(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pocketknife, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the design for a pocketknife shown in a closed position;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the pocketknife of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the pocketknife of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front view of the pocketknife of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a back view of the pocketknife of FIG. 1;

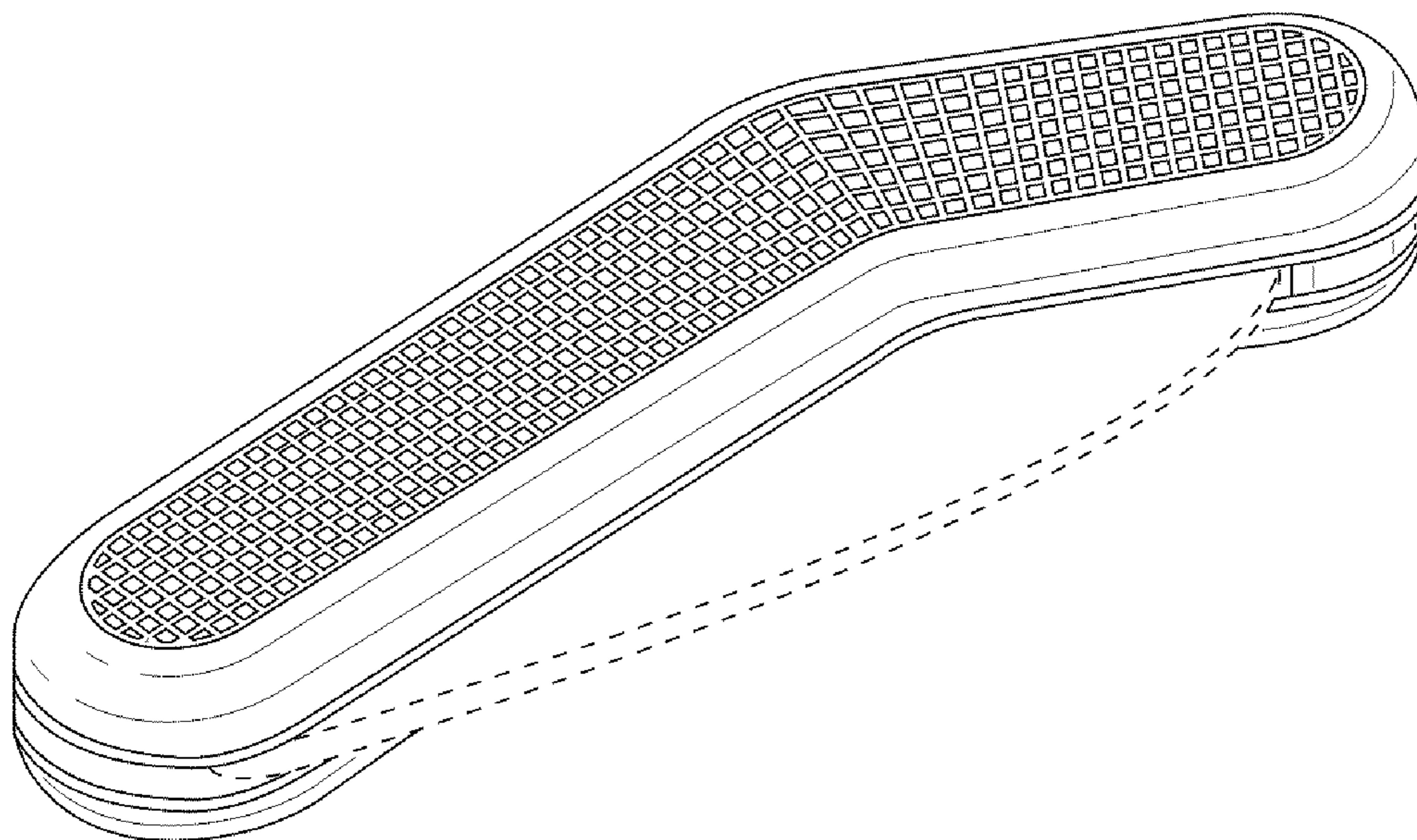
FIG. 6 is a first side view of the pocketknife of FIG. 1;

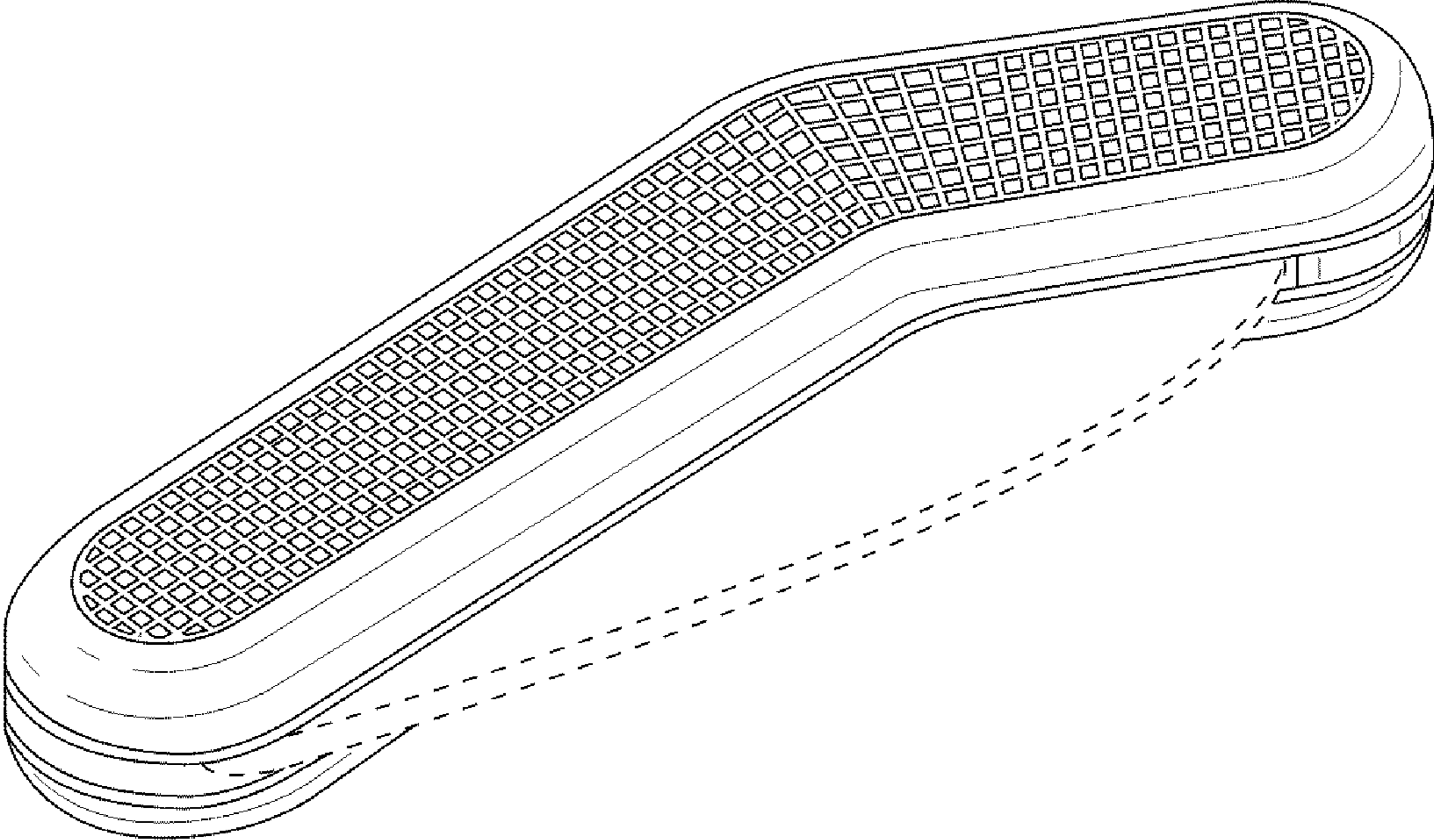

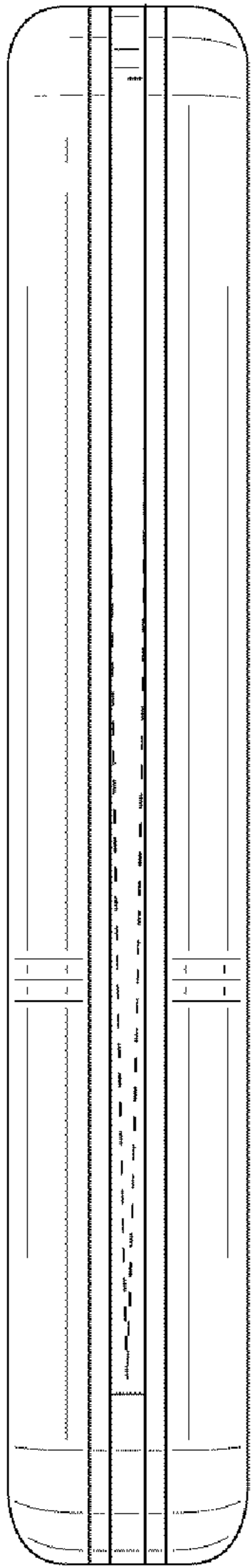

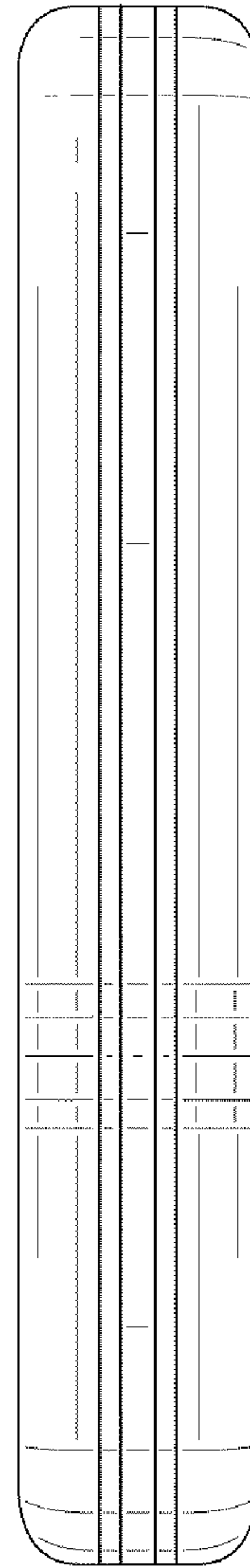

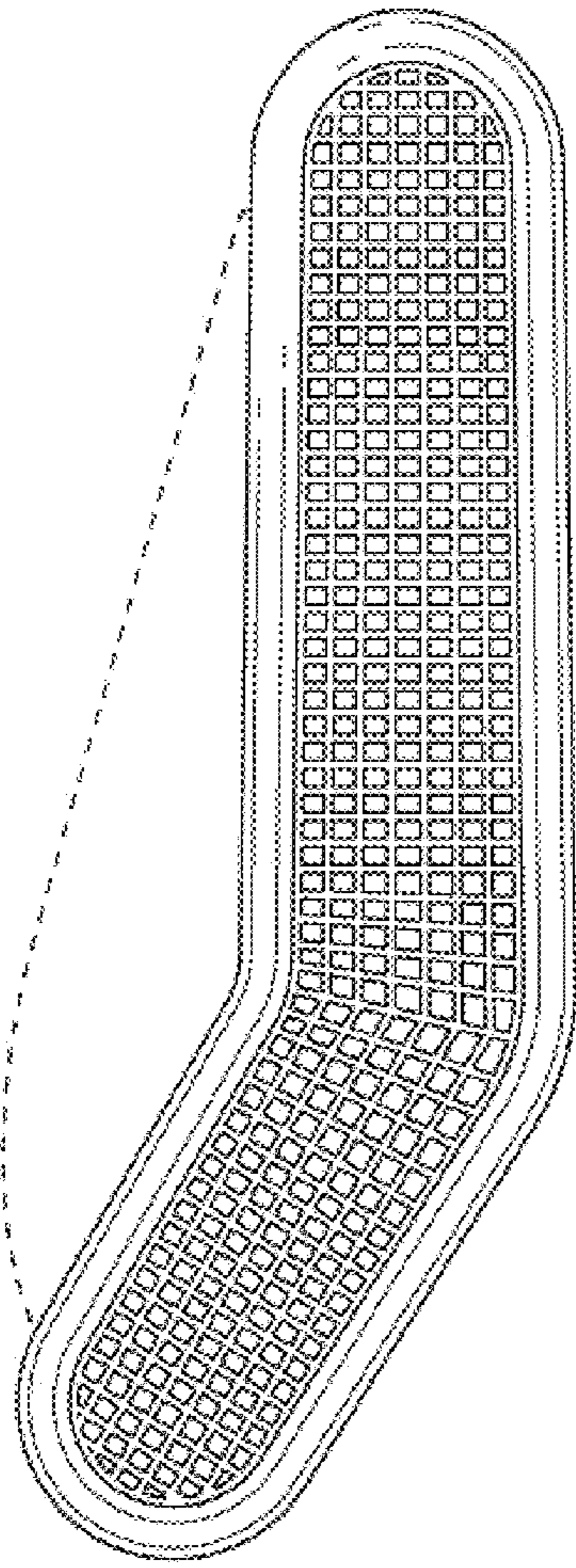

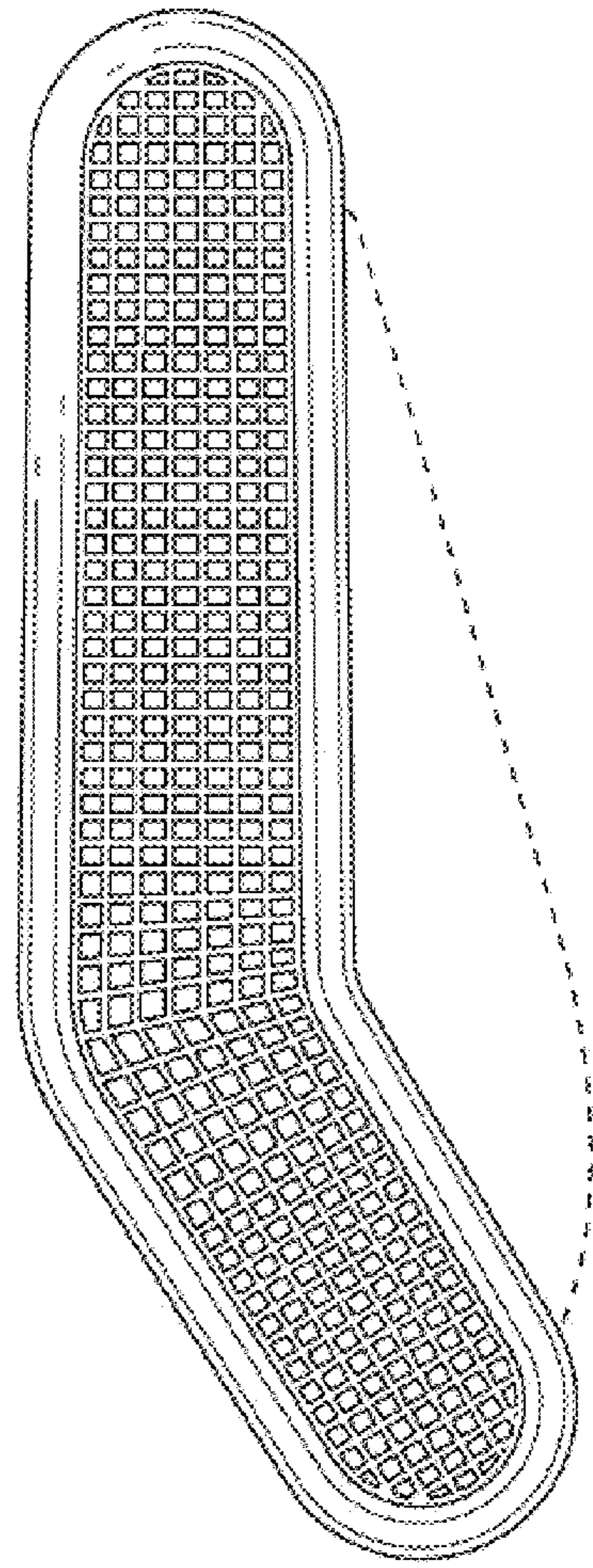

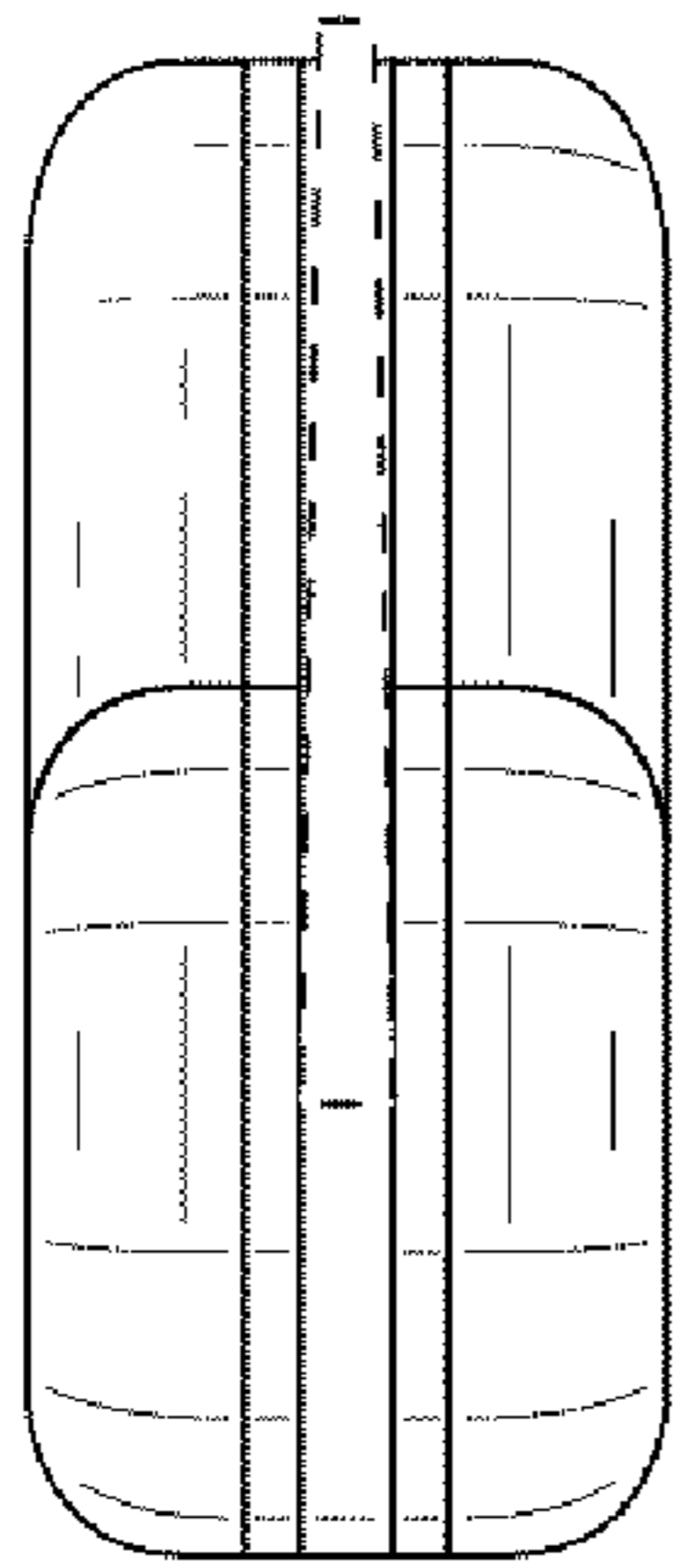

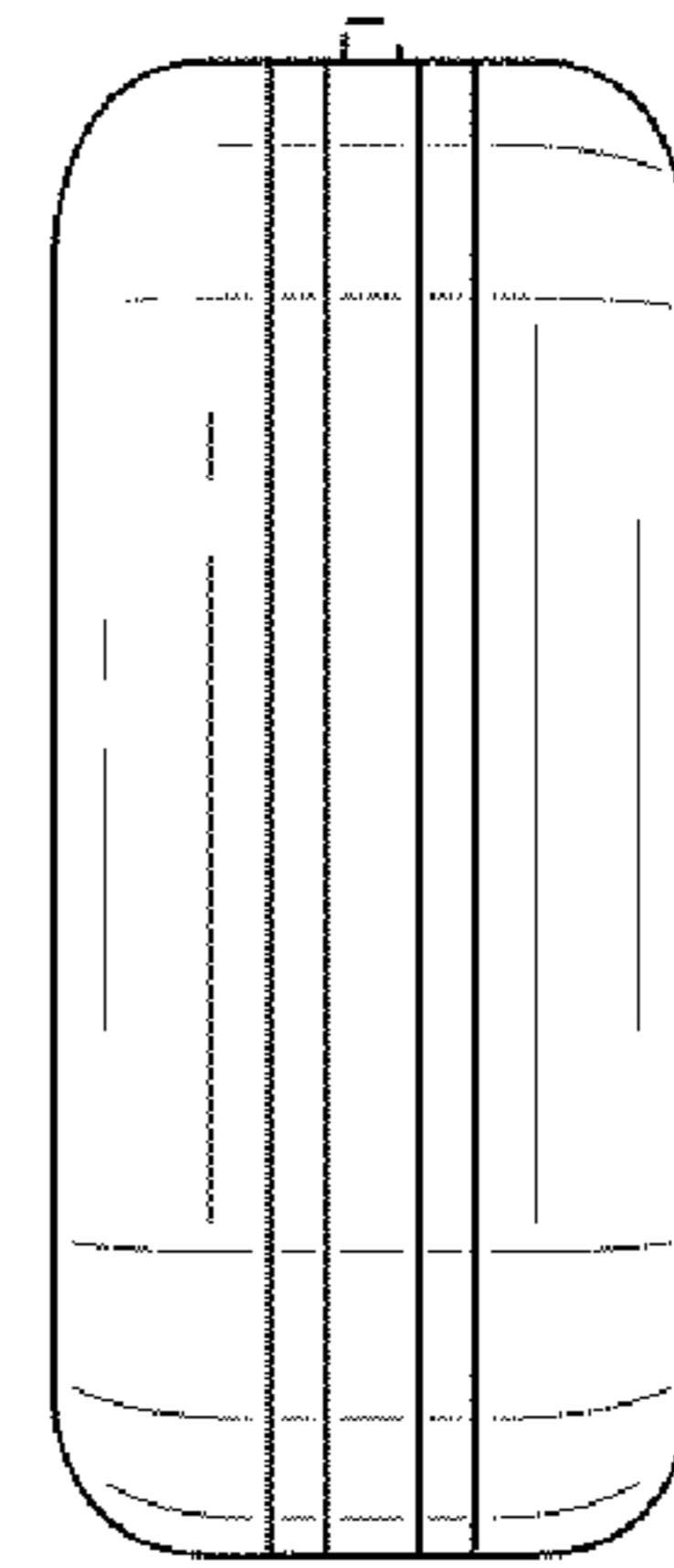

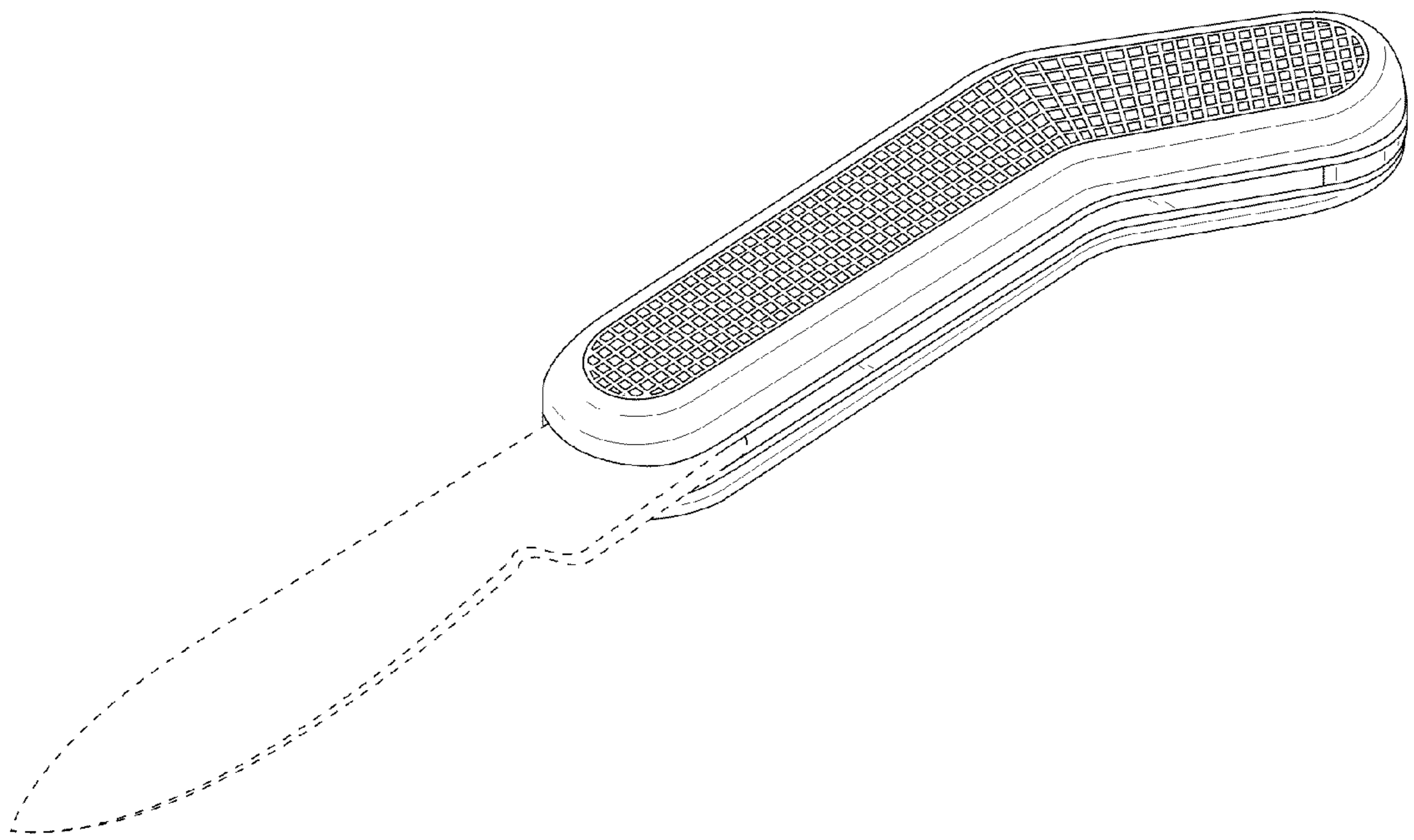
