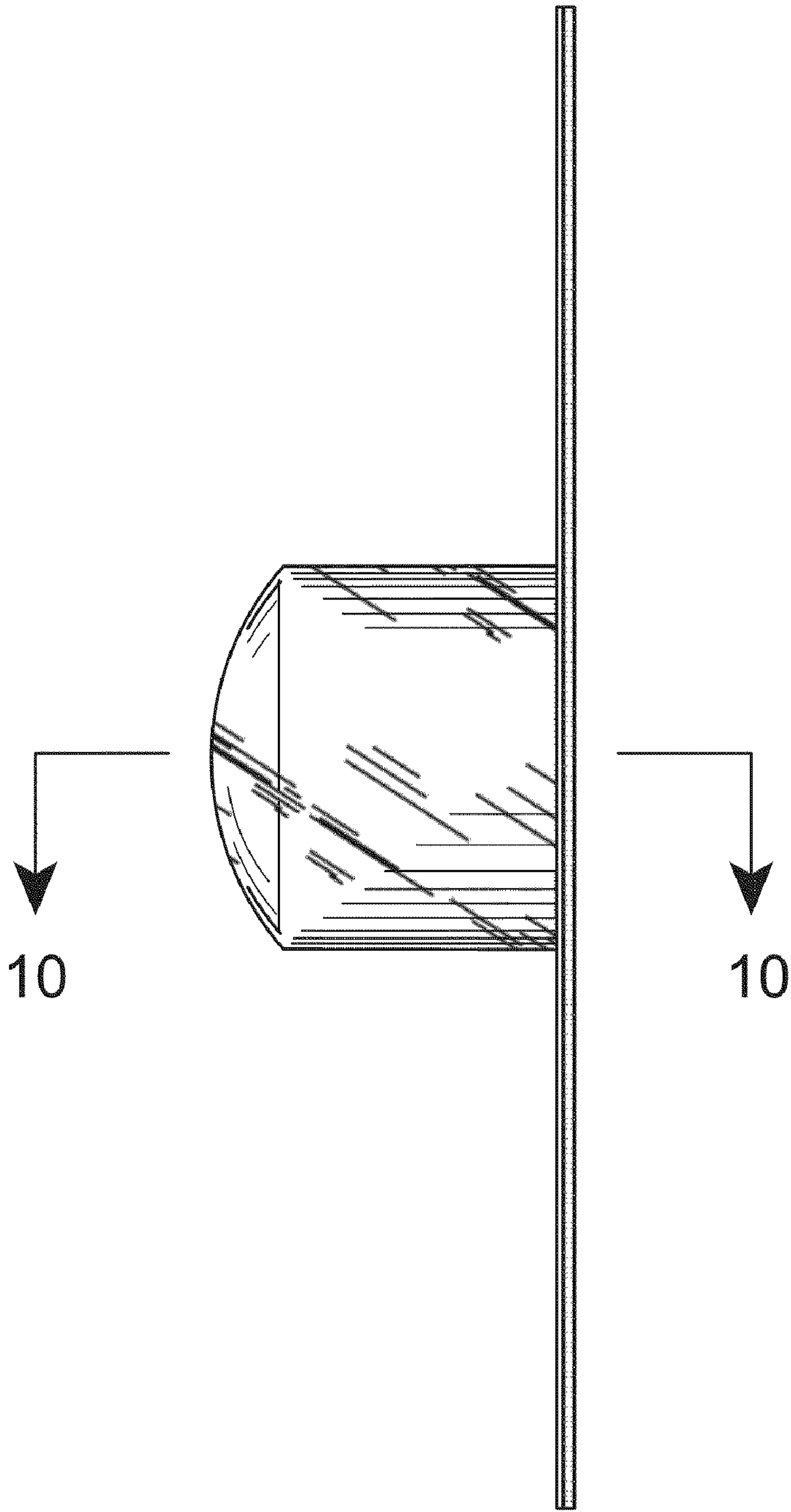

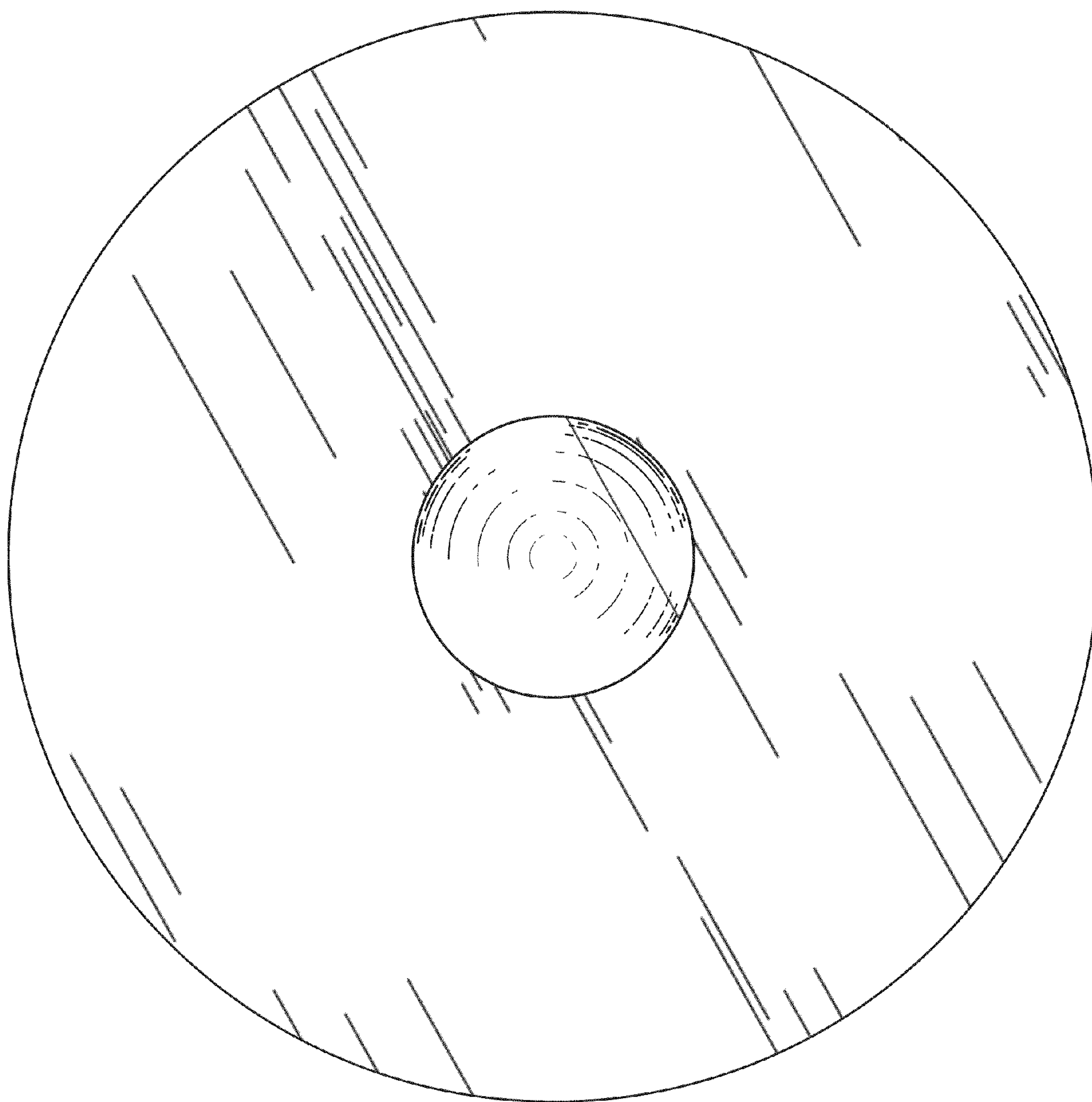
