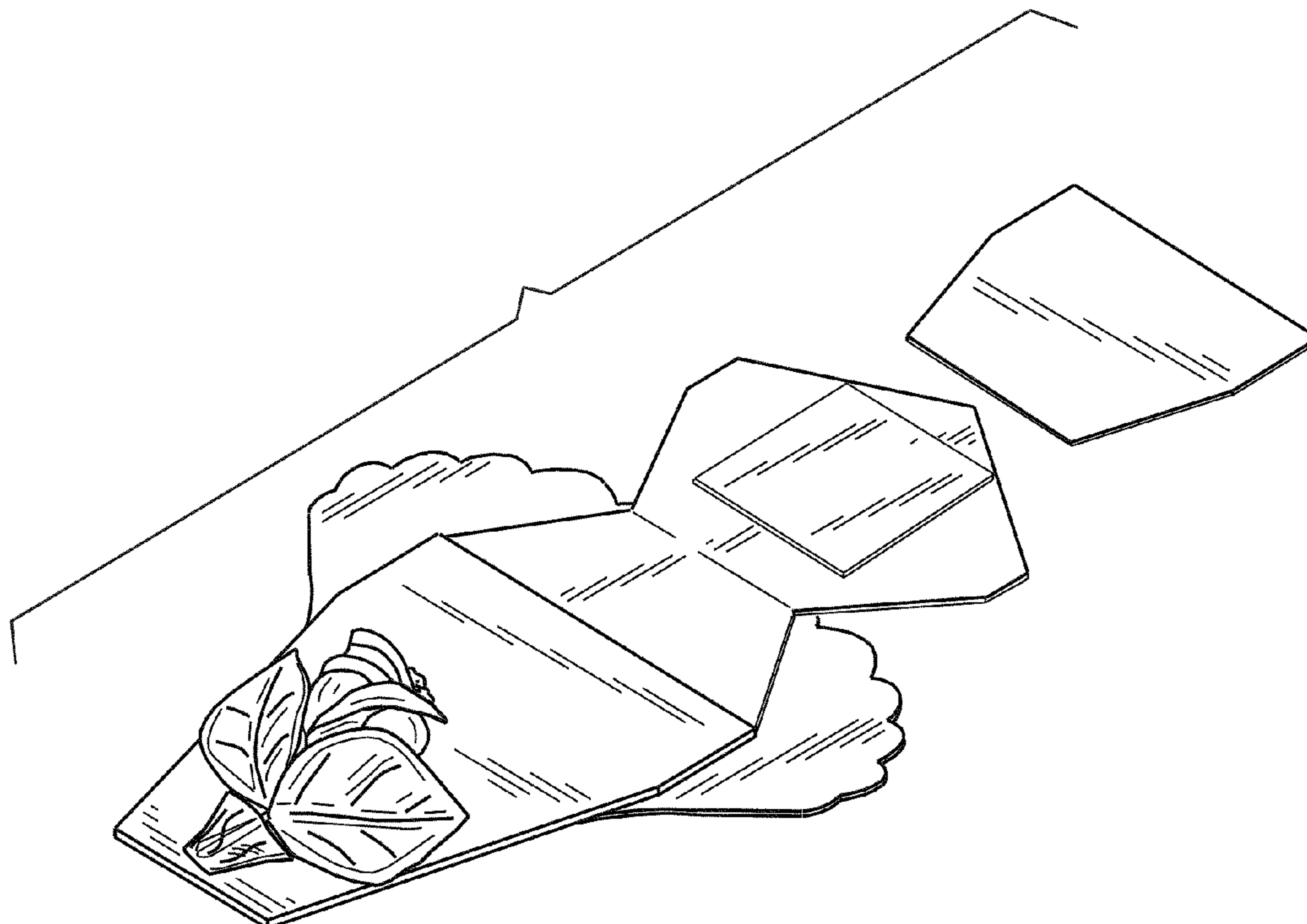
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a greeting card envelope, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a greeting card envelope, showing my new design in a closed position;
FIG. 2 is an exploded perspective view thereof, illustrated in an open position and further showing an internal greeting card thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken lines showing a photo in FIGS. 1 and 3 depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design.

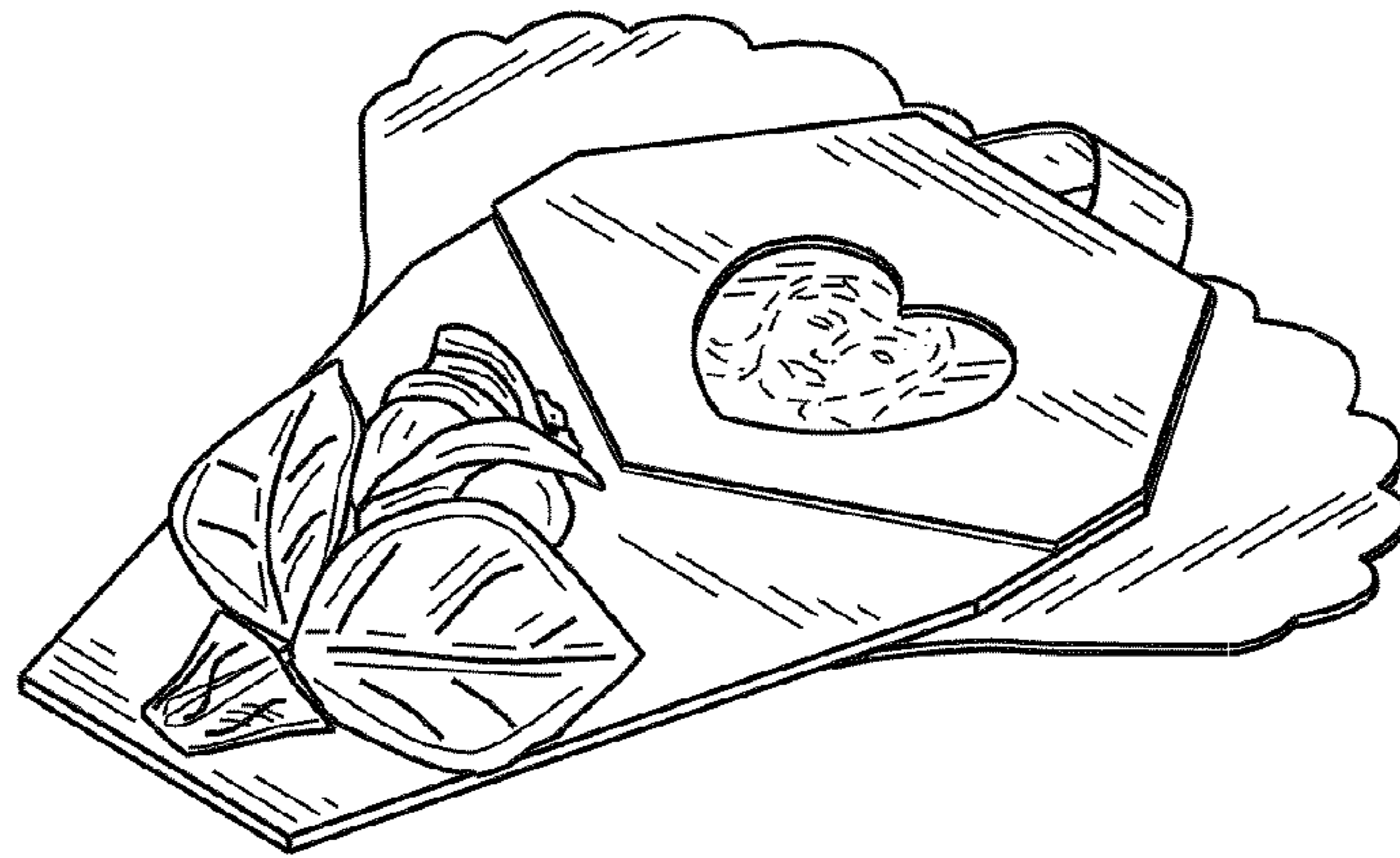

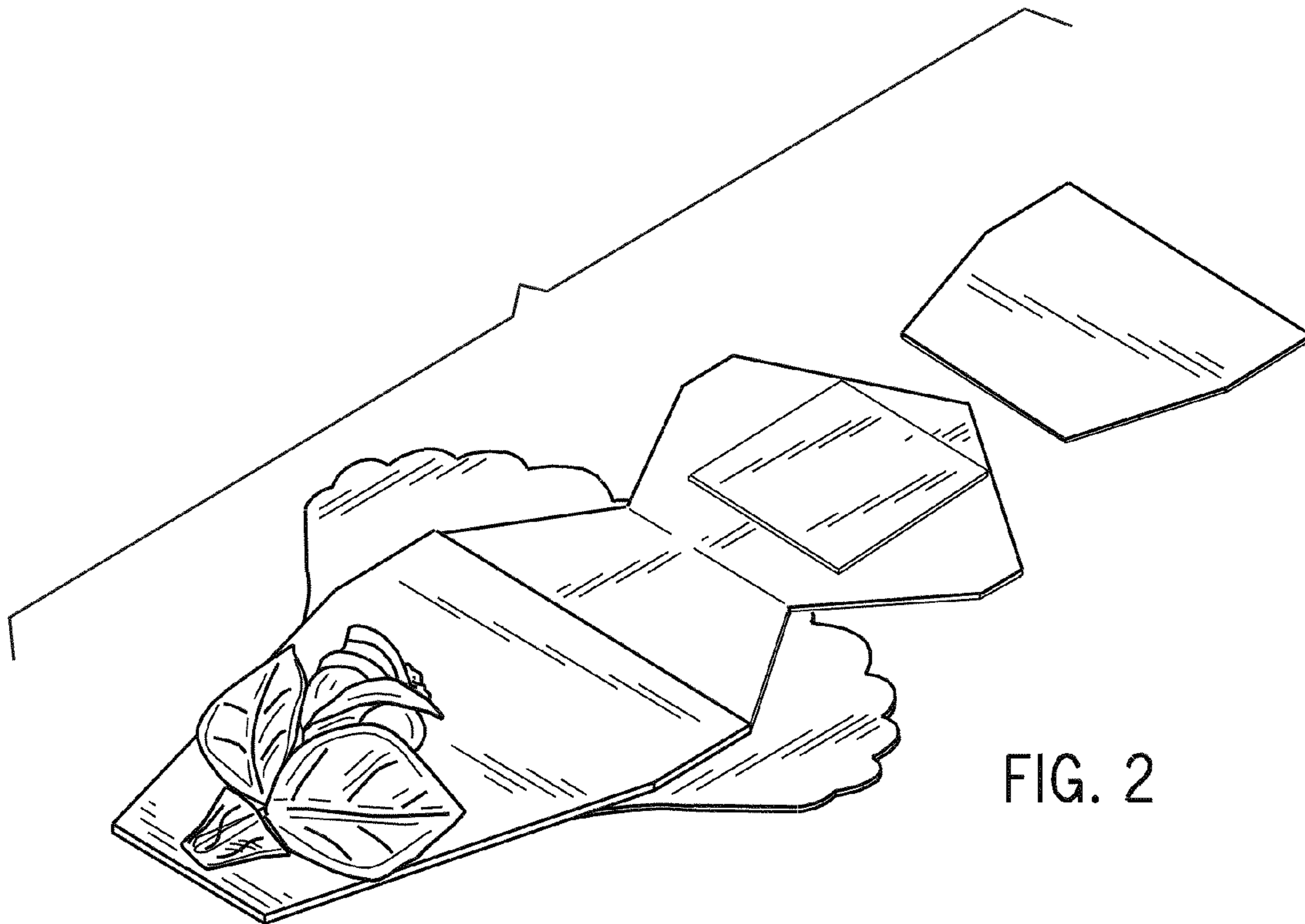
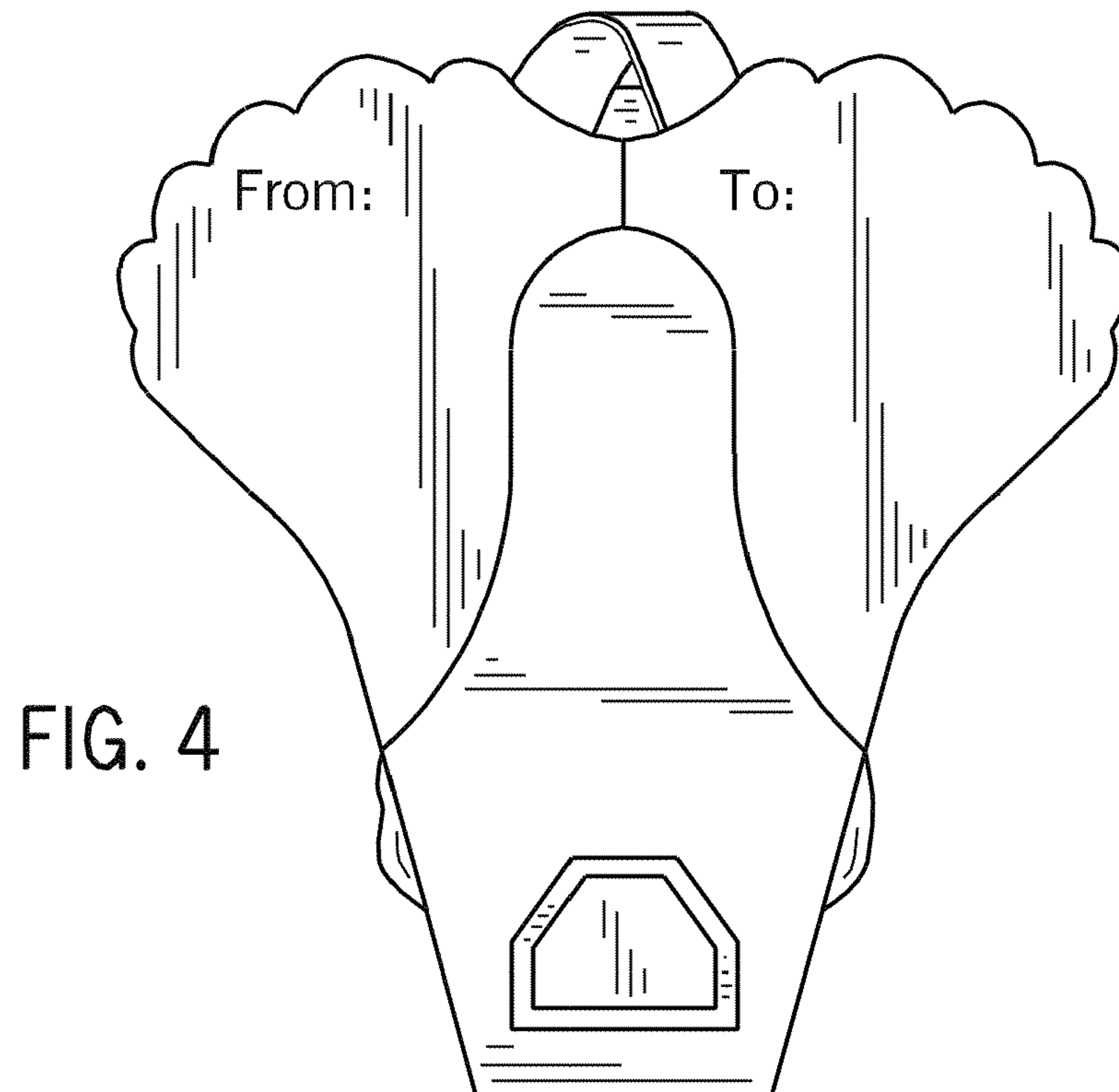
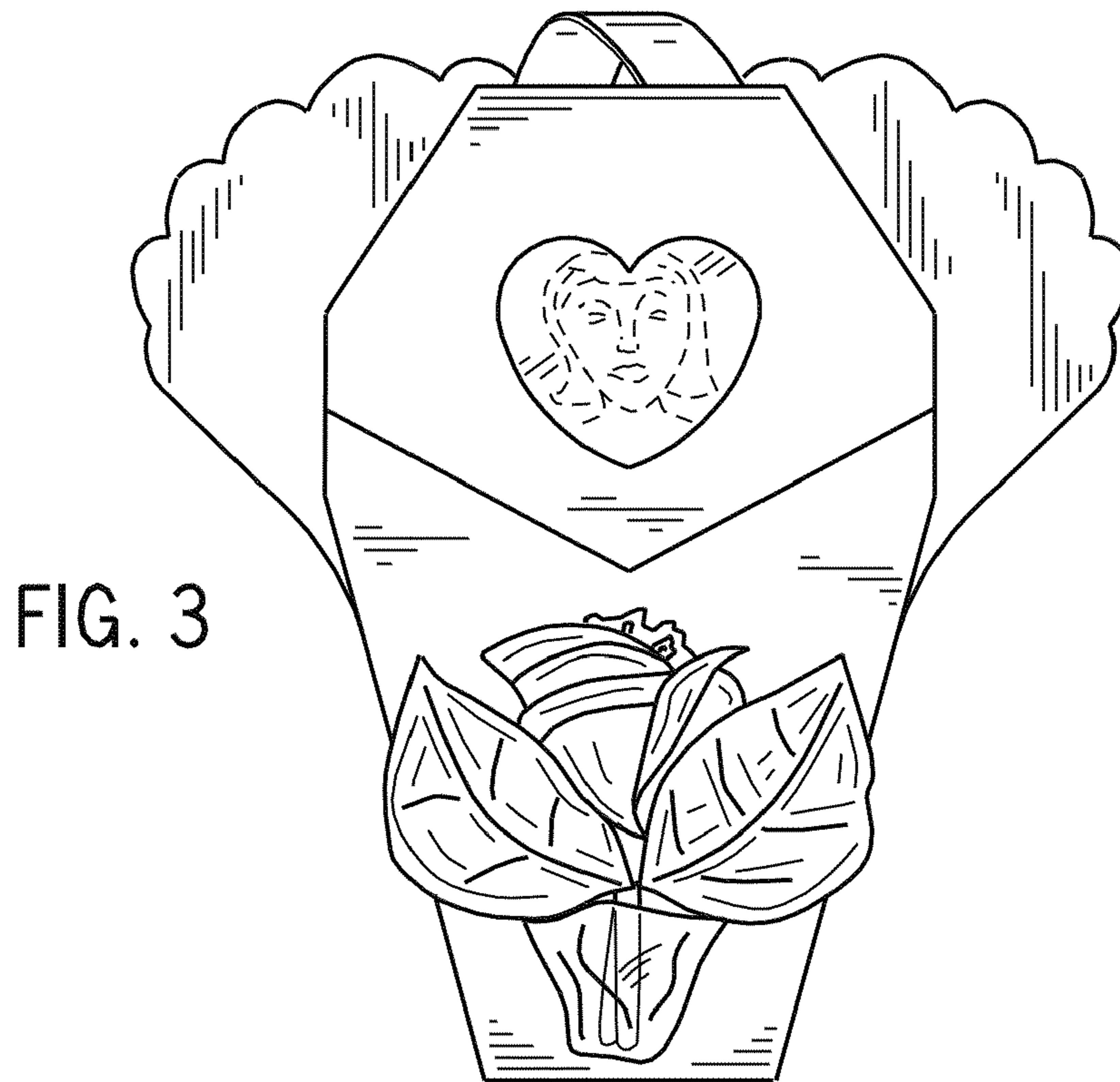

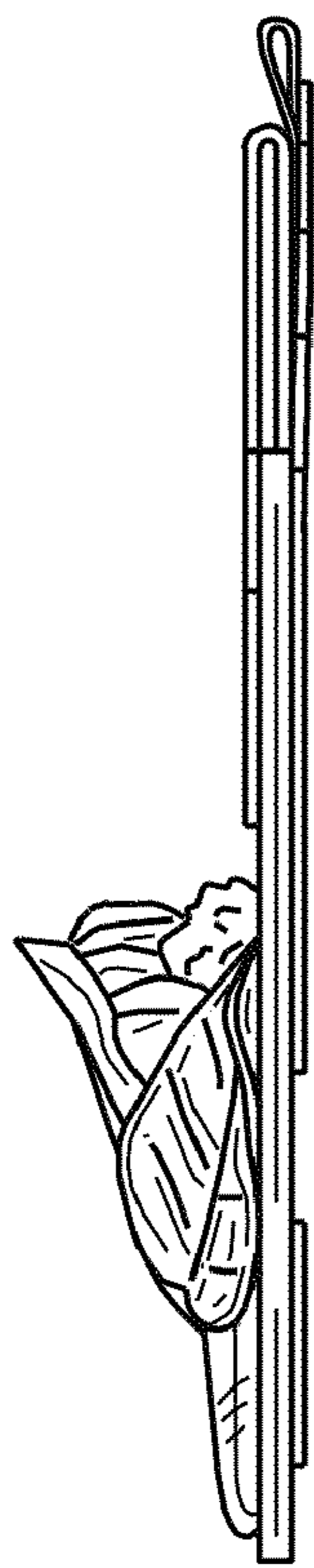

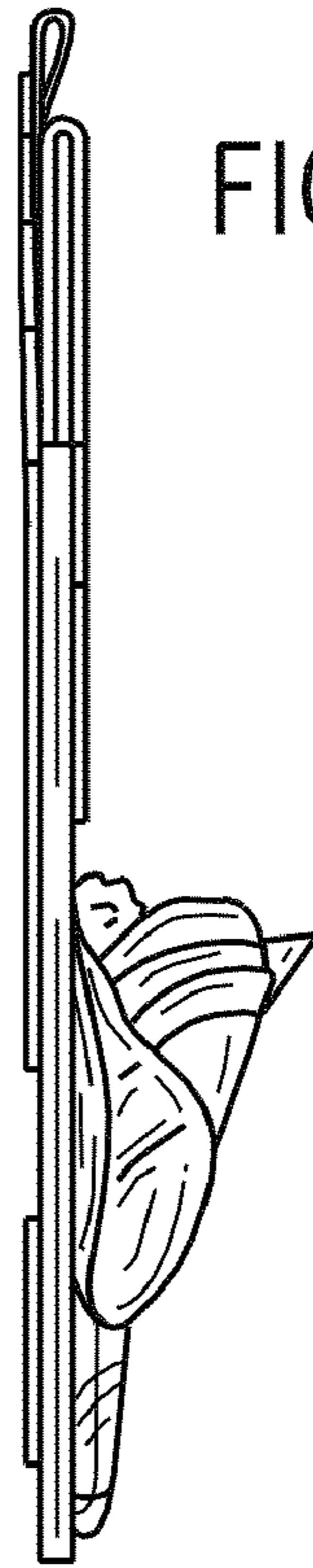

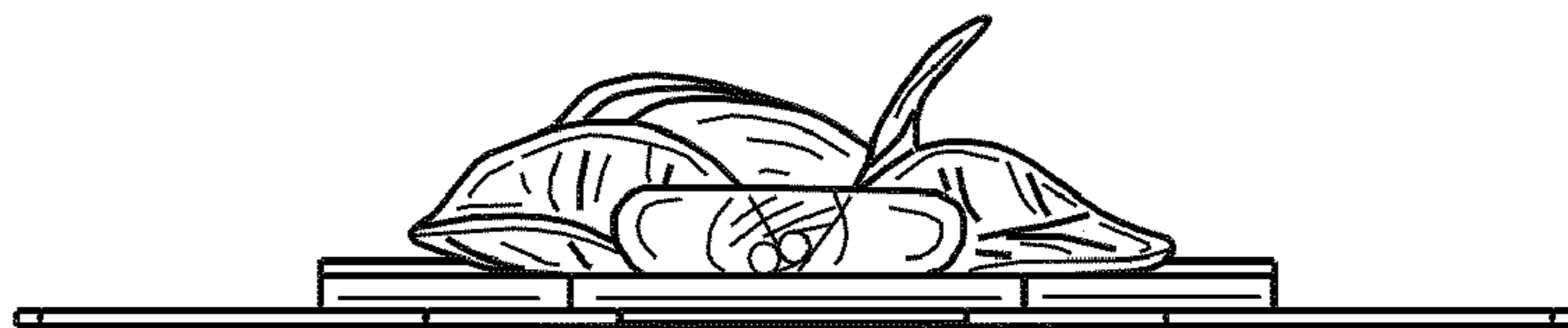
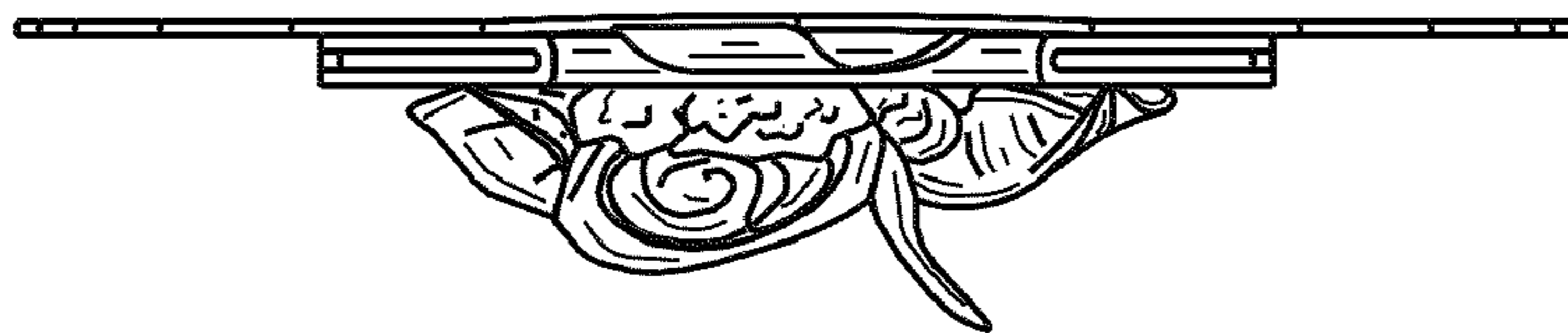
