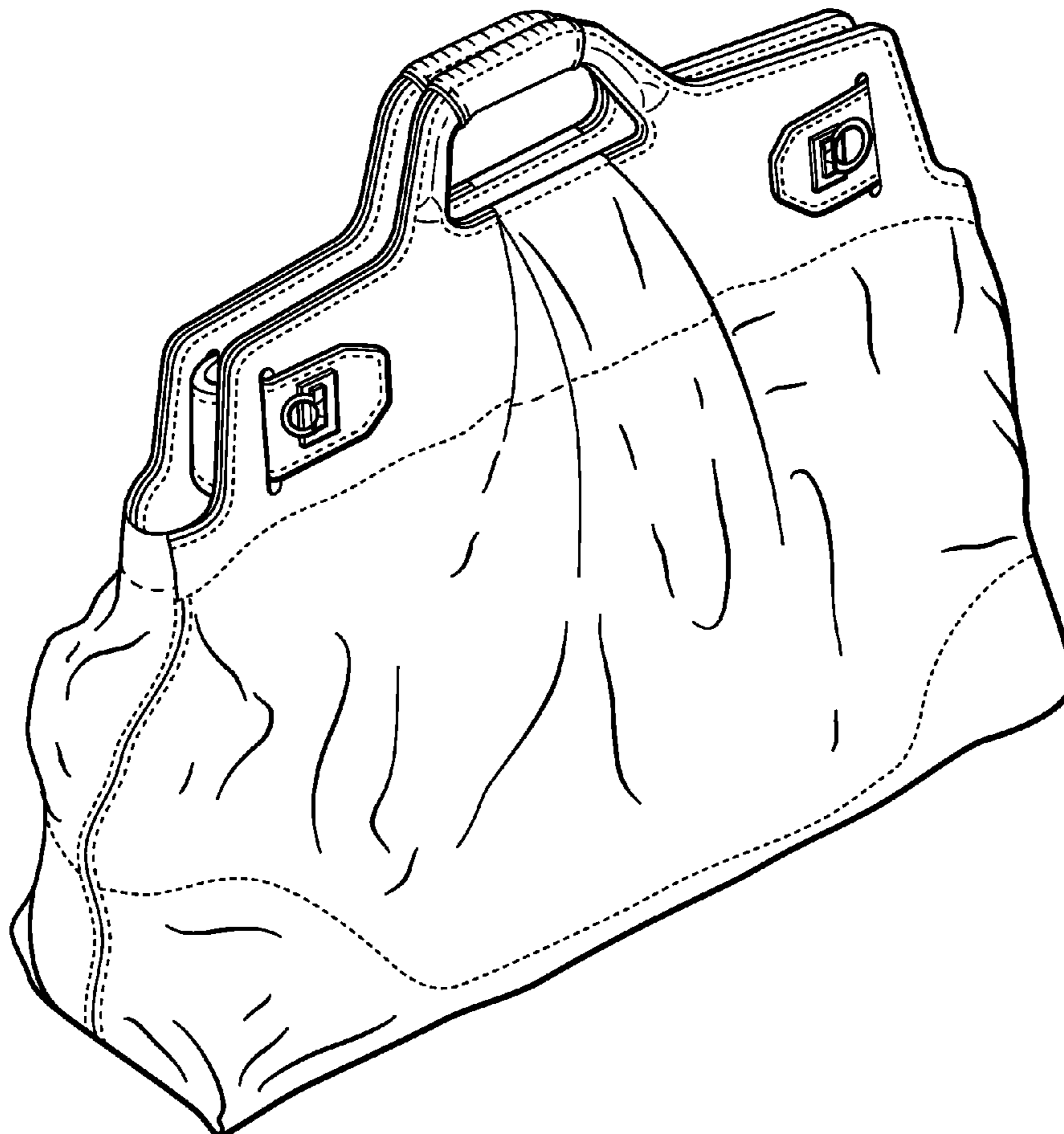
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a handbag;  
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is one side view thereof, the opposite side being its mirror image.

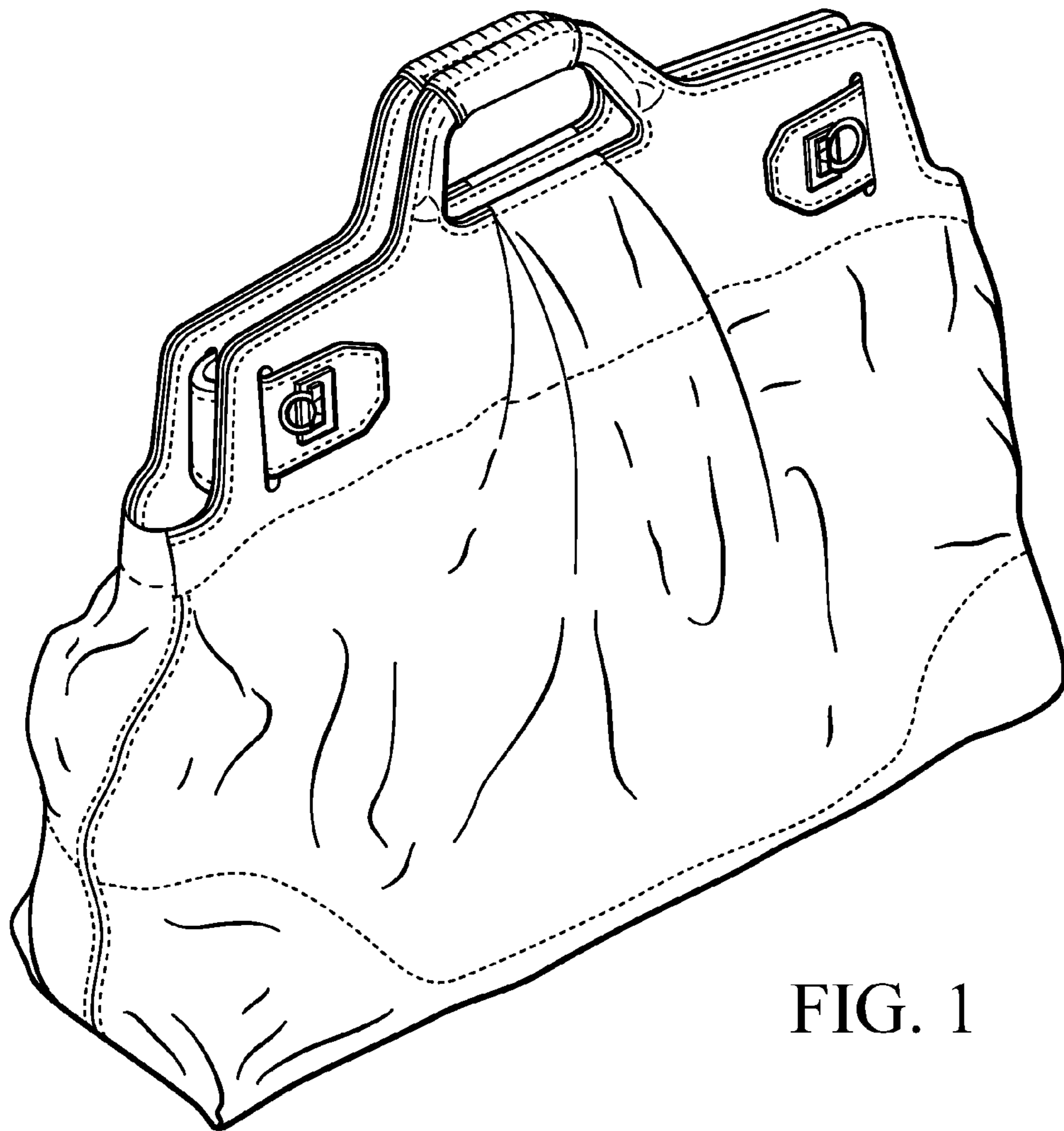

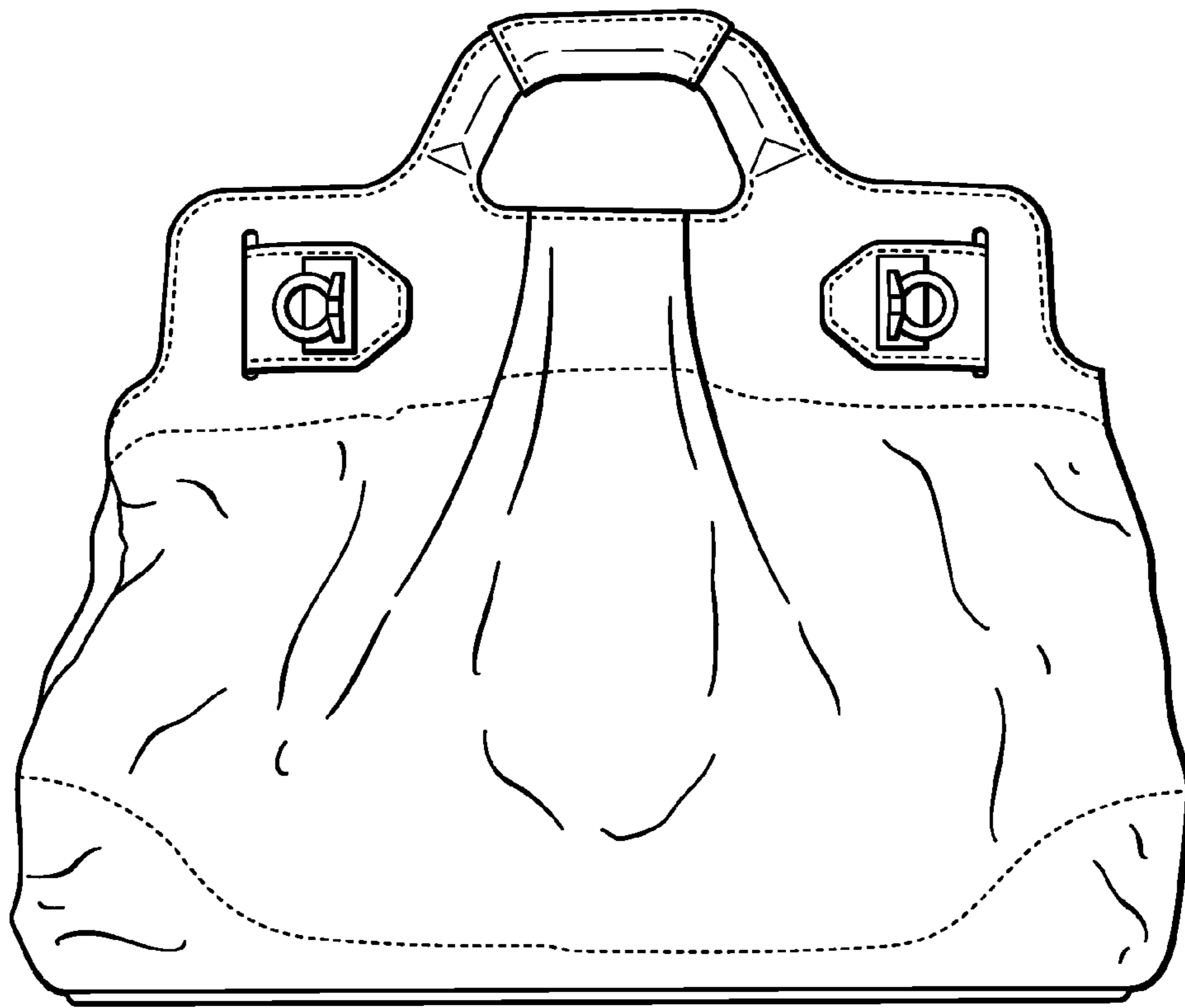

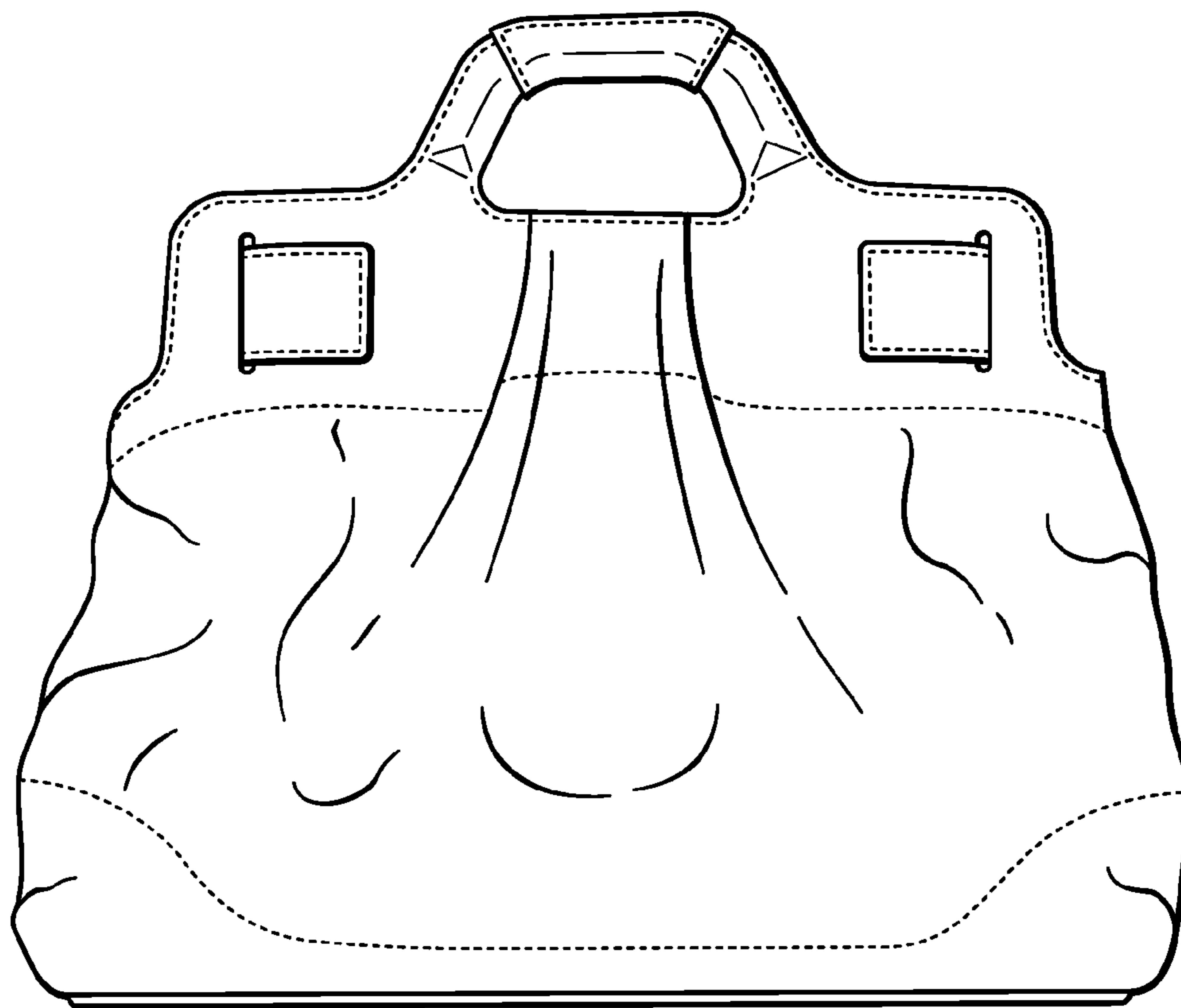

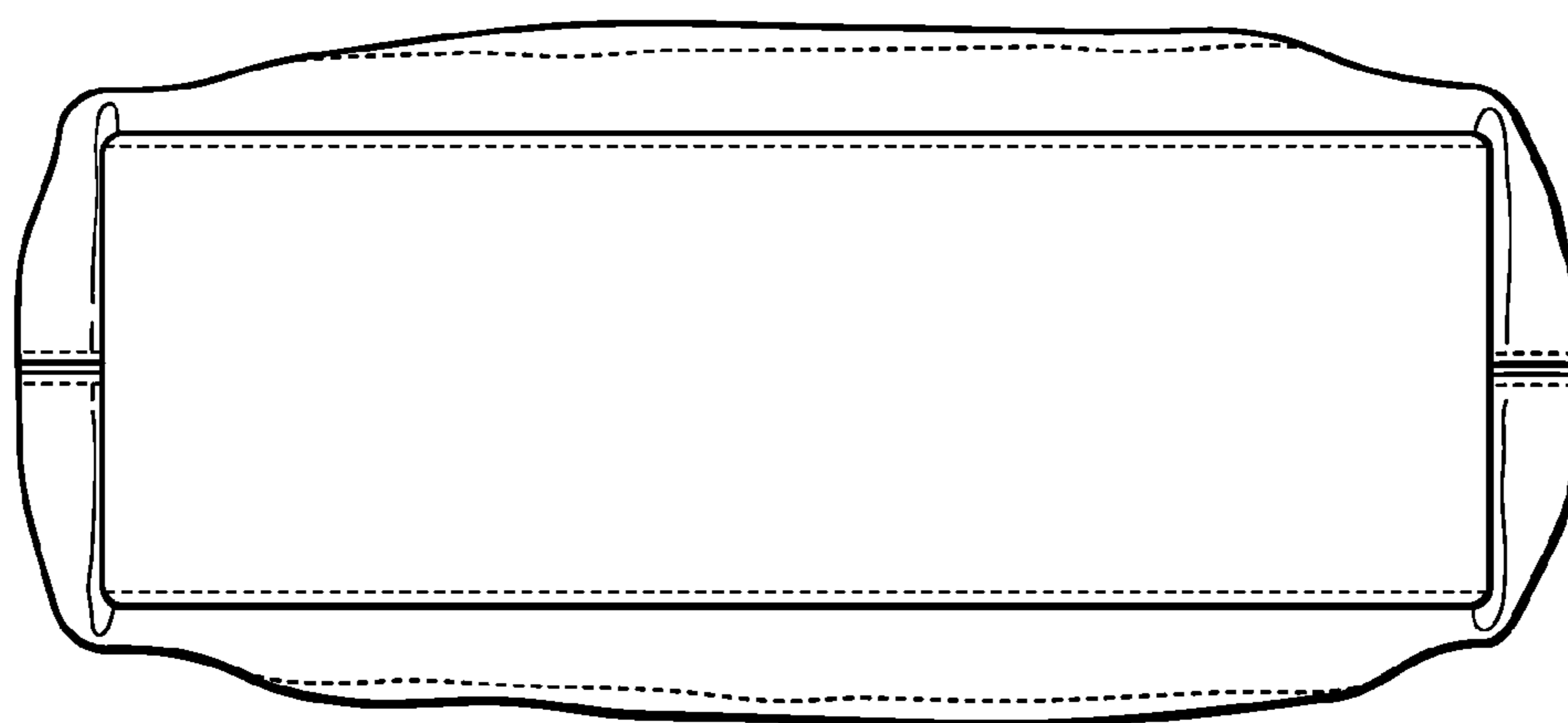

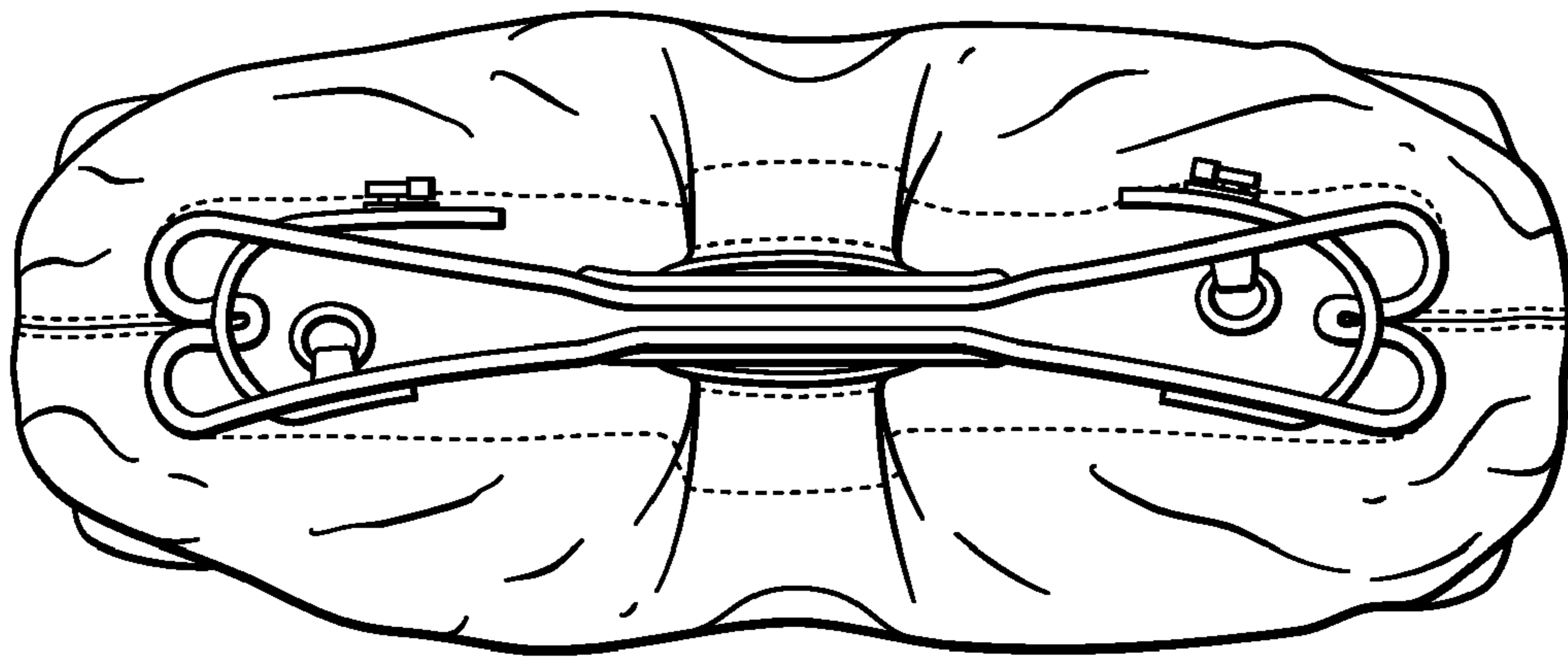

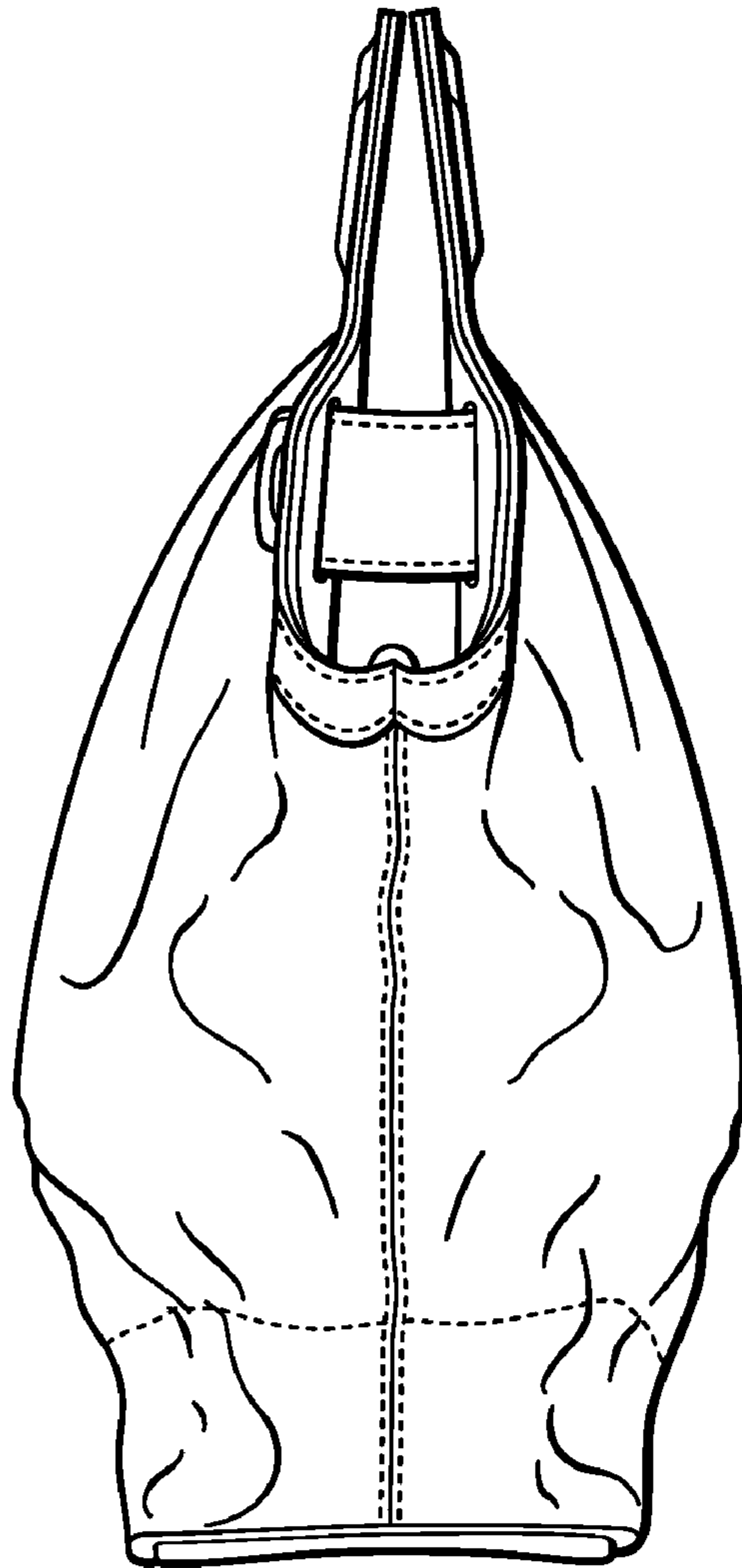
