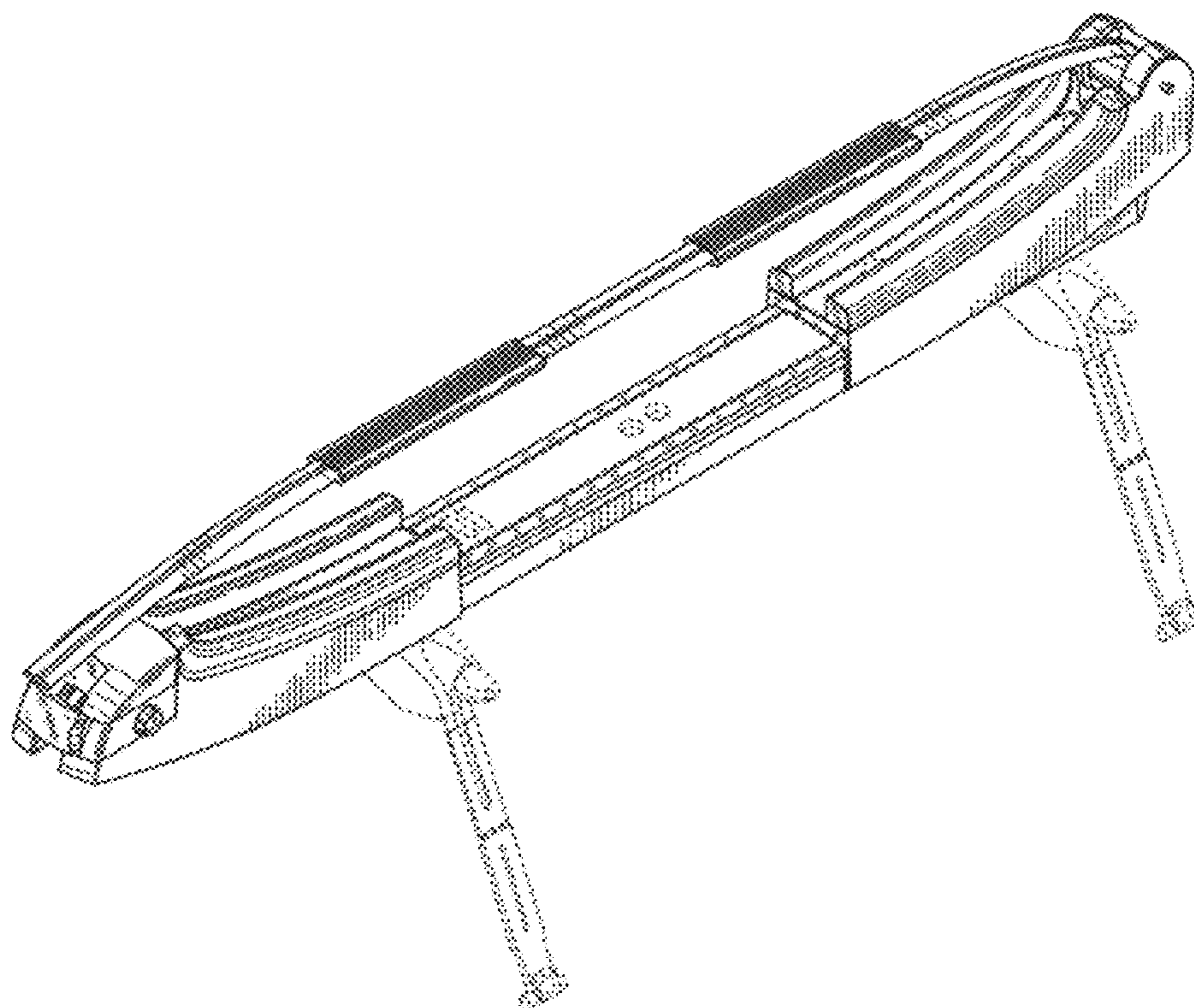
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a paddle board carrier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a paddle board carrier removably attached to an automotive vehicle;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a paddle board carrier;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The large dashed lines in FIG. 1 are directed to environment and are for illustrative purposes only. The broken lines in FIGS. 1 through 8 illustrate unclaimed portions of the design. The dashed lines and broken lines form no part of the claimed design.

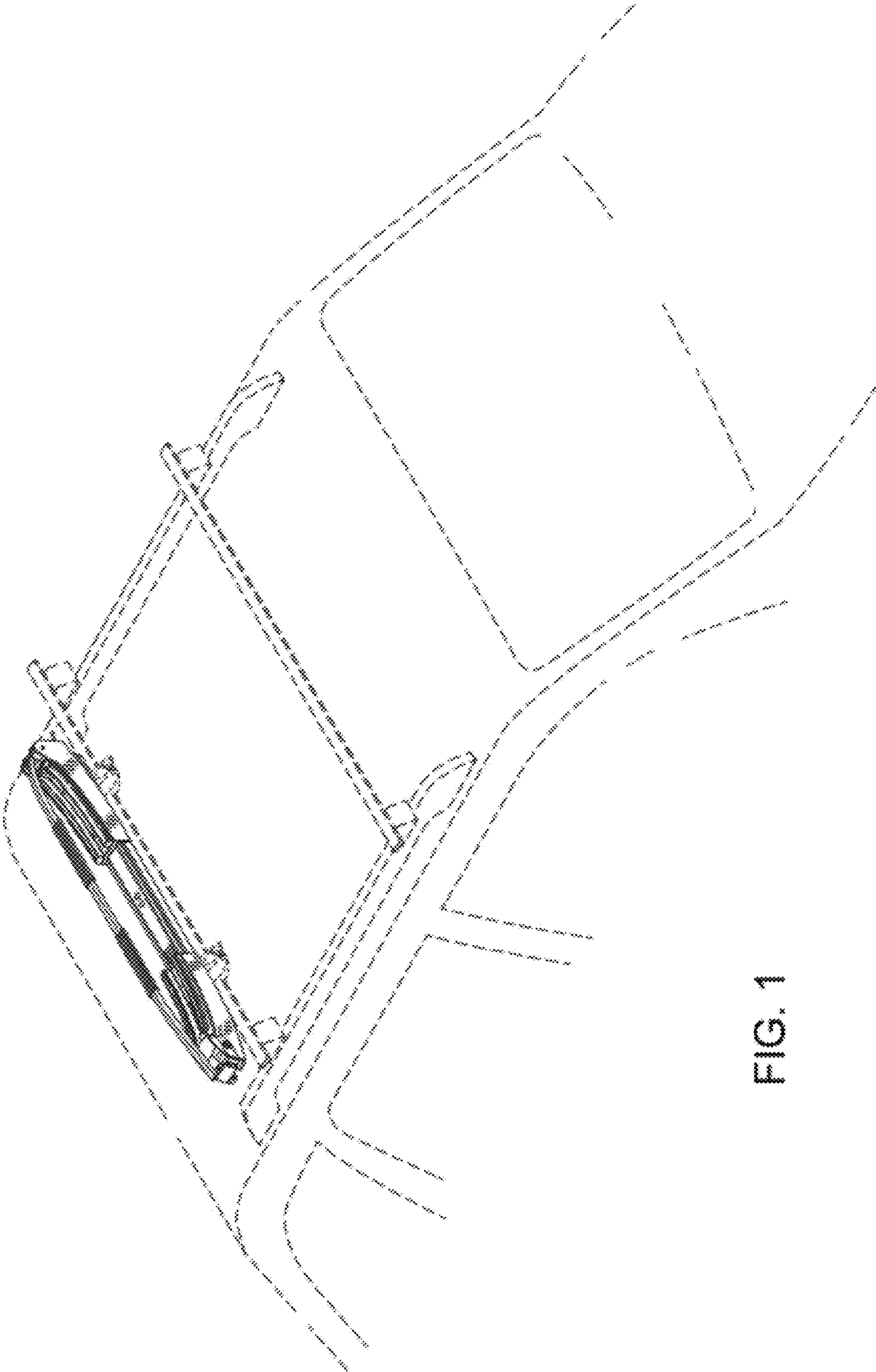

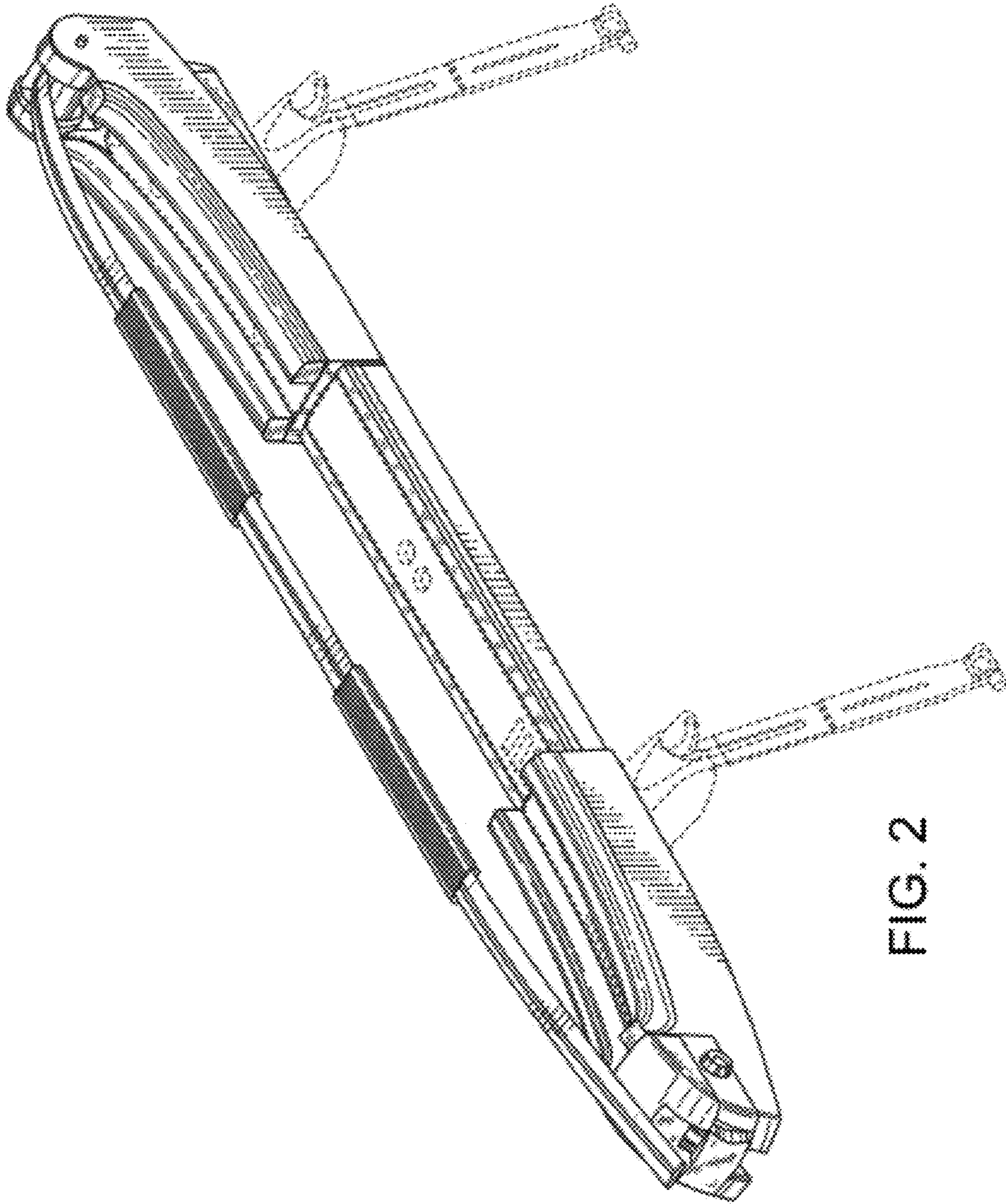

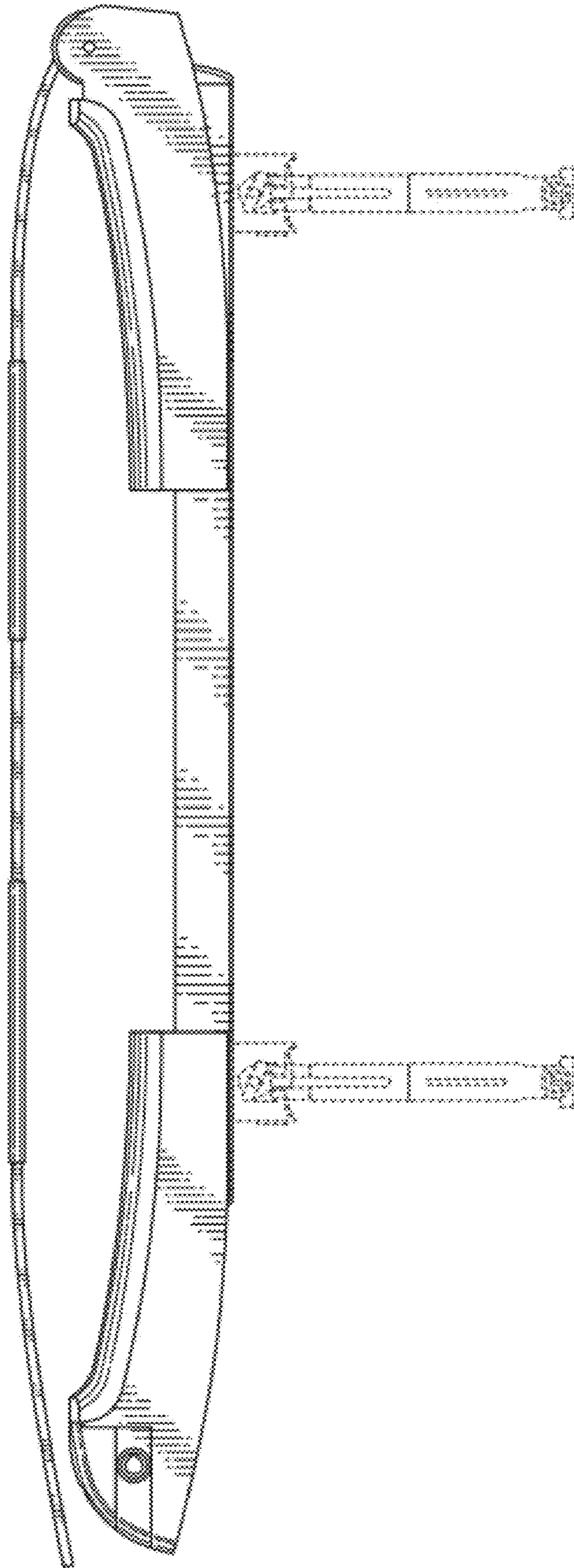

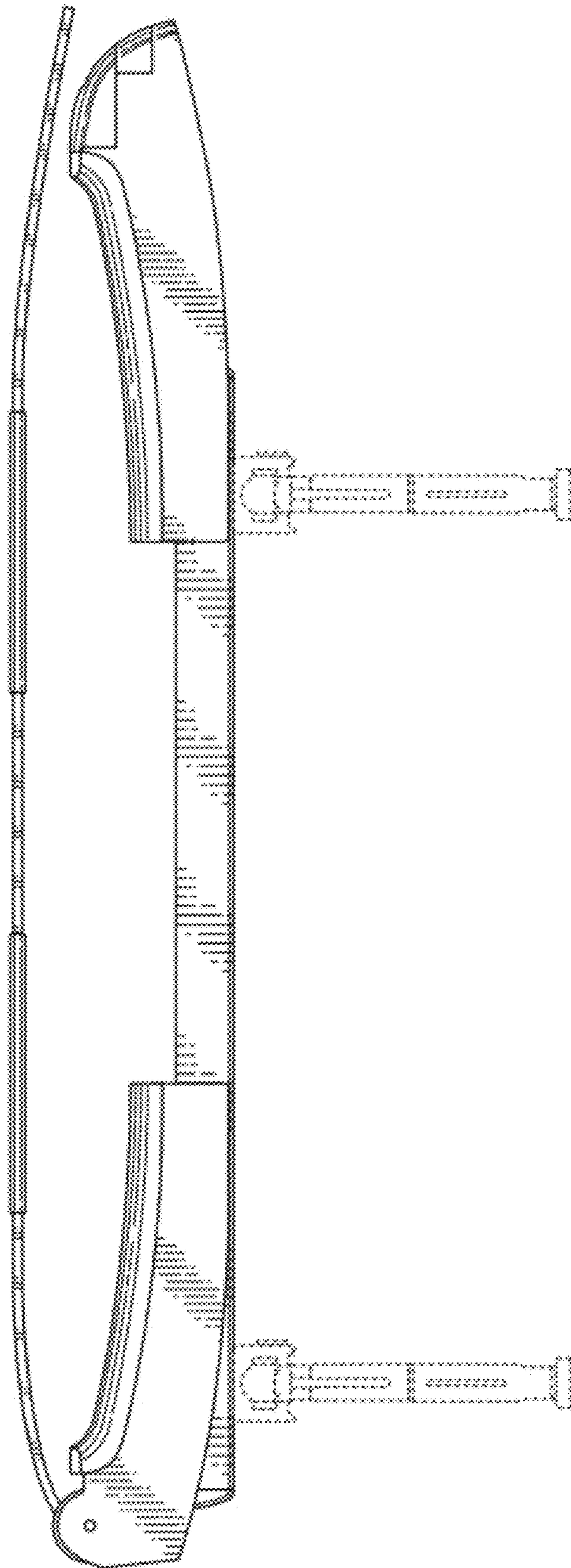

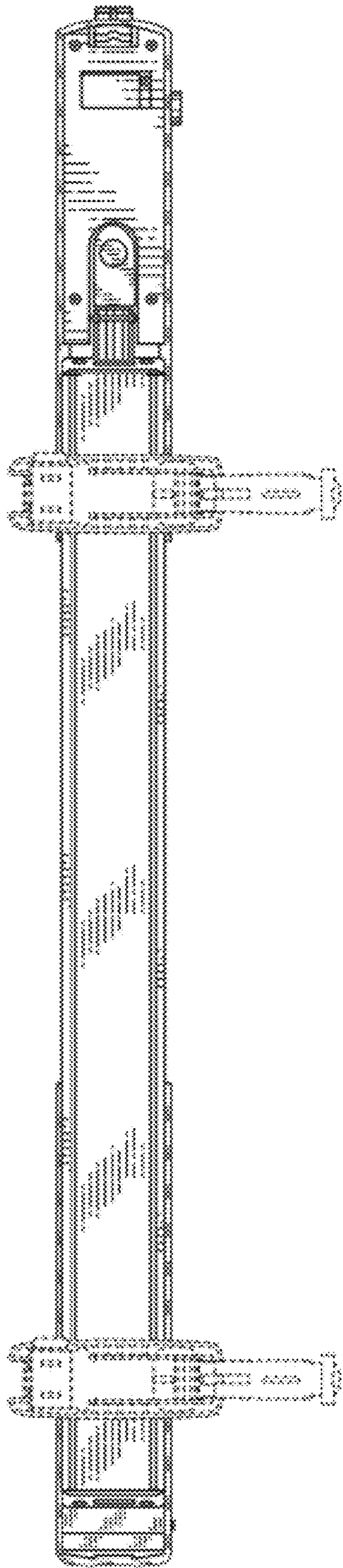

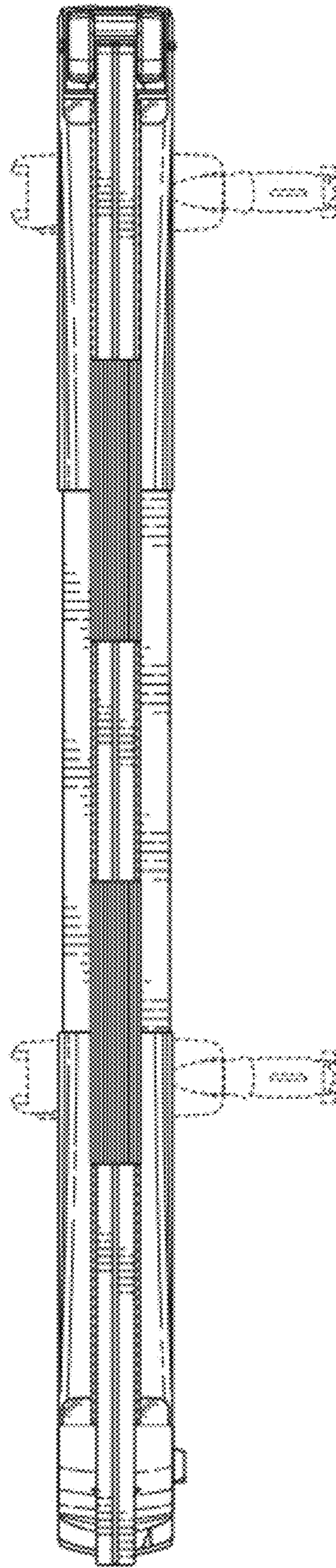

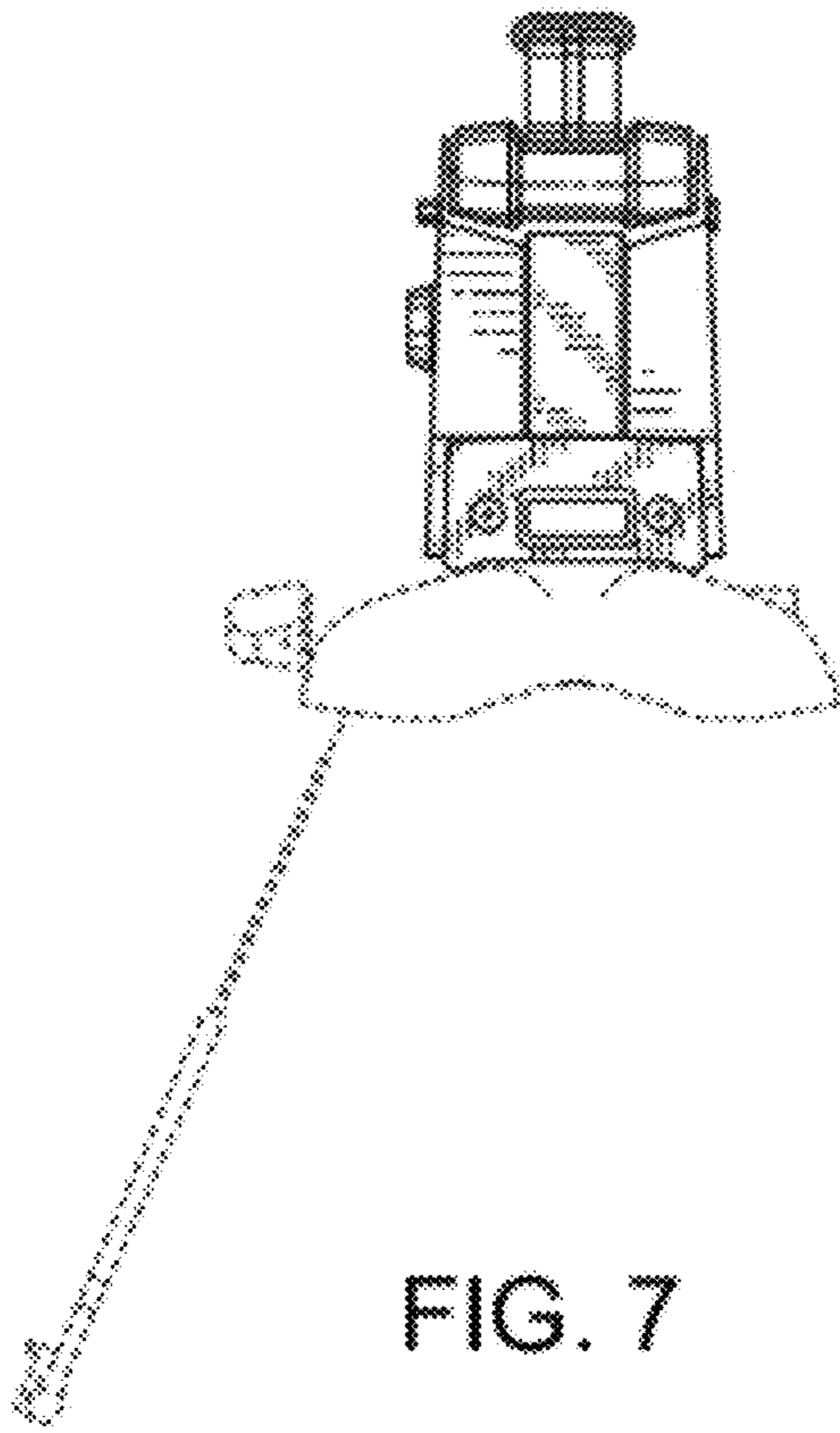

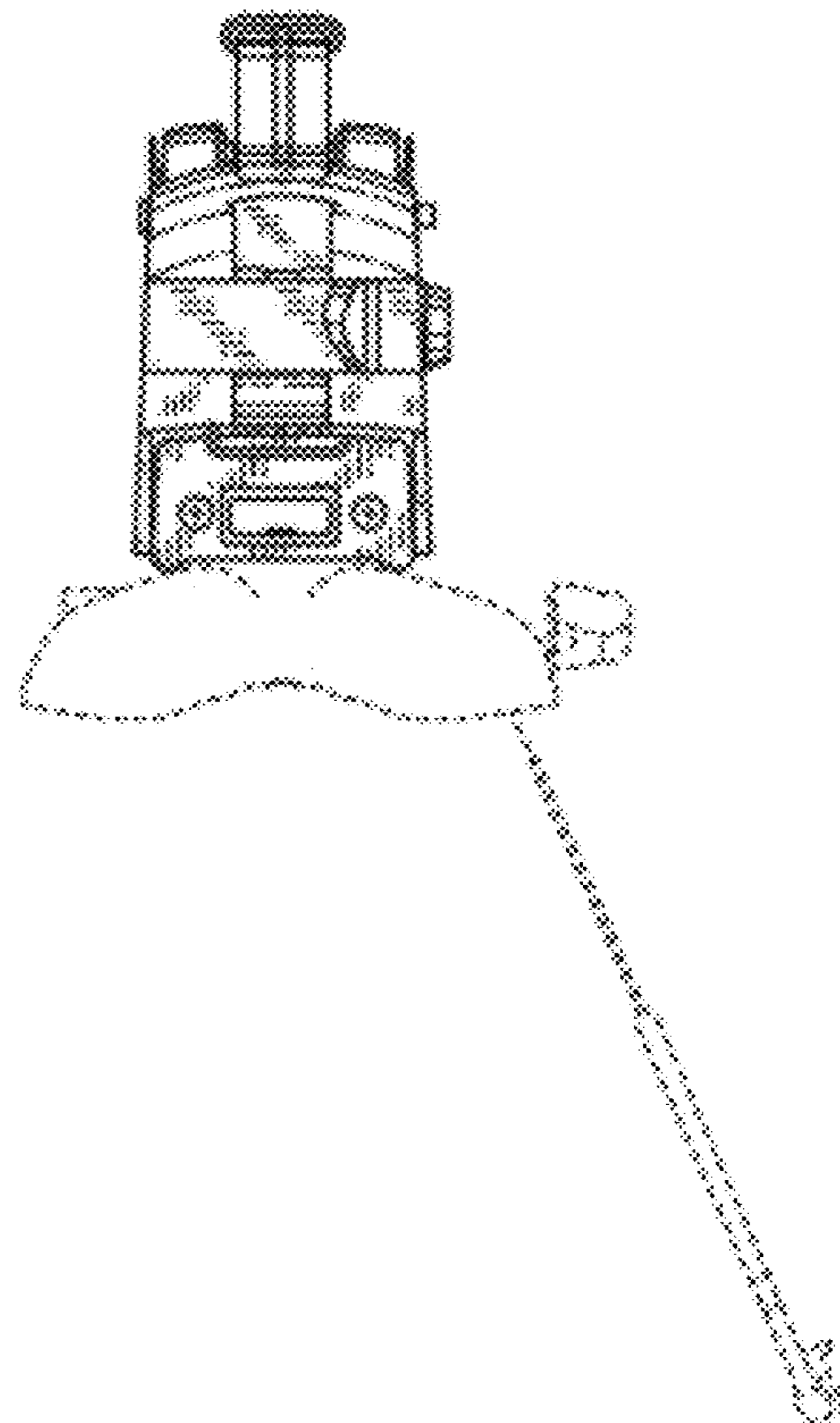
