The ornamental design for a necklace changeable to a pendant, as shown and described.

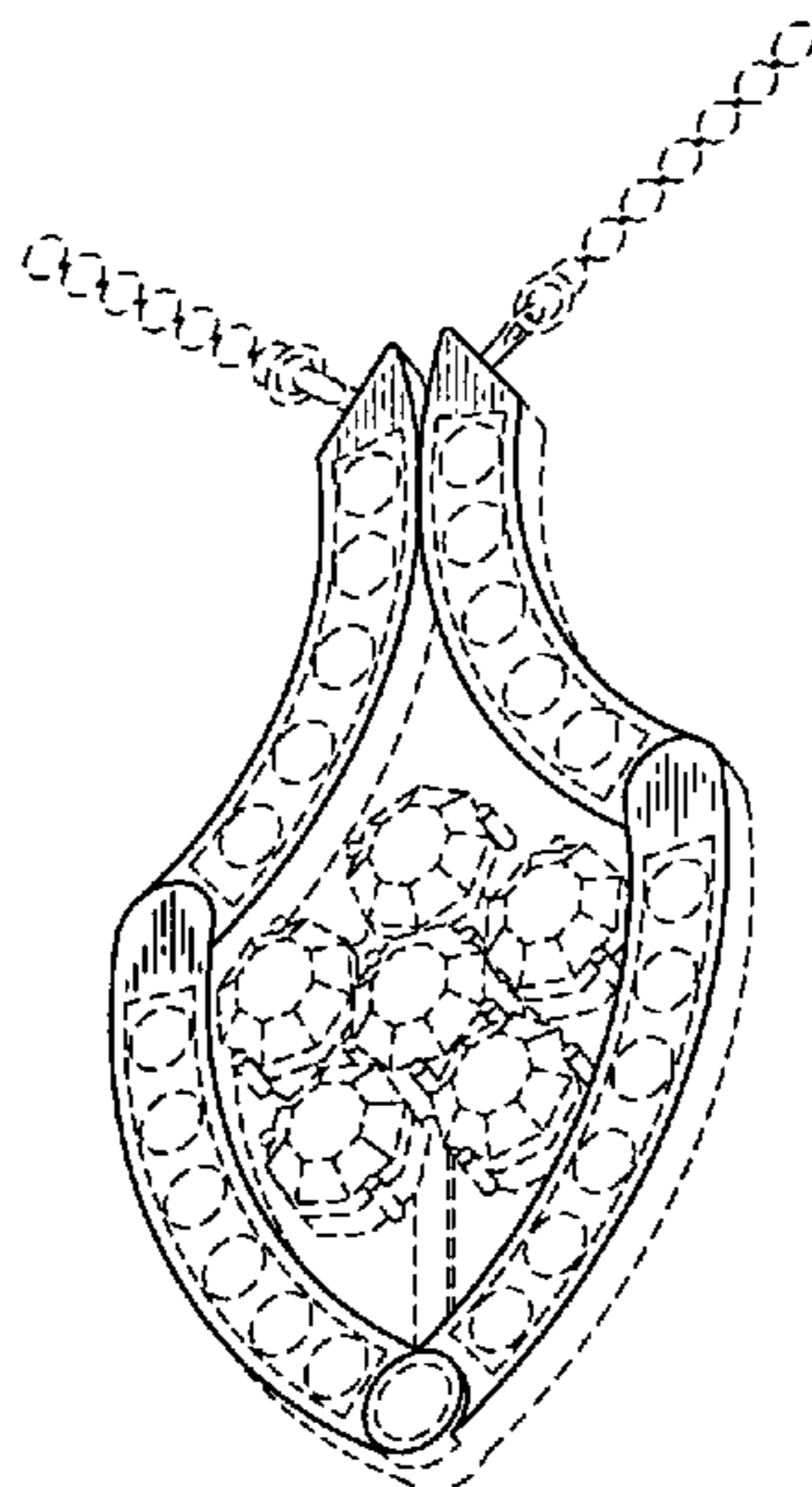
DESCRIPTION

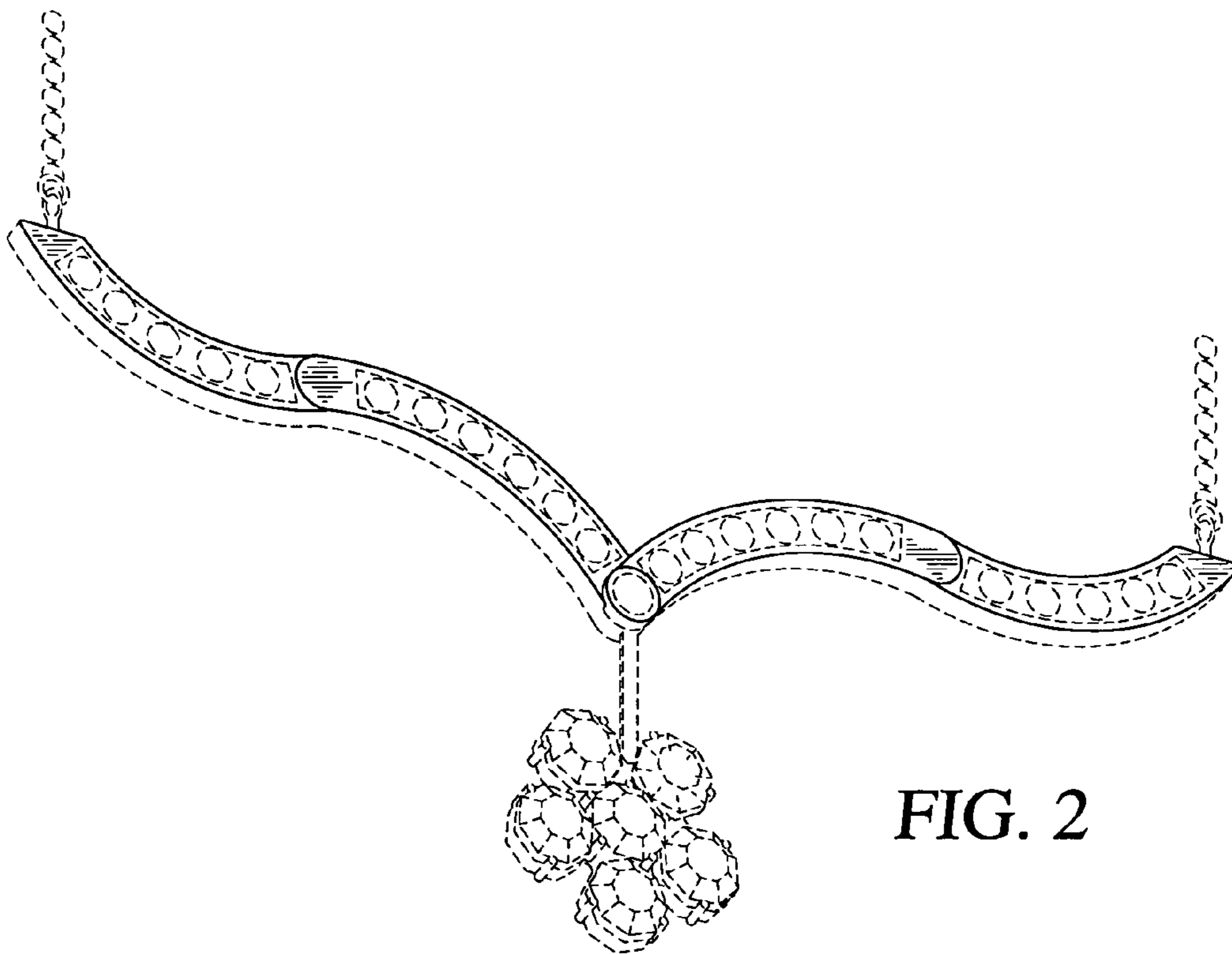
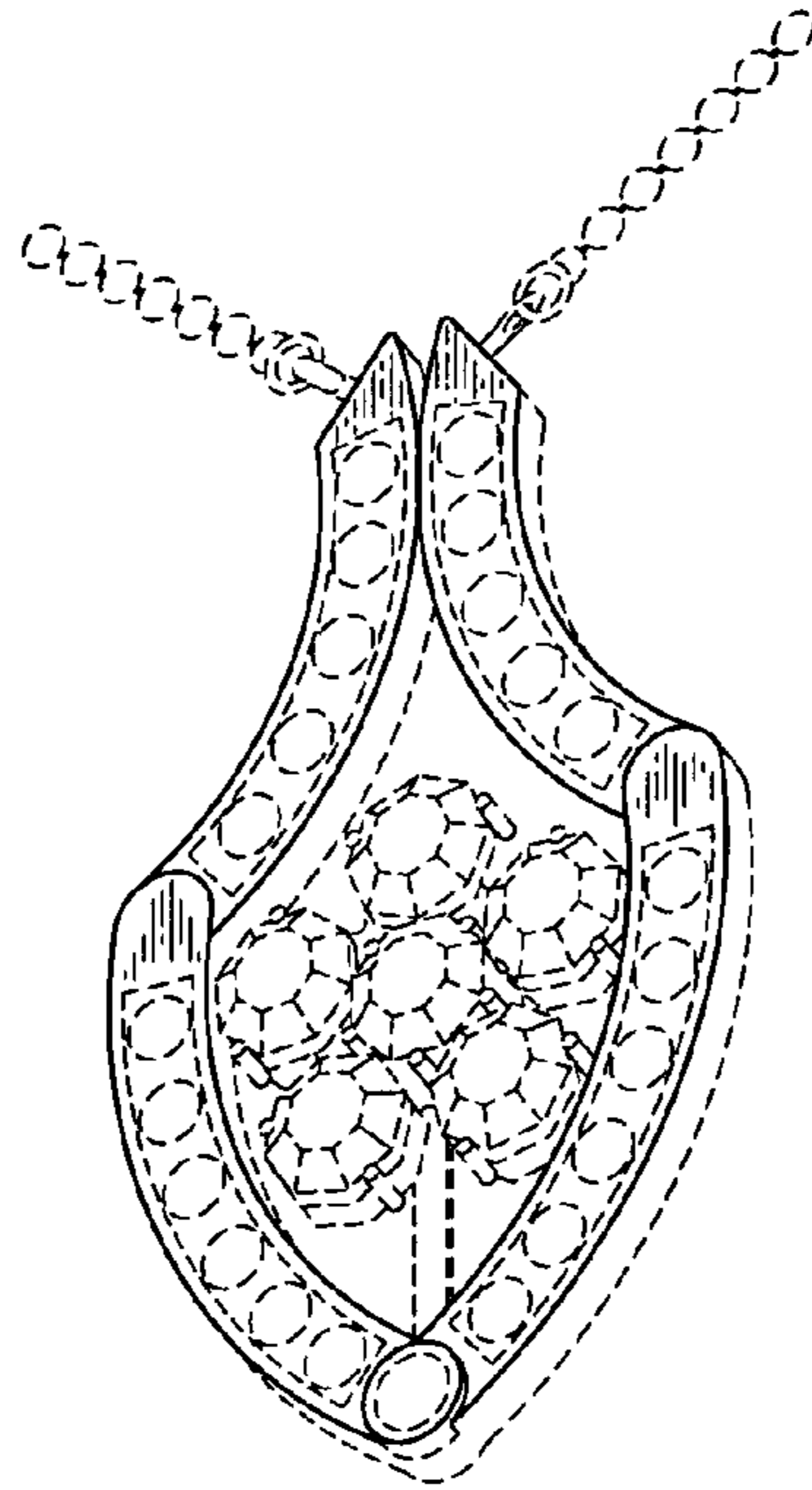
