### (57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoulder holster style carrier for personal items, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portion of a shoulder holster style carrier for personal items, which includes a strap assembly and removable carrier units. The other carrier unit is the same as the one shown except slightly smaller. The straps are shown broken away for convenience of illustration.

FIG. 2 is a top view of the carrier of FIG. 1 with the carrier units removed from the strap assembly.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the carrier of FIG. 1 with the carrier units removed from the strap assembly.

FIG. 4 is a side view of the carrier of FIG. 1 with the carrier units removed from the strap assembly. The opposite side of the carrier is the same as the illustrated side.

FIG. 5 is an end view of one end of the carrier of FIG. 1. The opposite end of the carrier is the same as the illustrated end. FIG. 6 is a perspective view of on of the carrier units of the carrier of FIG. 1 with a cover flap open.

FIG. 7 is a left side view of the carrier of FIG. 1 being worn by a user.


FIG. 8 is a front view of the carrier of FIG. 1 being worn by a user.


FIG. 9 is a right side view of the carrier of FIG. 1 being worn by a user; and,


FIG. 10 is a rear view of the carrier of FIG. 1 being worn by a user.

The broken line showing of environment in the drawing is included for the purpose of illustrating only and forms no part of the claimed design.



































