(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle for rail used in coverings
for architectural openings, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the handle of the present
invention mounted on a rail used in a covering for an archi-
tectural opening.

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the handle as shown in FIG.
1.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the handle as shown in FIG. 1 with
the bottom plan view being the mirror image thereof.

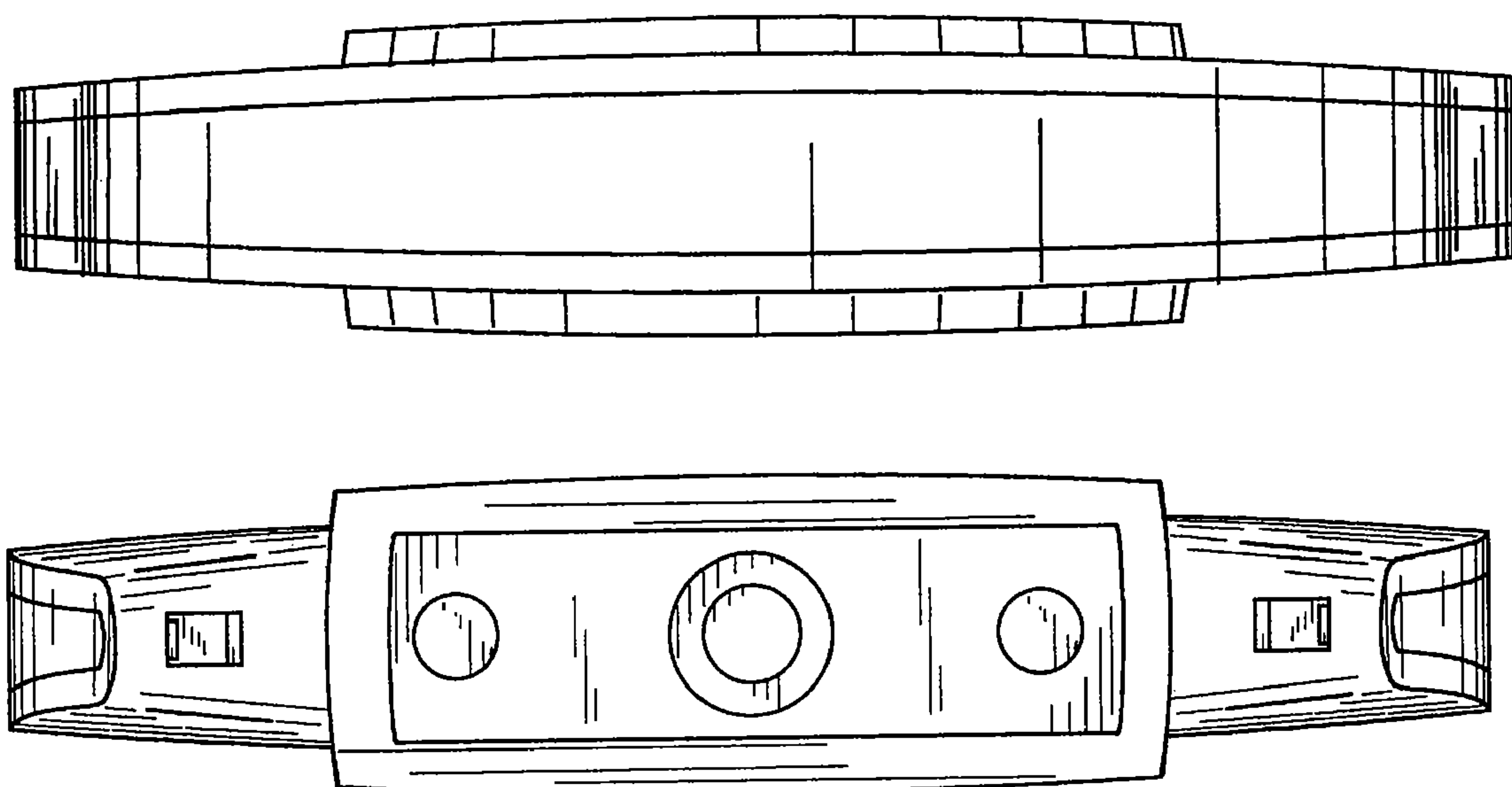
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view of the handle as seen in
FIG. 3 with the right side elevation being a mirror image
thereof.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the handle as shown in FIG.
1; and,

FIG. 6 is an isometric view of the handle looking downwardly
at the rear of the handle.

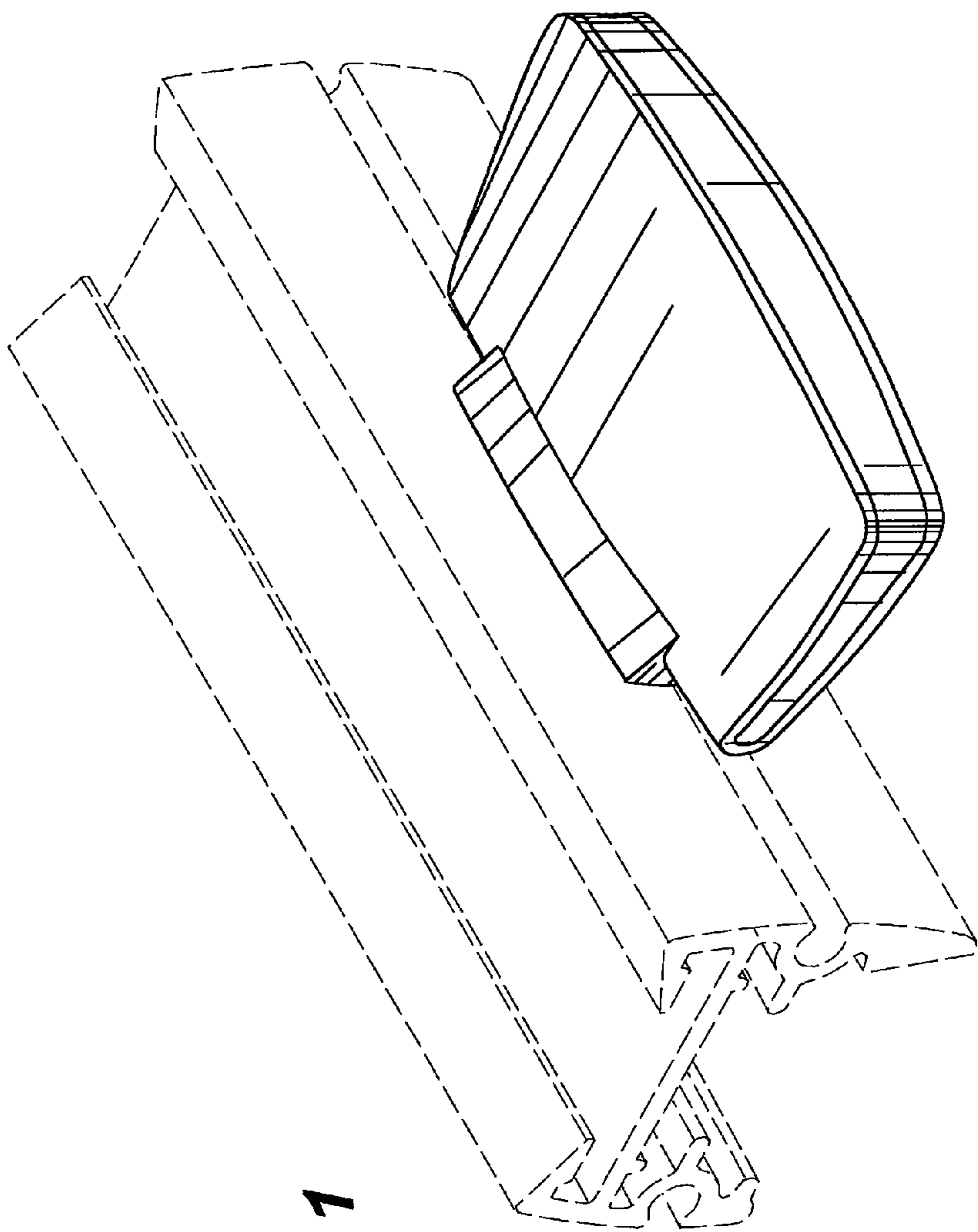

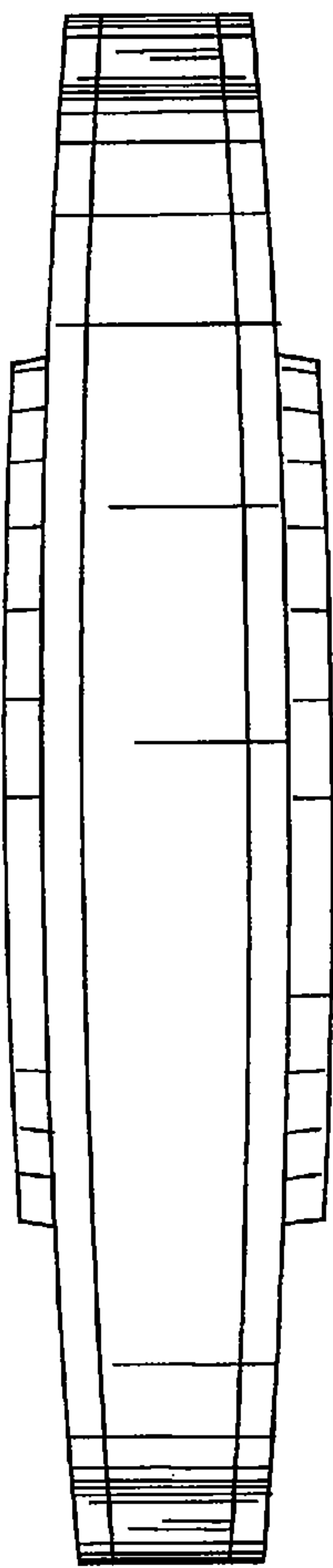

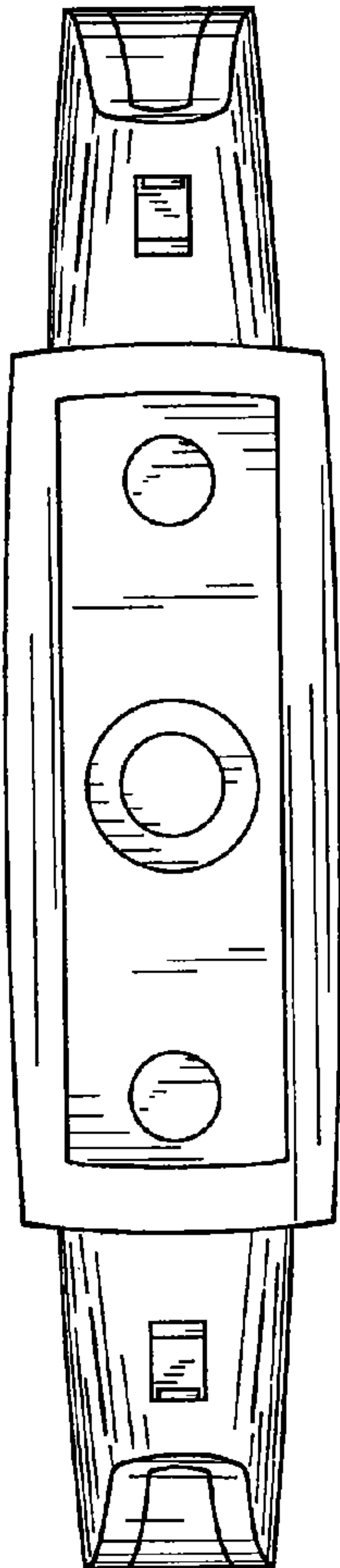

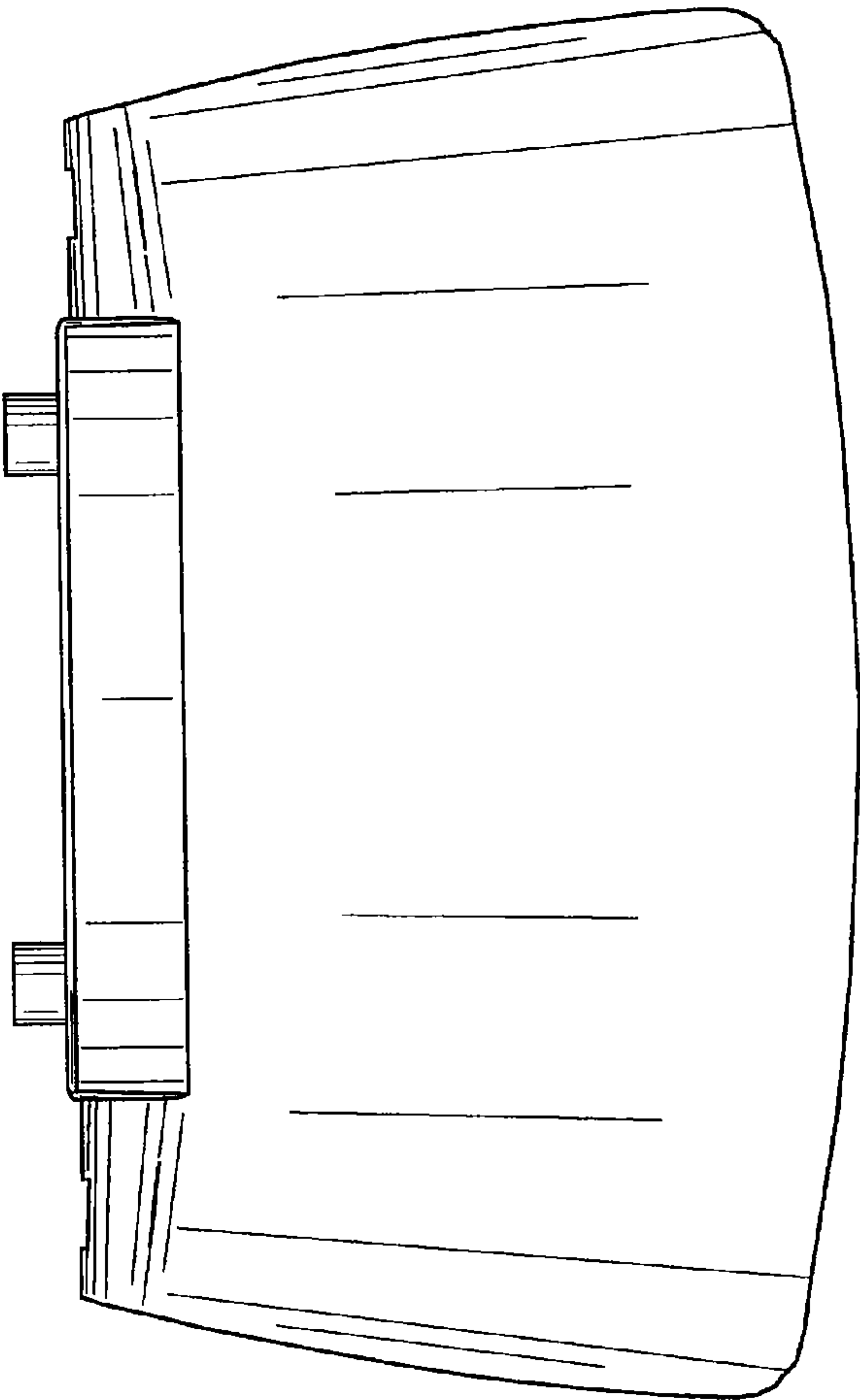

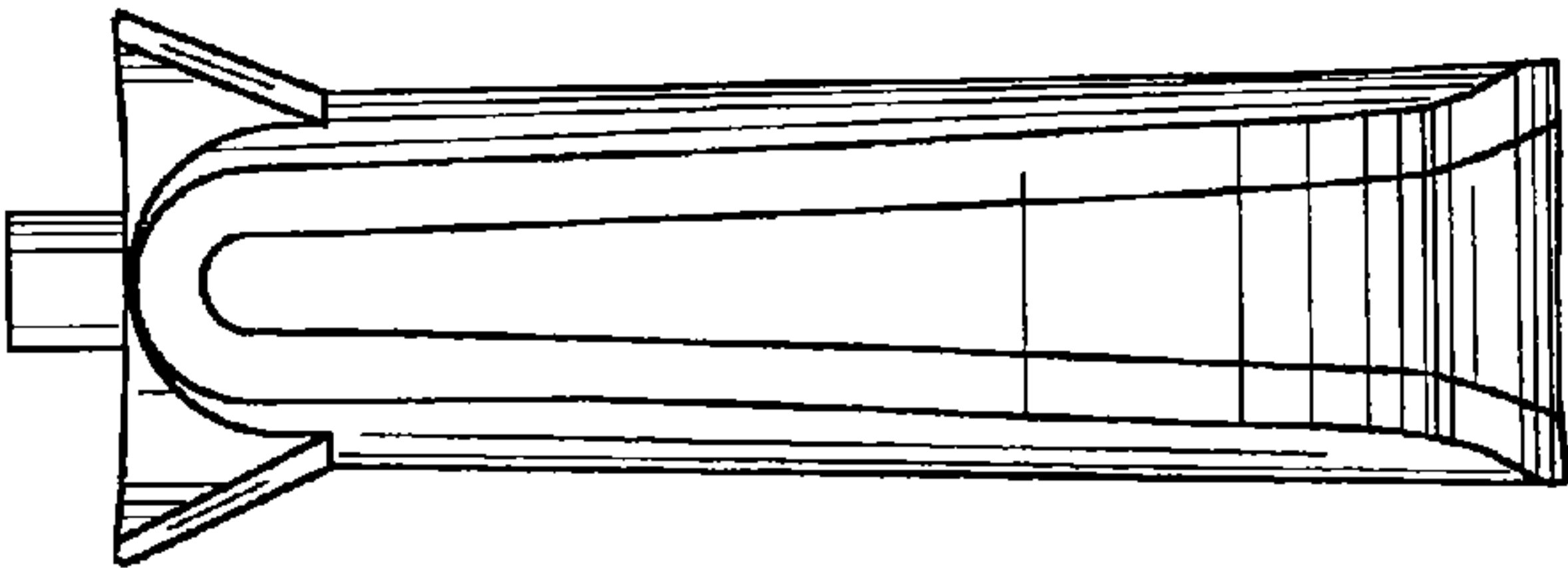

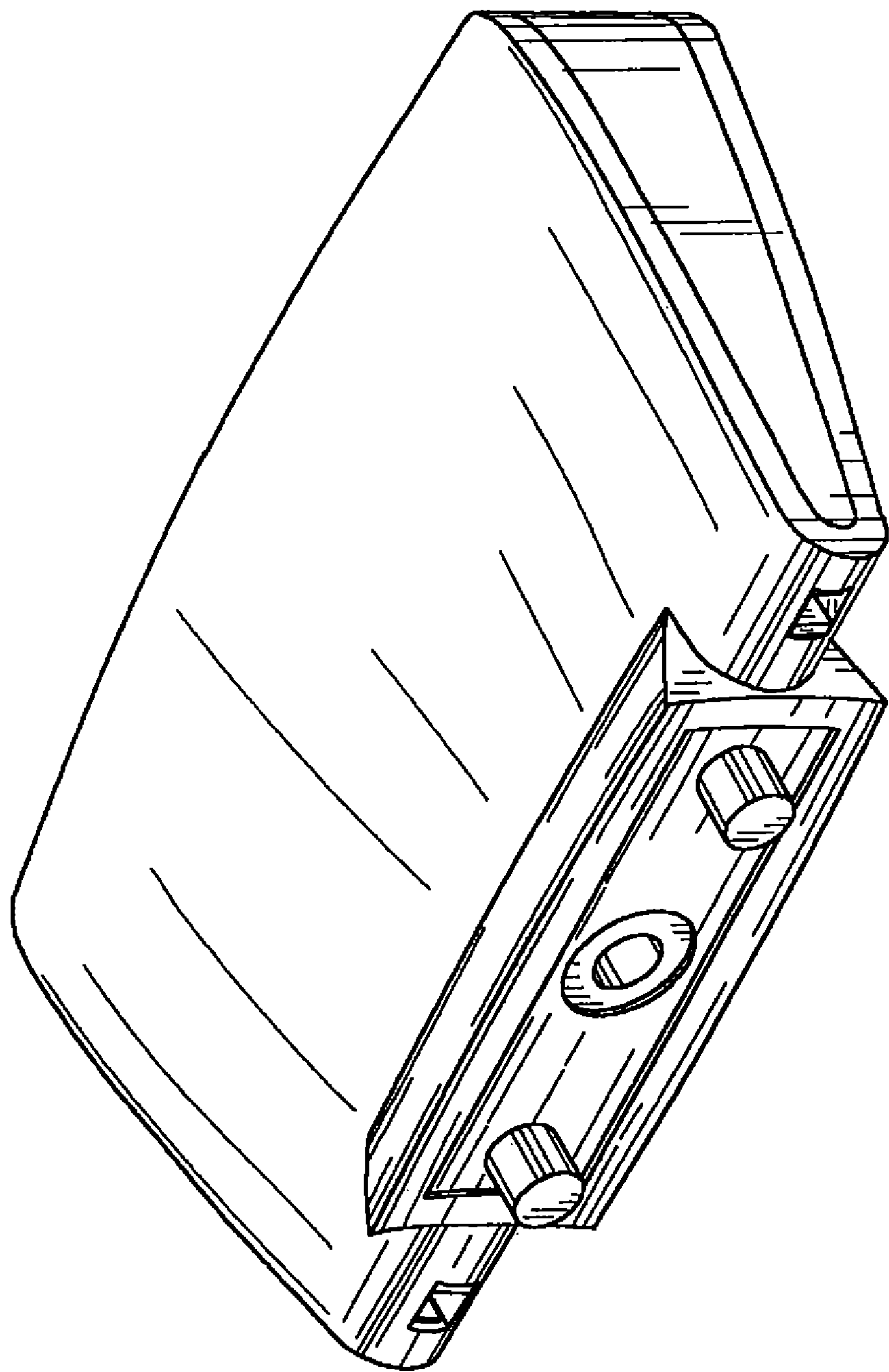
