#### (57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a scarf and belt rack, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged front perspective view of a single clip mounted on a strap, being one of a plurality of identical clips used in our scarf and belt rack design as described below;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged bottom plan view of the design of this invention;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view of the design of this invention;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged left side view of a single clip mounted on a strap;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged front elevational view of a single clip mounted on a strap;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged rear view of a single clip mounted on a strap;

FIG. 7A is a front perspective view of the highest section of ten continuous sections of the scarf and belt rack showing our new design;

FIG. 7B is a front perspective view of the next lower section being a continuation of the section of FIG. 7A;

FIG. 7J is a front perspective view of the lowest section being a continuation of the section of FIG. 7I;




FIG. 8A is a rear perspective view of the highest section of ten continuous sections of the scarf and belt rack showing our new design;


FIG. 8G is a rear perspective view of the next lower section being a continuation of the section of FIG. 8F;


FIG. 8H is a rear perspective view of the next lower section being a continuation of the section of FIG. 8G;


FIG. 8I is a rear perspective view of the next lower section being a continuation of the section of FIG. 8H; and,


FIG. 8J is a rear perspective view of the lowest section being a continuation of the section of FIG. 8I.

FIG. 8F is a rear perspective view of the next lower section being a continuation of the section of FIG. 8E;



















































