(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an infant car seat boot, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a forward perspective view of the infant car seat boot showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view from the lowermost end thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the opposing vantage of that shown in FIG. 2 viewed from the uppermost end thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the infant car seat boot;

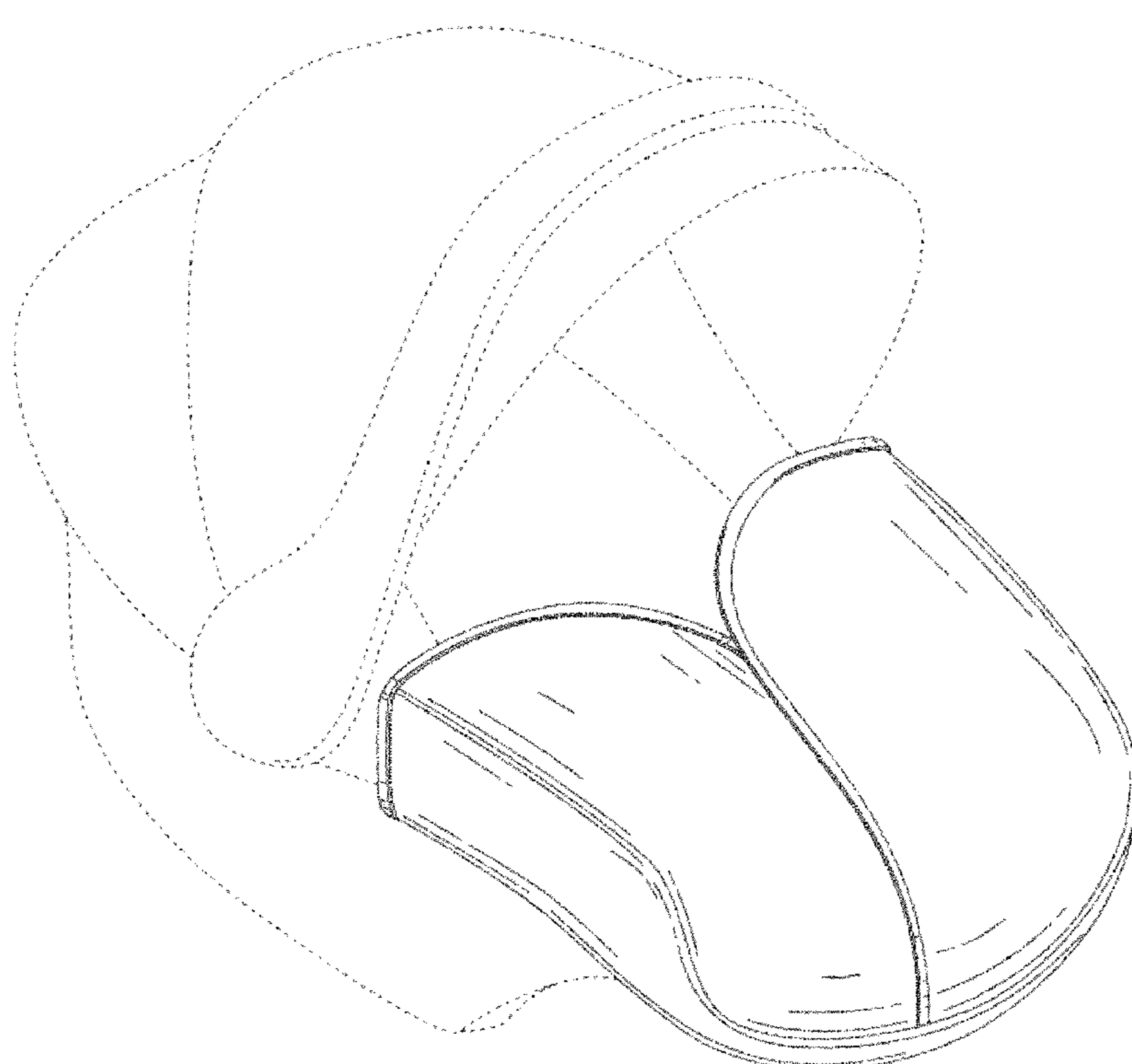
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is forward perspective view of the infant car seat boot in an alternate position; and,

FIG. 9 is a forward perspective view of the infant car set boot in another alternate position.

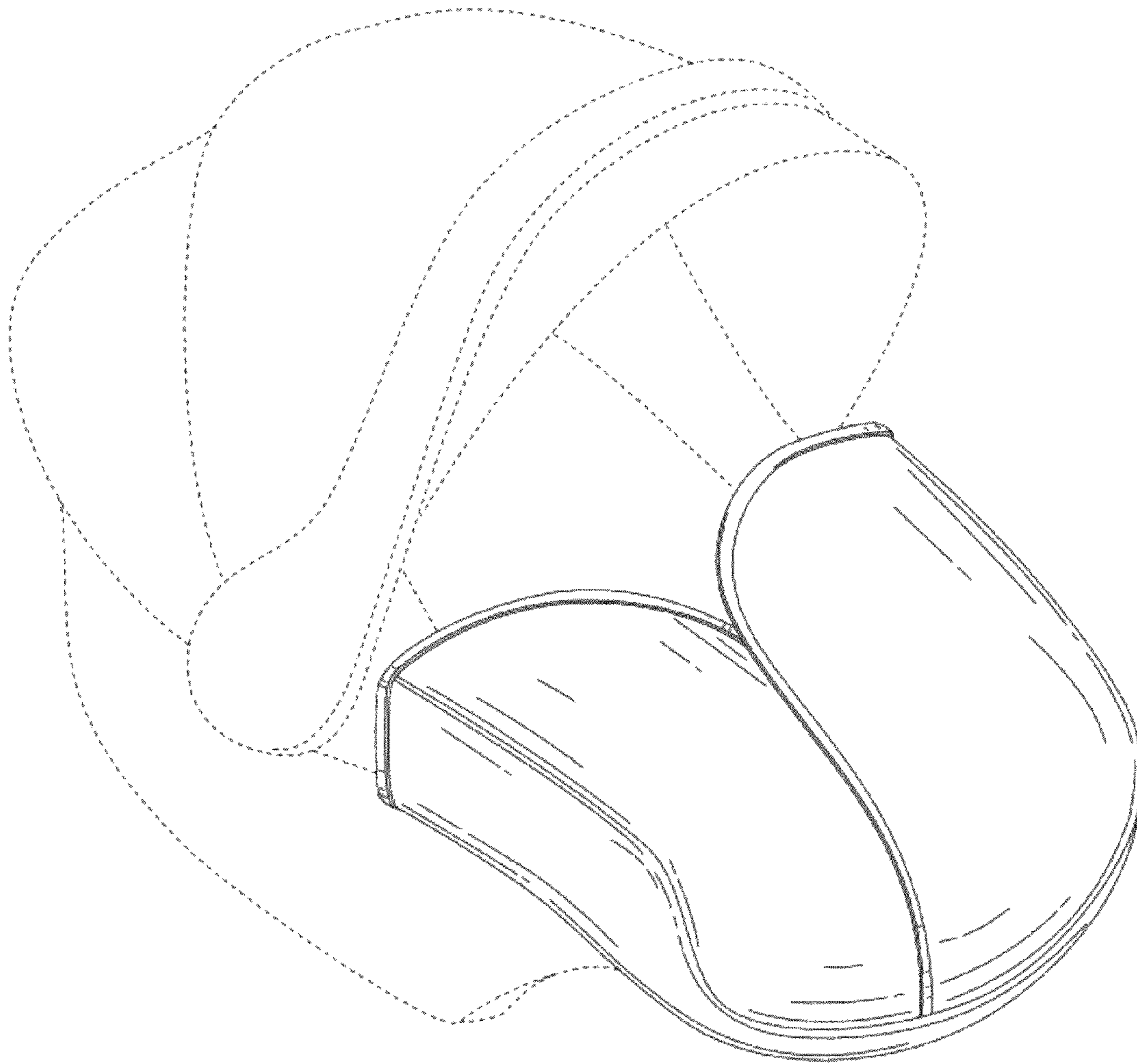

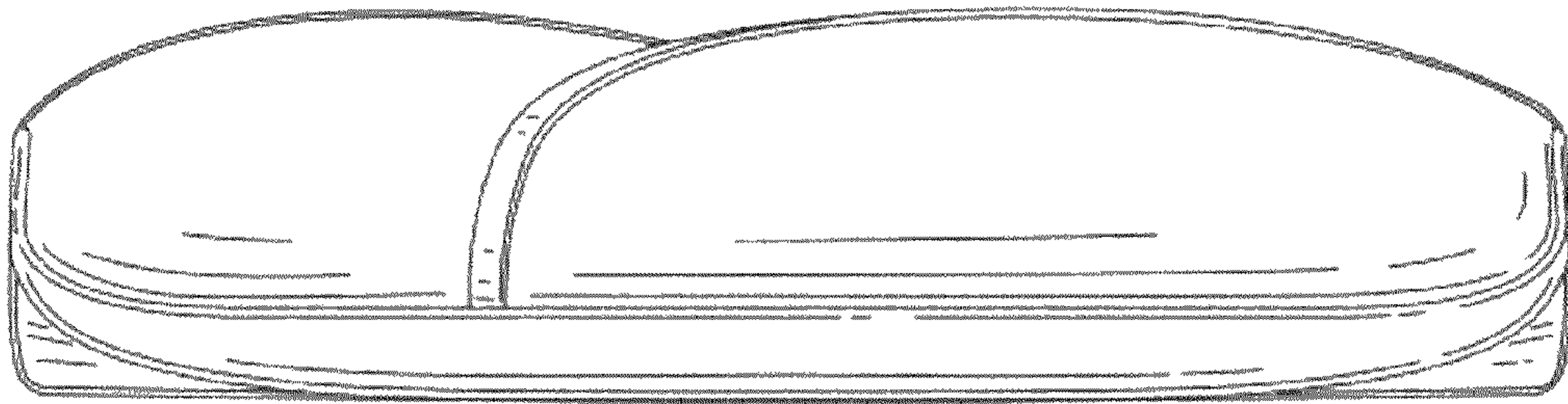

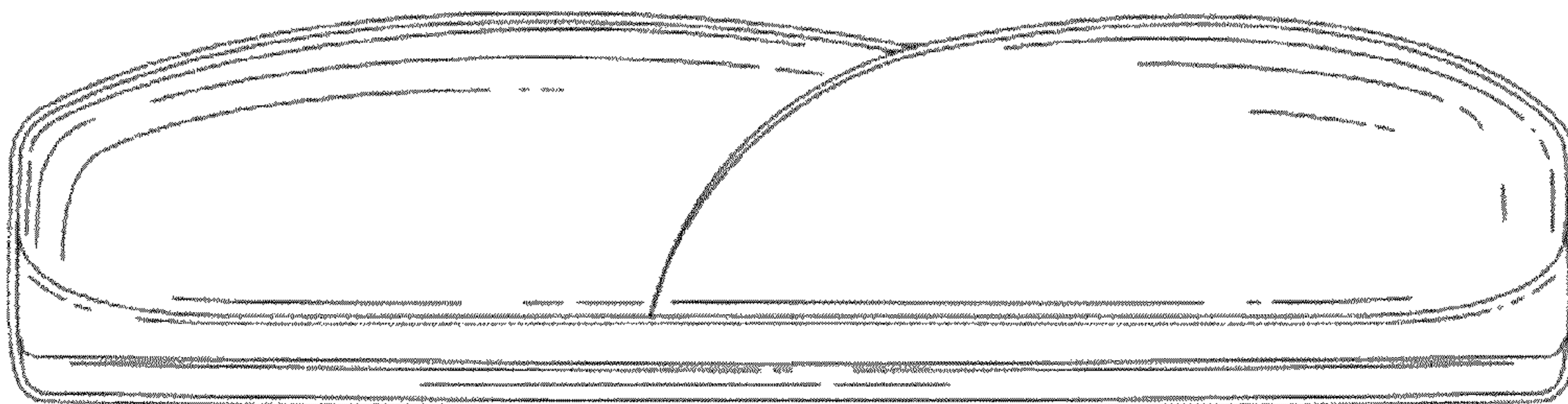

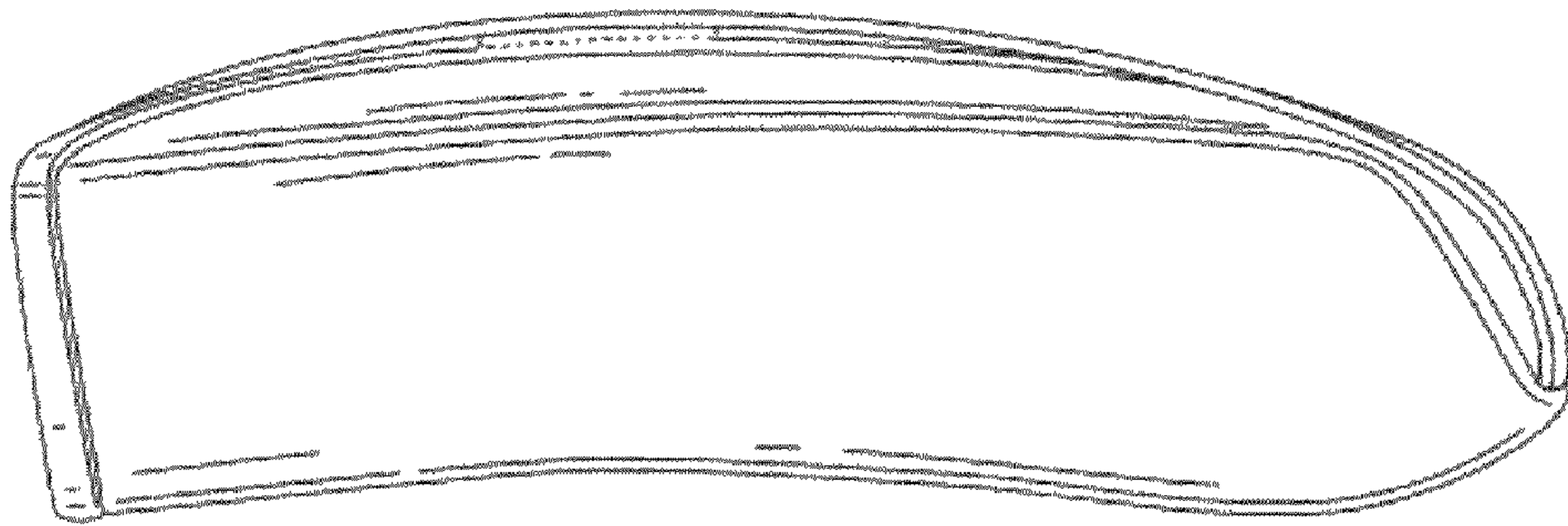

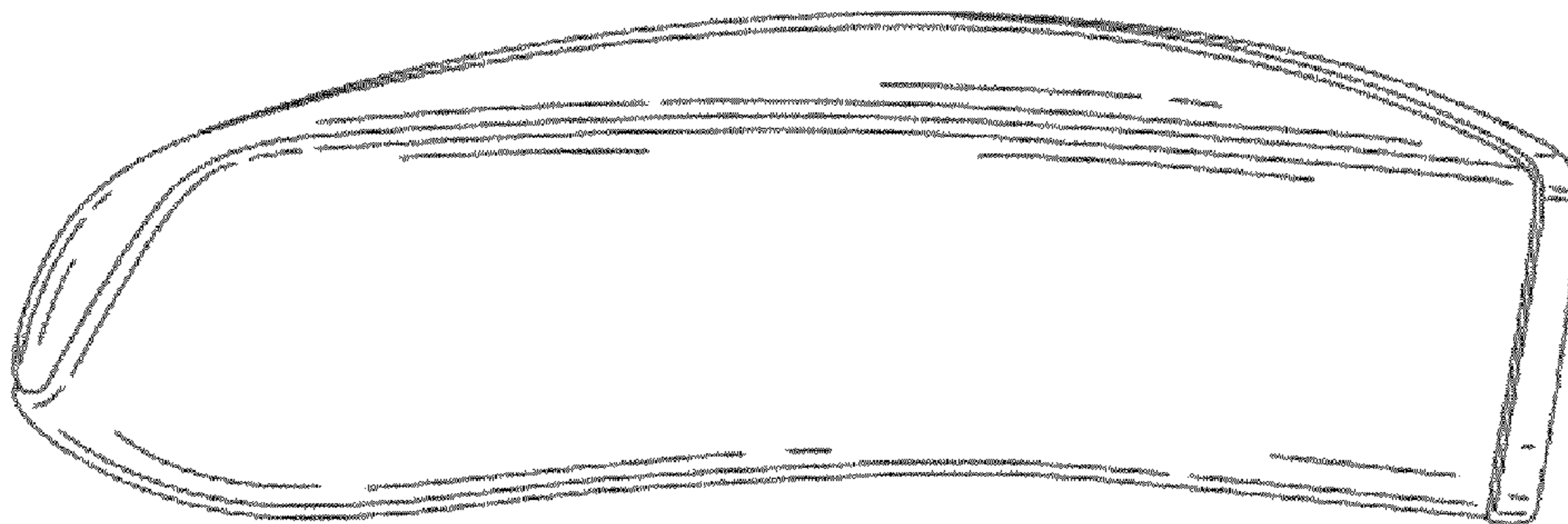

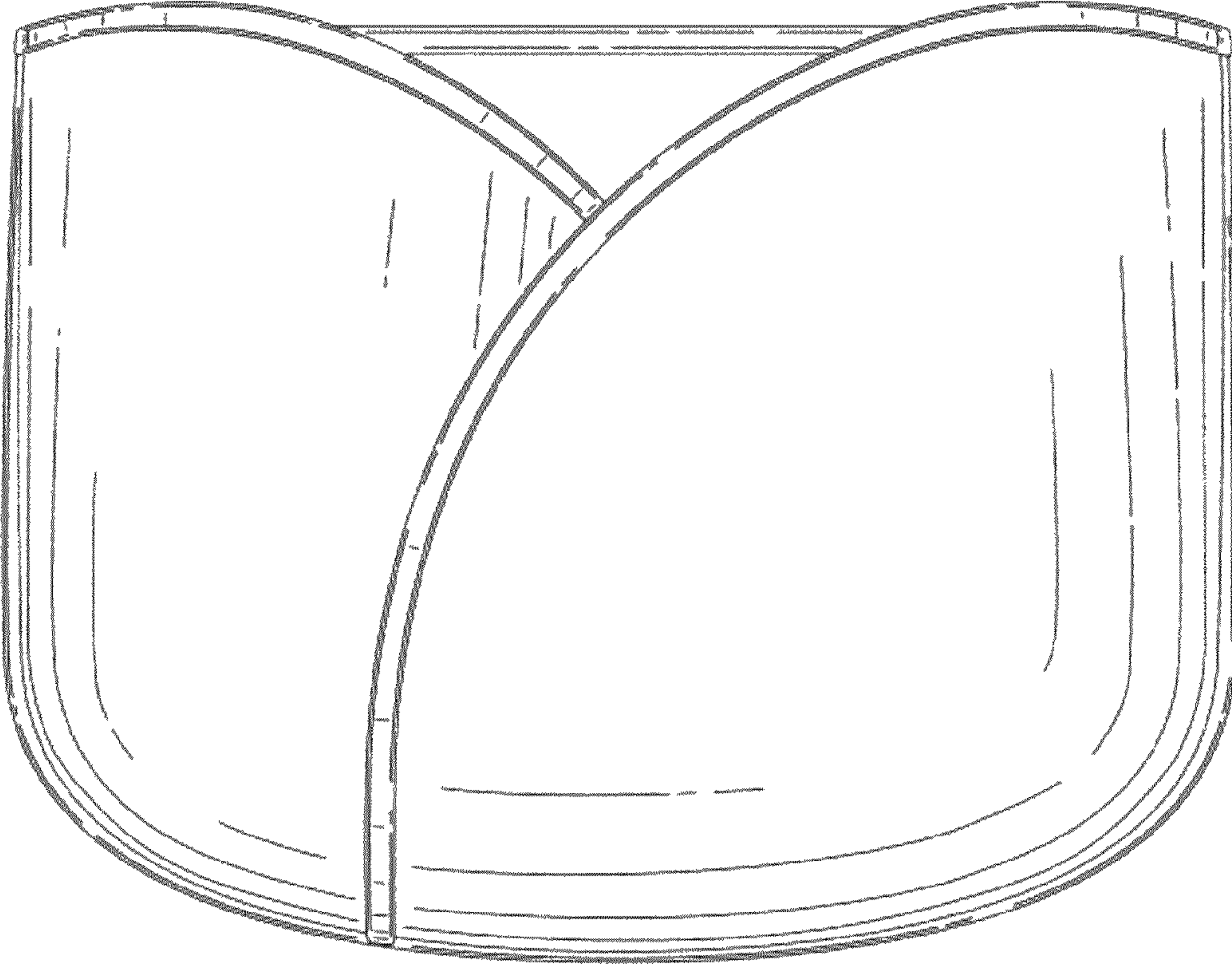

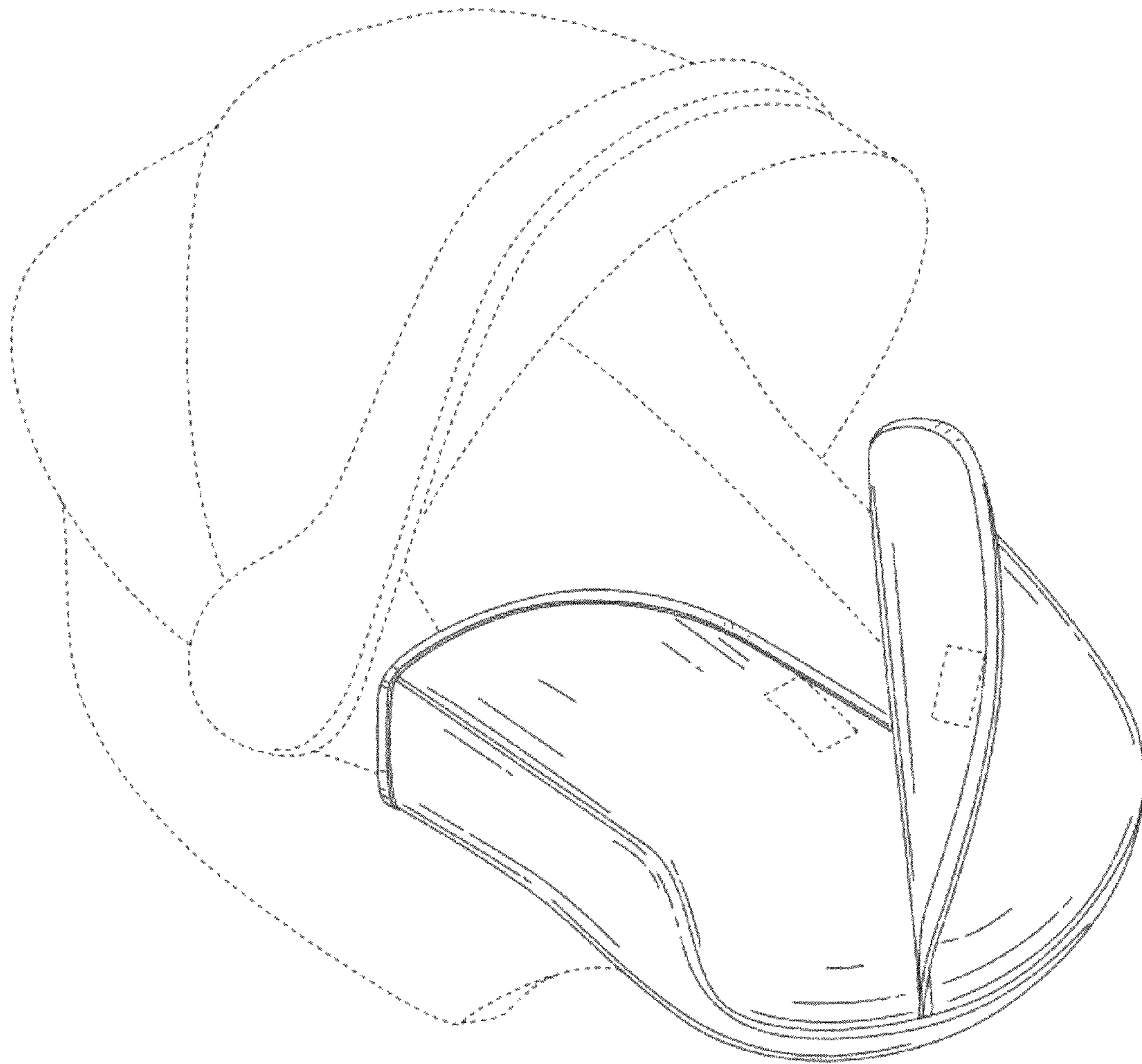

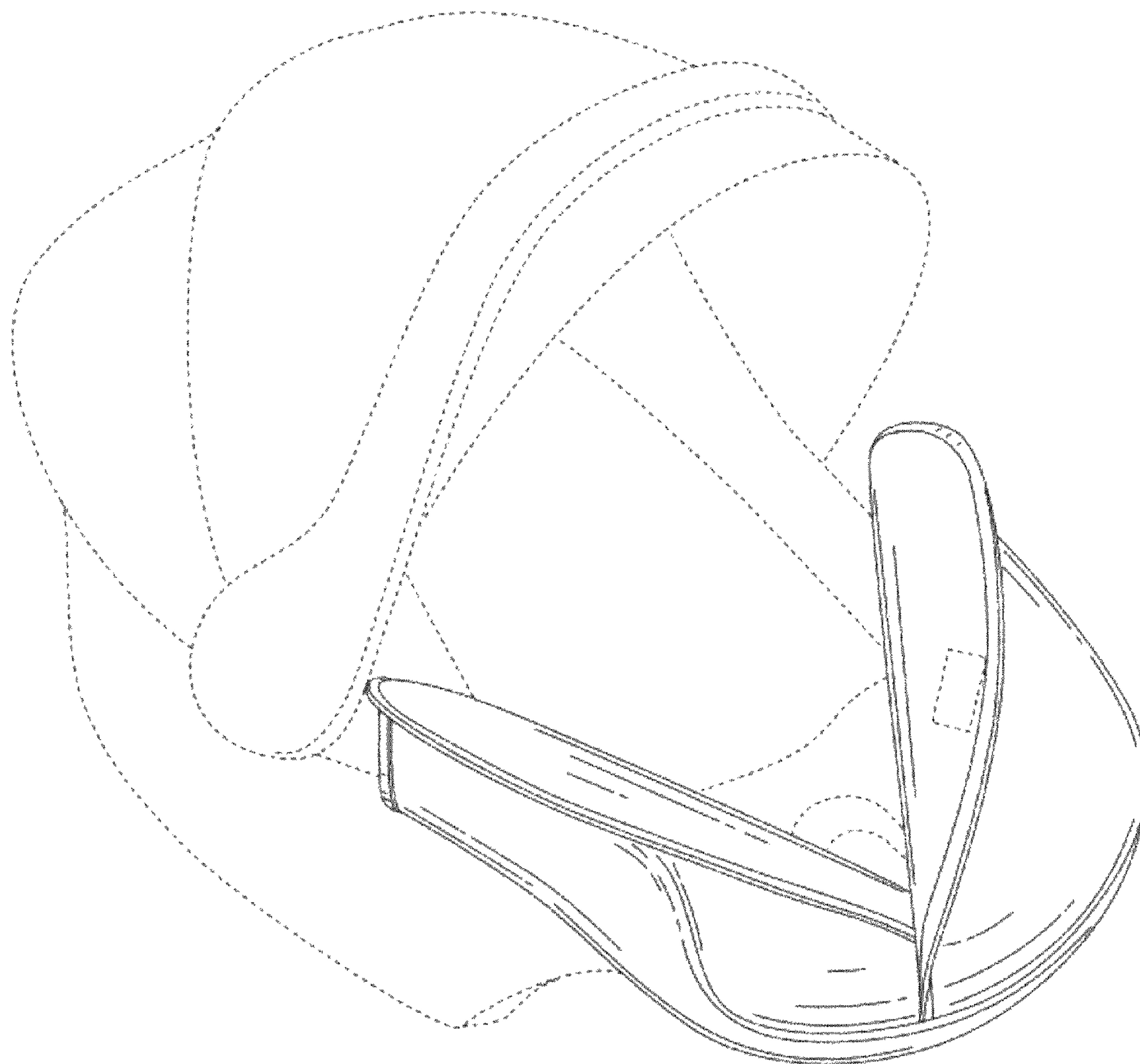
