(57) **CLAIM**

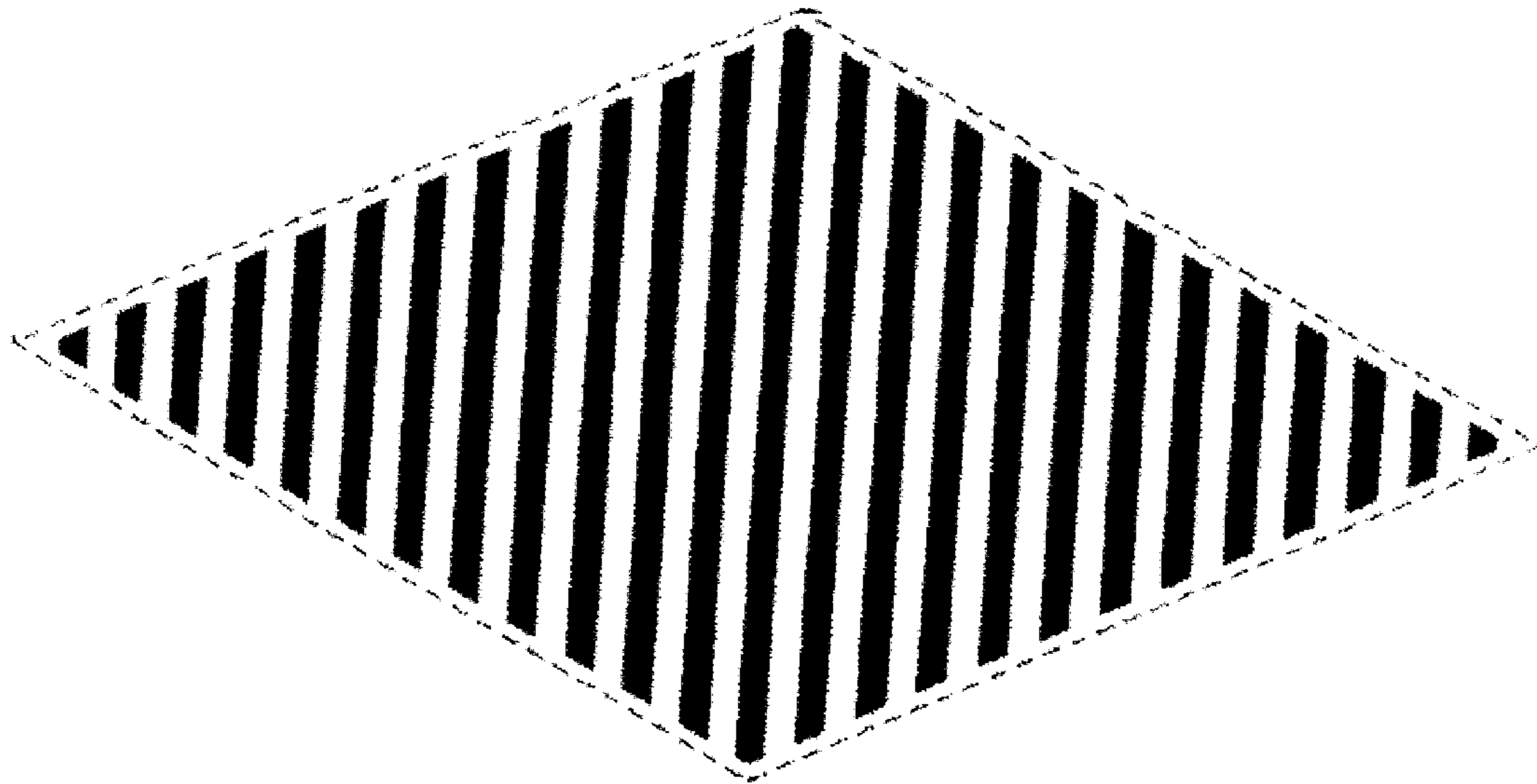
The ornamental design for a nonwoven web product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

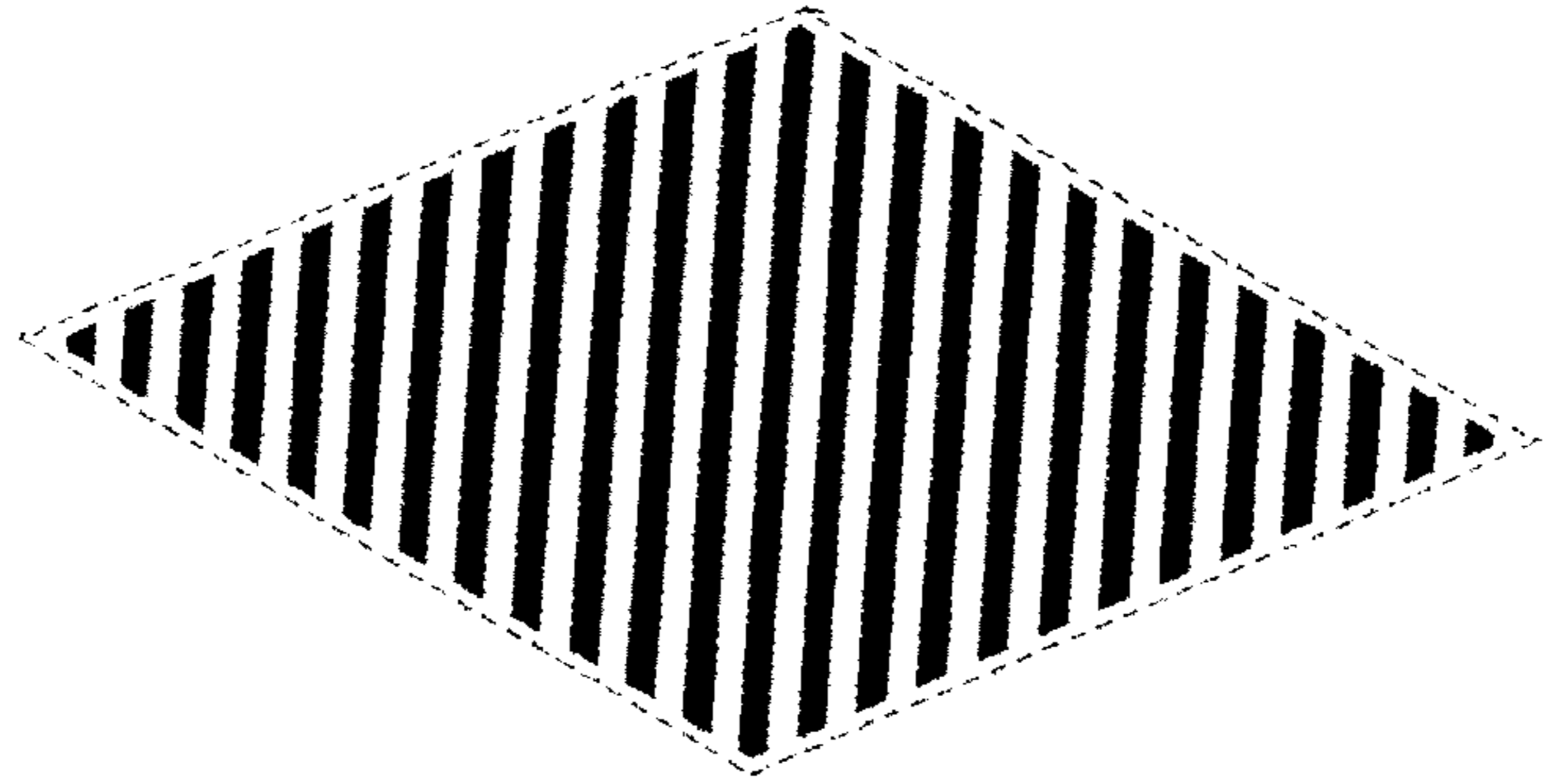

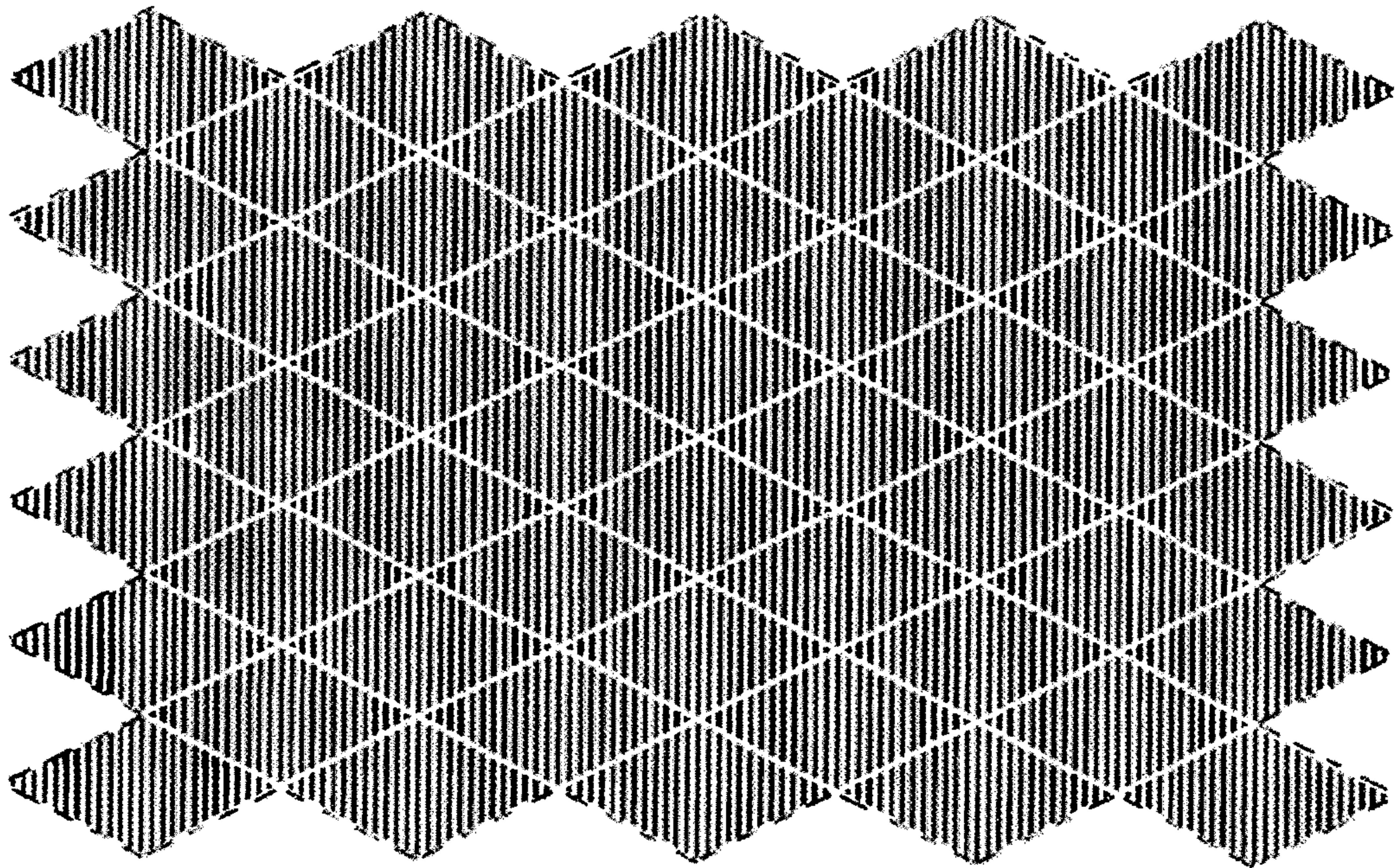
