DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe upper in accordance with my new design.

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof; and,

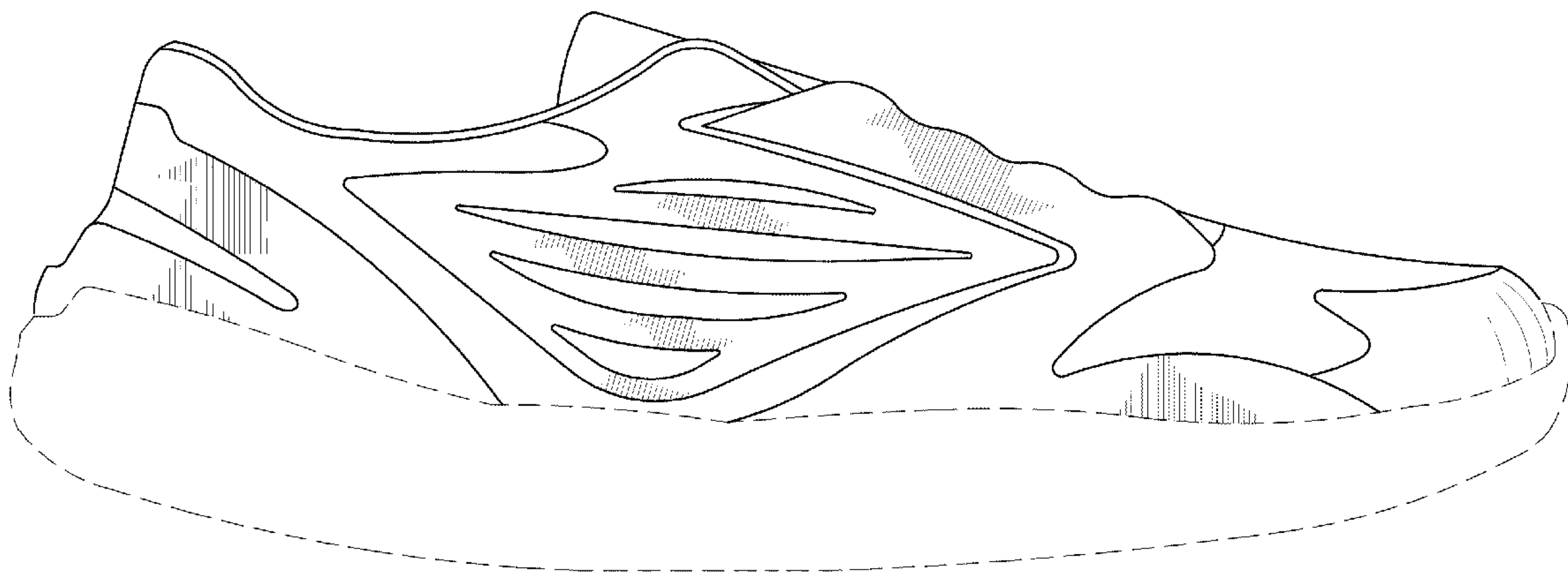

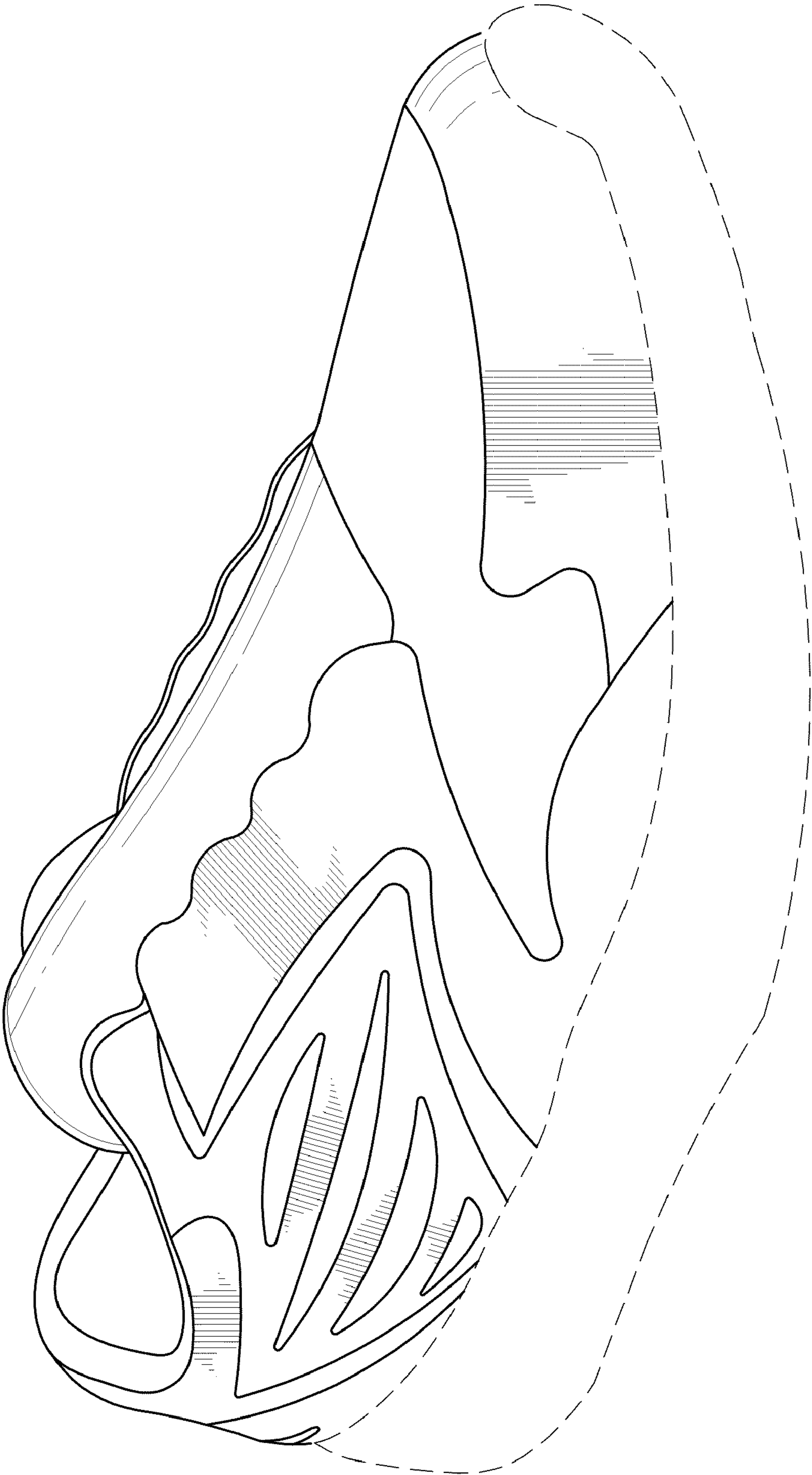

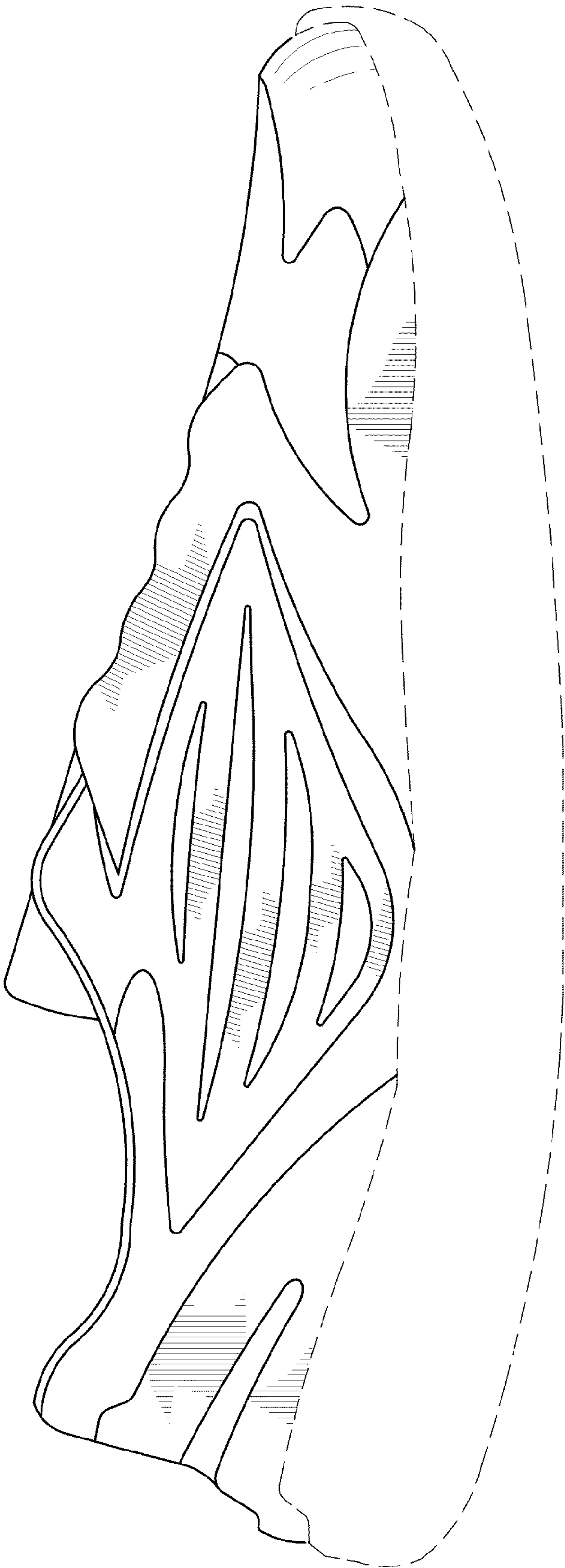
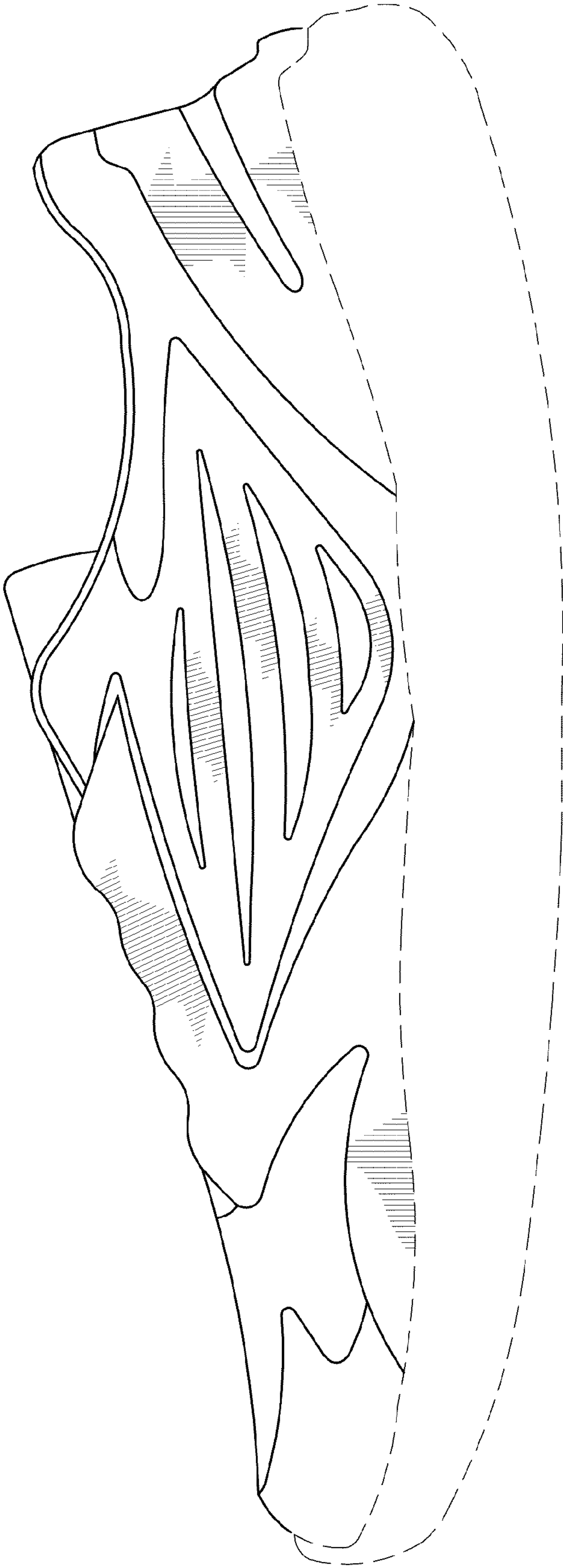

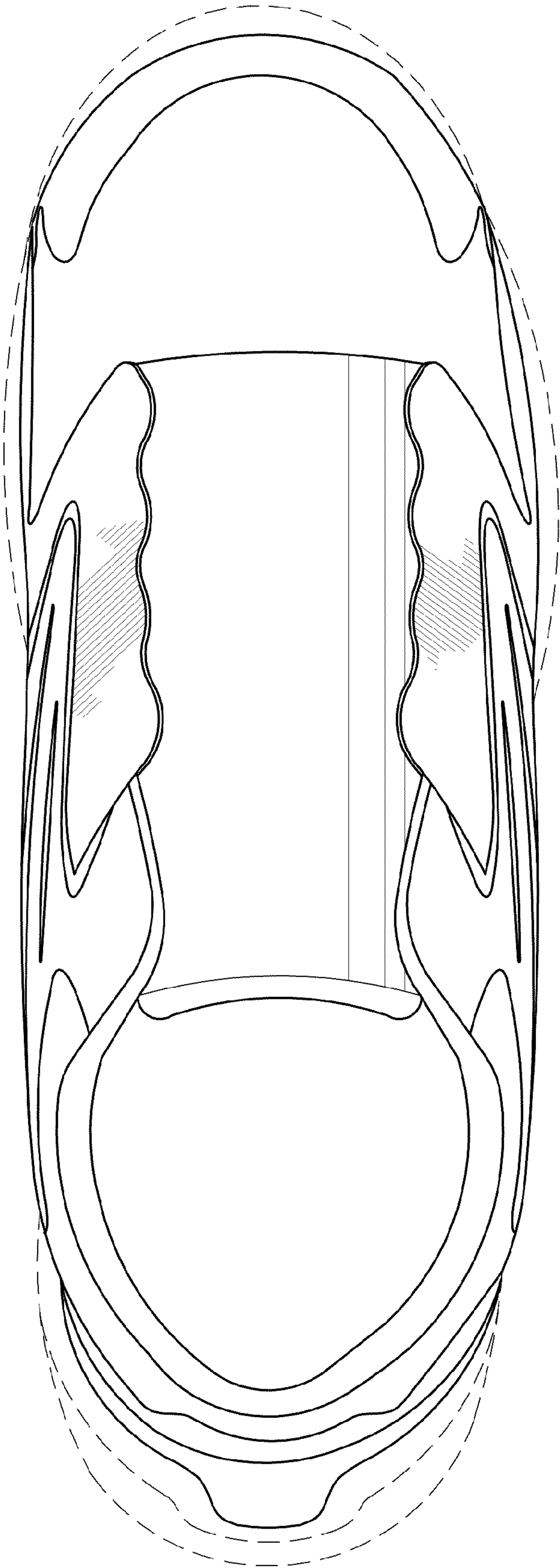

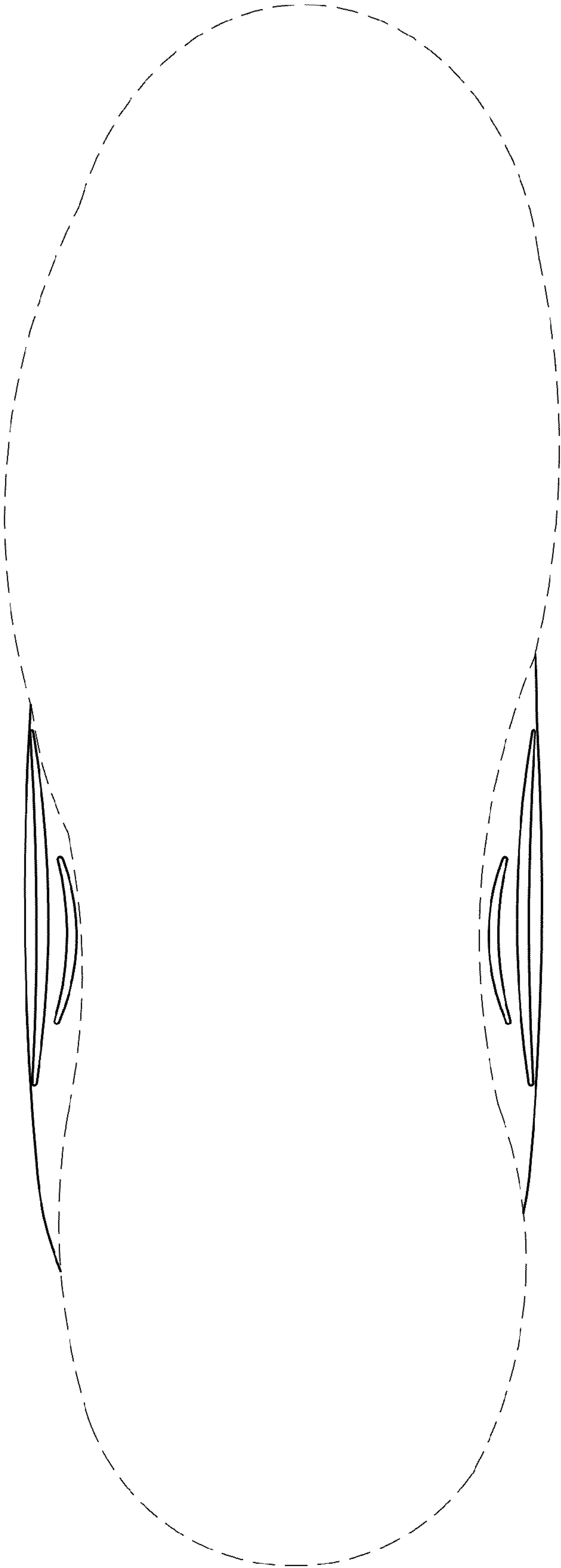

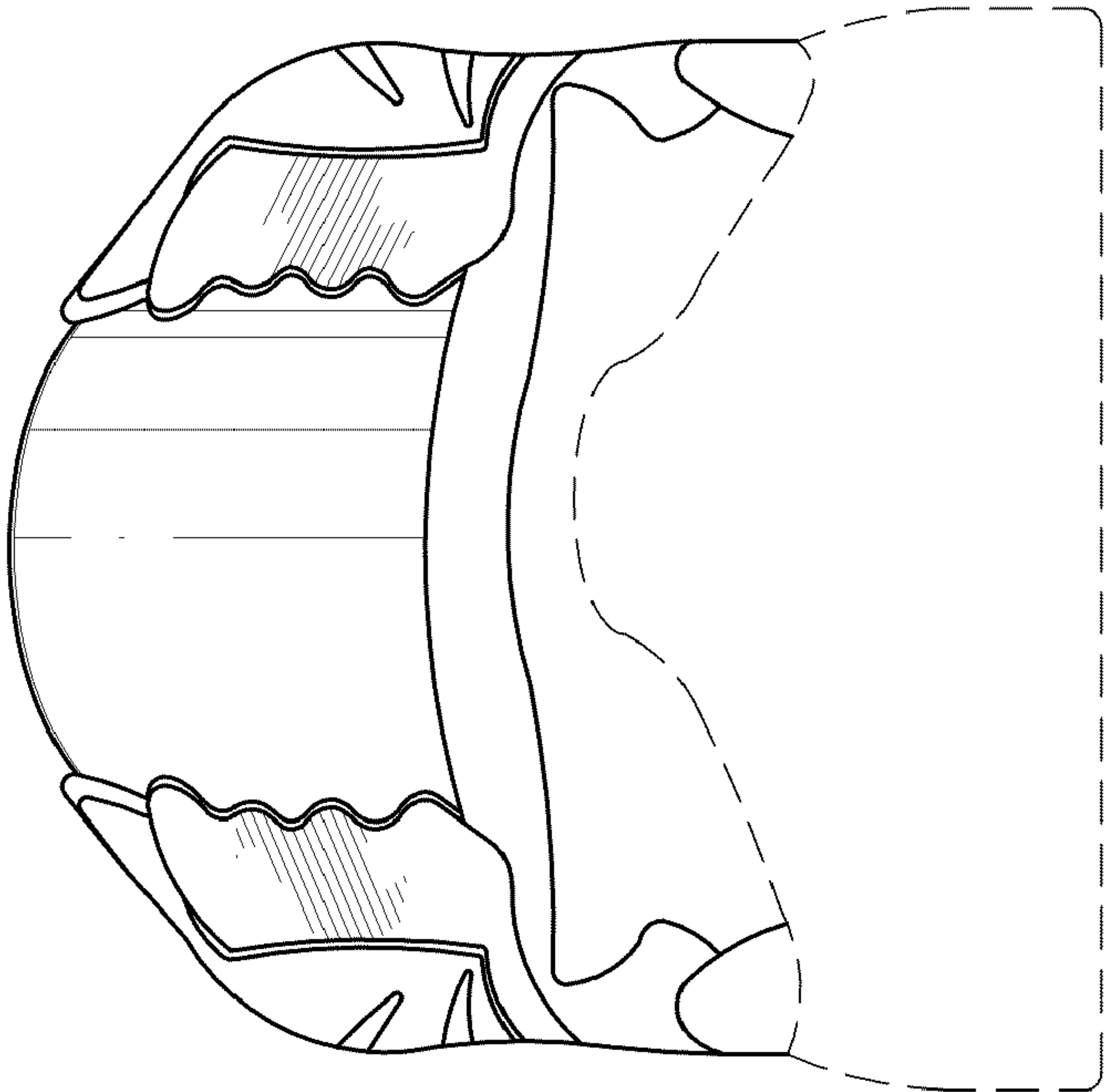
