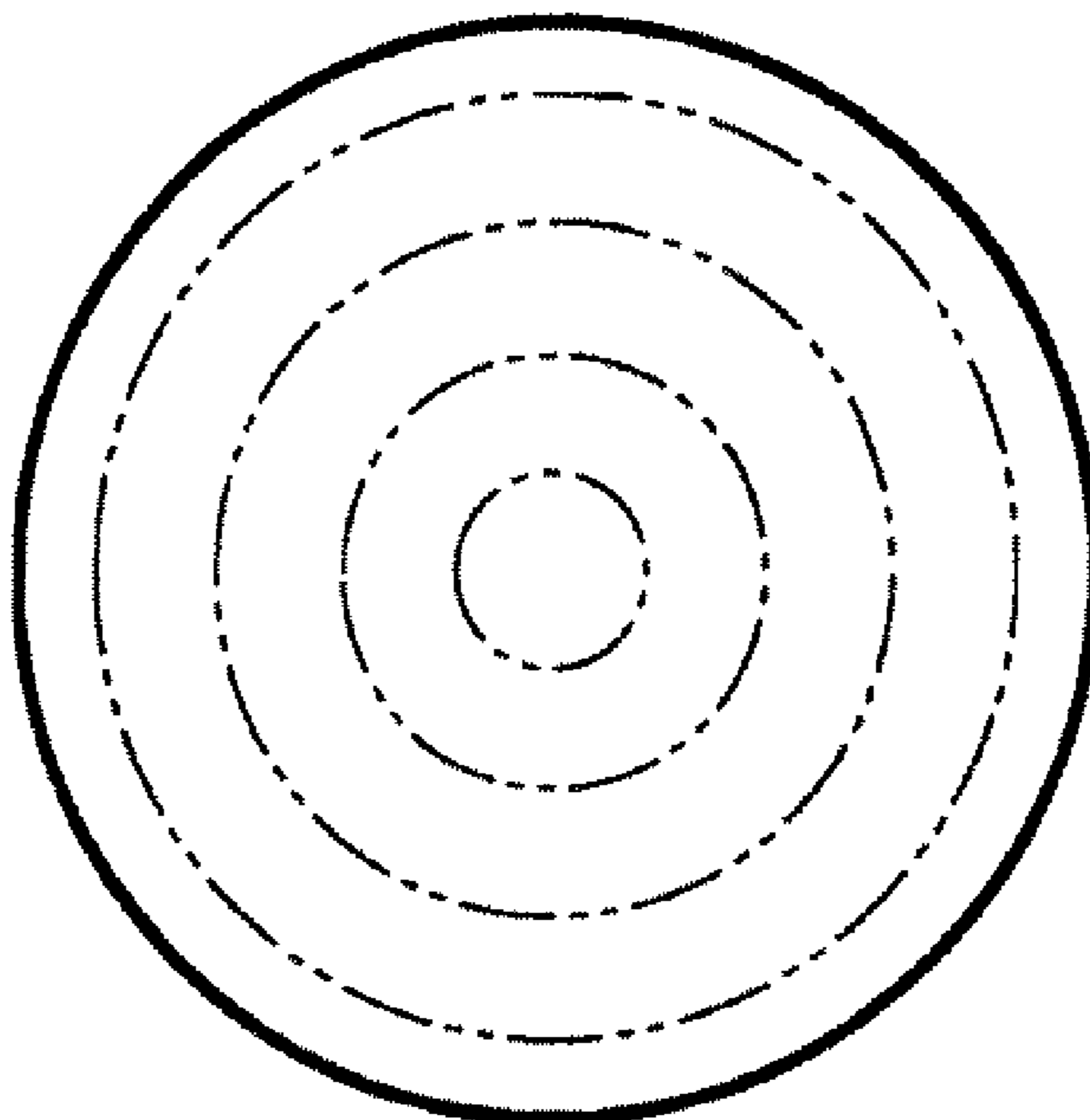

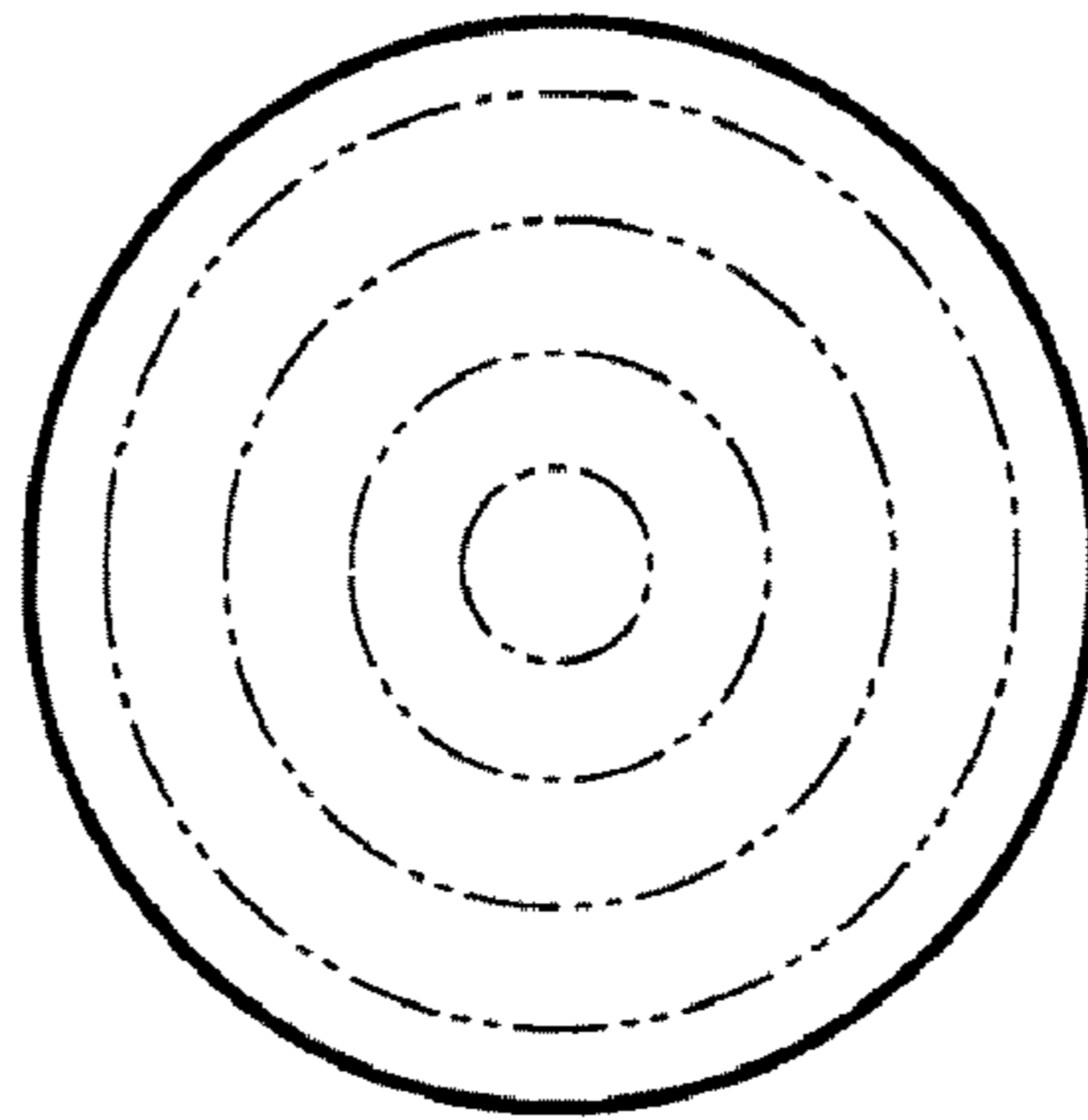
The ornamental design for a pedestal or similar article, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

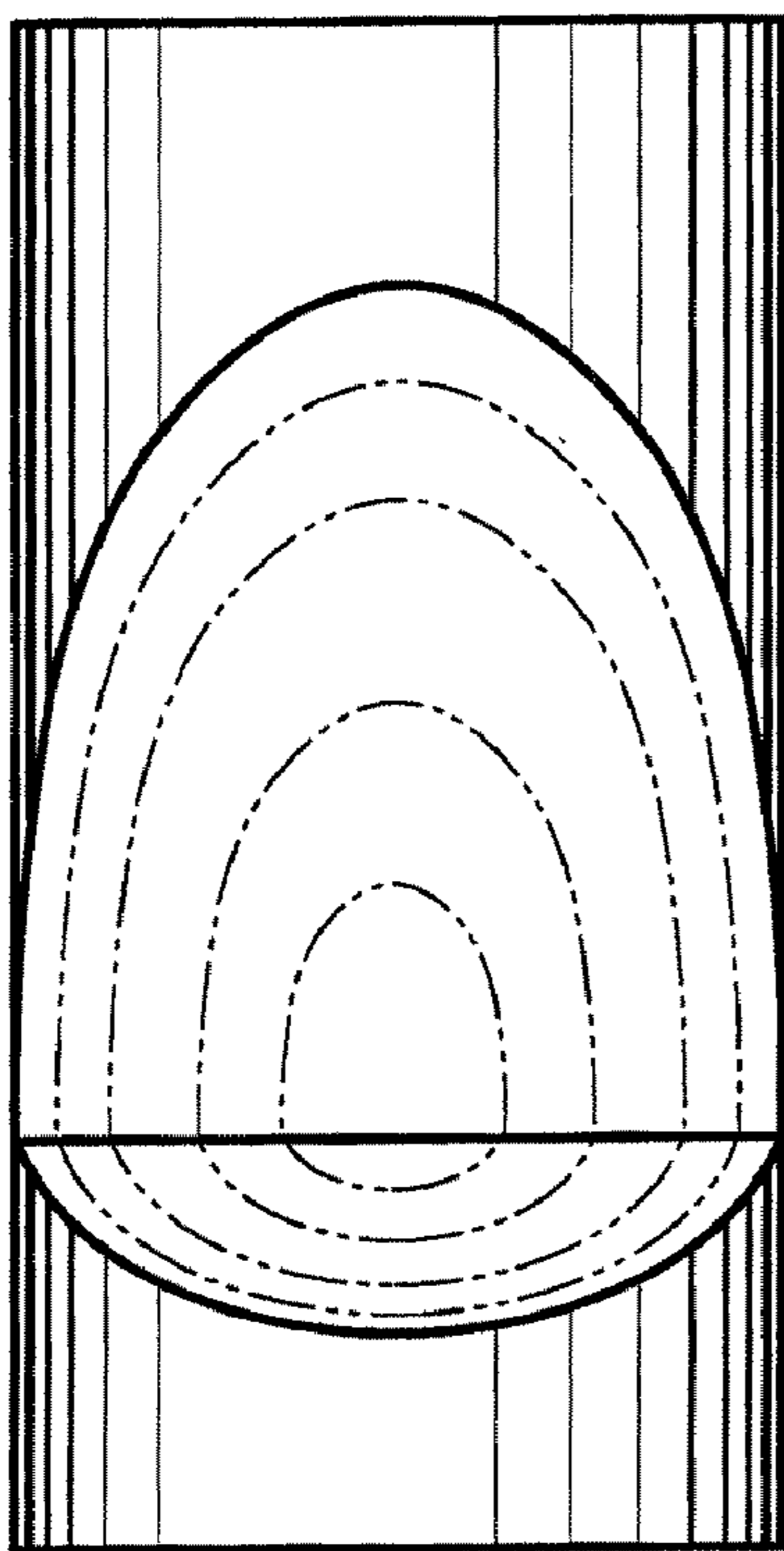
FIG. 1 is a top, plan view of a pedestal or similar article according to the present invention;

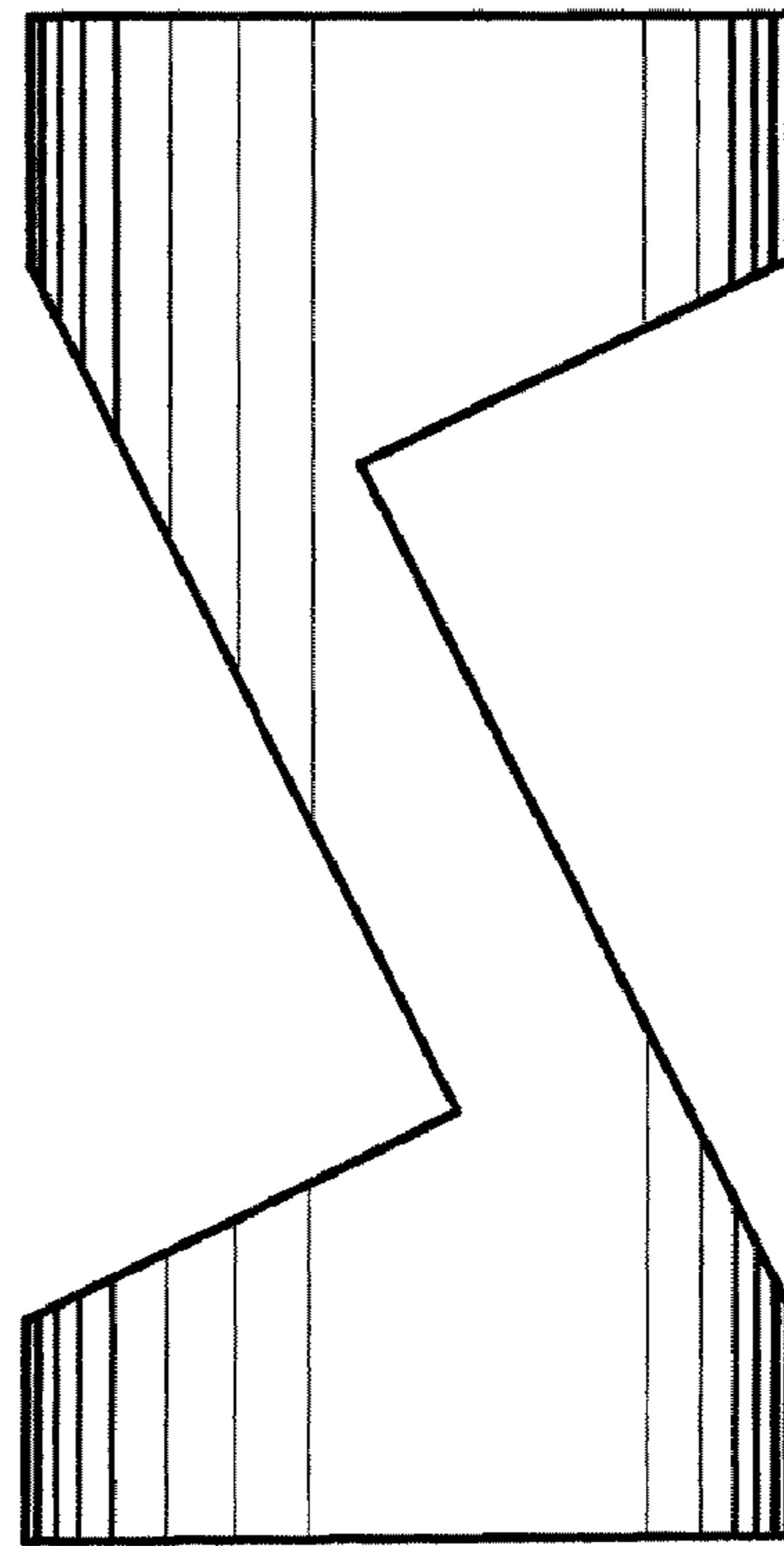




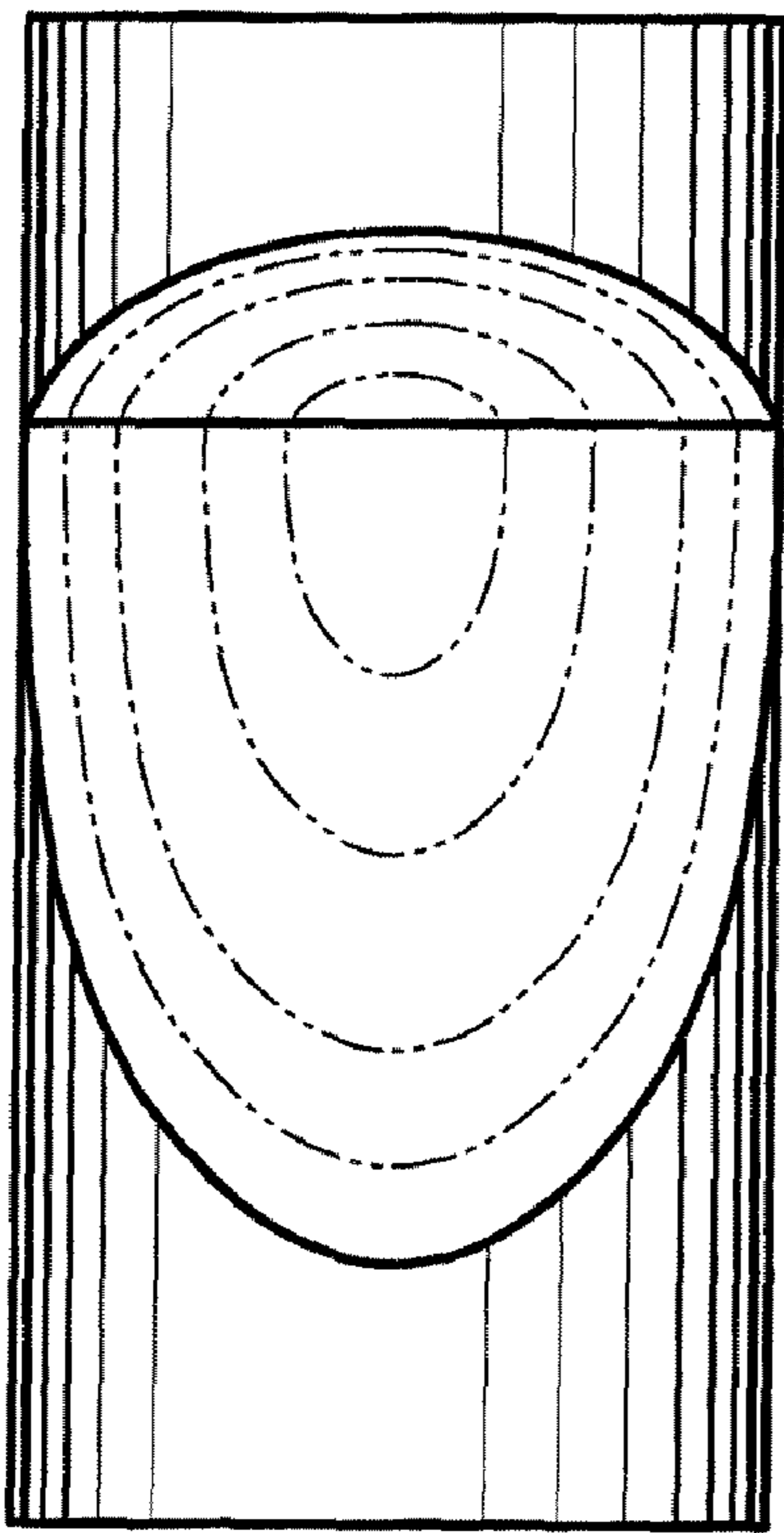

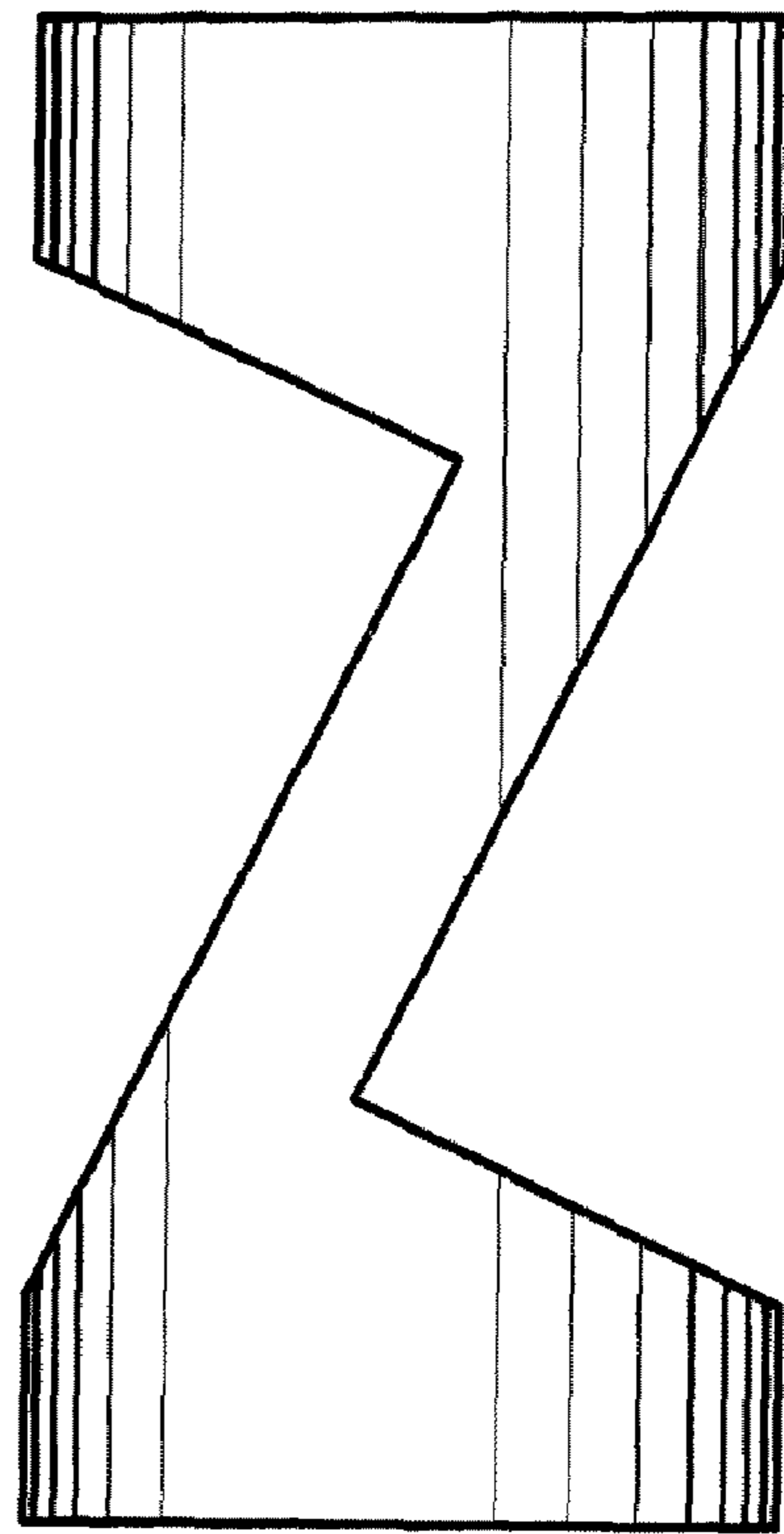

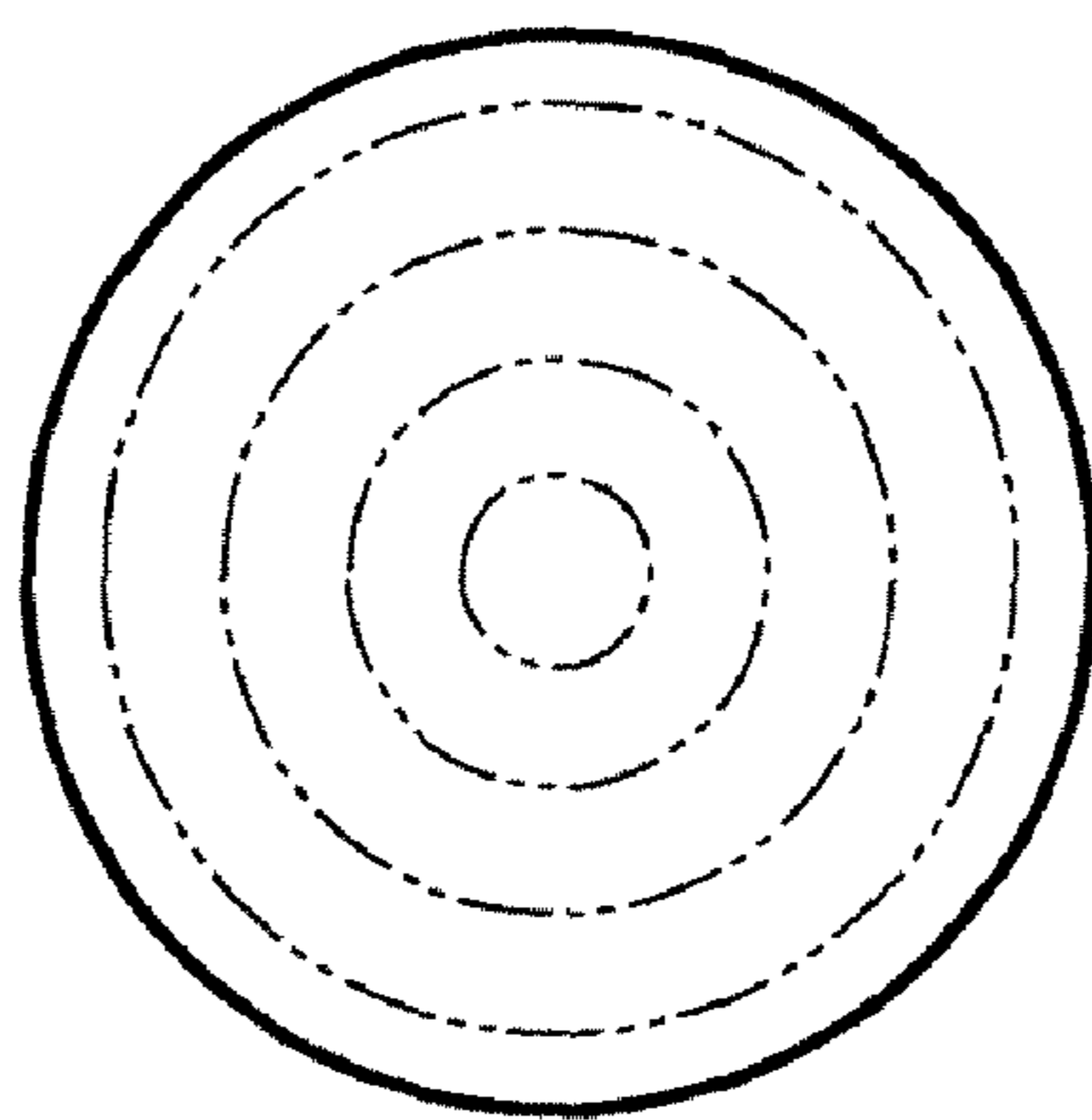
