The ornamental design for a pony cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above of our new design for a pony cap.

FIG. 2 is an elevational view from the rear of the pony cap shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a perspective view from the front and below of the pony cap shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the pony cap shown in FIG. 1.

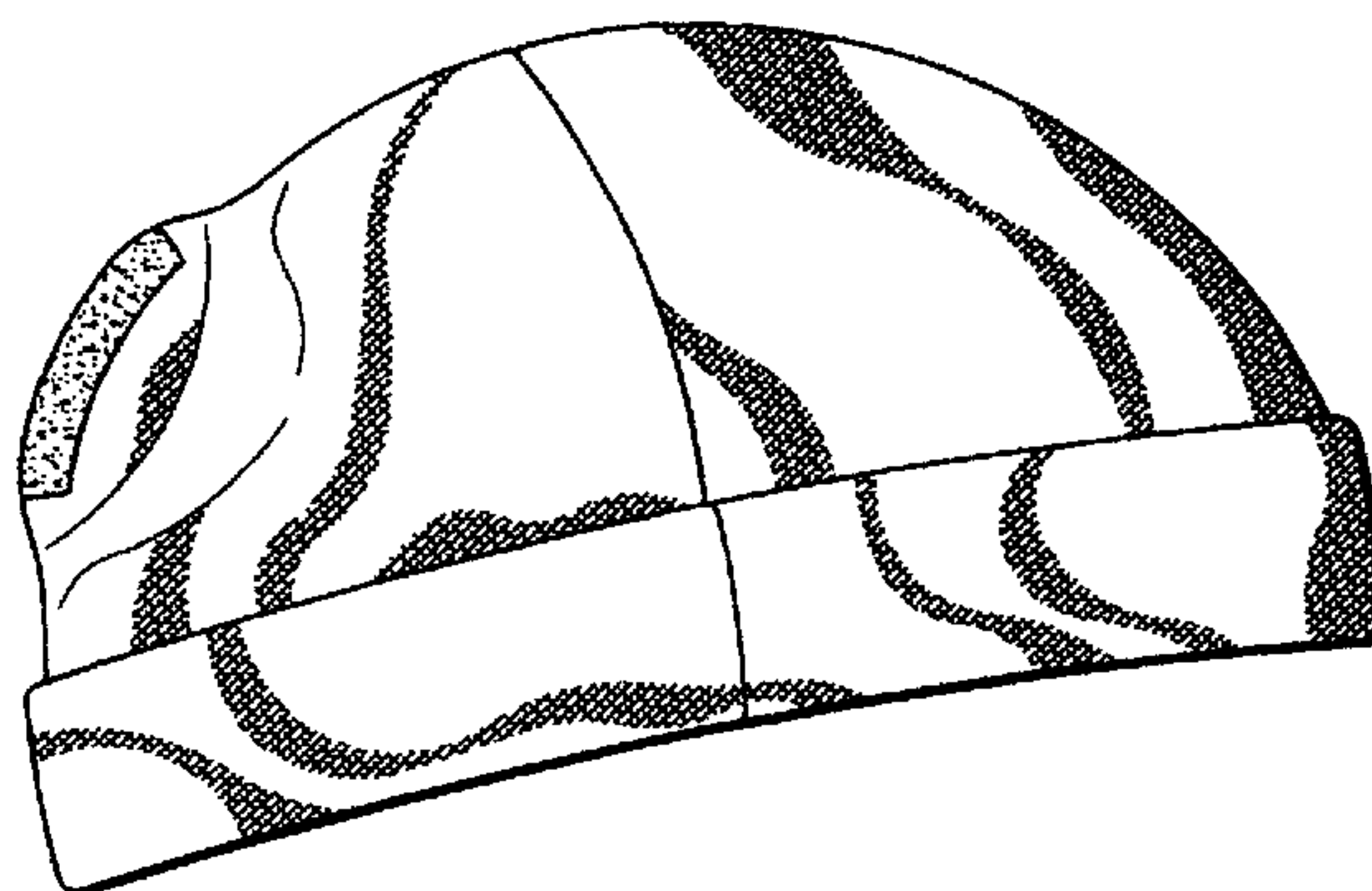
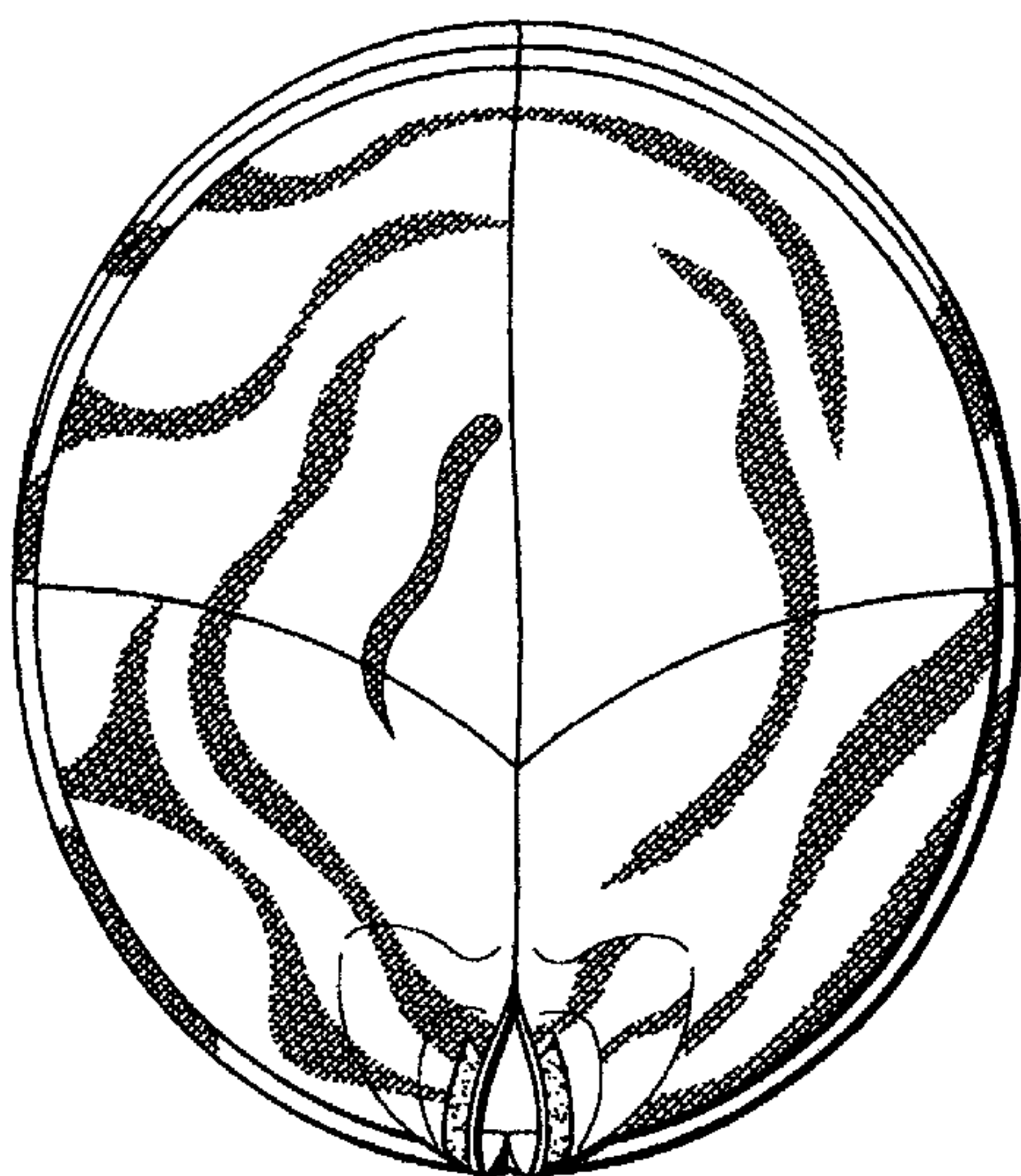
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of one side of the pony cap shown in FIG. 1. An elevational view of the opposite side is a mirror image thereof; and,

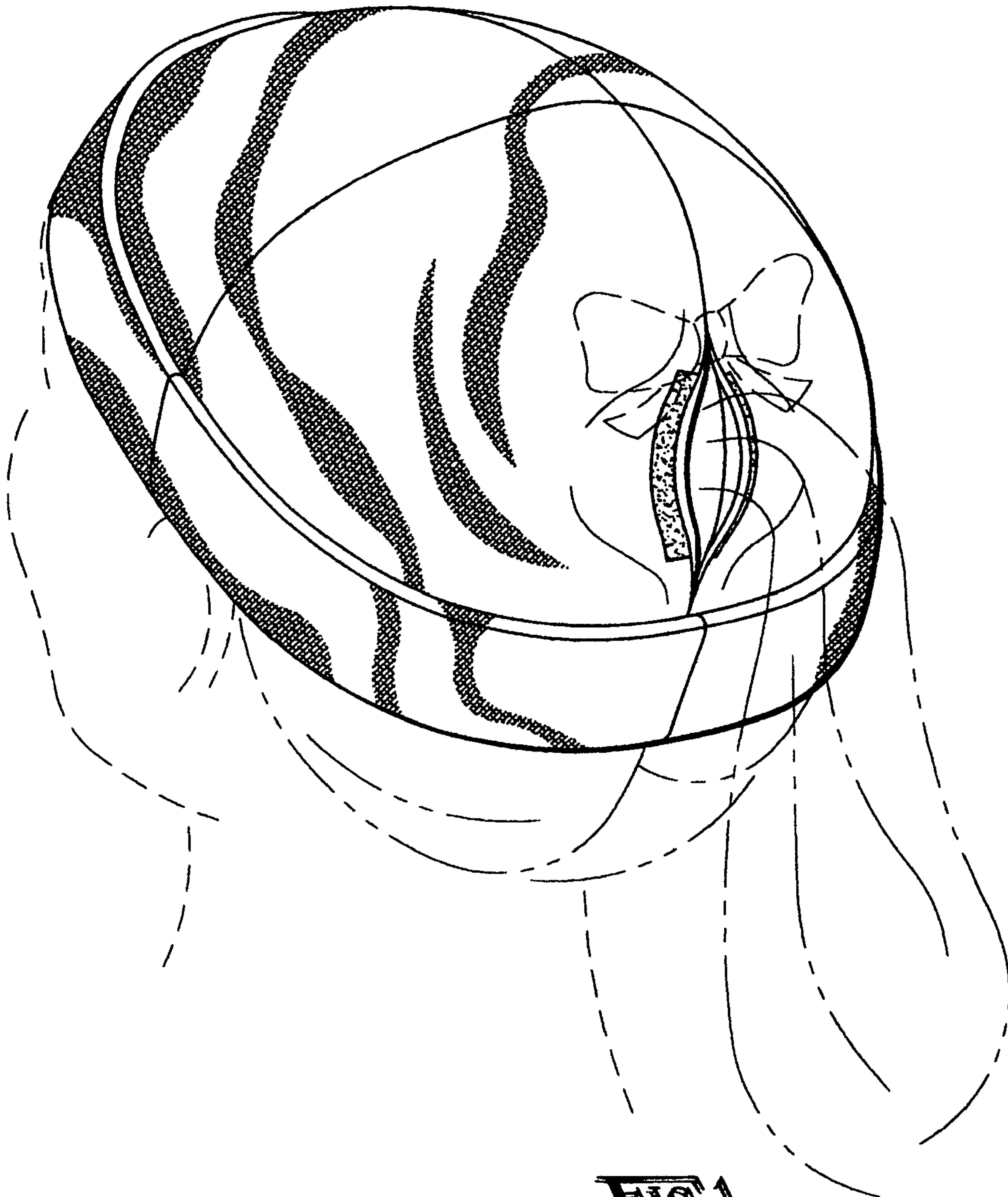

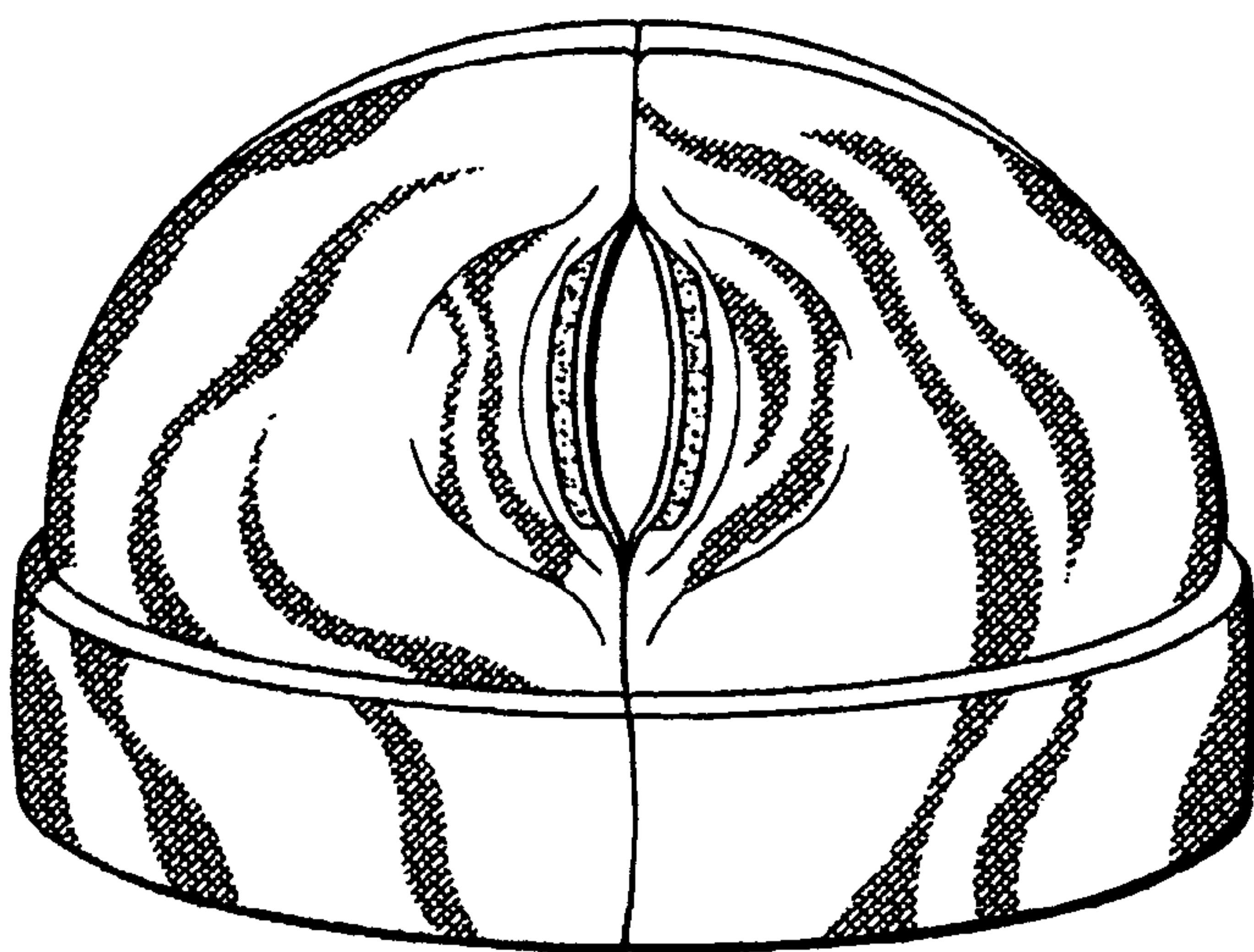

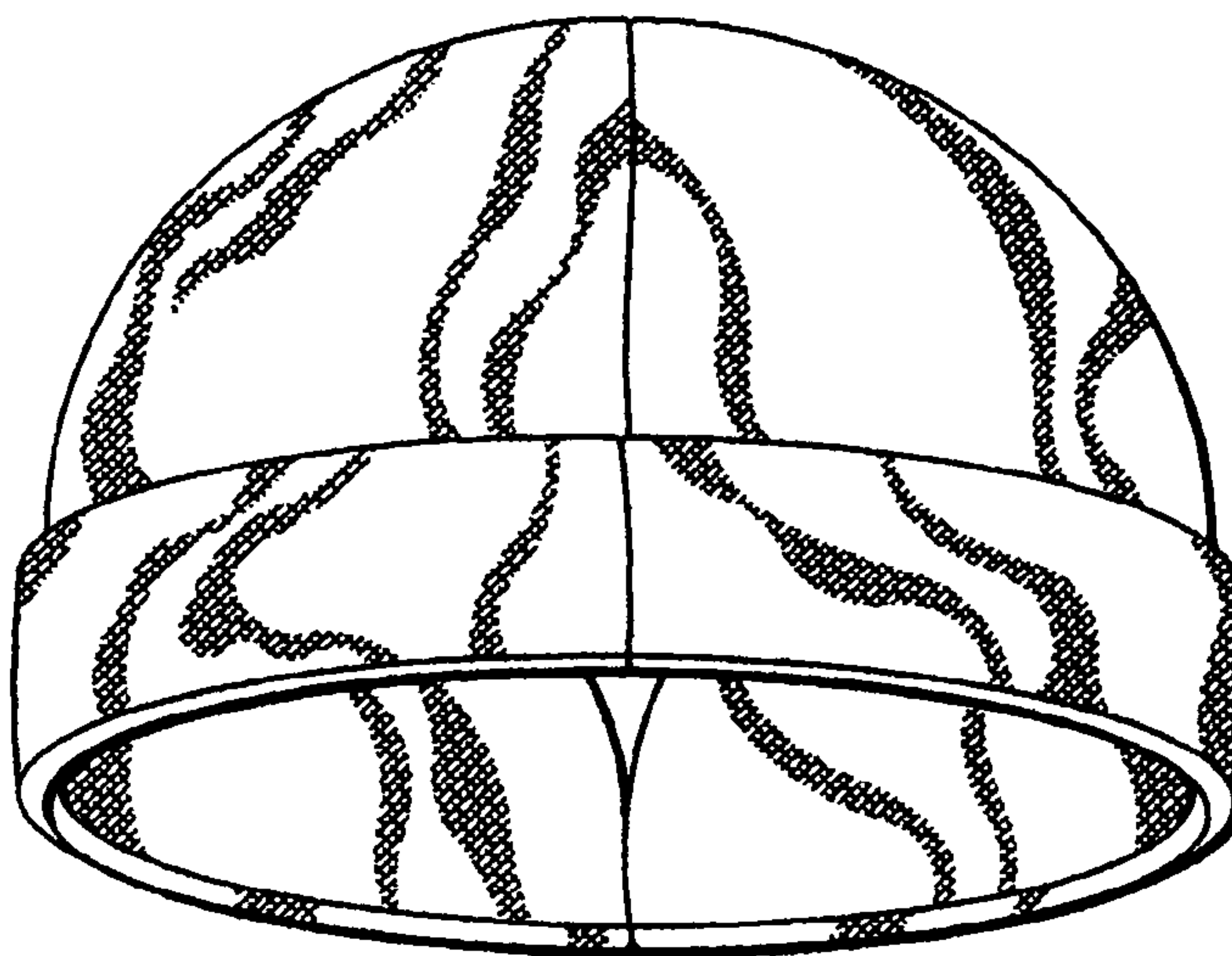
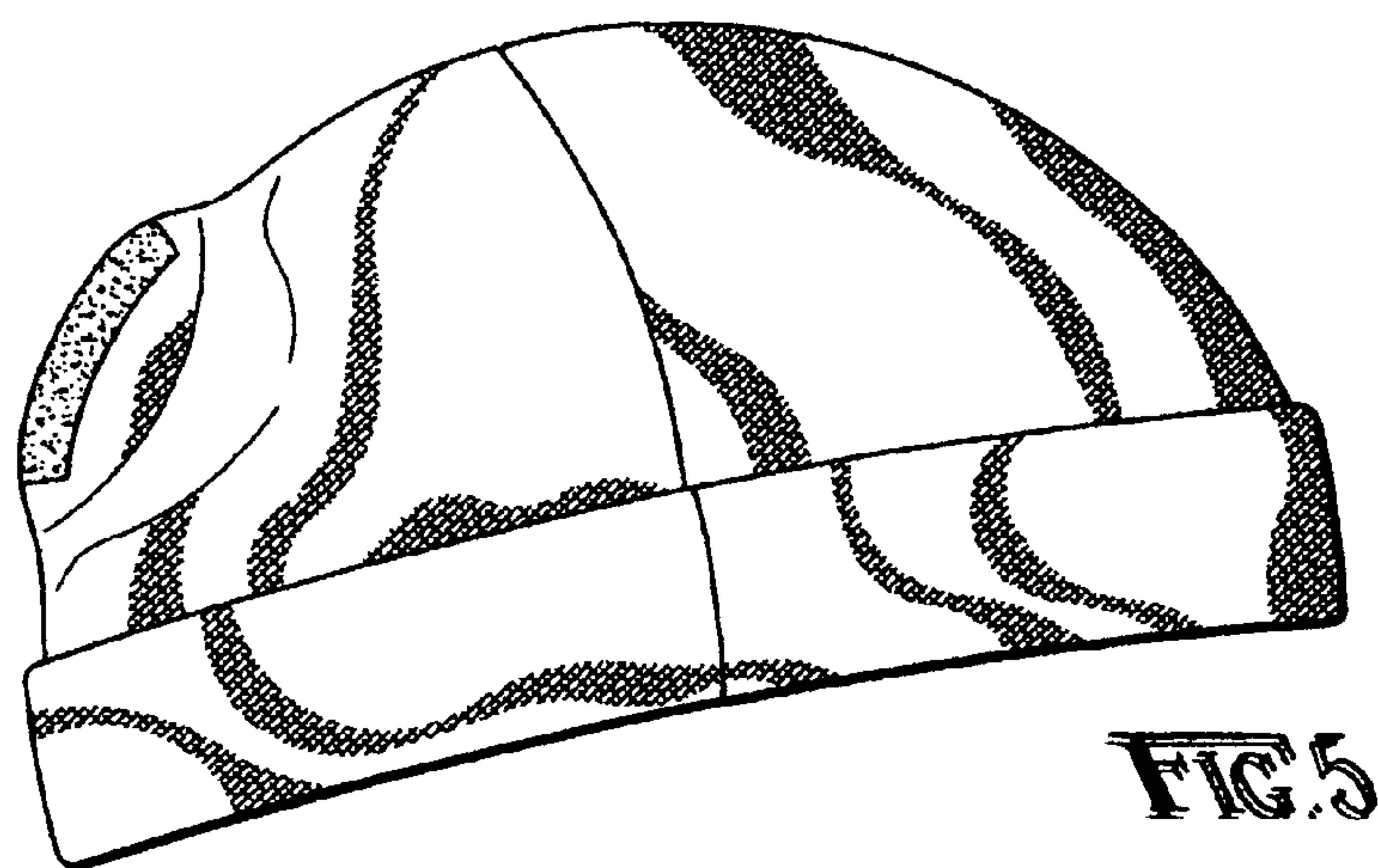
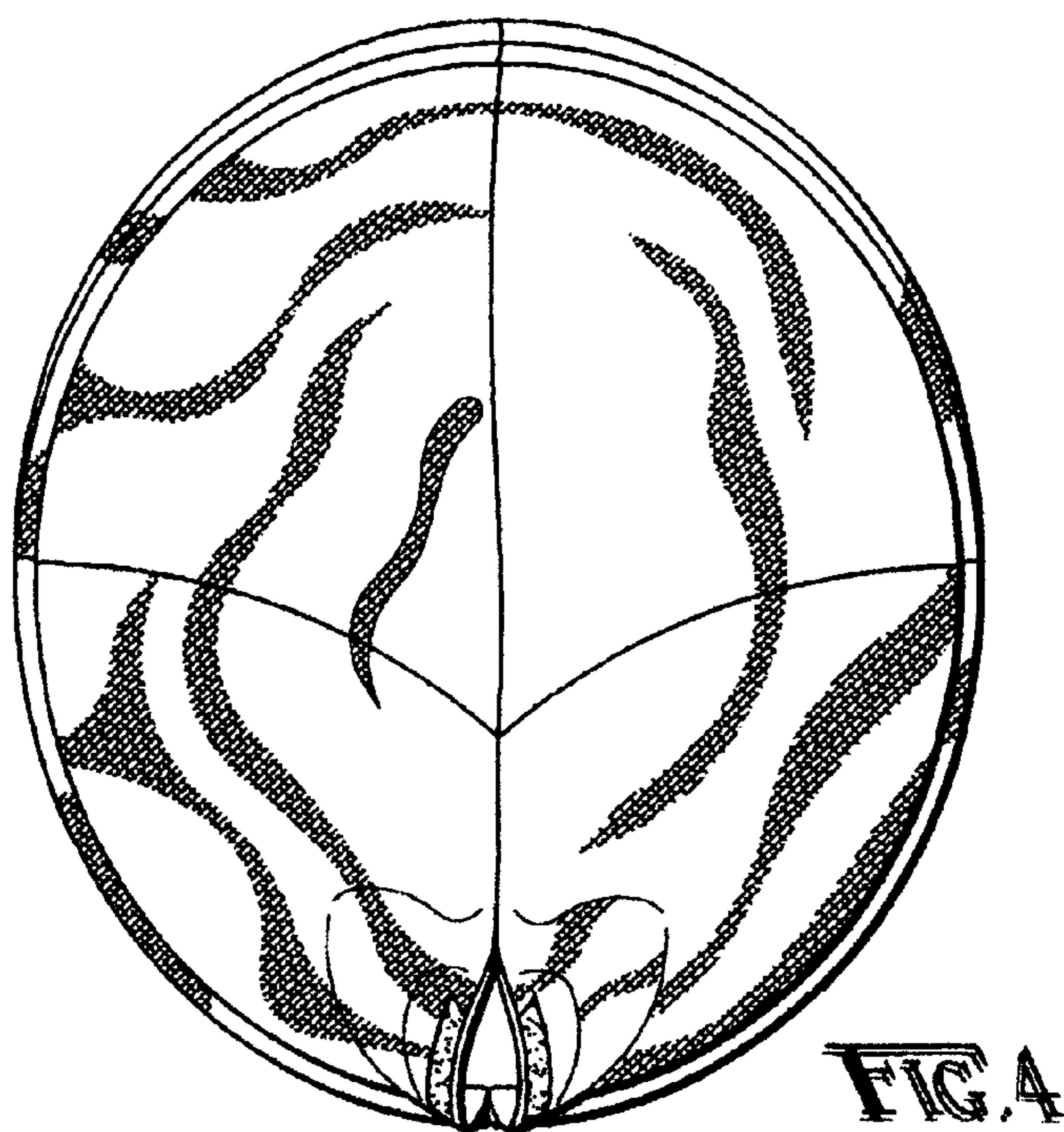

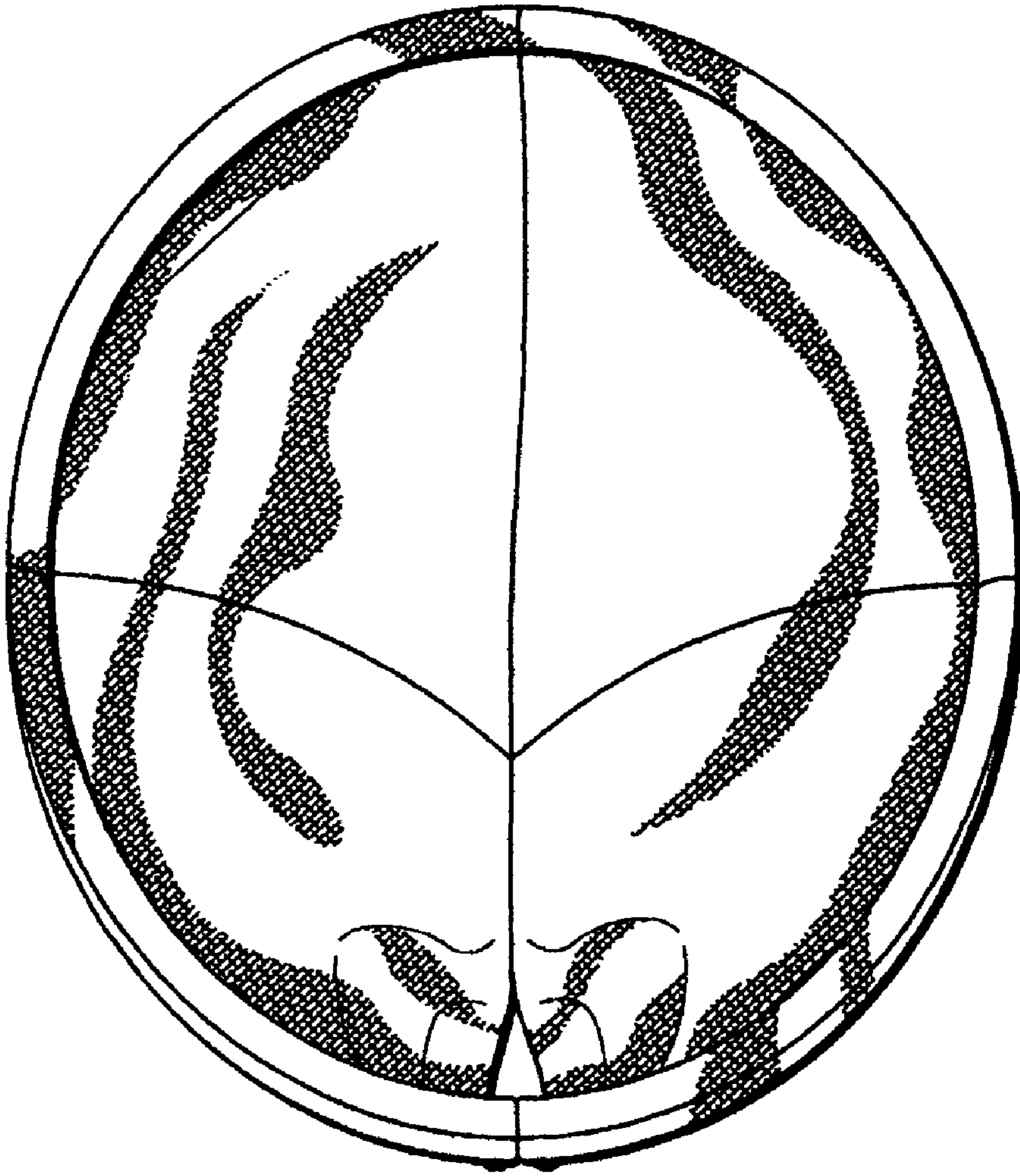
