(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined trash and recycling receptacle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined trash and recycling receptacle having a first bottom section of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a first side view of the receptacle of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a second side view of the receptacle of FIG. 1;

FIG. 19 is a perspective view of the receptacle having a third top section and a first bottom section of the present invention;

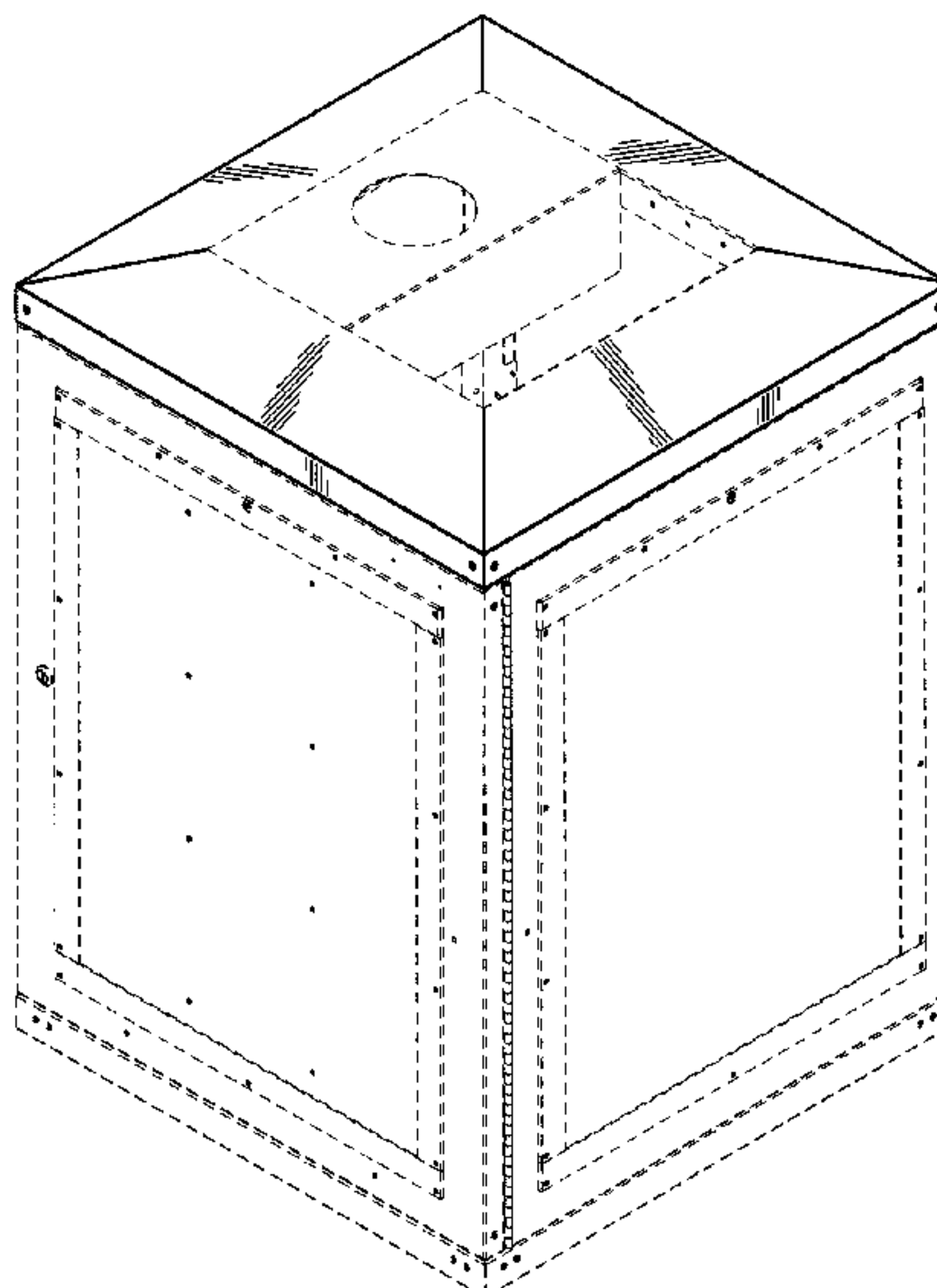
FIG. 20 is a top view of the receptacle of FIG. 19.

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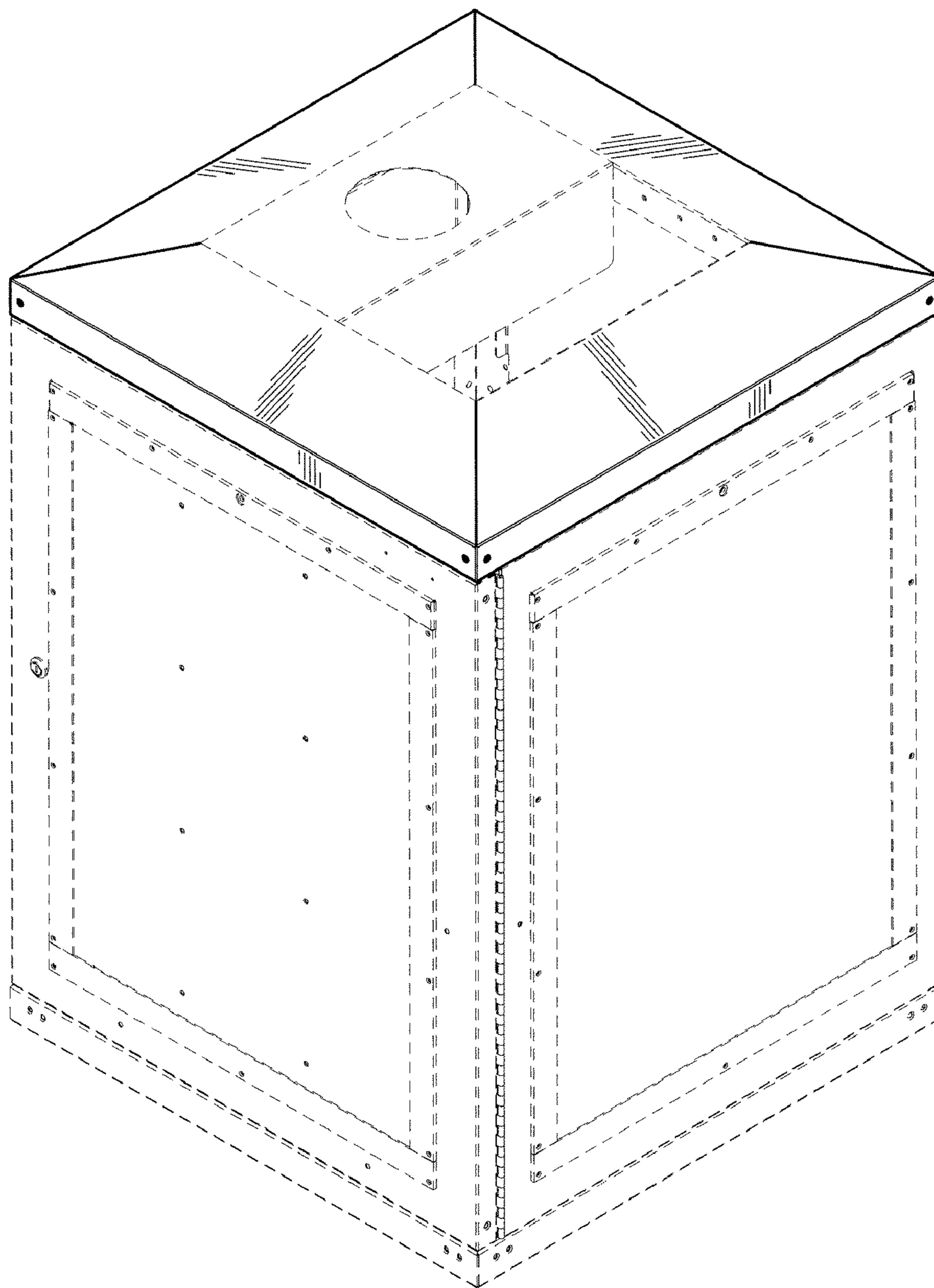

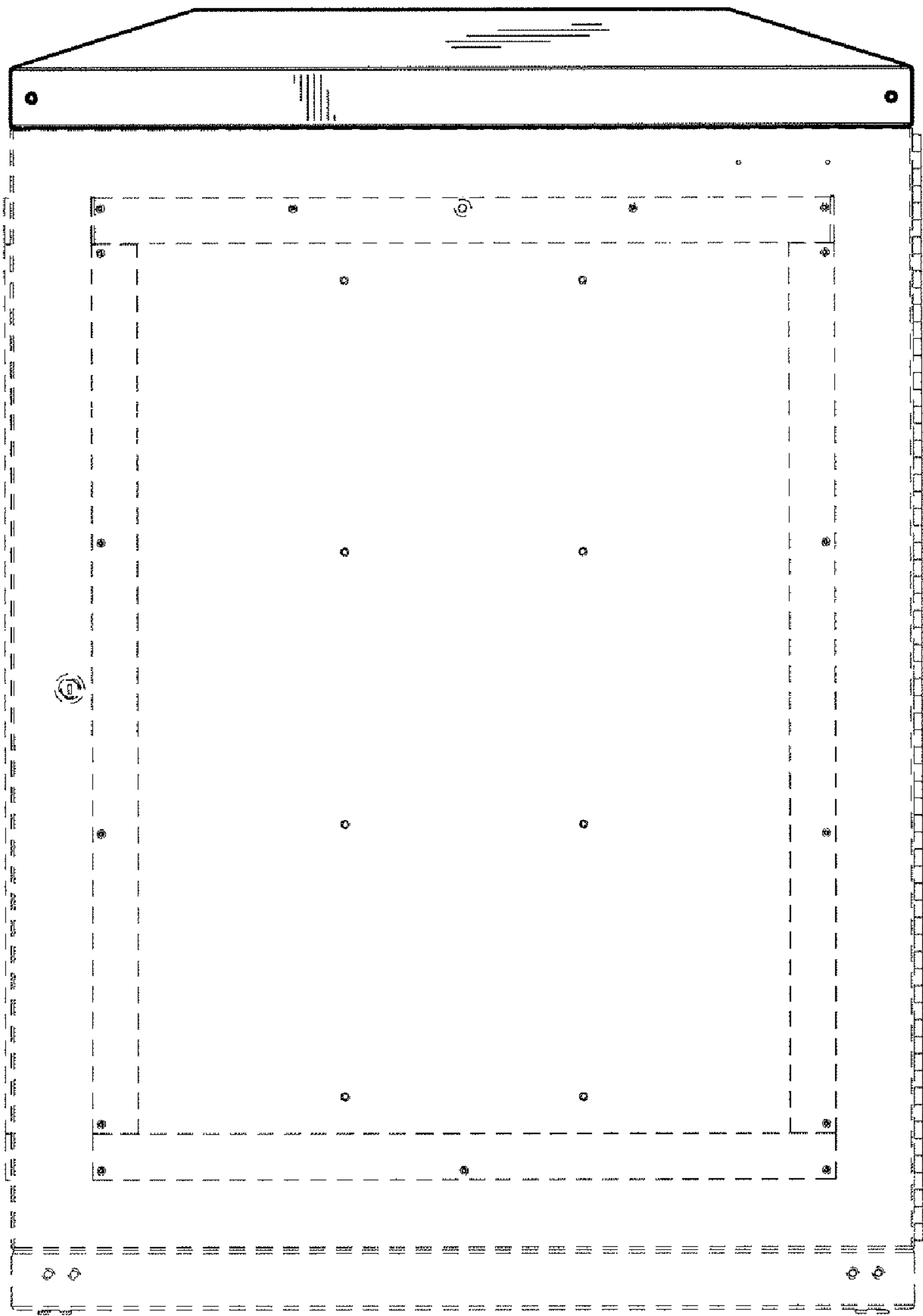

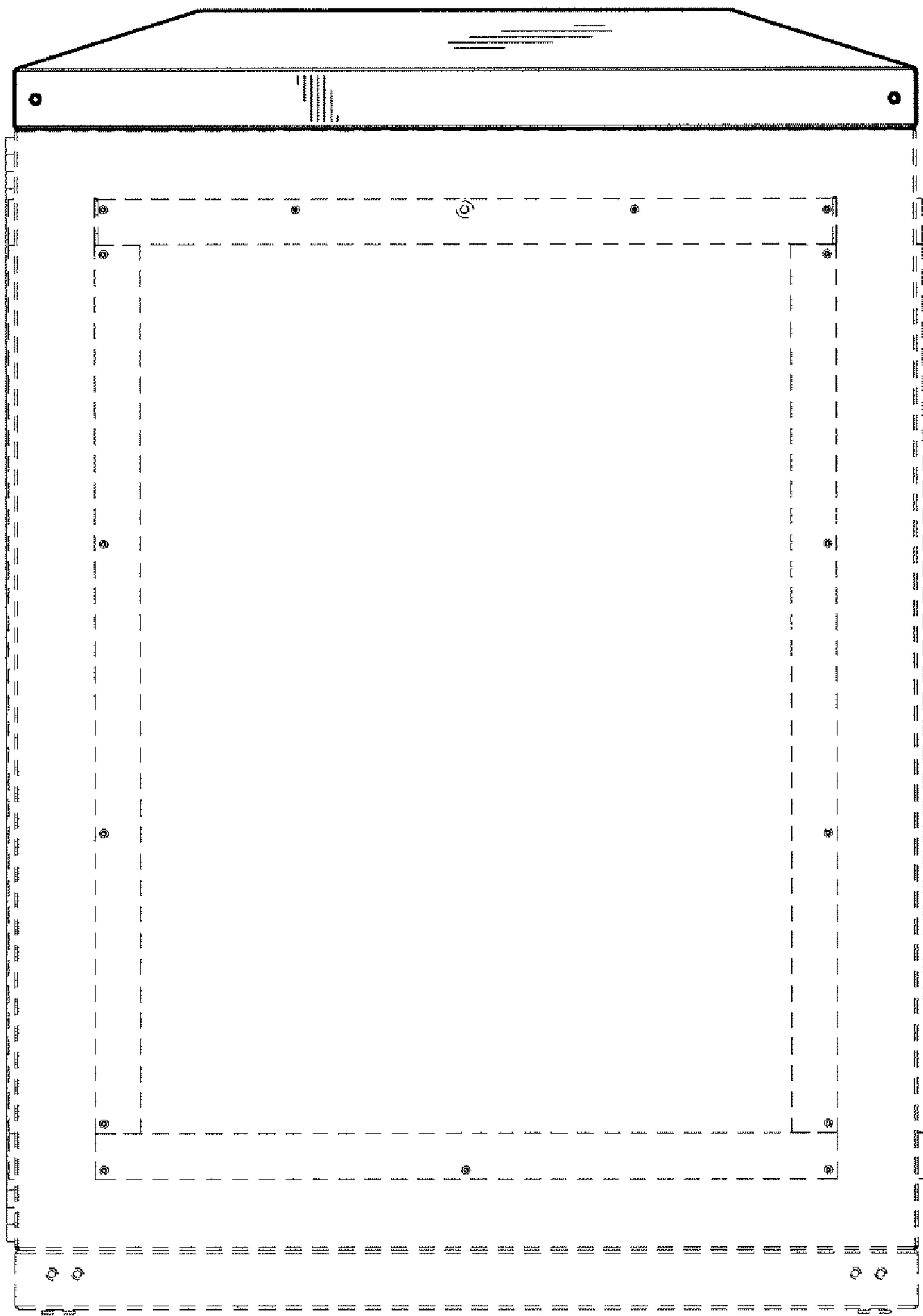

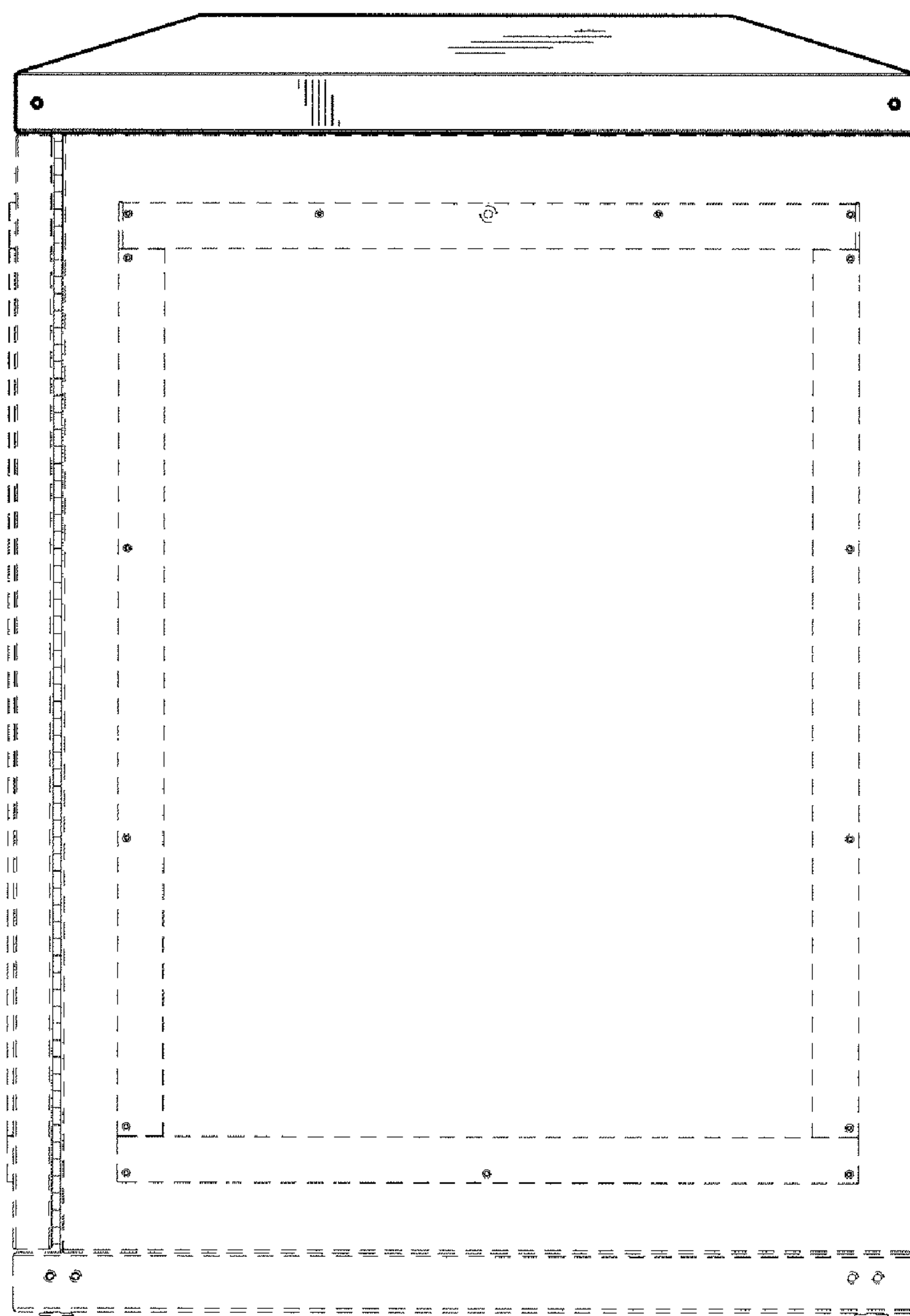

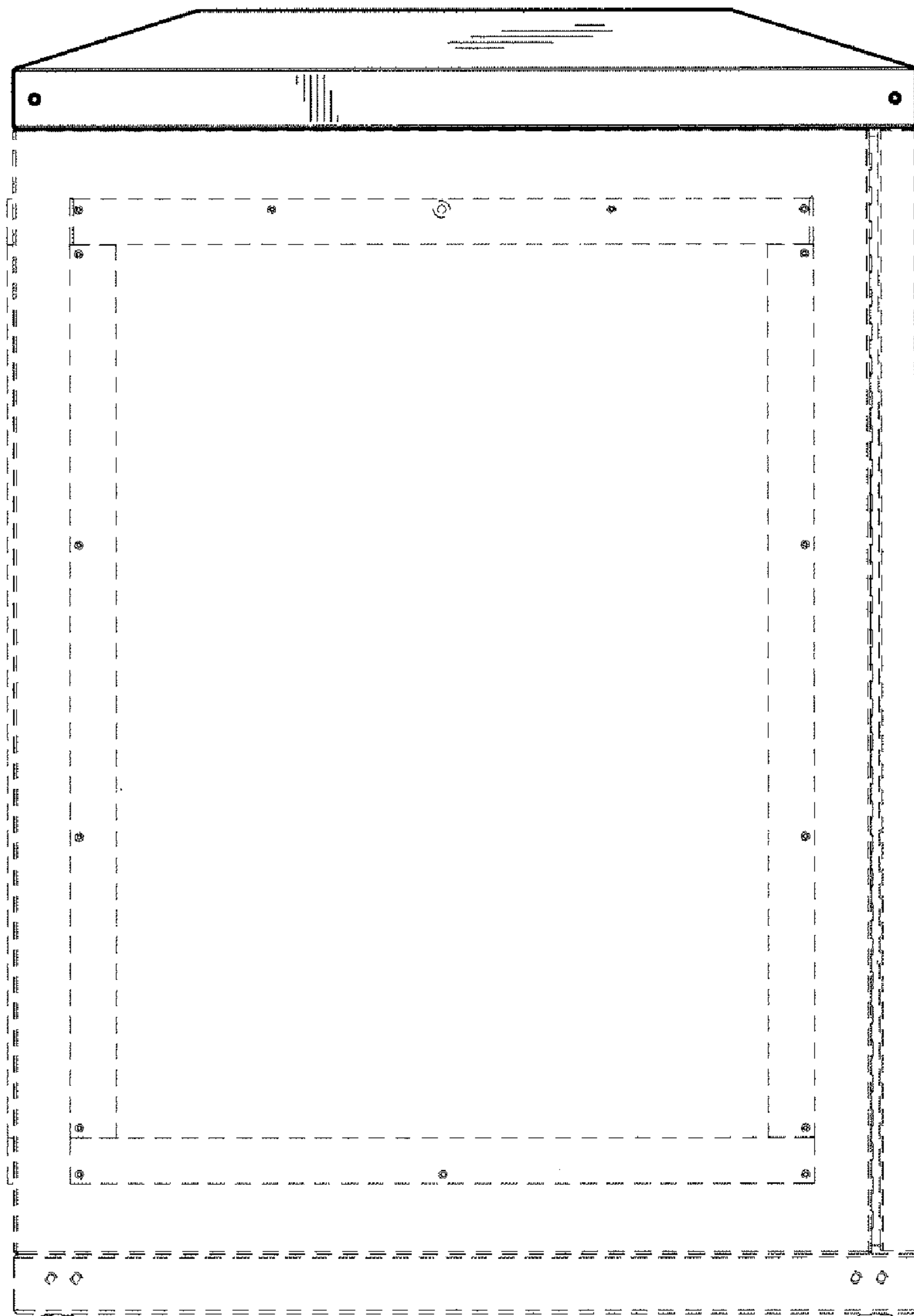

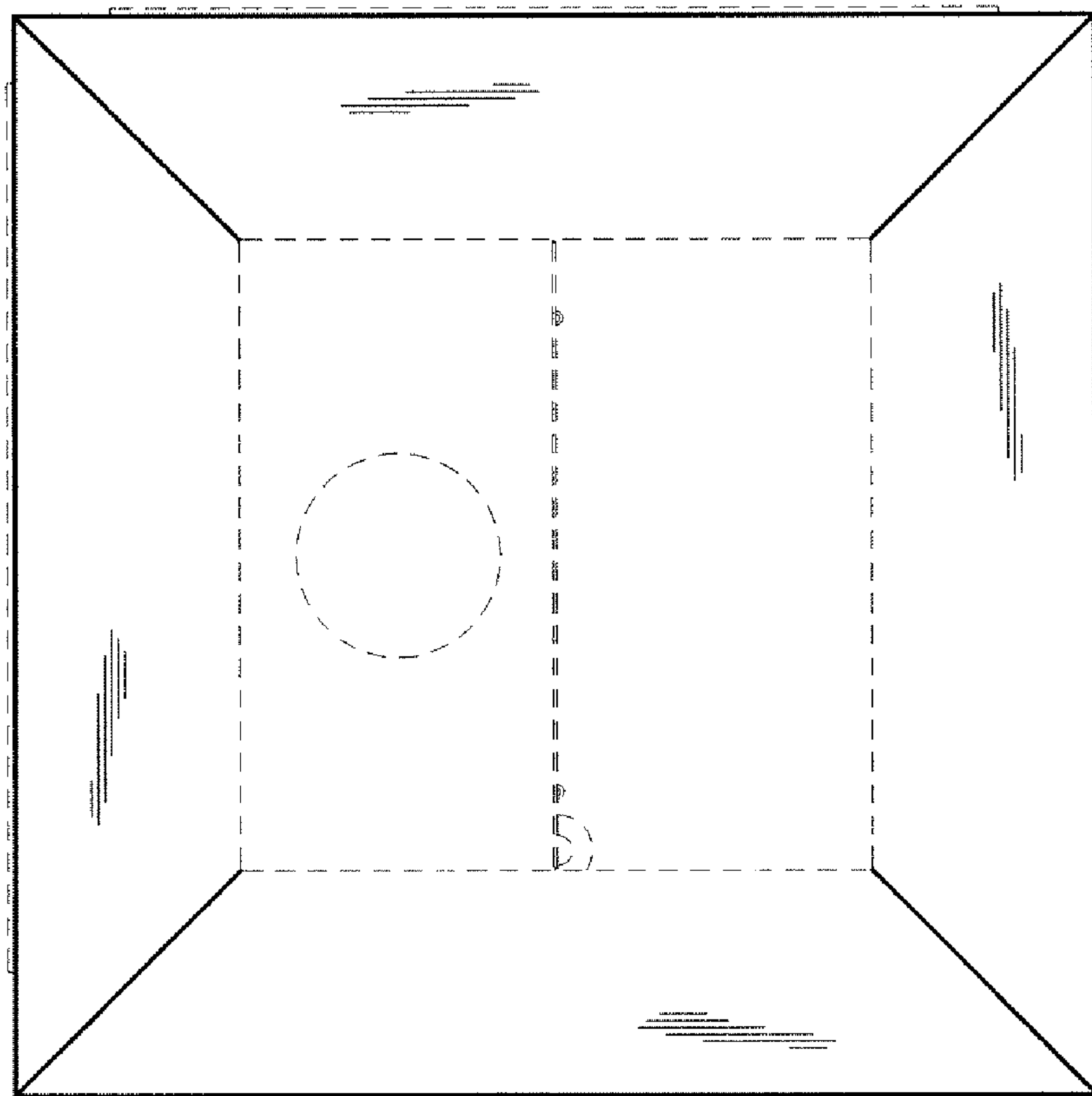

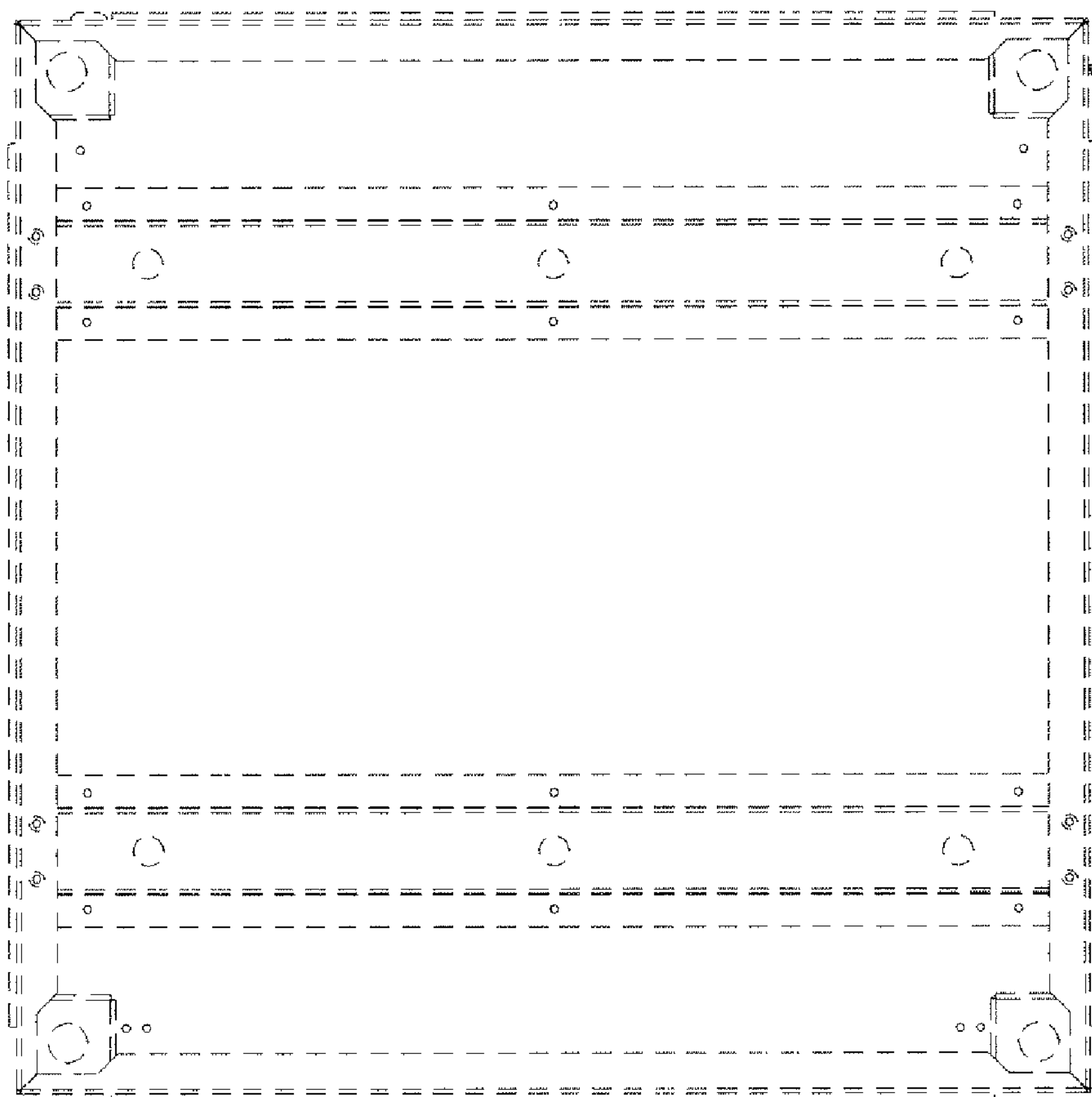

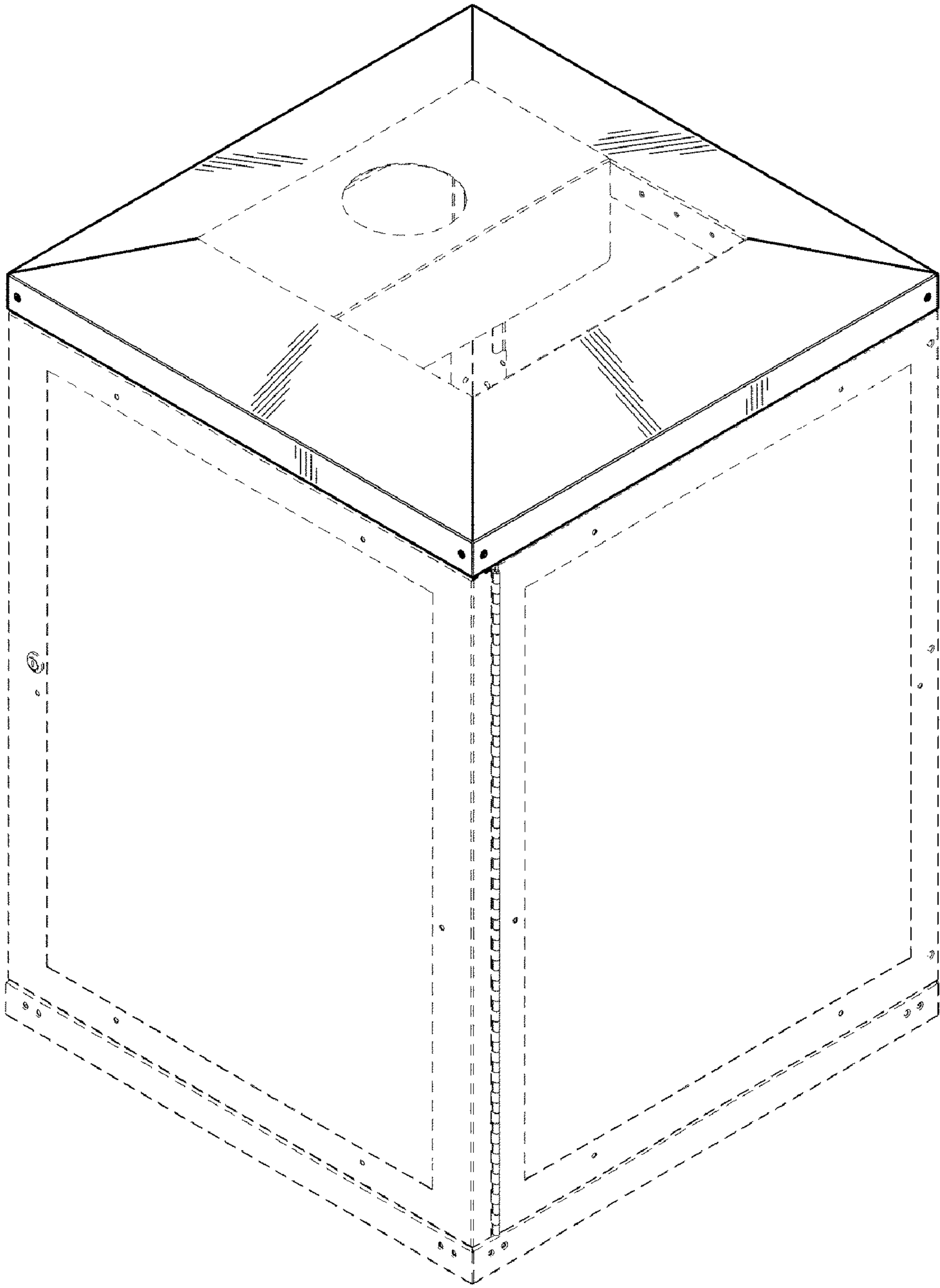

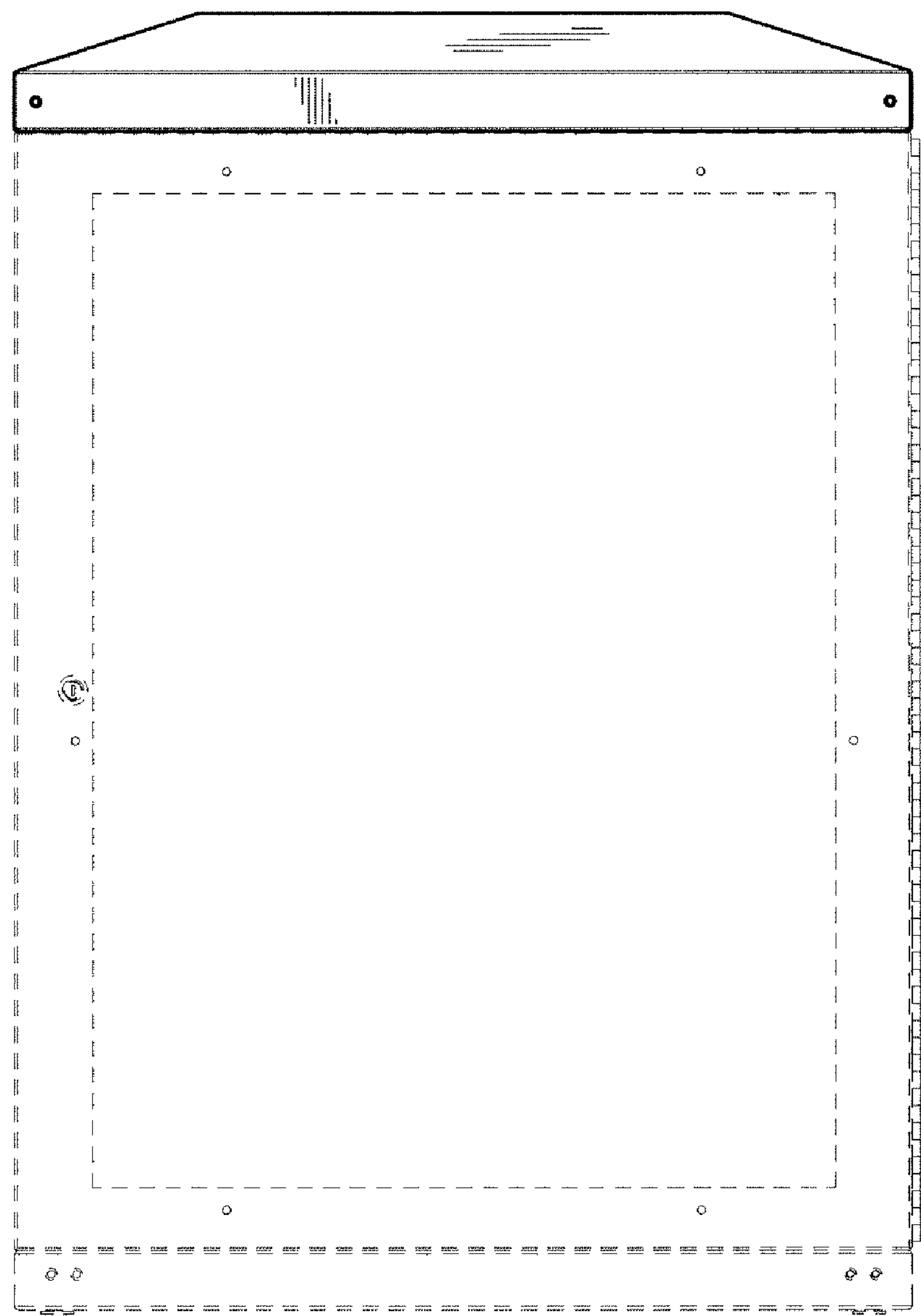

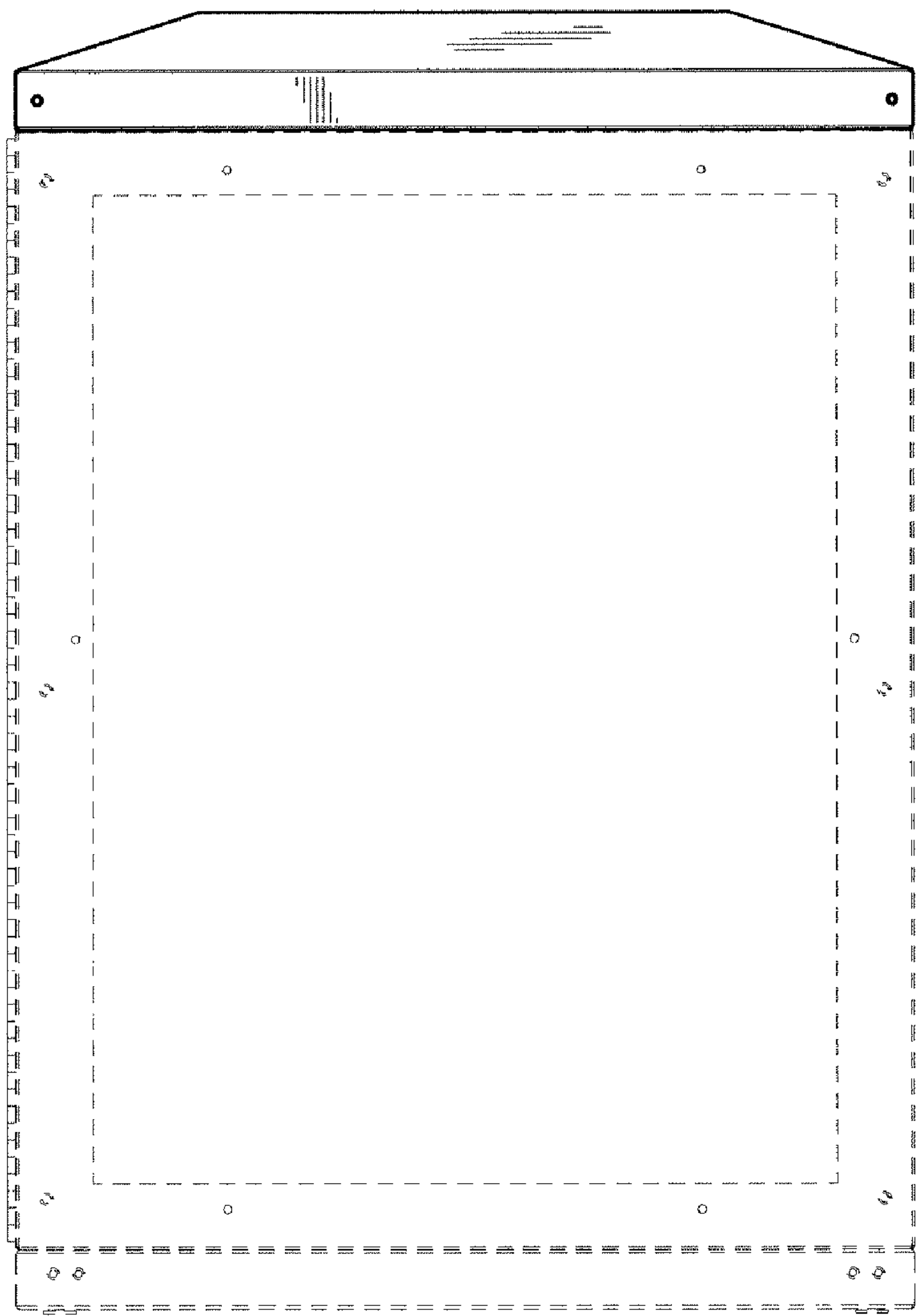

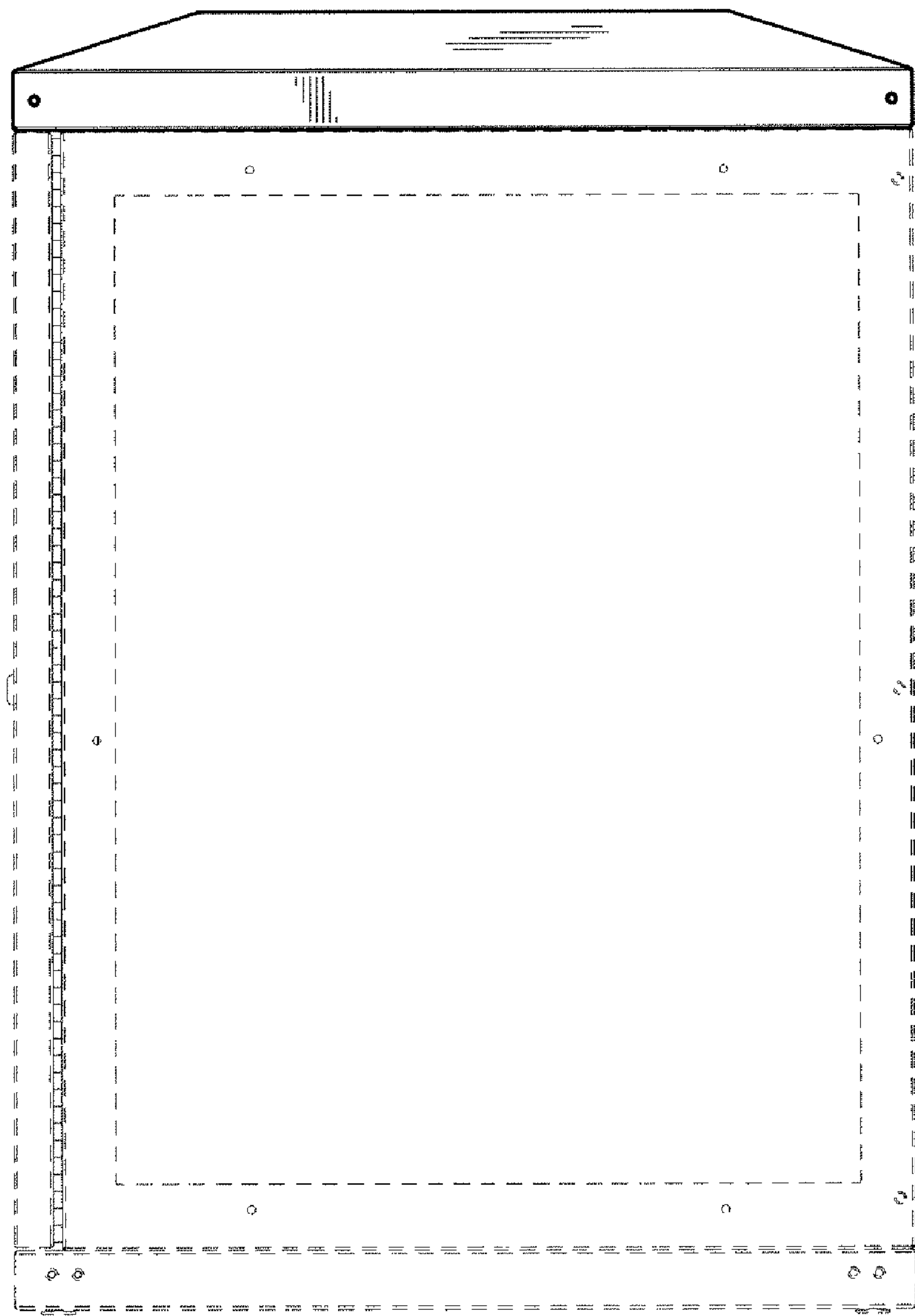

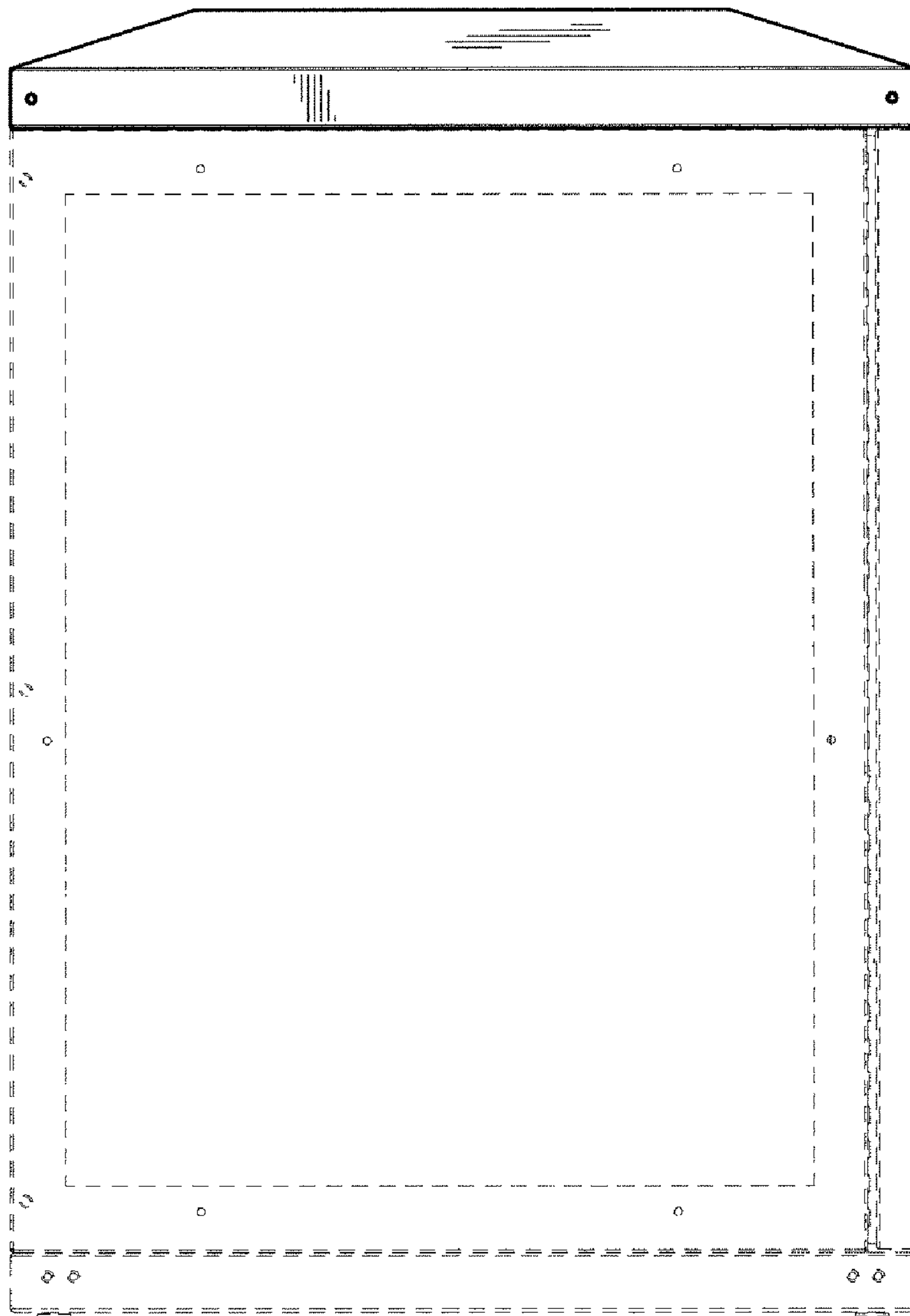

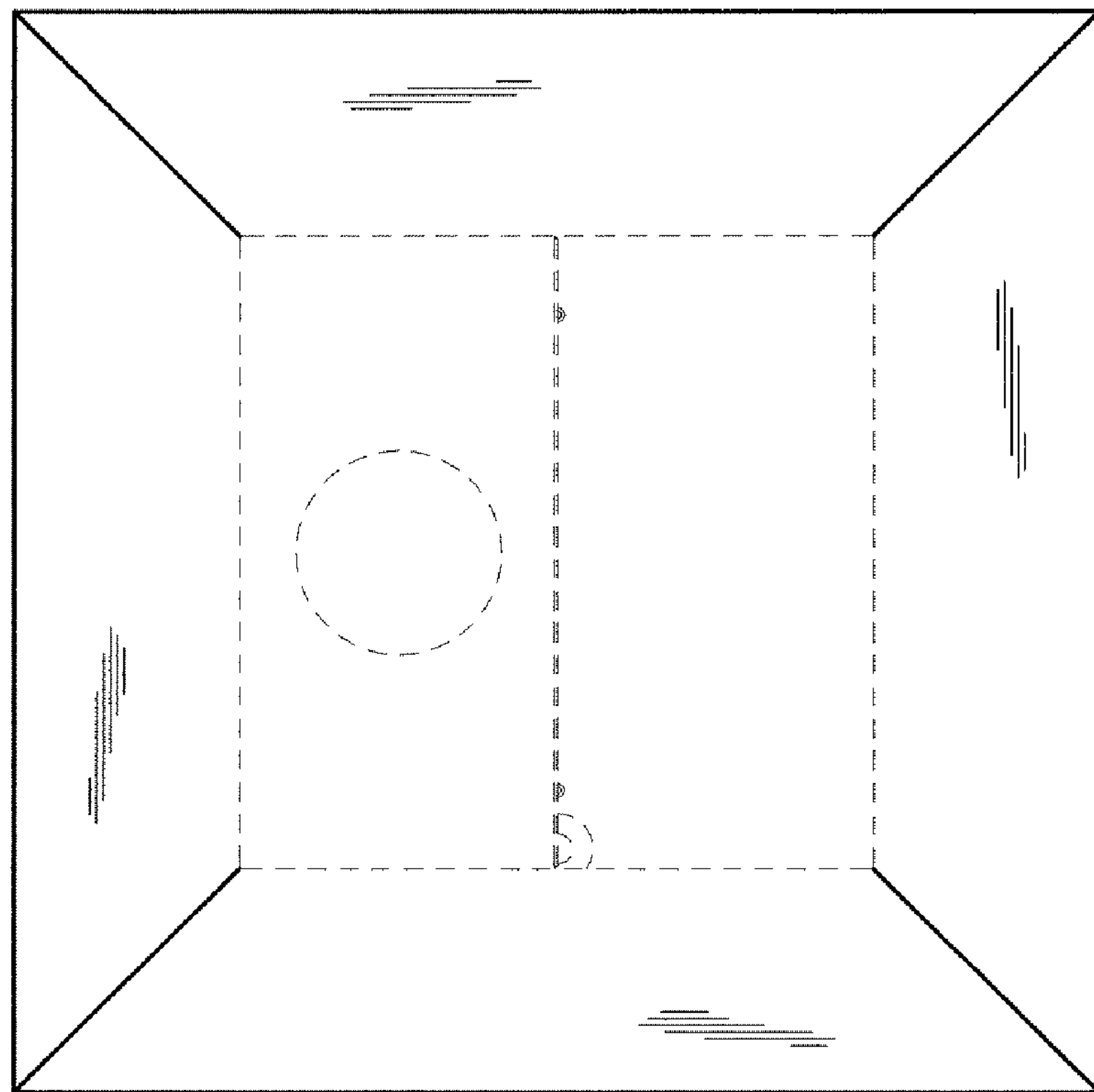

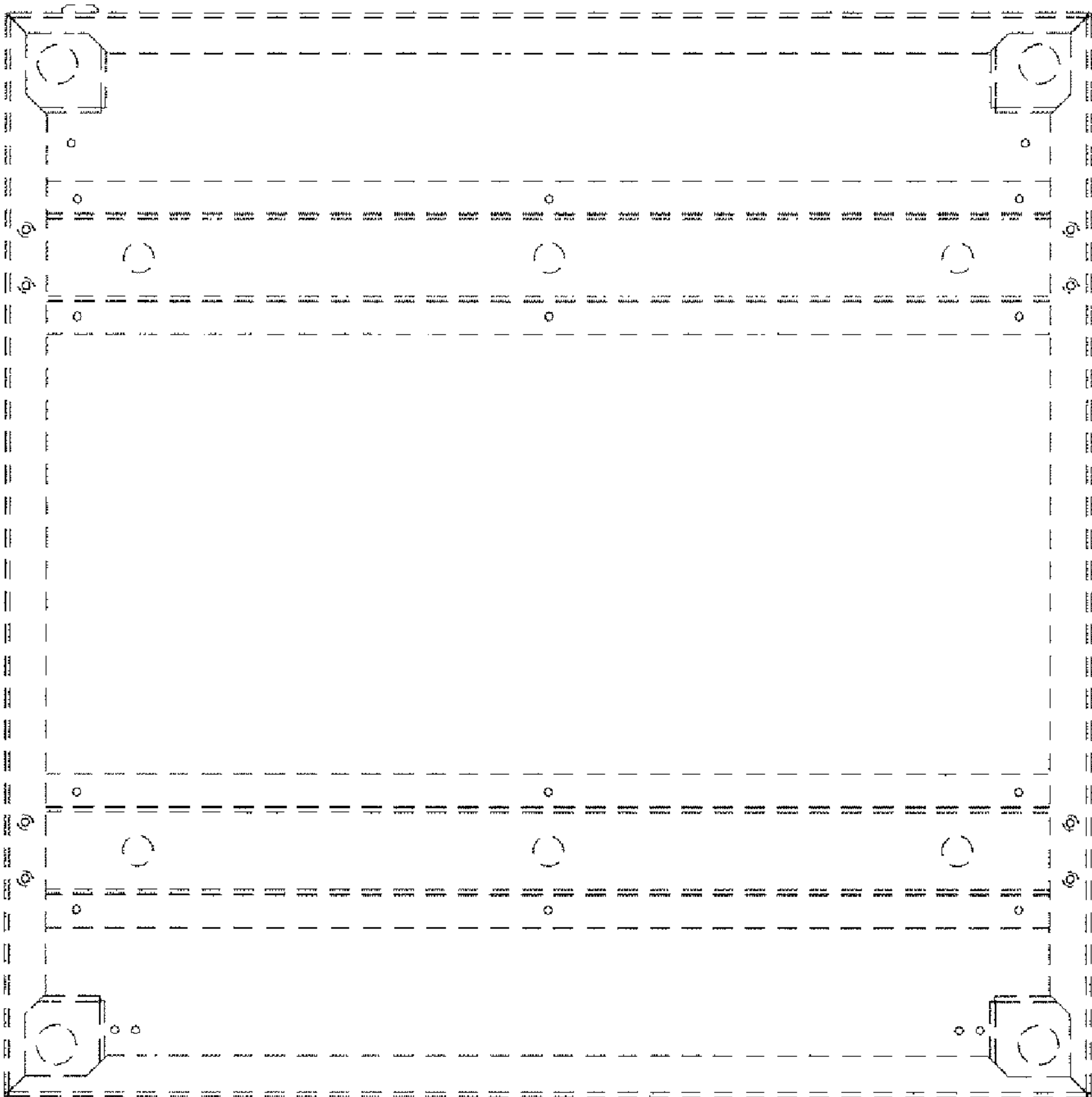

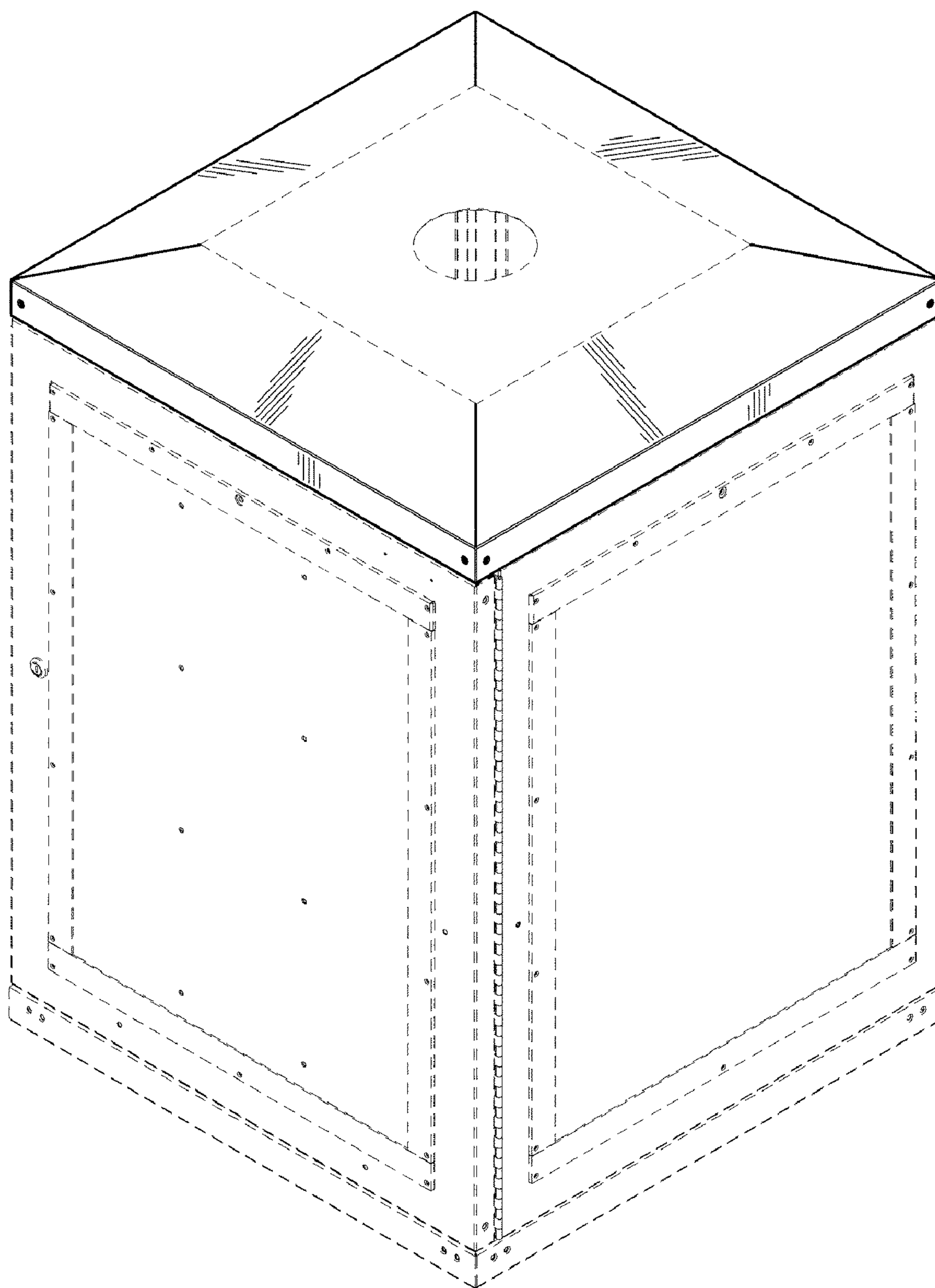

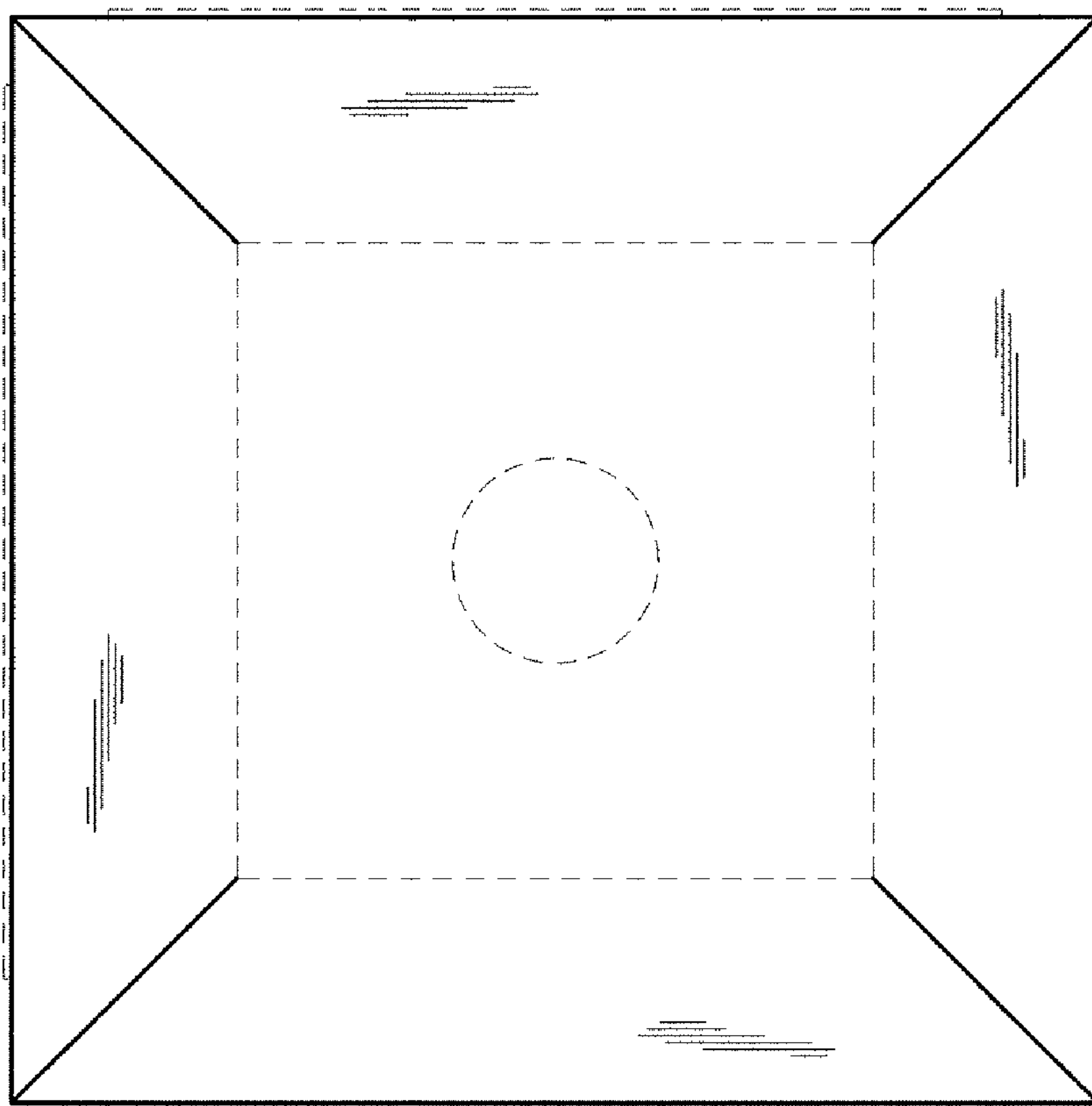

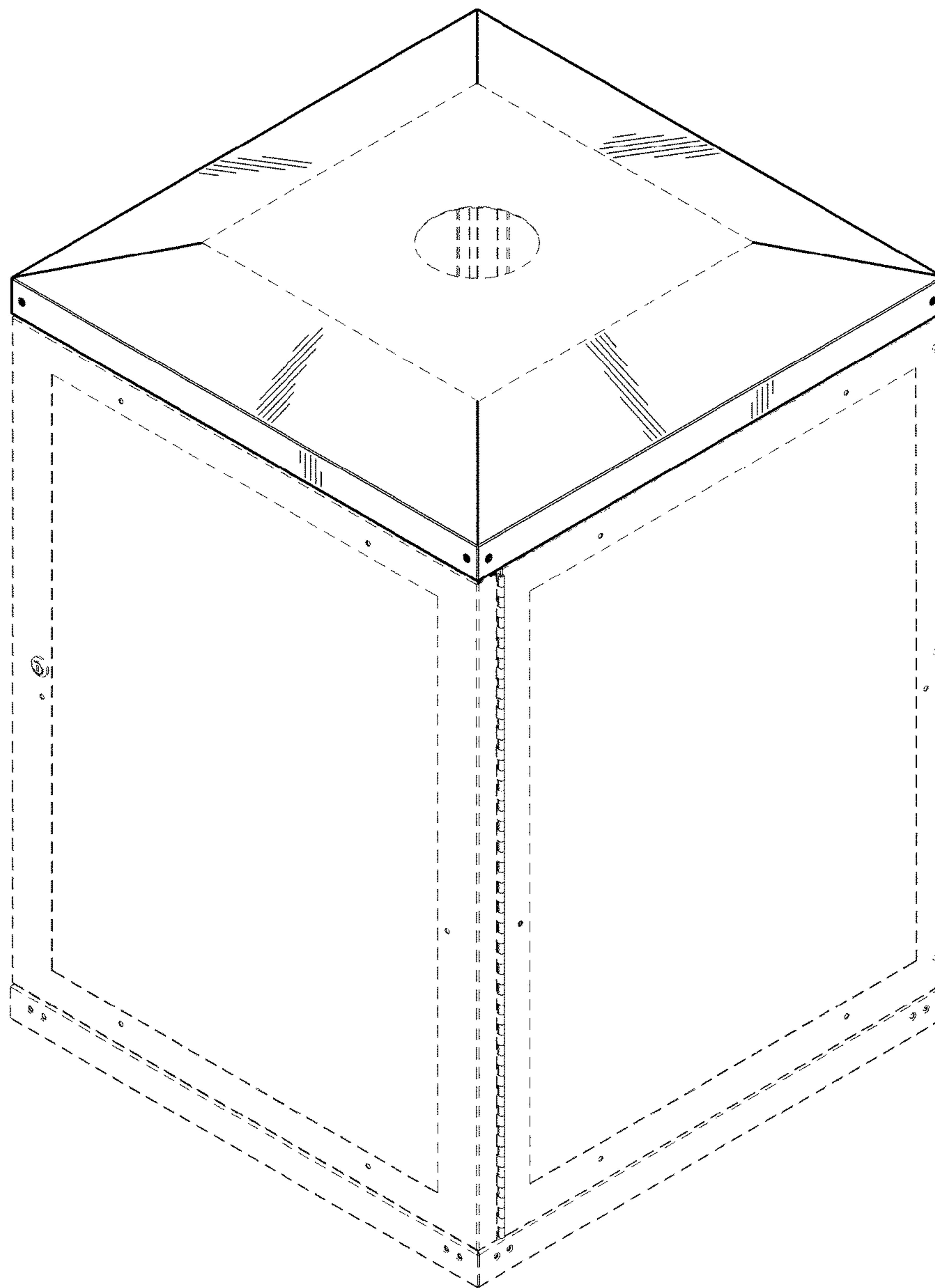

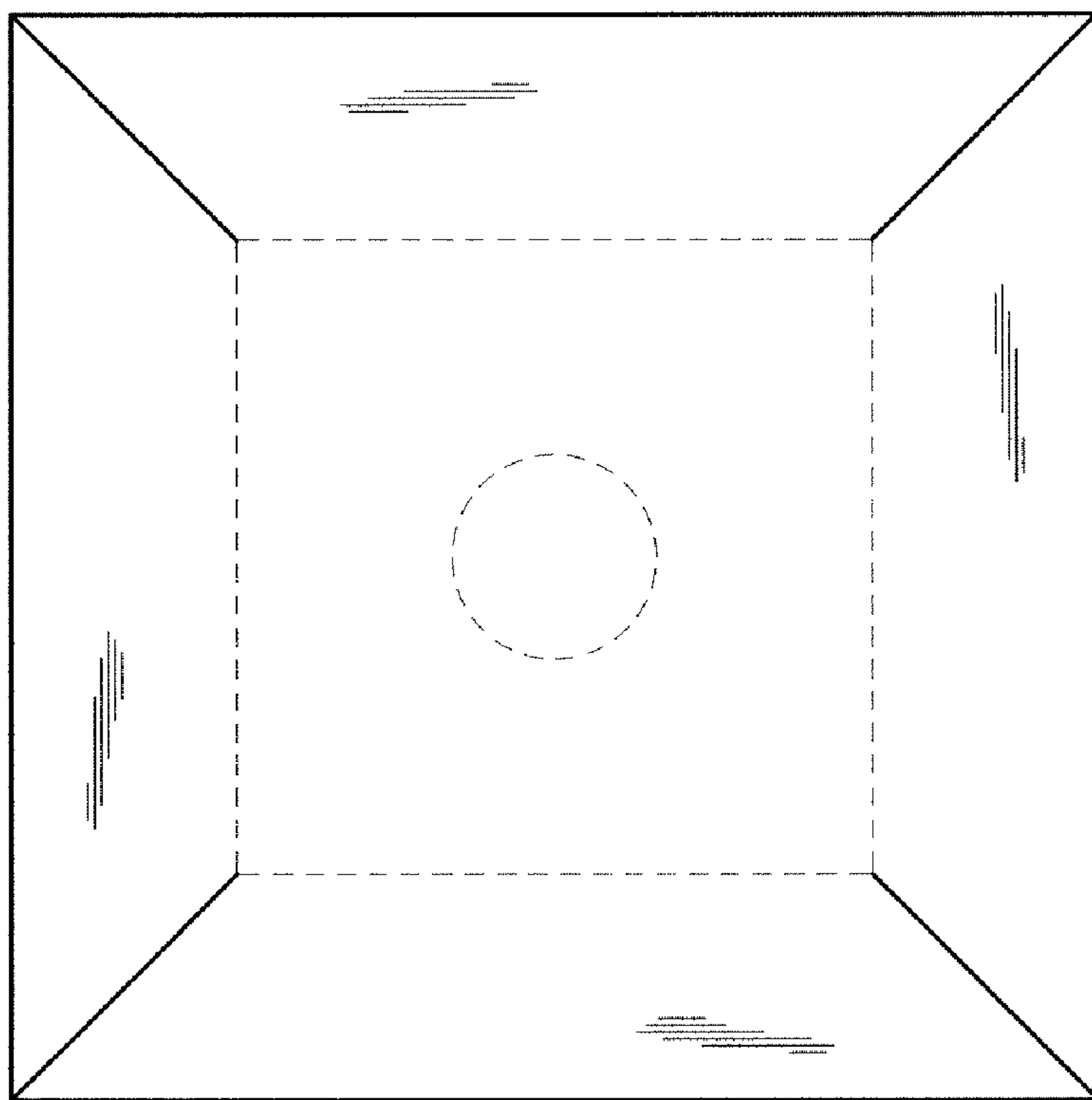

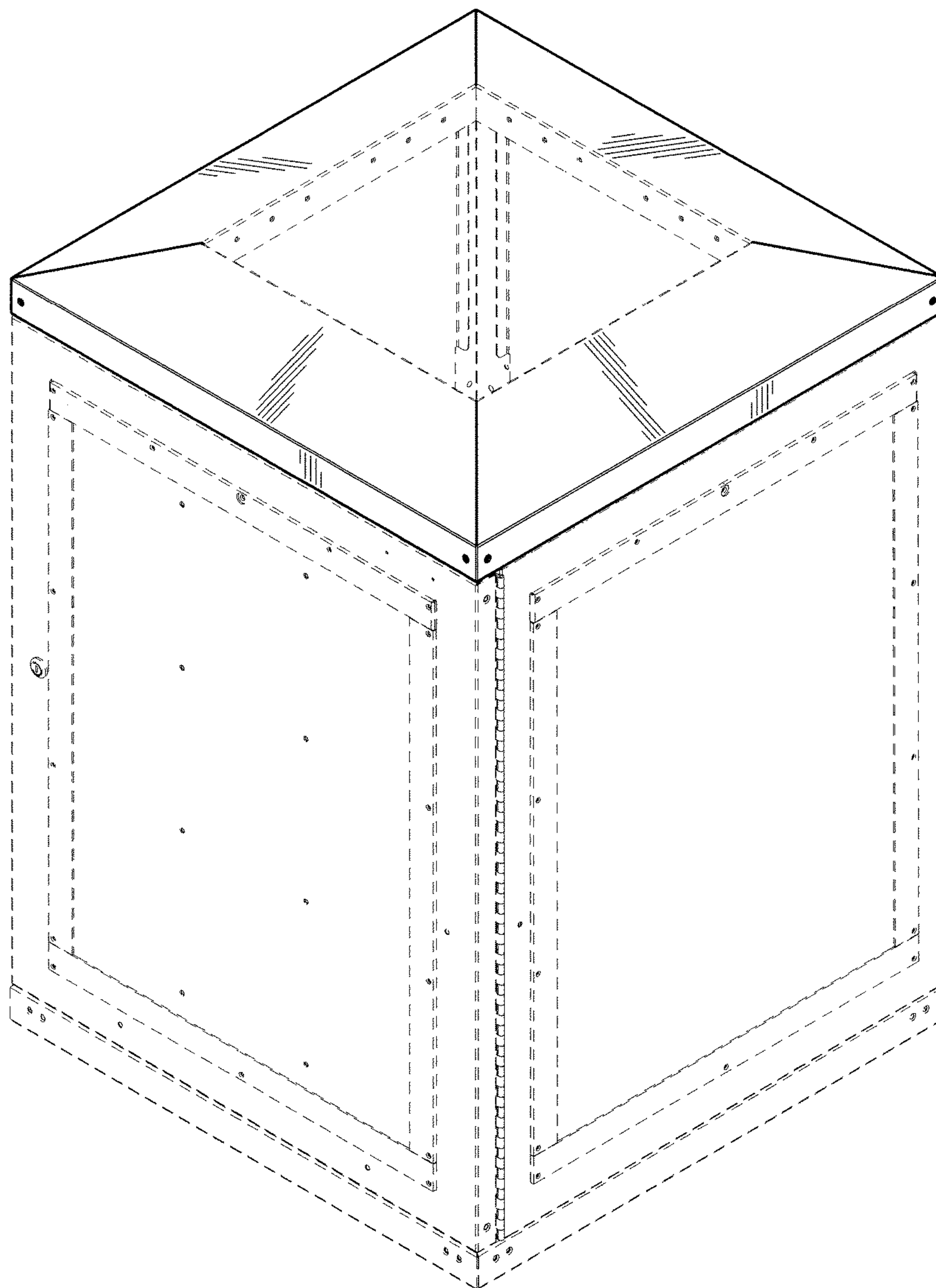

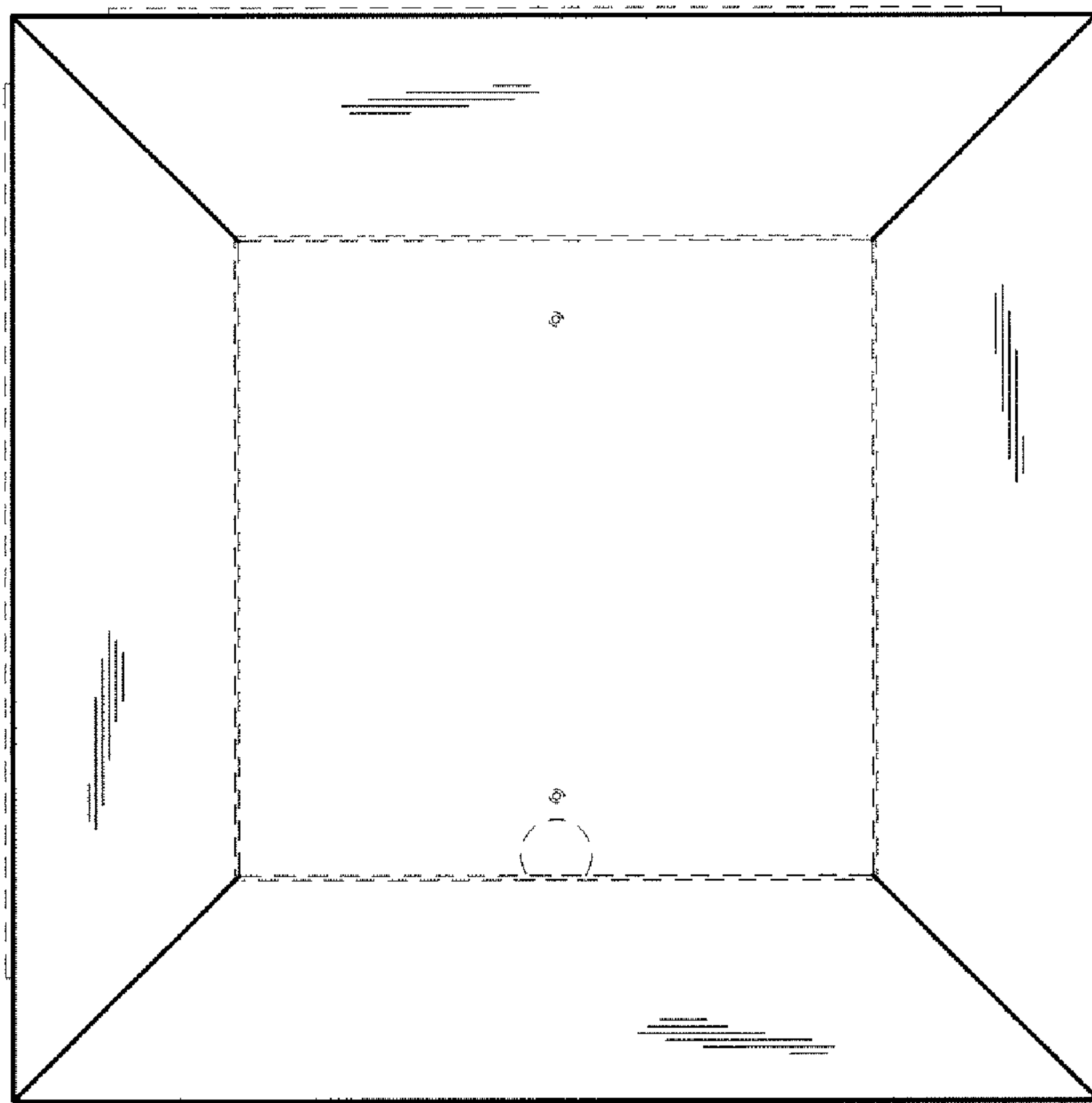

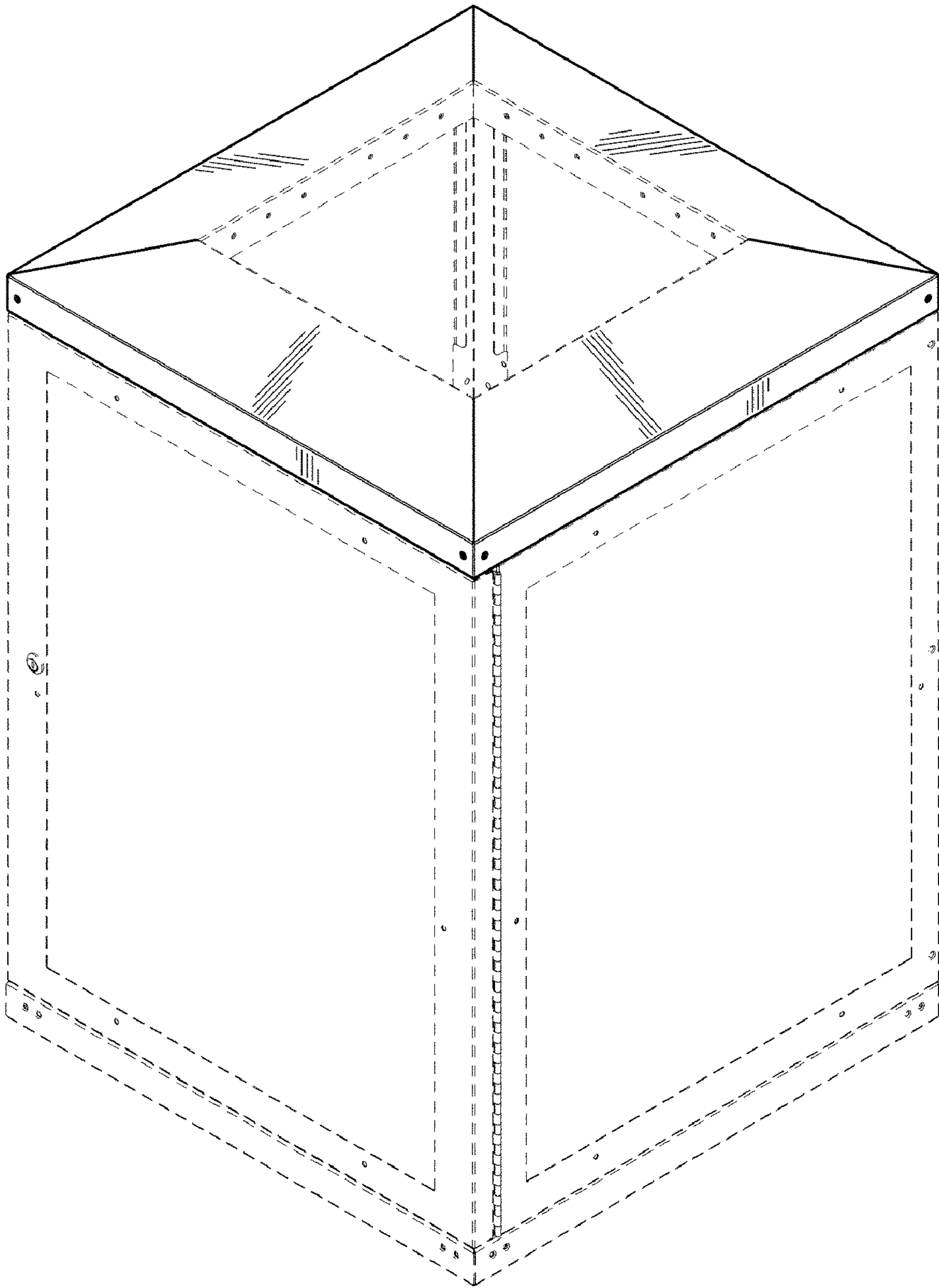

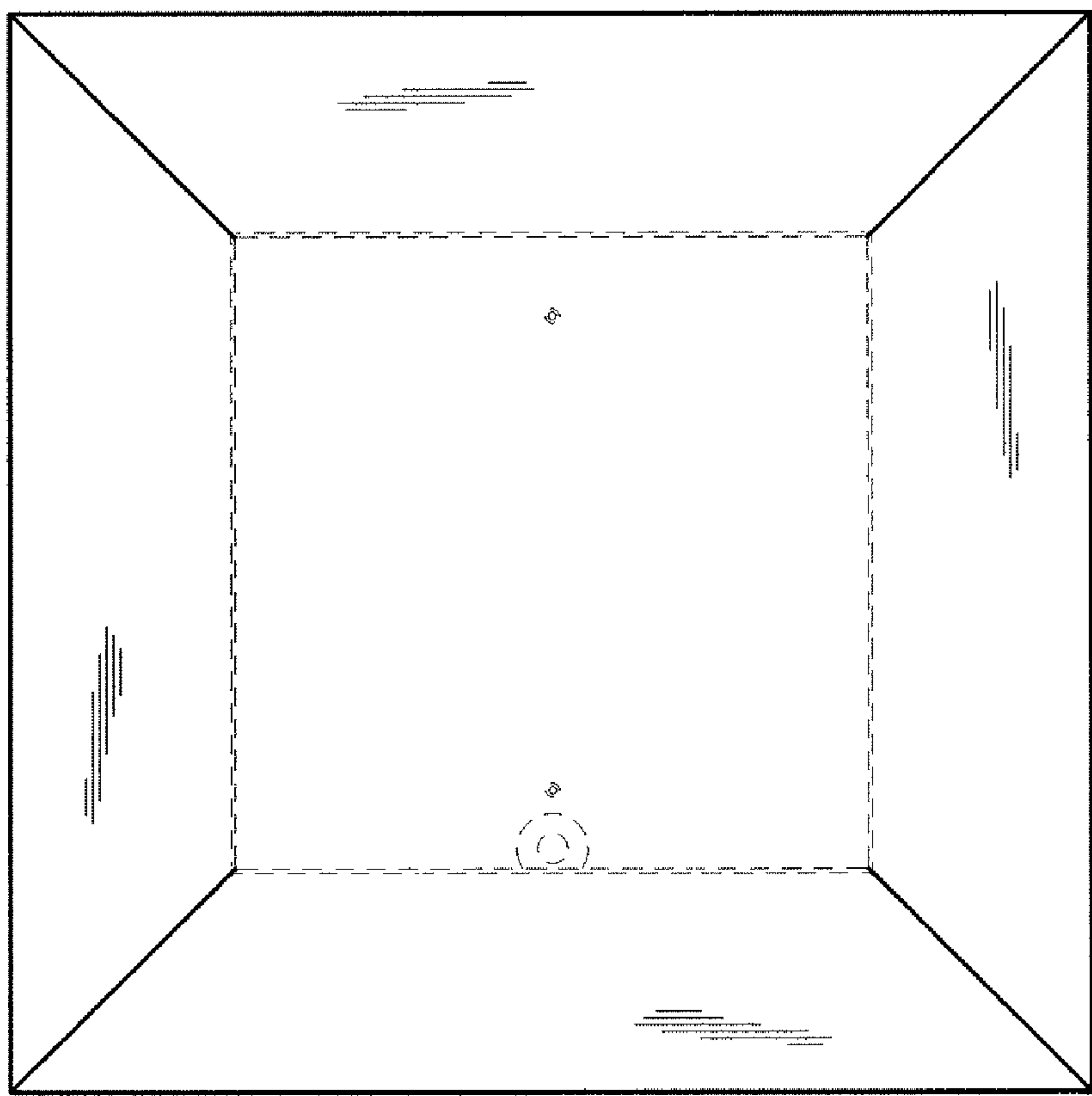
