## (57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tibial impaction tool, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tibial impaction tool shown in an environment illustrating our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the tibial impaction tool shown removed from its environment in order to show aspects of the design that are not apparent in the perspective view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a rear end elevation view thereof; and,














