(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for the folded towel dispenser, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a left-side view of the folded towel dispenser.

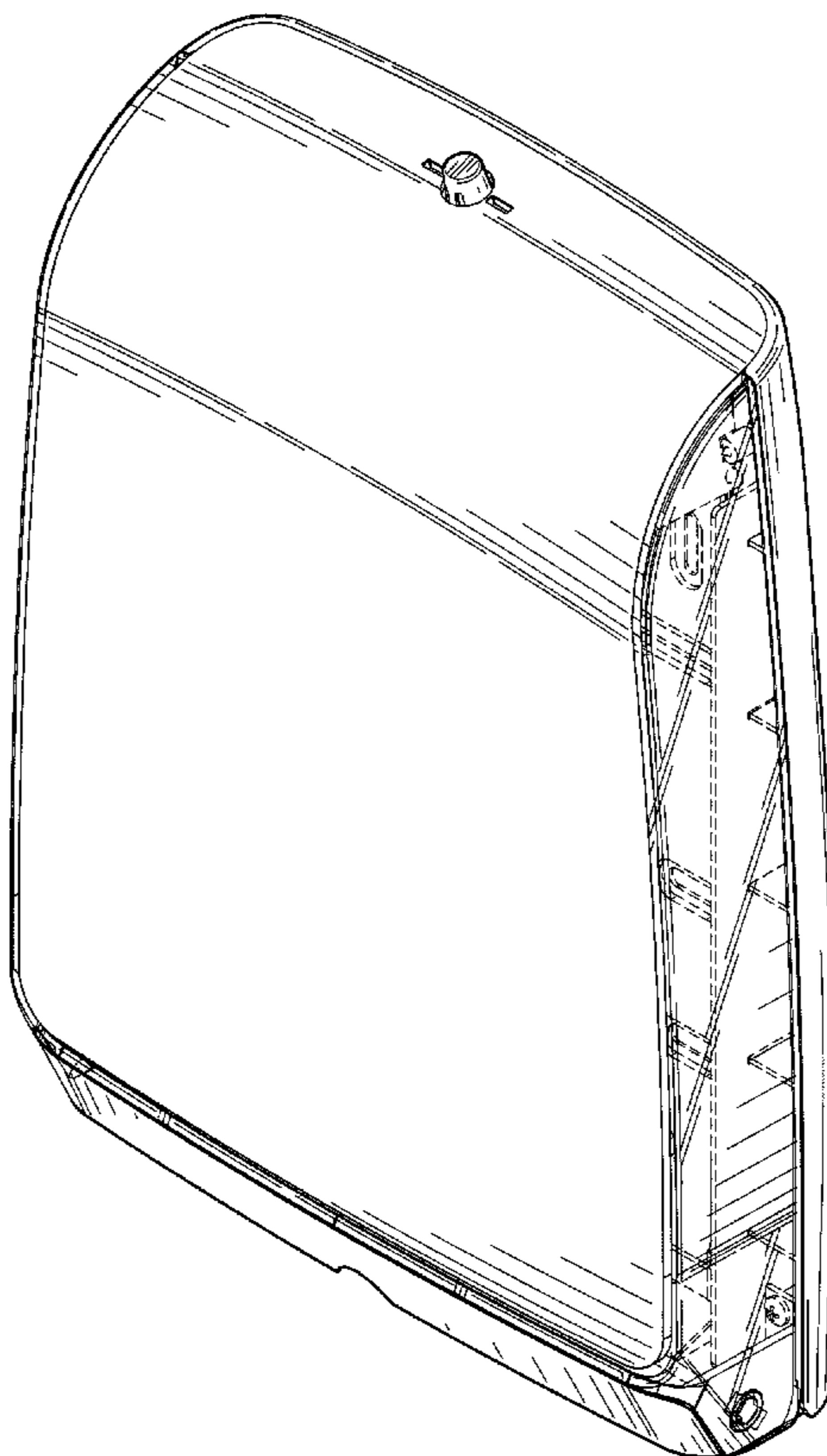
FIG. 5 is a back view of the folded towel dispenser.

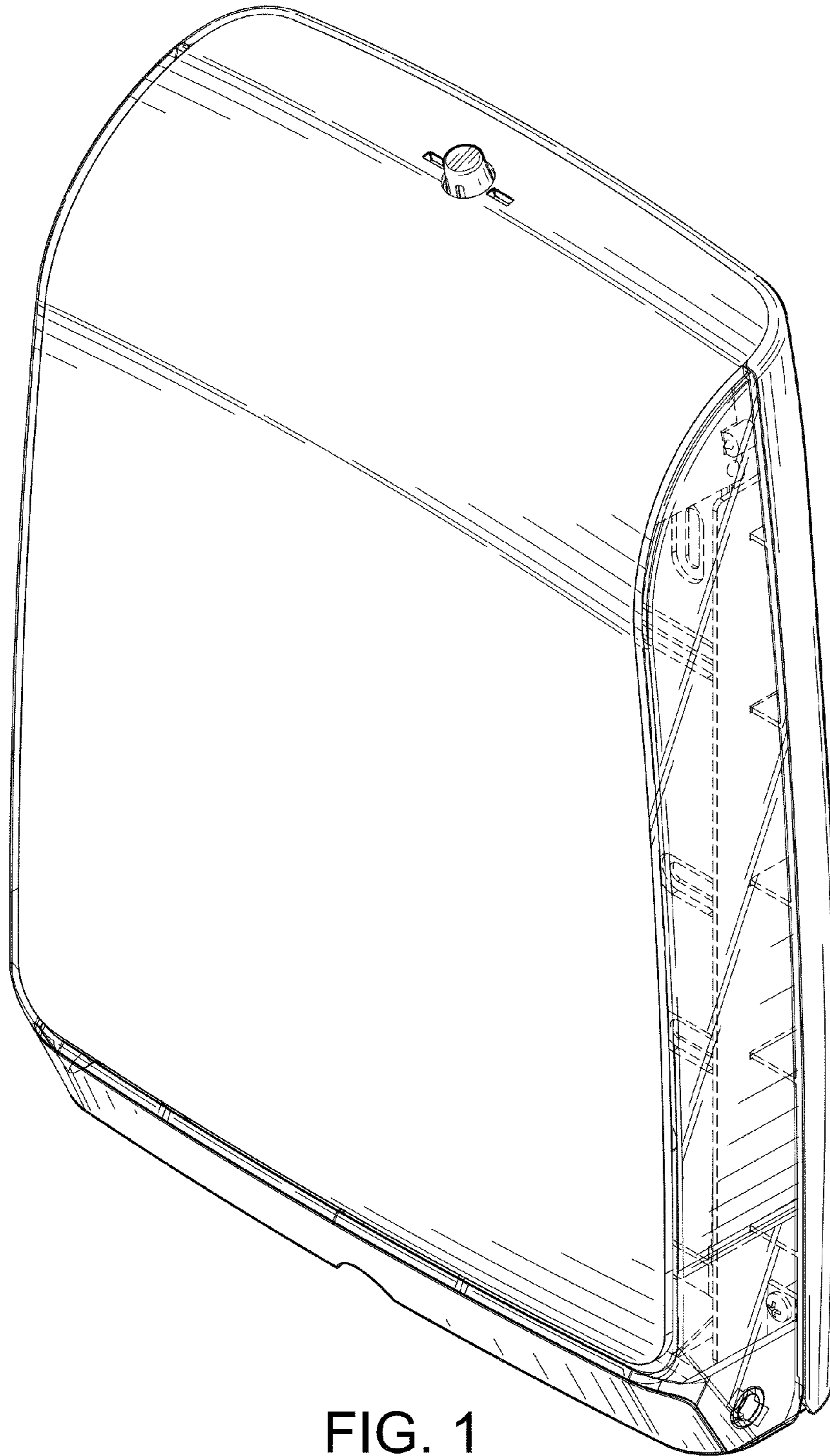

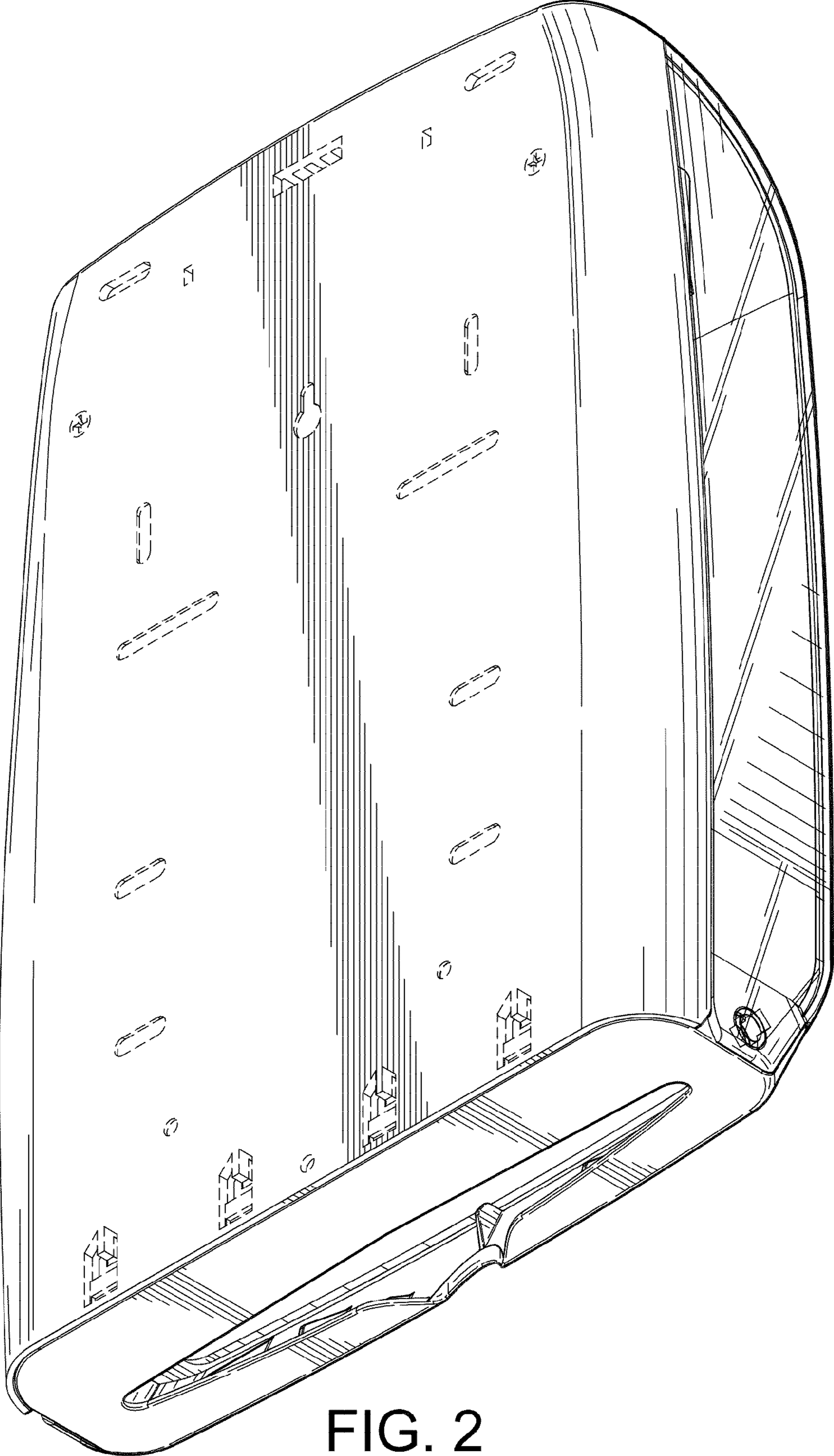

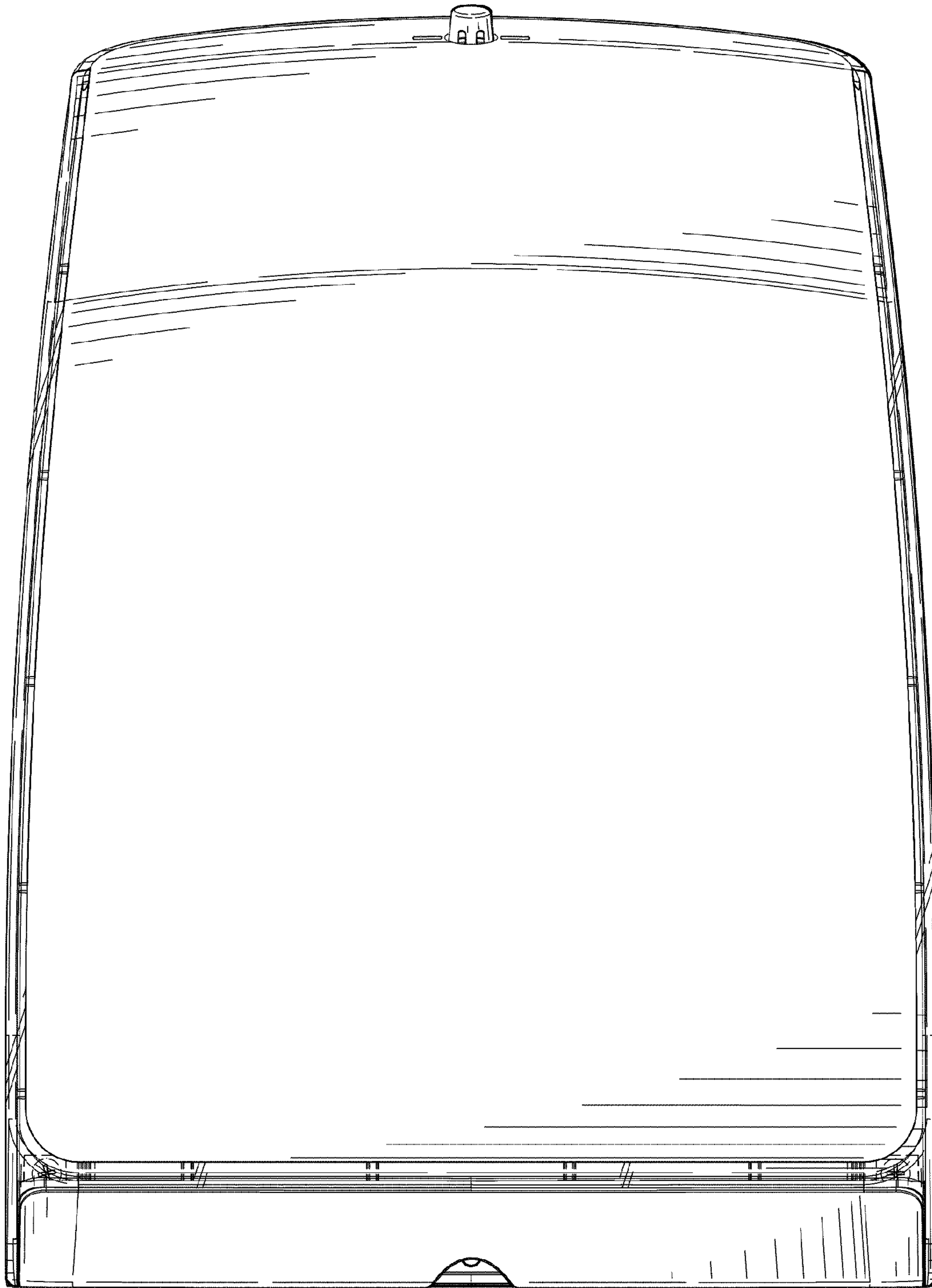

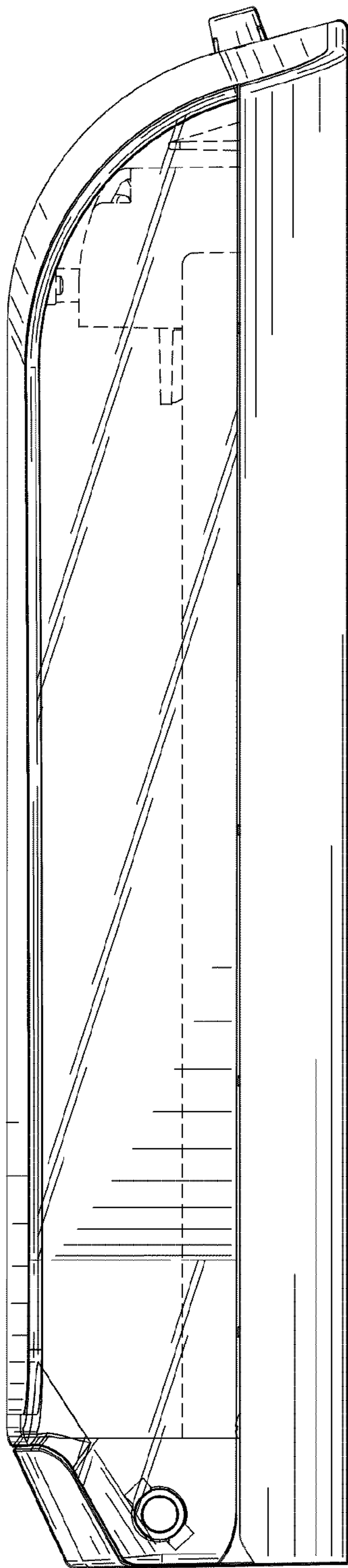

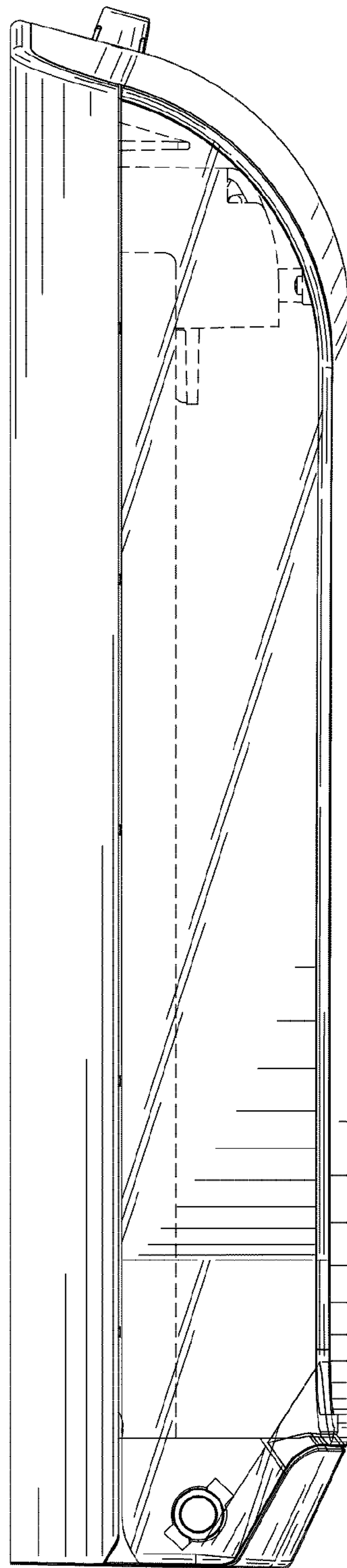

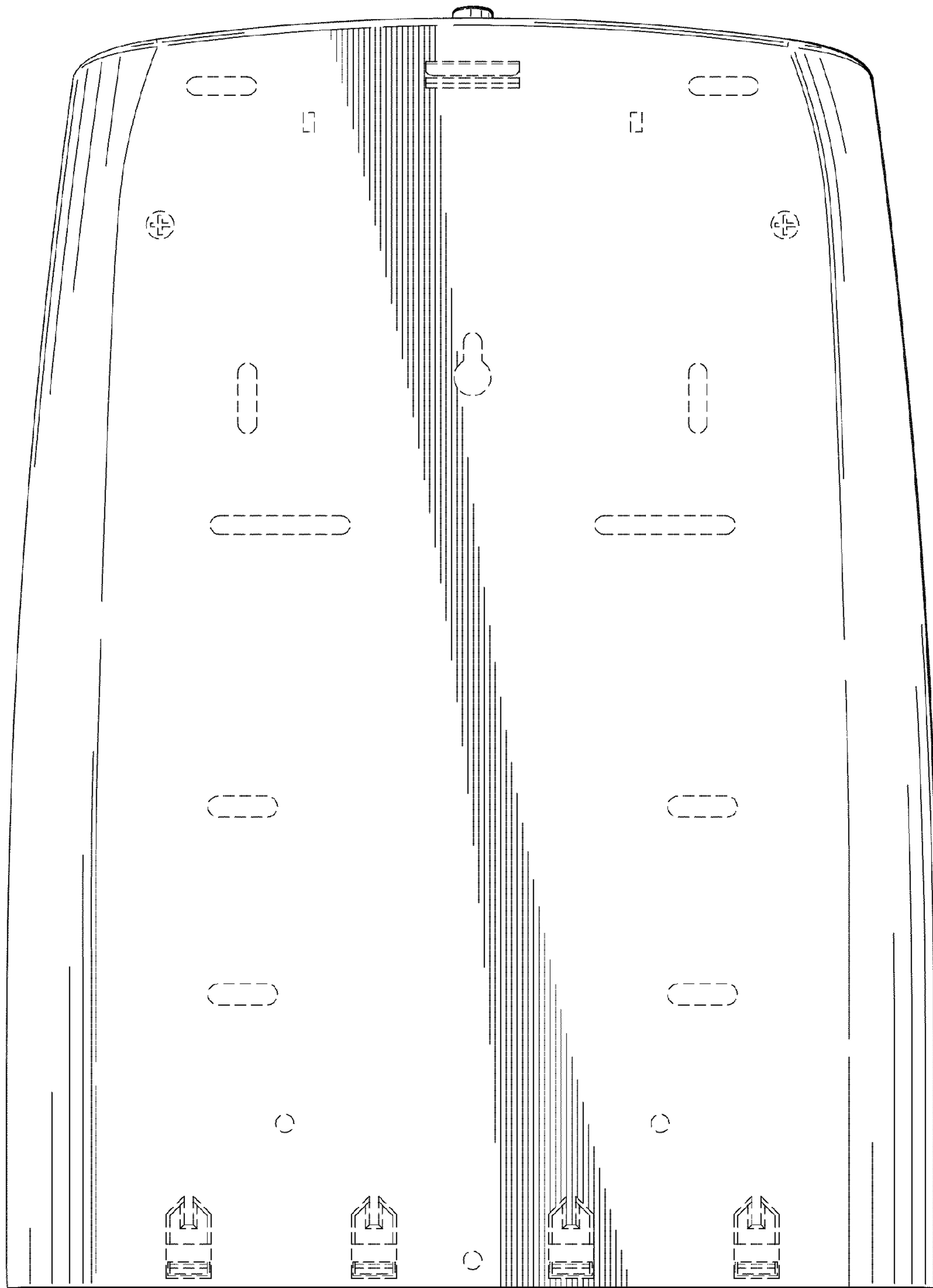

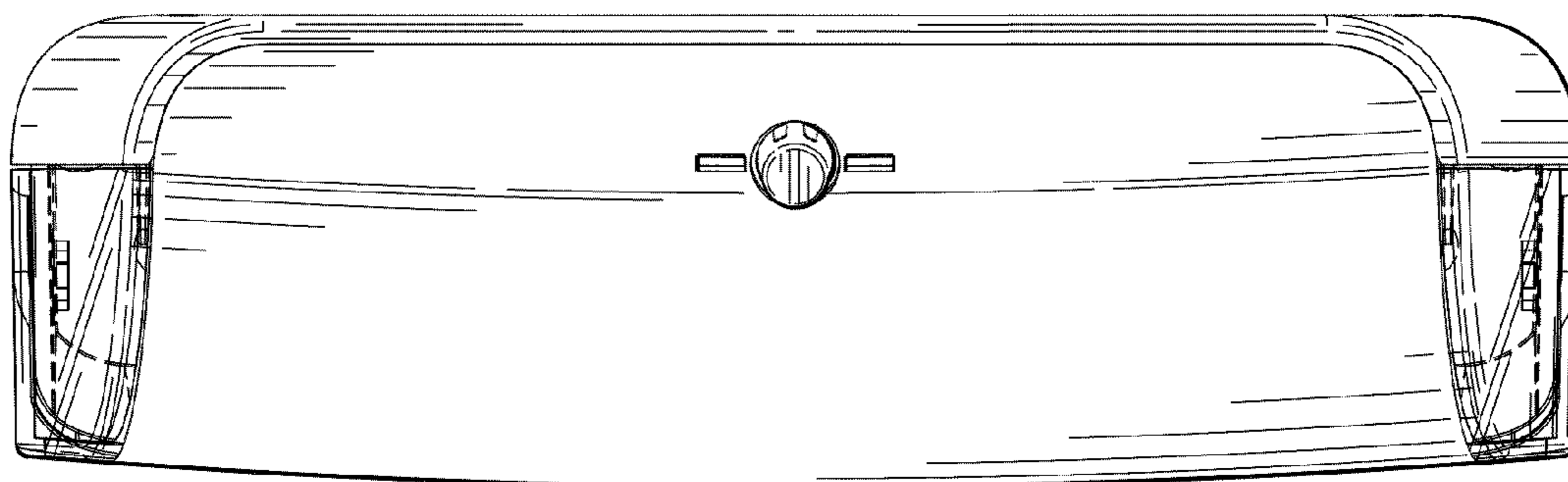

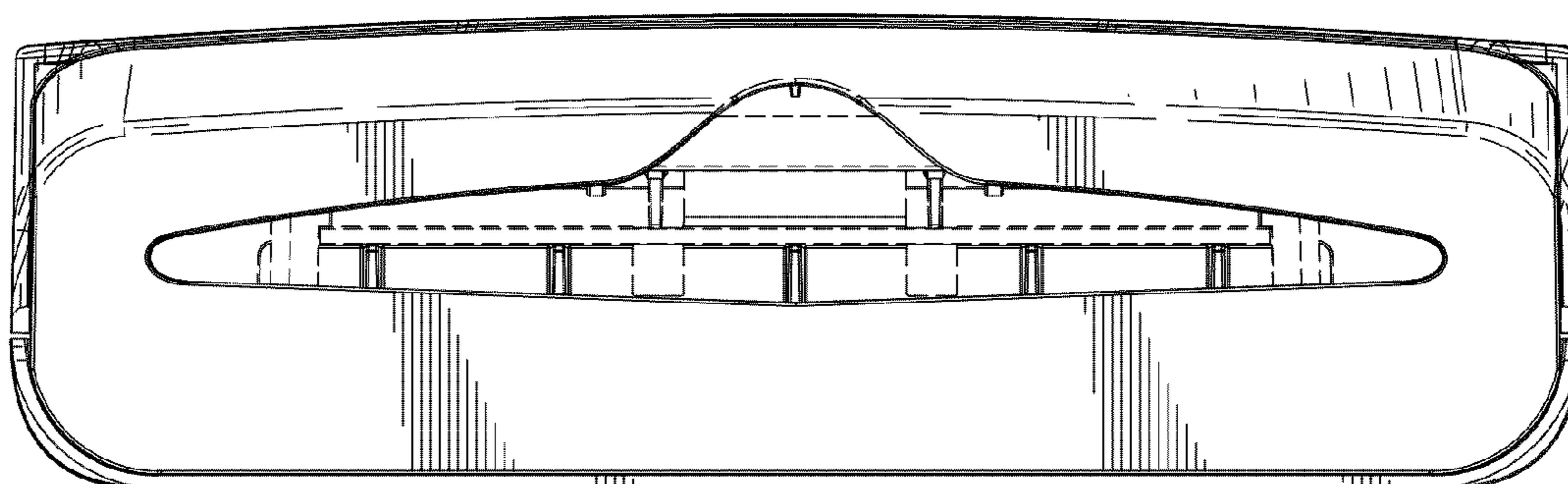
