illustrated in FIGS. 1 and 2.

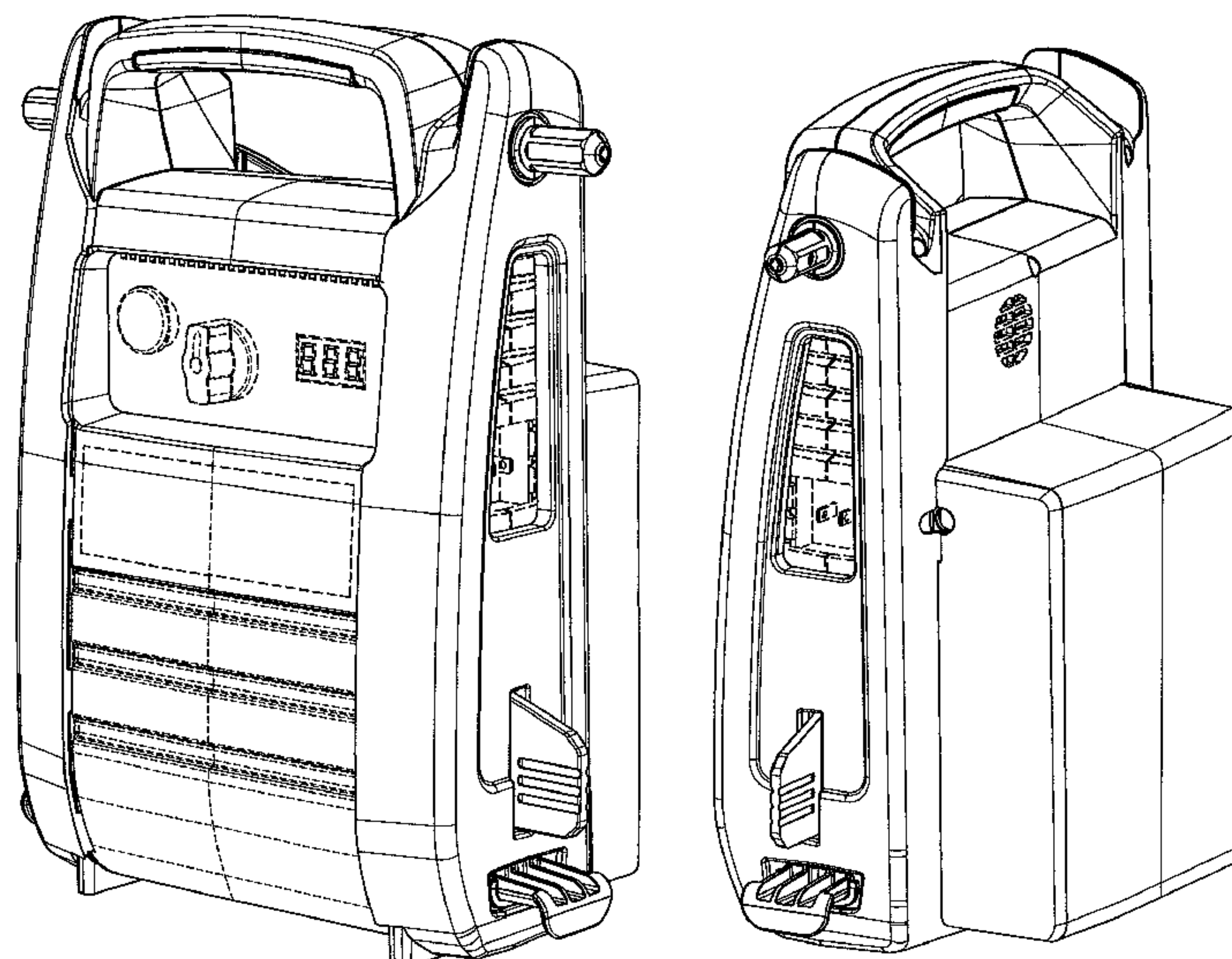
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the battery booster pack

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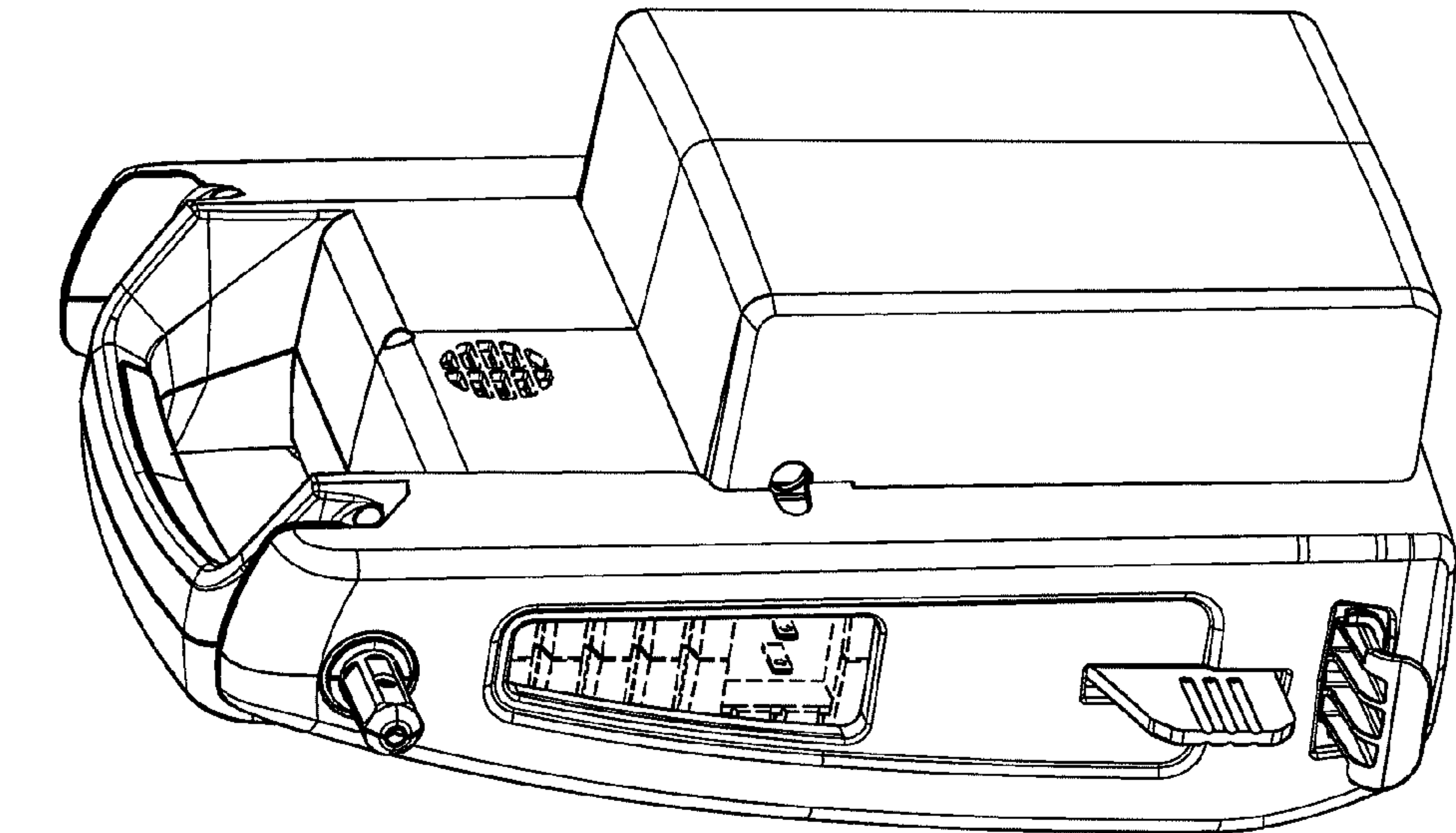

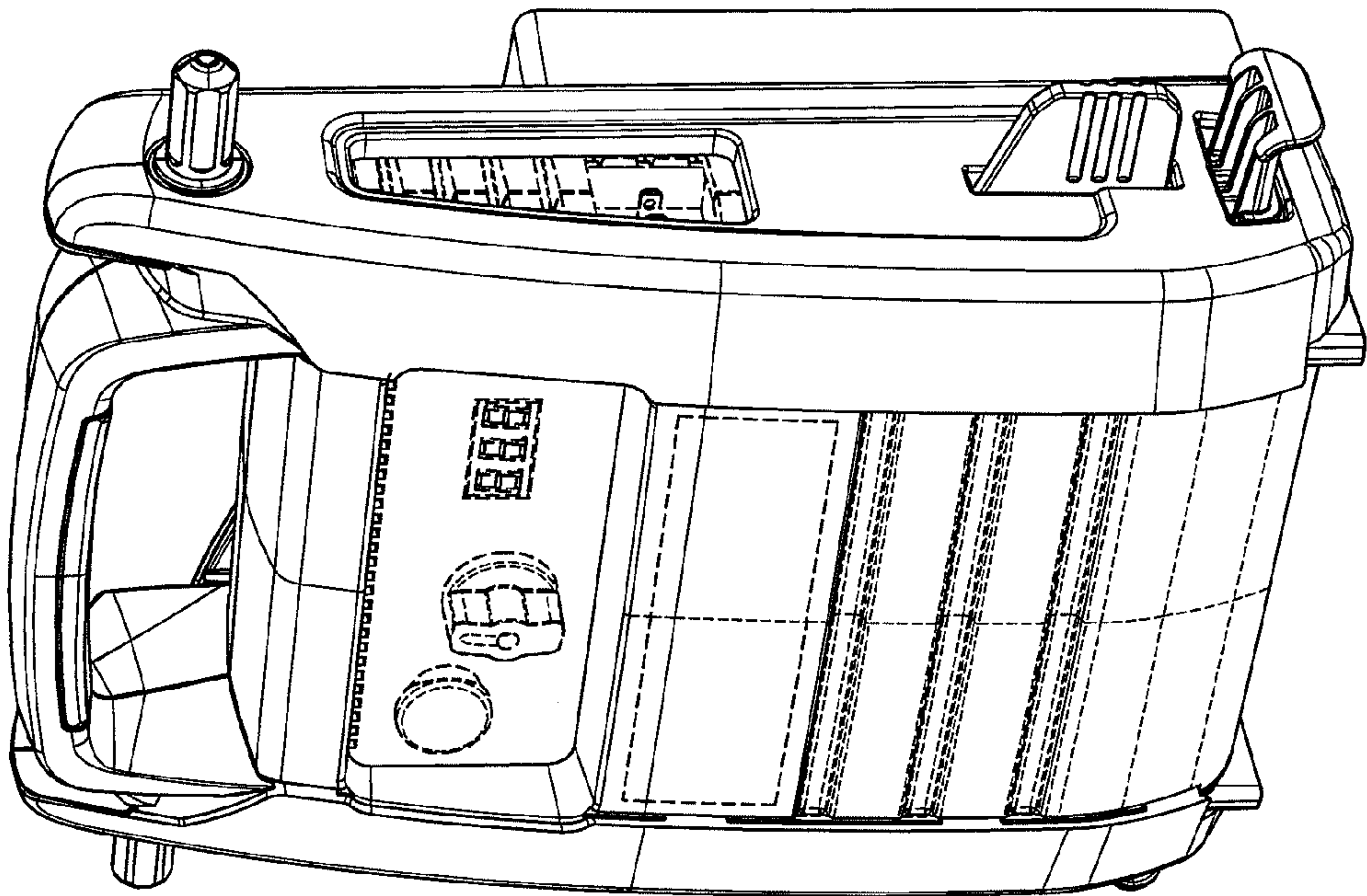

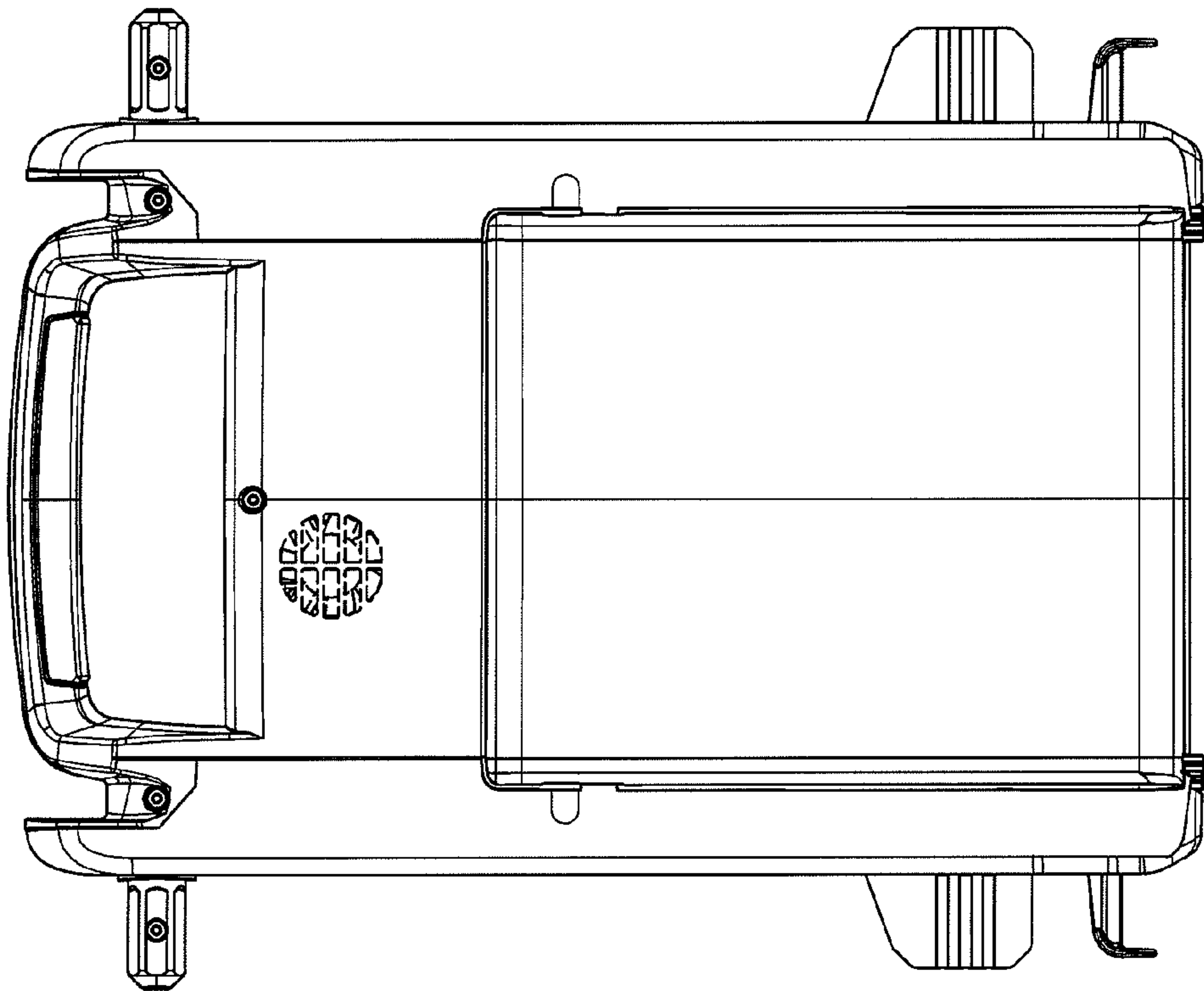

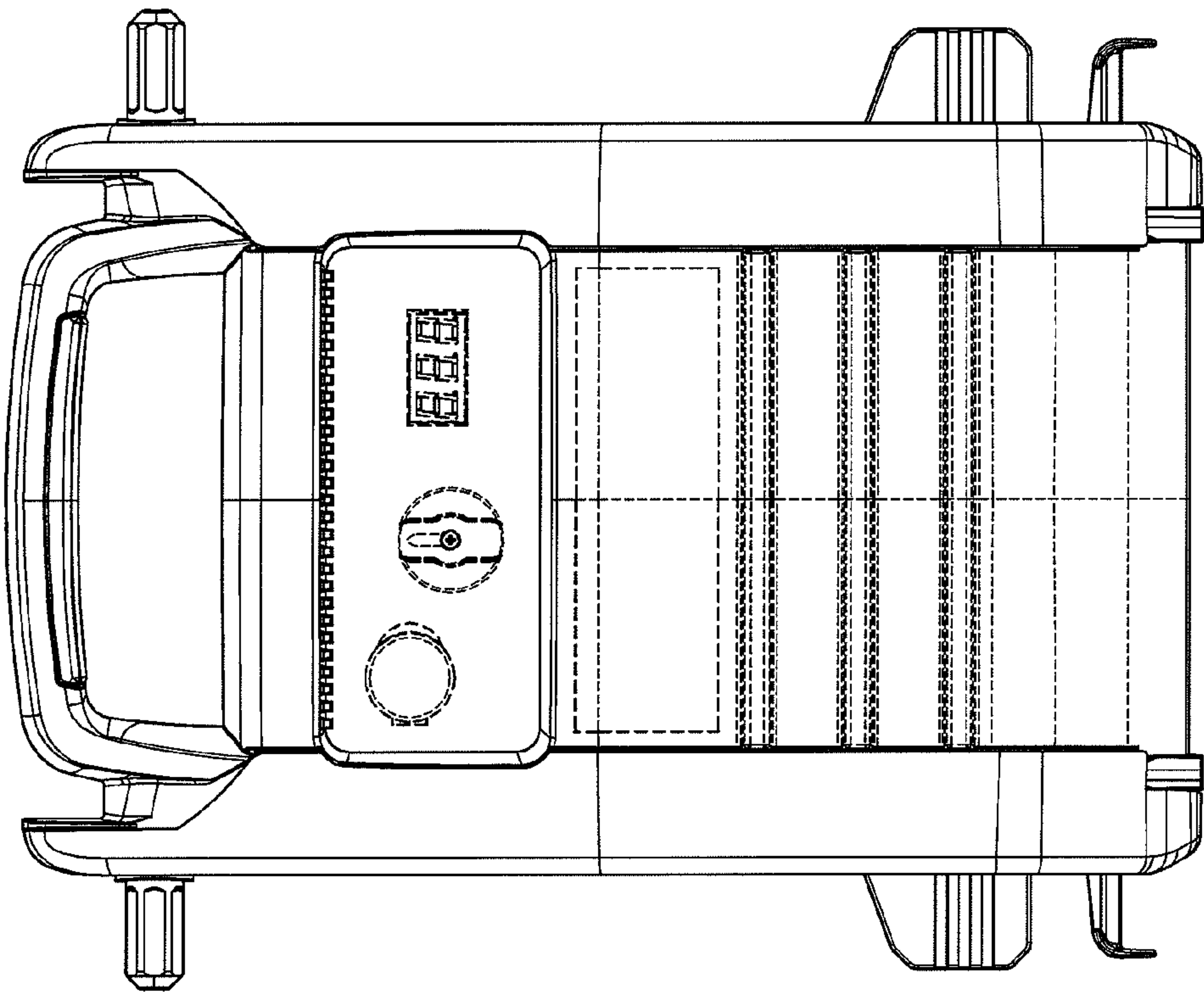

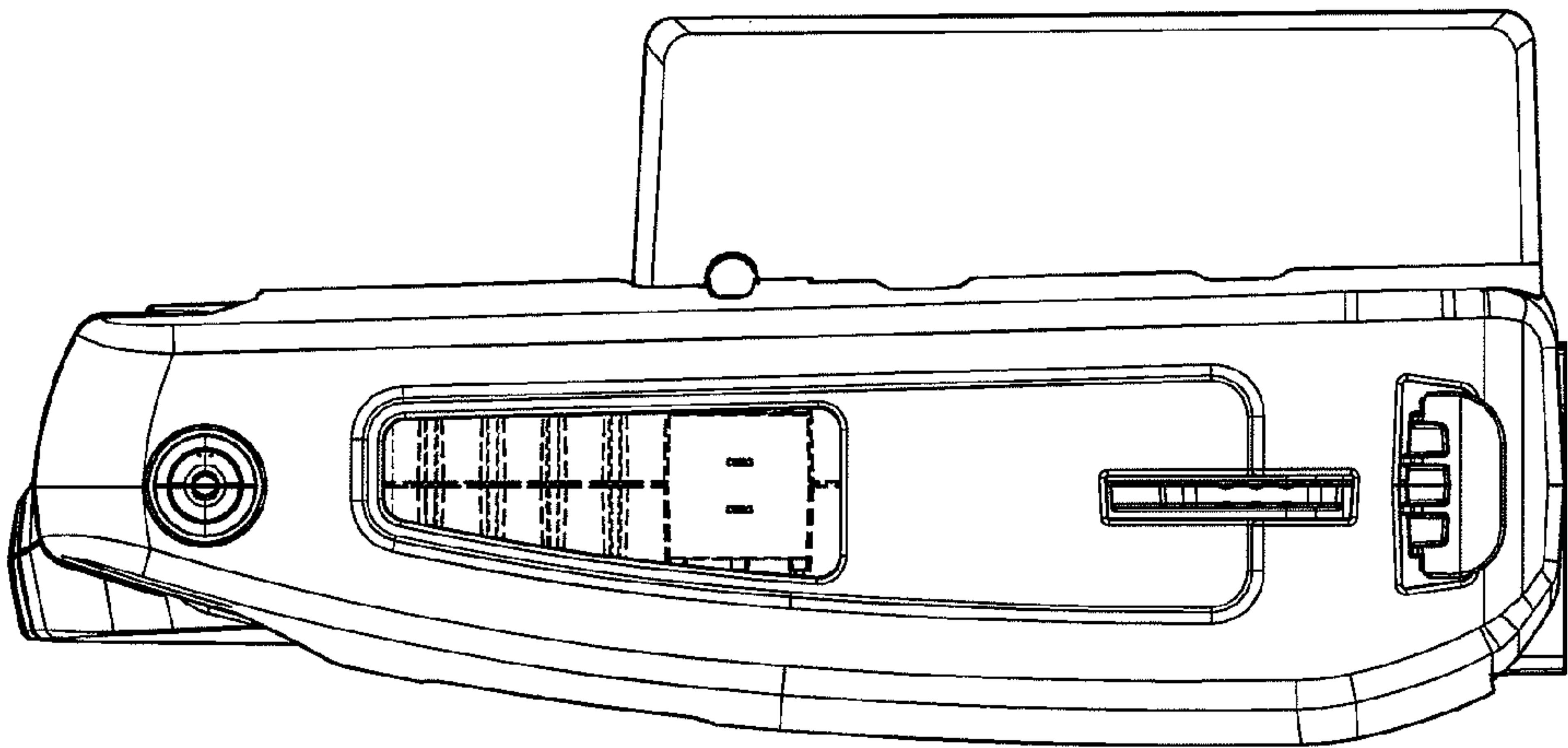

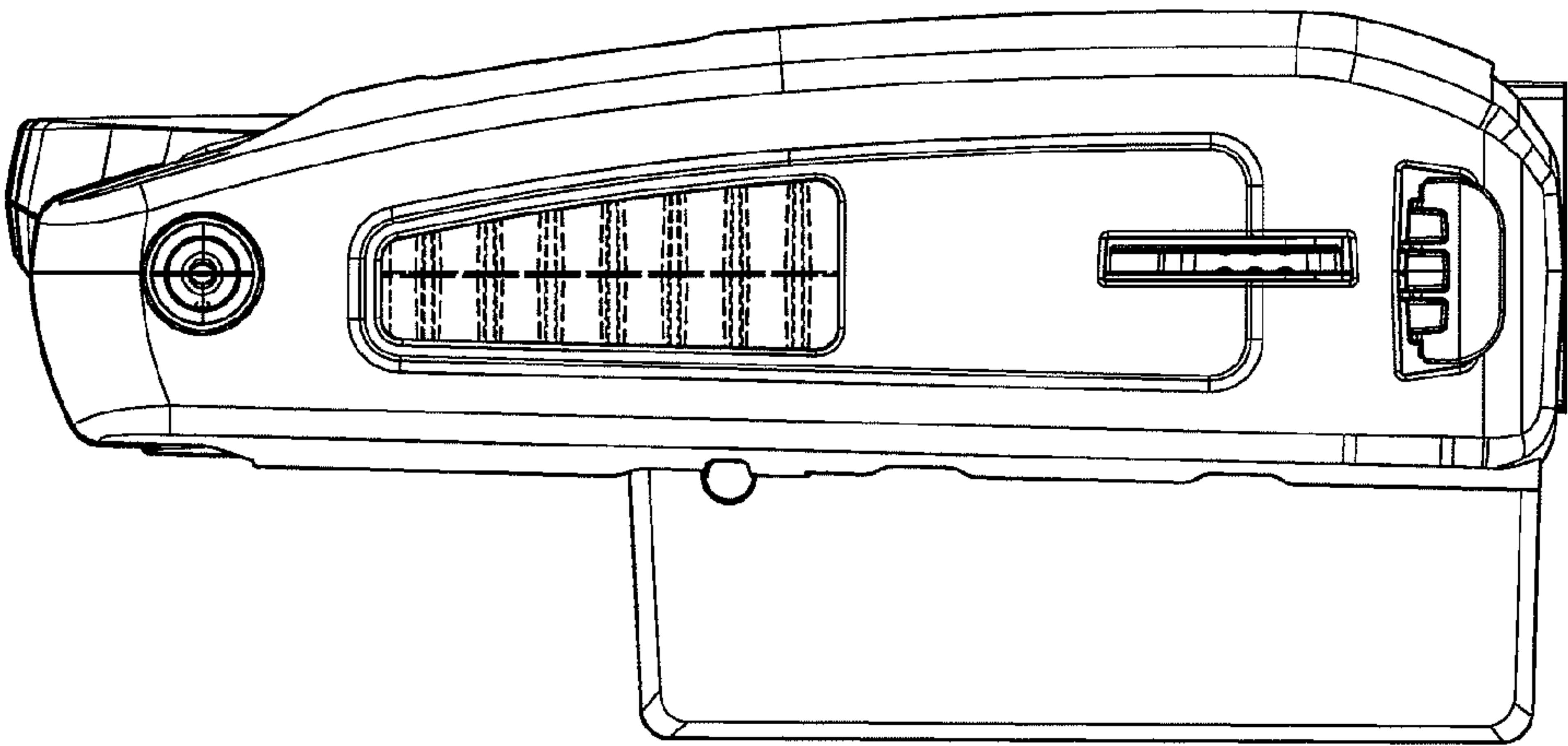

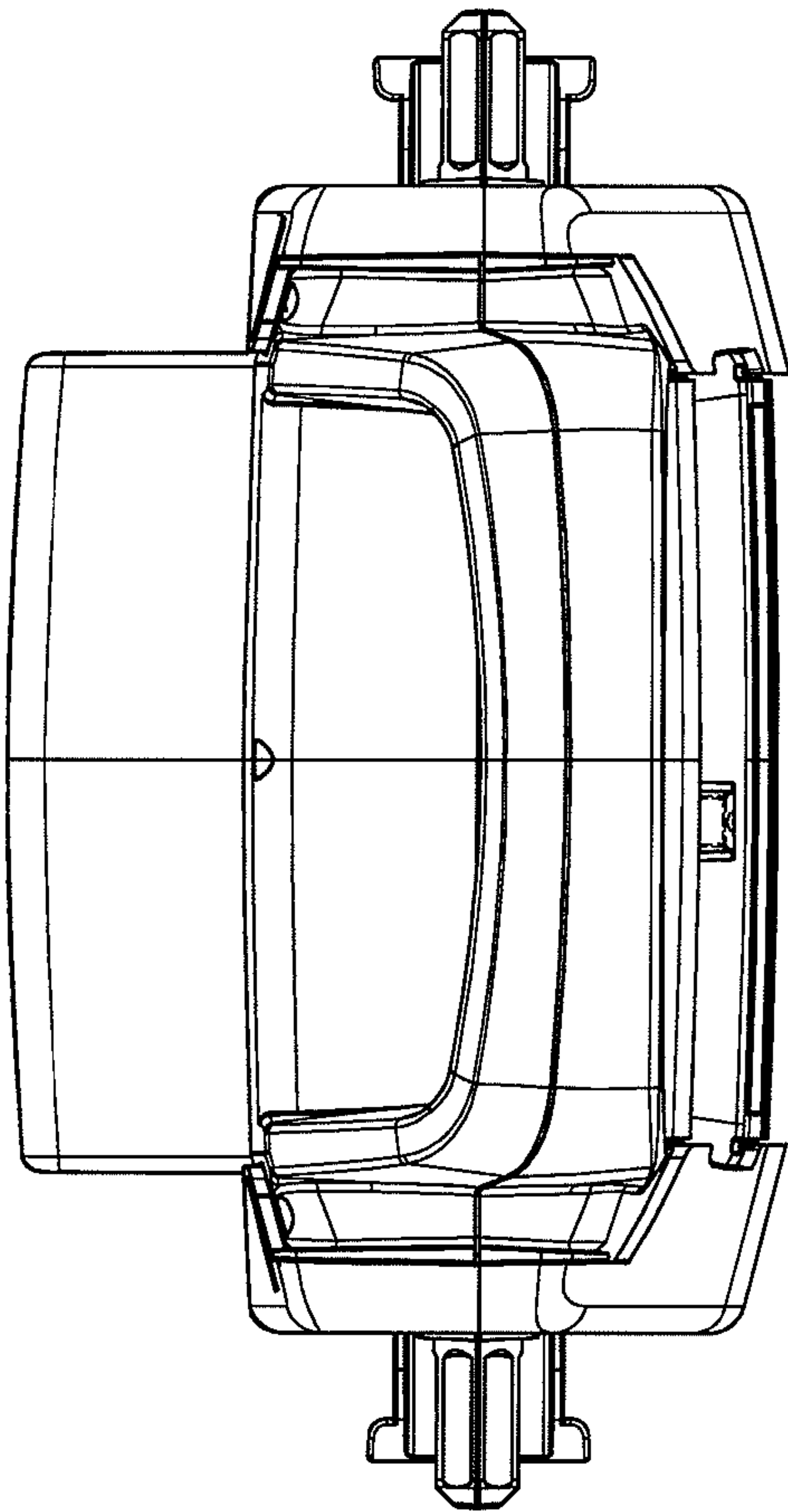
