FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view thereof; and,

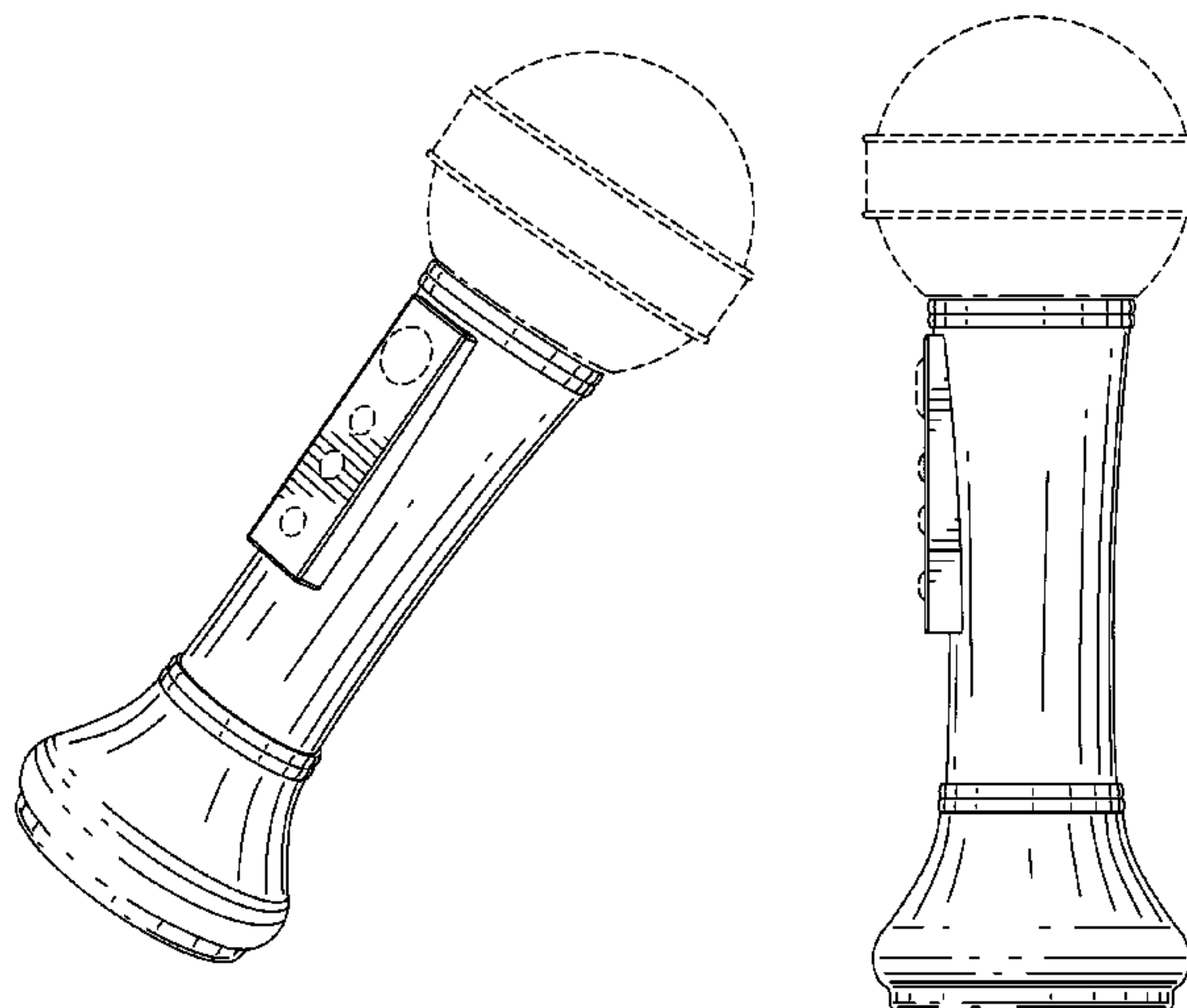
FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view thereof.

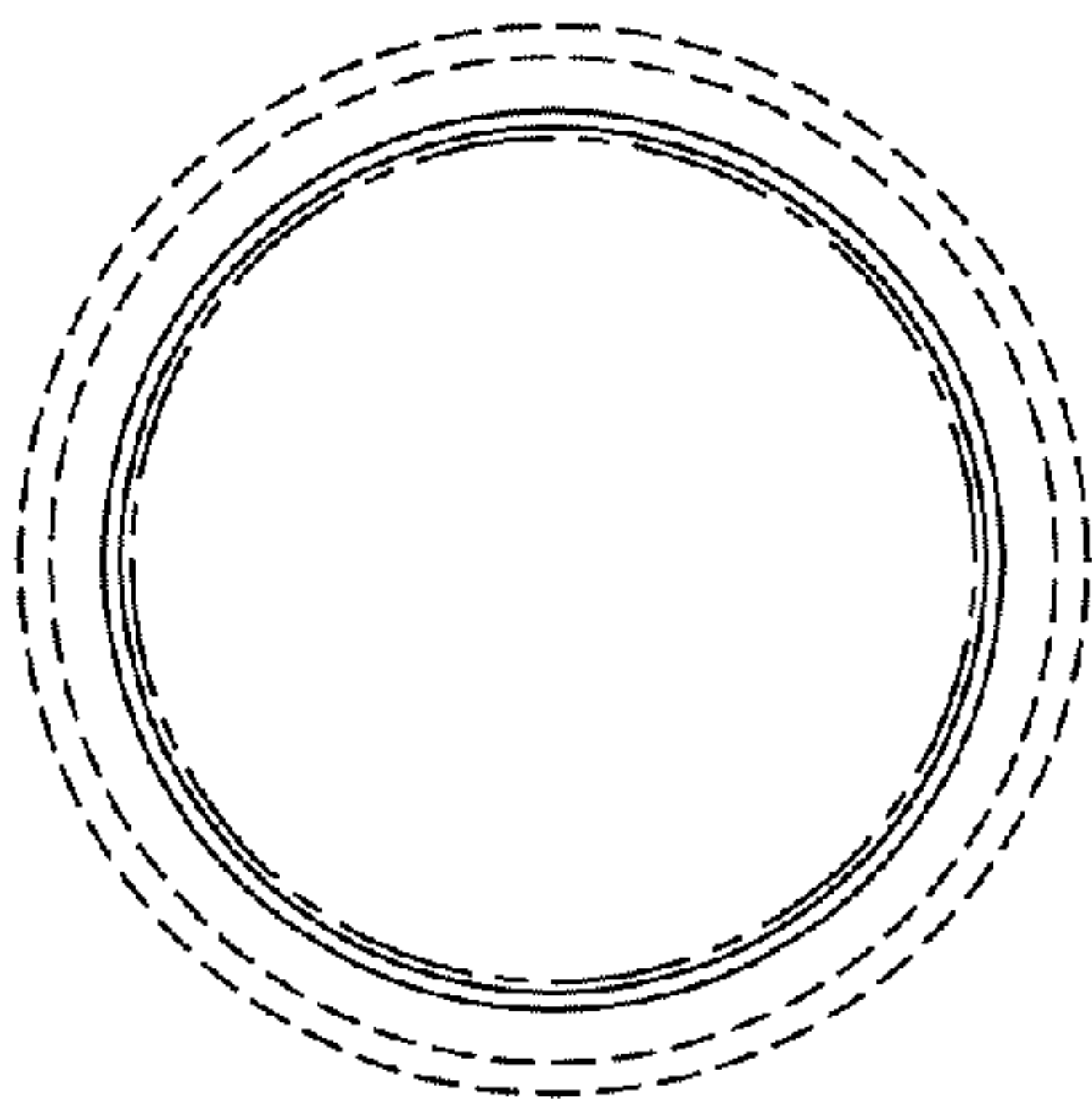
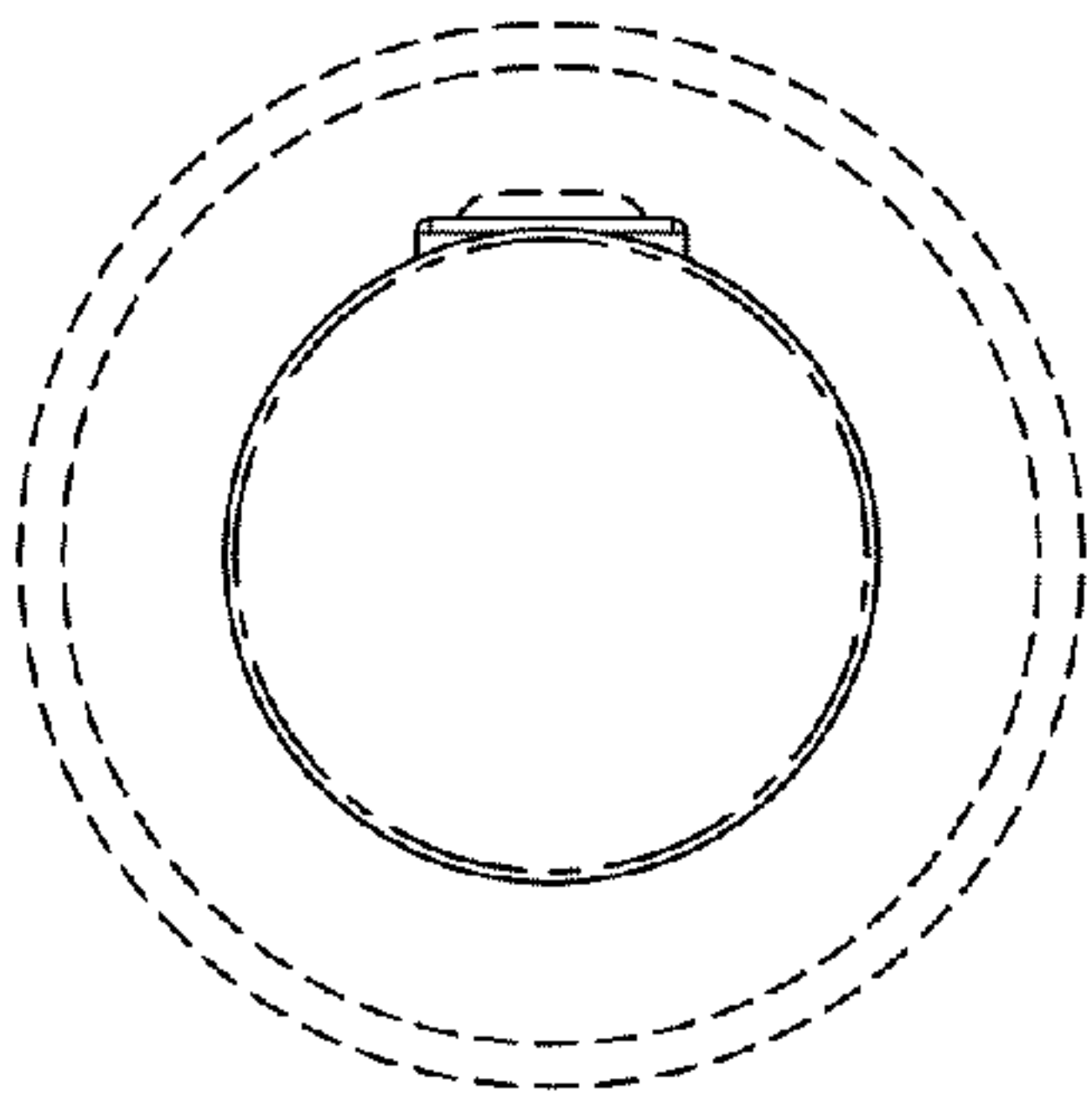
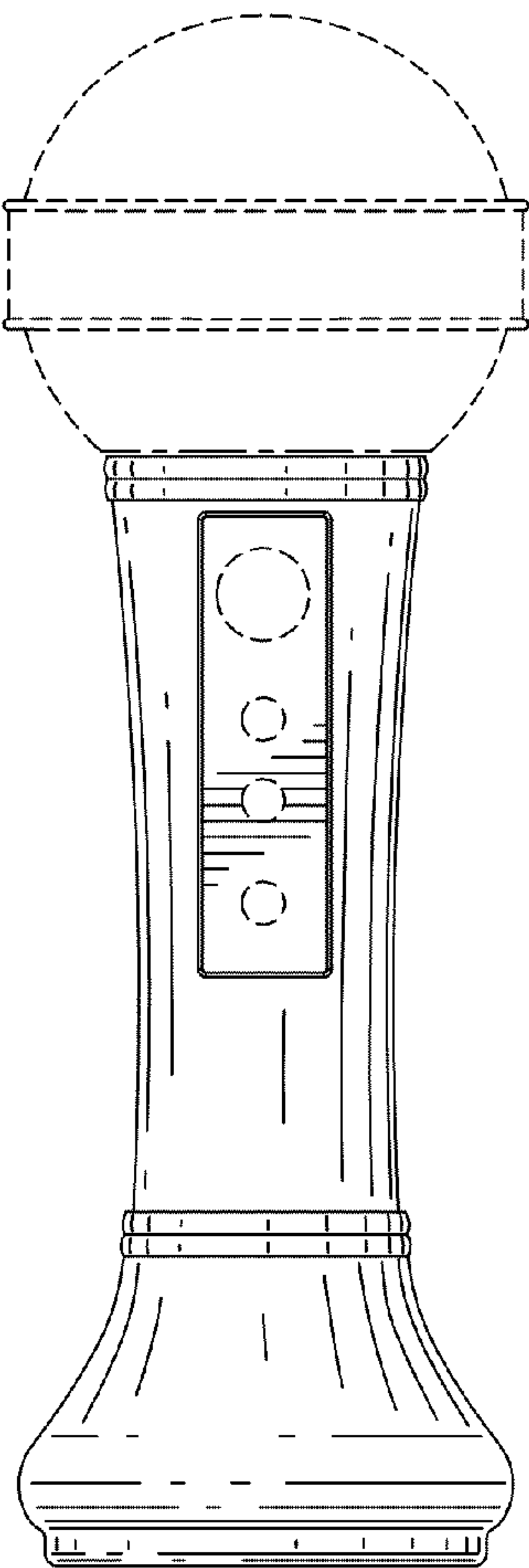
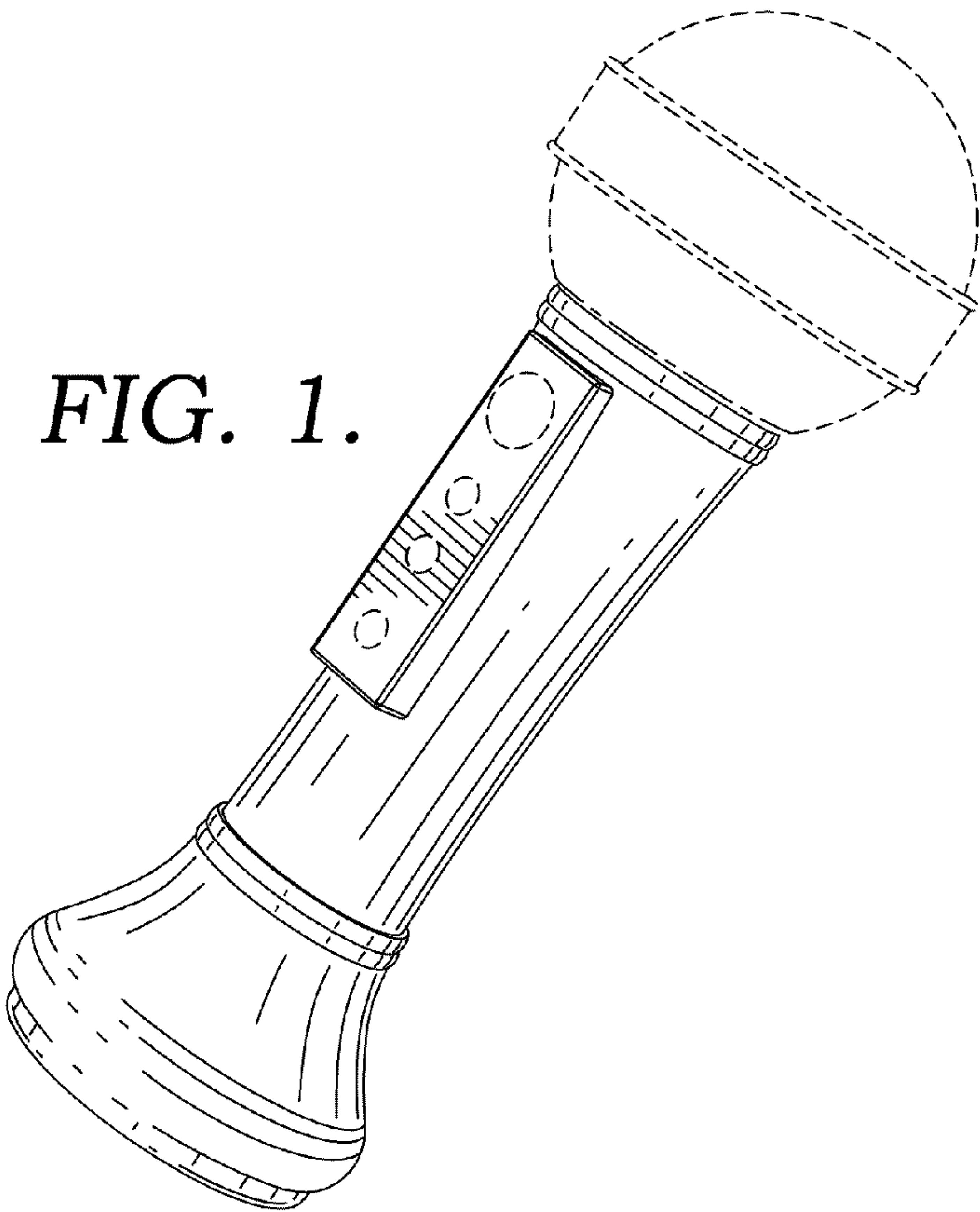

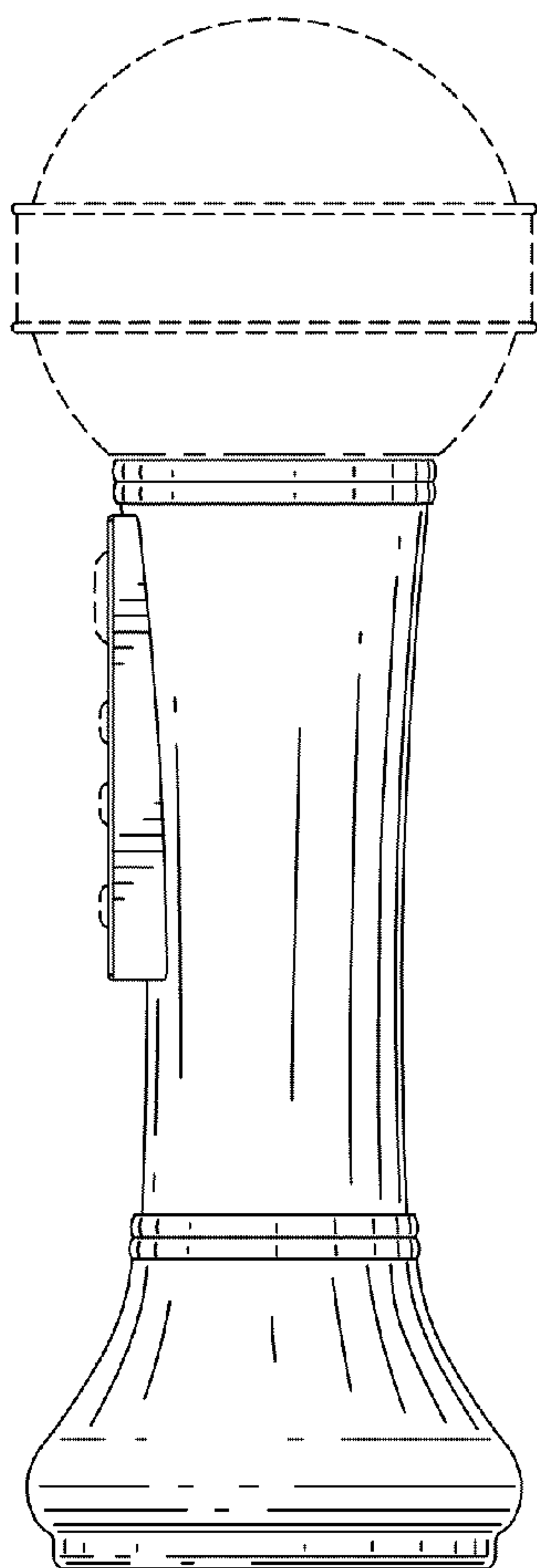

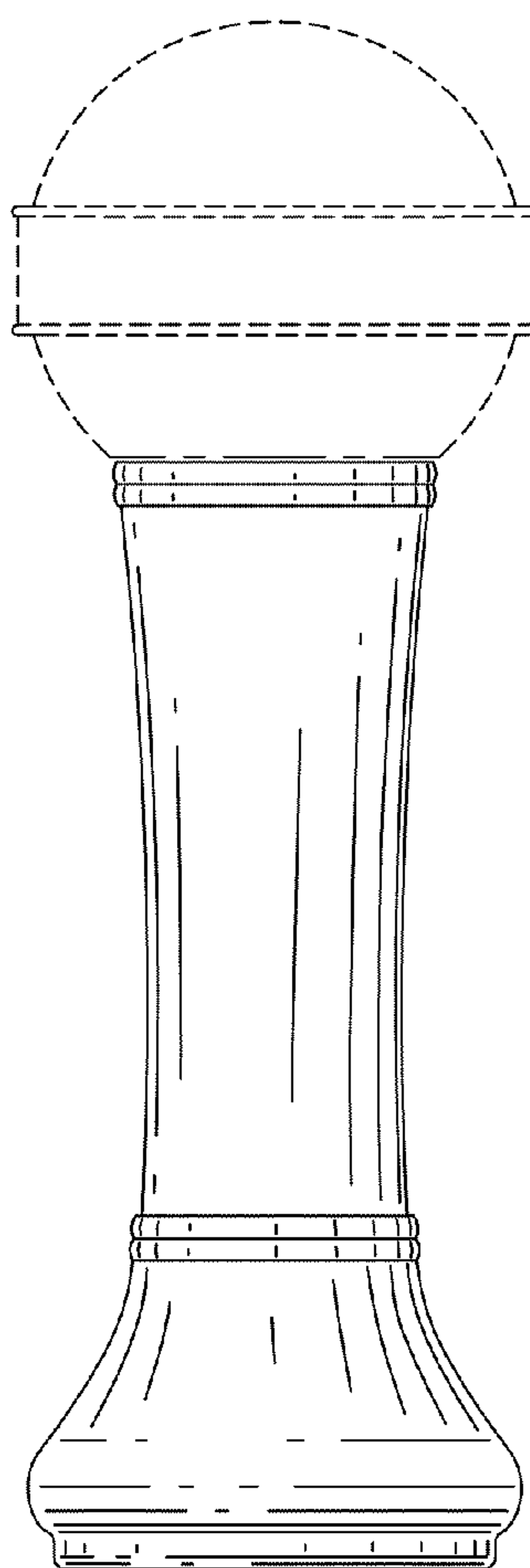

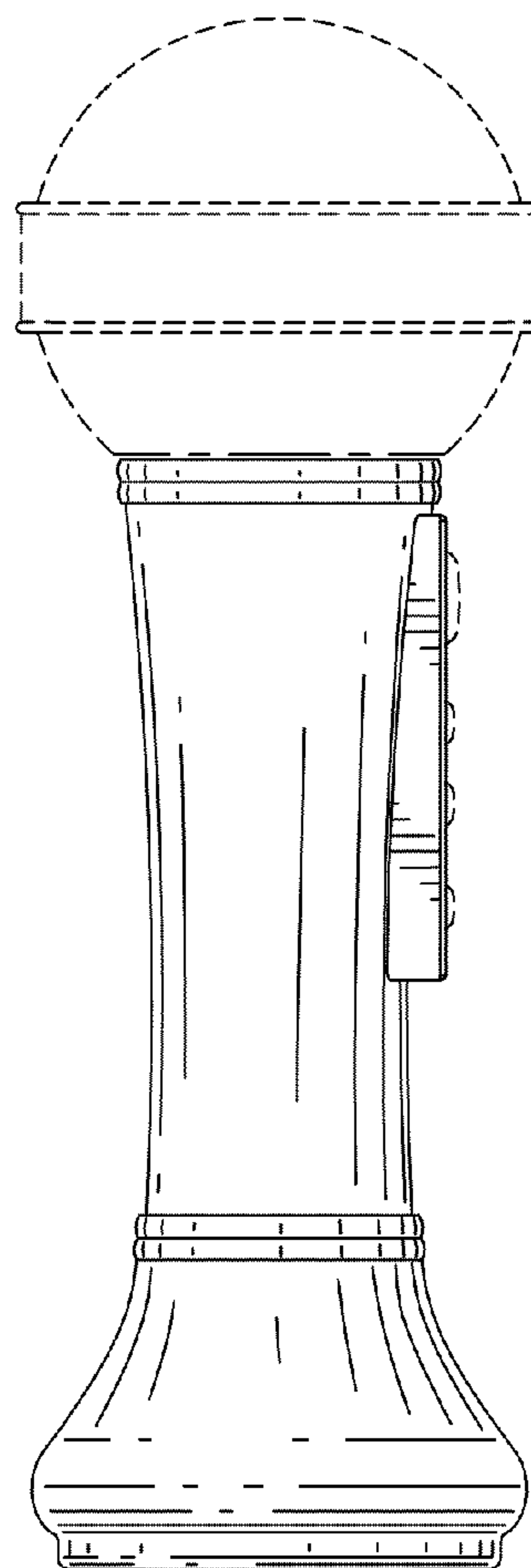
