(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wristband with adjacent labels, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first embodiment of a top, front and left-side perspective view of a wristband with adjacent labels, embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top, front and left-side elevational view of the wristband shown in FIG. 1, with the adjacent labels removed;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view showing the wristband of FIG. 7 in a normally worn configuration;

FIG. 10 is a Second embodiment of a top, front and left-side perspective view of a wristband with adjacent labels, embodying my new design;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 14 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a side elevational view thereof;

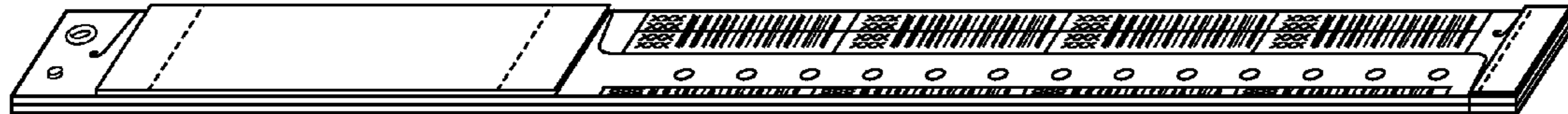
FIG. 16 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;

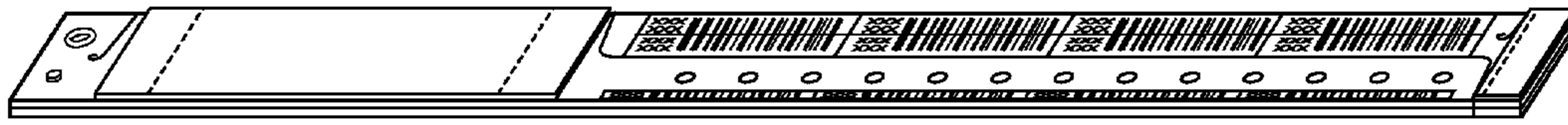

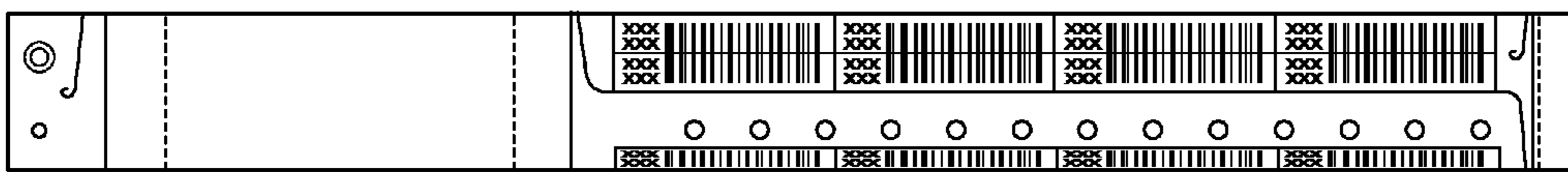

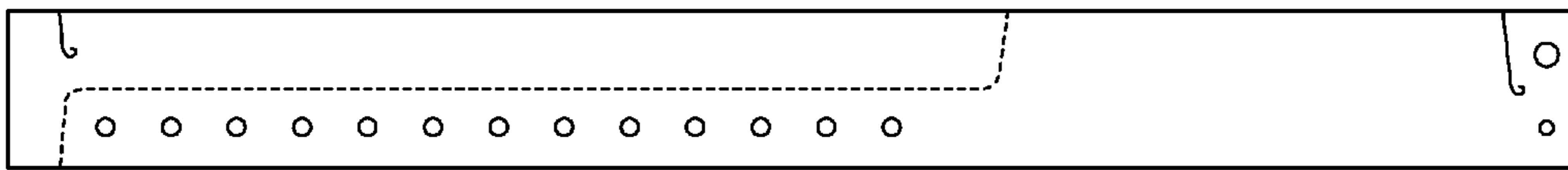

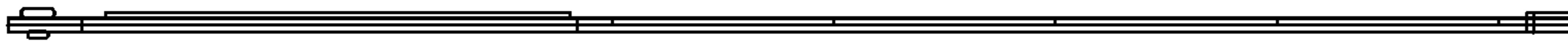

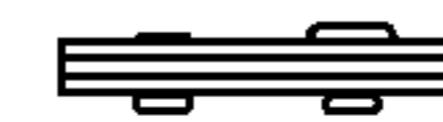

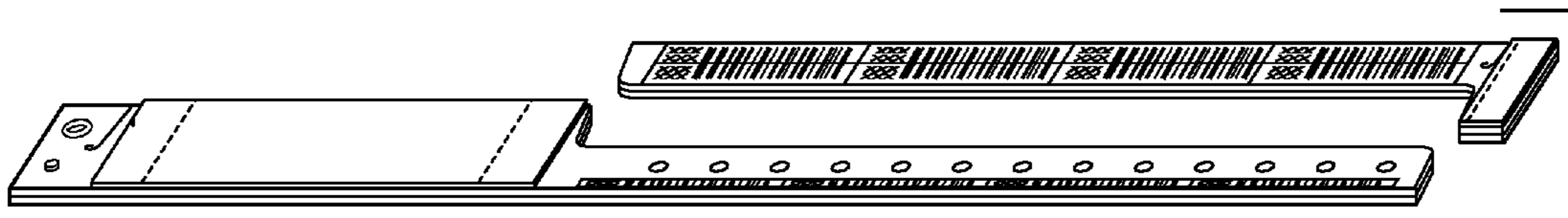

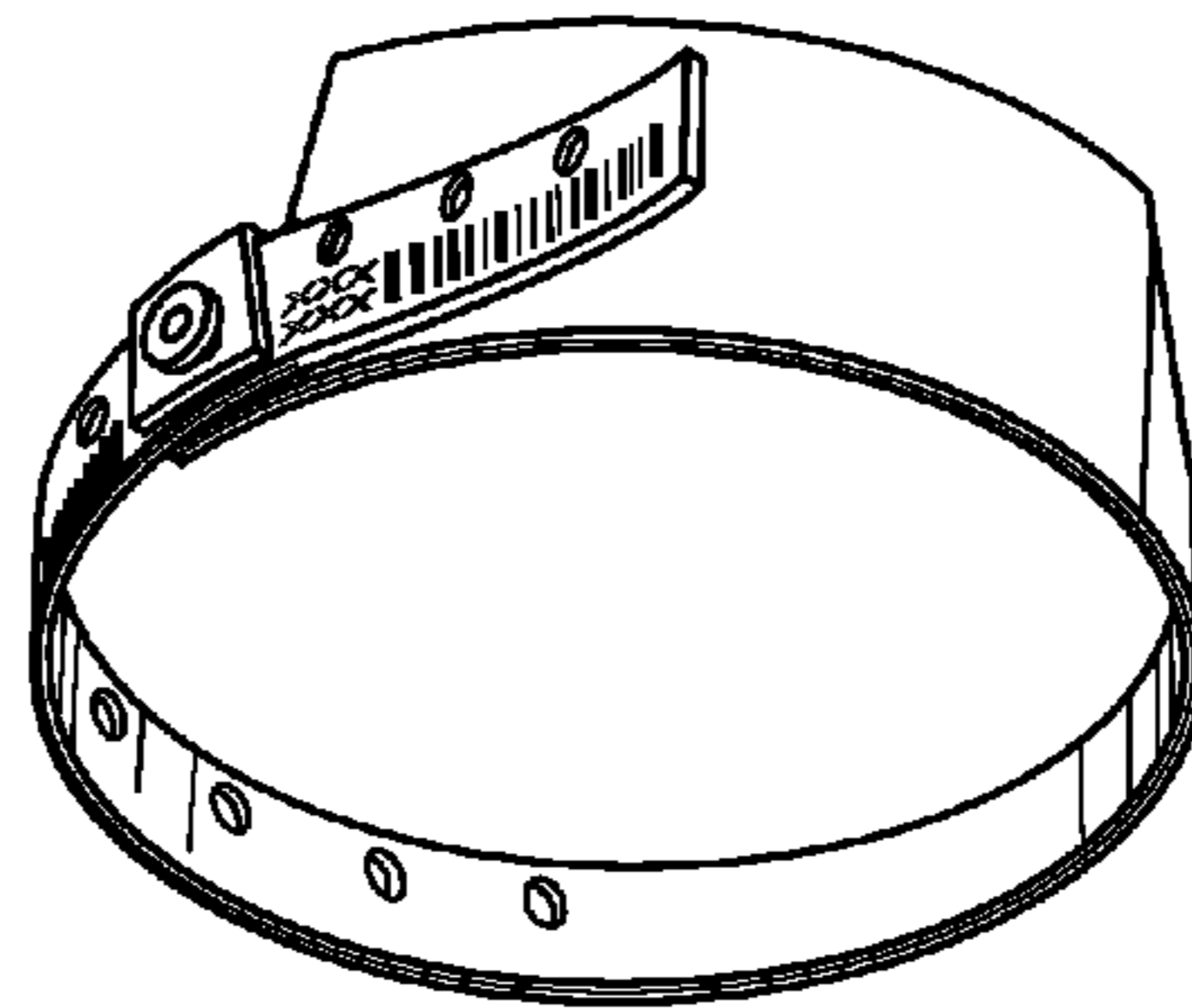

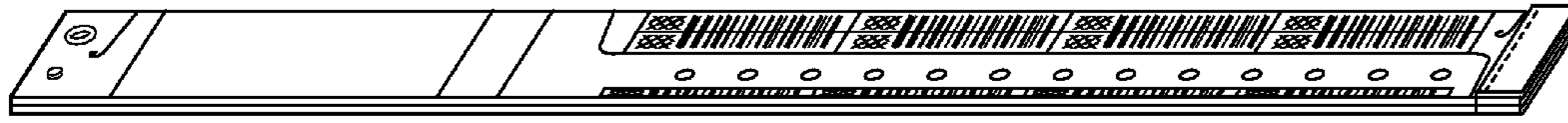

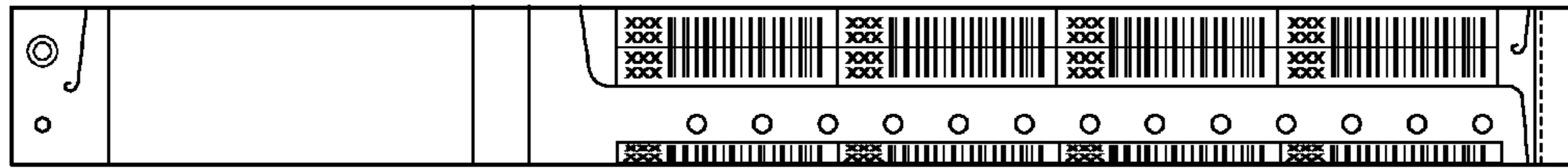

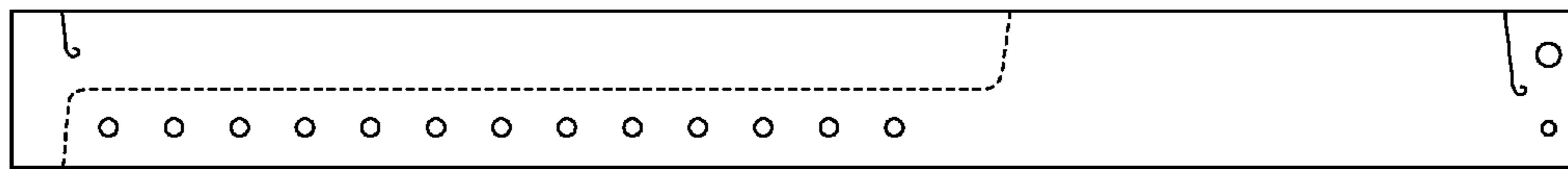

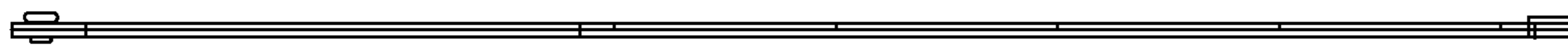

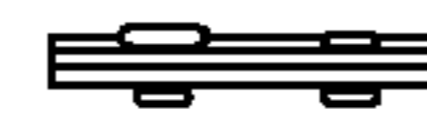

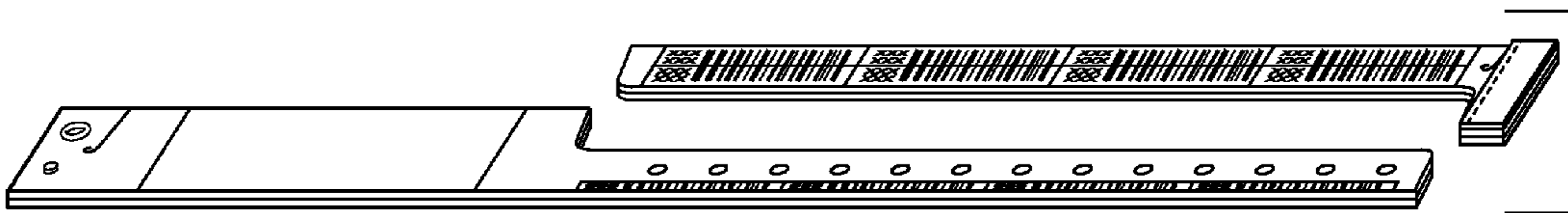

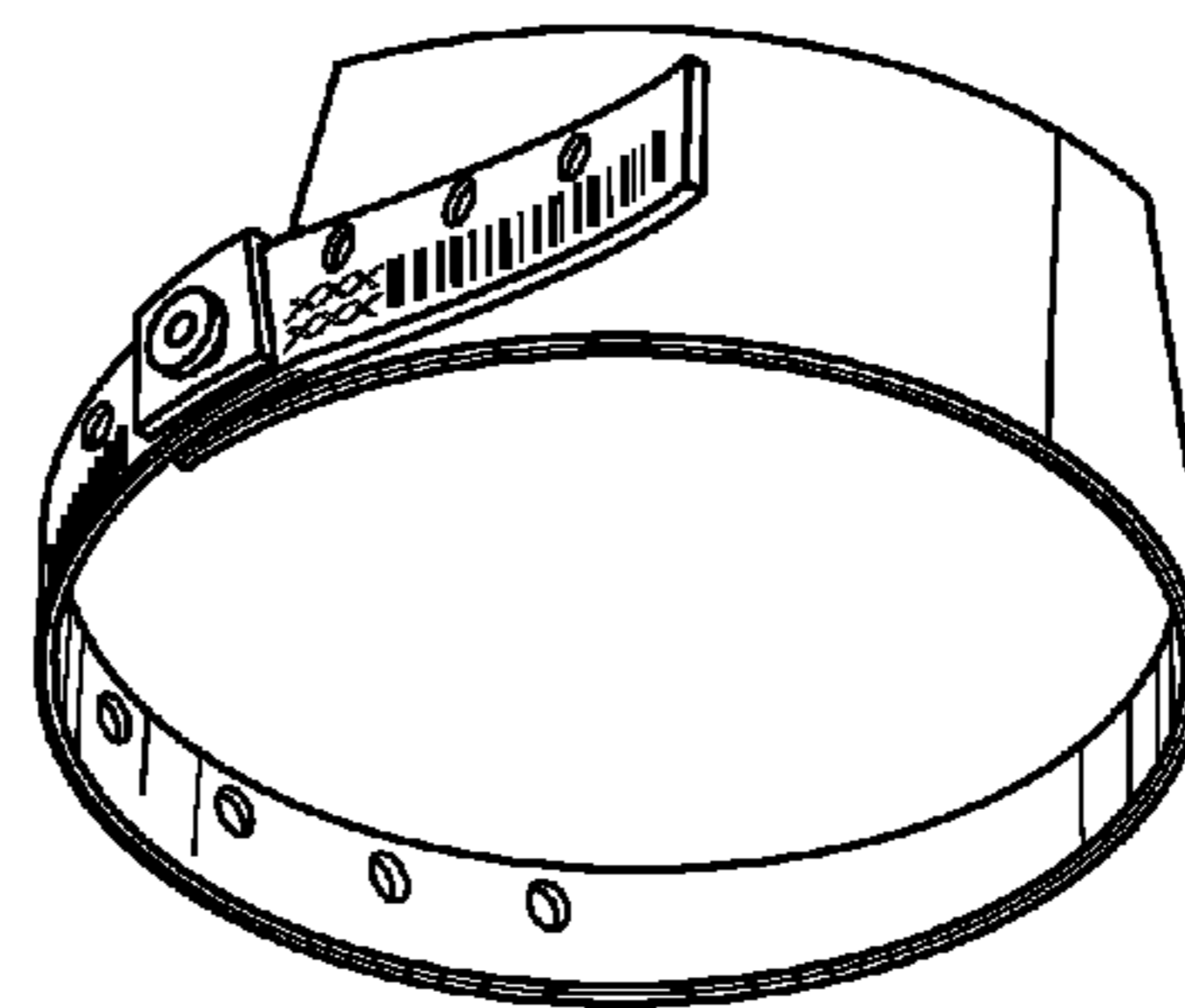
