(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a collapsible shoulder bag, as  
shown and described

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the shoulder bag in its  
expanded state.

FIG. 2 is a front view of the shoulder bag in its expanded  
state. The back view of the shoulder bag in its expanded  
state is identical.

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the shoulder bag in its expanded  
state.

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the shoulder bag in its expanded  
state.

FIG. 5 is a top view of the shoulder bag in its expanded state.

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the shoulder bag in its expanded  
state.

FIG. 7 is an enlarged, fragmented view of the center of the  
underside of the shoulder strap, depicting a close up of the  
shoulder pad.

FIG. 8 is an enlarged, fragmented view of the interior right  
side of the bag in its expanded state, depicting a pouch placed  
at the juncture of the bag body and the shoulder strap.

FIG. 9 is a front view of the bag in its collapsed state.

FIG. 10 is a rear view of the bag in its collapsed state.

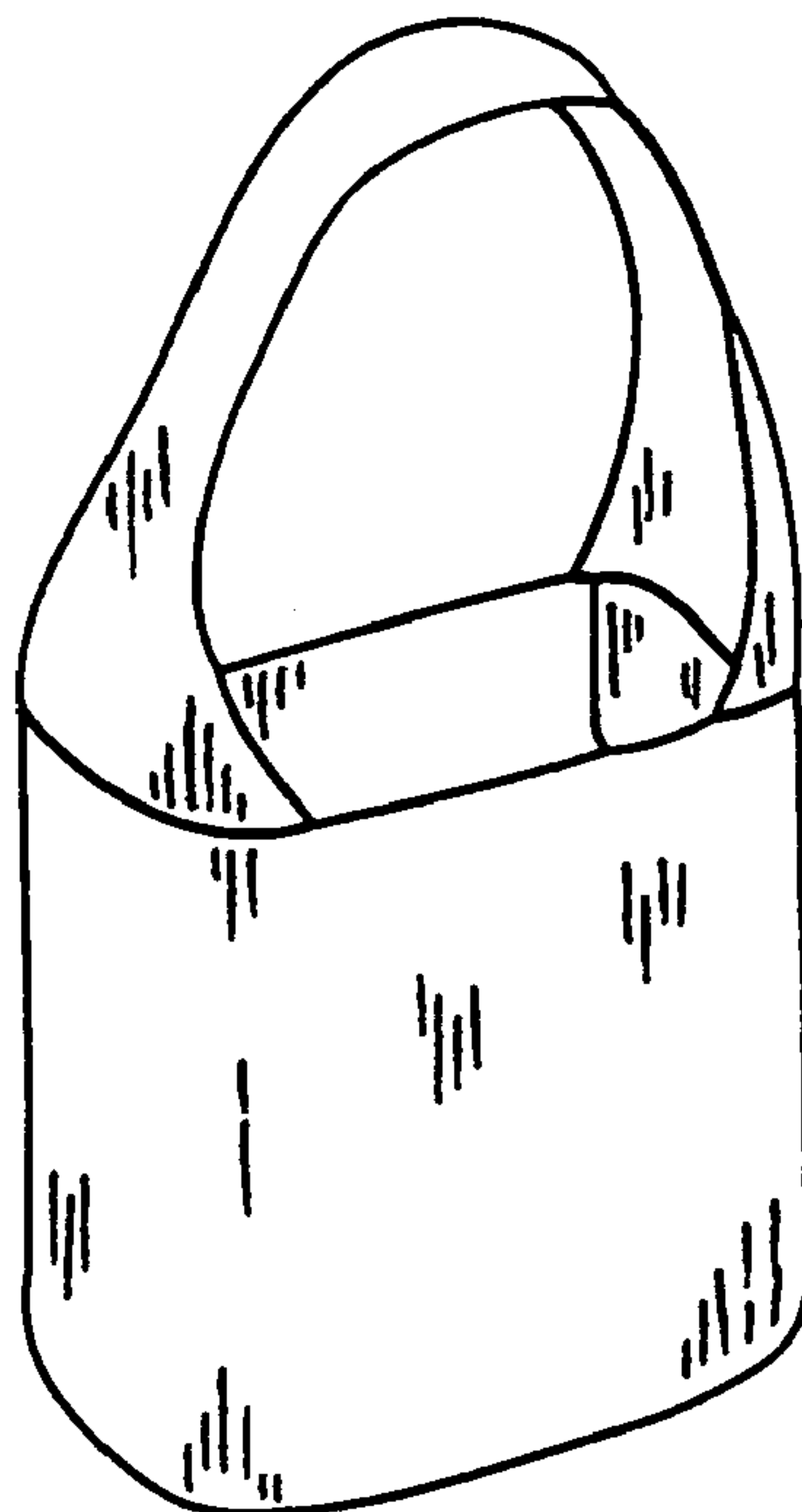
FIG. 11 is a right side view of the bag in its collapsed state;  
and,

FIG. 12 is a left side view of the bag in its collapsed state.

Our shoulder bag in its expanded state is characterized by a  
shoulder strap that flares out on both ends, a capsule shaped  
shoulder patch on the underside of the shoulder strap, and a  
pouch on the interior of the bag.

Our shoulder bag in its collapsed state is characterized by a  
round spherical form.

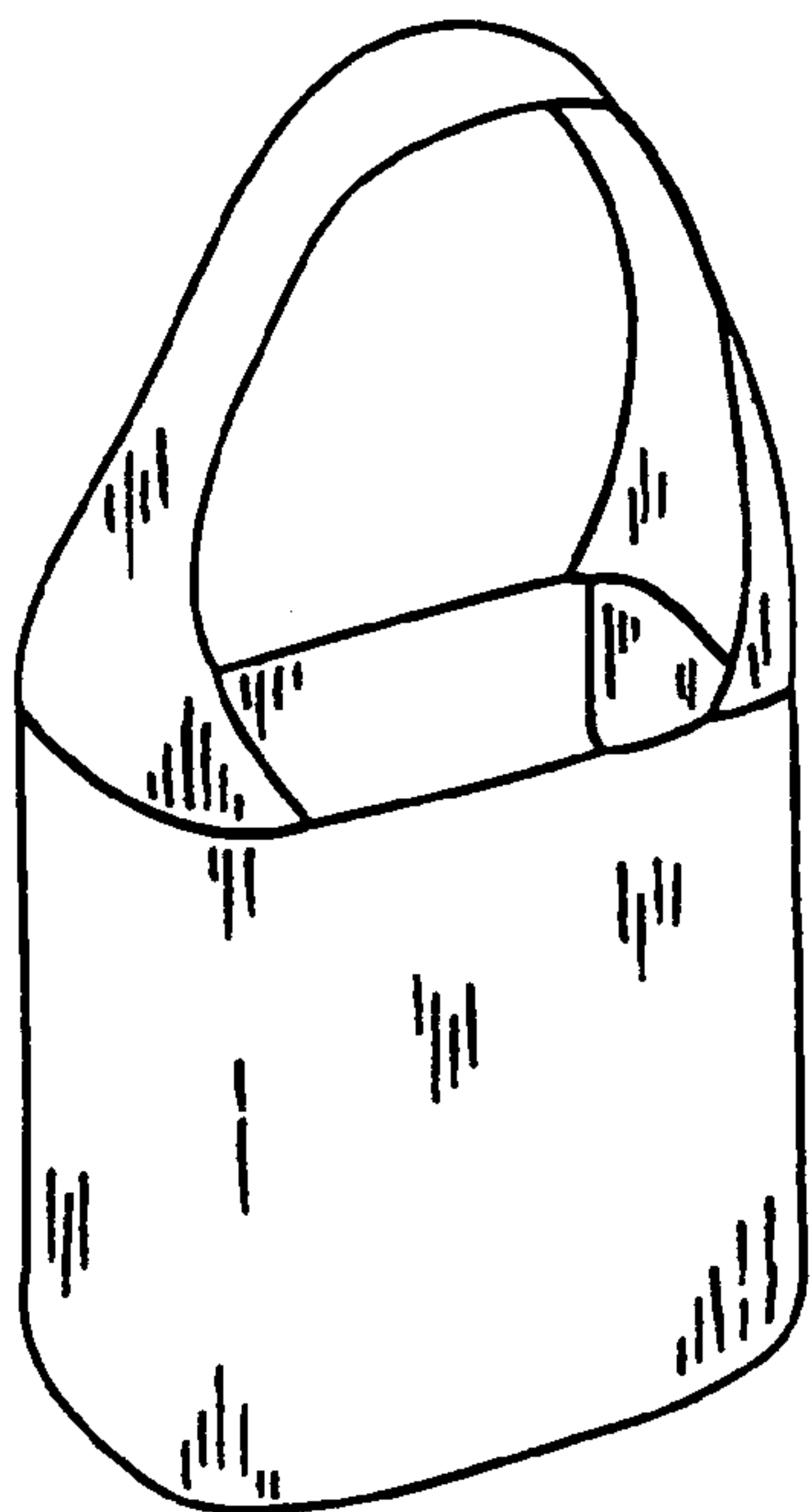

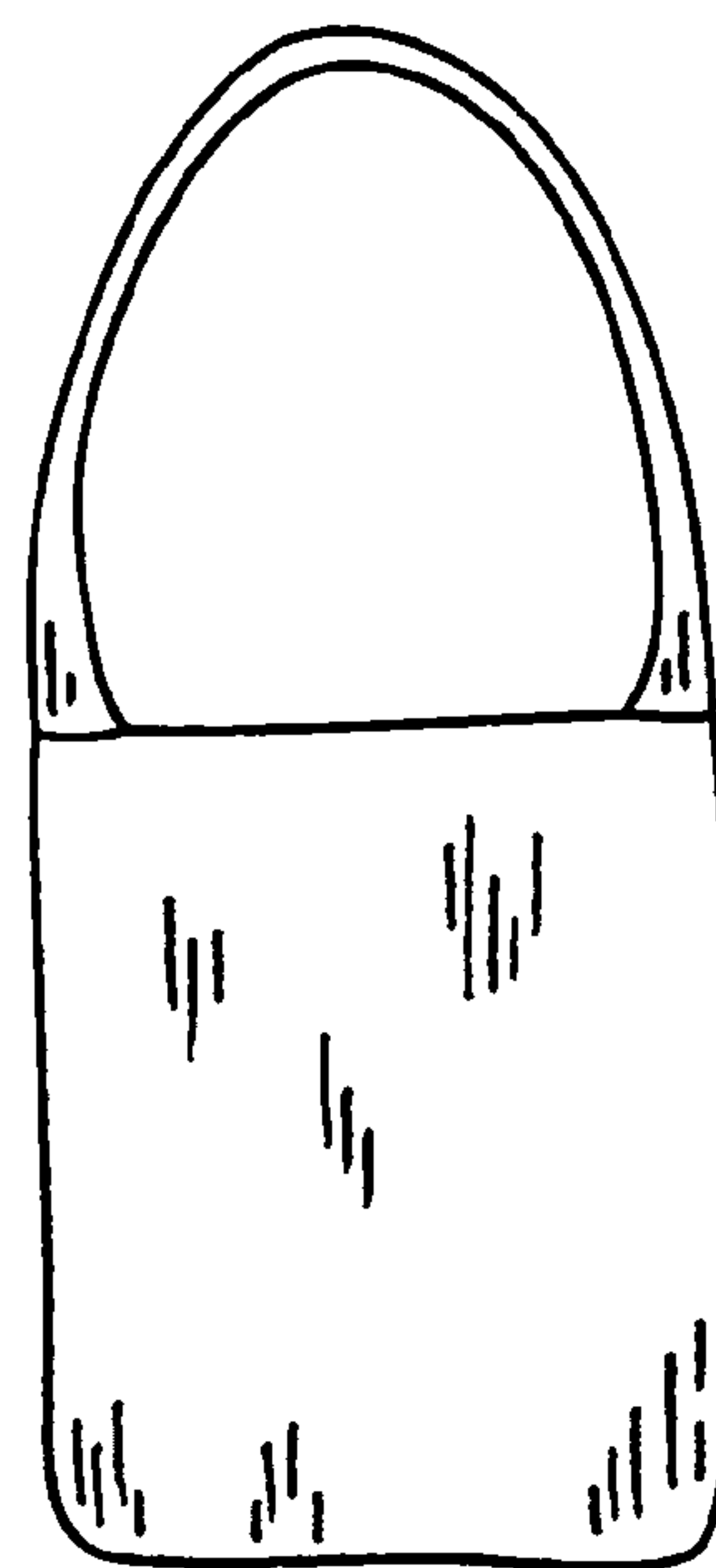

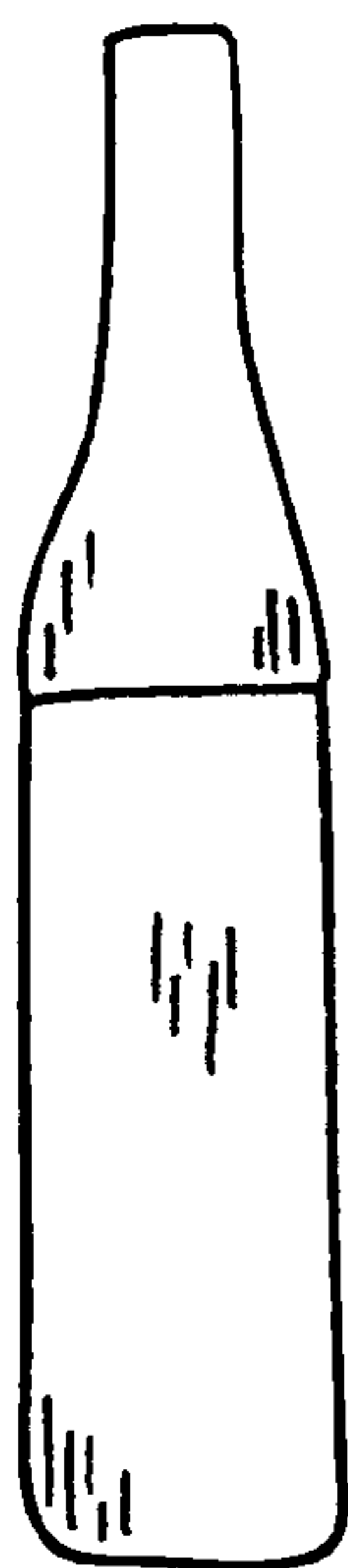

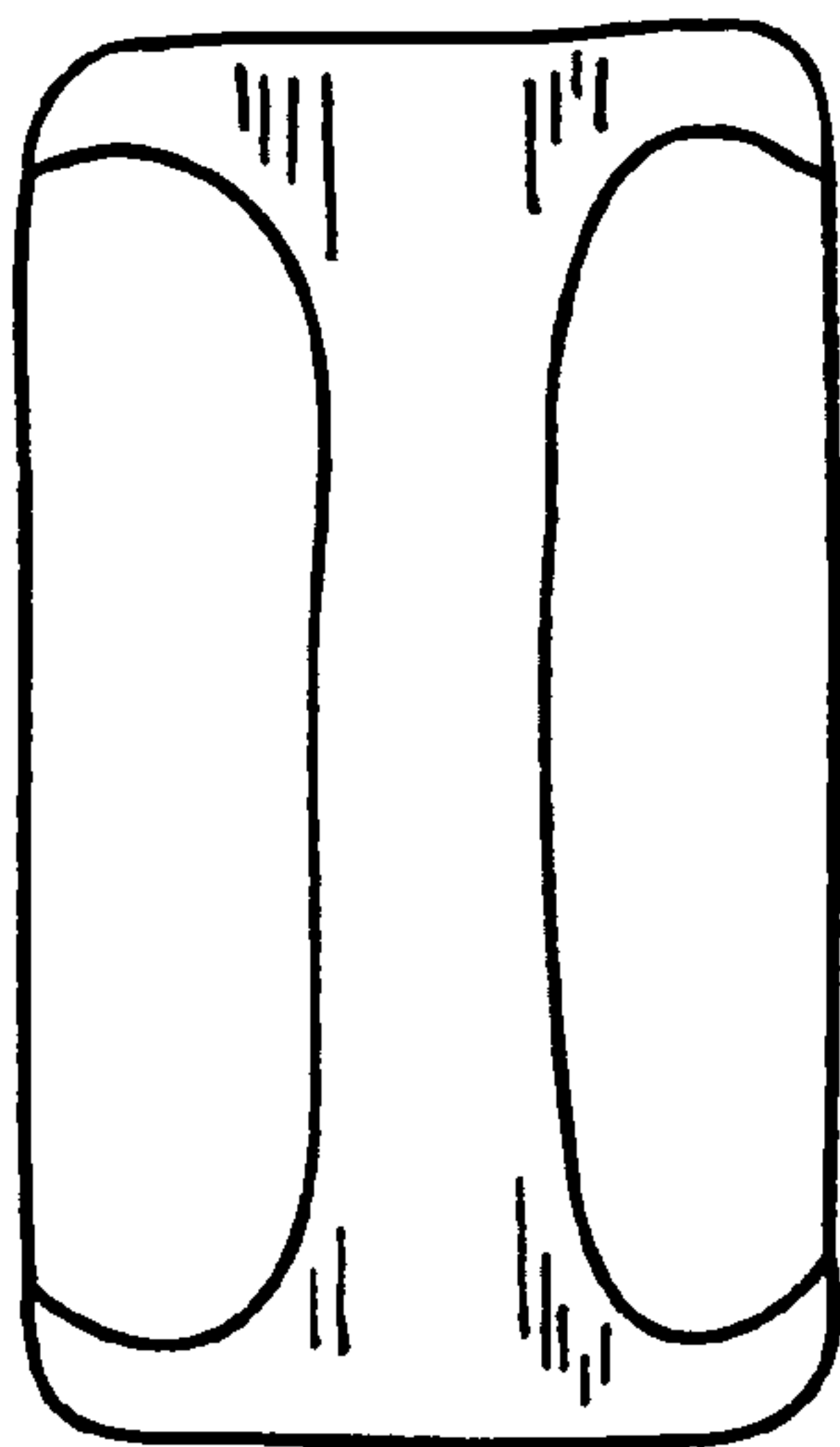

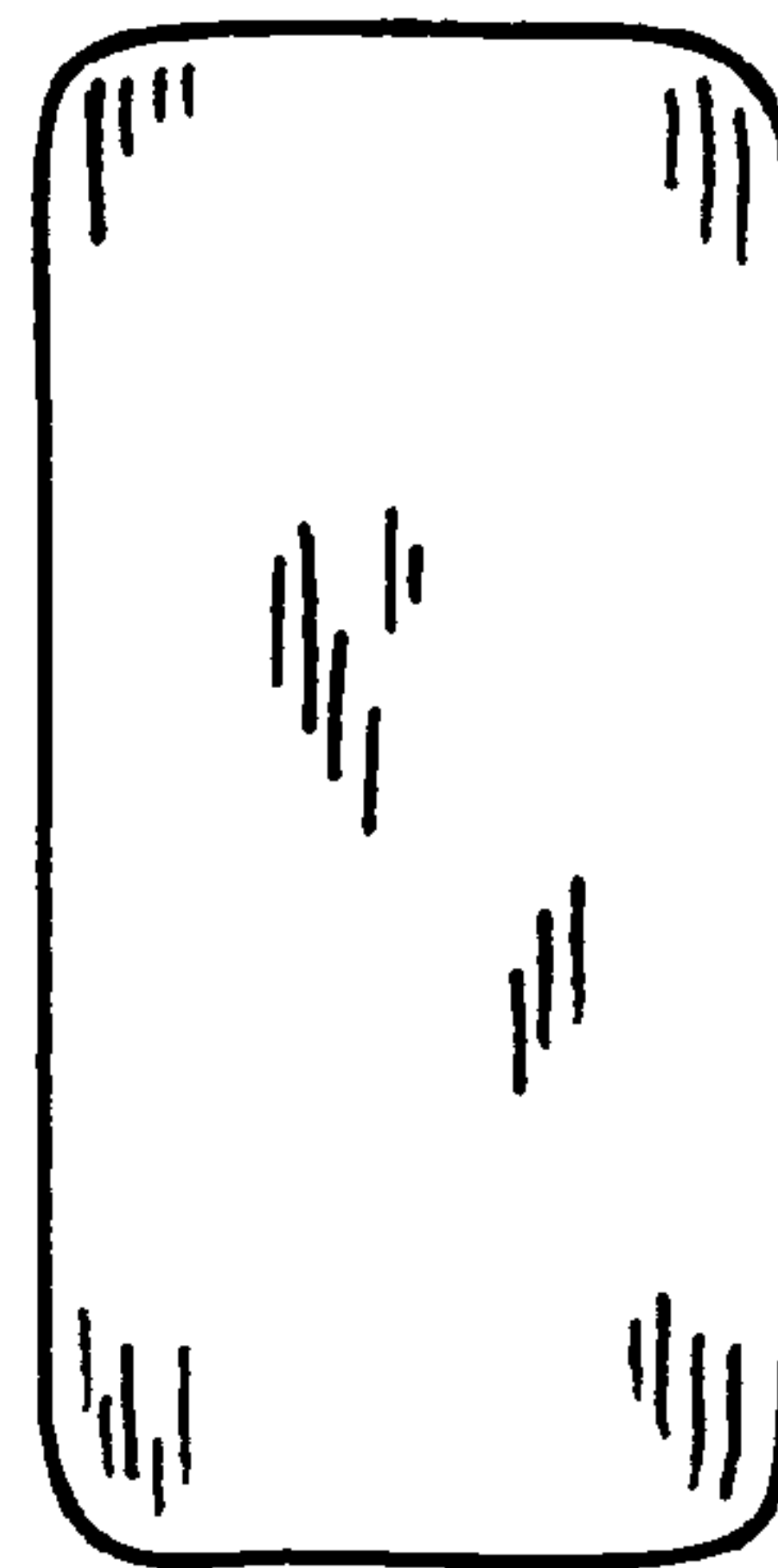

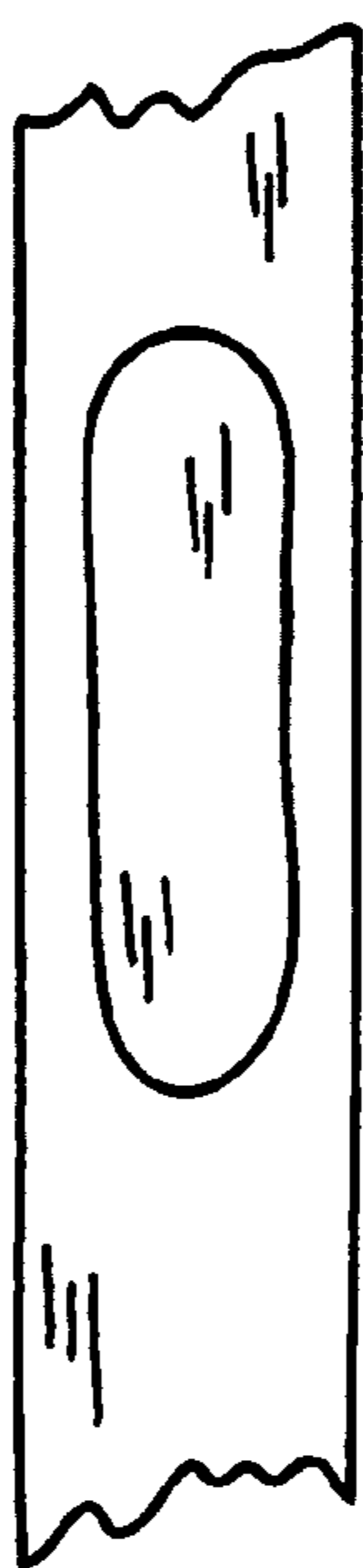

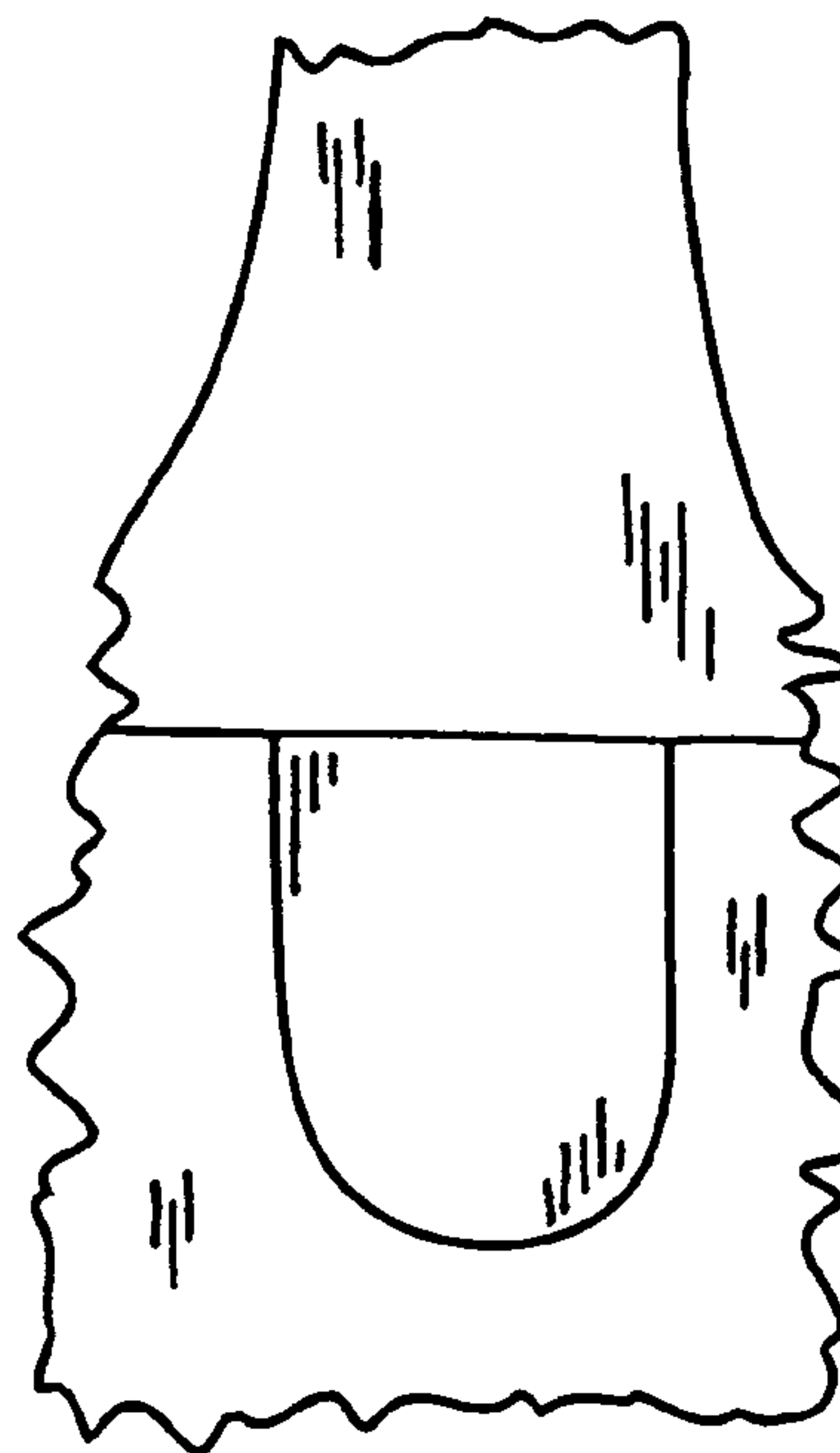

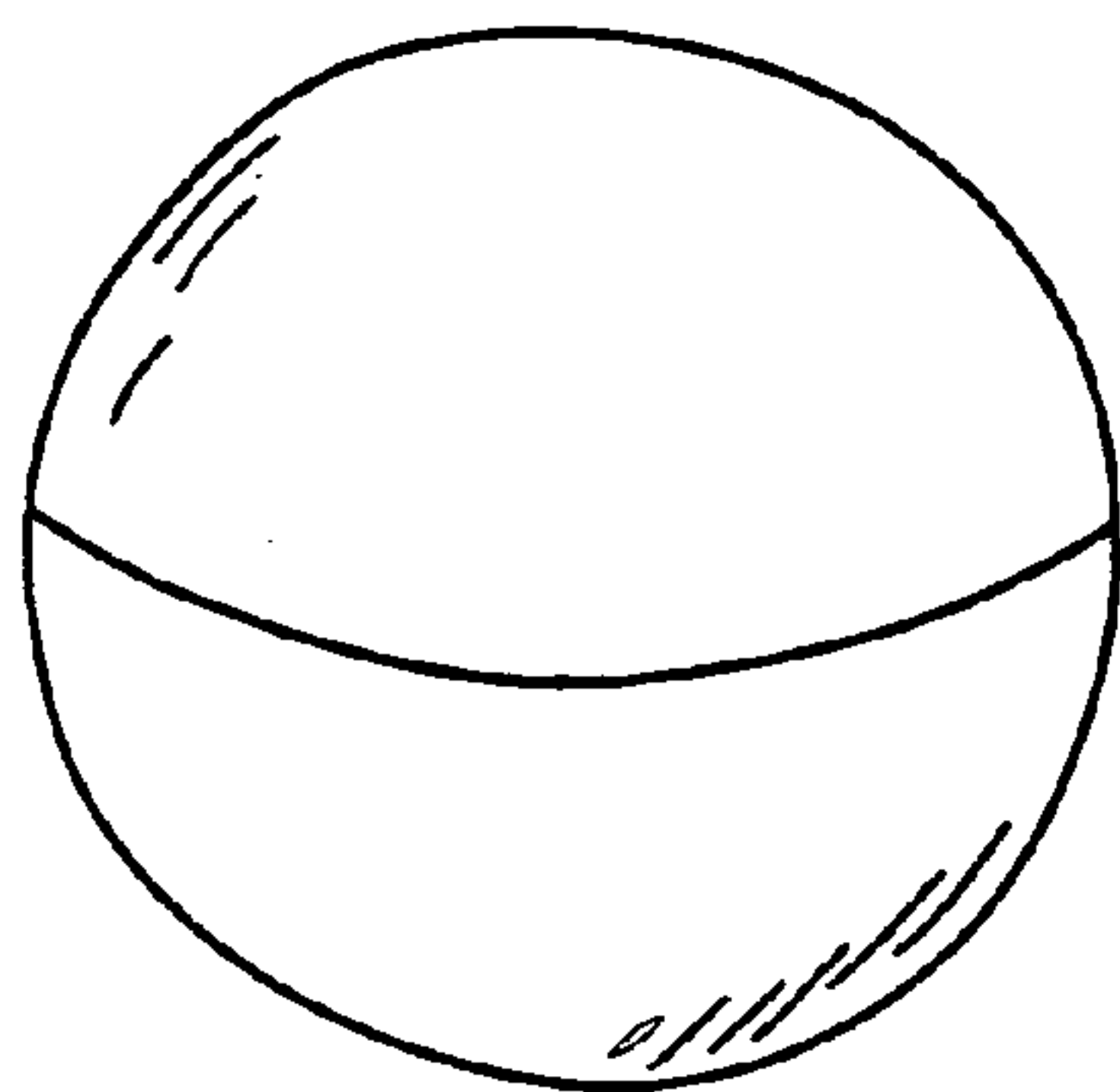

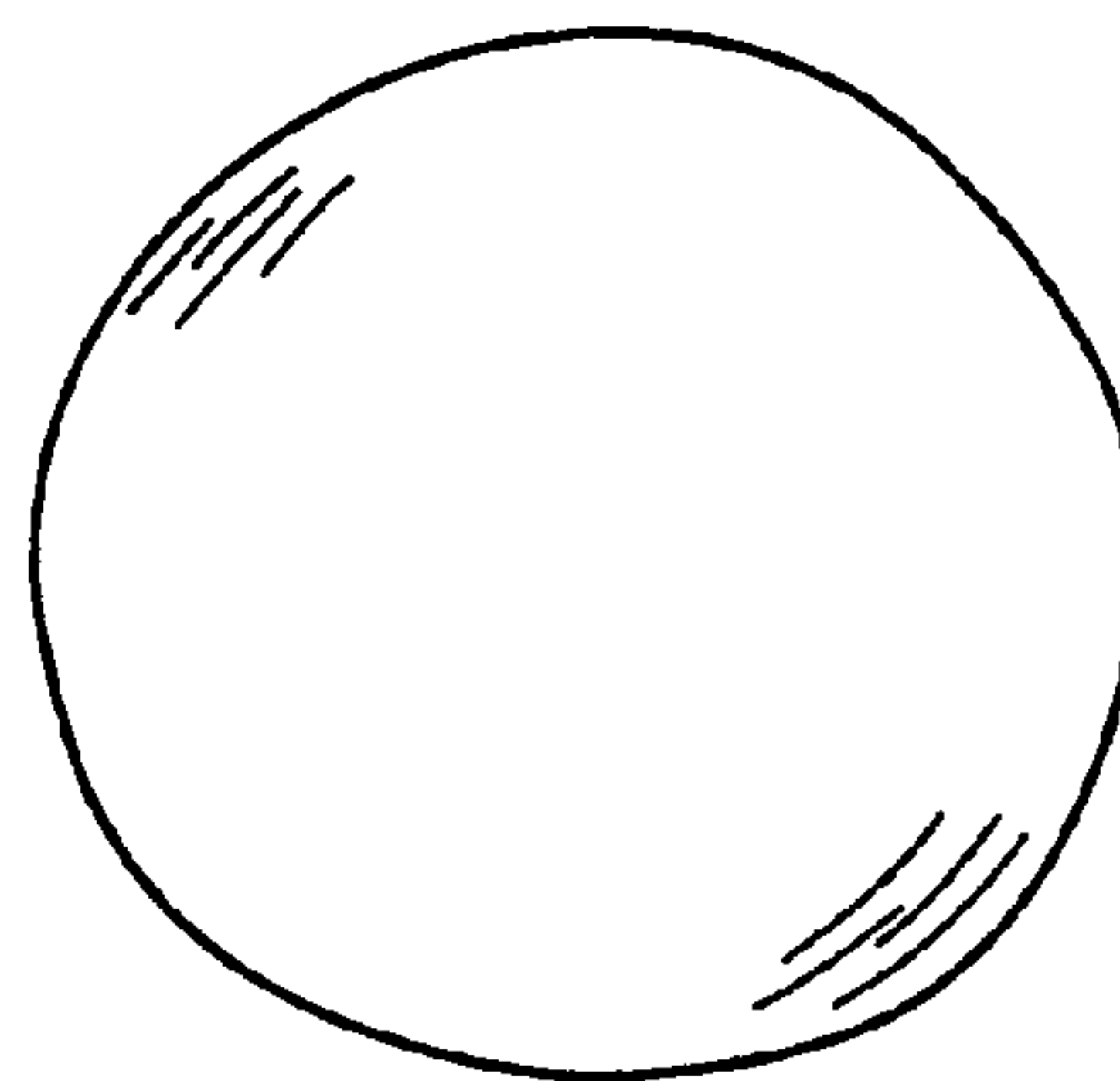

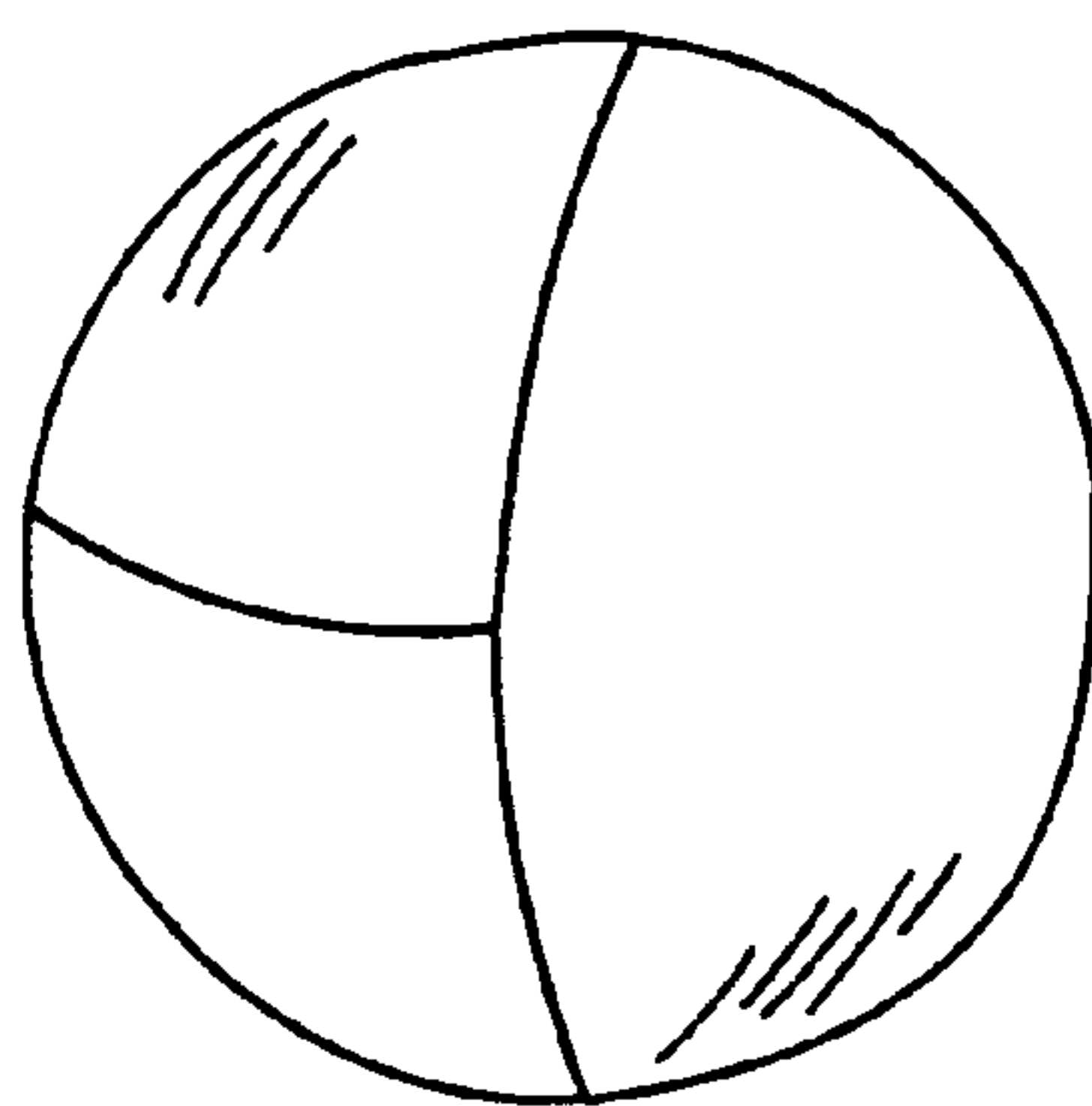

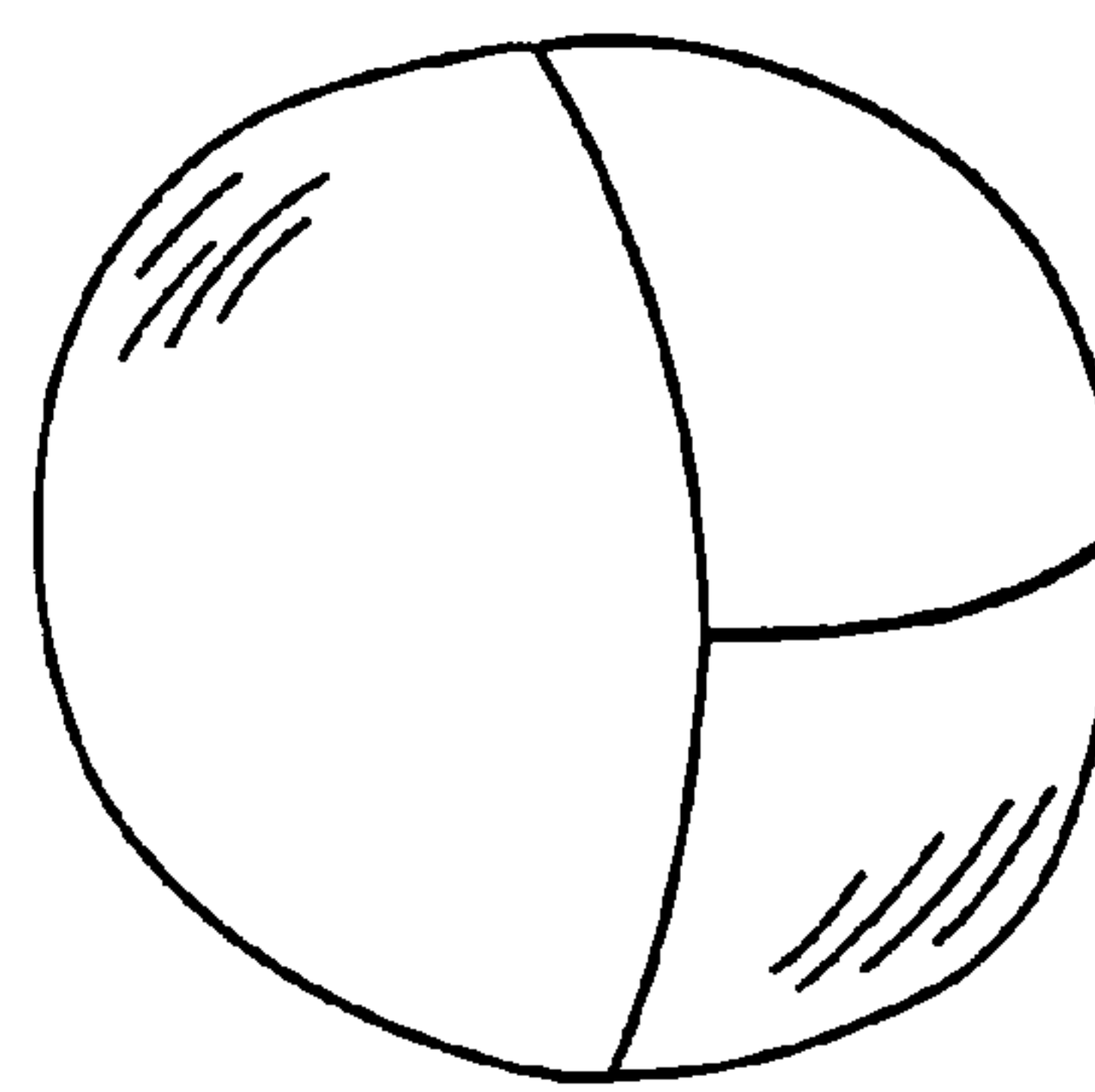
