The ornamental design for a portable beverage dispenser with four spigots and one divider, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded top perspective view of a portable beverage dispenser with four spigots and one divider showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an exploded side elevational view thereof (the opposite side elevation being a mirror image thereof);

FIG. 3 is an exploded front elevational view thereof (the rear elevation being a mirror image thereof);

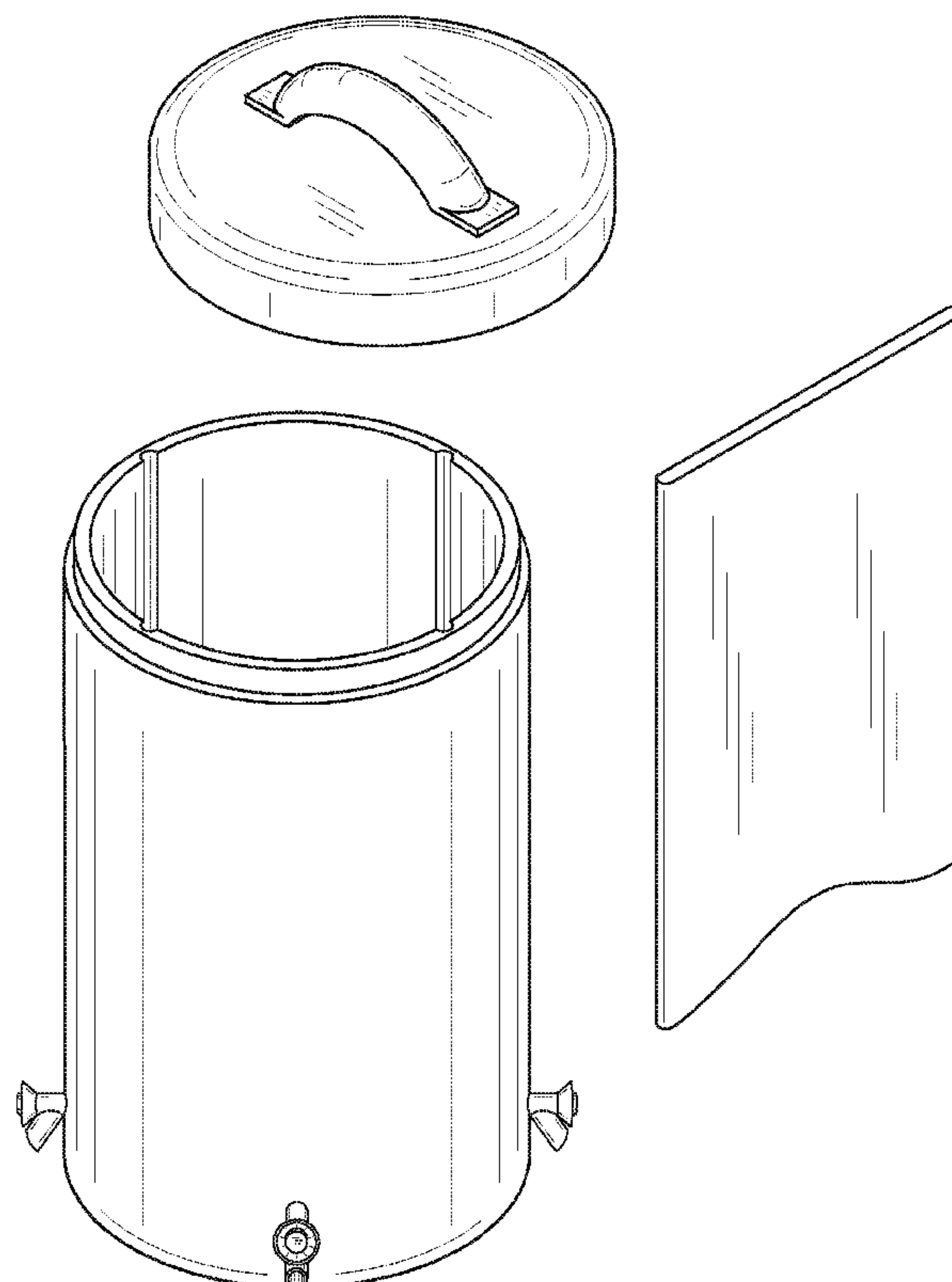
FIG. 4 is an exploded top plan view thereof;

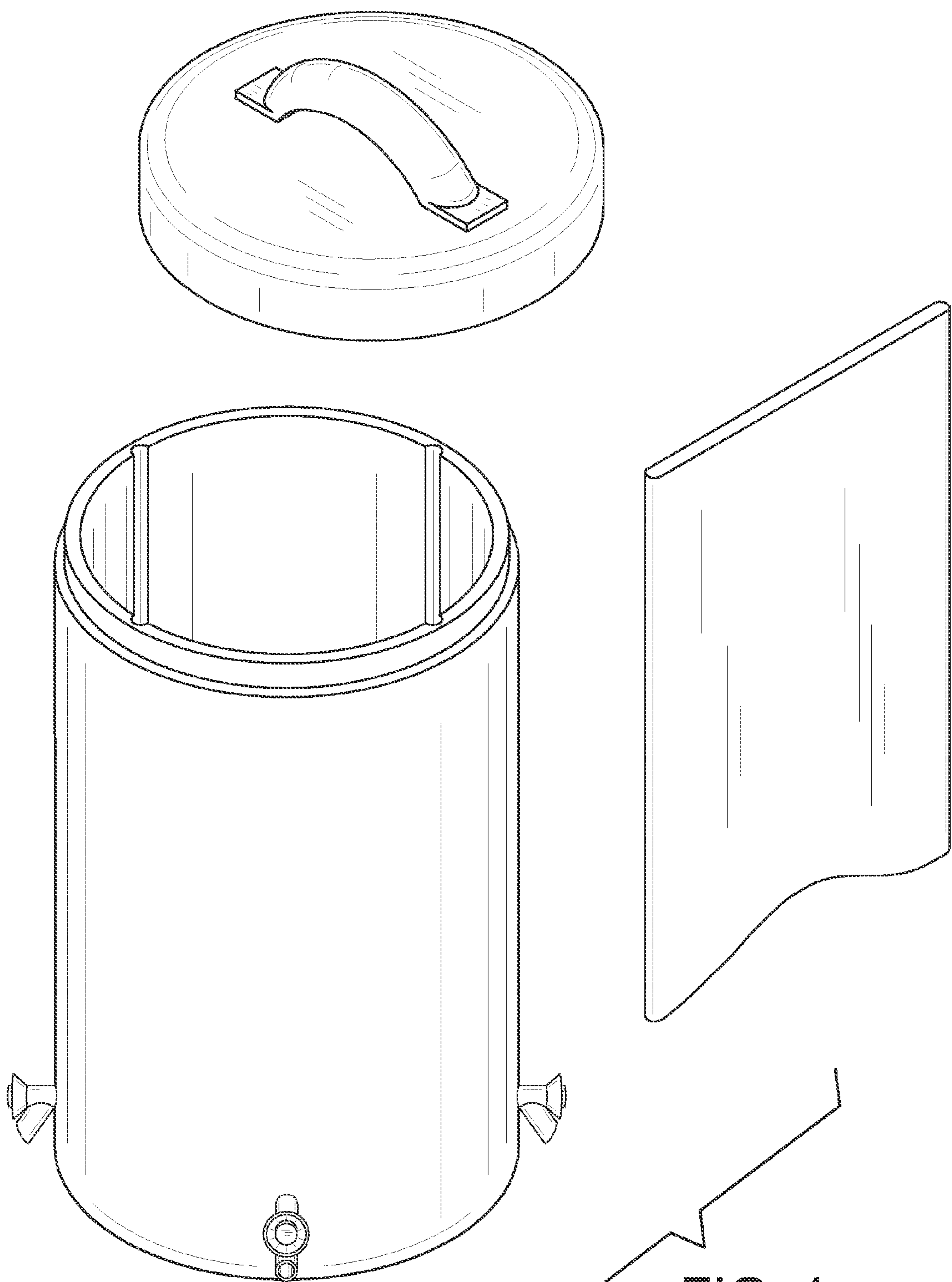

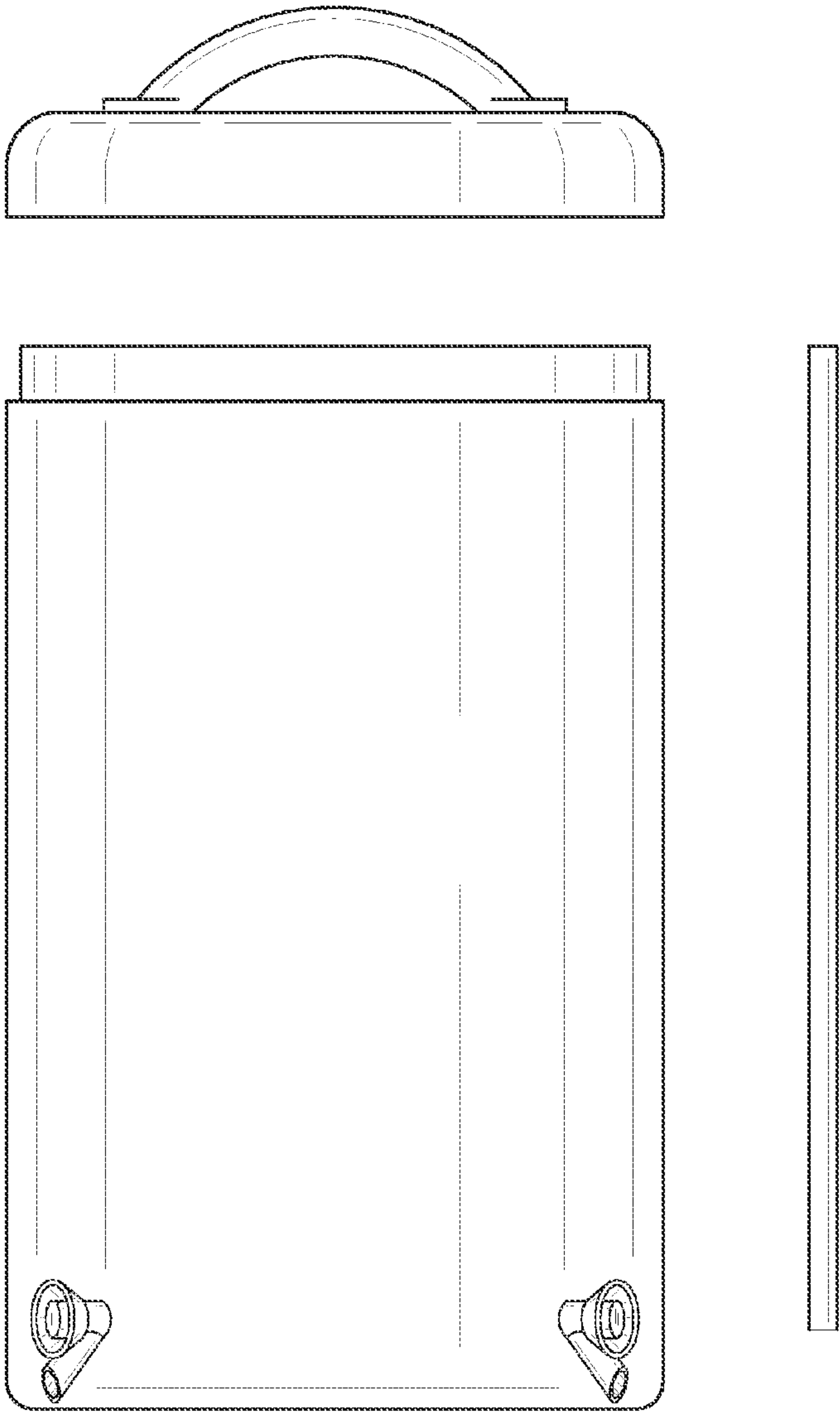

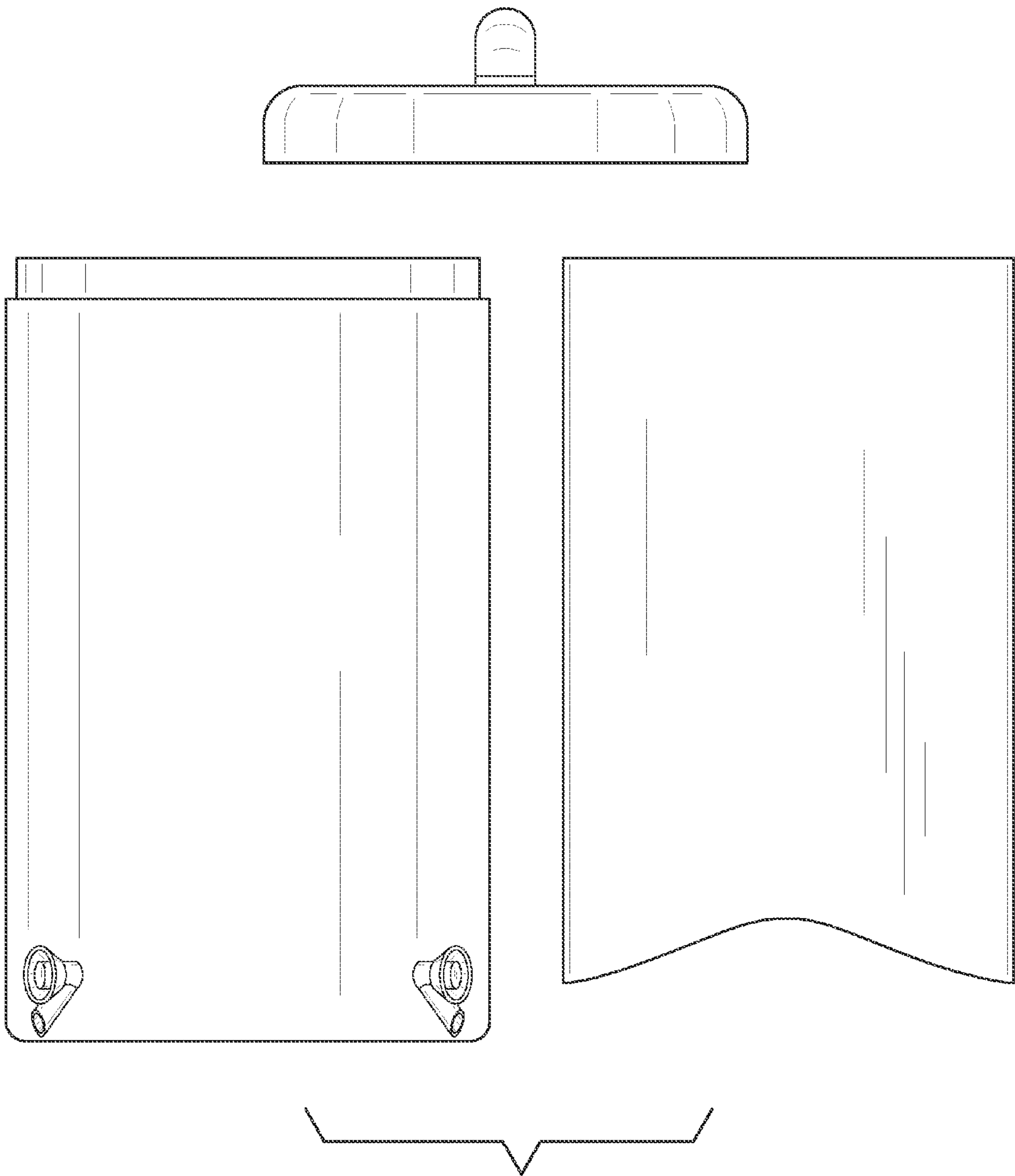

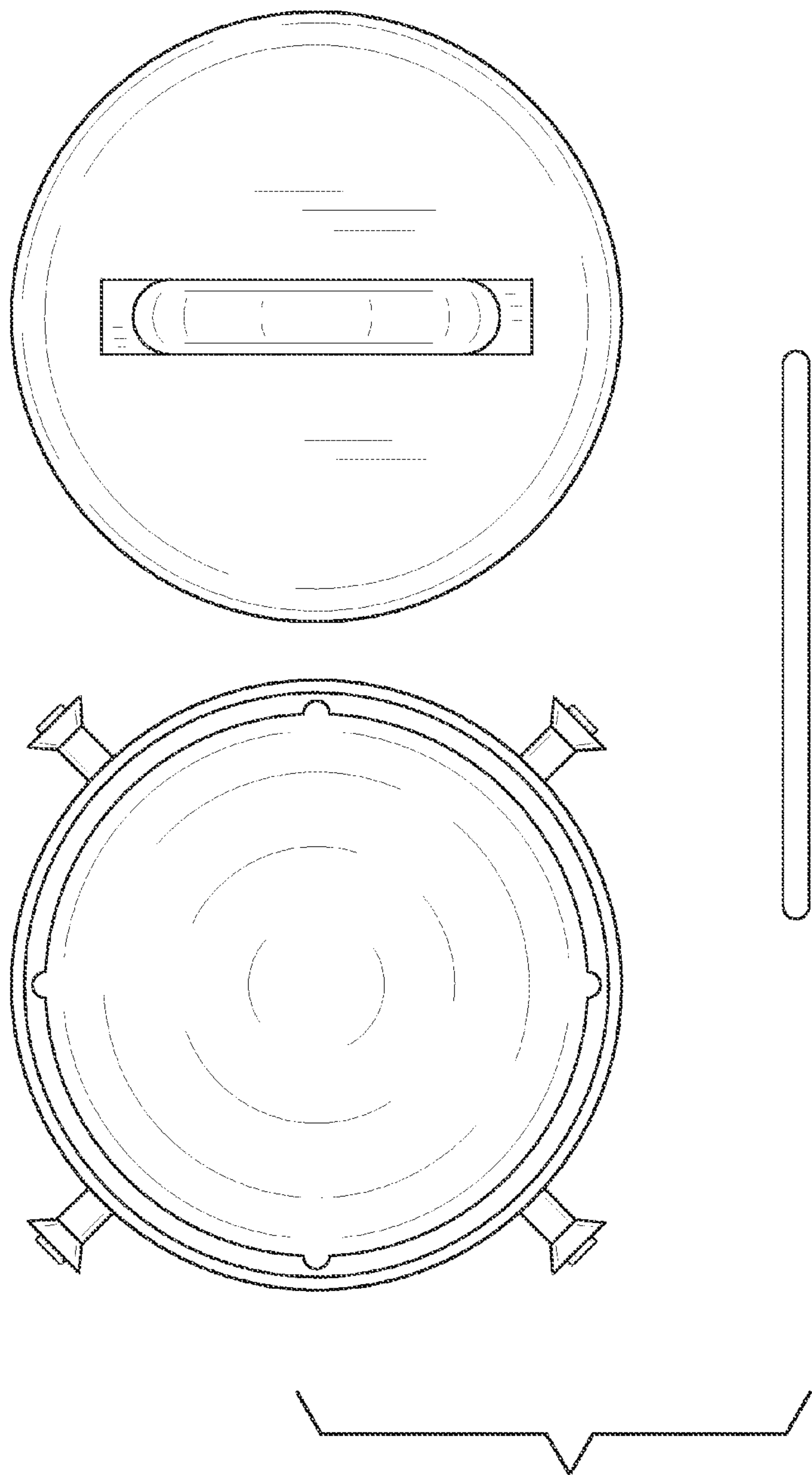

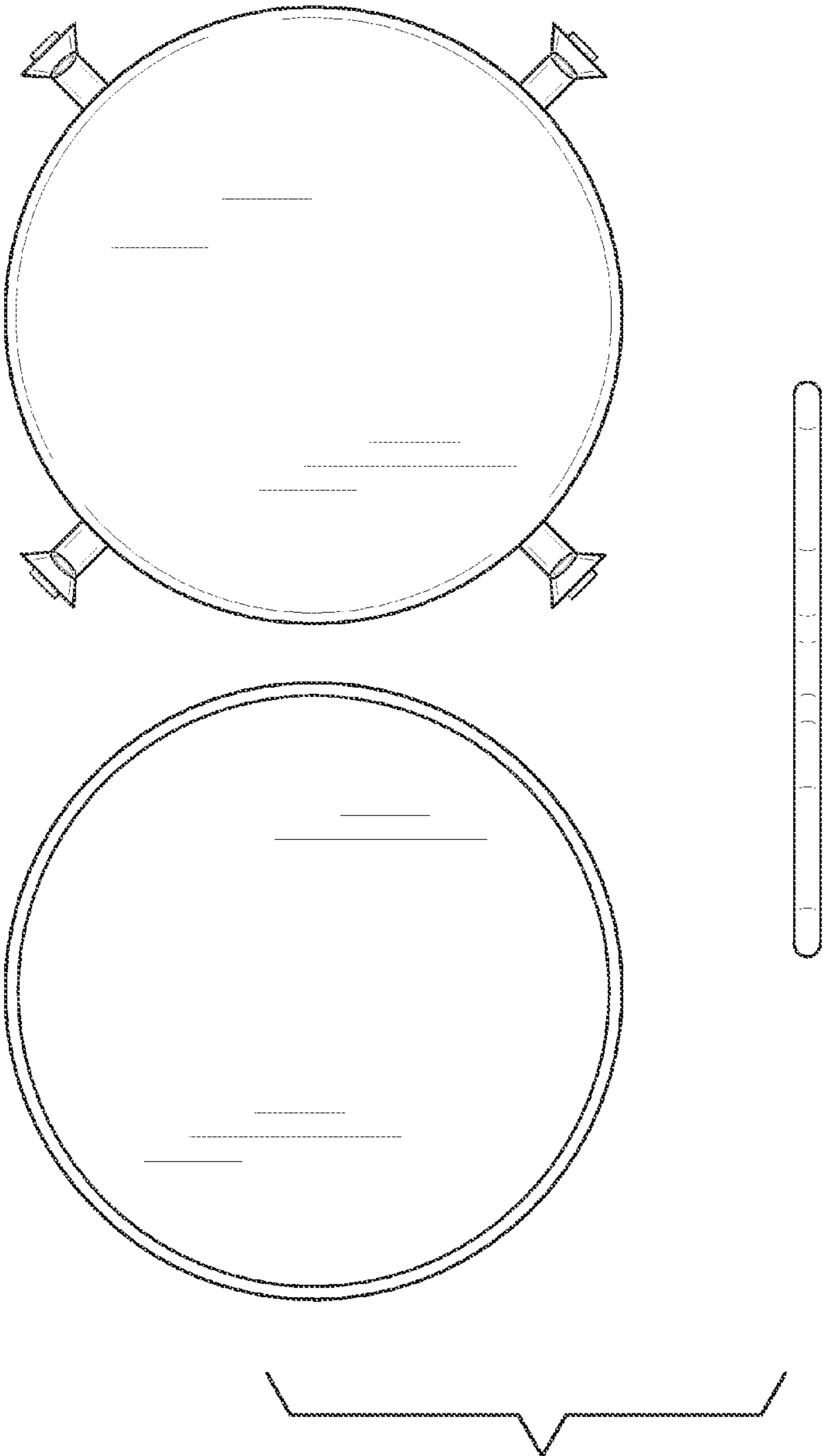

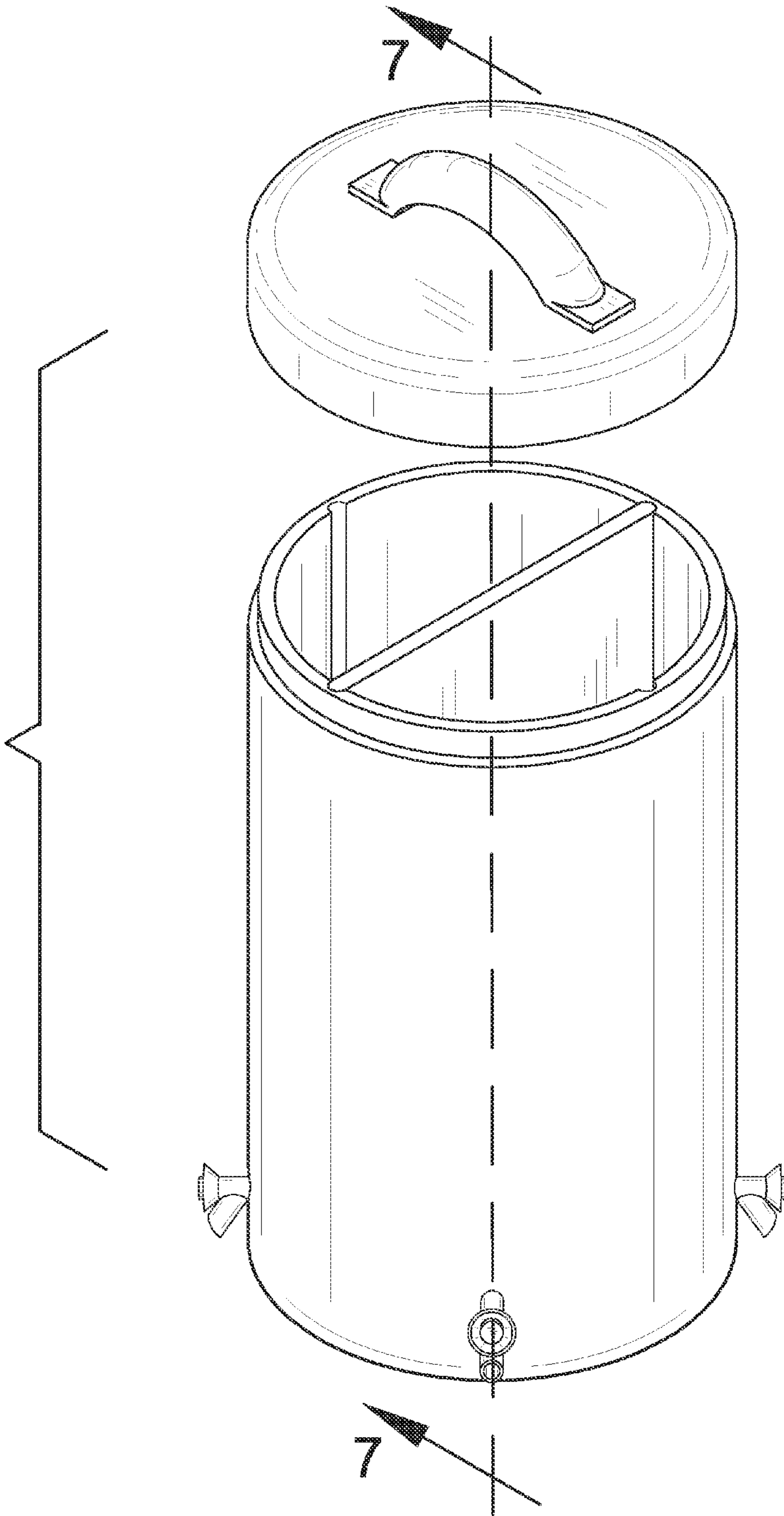

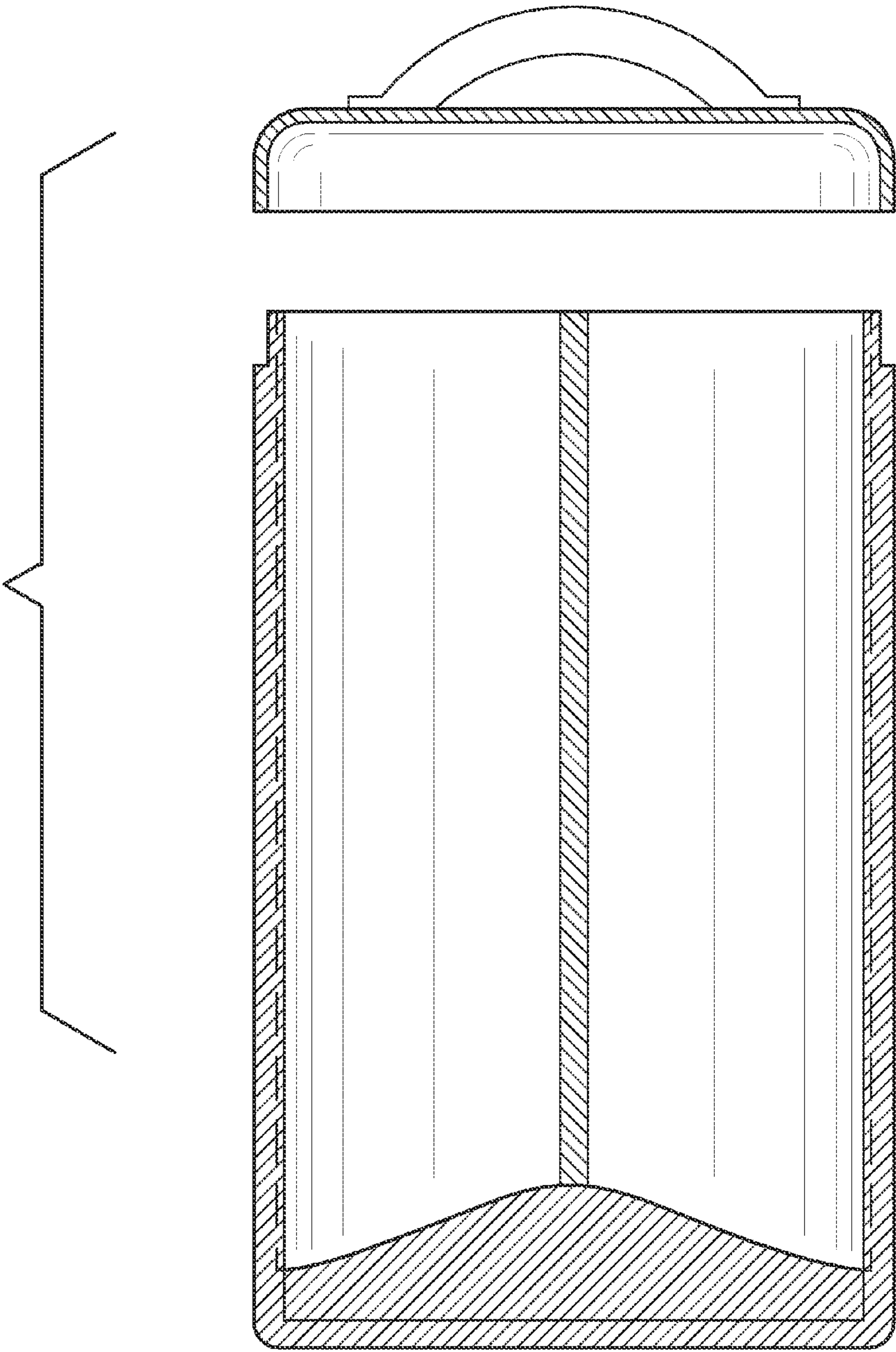
