DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a bullet-shaped in-ear miniature speaker system showing our new design, shown separately for purposes of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the bullet-shaped in-ear miniature speaker system of the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a left side view of the bullet-shaped in-ear miniature speaker system of the present invention;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the bullet-shaped in-ear miniature speaker system of the present invention;

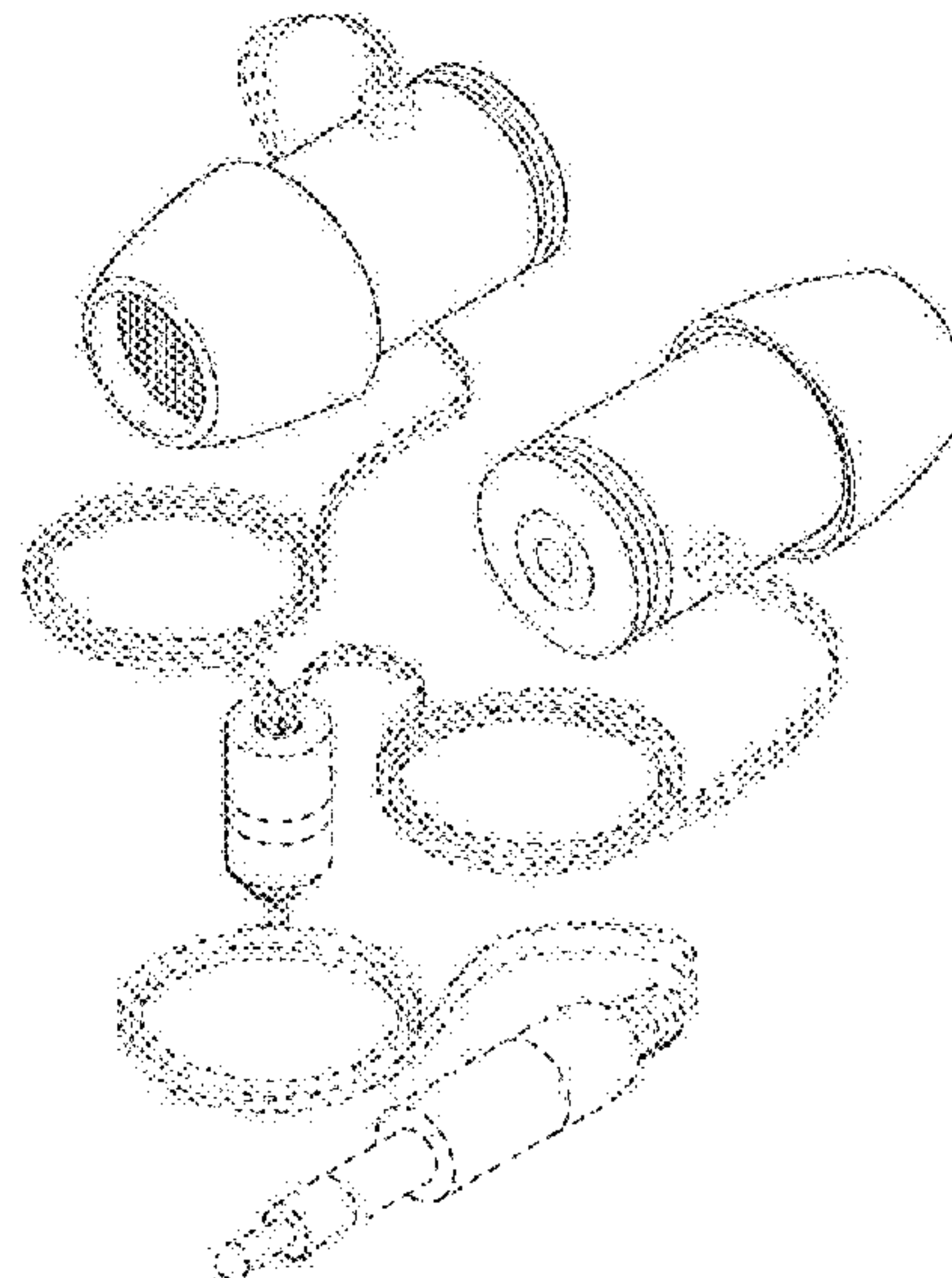
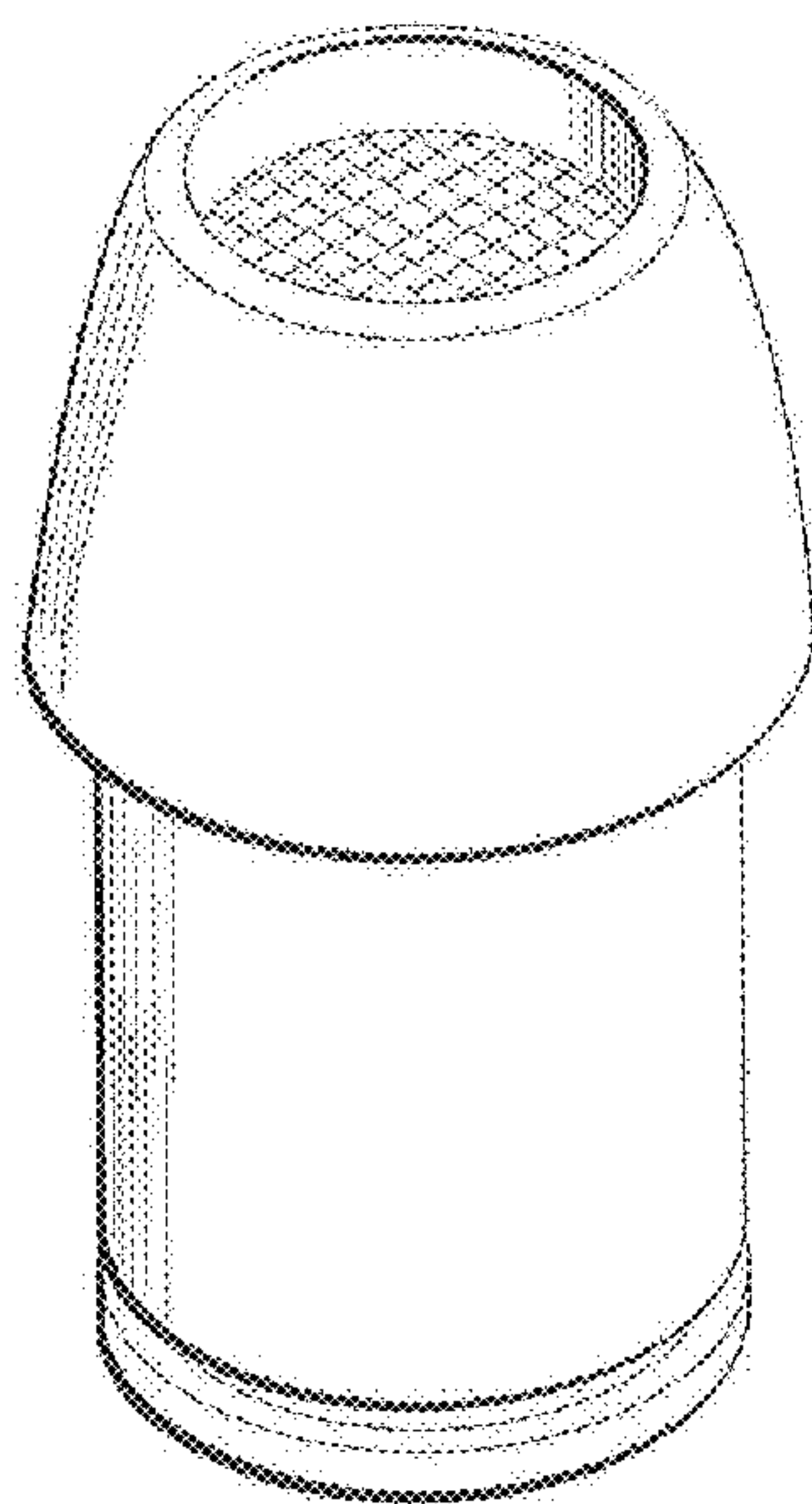
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the bullet-shaped in-ear miniature speaker system of the present invention;

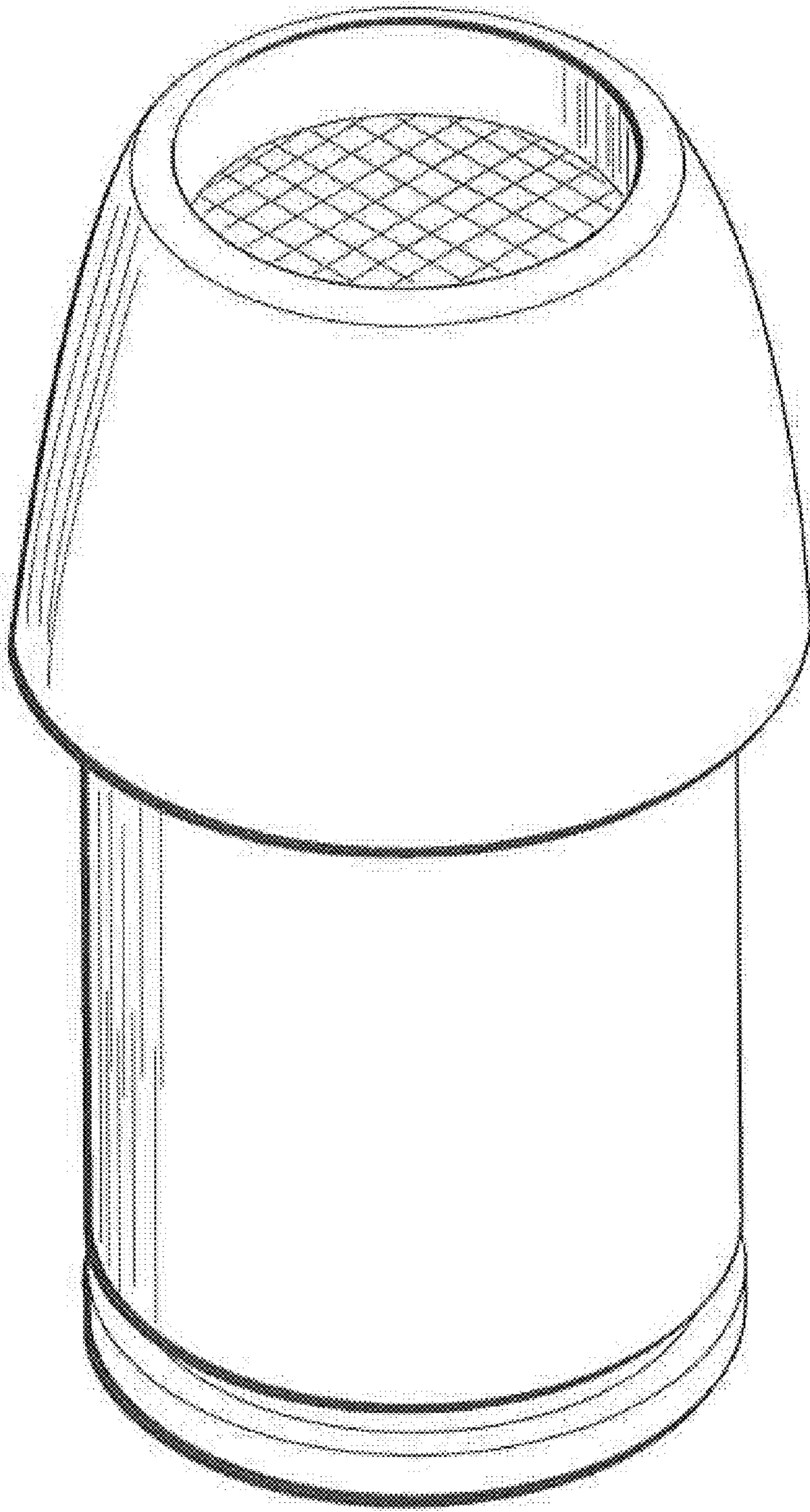

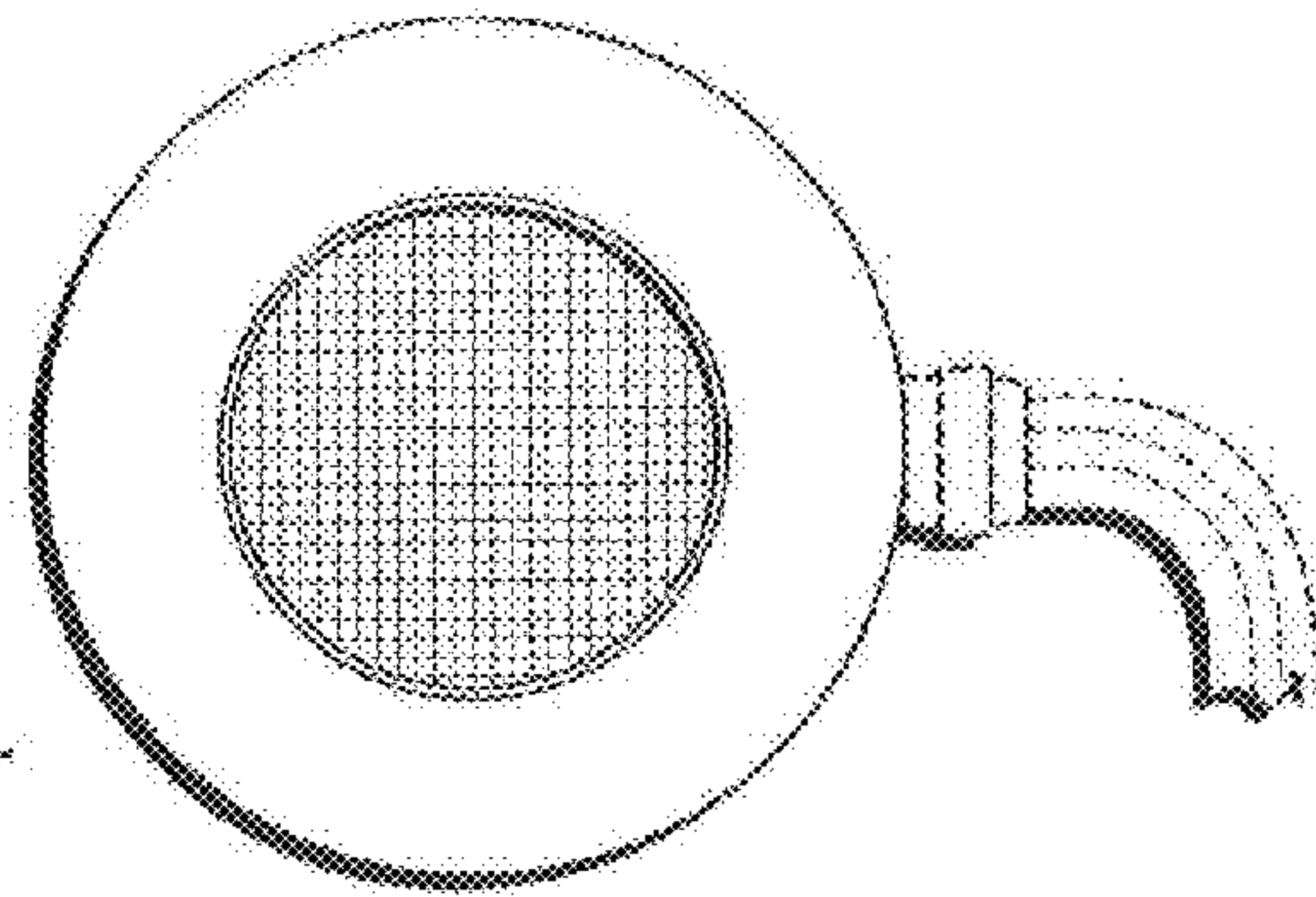

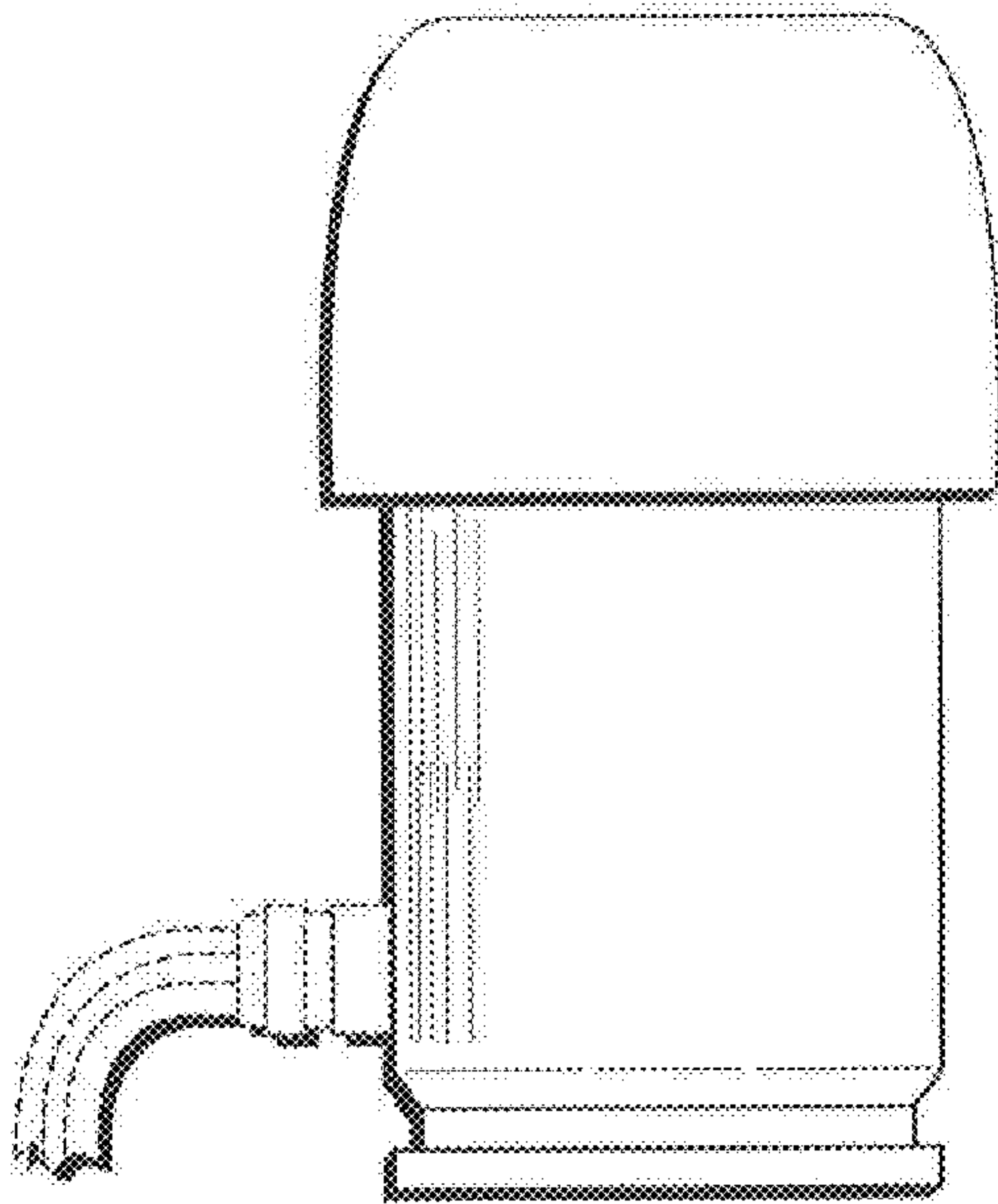

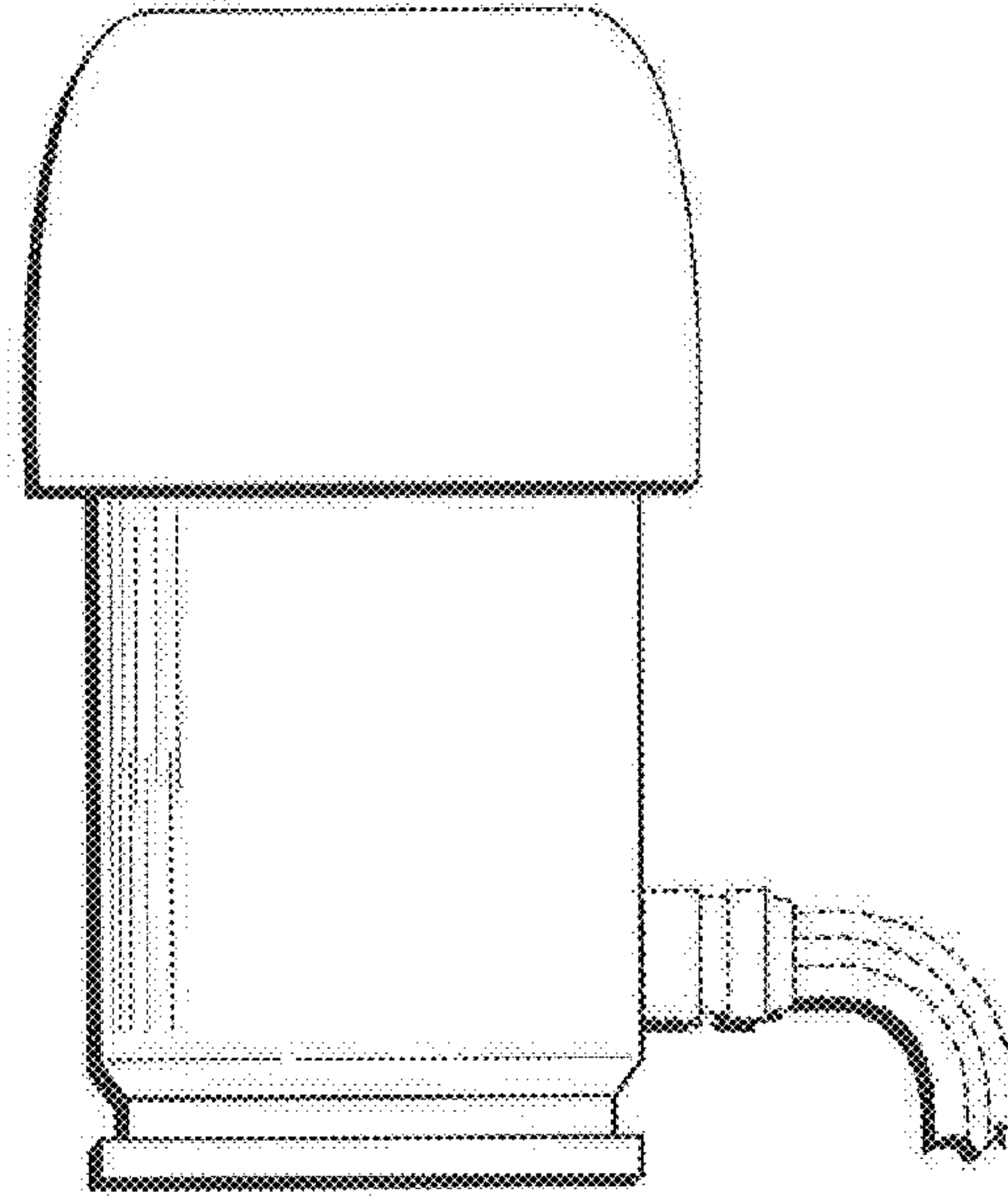
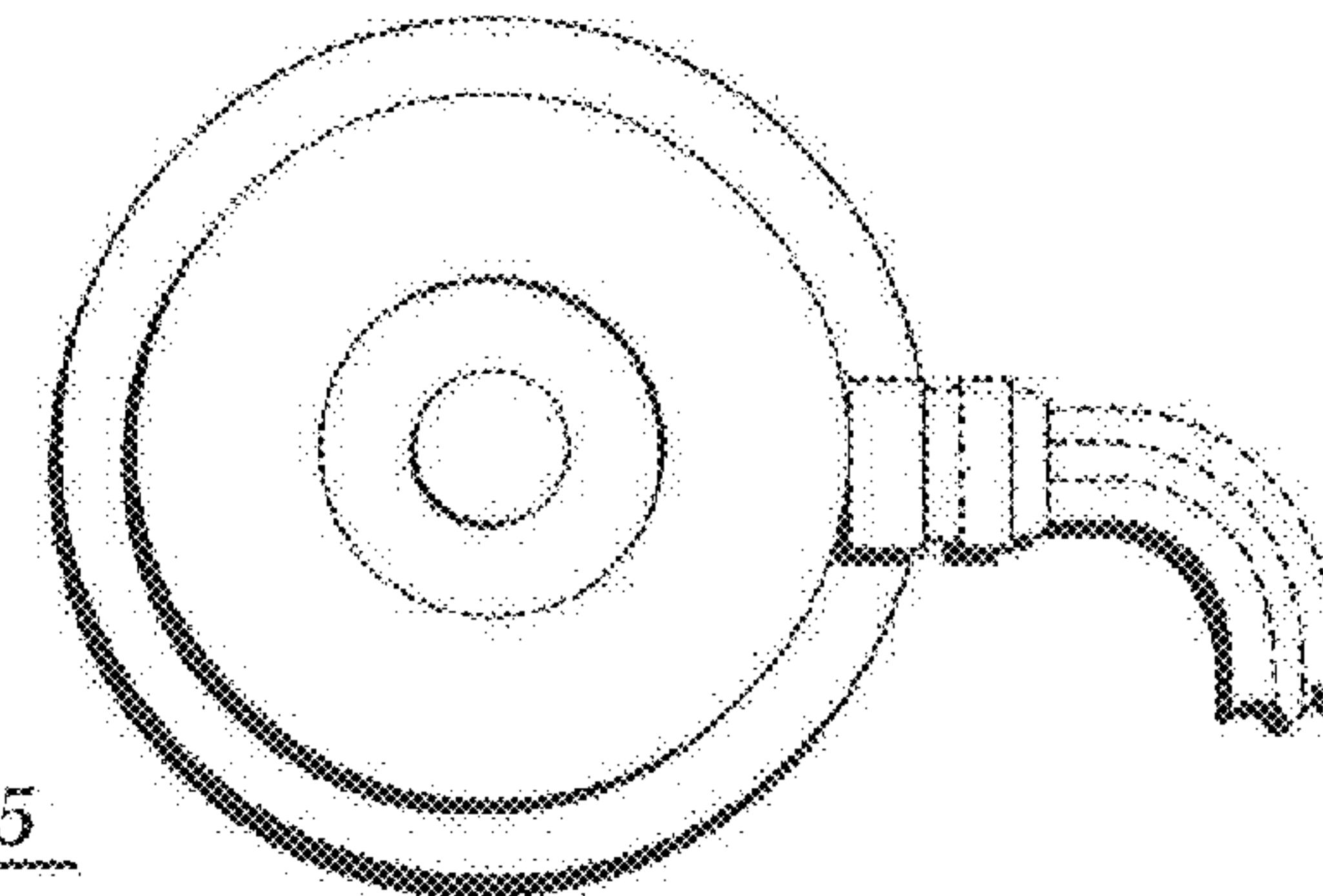

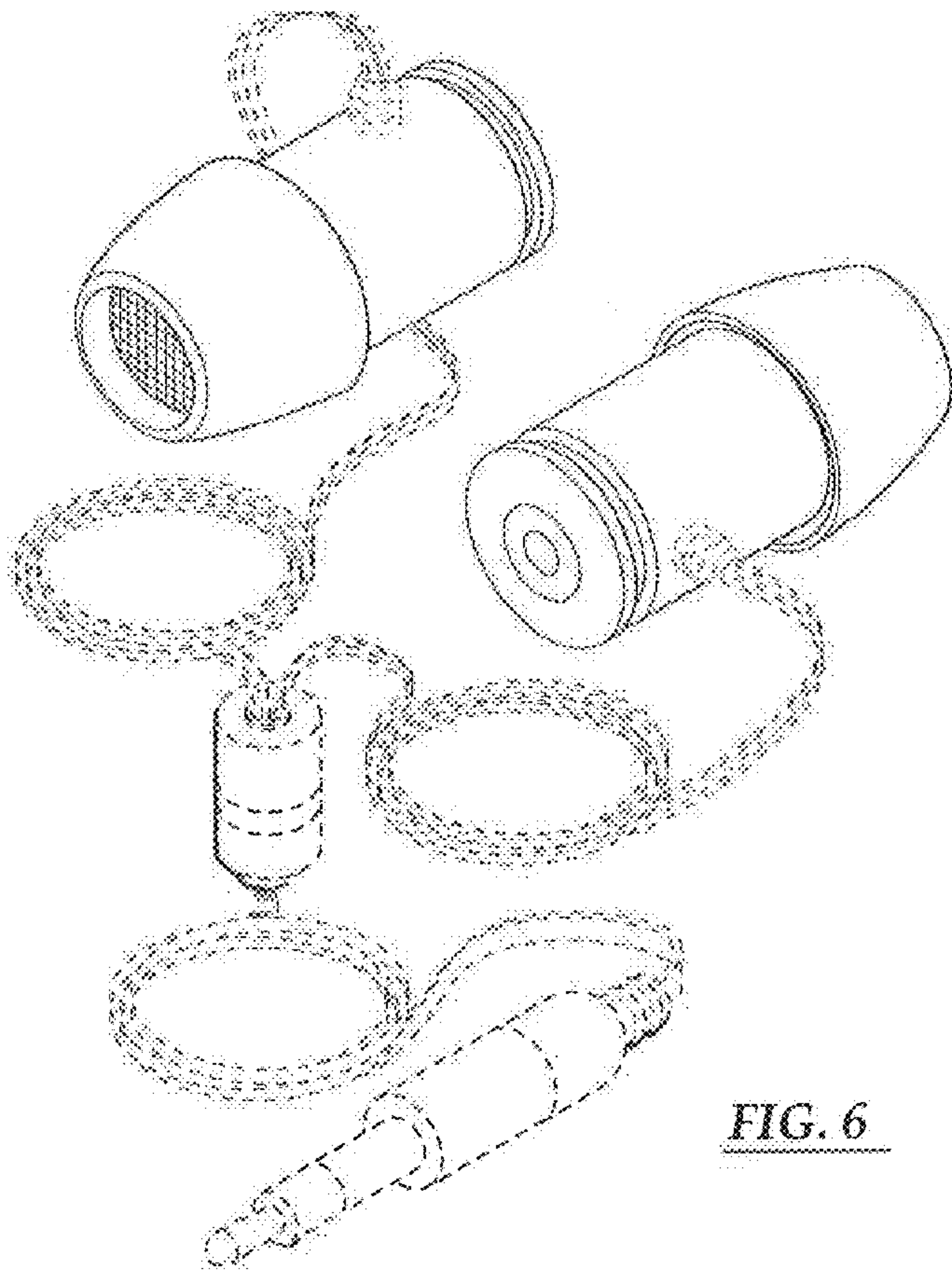

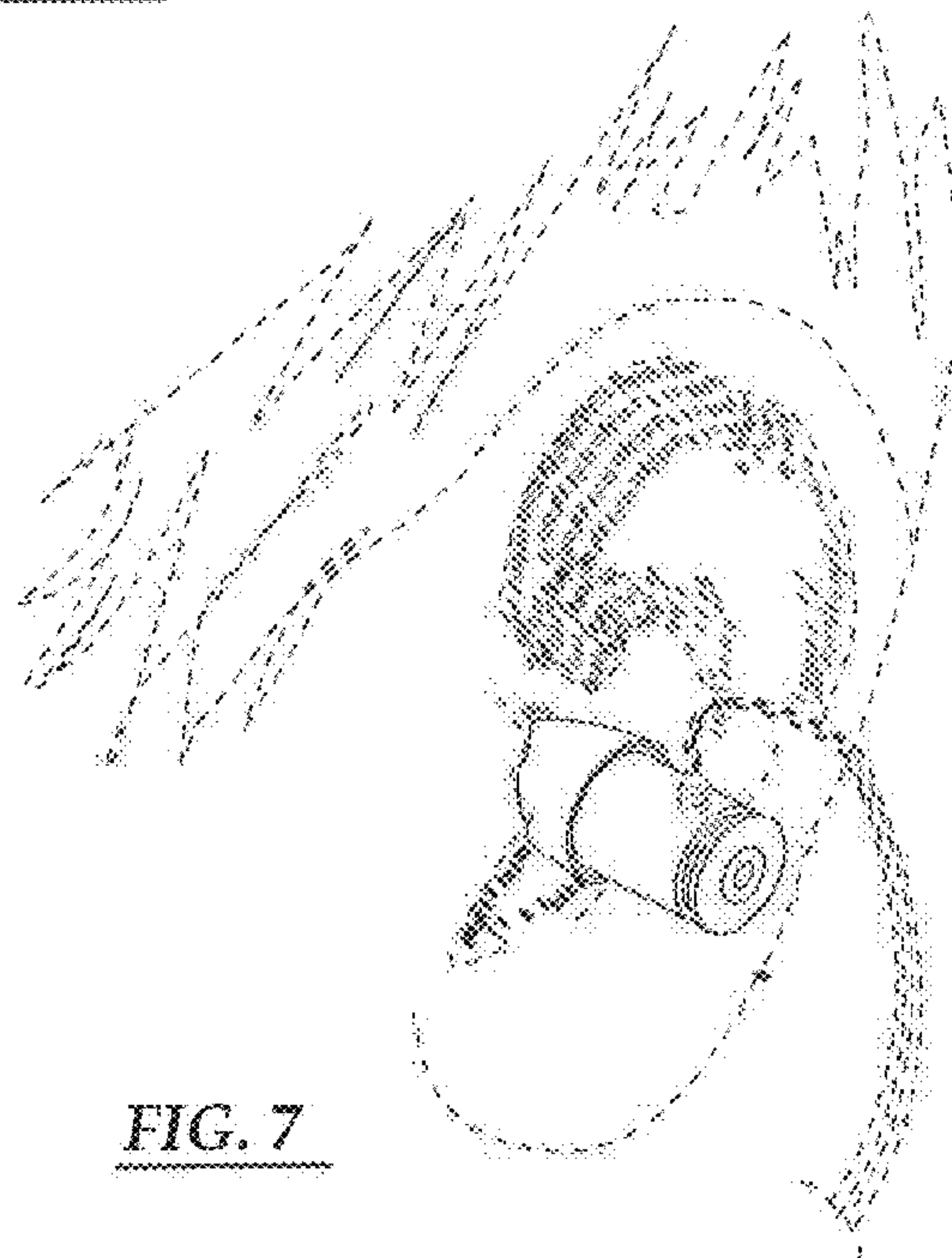
