FIG. 1 is an elevation view of a first preferred embodiment of our design, as it would appear on the front of a man when worn;

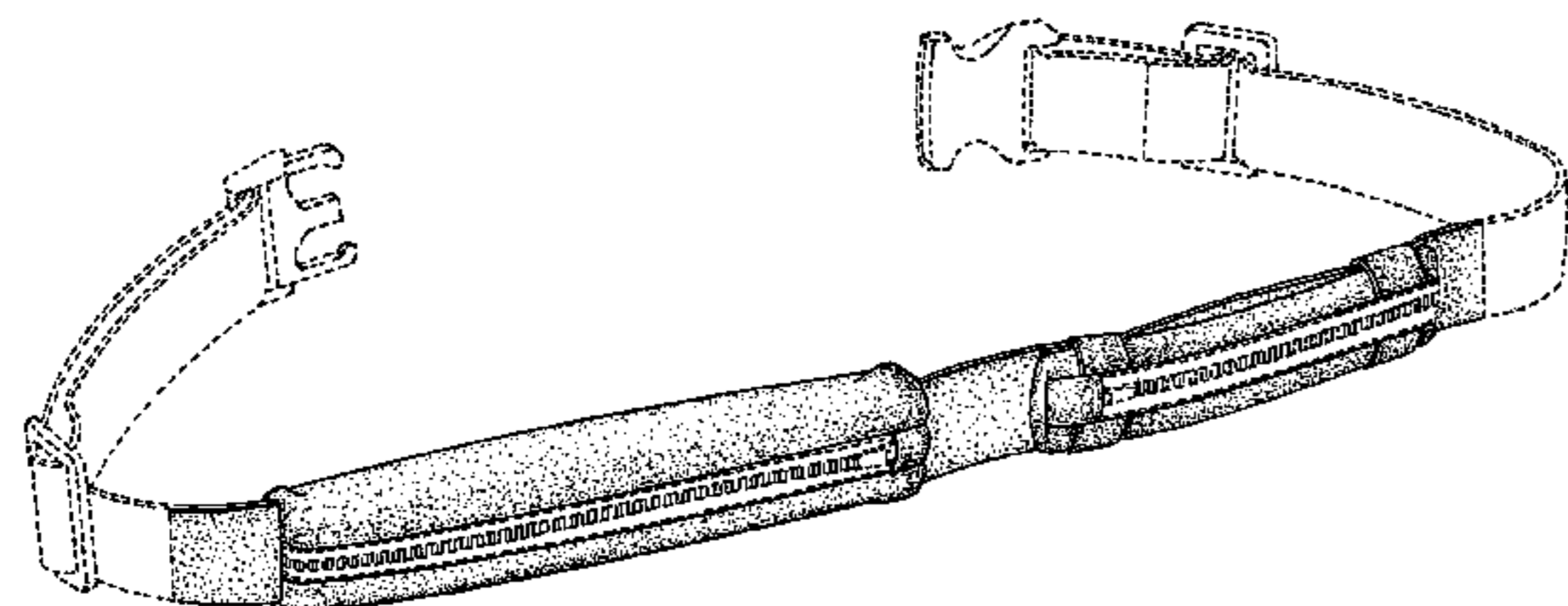


FIG. 2 is an elevation view of the first preferred embodiment of our design, as it would appear on the back of a man when worn;

FIG. 15 is a top elevation view of the second preferred embodiment of our design;

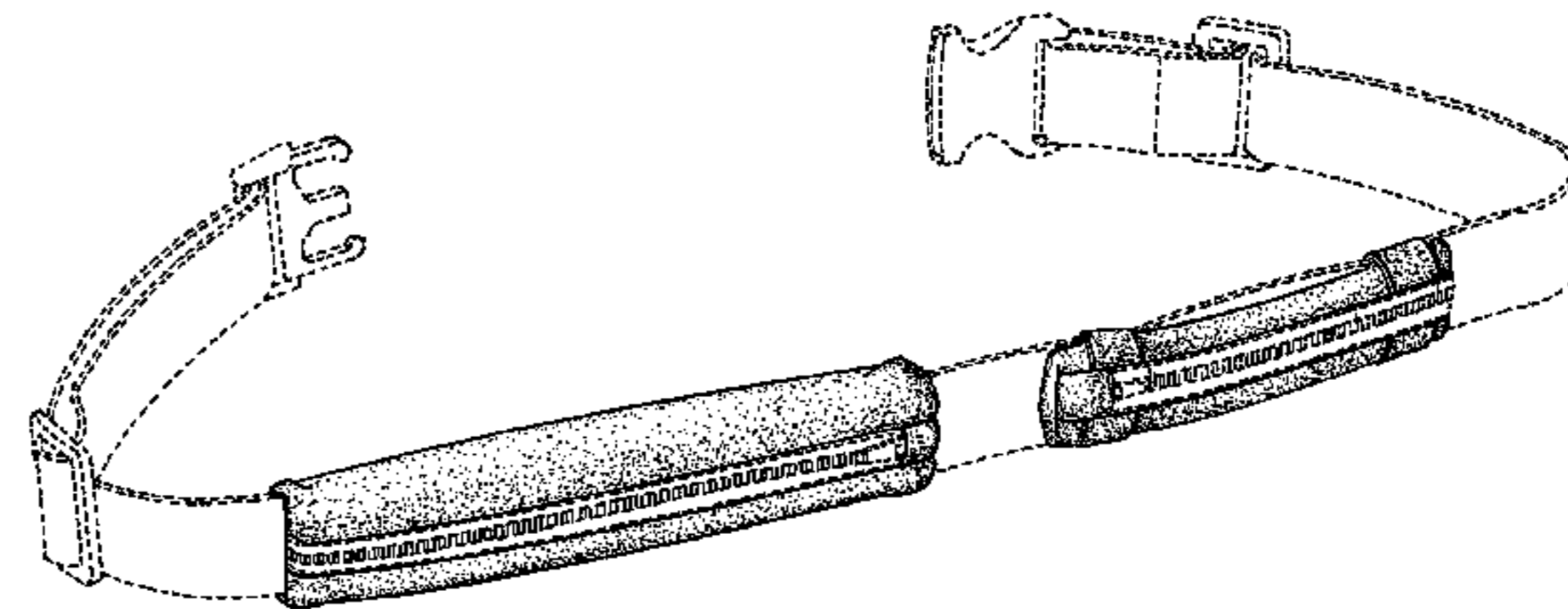
FIG. 16 is a bottom elevation view of the second preferred embodiment of our design;

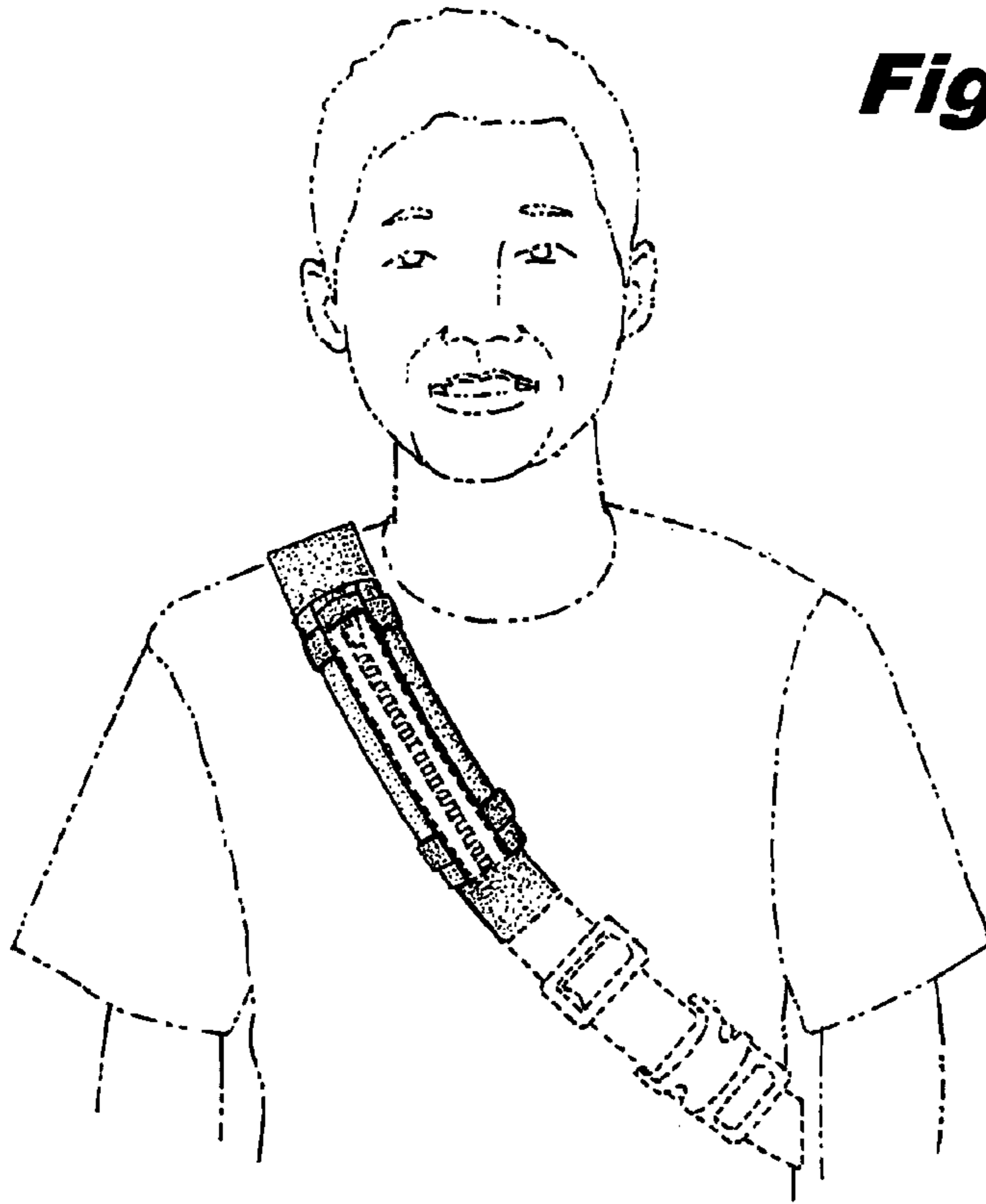
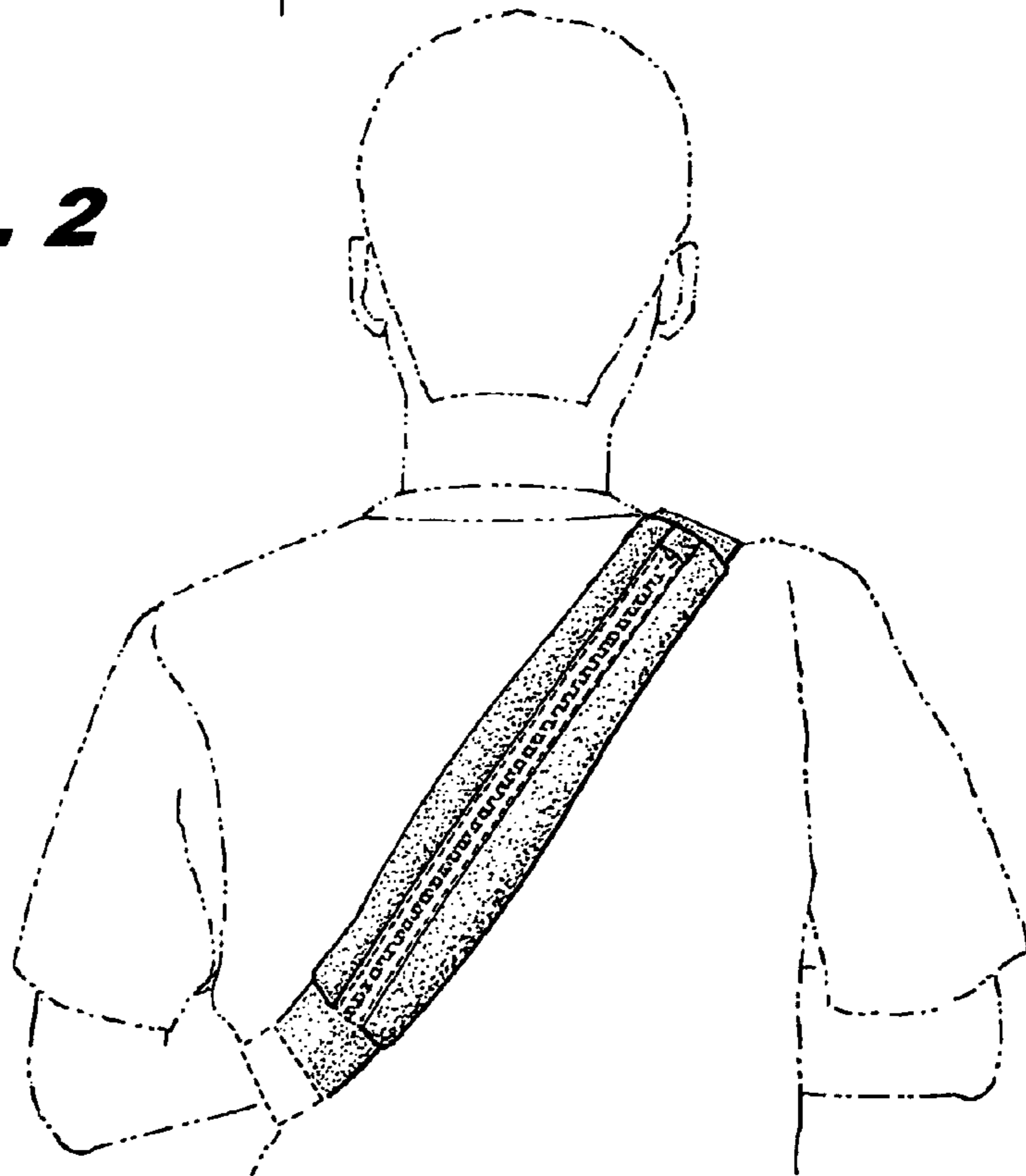

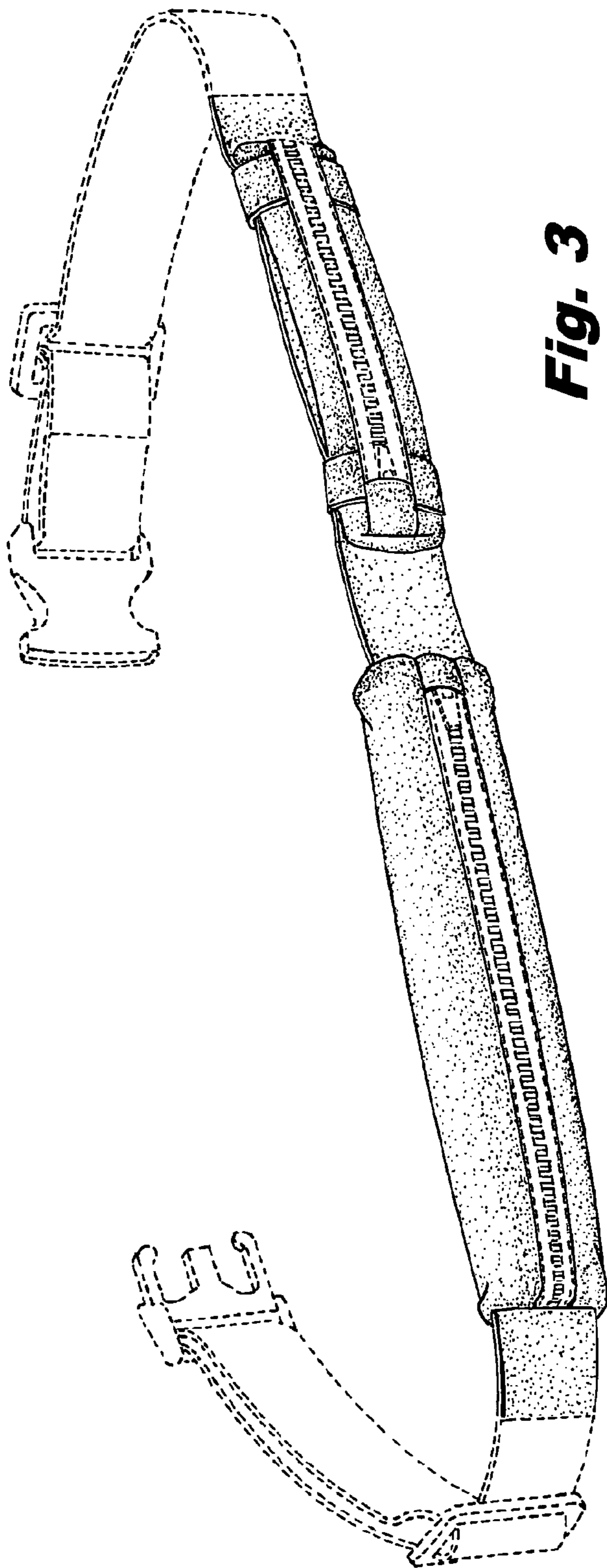

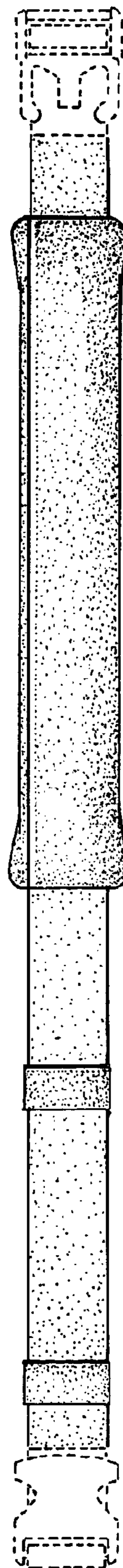

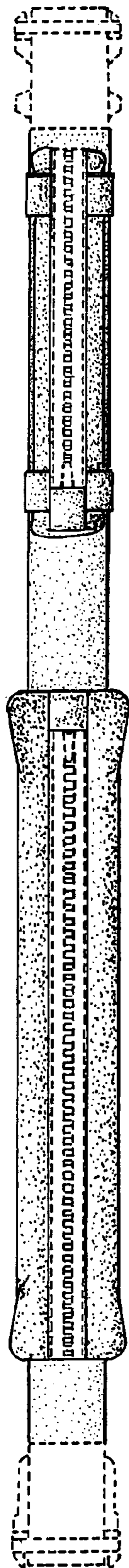

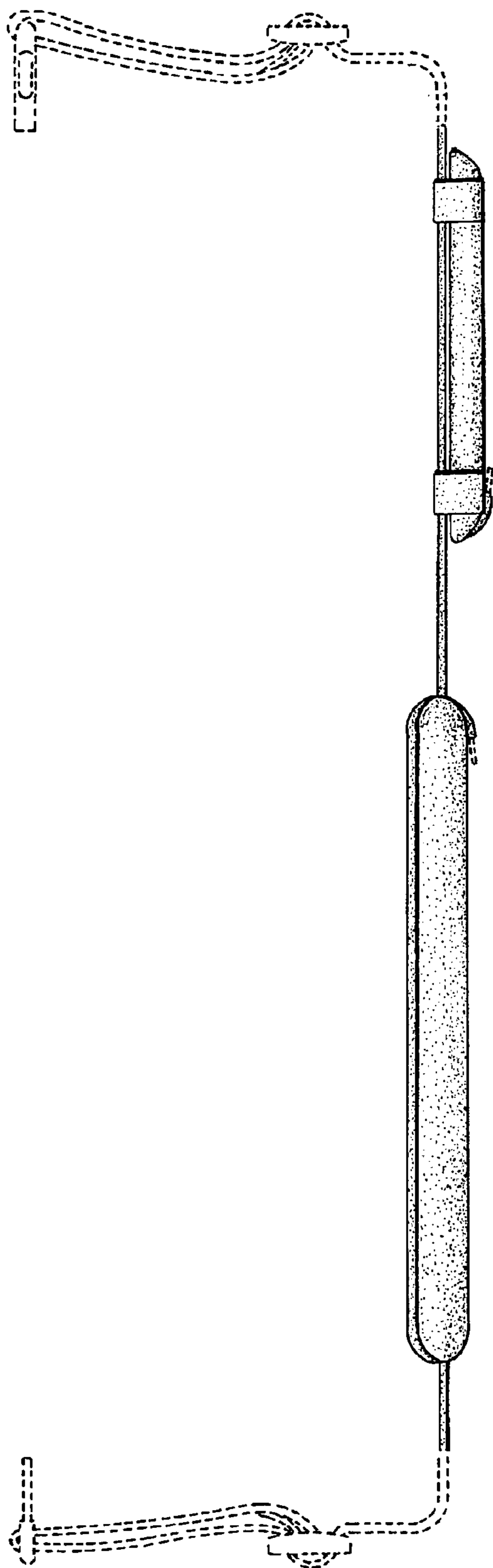

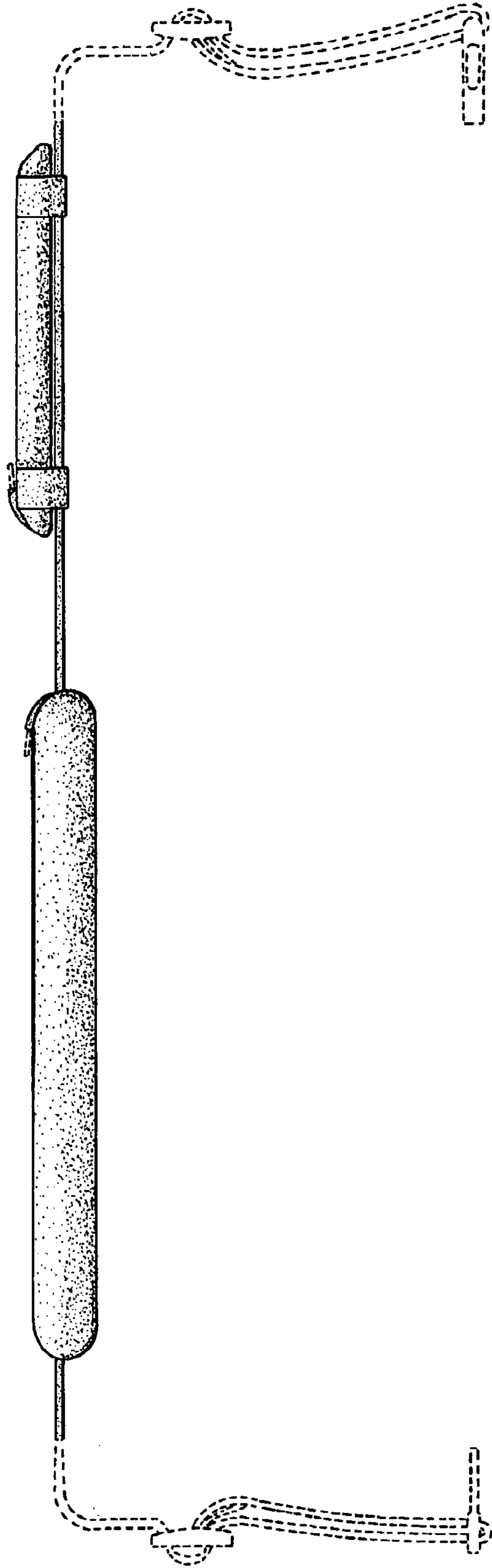

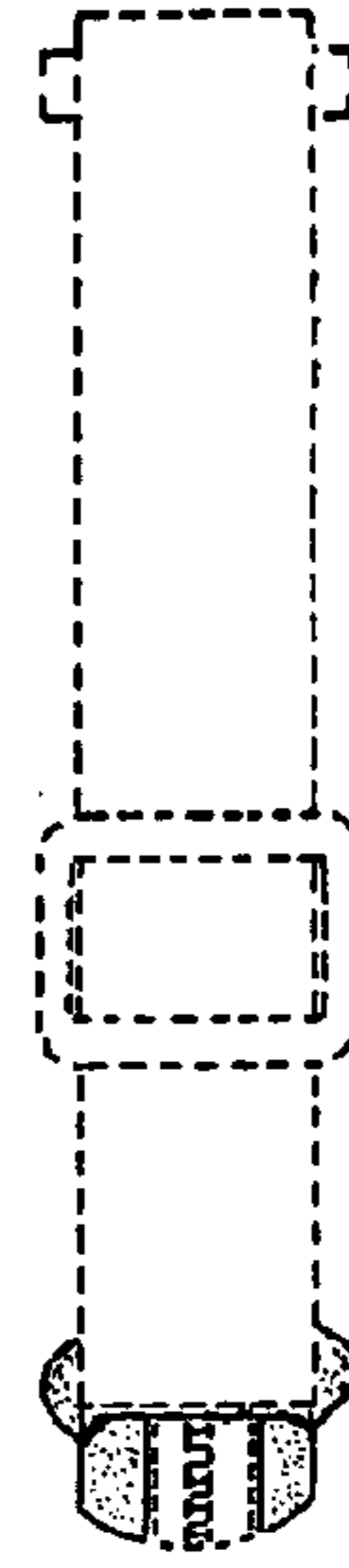

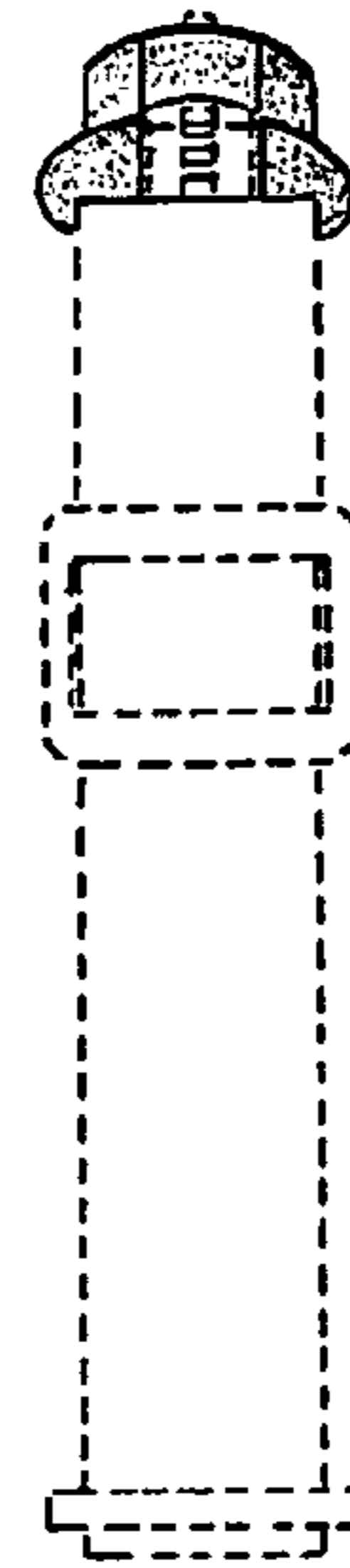

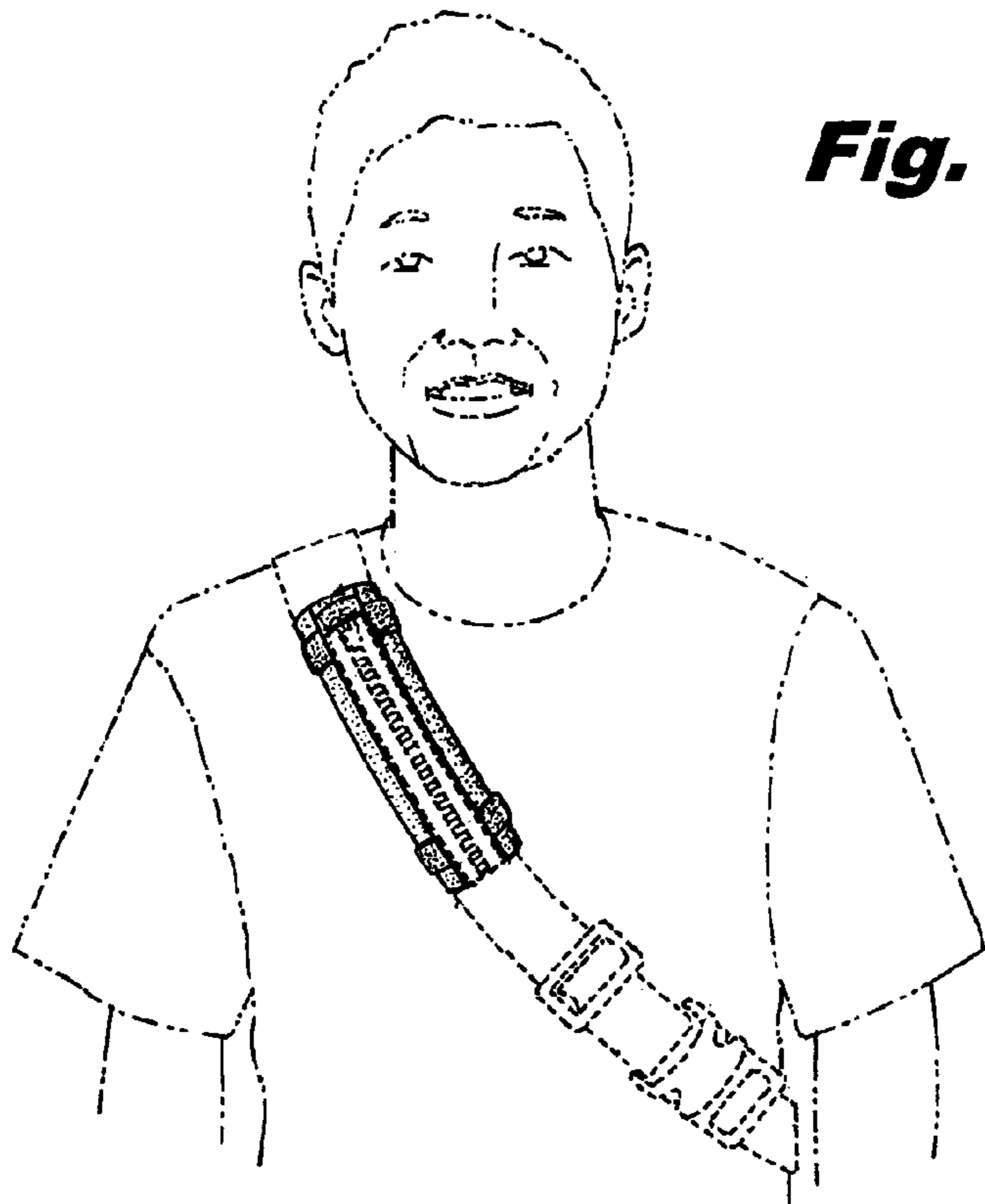

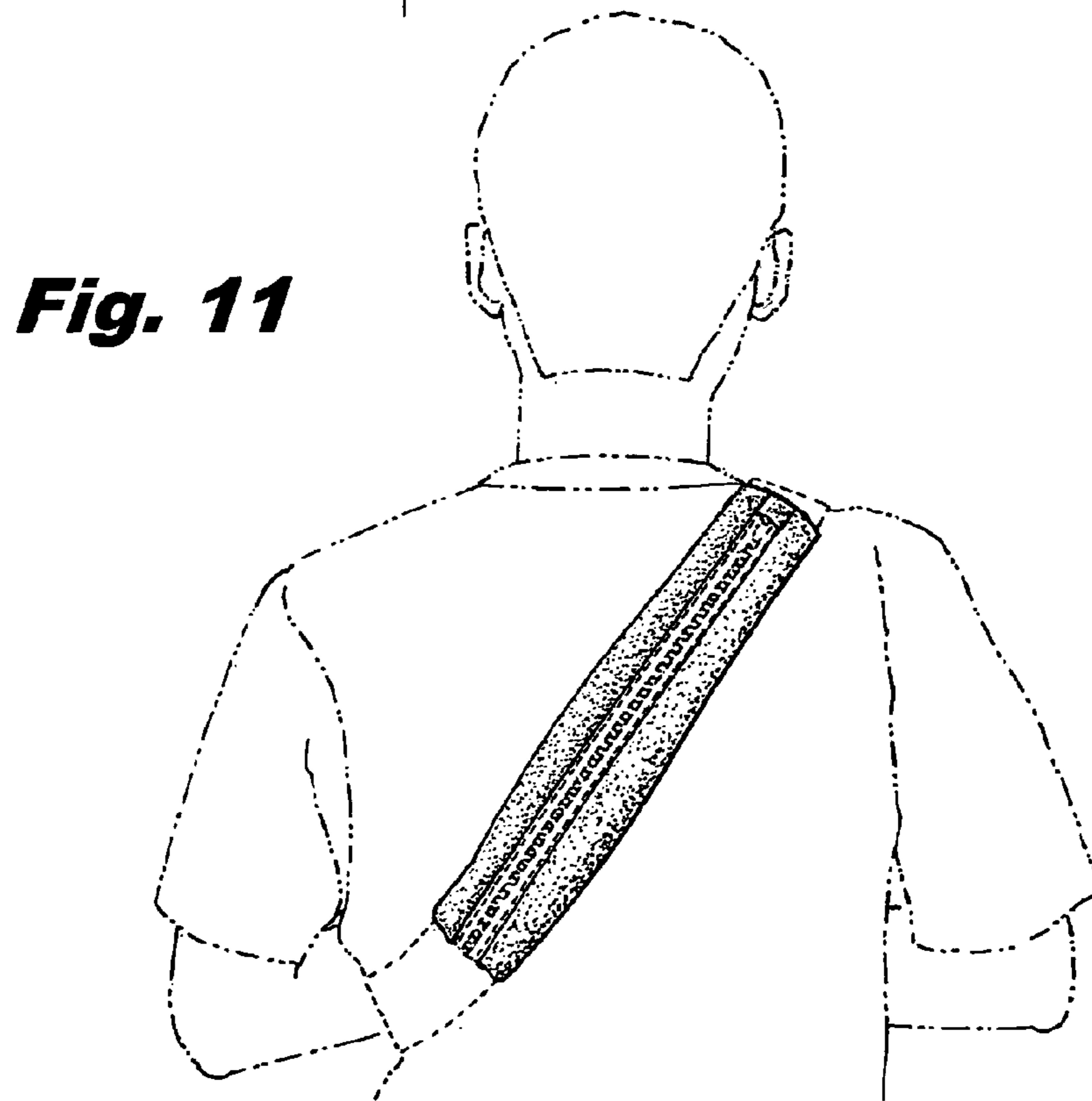

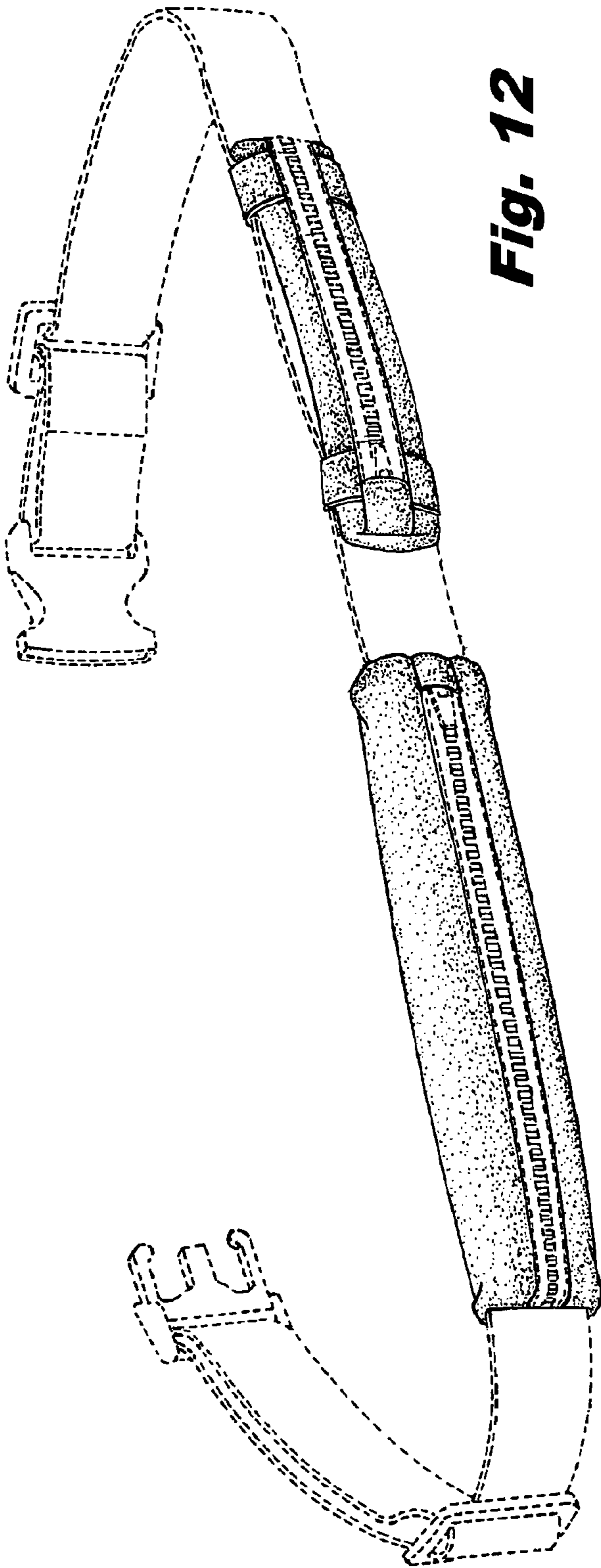

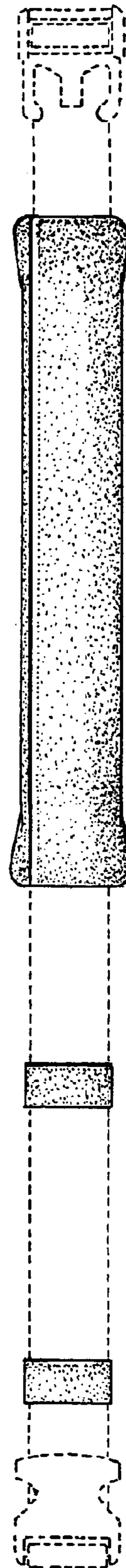

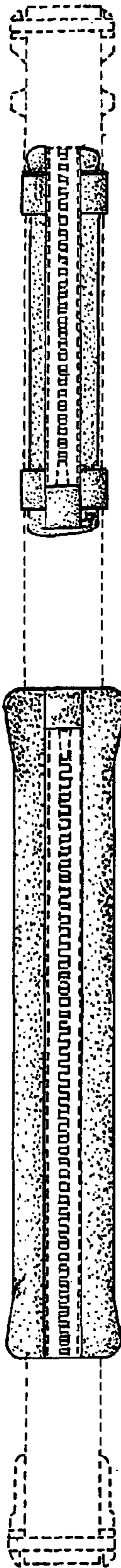

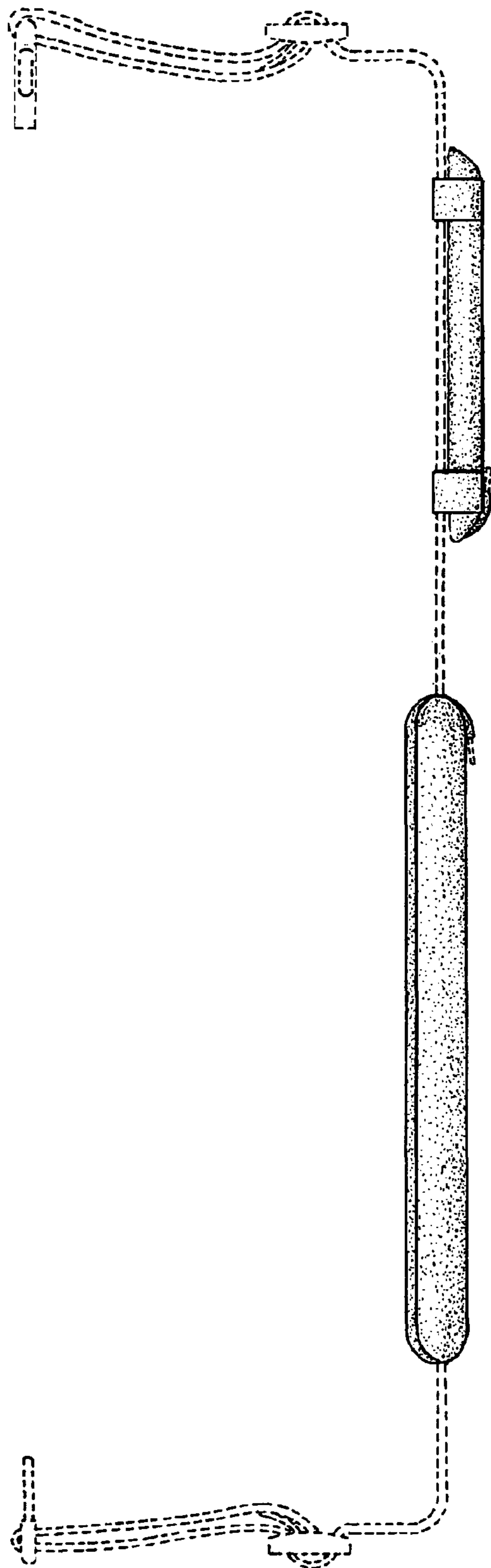

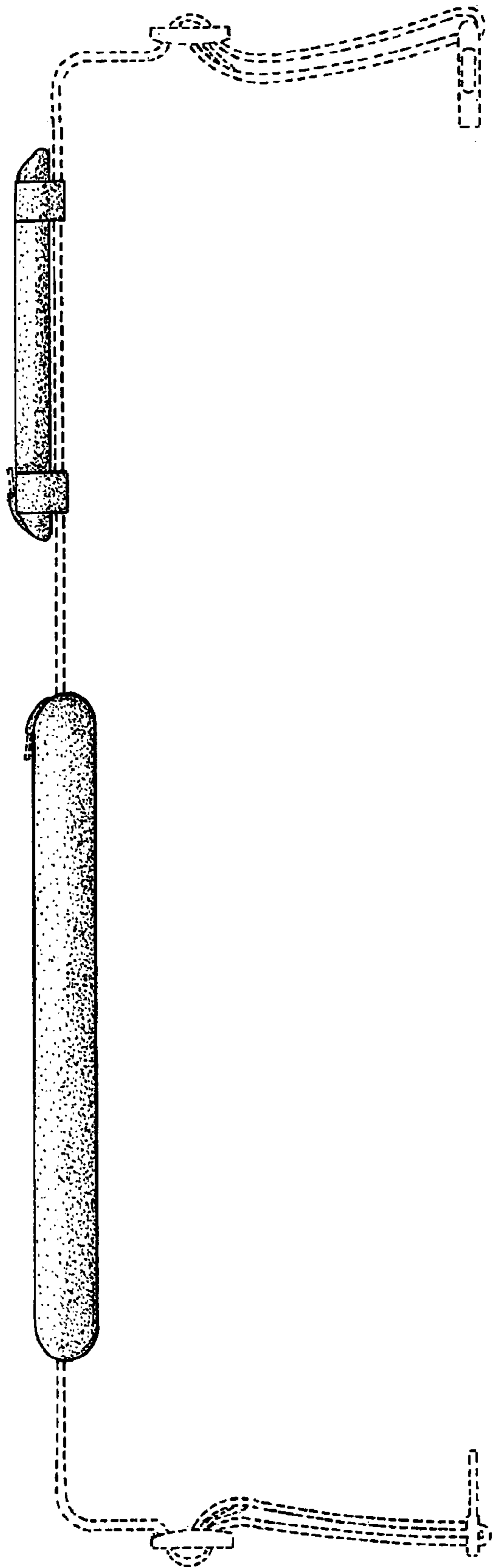

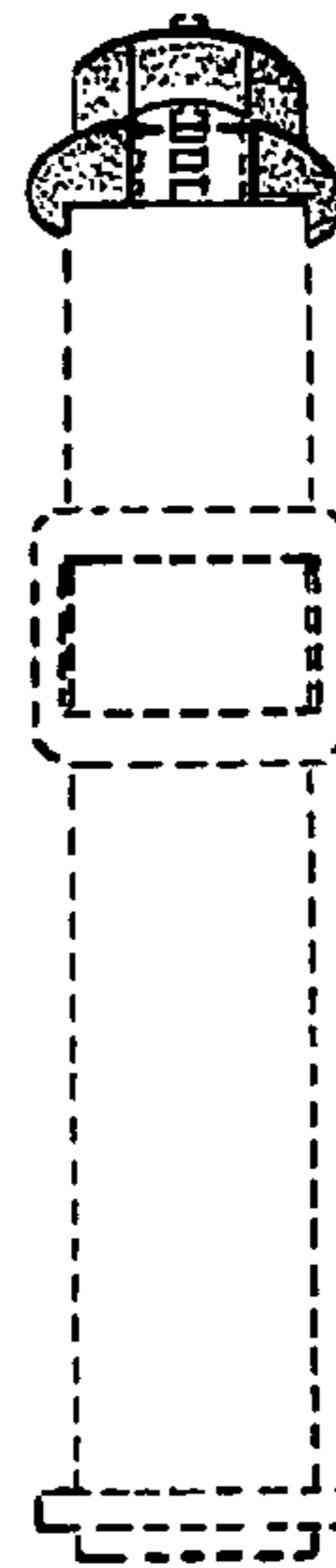
