DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of sleeping bag, showing our new design;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

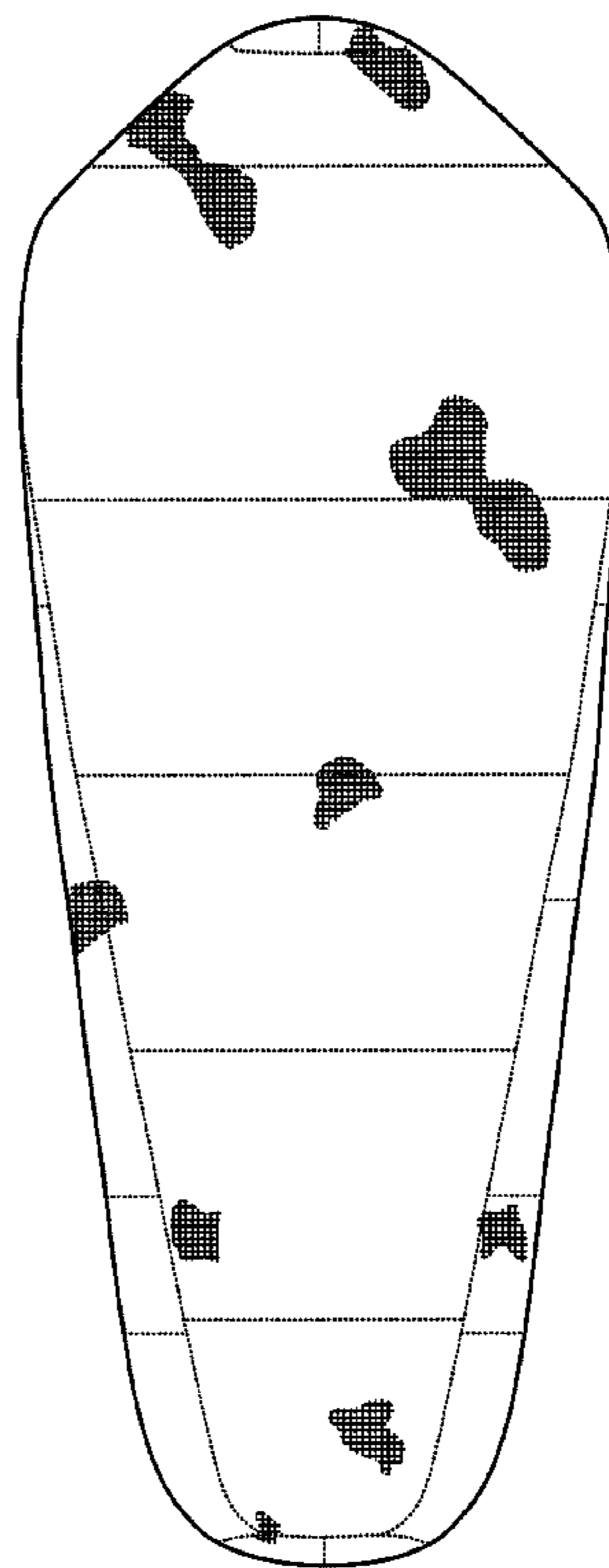
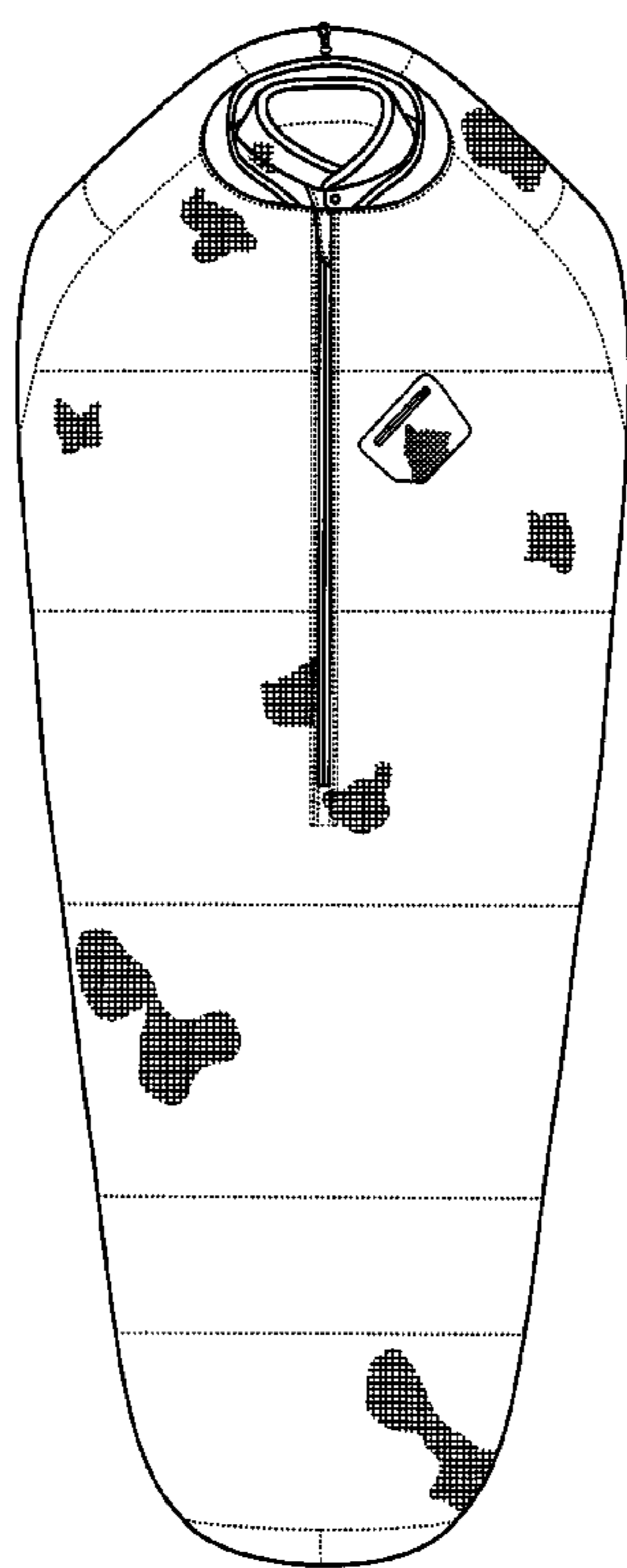
FIG. 5 is an enlarged top view thereof;

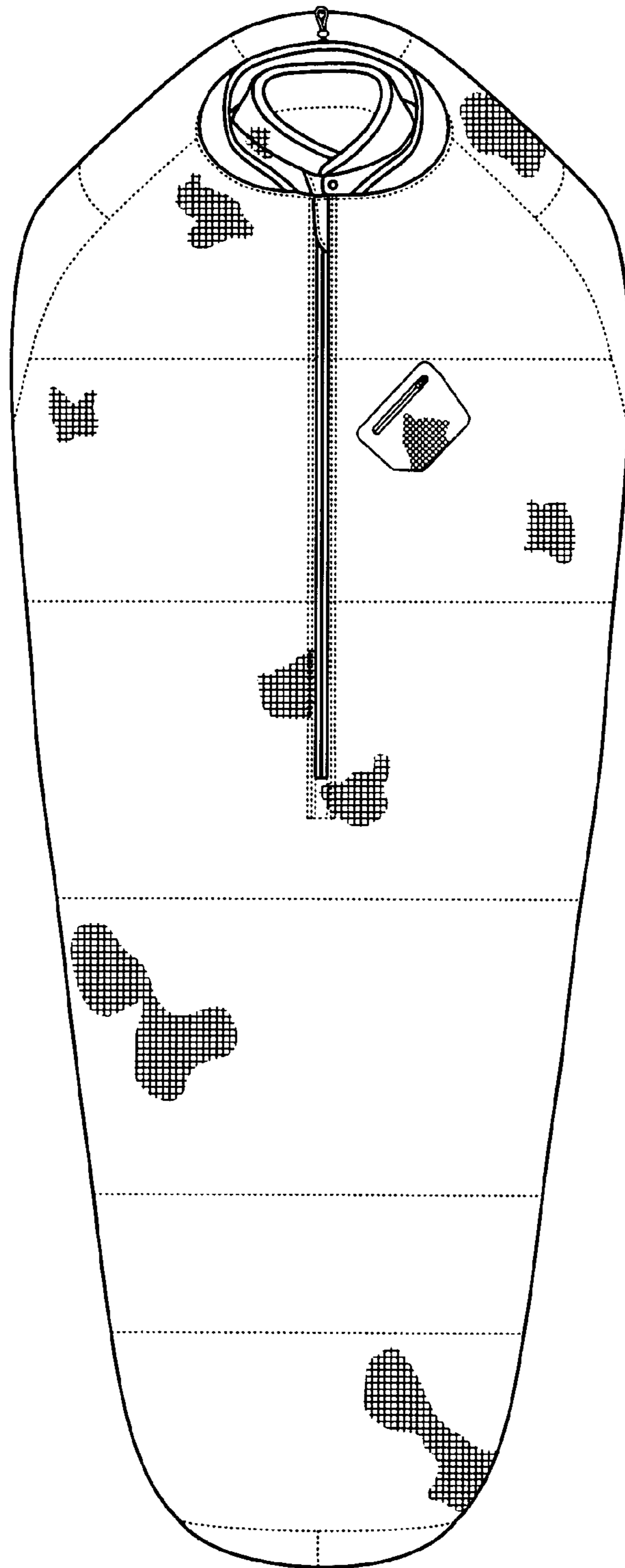

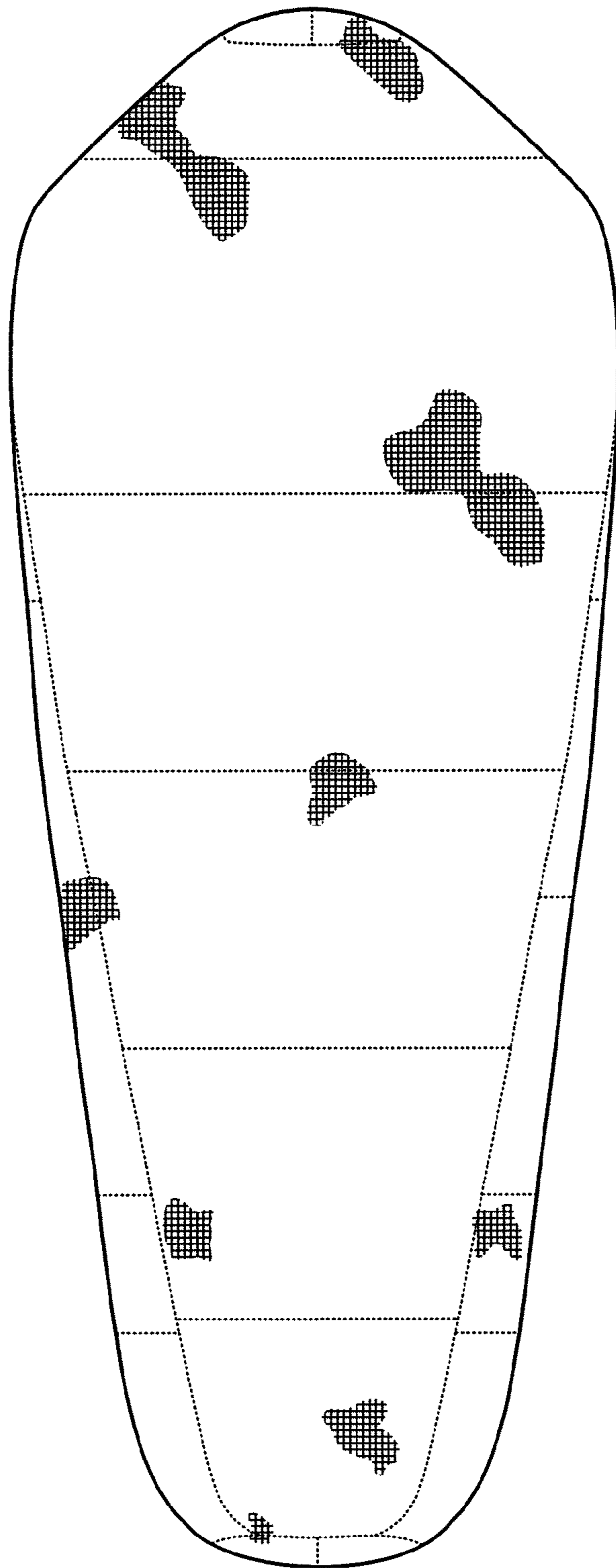

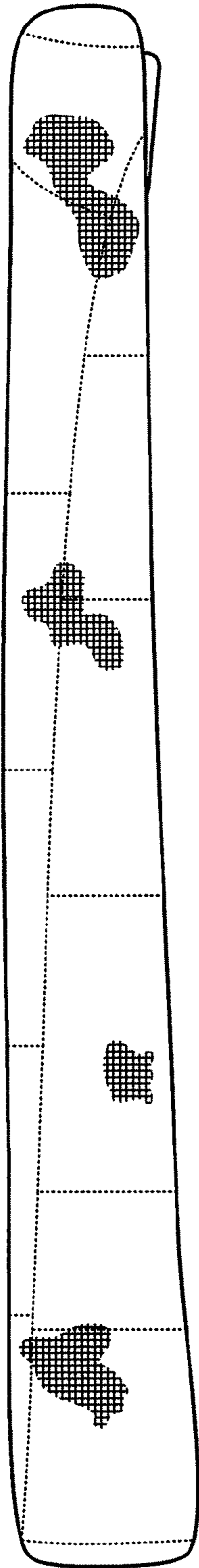

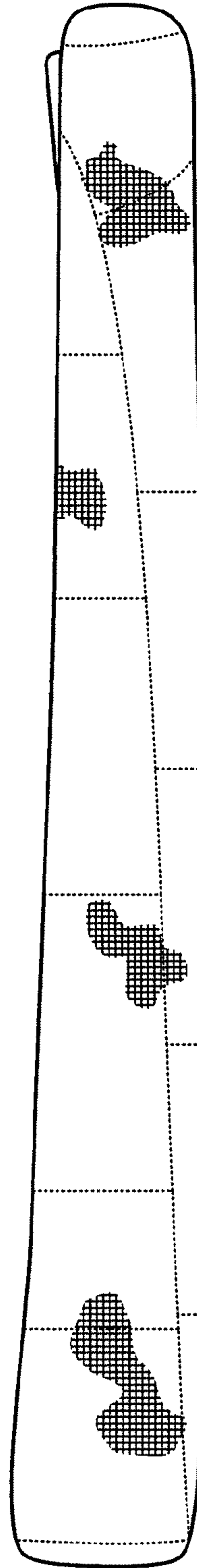

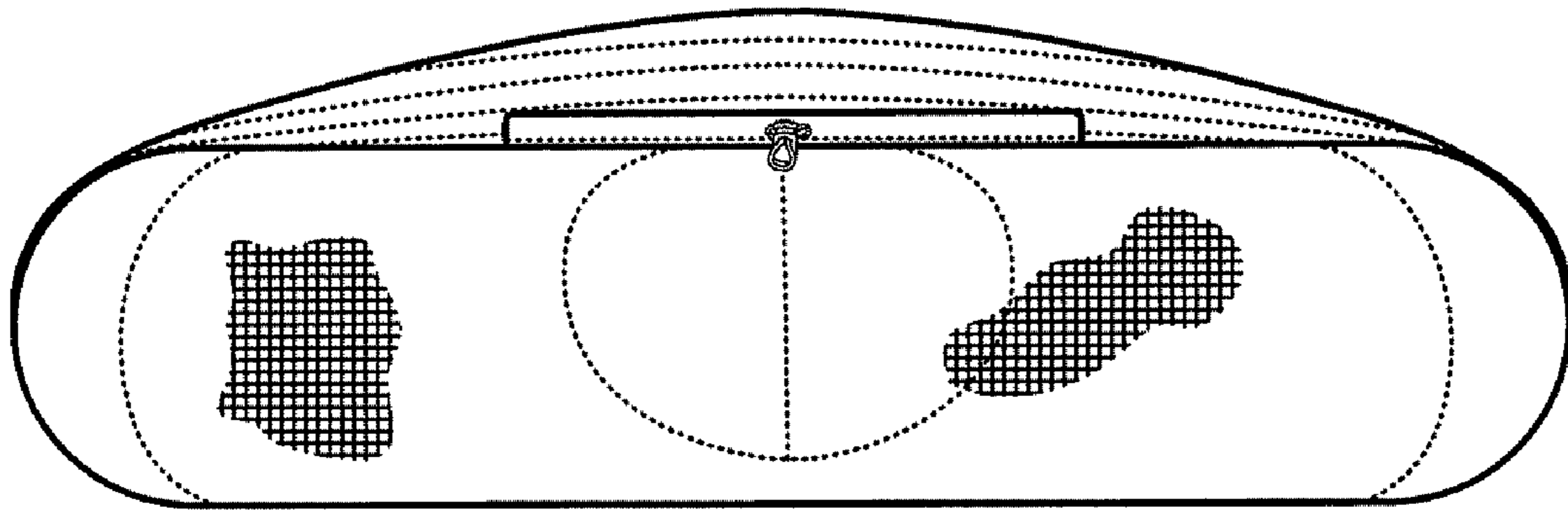

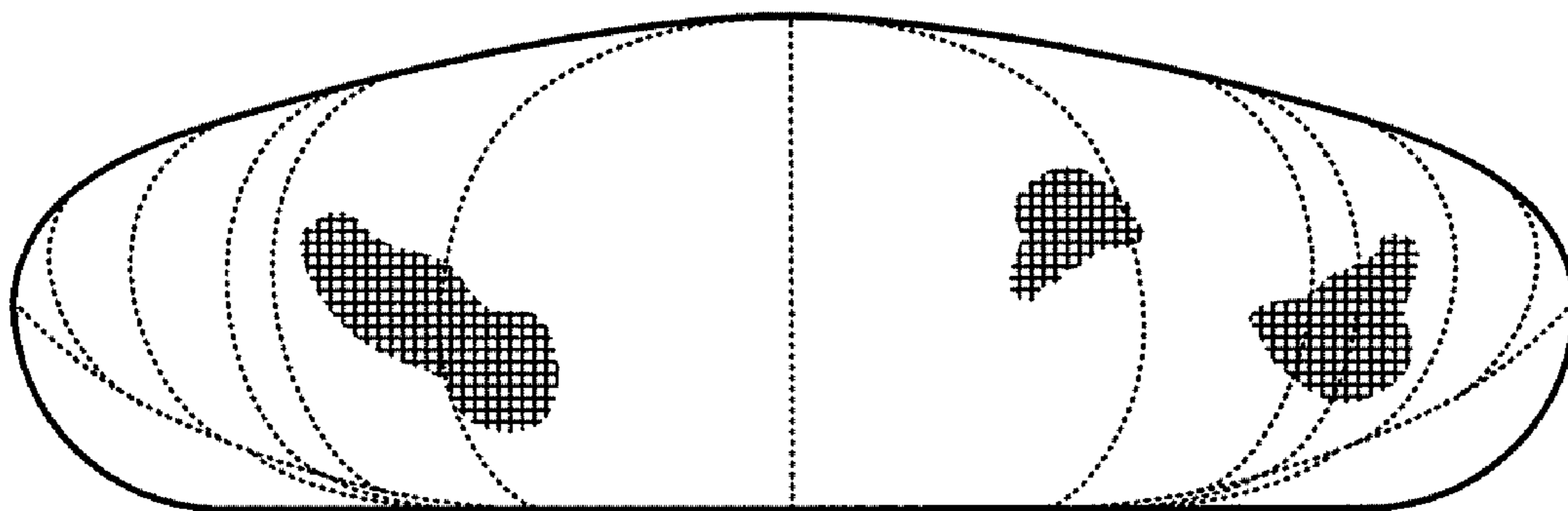

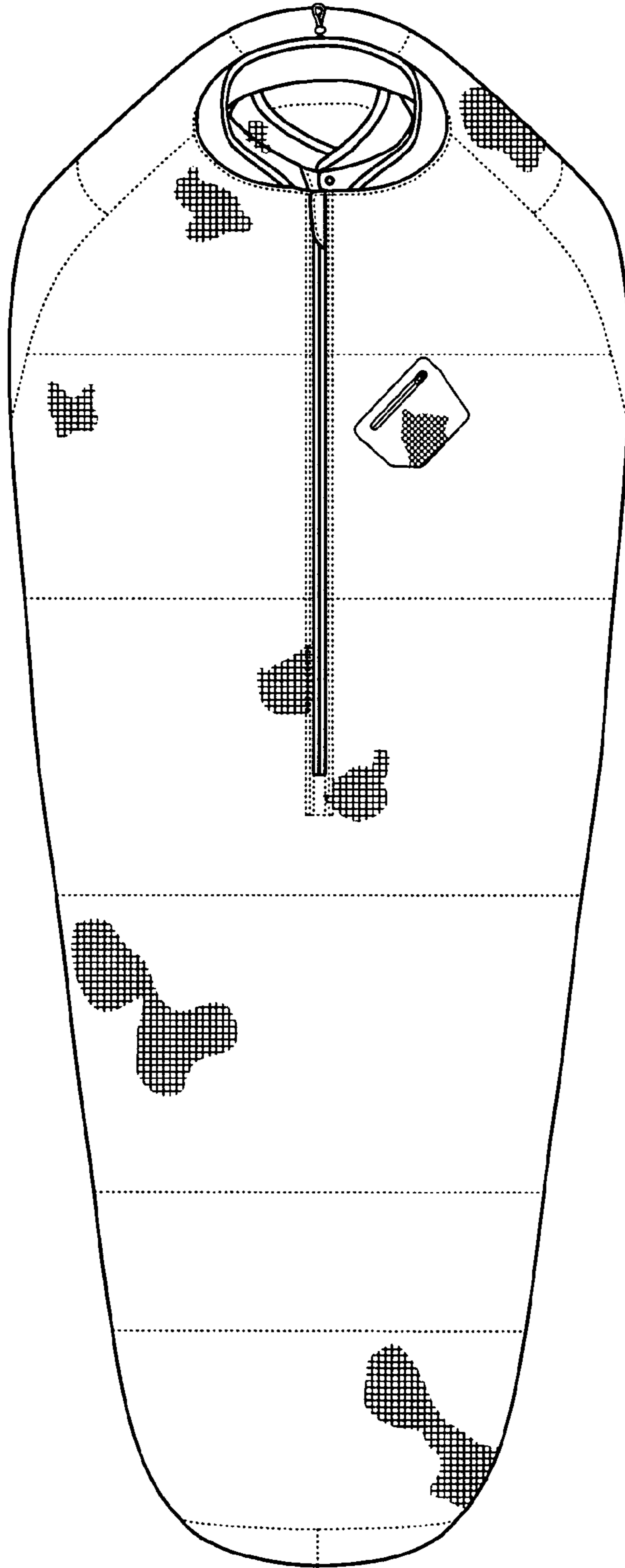
