(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for chair backrest and seat, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair backrest and seat
of the invention. The view from the opposite side being a
mirror image thereof.

FIG. 2 is a side view of a chair backrest and seat of the
invention. The view from the opposite side being an identical
mirror image thereof.

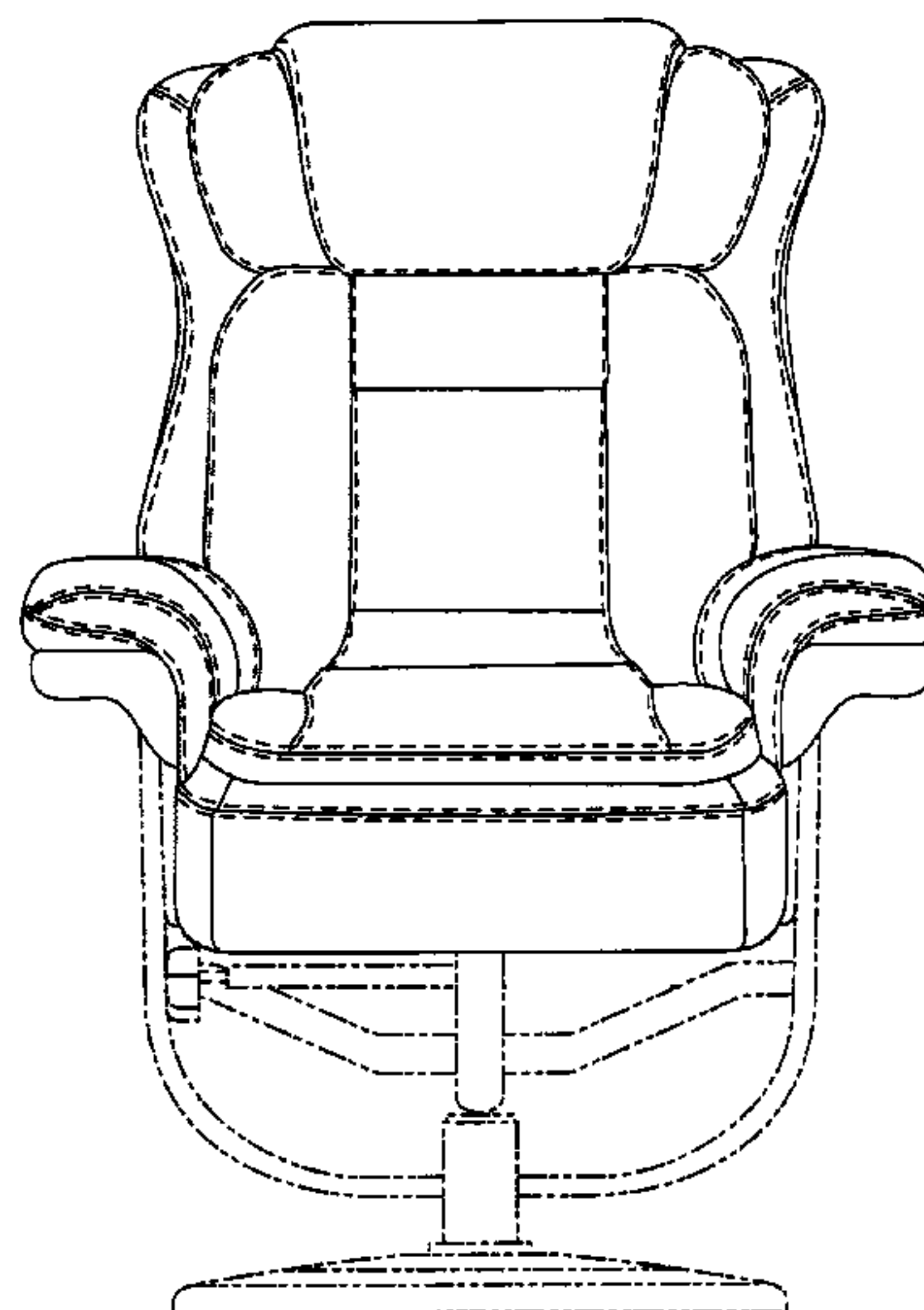
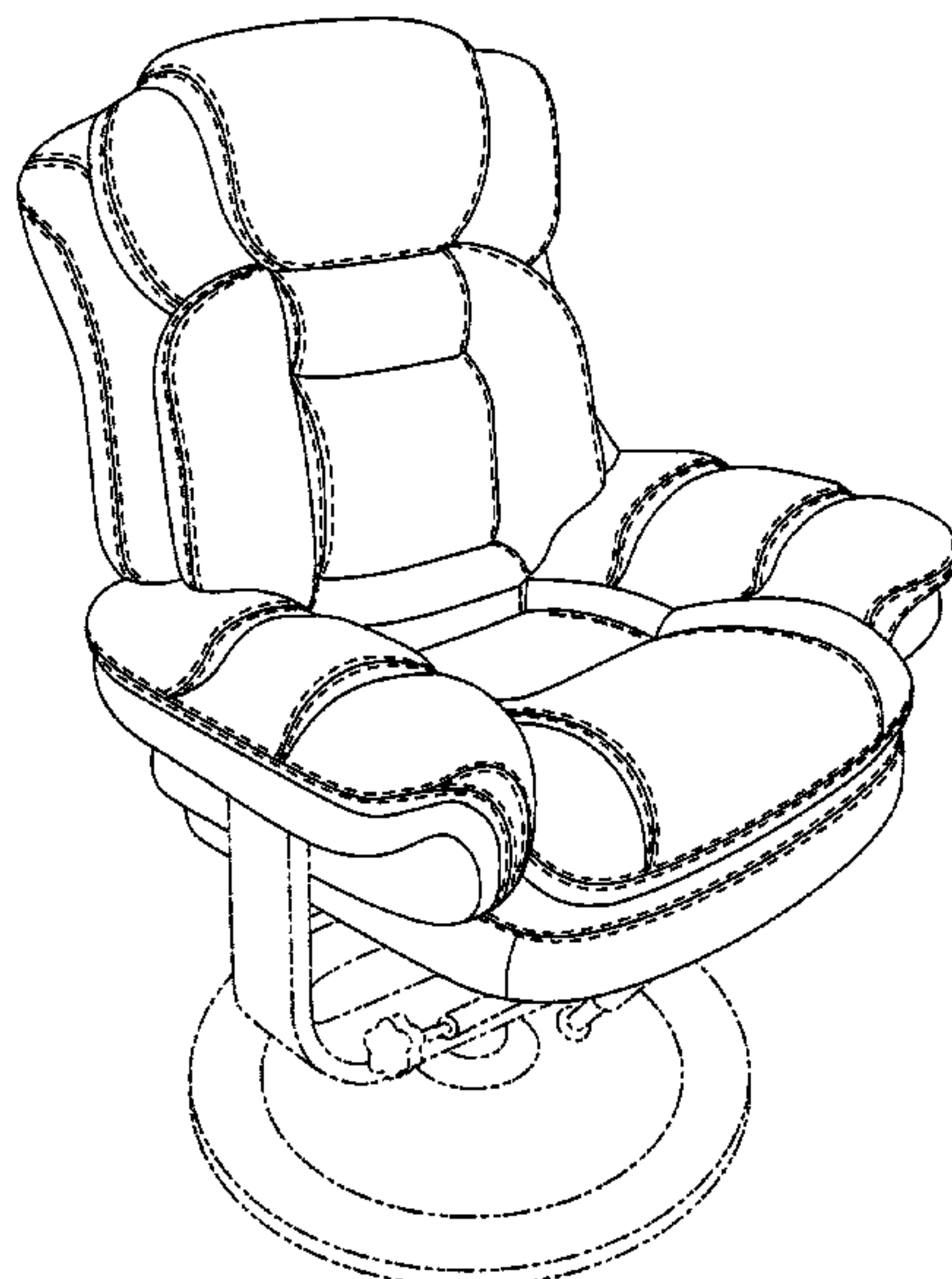
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of a chair backrest and seat

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a chair backrest and seat of the
invention.

other dashed lines, comprising two short and one long dashed

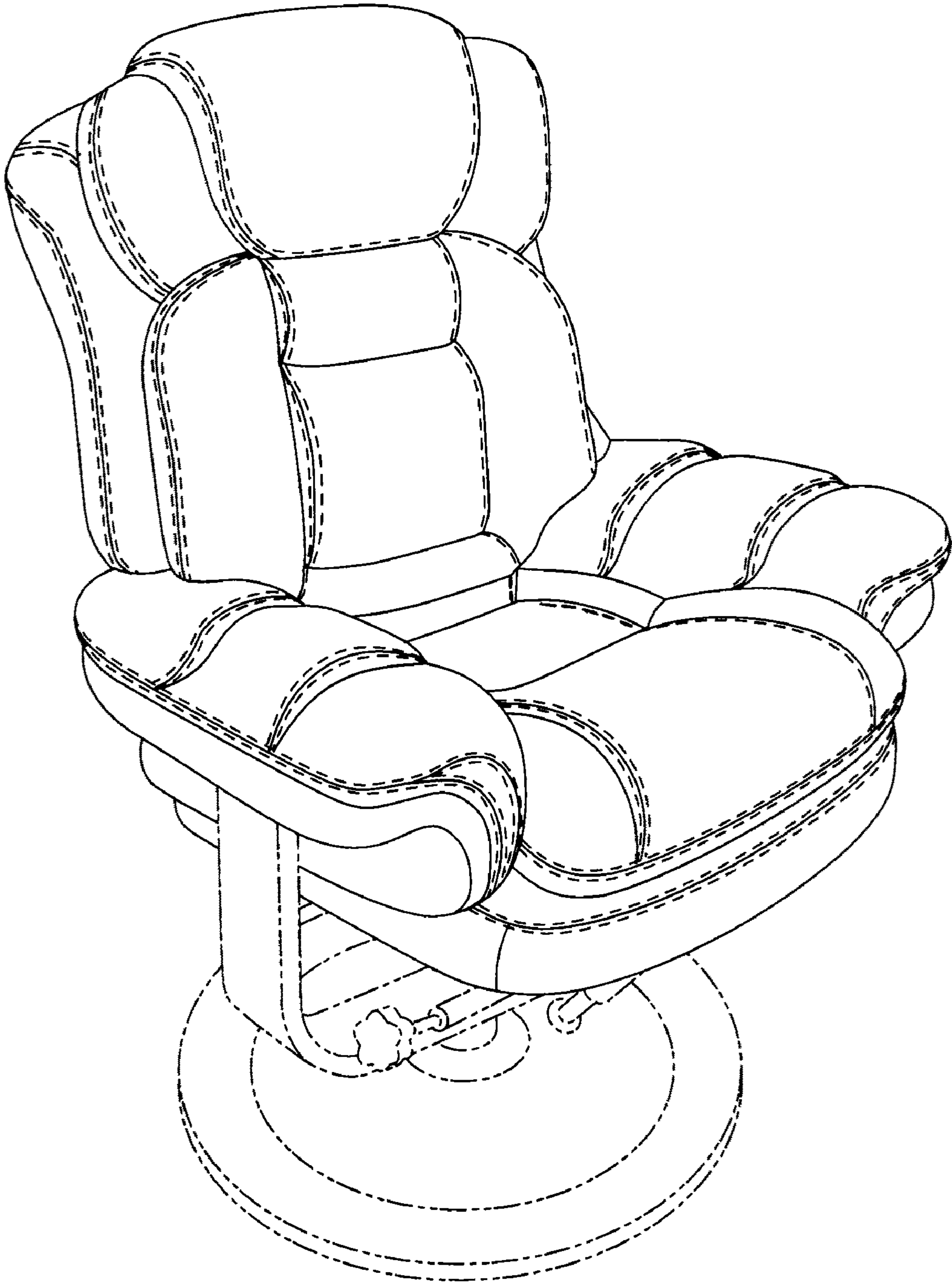

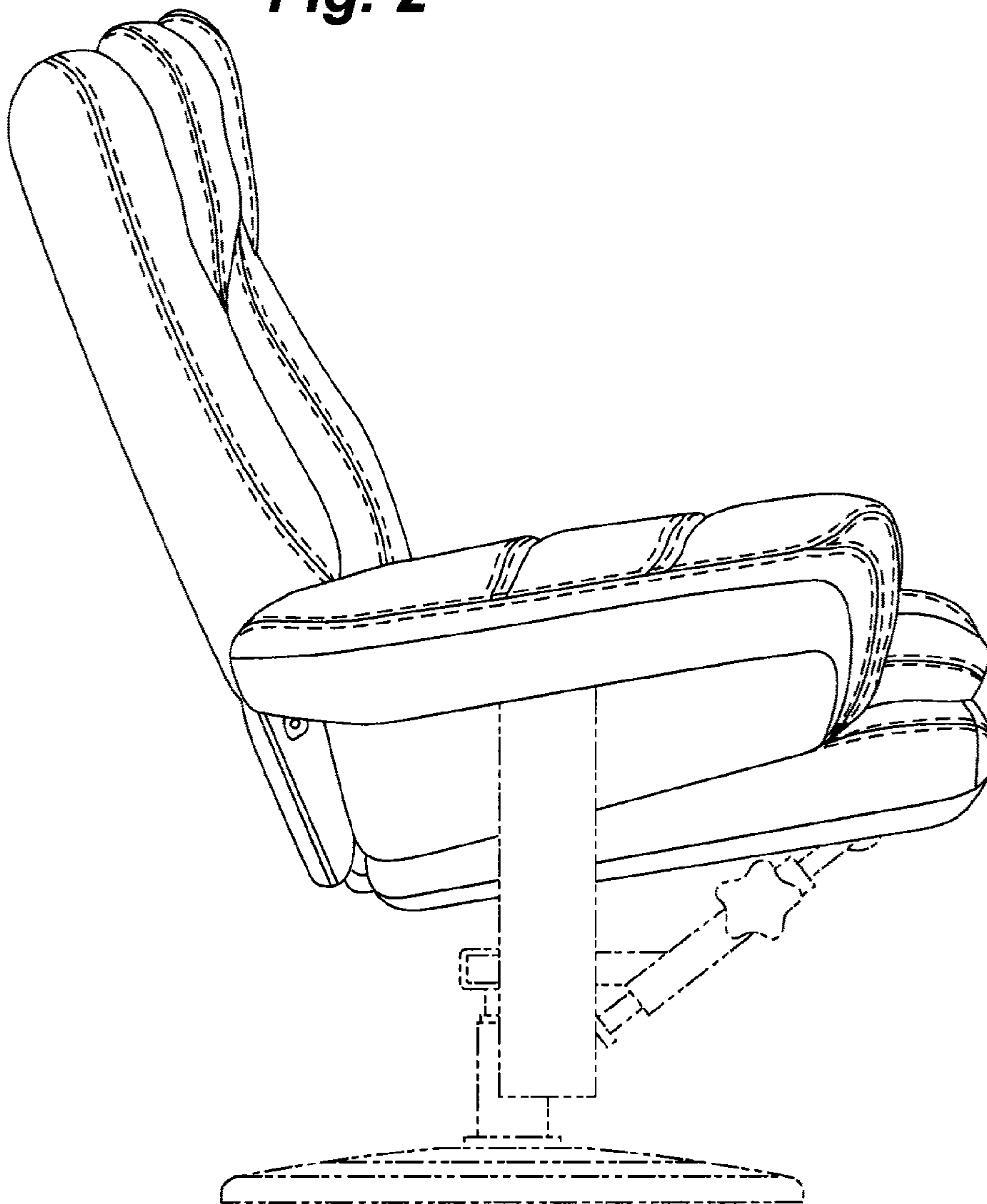

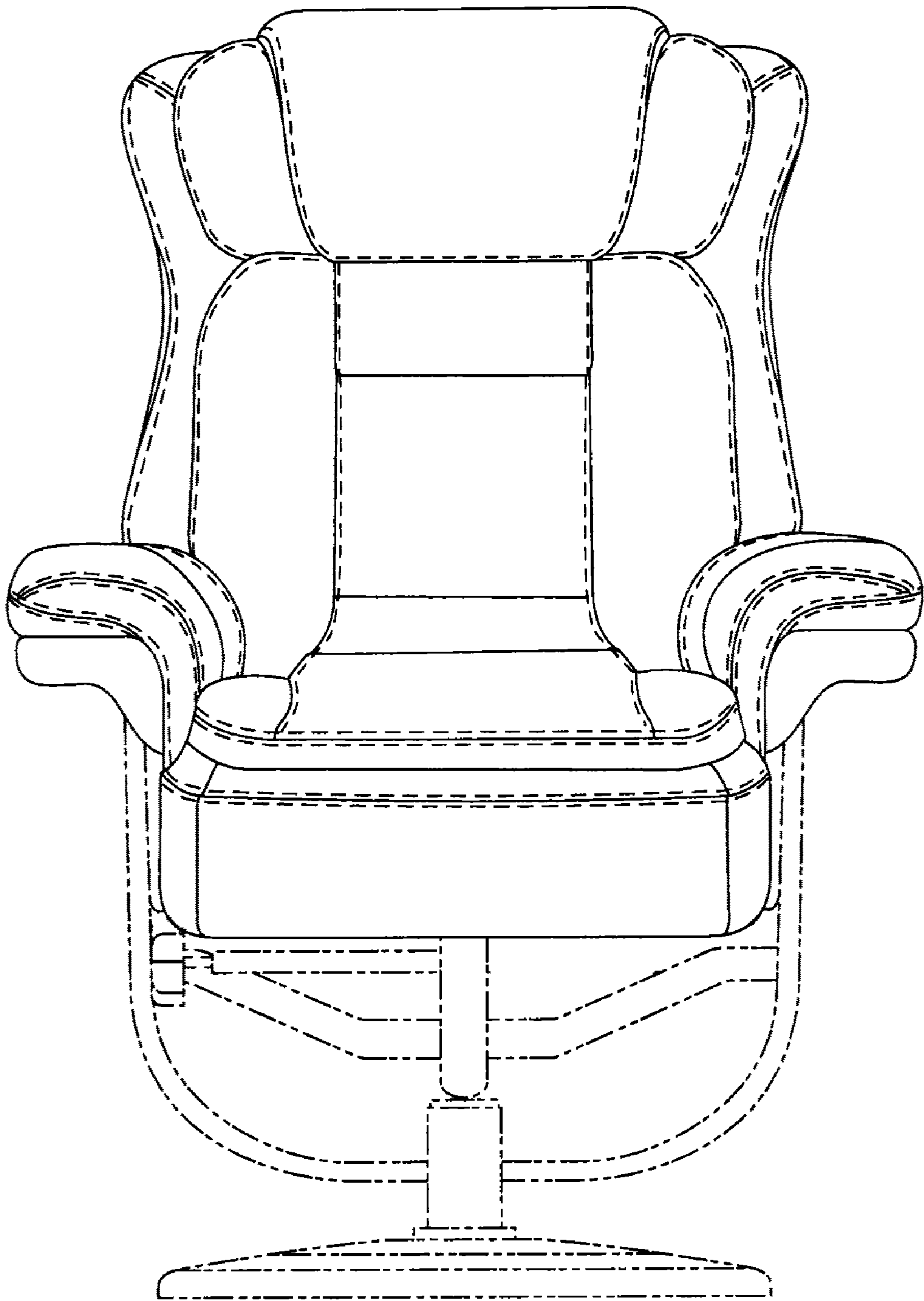
