The ornamental design for a belt carrier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view showing our new design for a belt carrier, the portions of the belt carrier shown in dotted and dashed lines form no part of the claimed design, FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof, FIG. 3 is a front view thereof, the portions of the belt carrier shown in dotted and dashed lines form no part of the claimed design, FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof, the portions of the belt carrier shown in dotted and dashed lines form no part of the claimed design, FIG. 5 is a top view thereof, FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image, the portions of the belt carrier shown in dotted and dashed lines form no part of the claimed design. The broken line showing of surfaces of the belt carrier represents stitching and forms a part of the claimed design.














