The ornamental design for a thumb guard, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a thumb guard according to the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the thumb guard shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof.

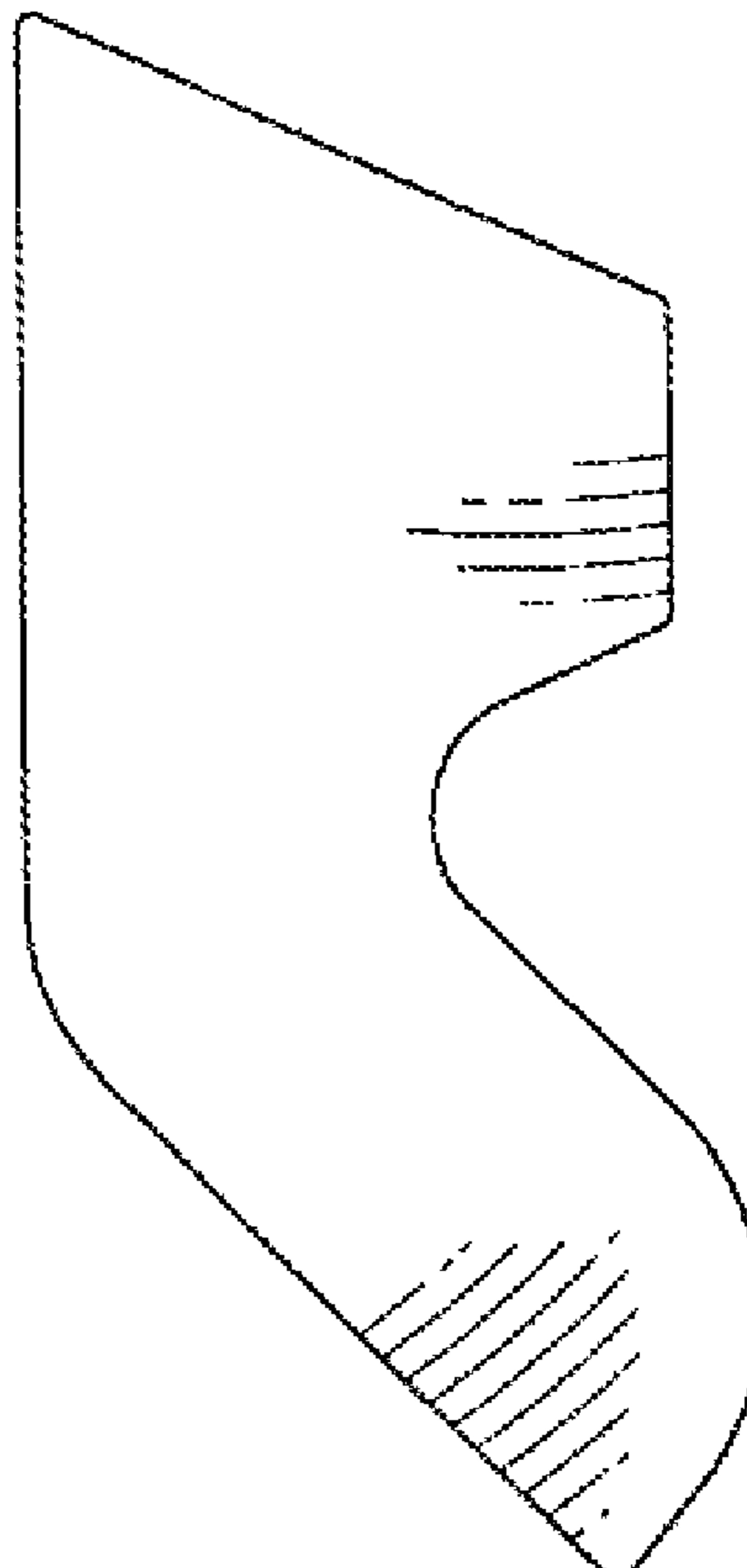
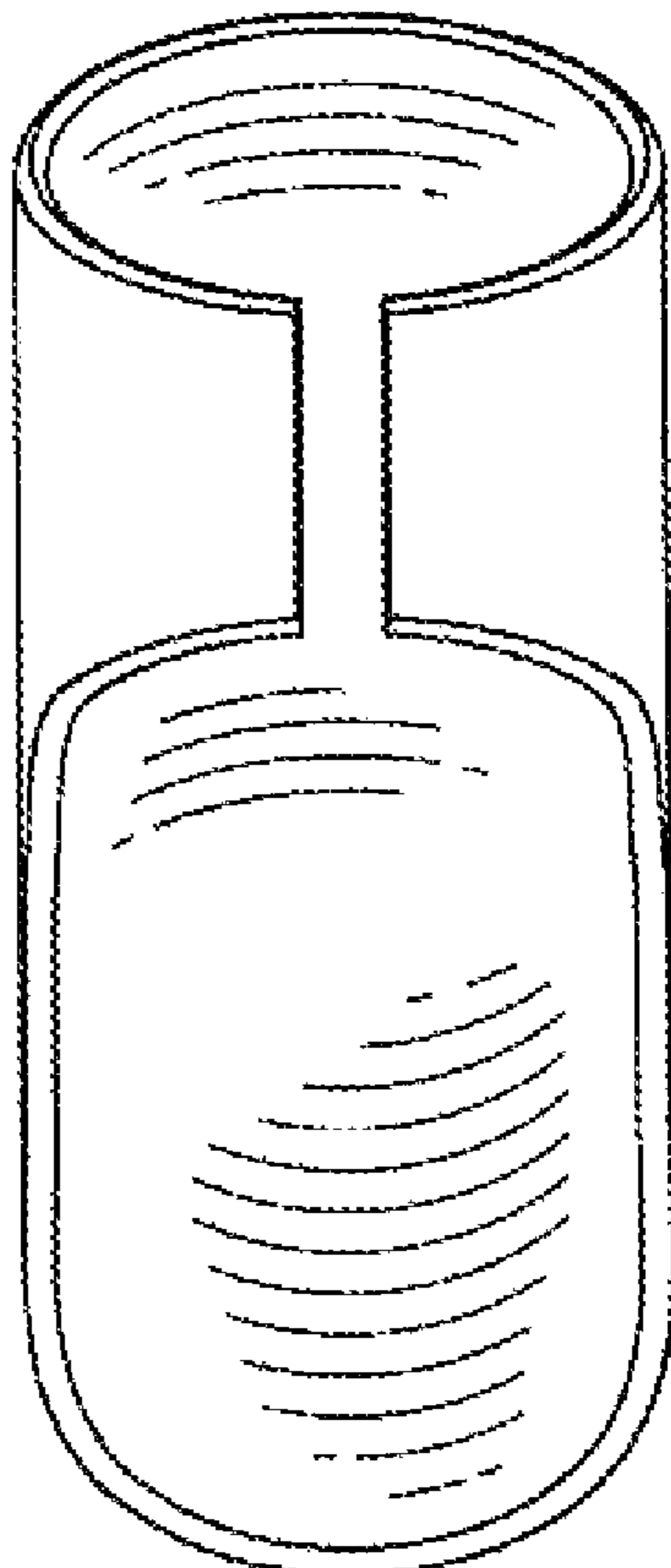
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof.

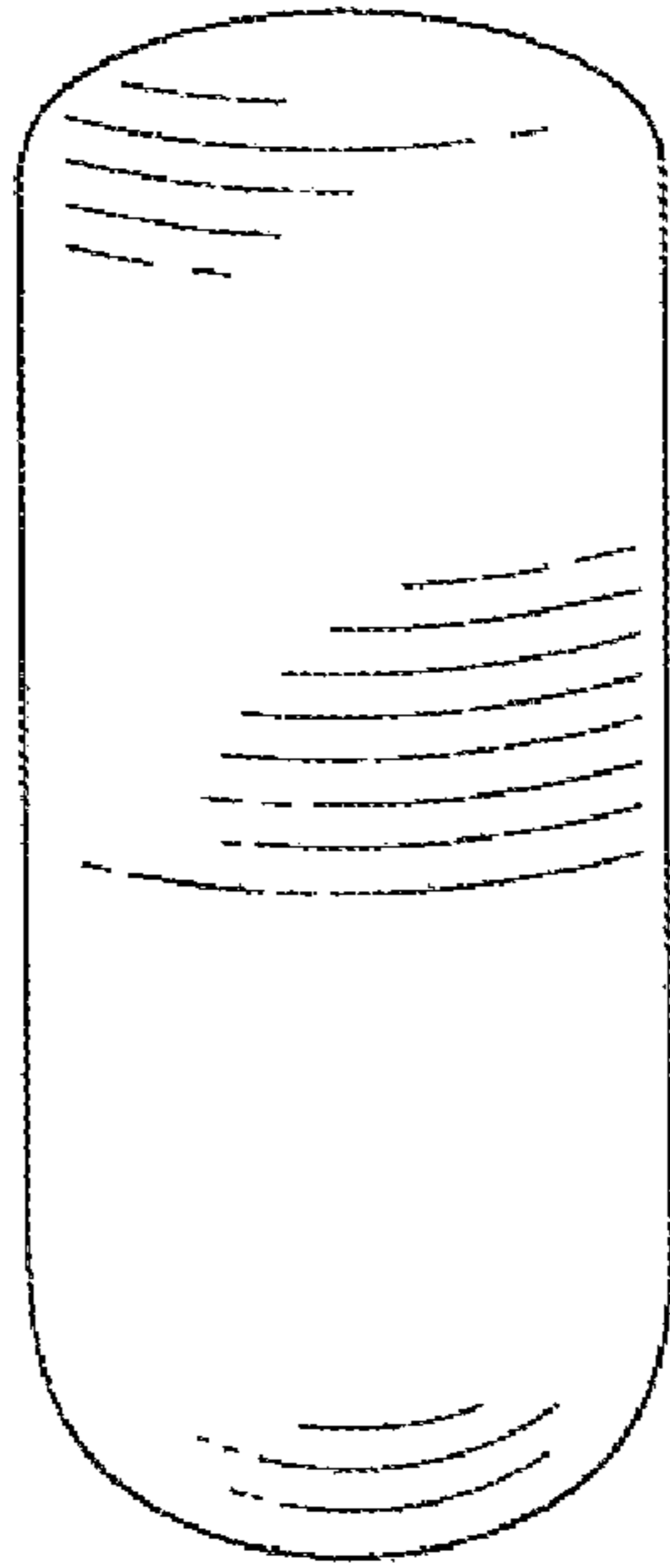

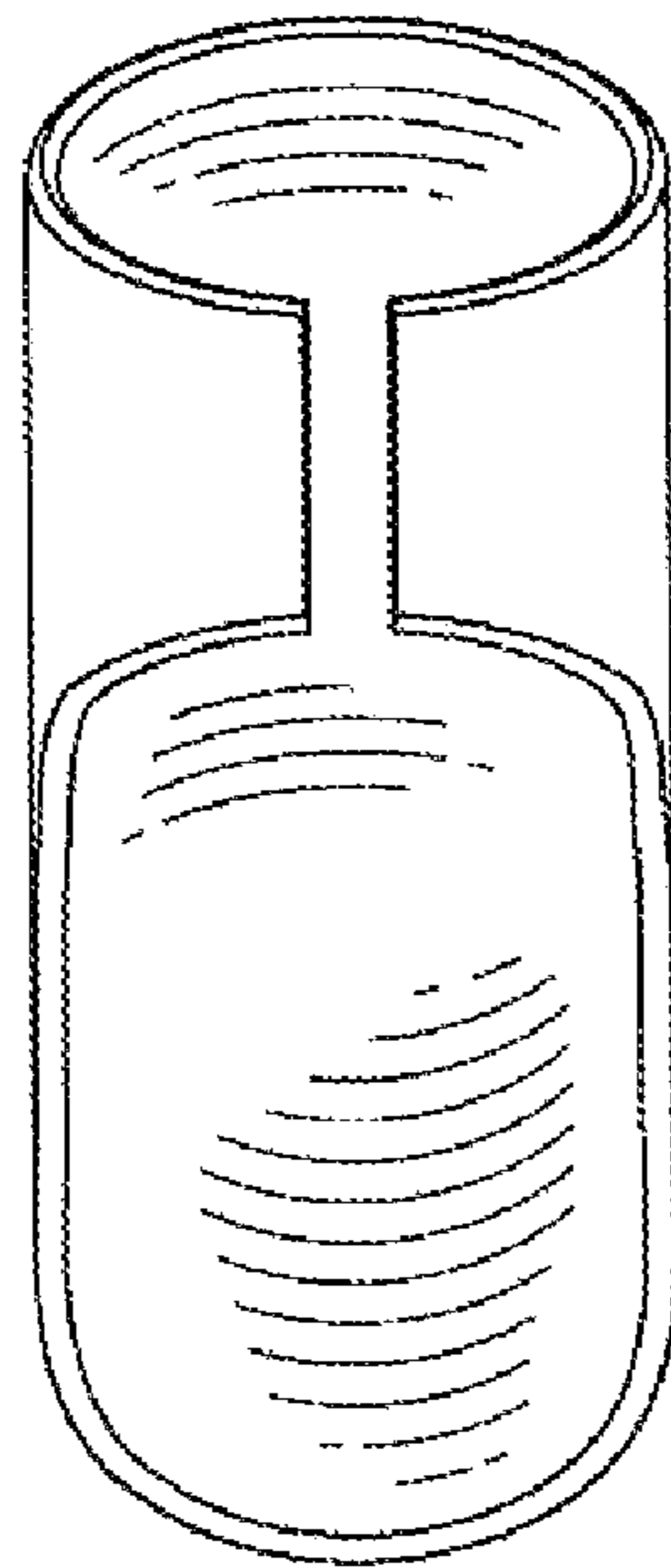

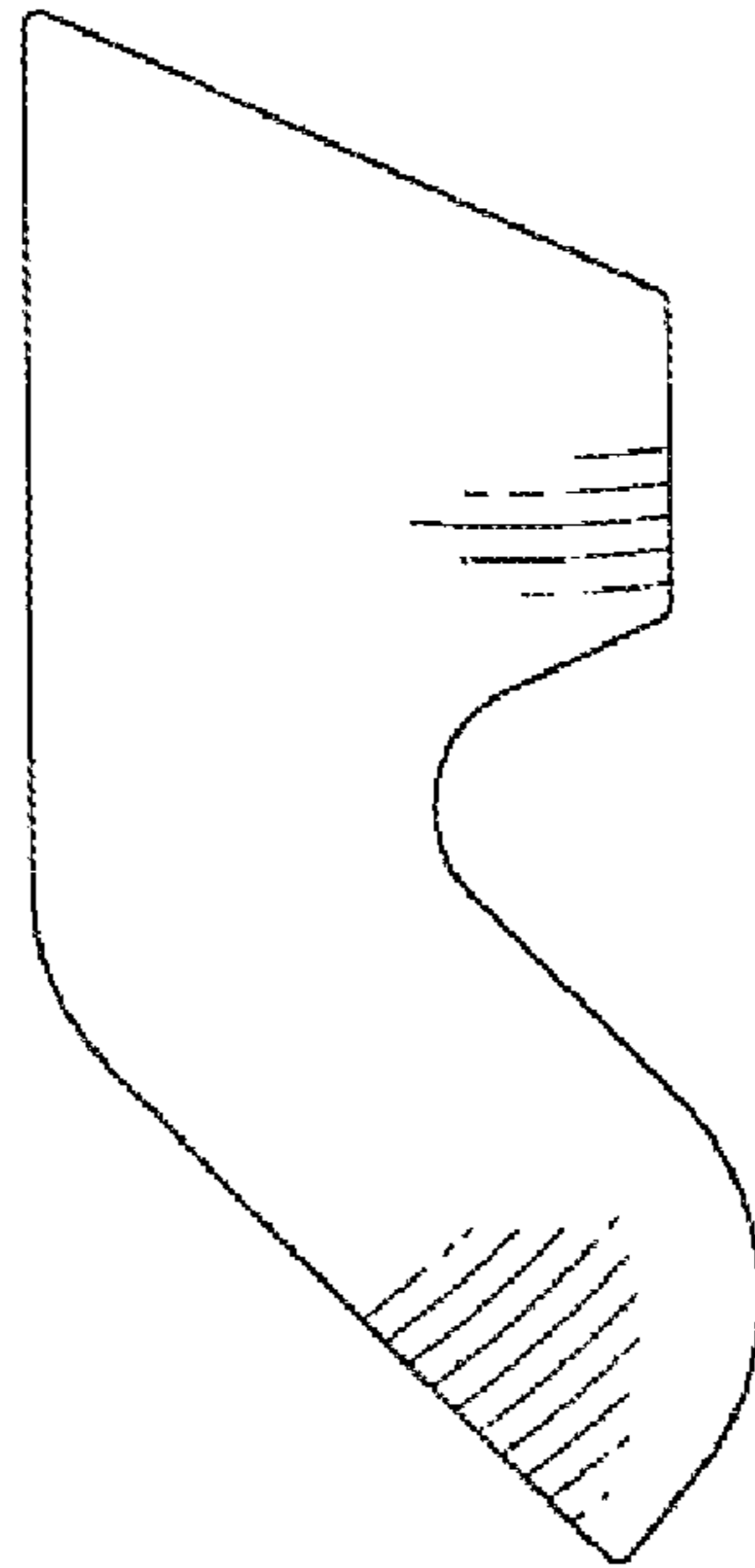

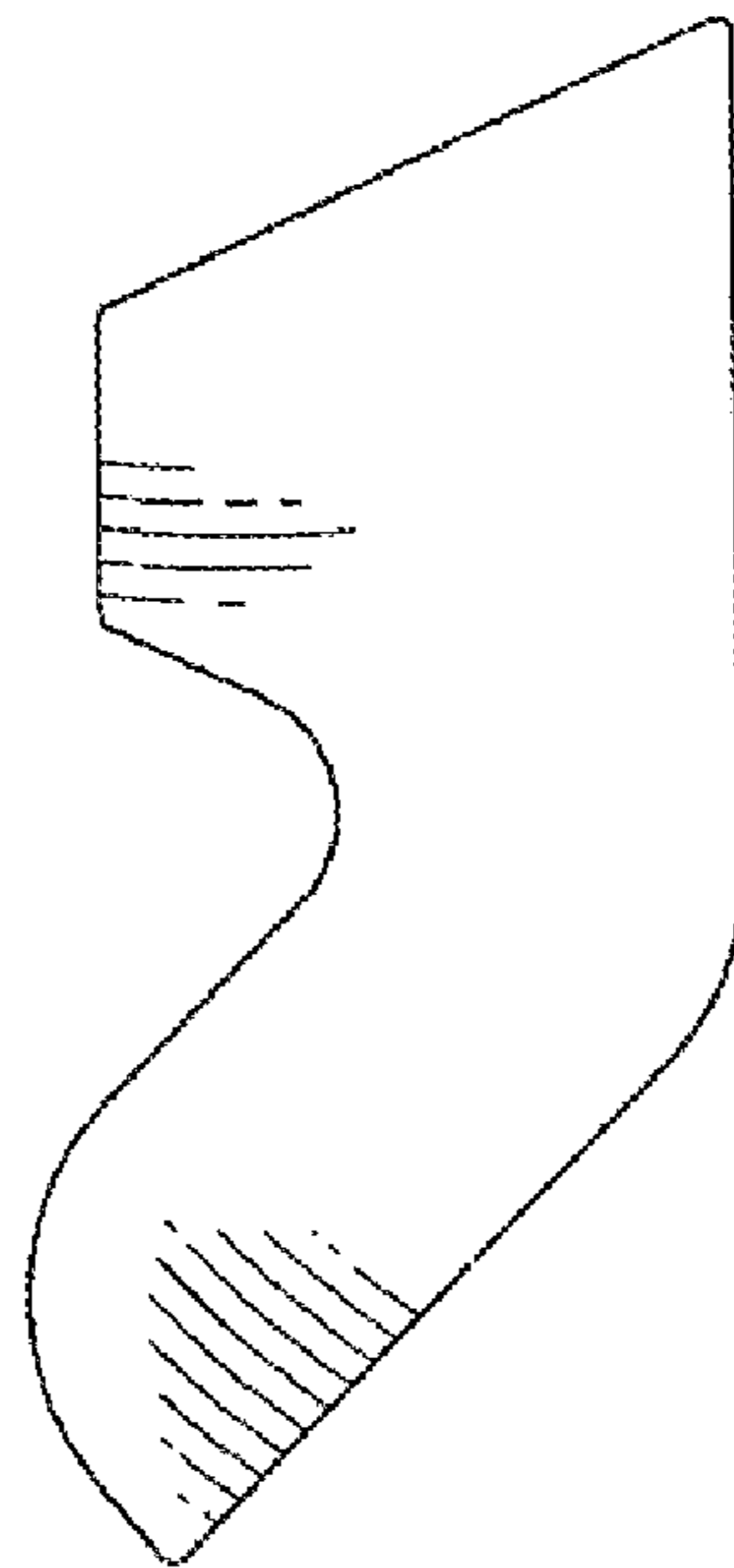

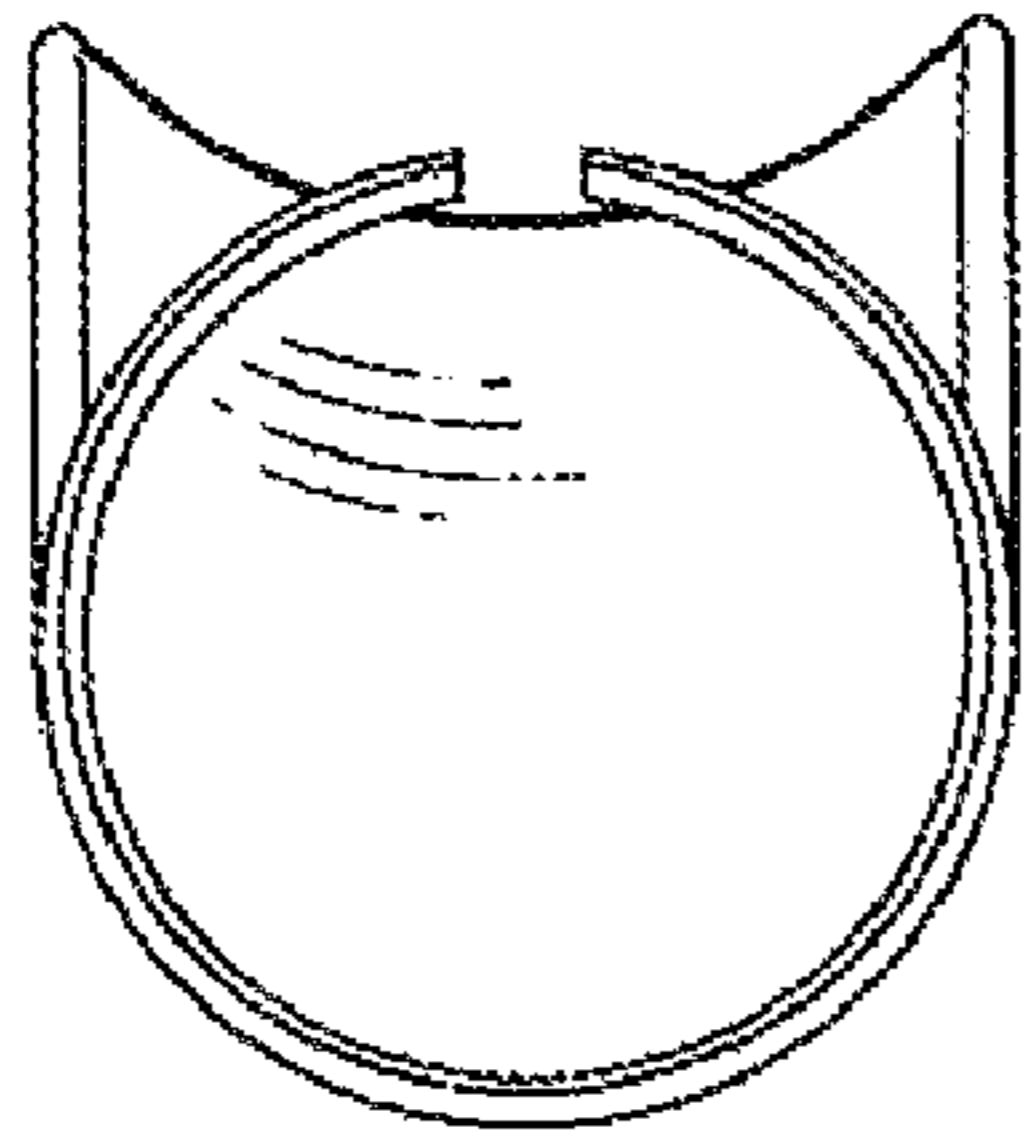

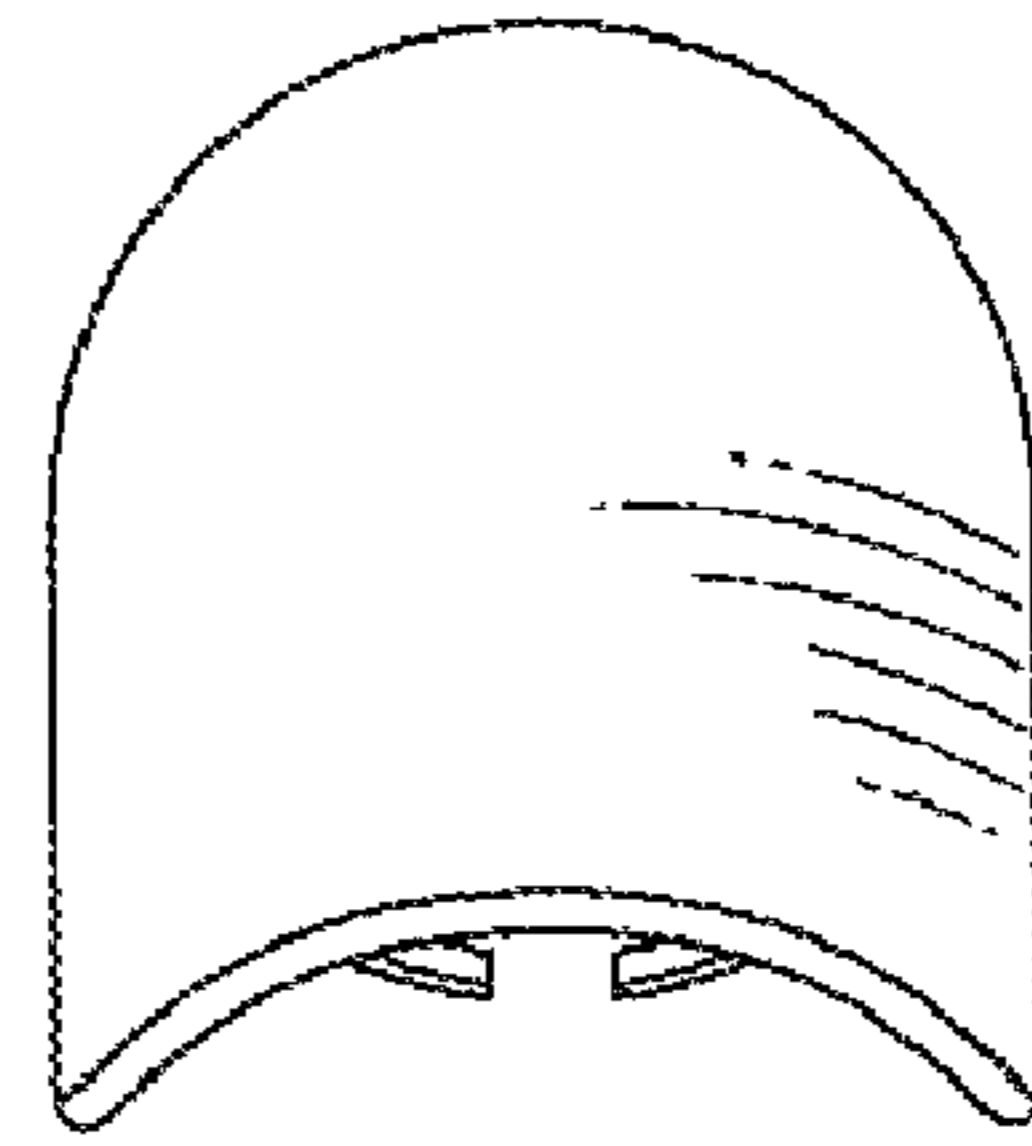

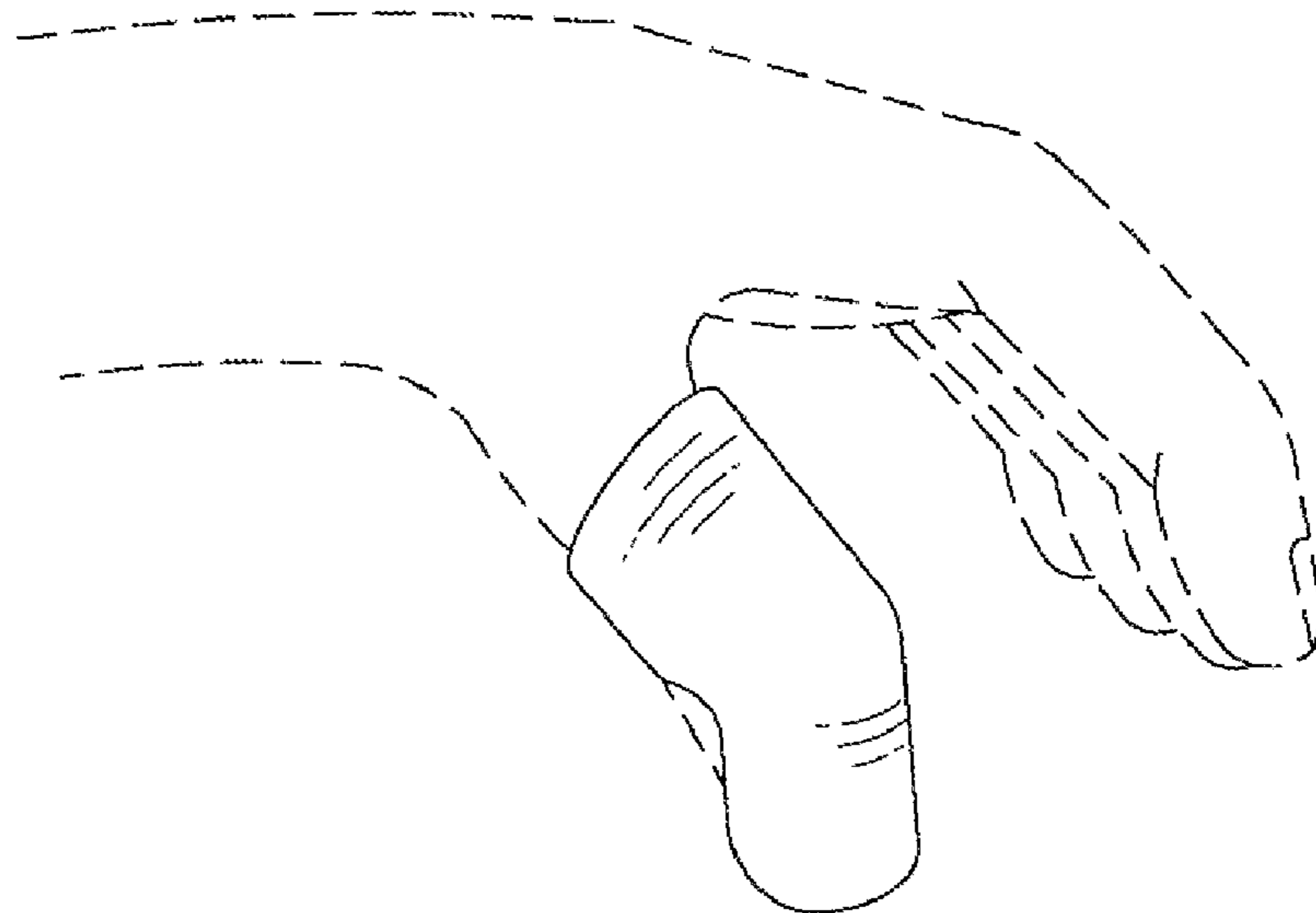
