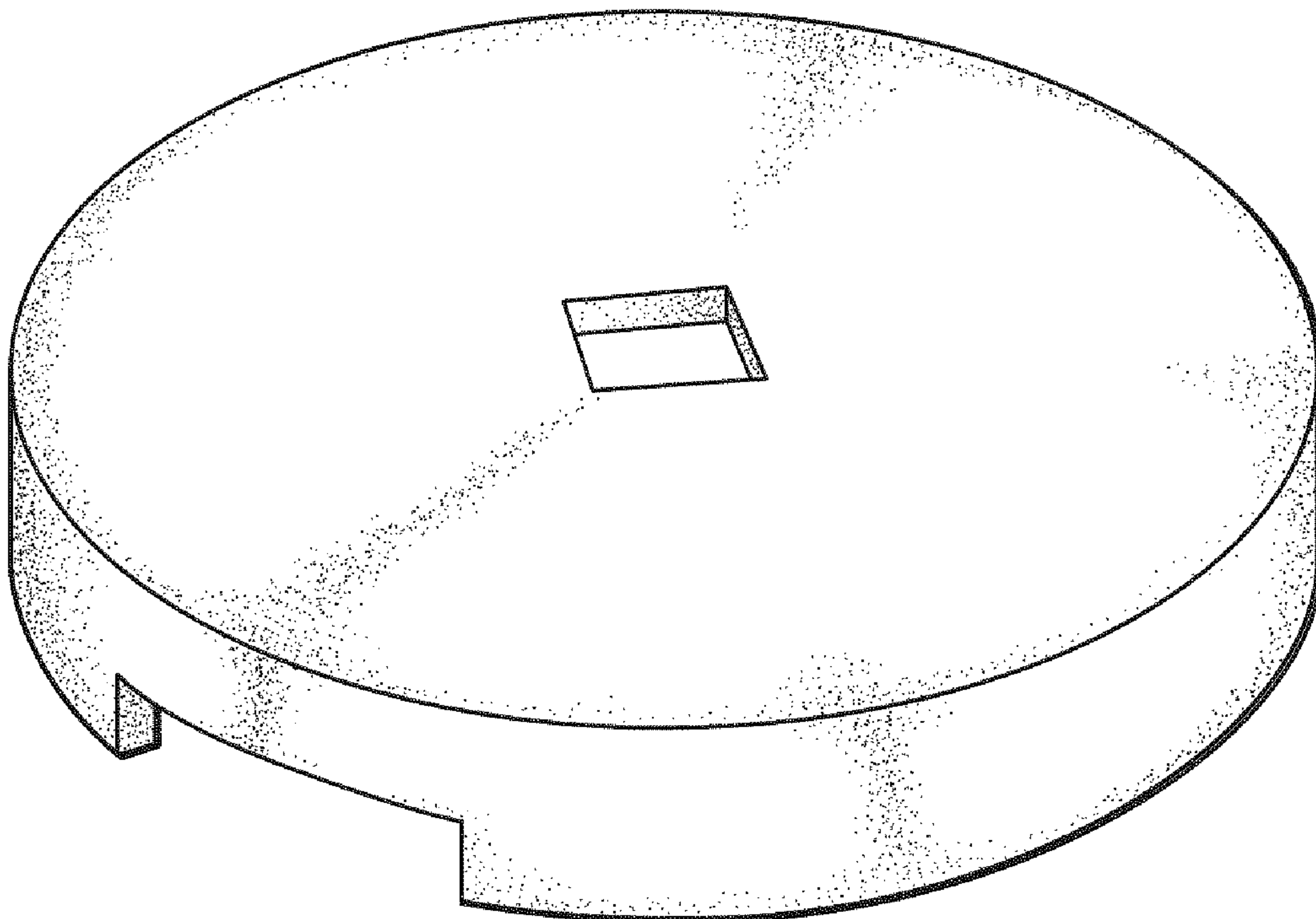
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment according to the present invention.

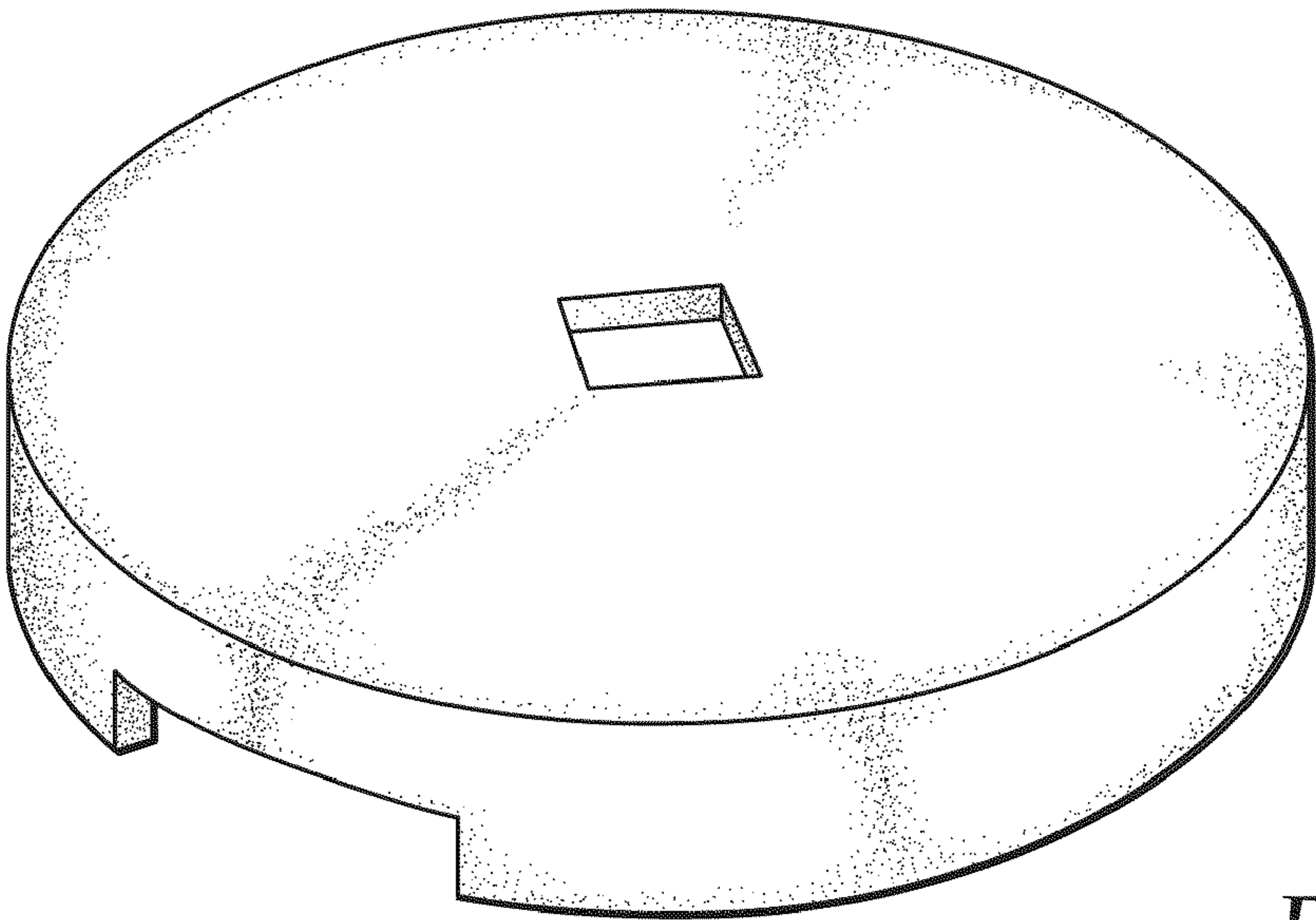

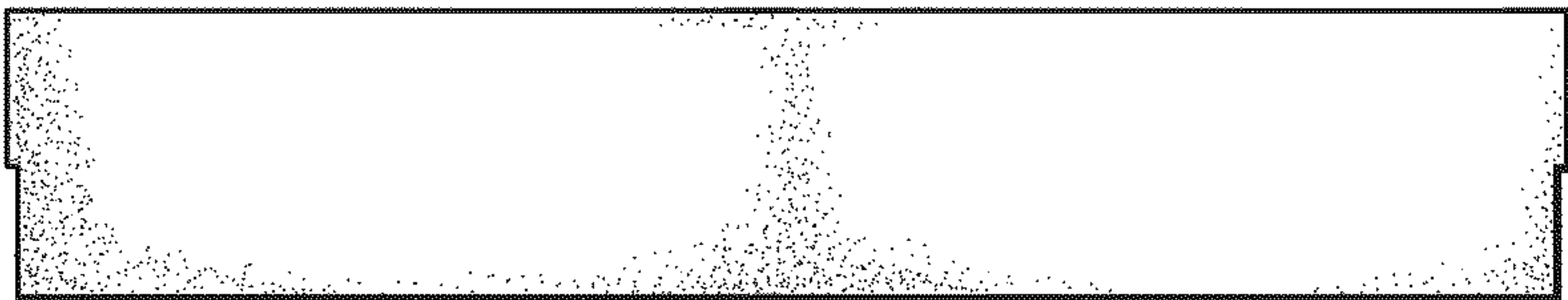

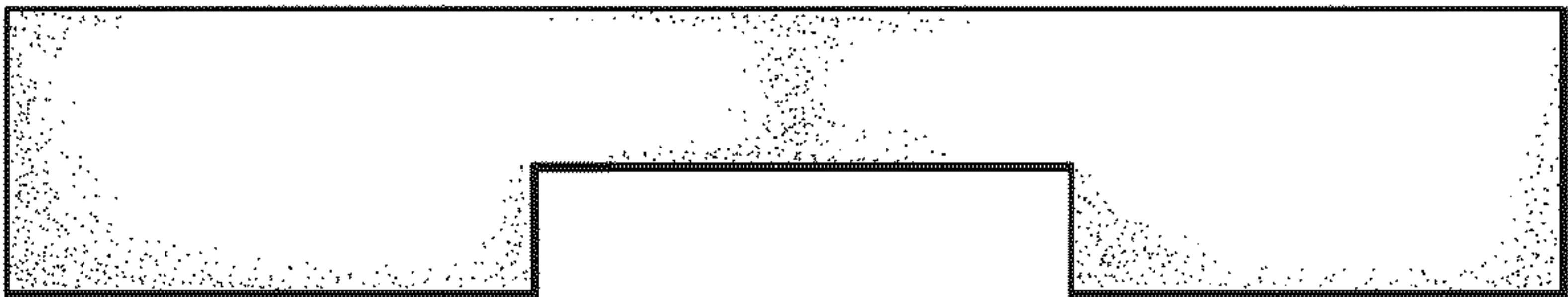

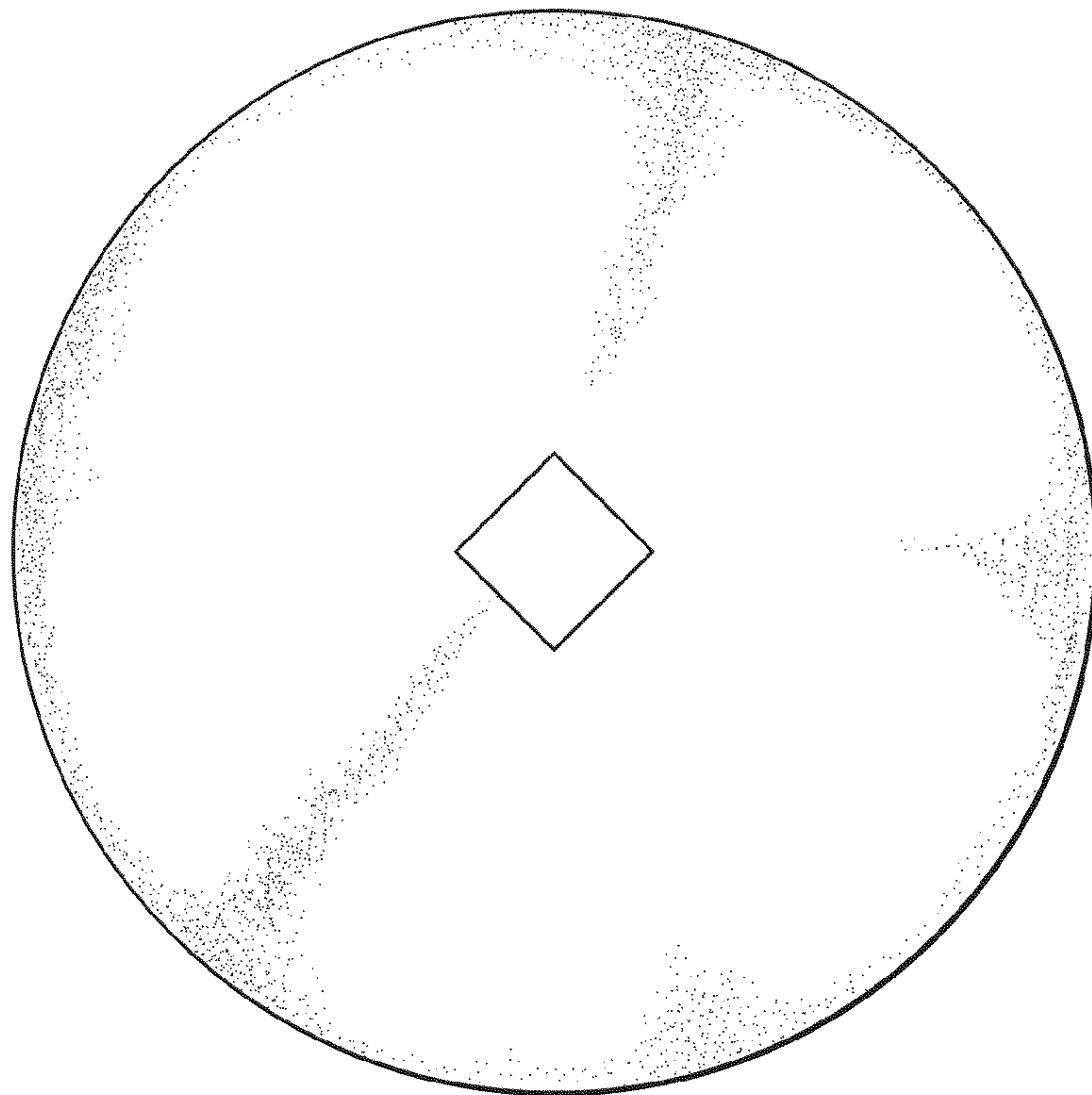

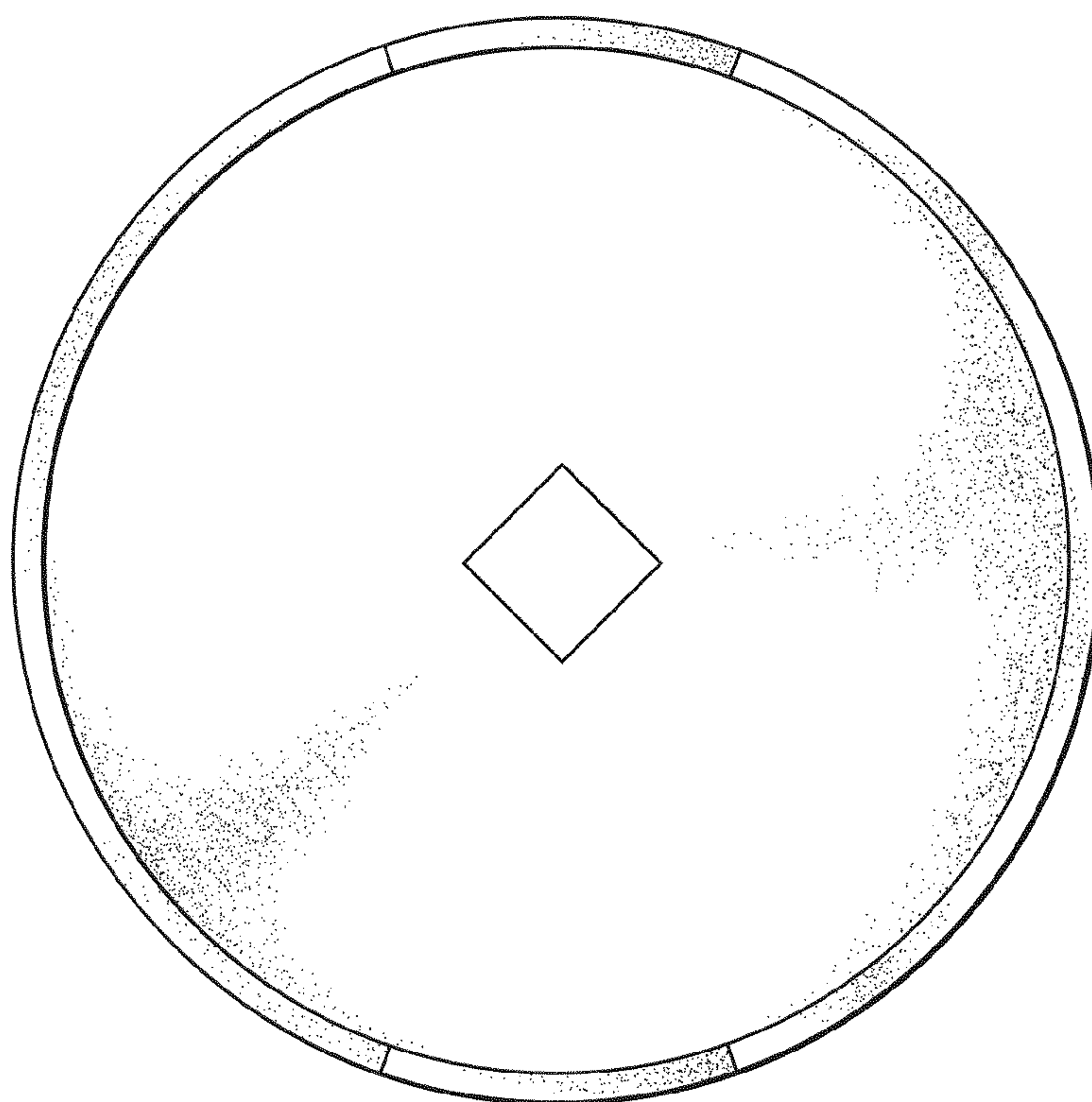
