FIG. 2 is a front plan view thereof, the rear plan view being the same in appearance;

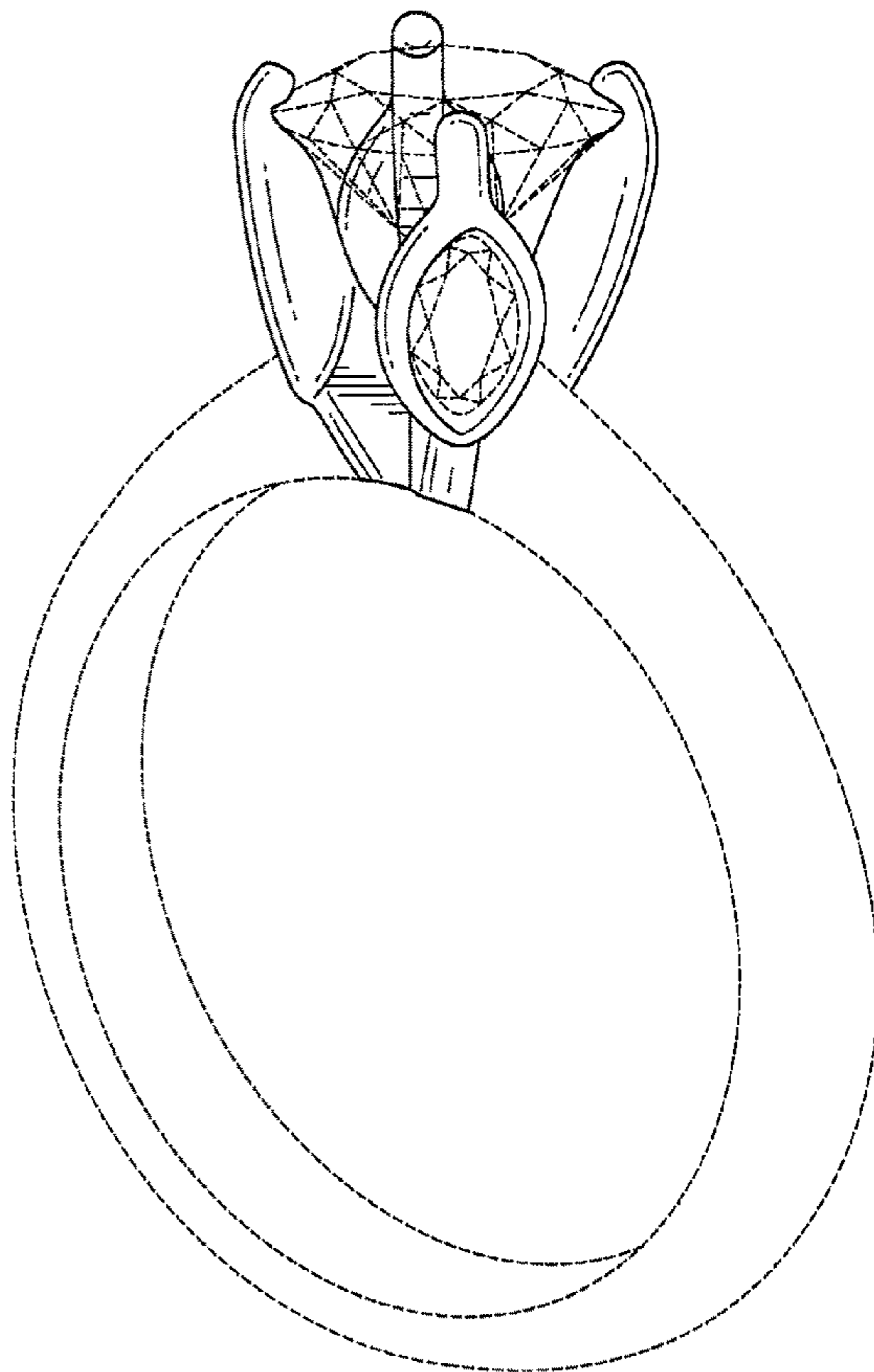
FIG. 3 is a side view thereof, the opposite side view being the same in appearance;

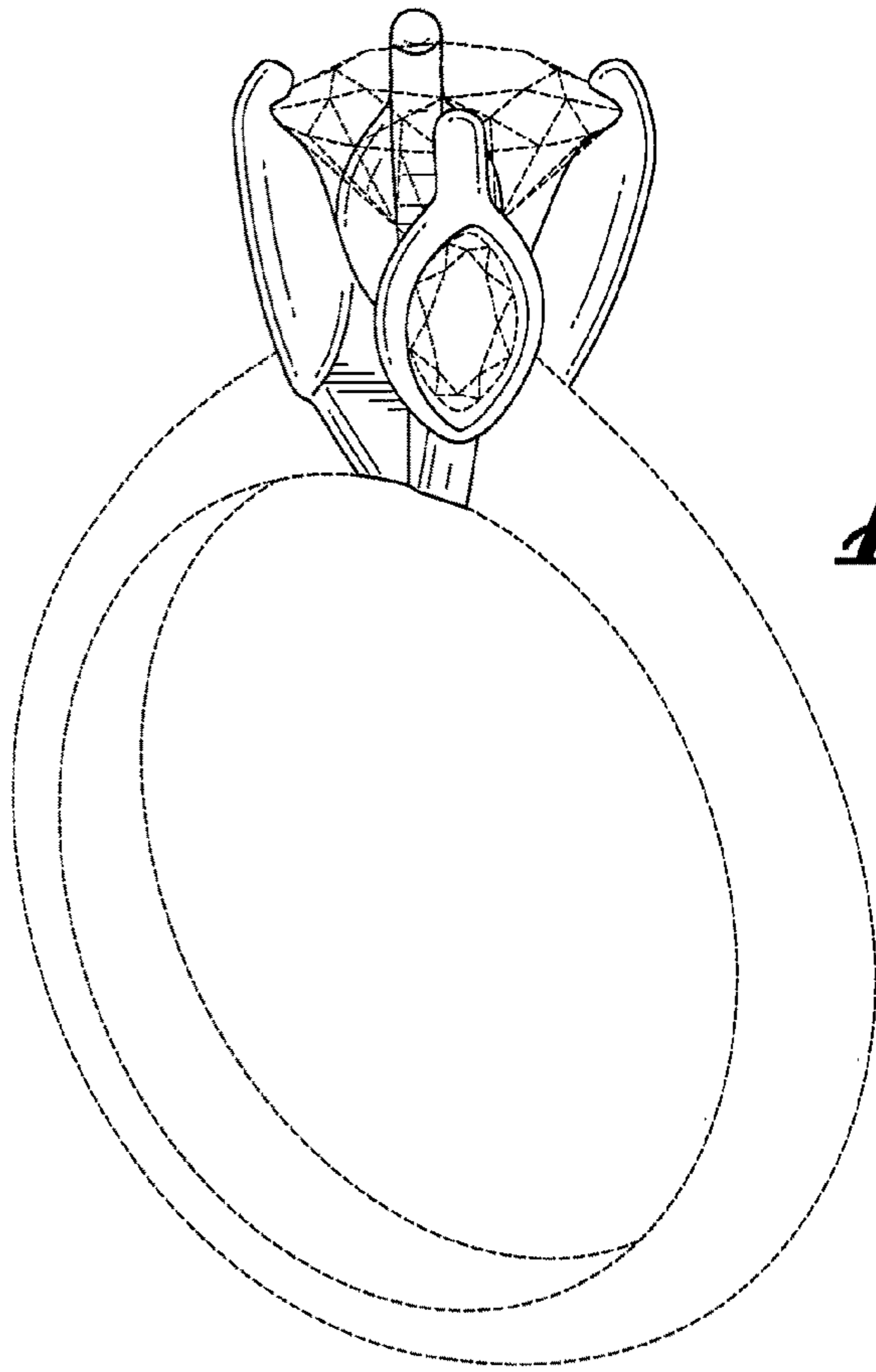

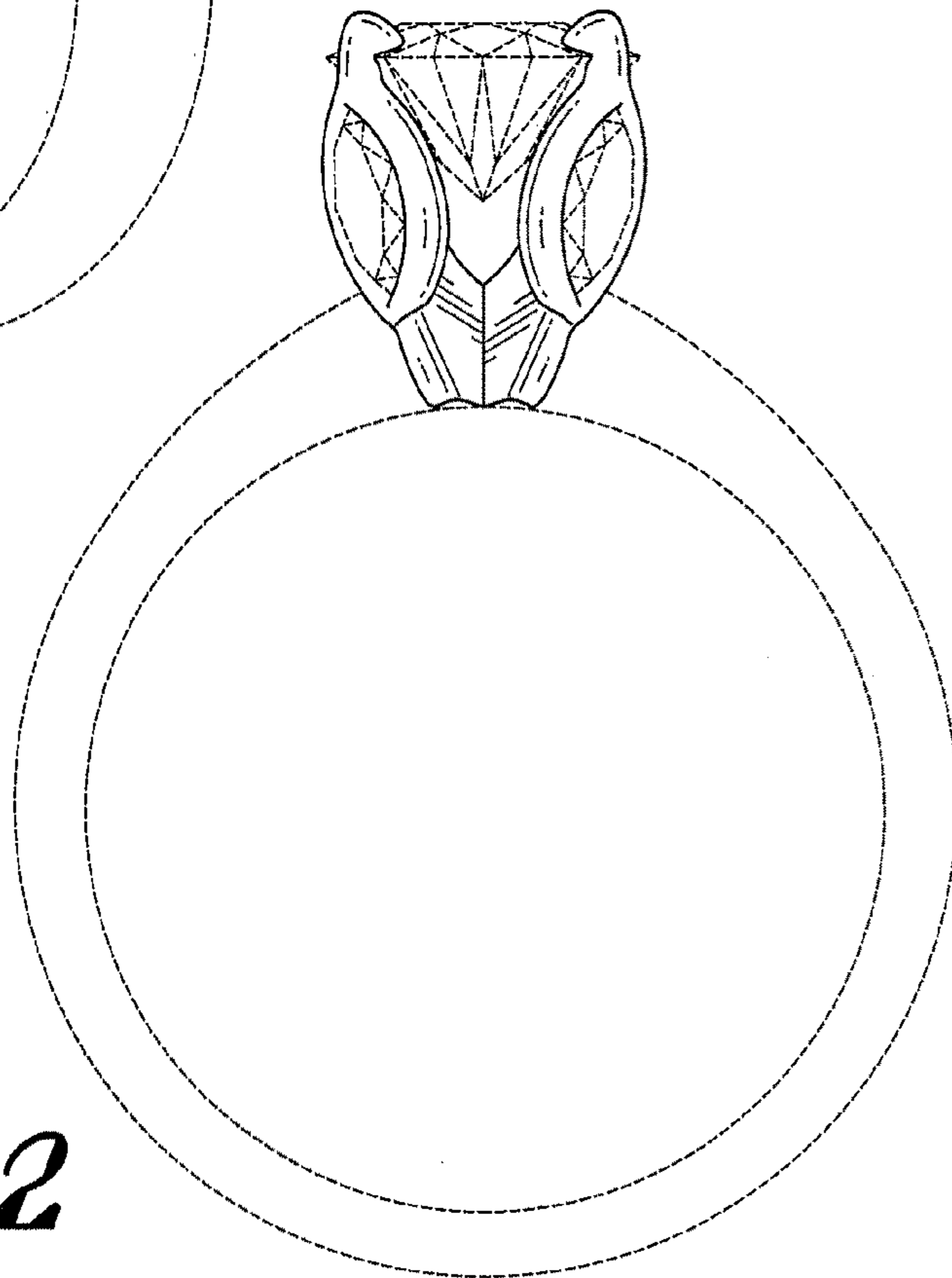

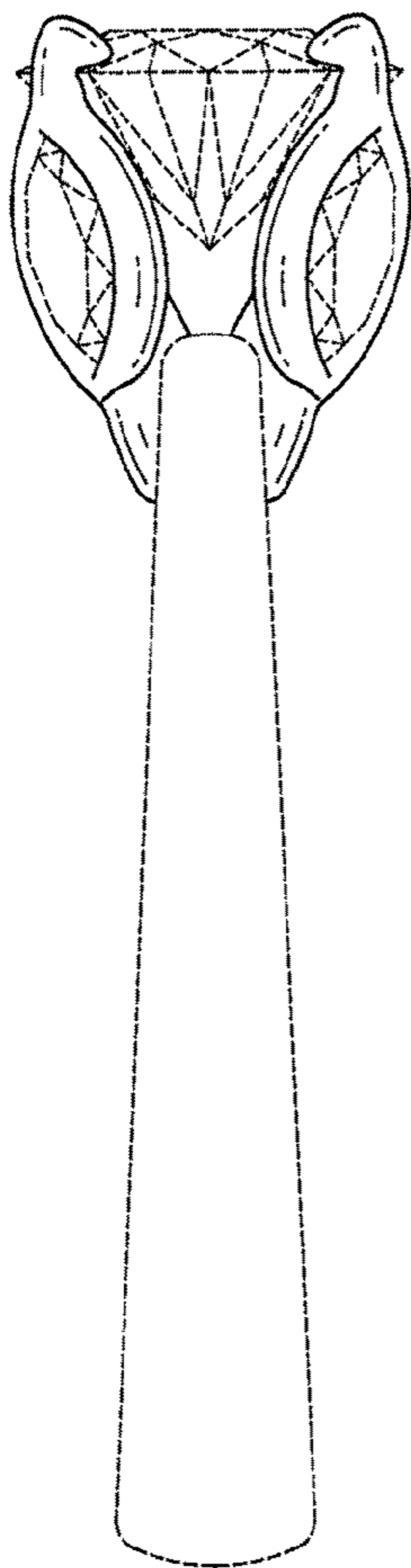

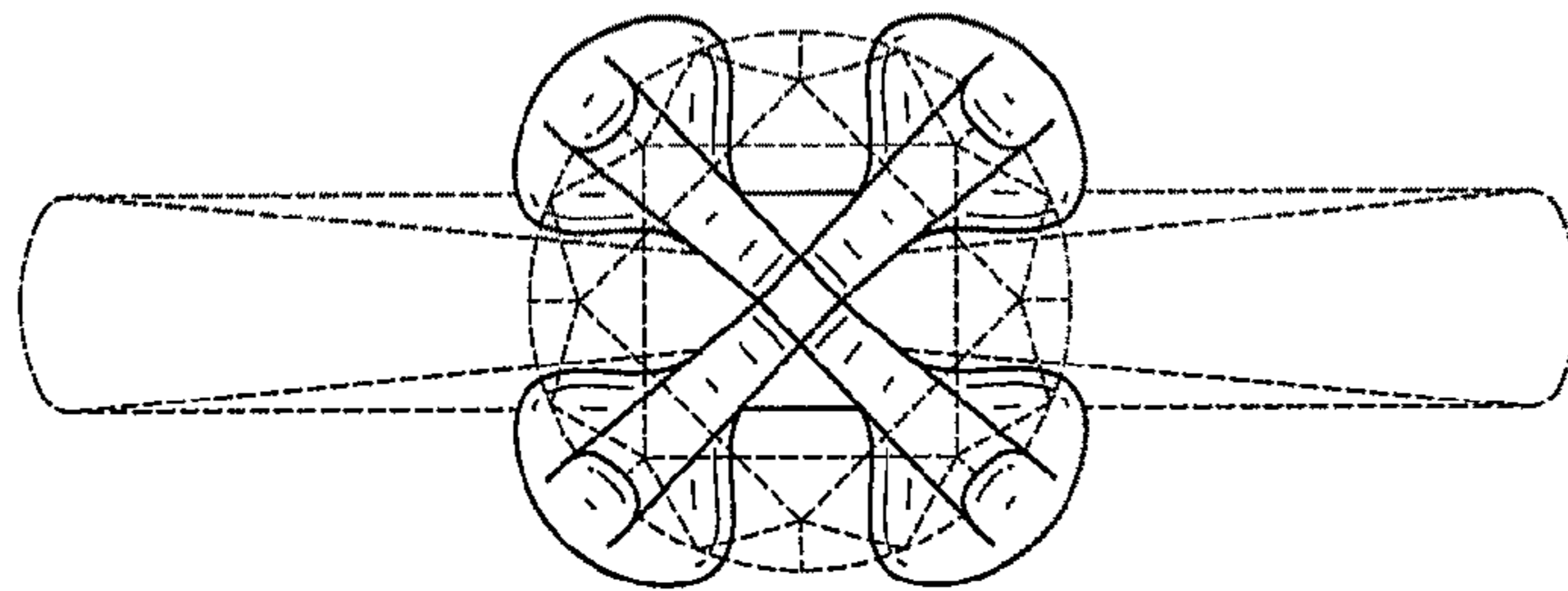

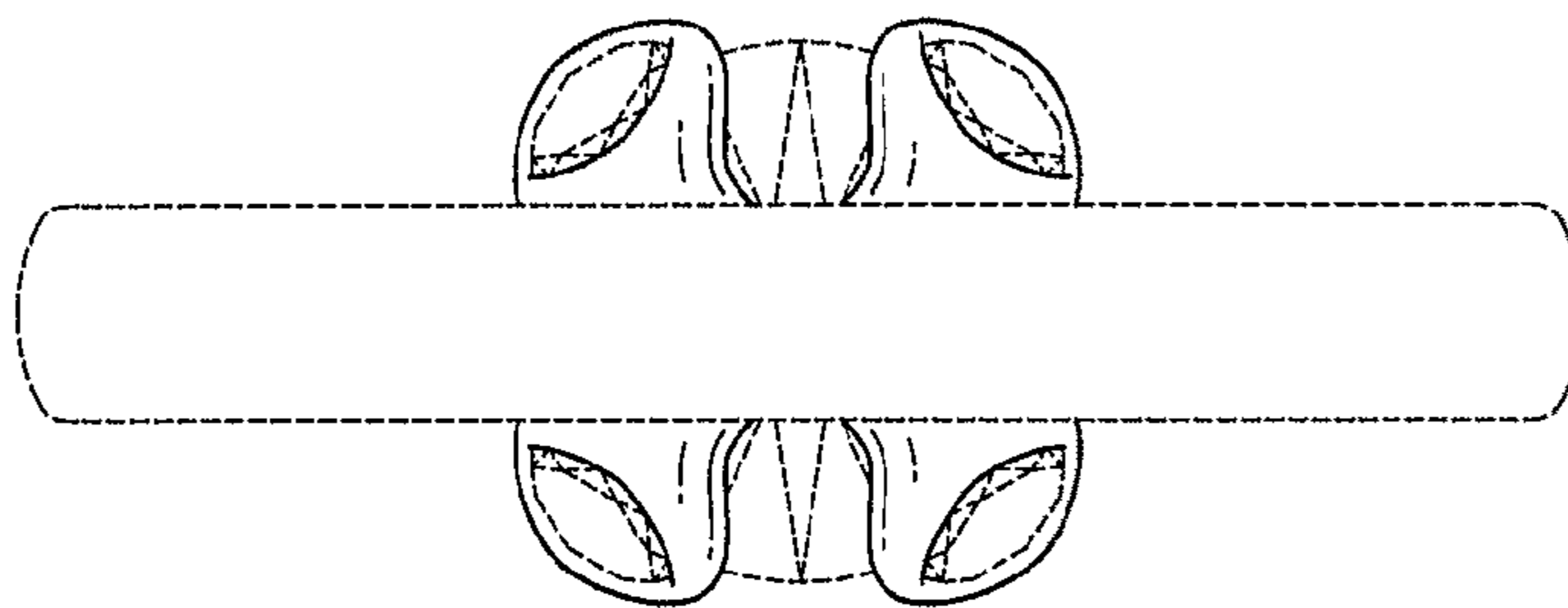
