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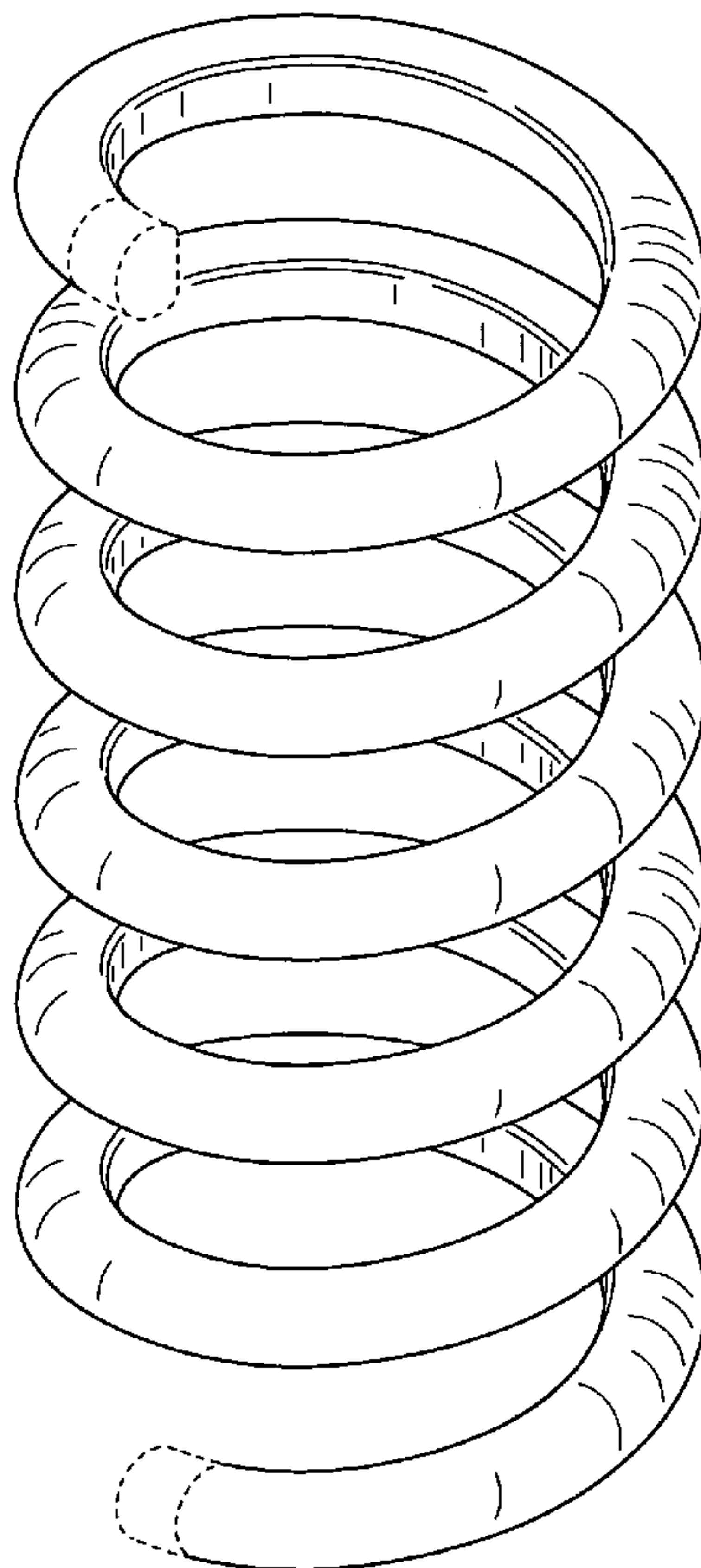
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an insect repellant showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the insect repellant shown in FIG. 1 (with the rear side being a mirror image thereof);
FIG. 3 is a side view of the insect repellant shown in FIG. 1 (with the other side view being a mirror image thereof);
FIG. 4 is a top view of the insect repellant shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the insect repellant shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of the insect repellant shown in FIG. 1, shown in the environment of a cylindrical pole.
The broken lines depicting the end portions of the insect repellant and the cylindrical pole show unclaimed subject matter.

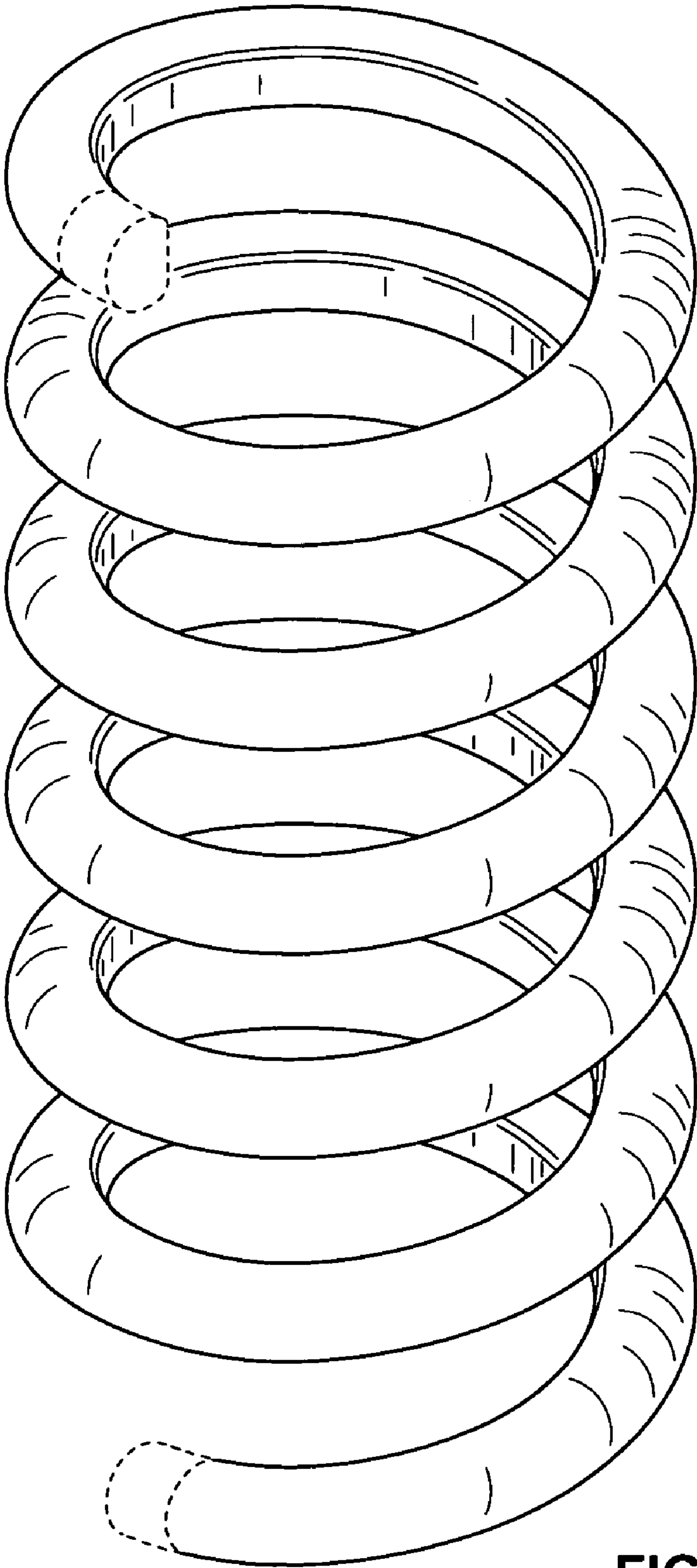

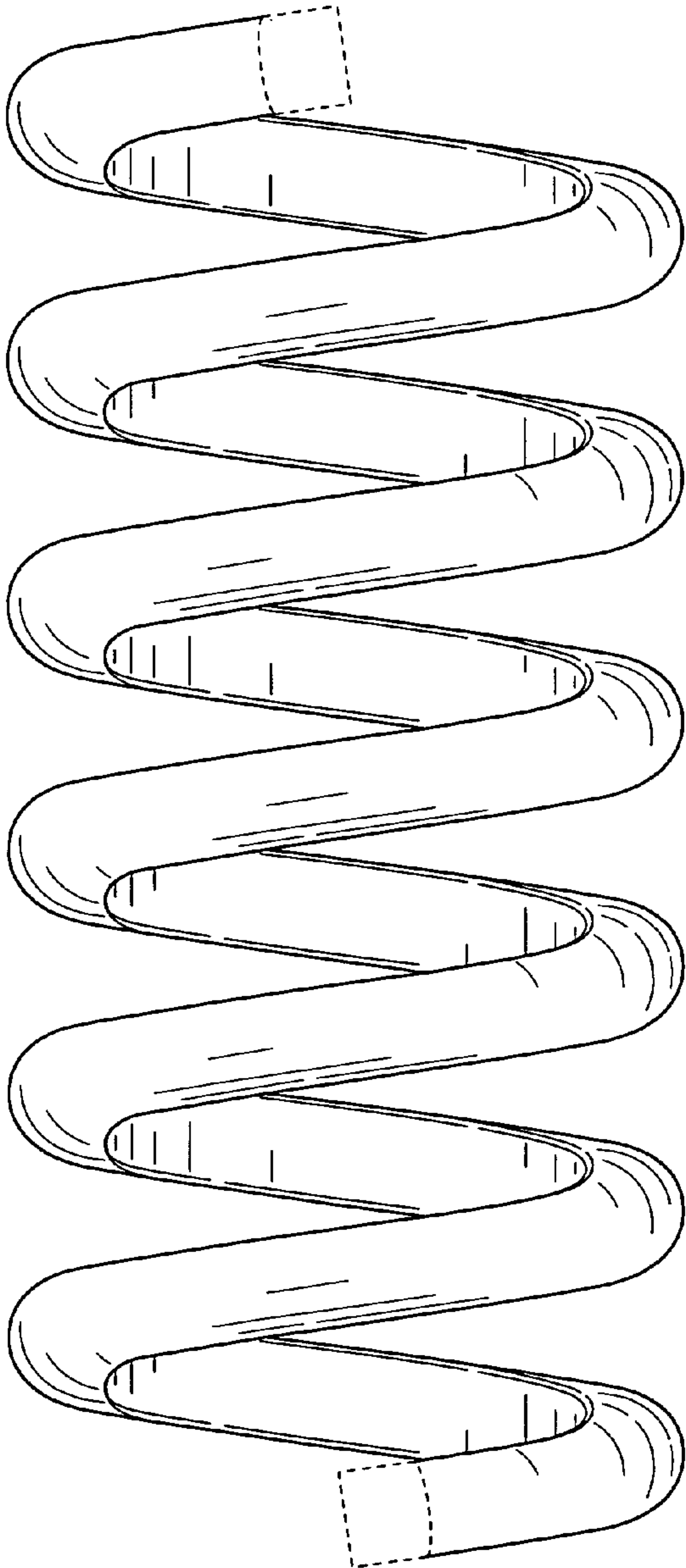

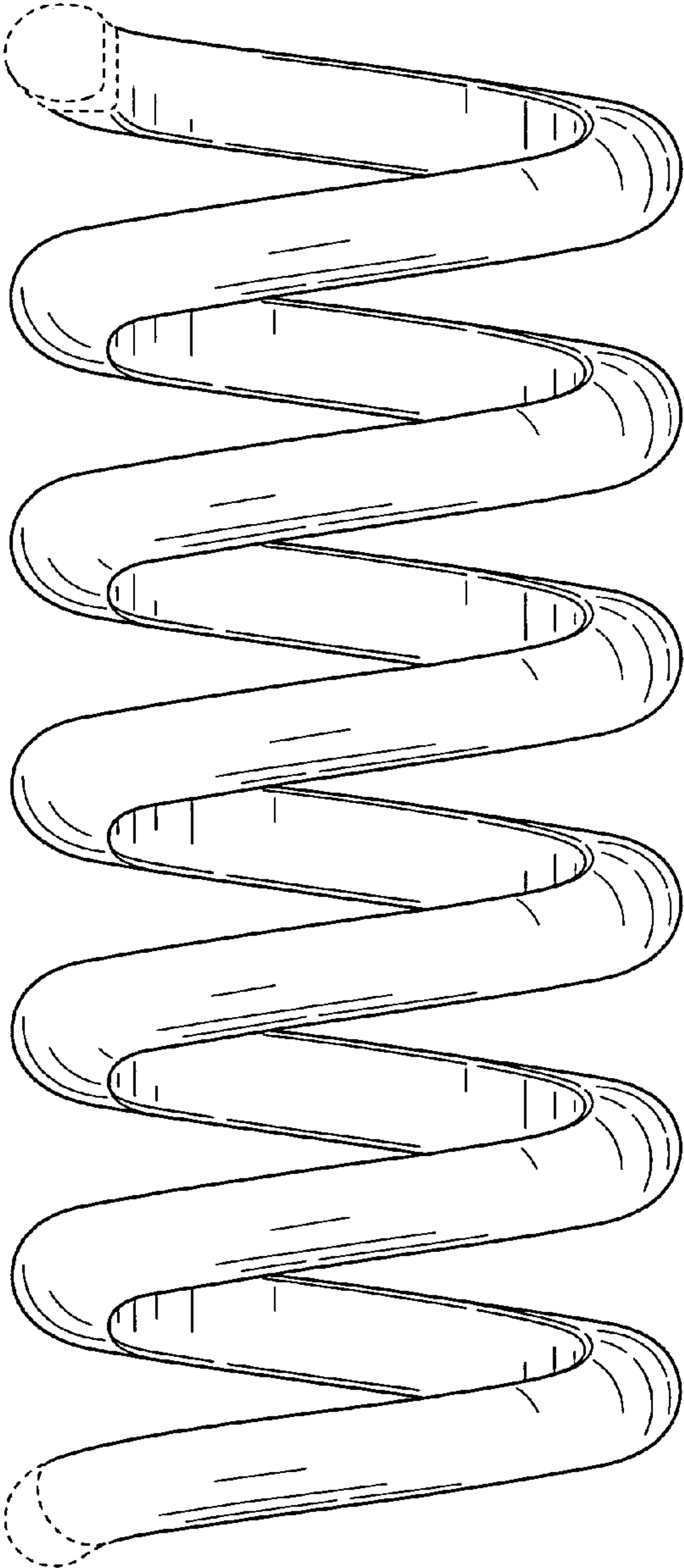

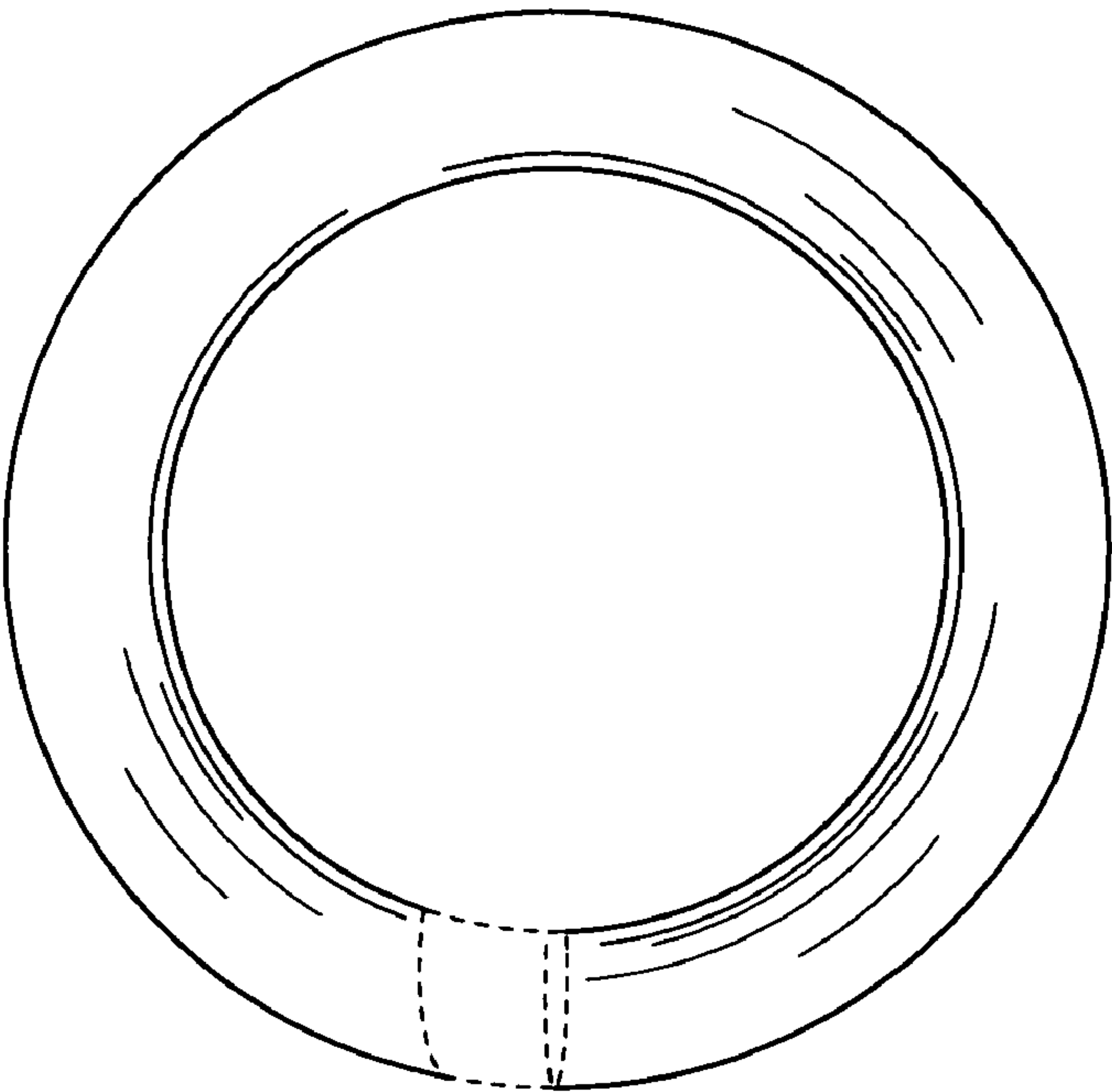

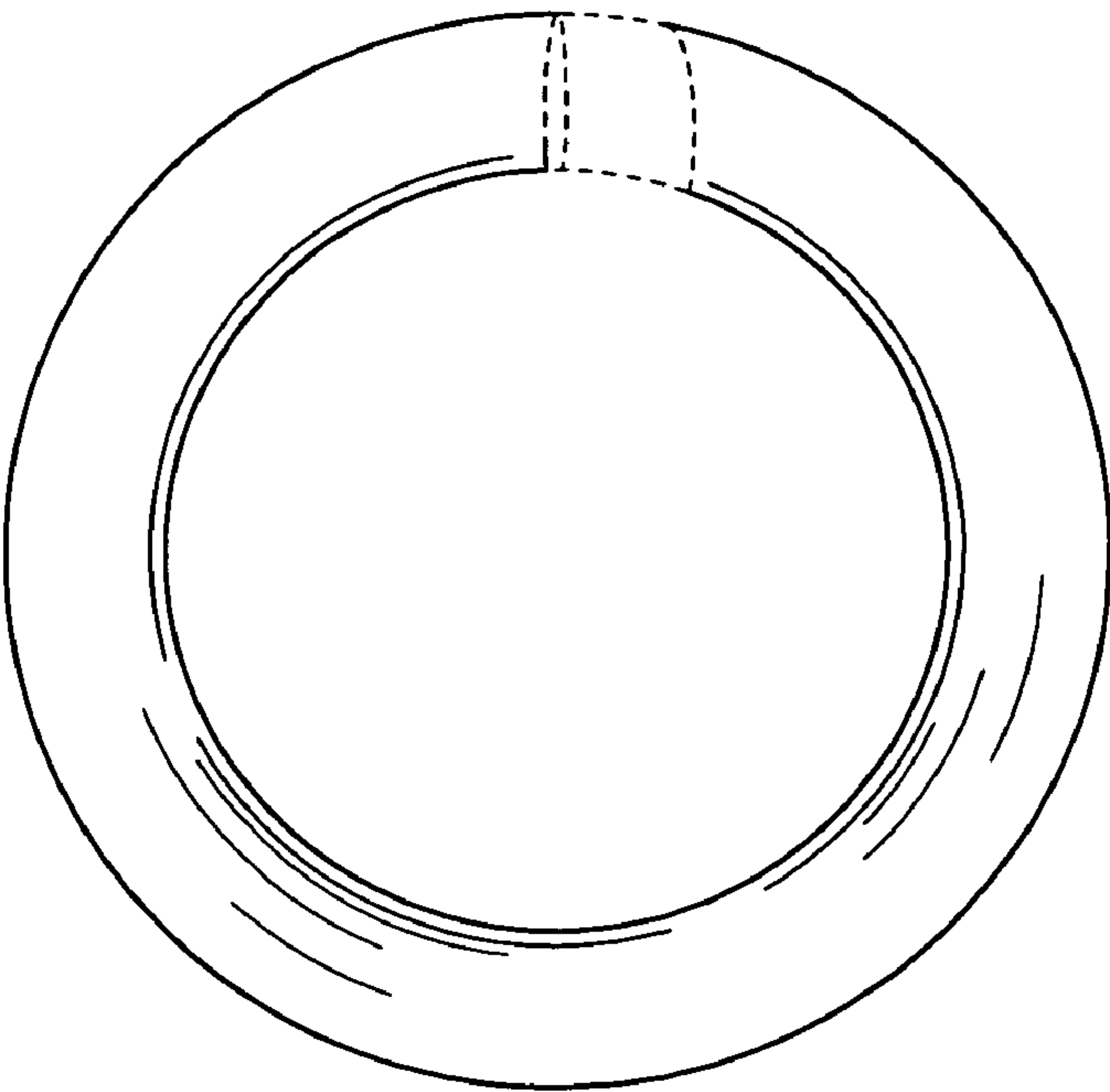

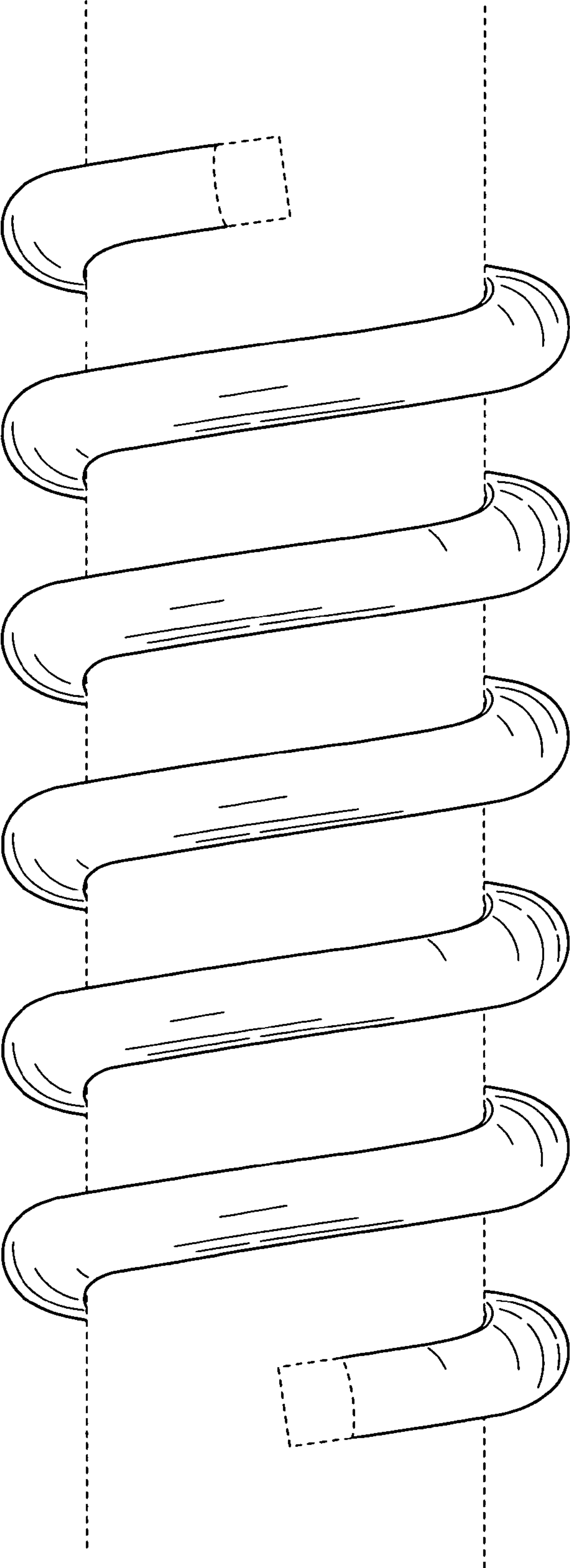
