(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a mirror glove, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a mirror glove according to the present design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the mirror glove of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the mirror glove of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the mirror glove of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the mirror glove of FIG. 1.

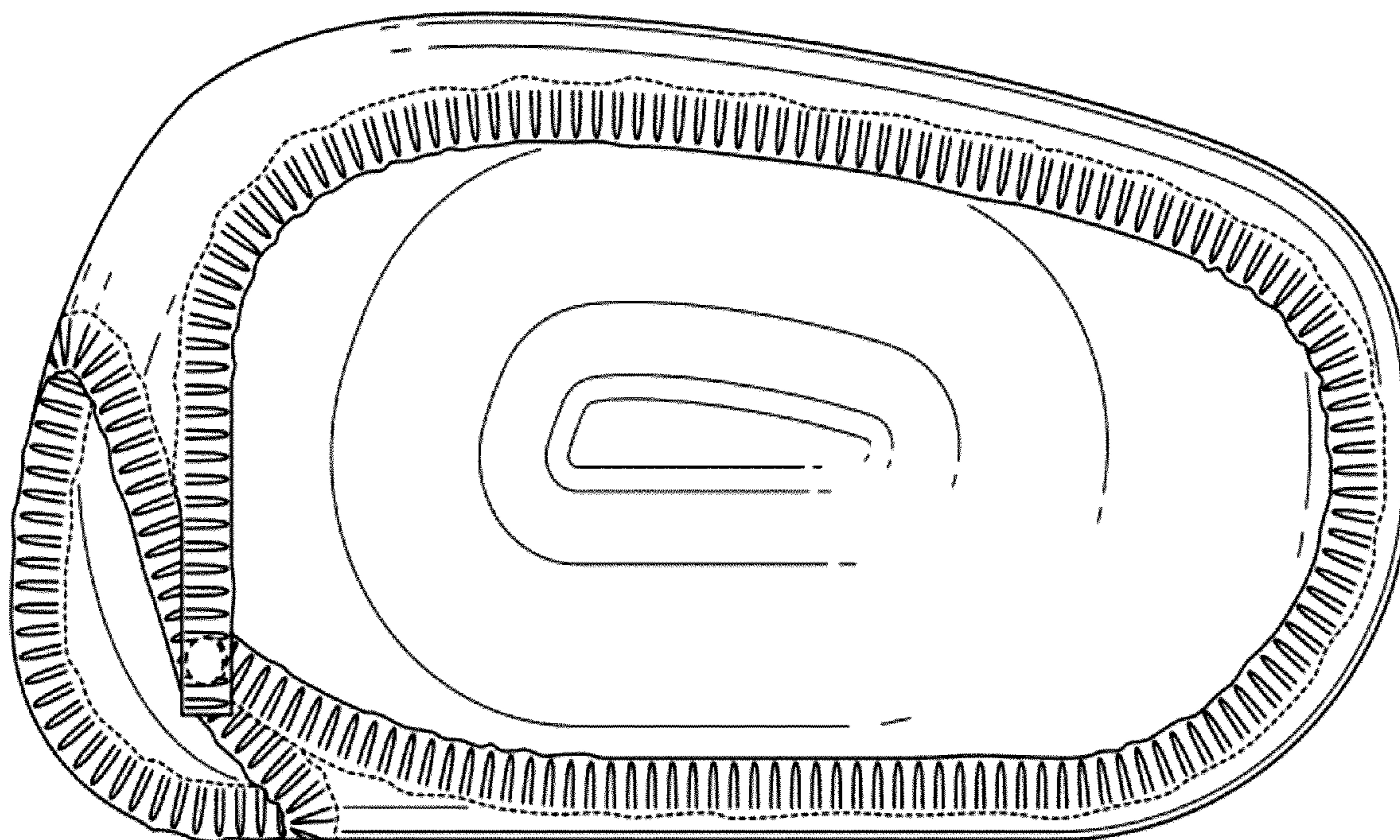
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the mirror glove of FIG. 1.

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the mirror glove of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a mirror glove according to an embodiment of the present design installed on a vehicle.

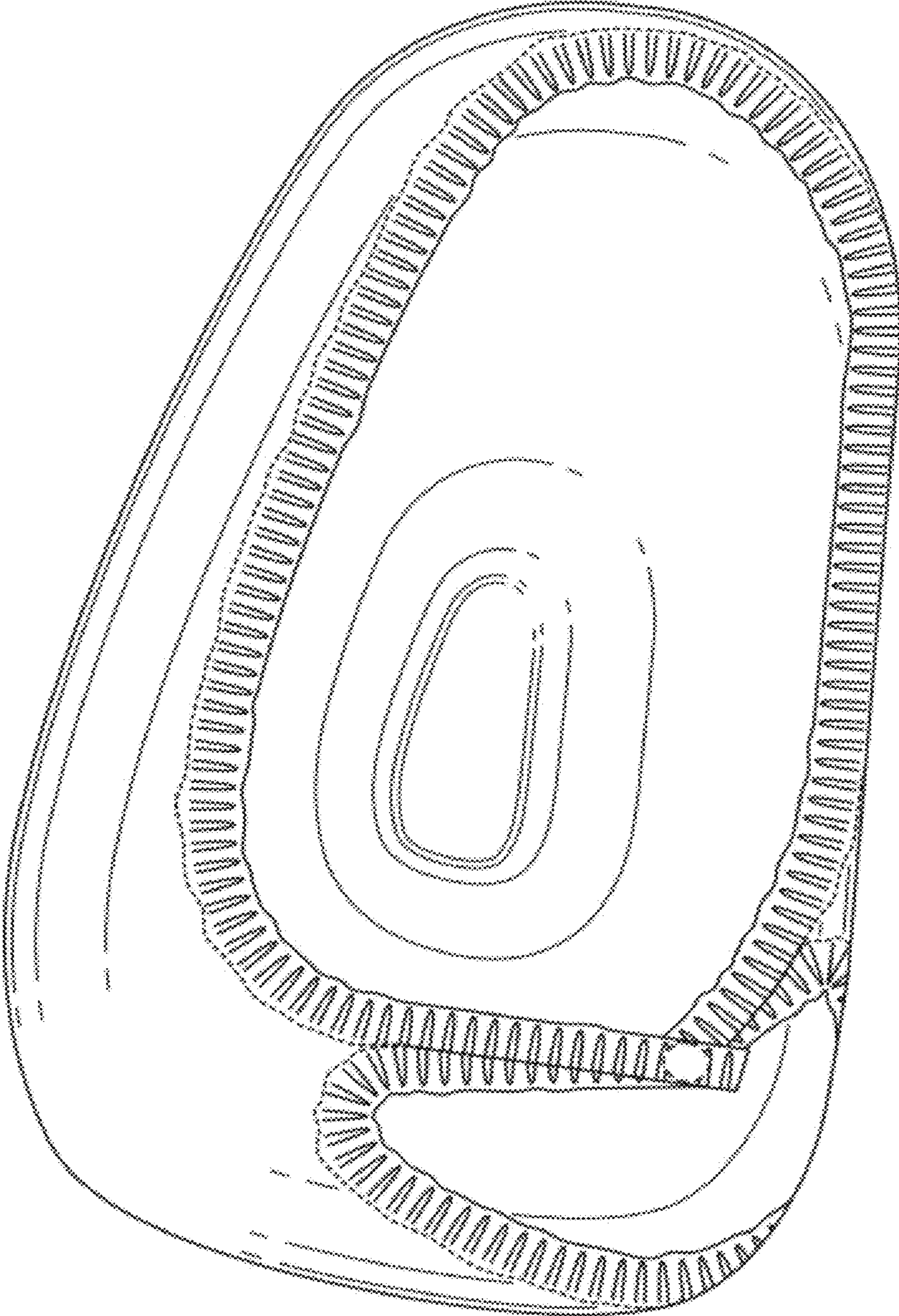

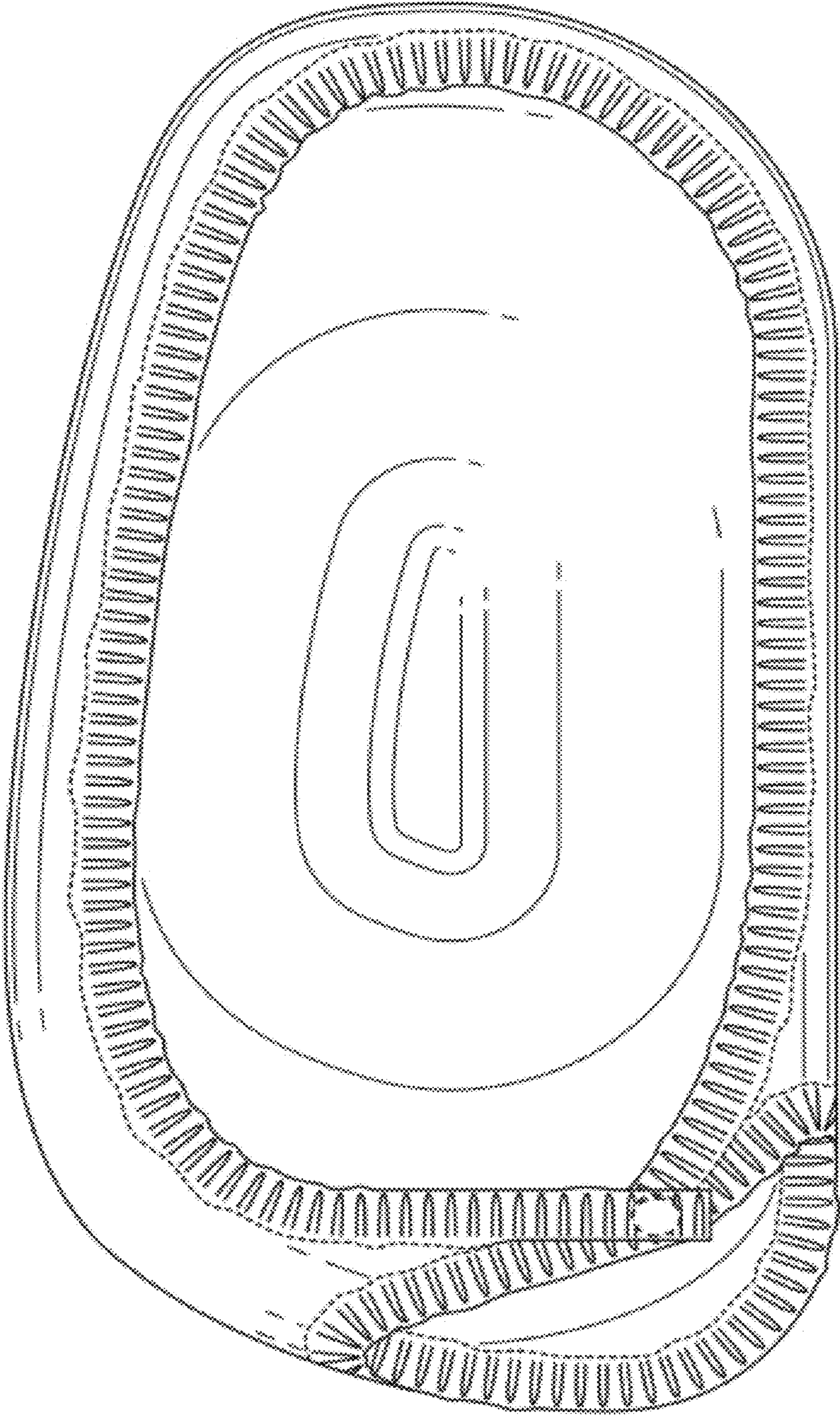

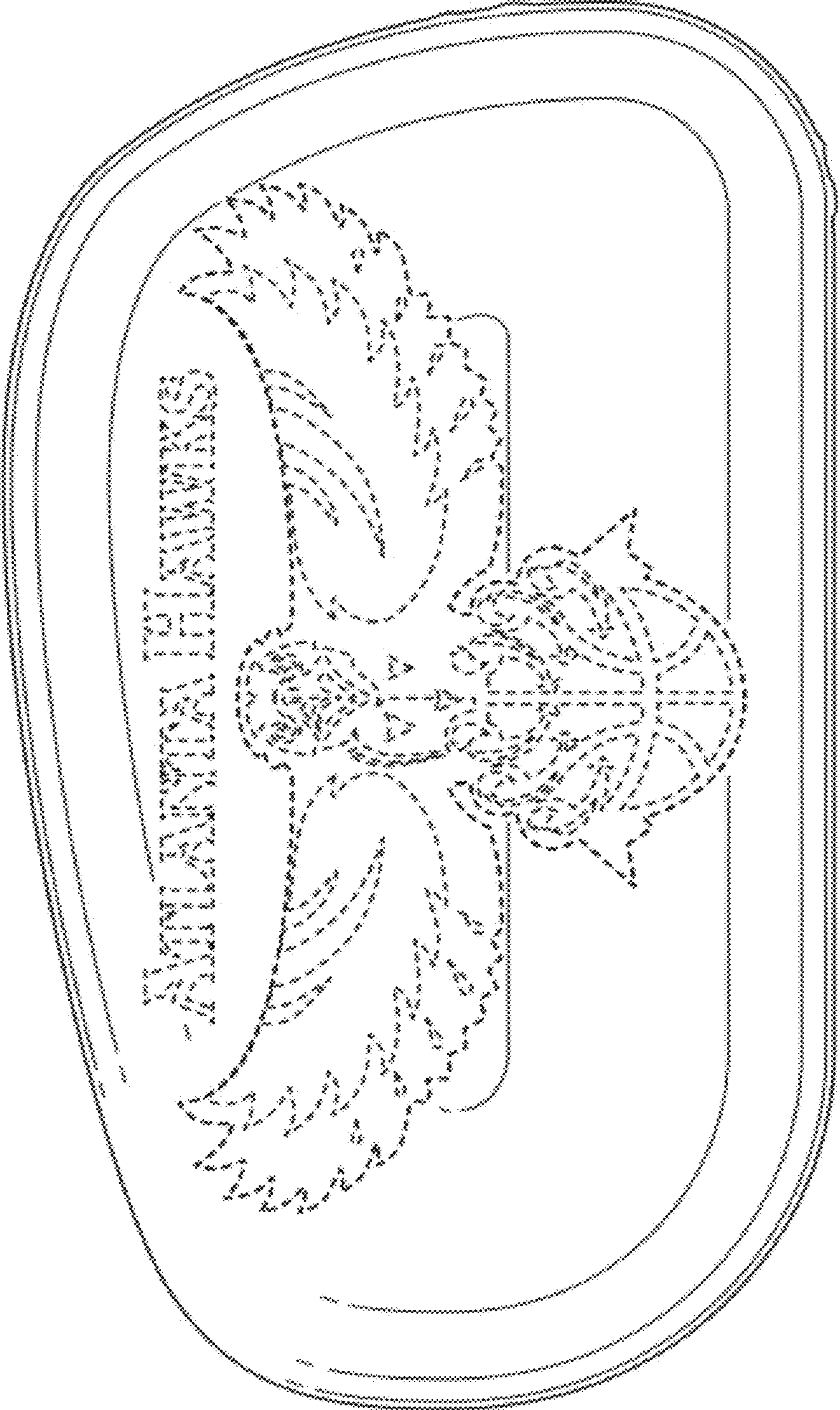

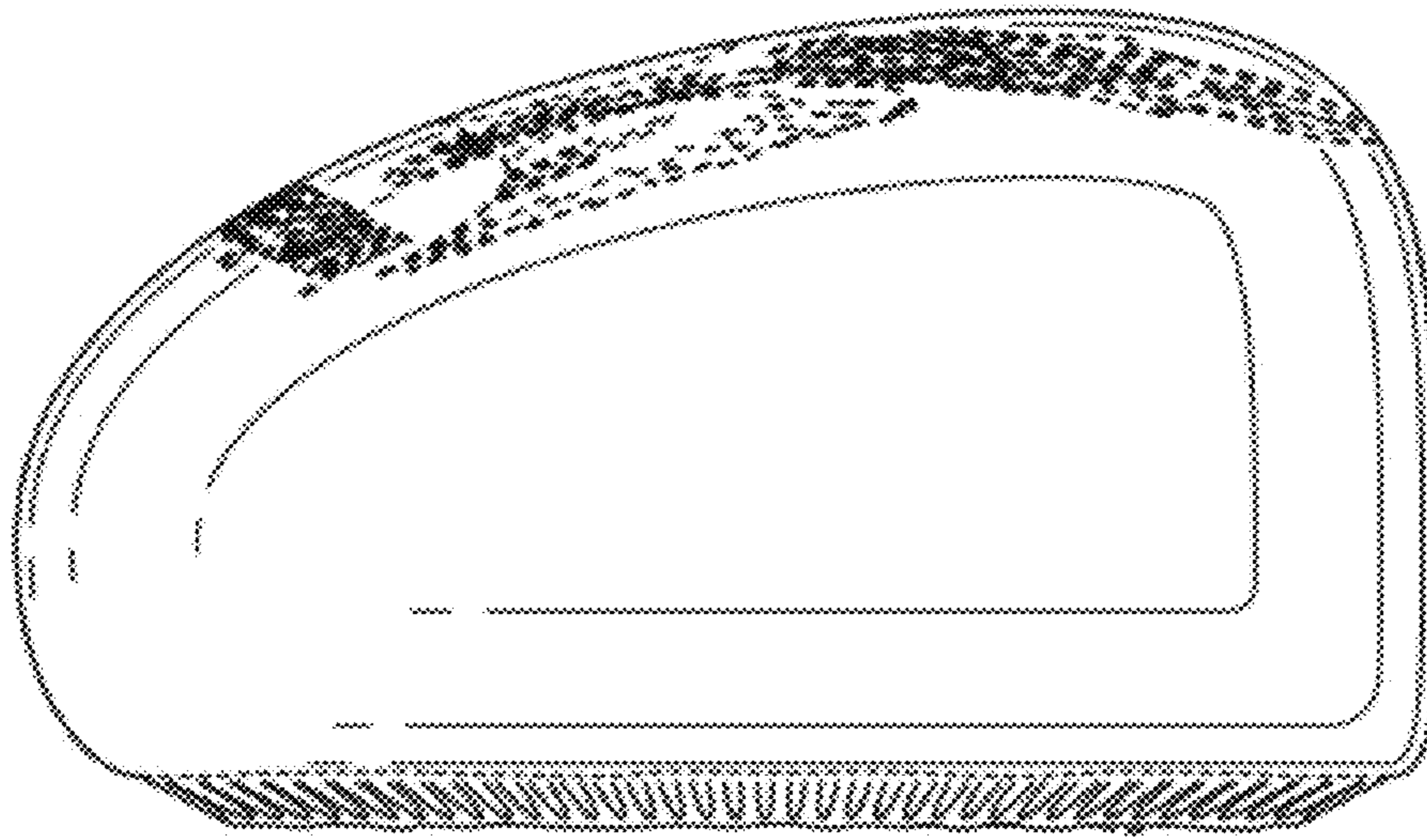

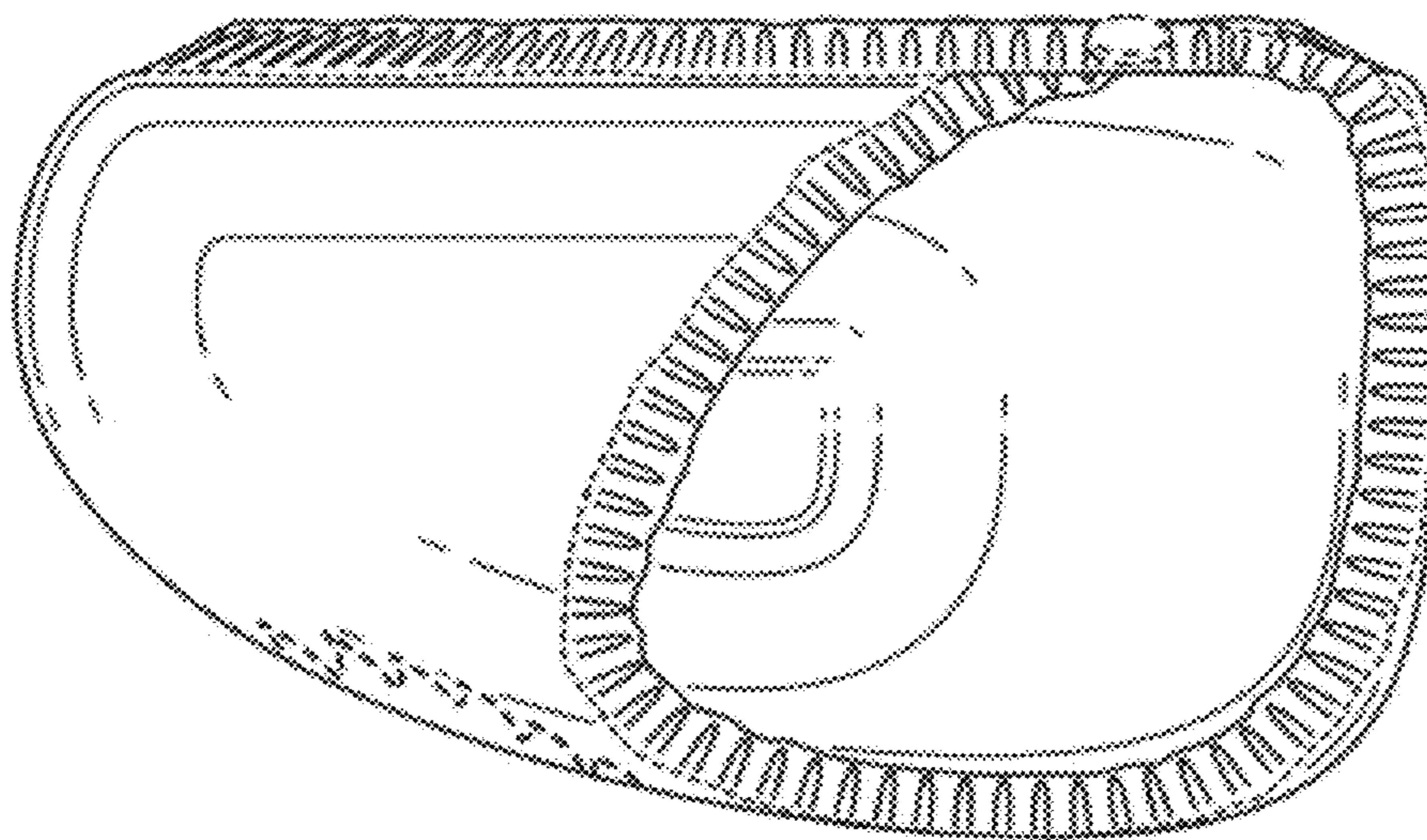

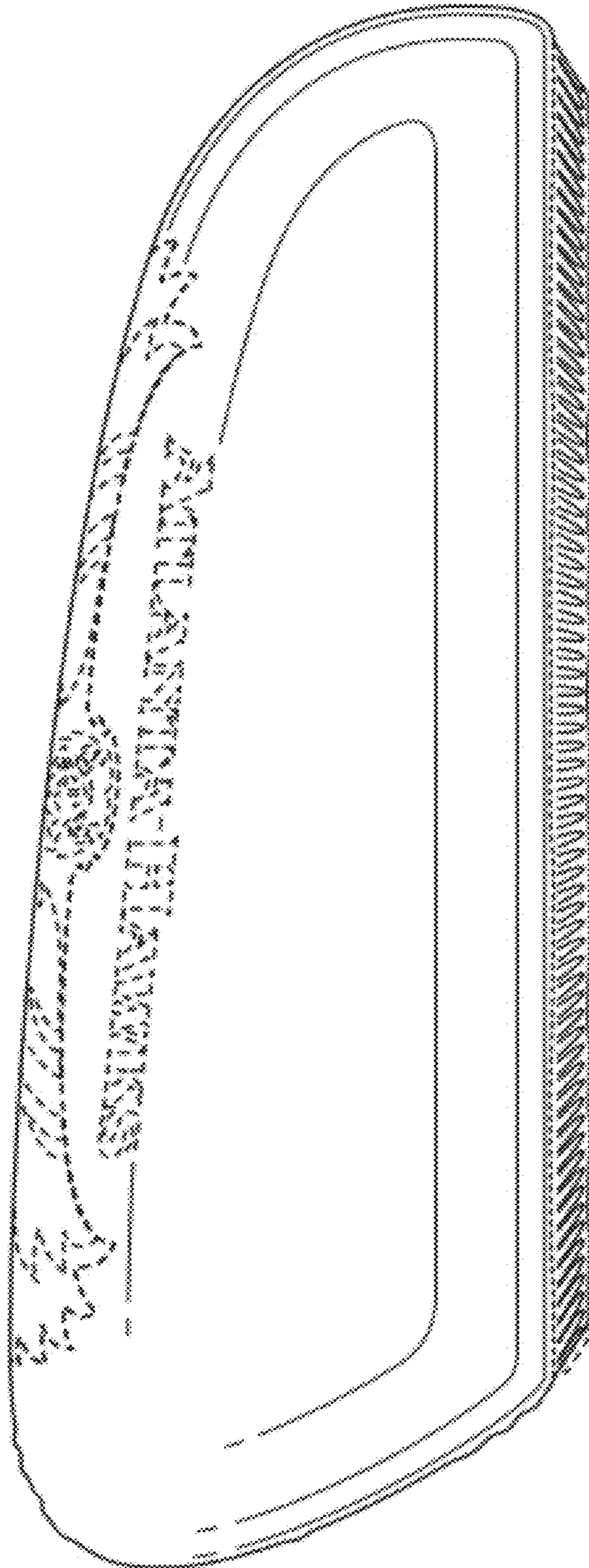

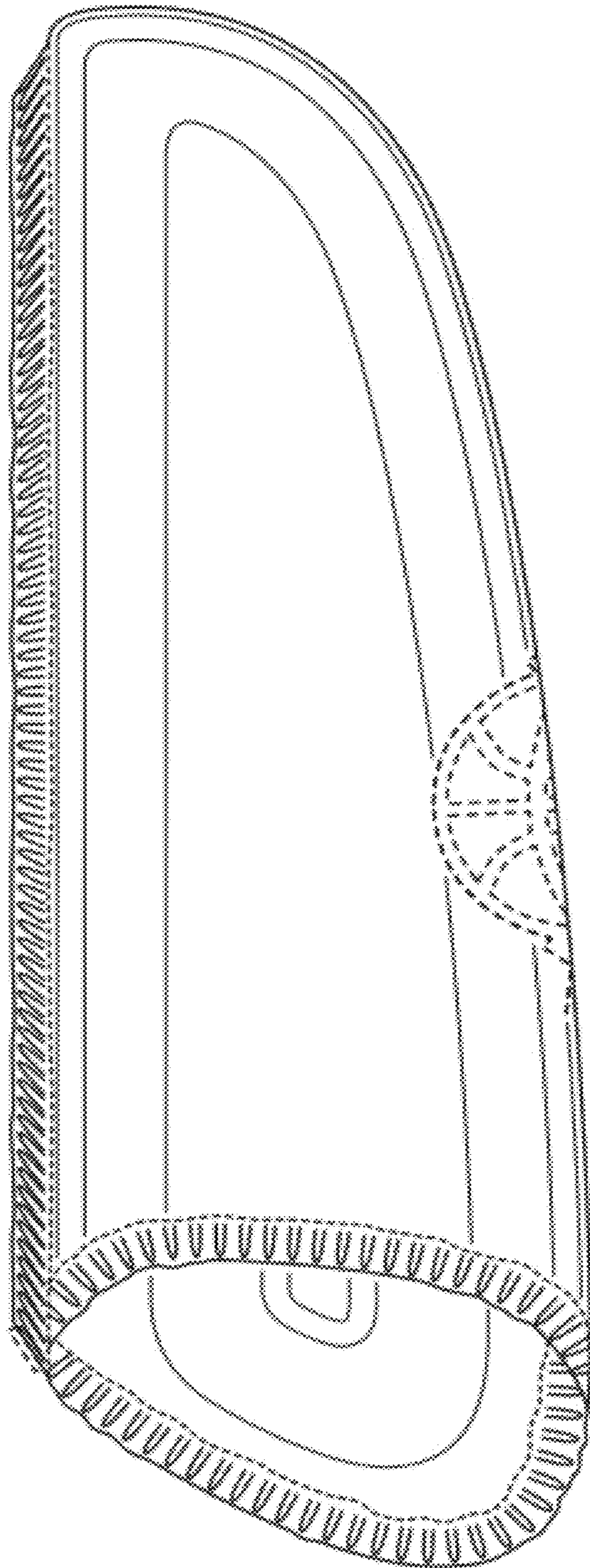

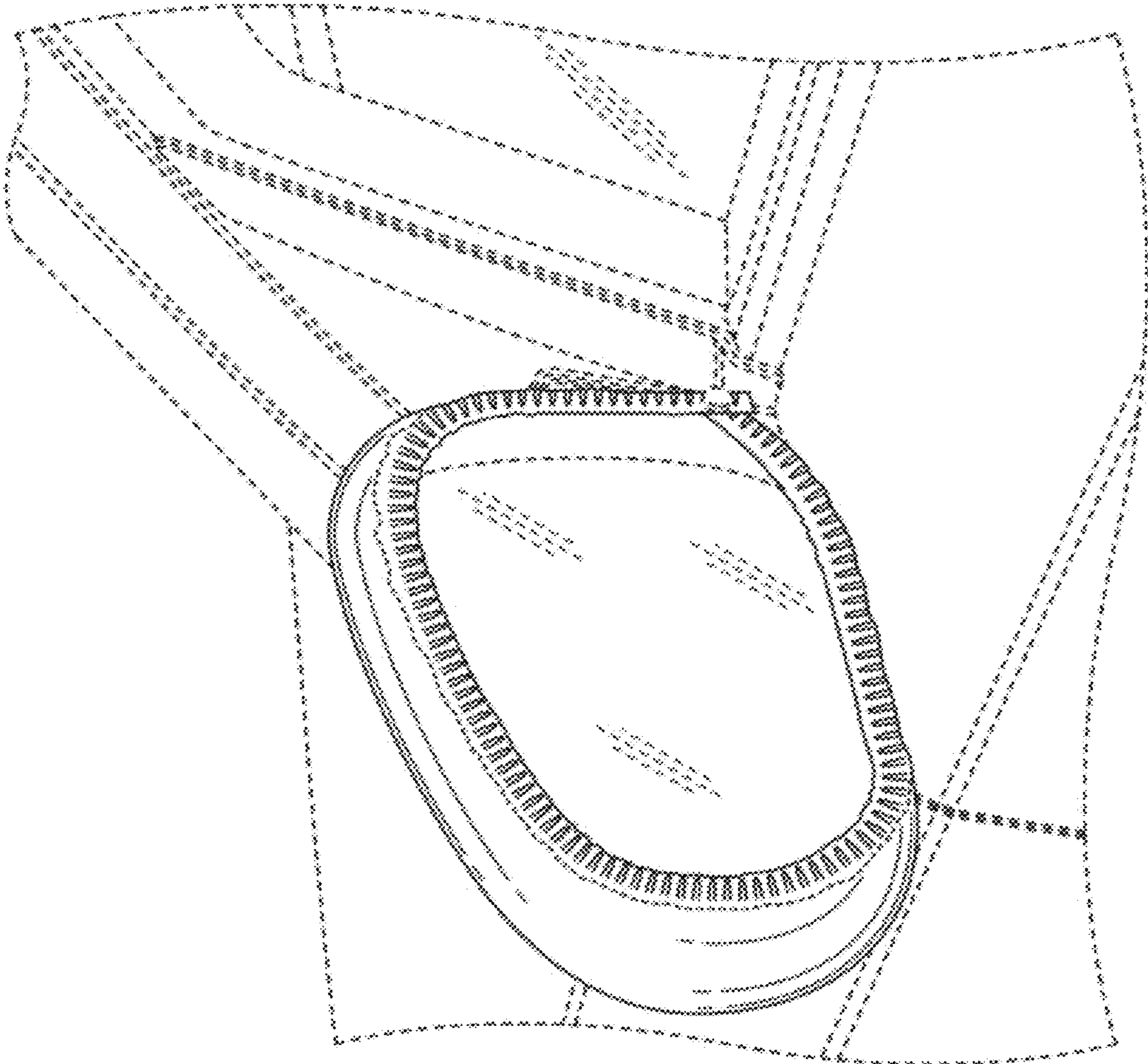
