The ornamental design for a water bottle, as shown and described.

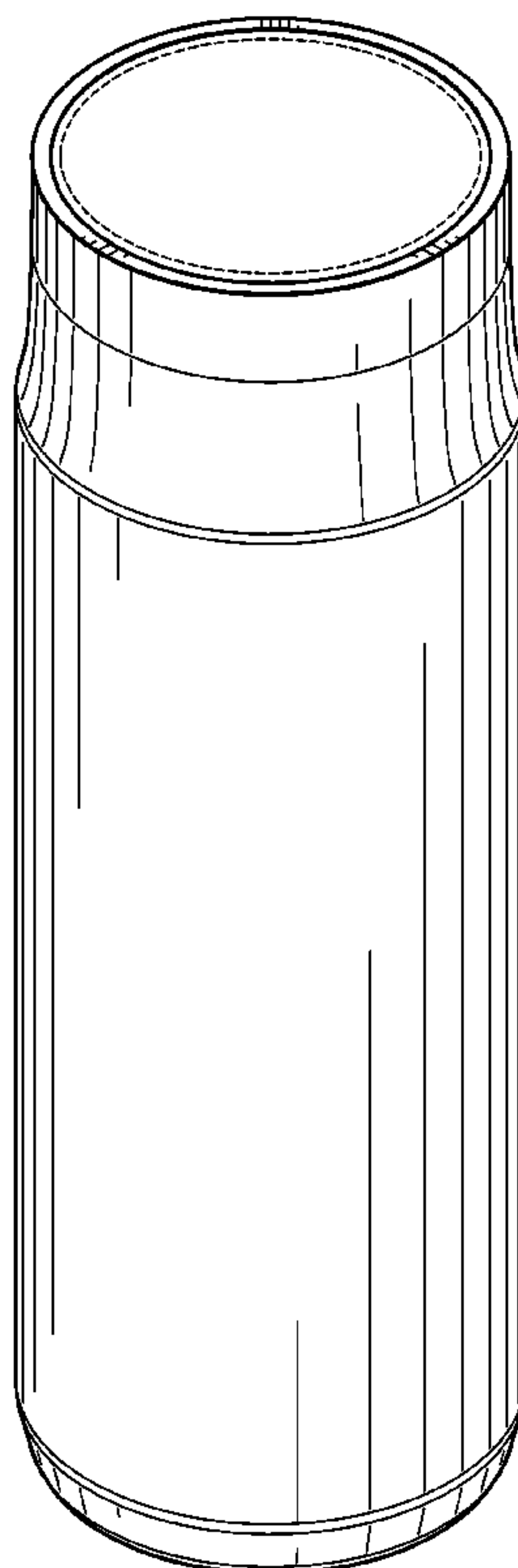
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the present invention, the back side view, right side view and left side view being a mirror image thereof;

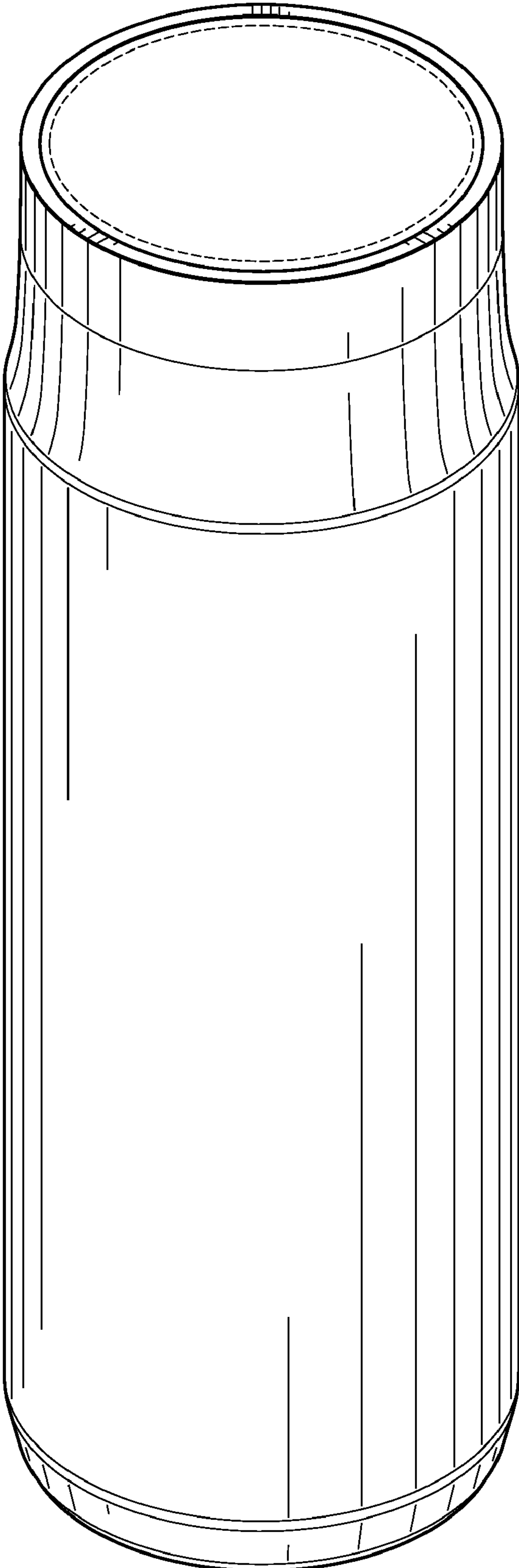

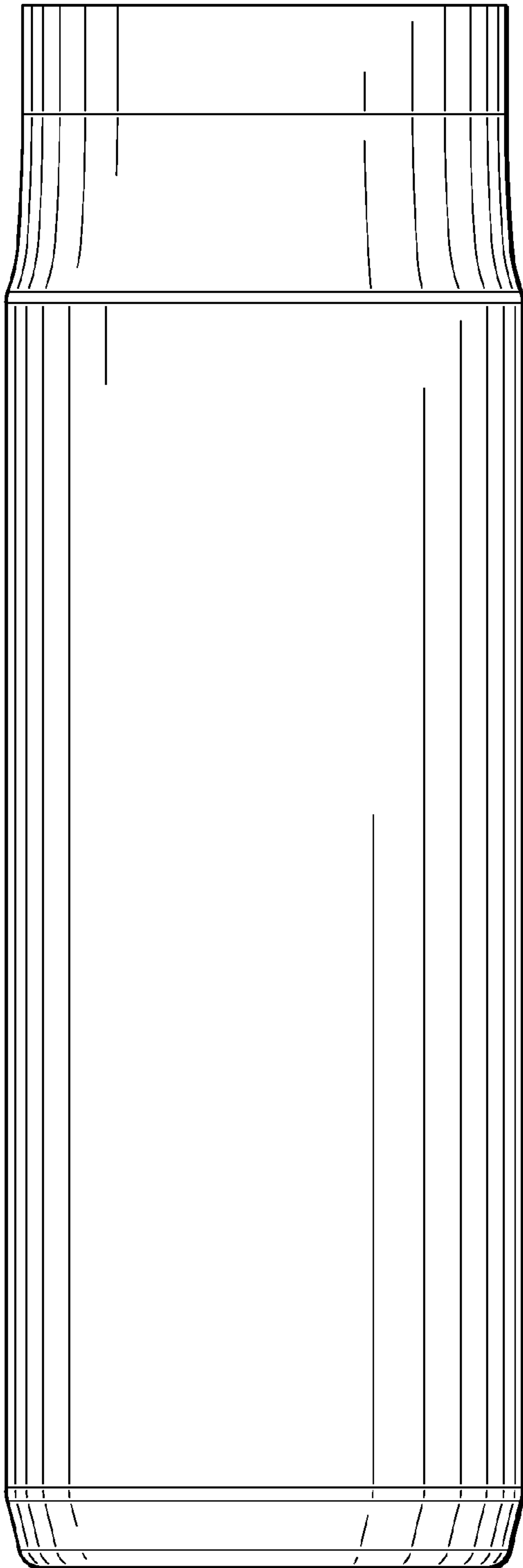

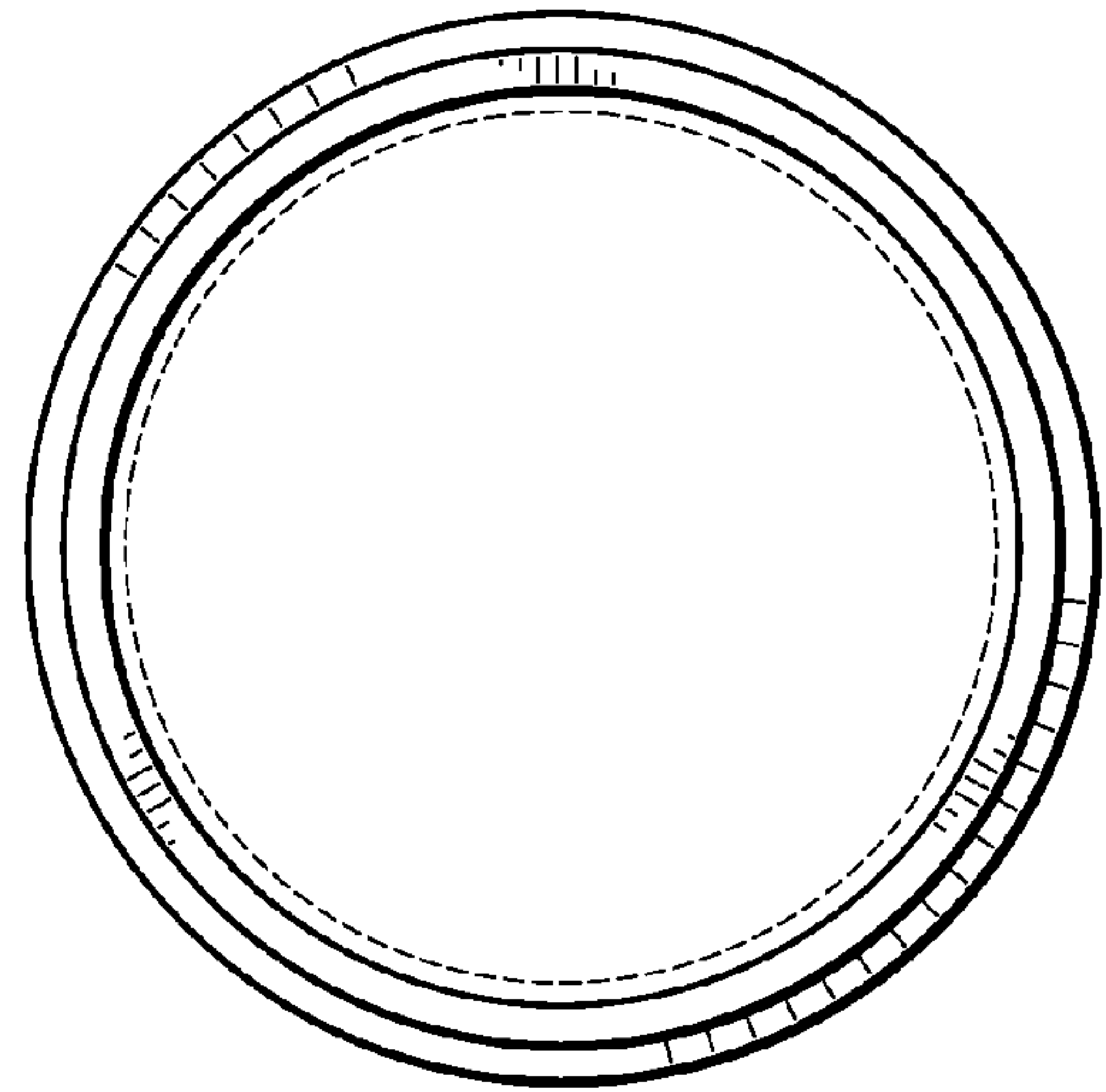

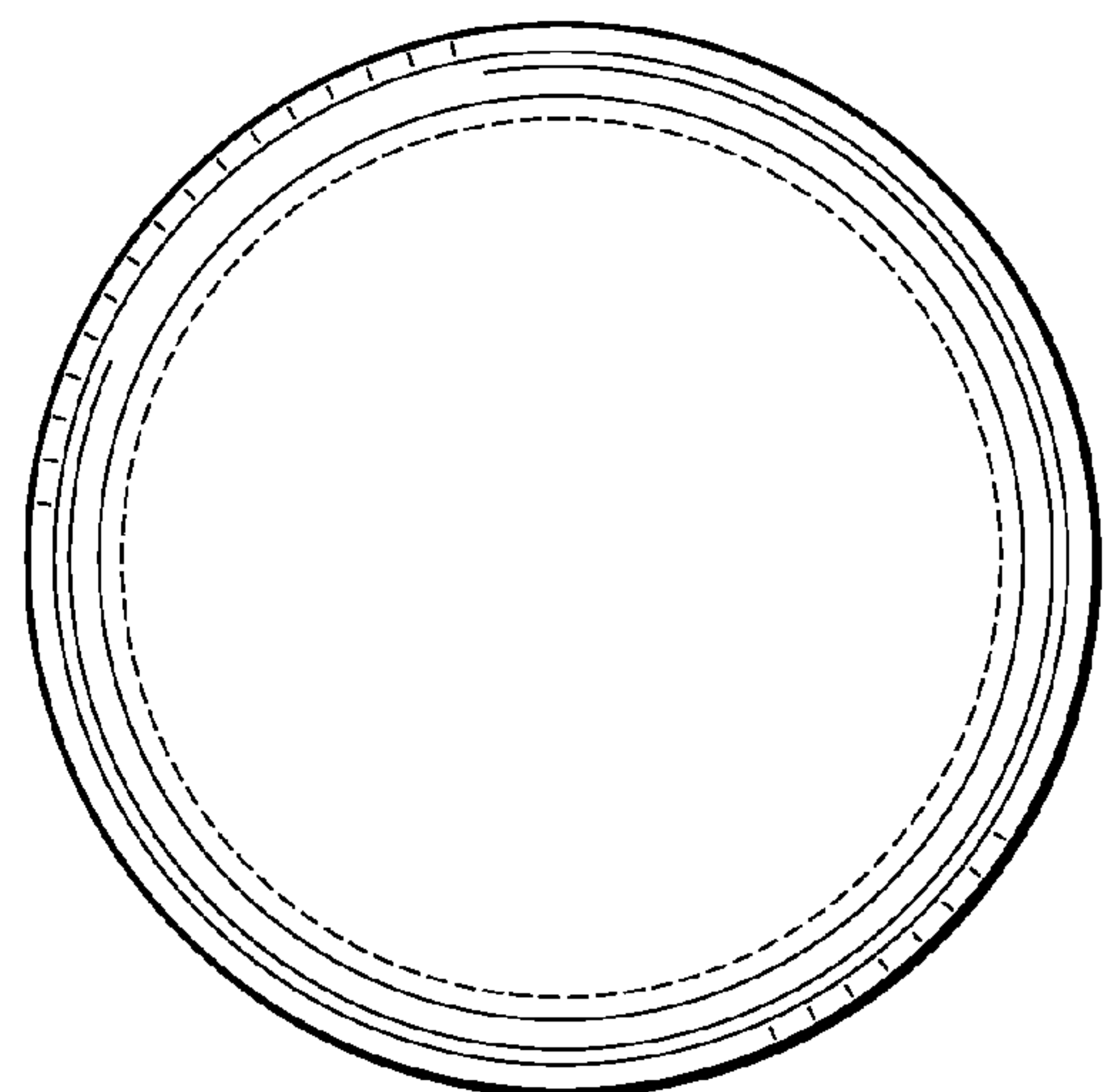
