FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view thereof.

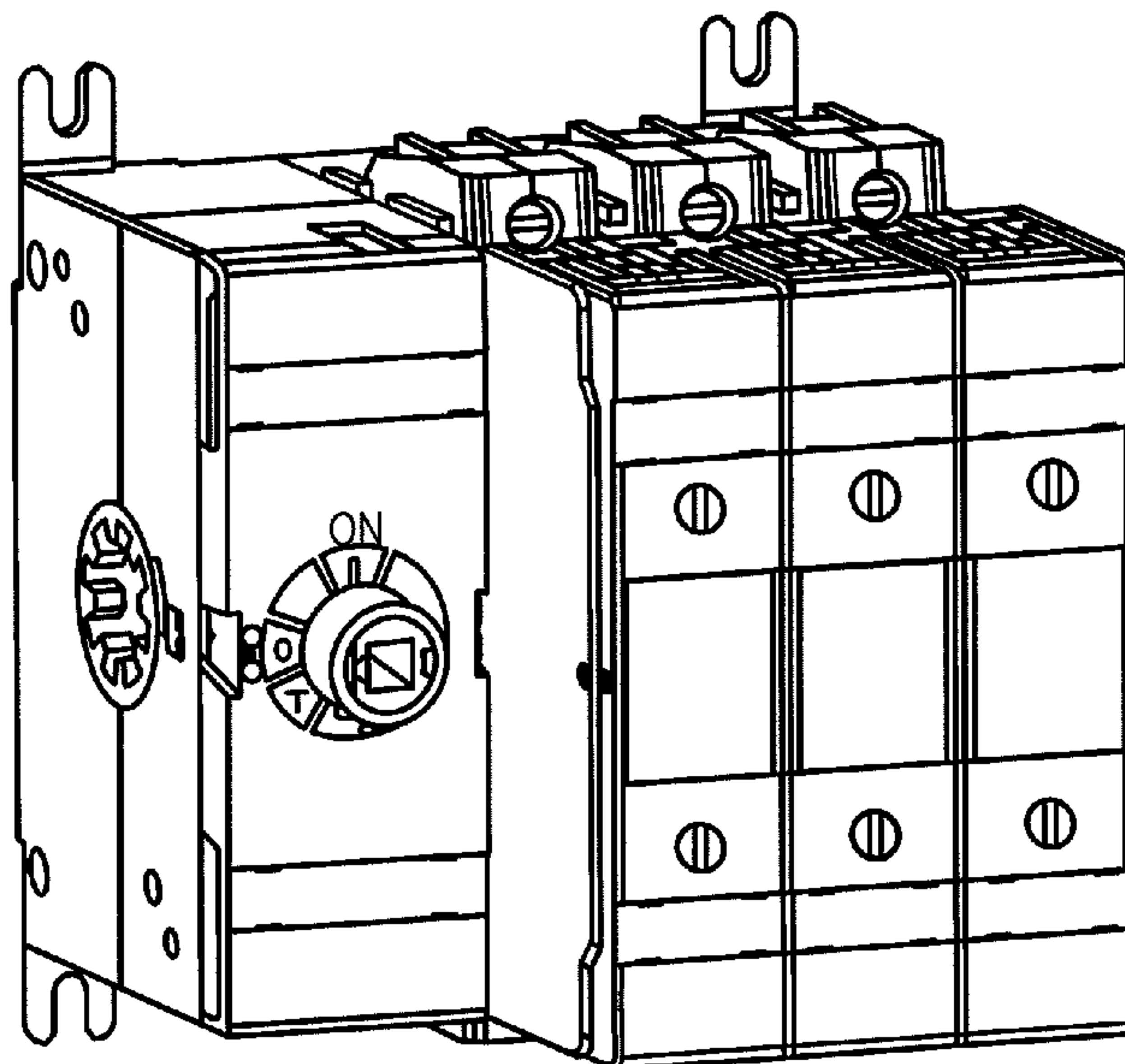
FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view thereof.

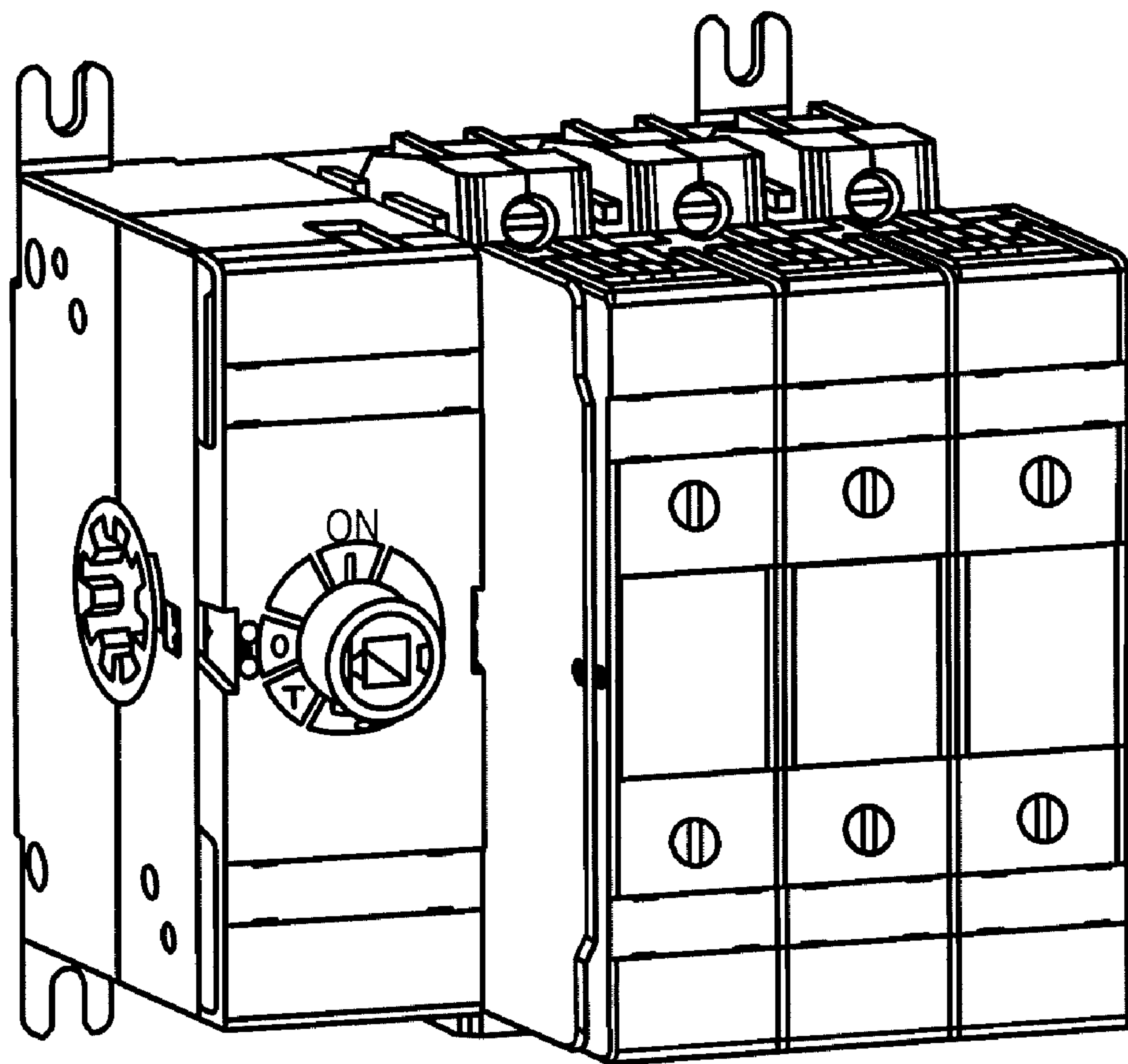

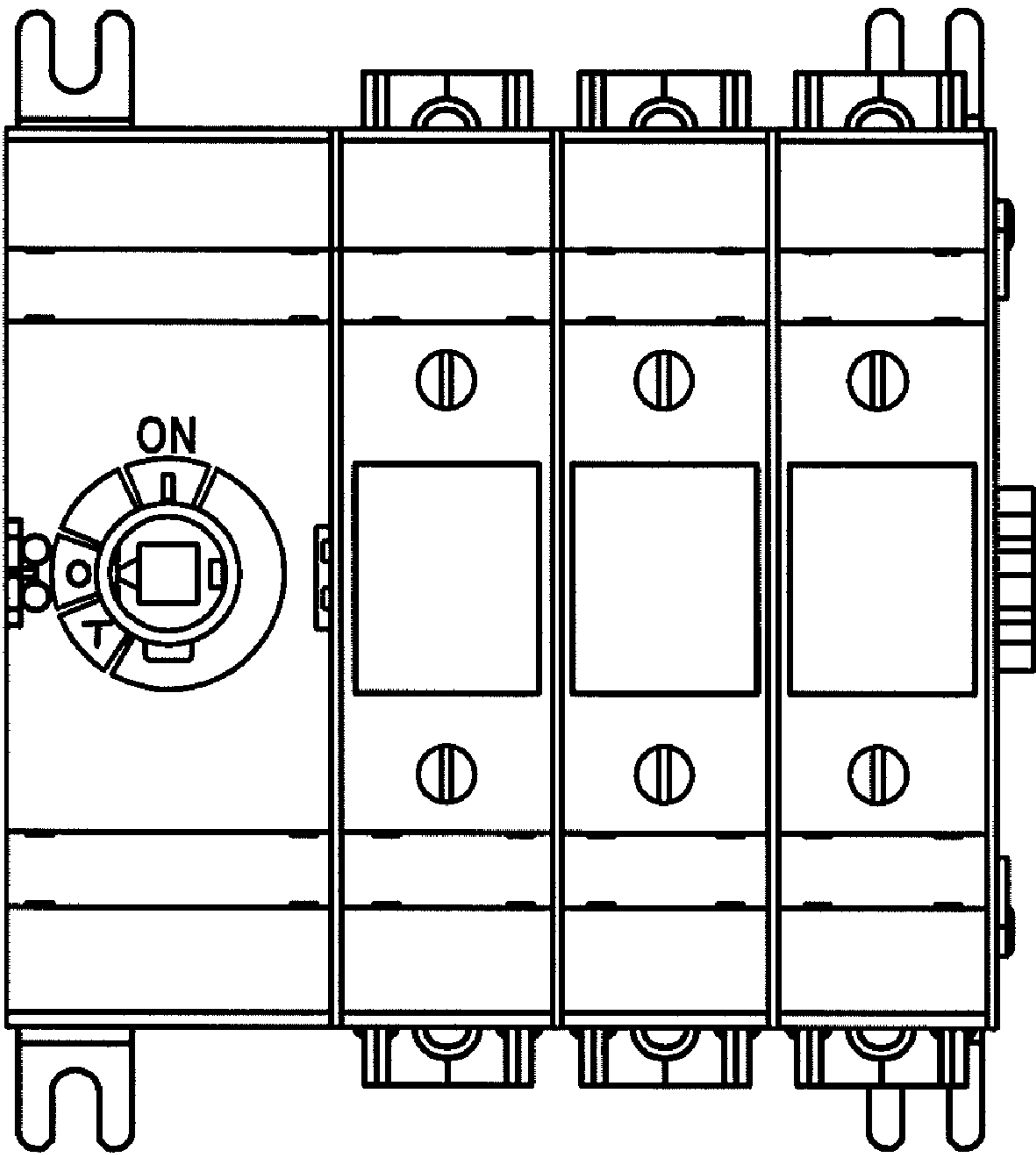

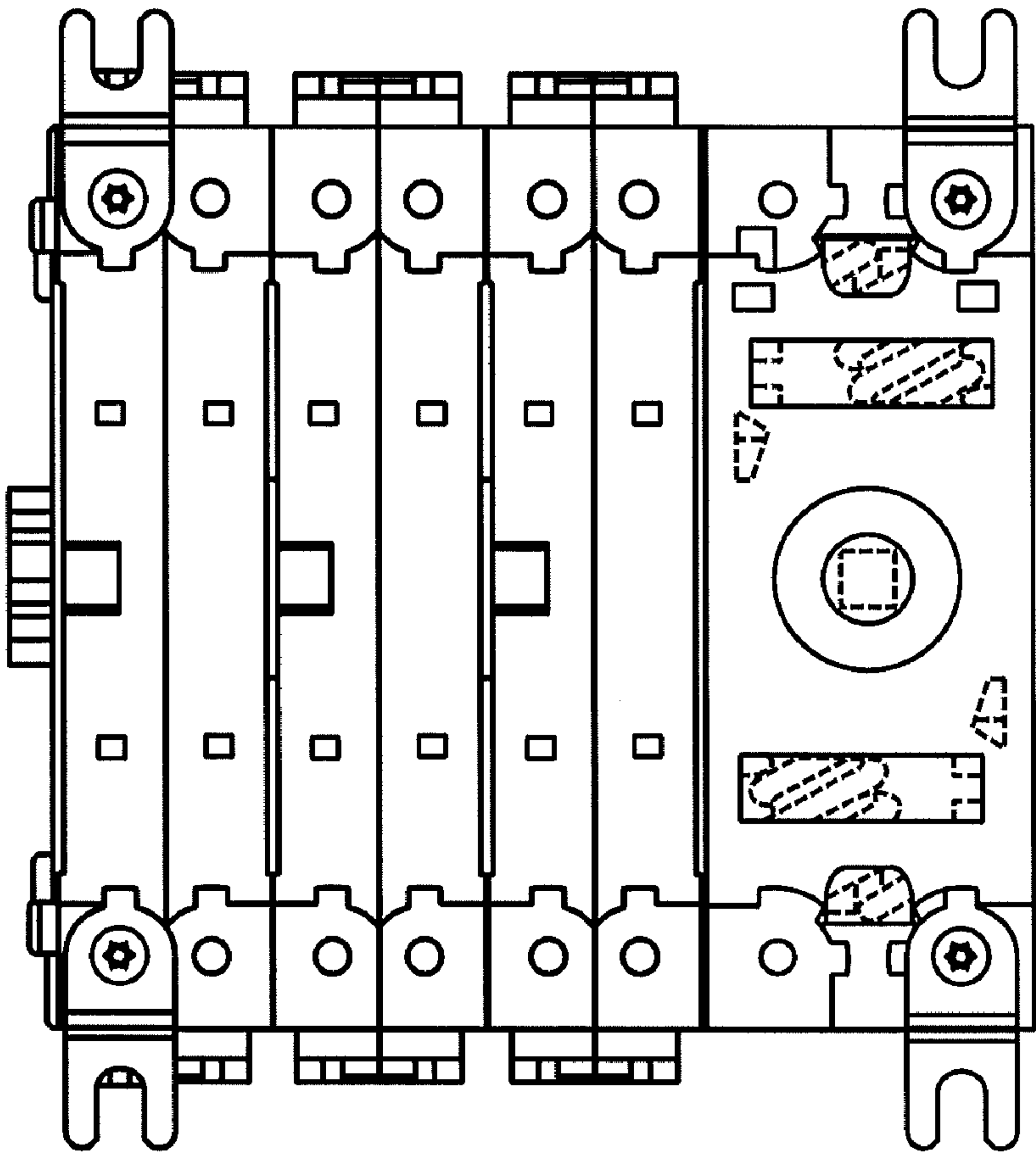

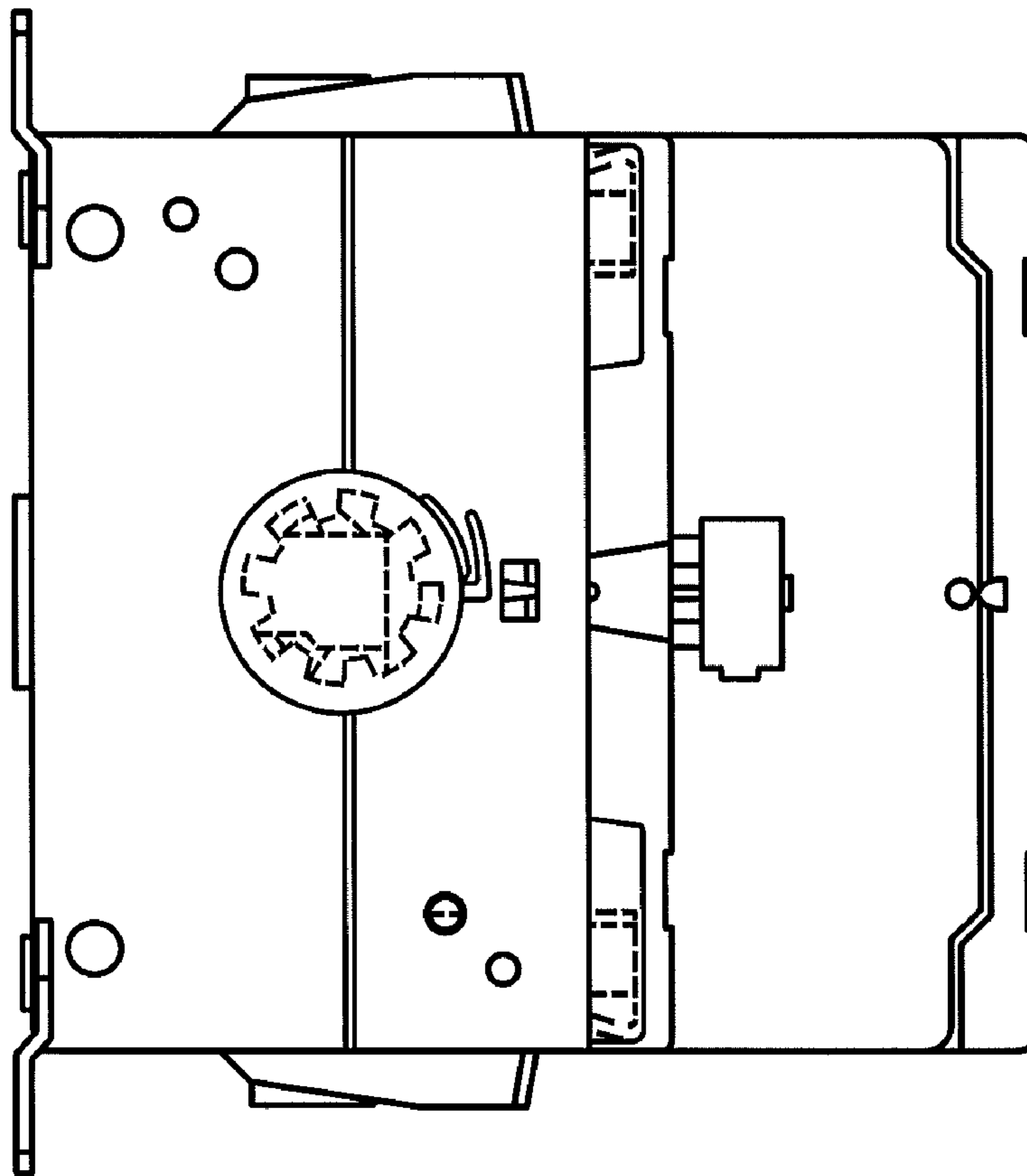

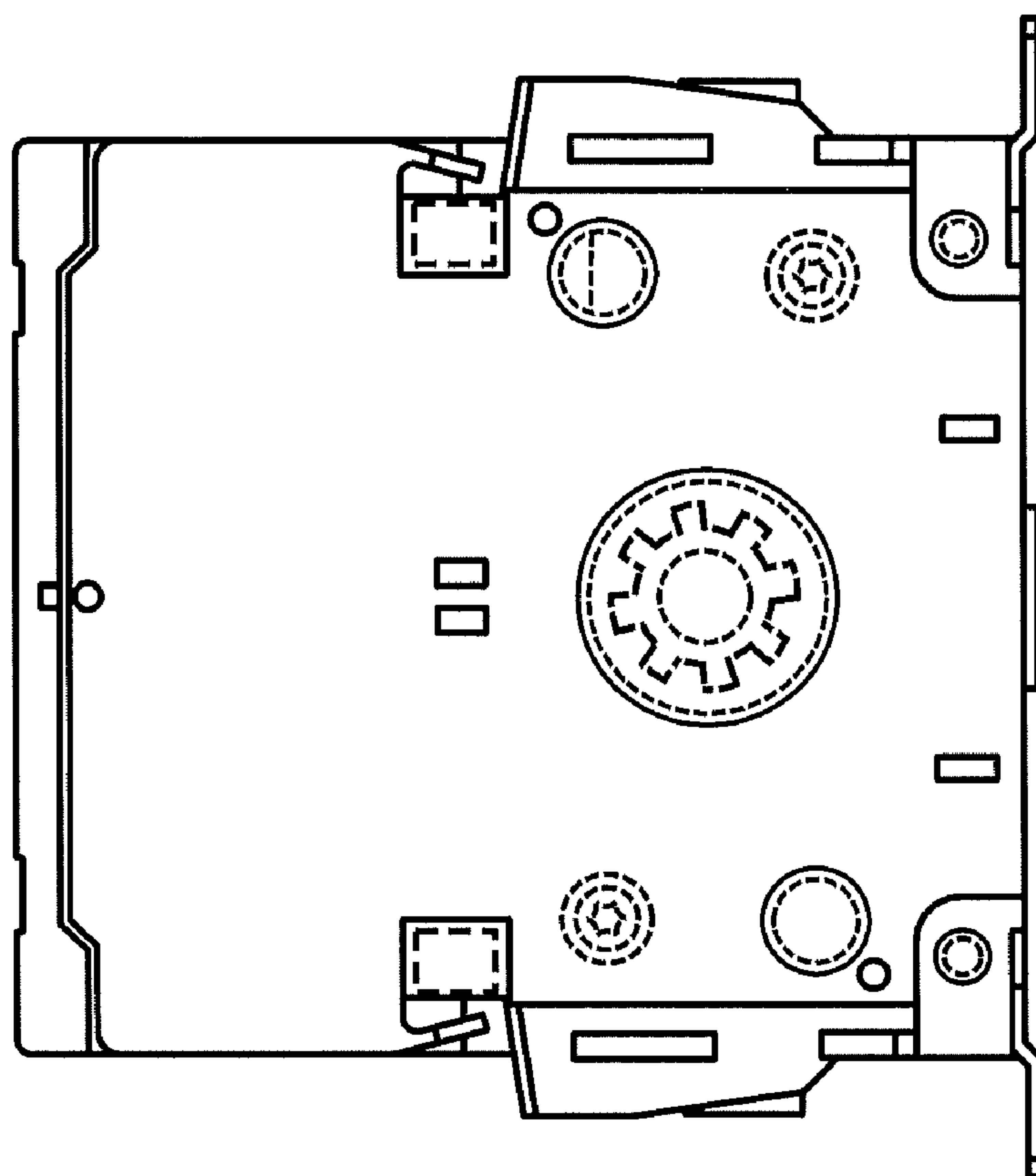

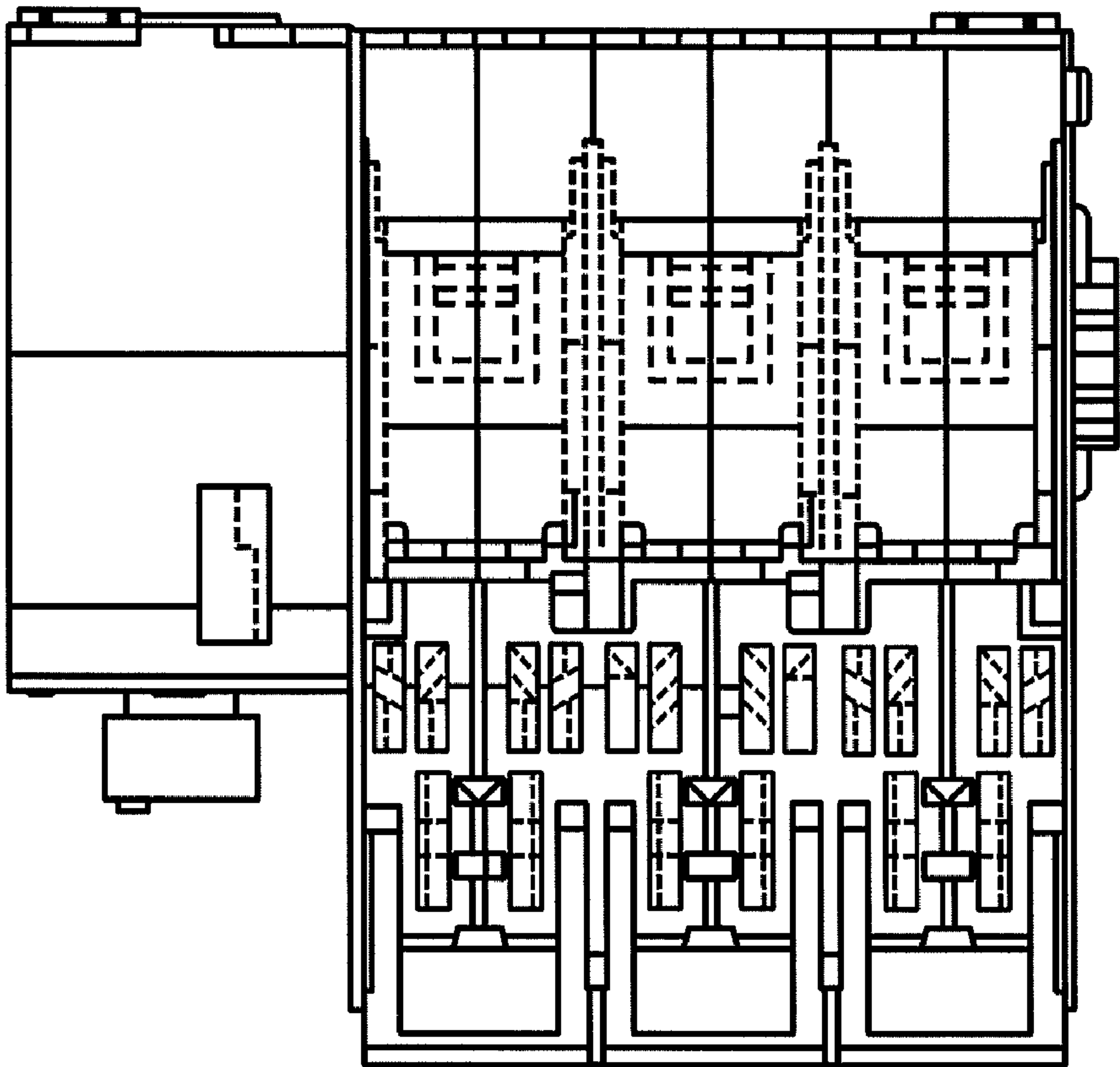

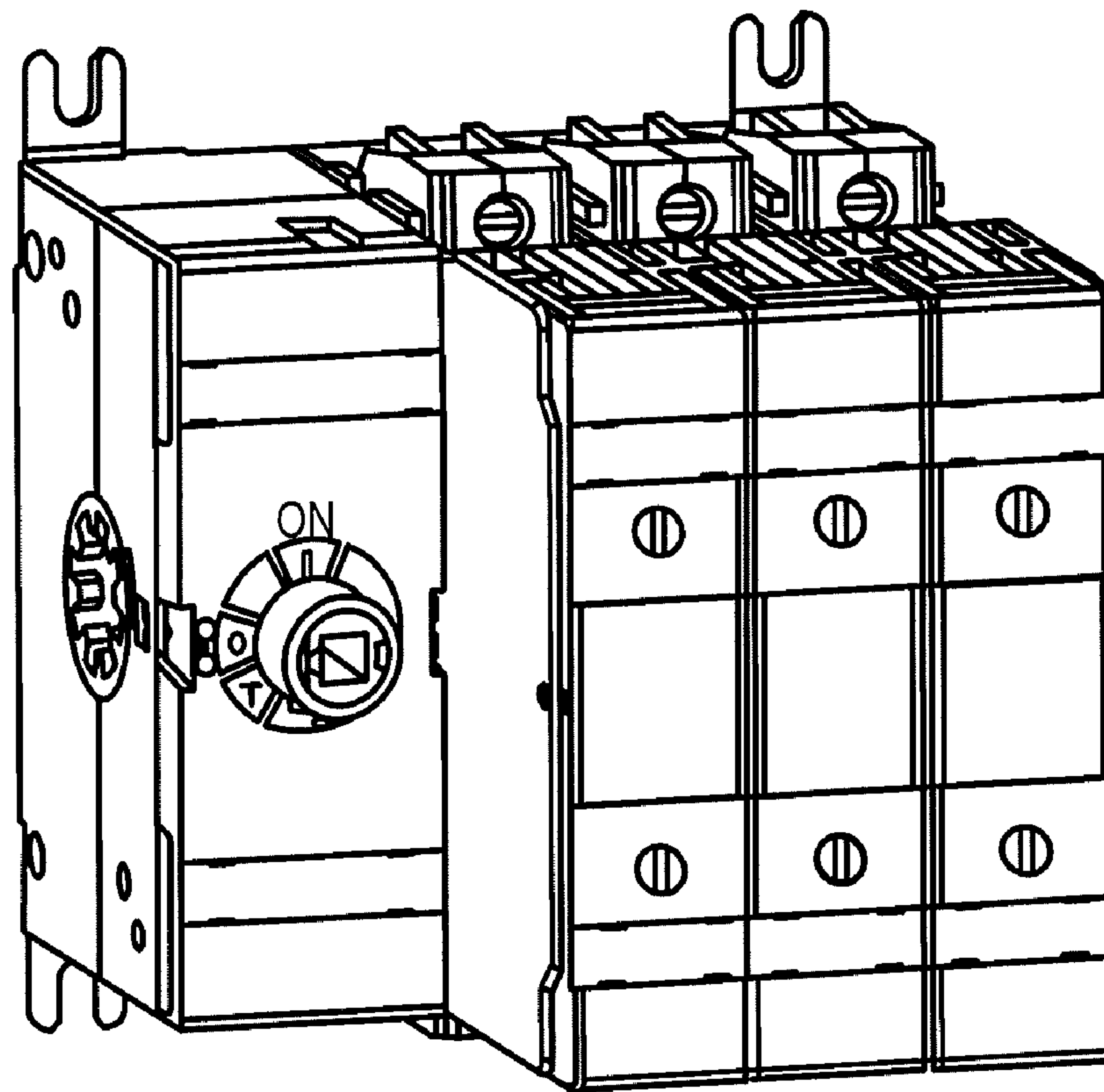

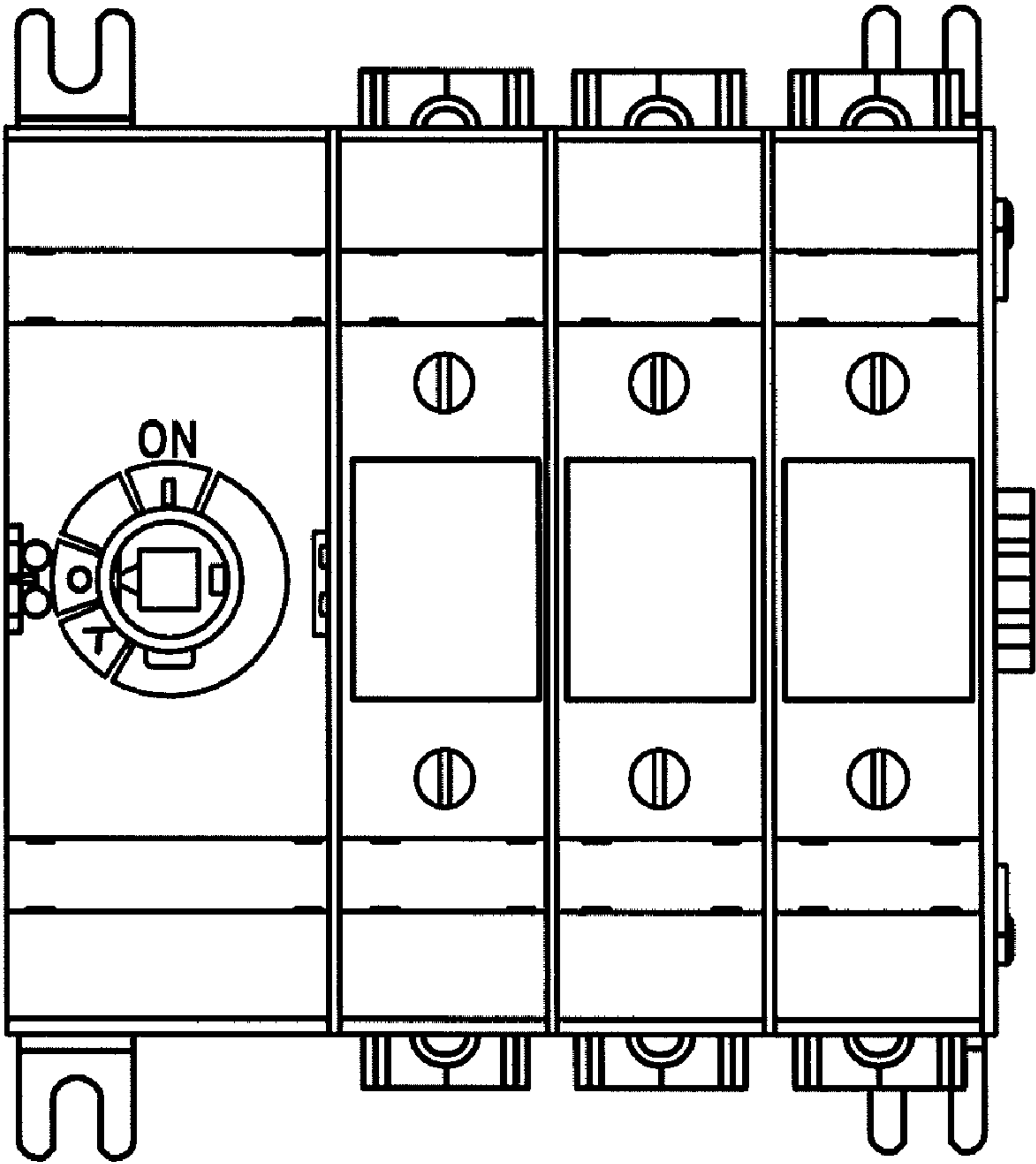

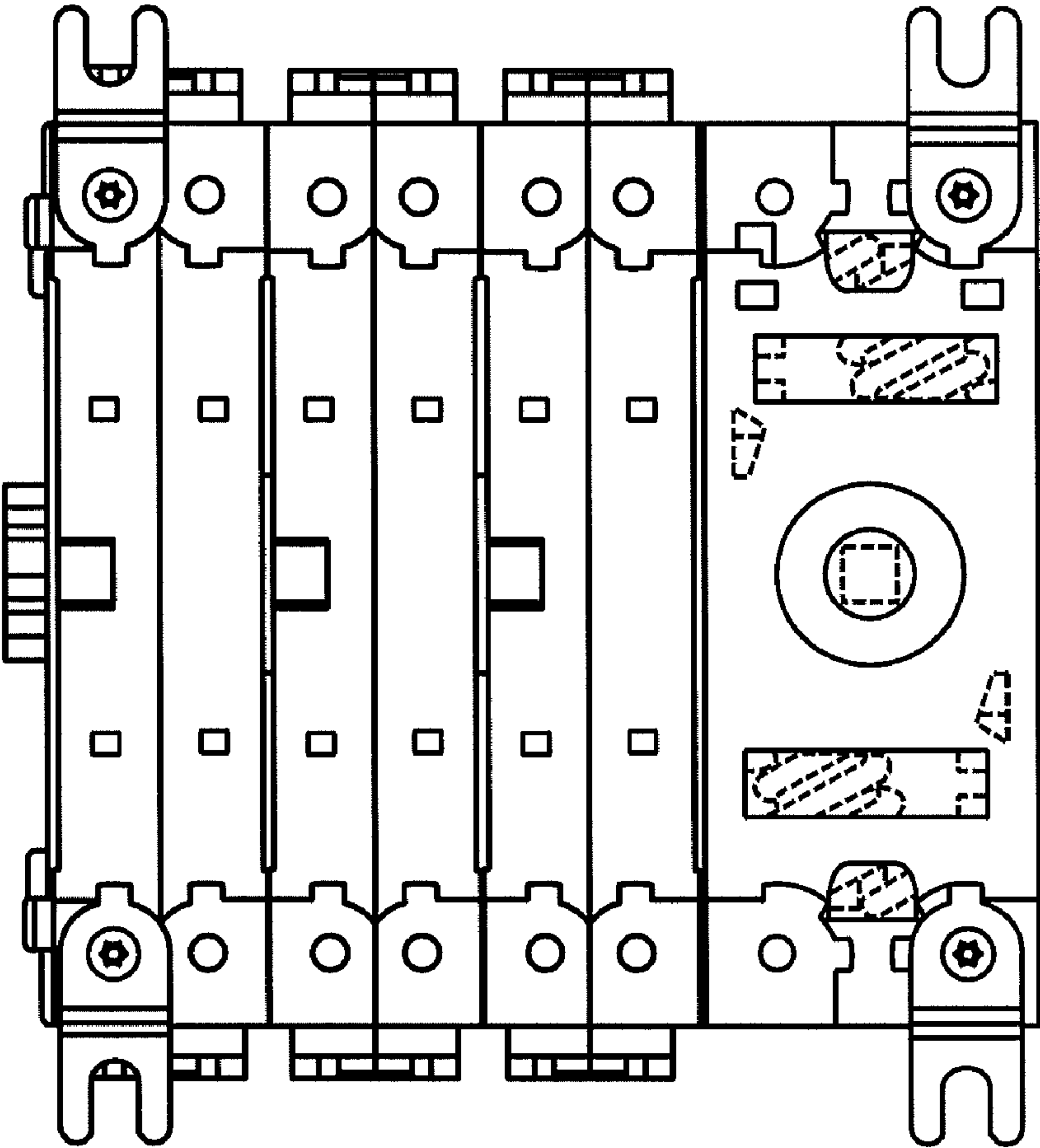

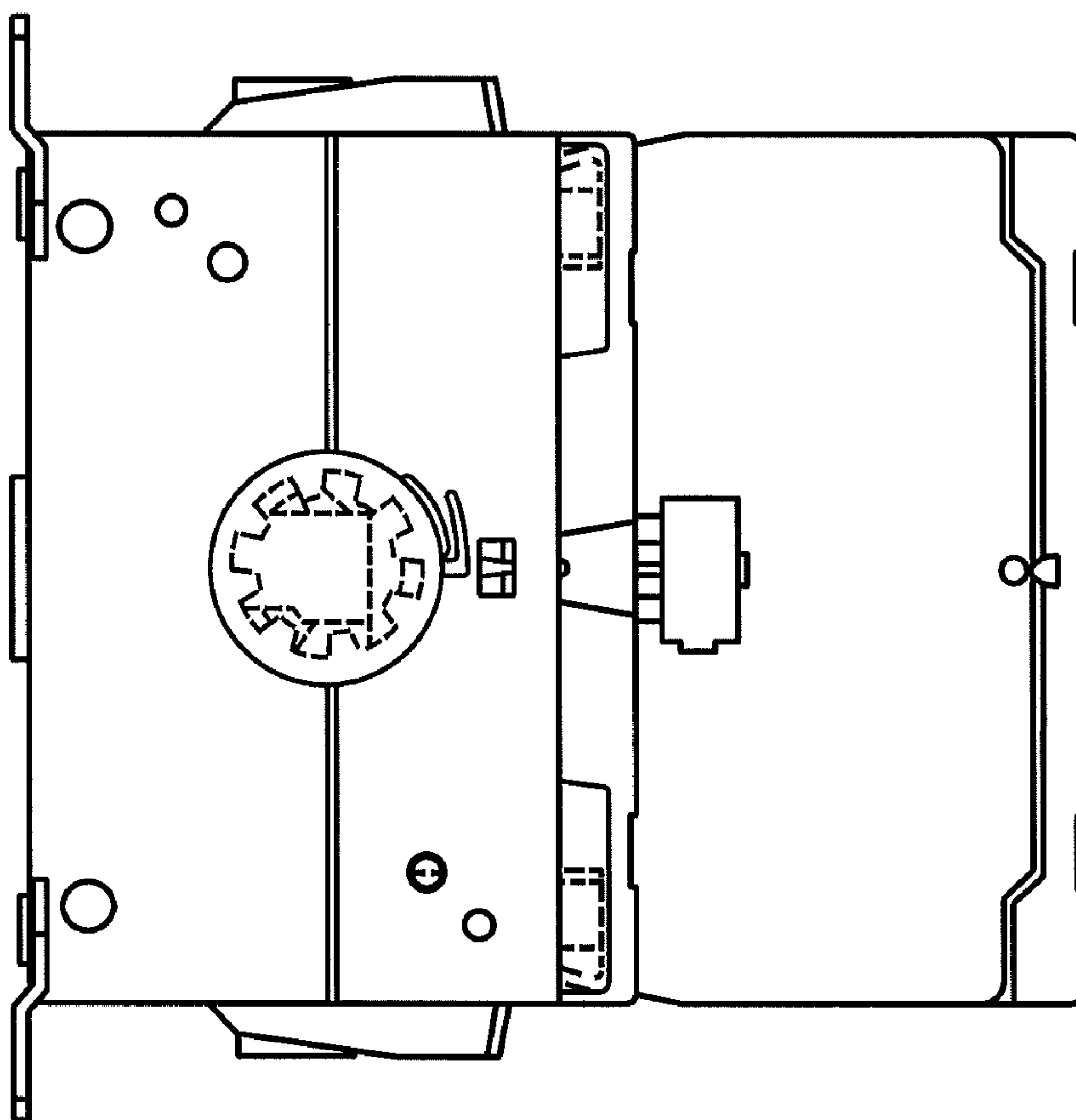

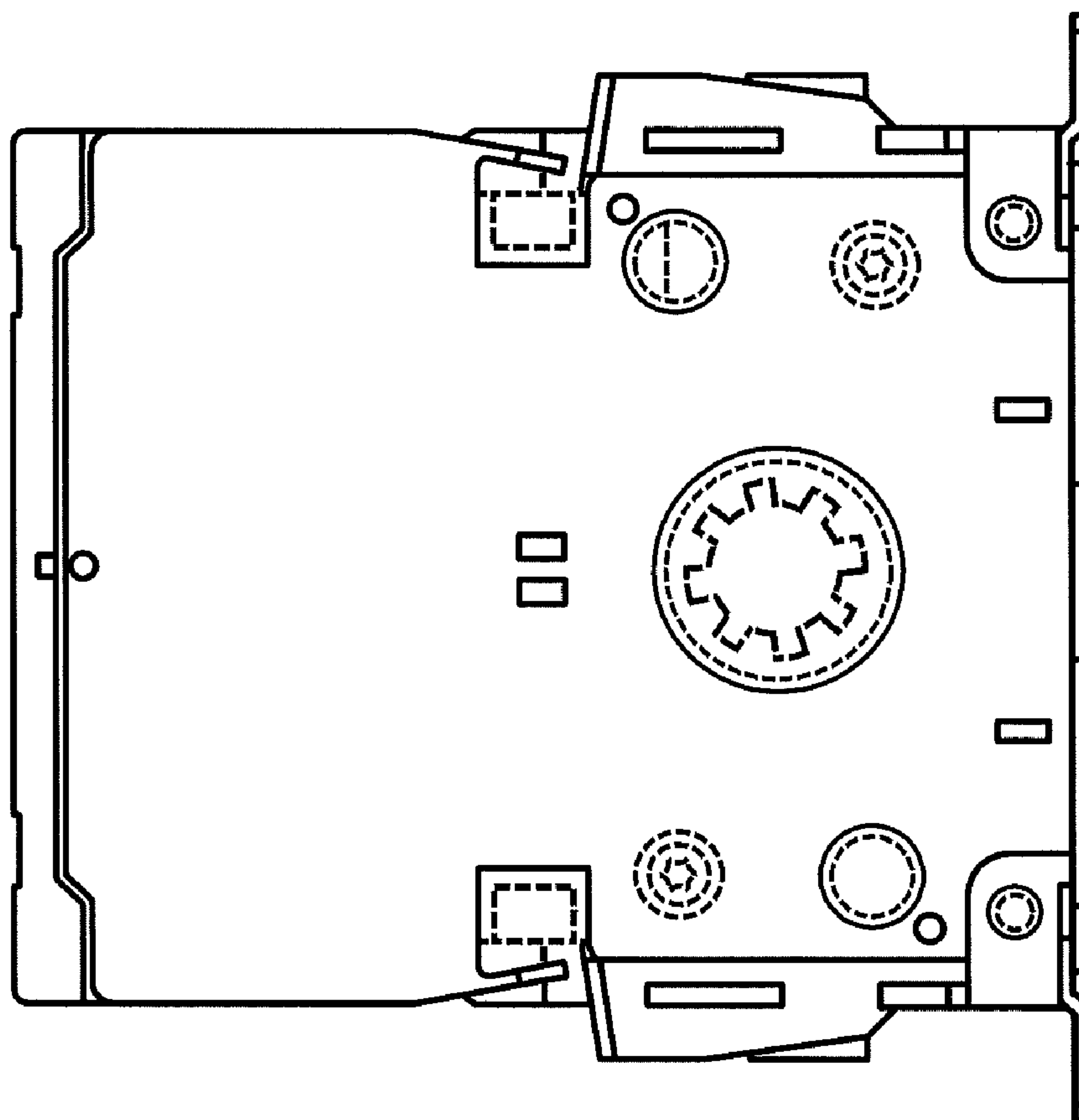

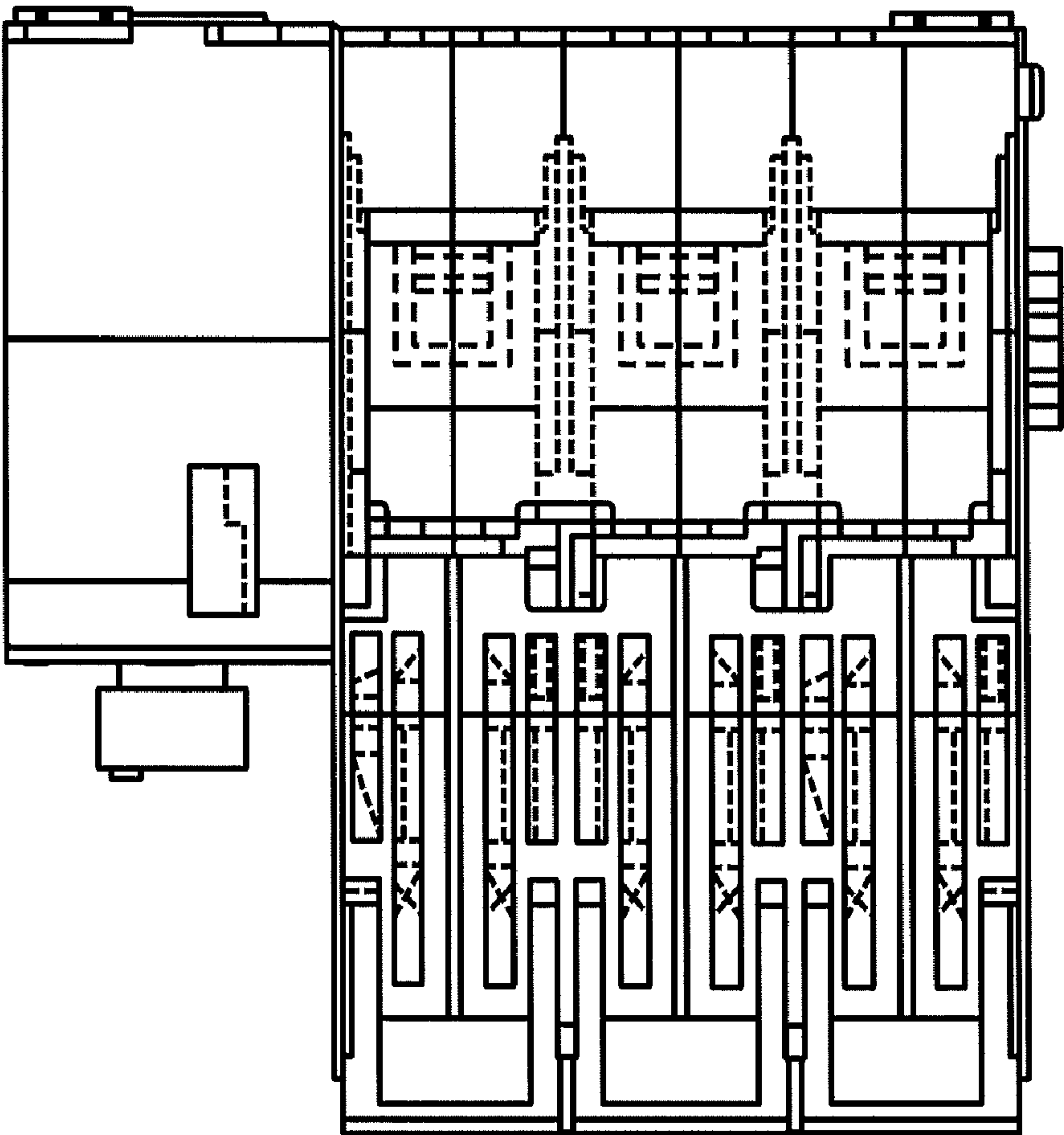
