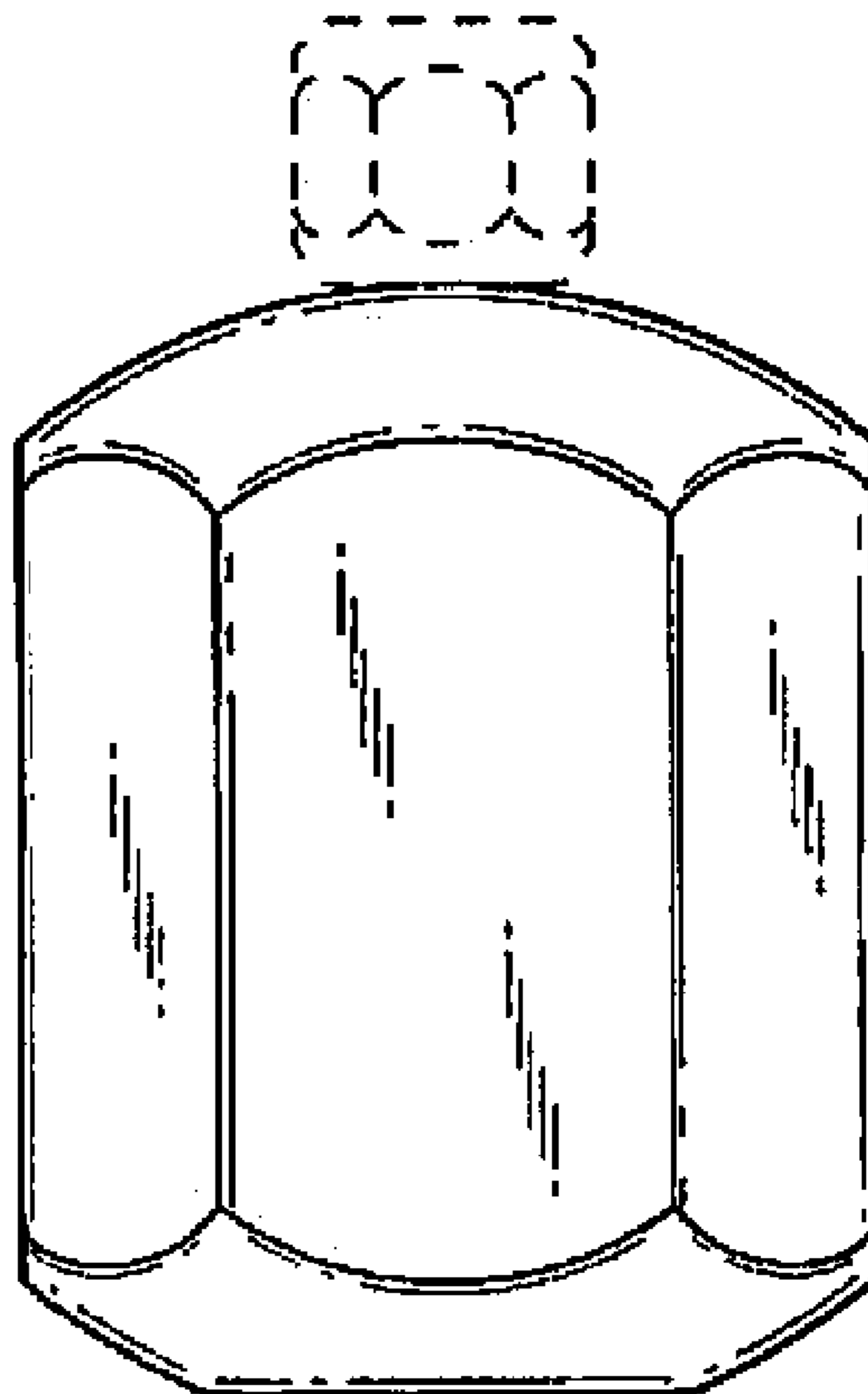
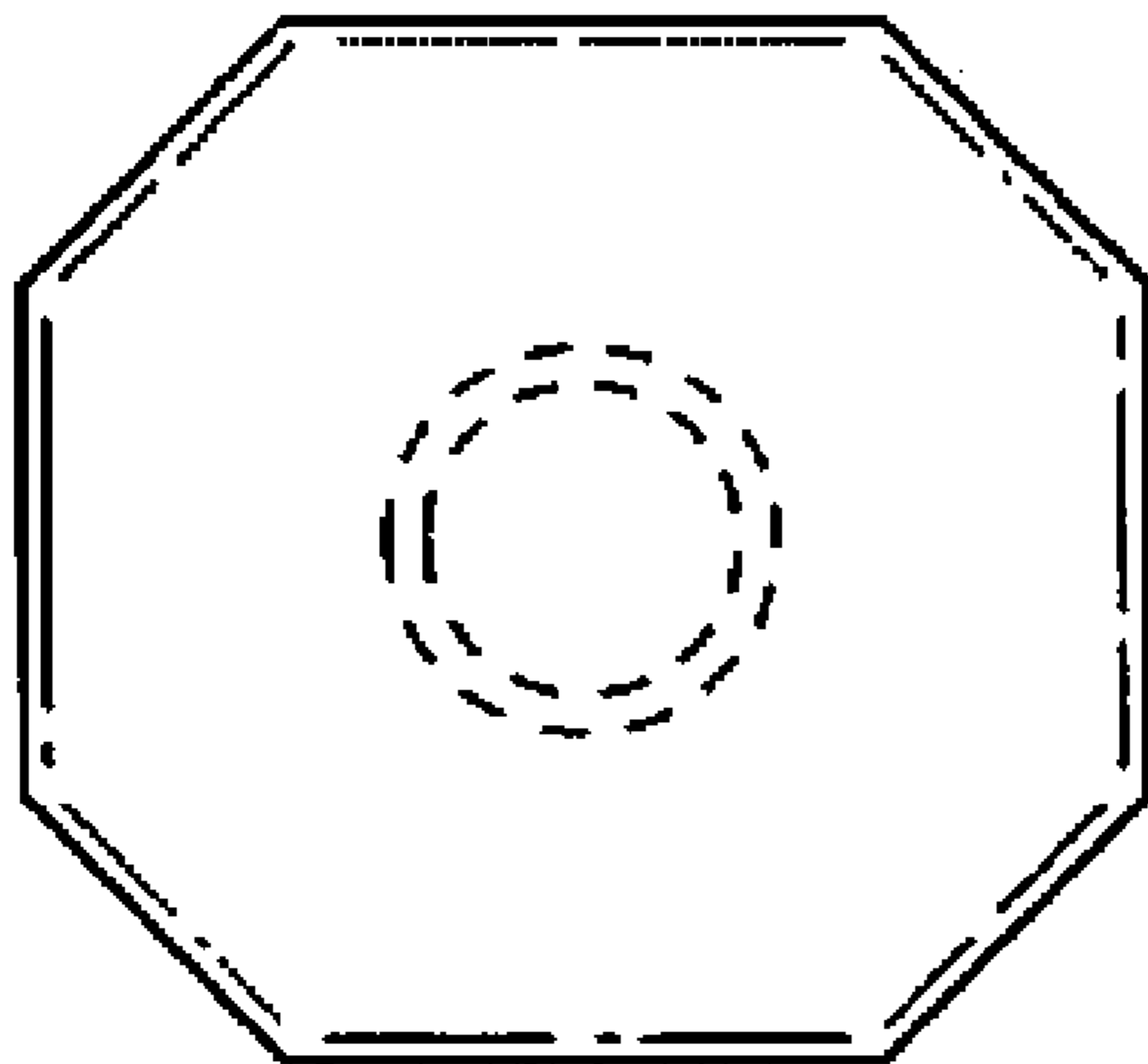
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle for cologne and perfume, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a bottle for cologne and perfume showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposing side elevation view being identical.
The broken lines in the drawings showing the bottle closure illustrate the portions of the design that form no part of the claim.

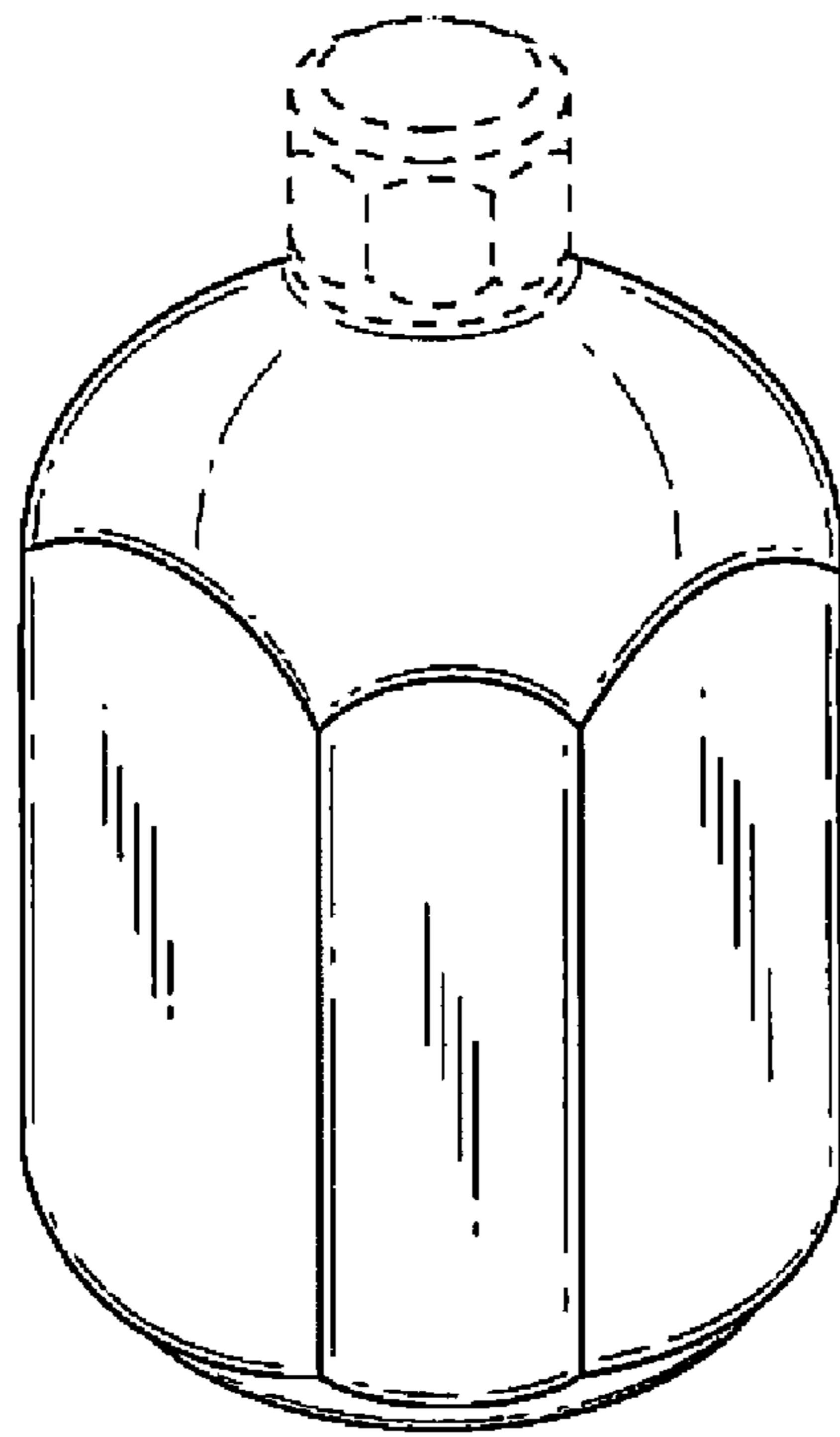

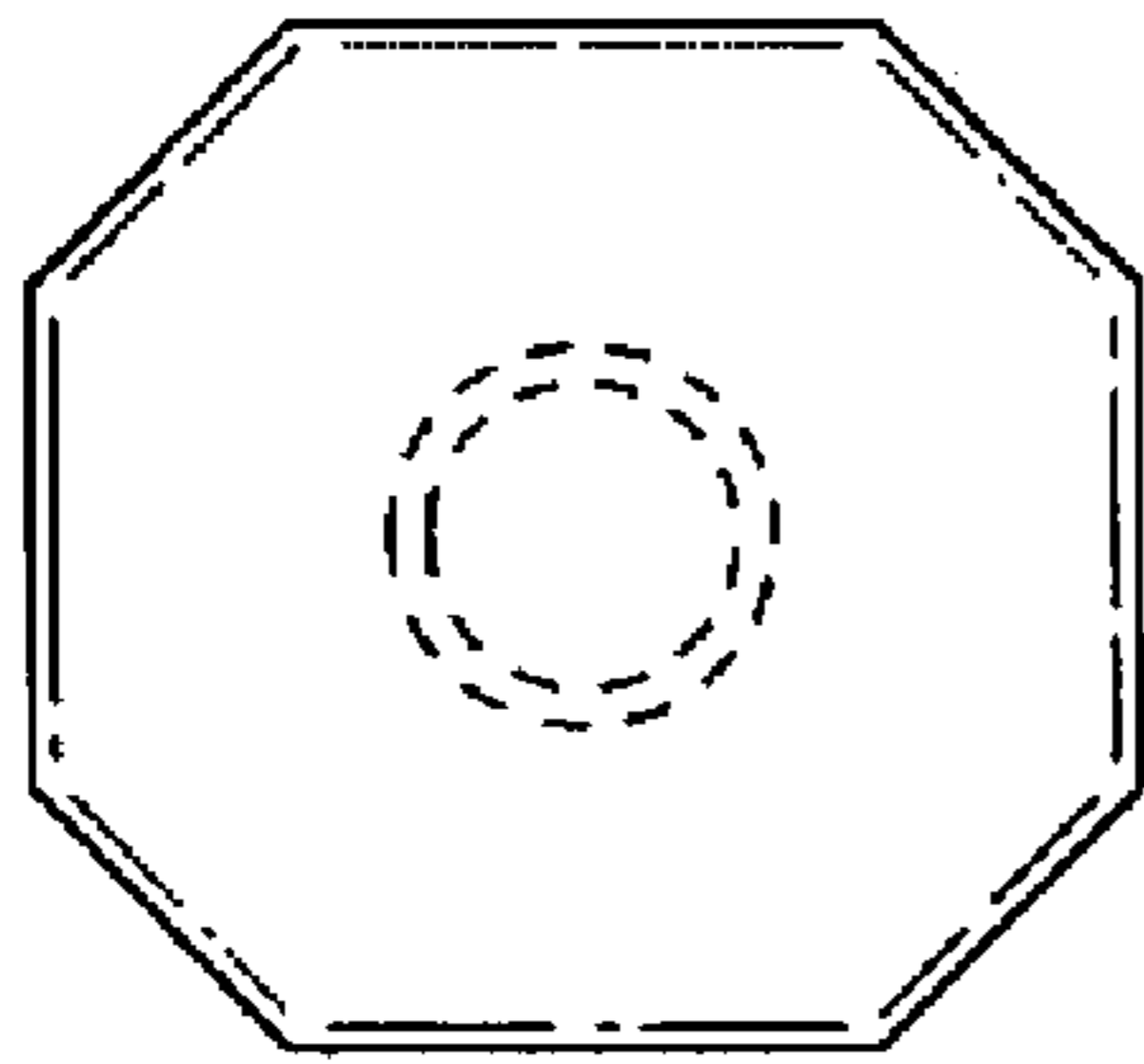

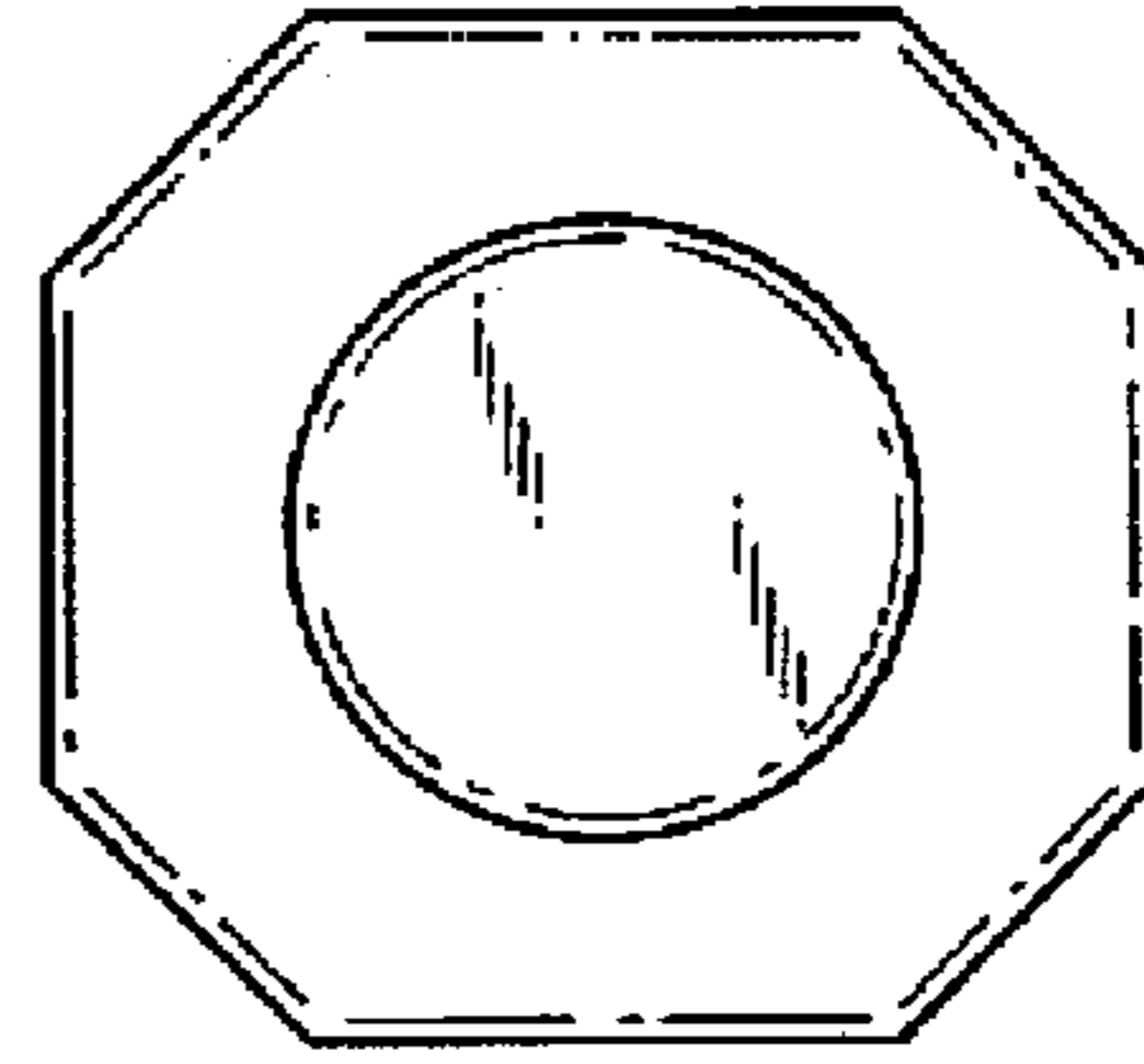

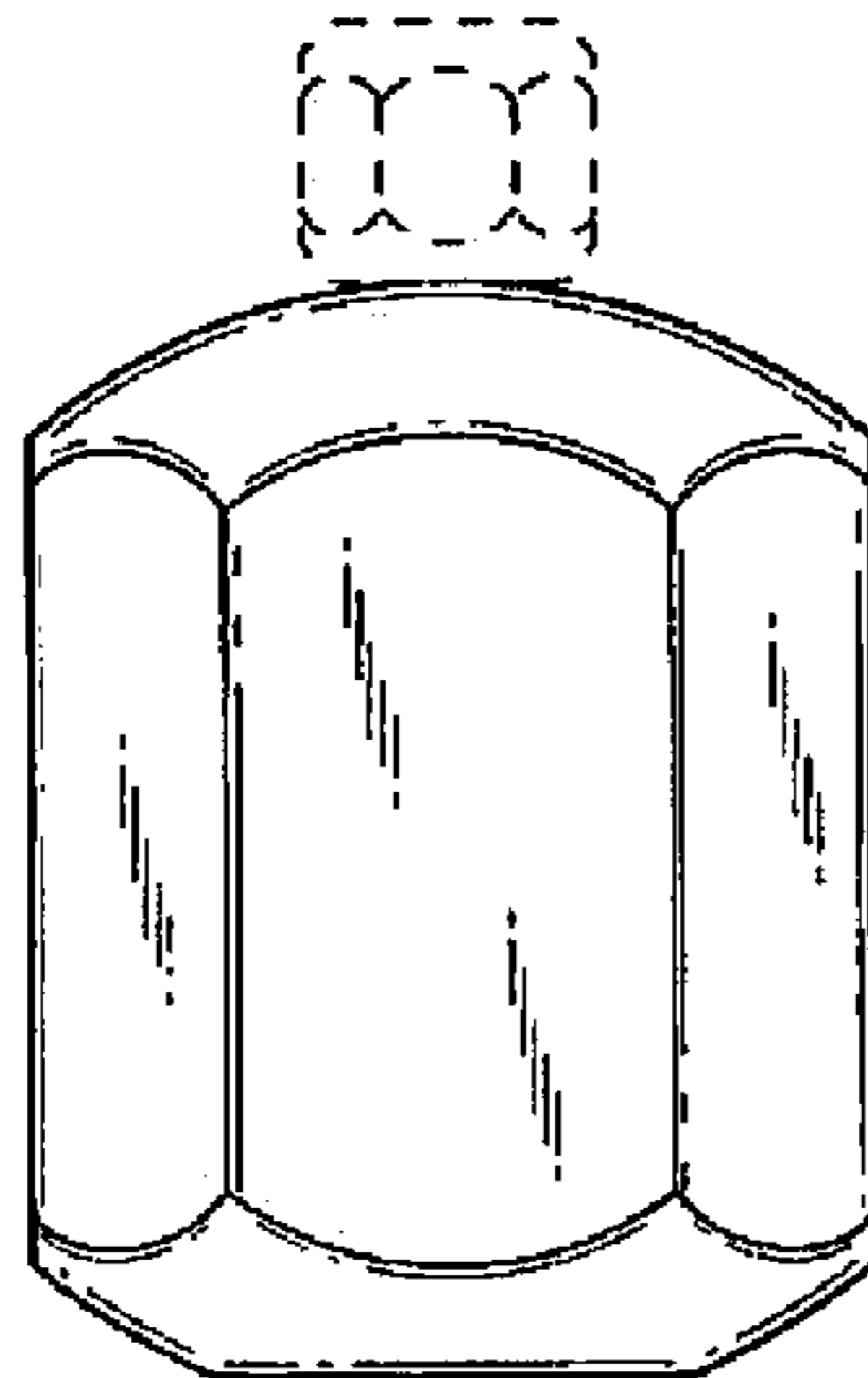

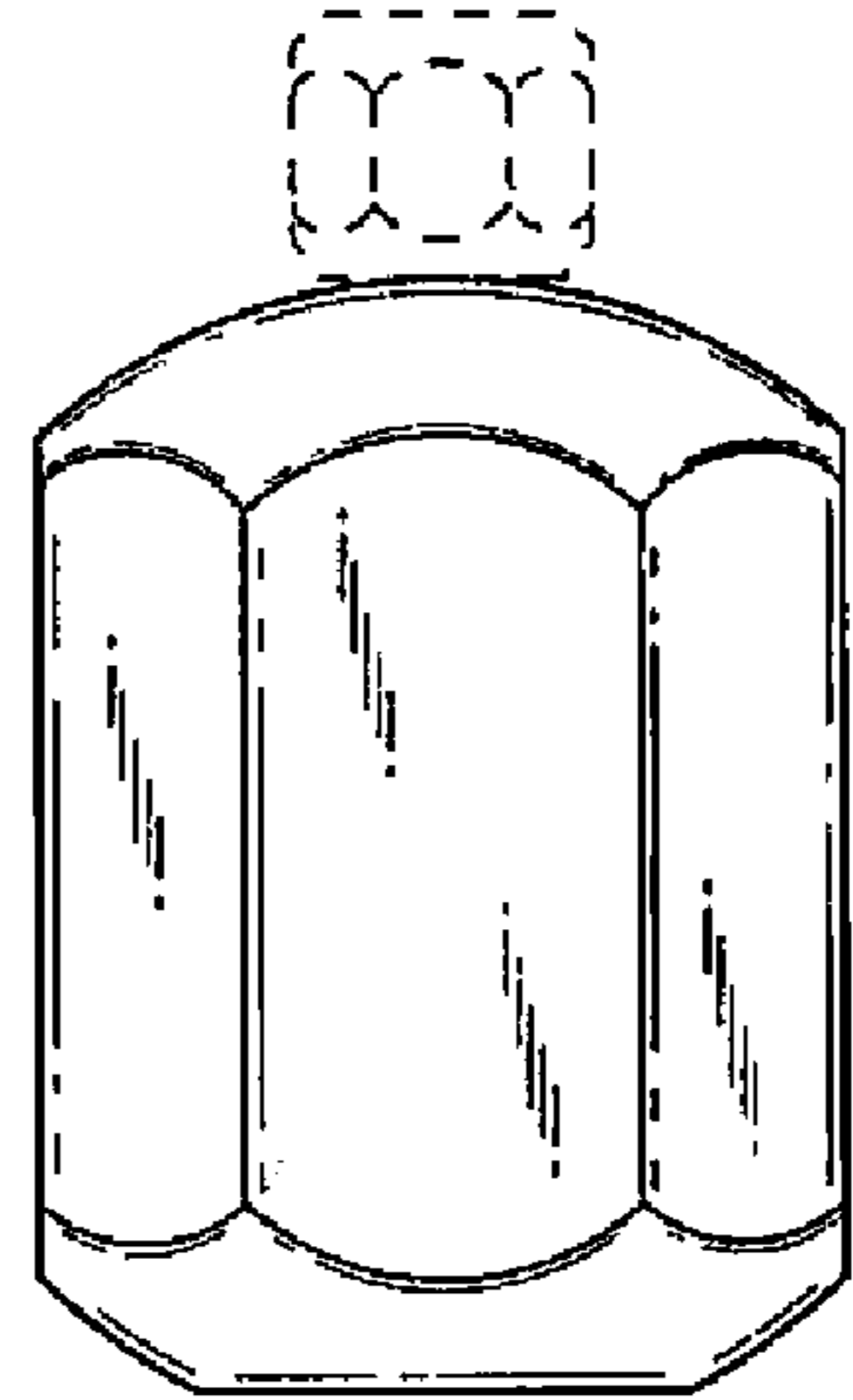
