FIG. 7 is a top view thereof;

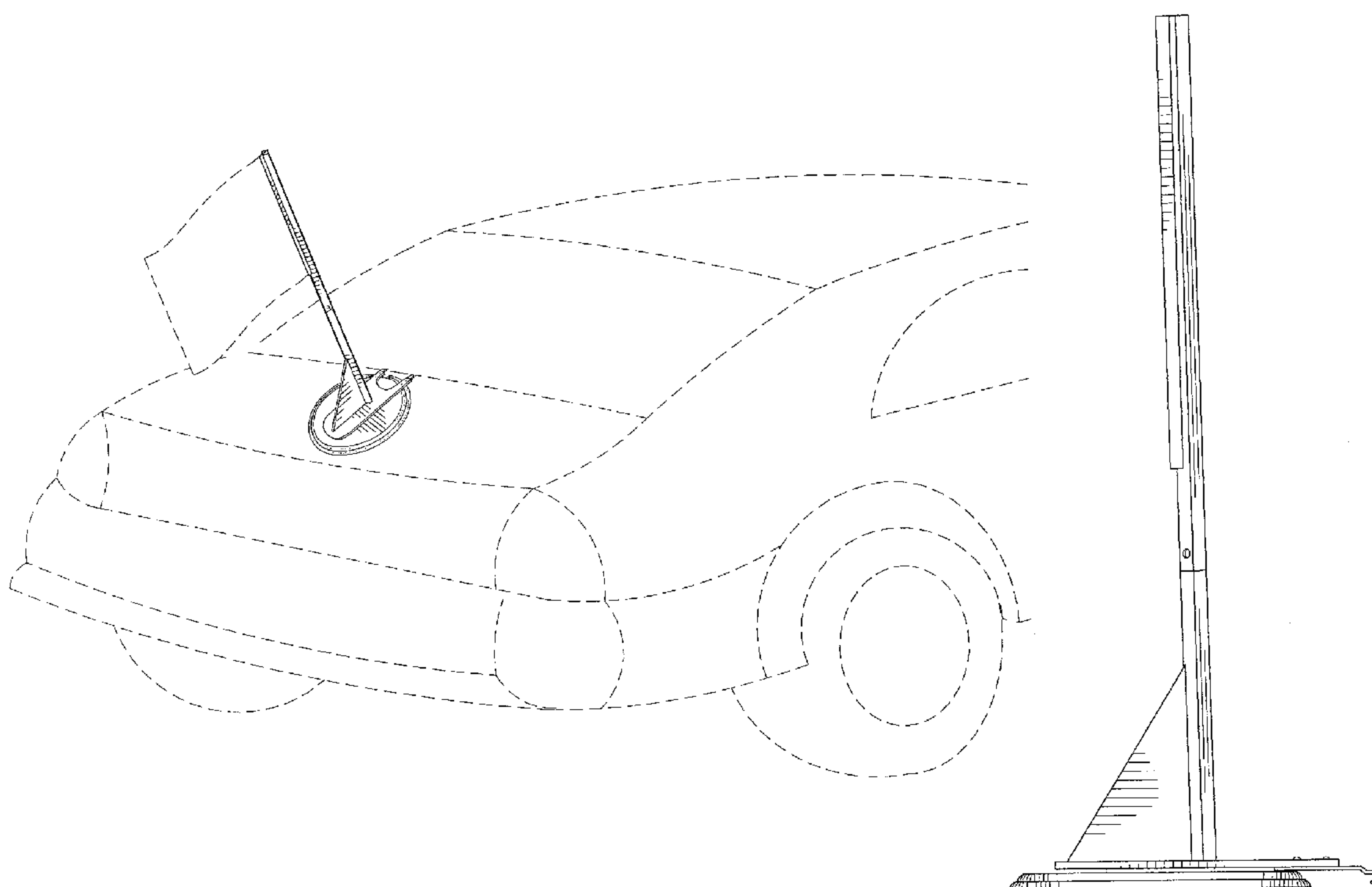
FIG. 8 is an enlarged rear view of the upper section of the truck mounted flag holder with the flag clasp part removed;

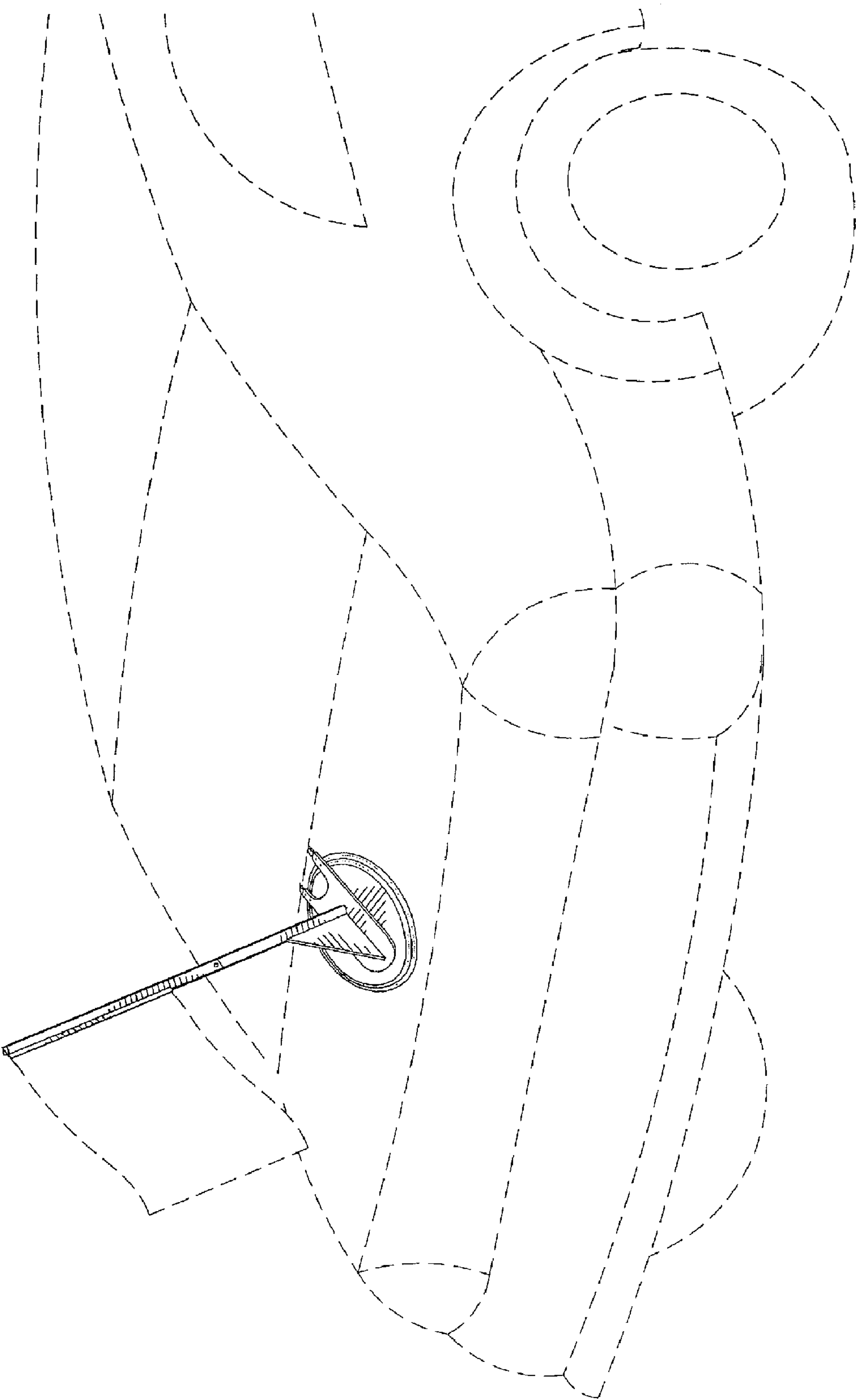

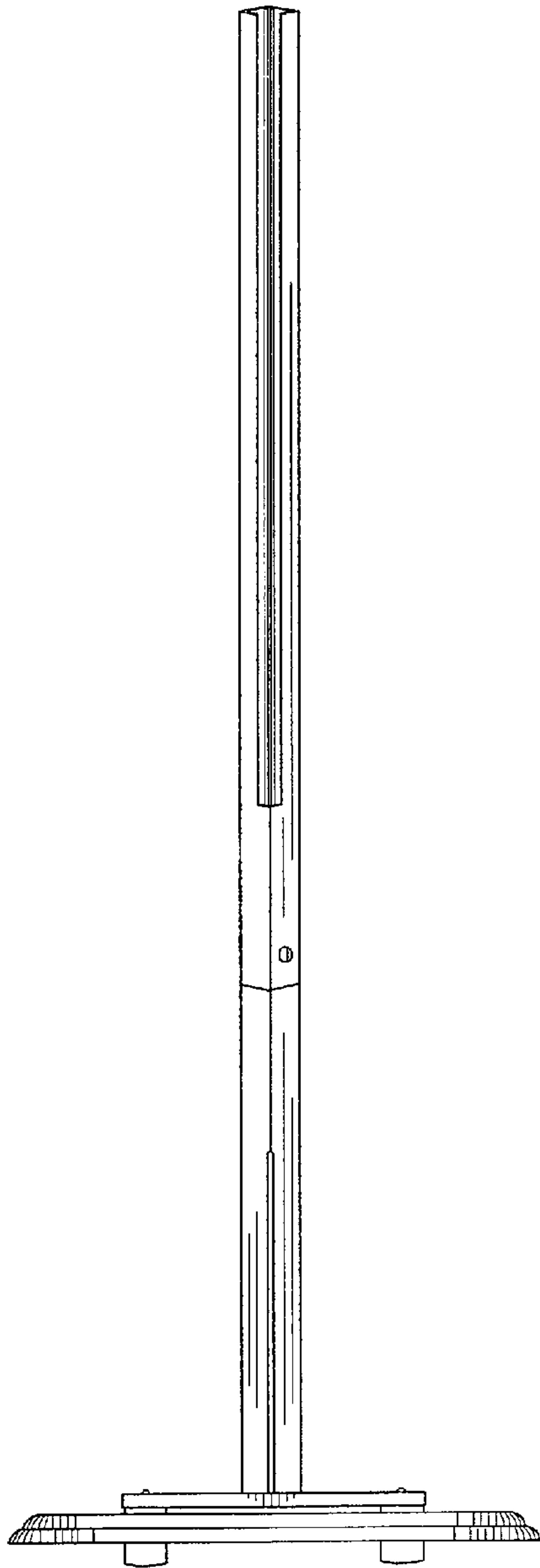

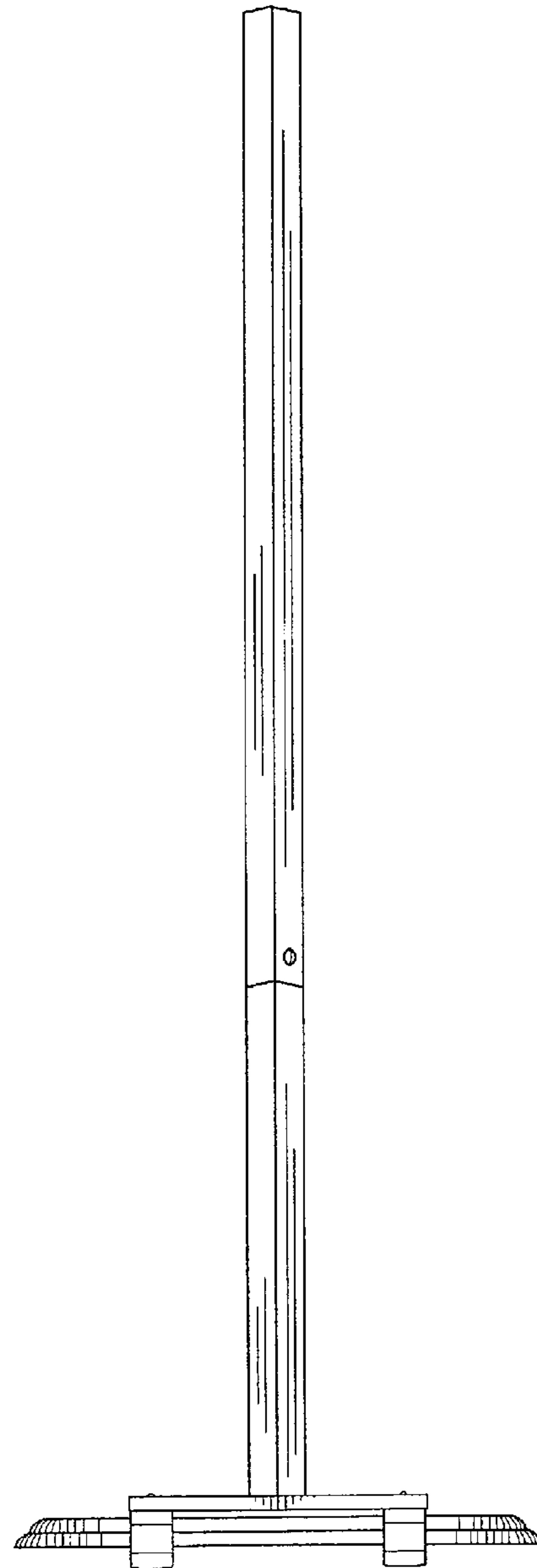

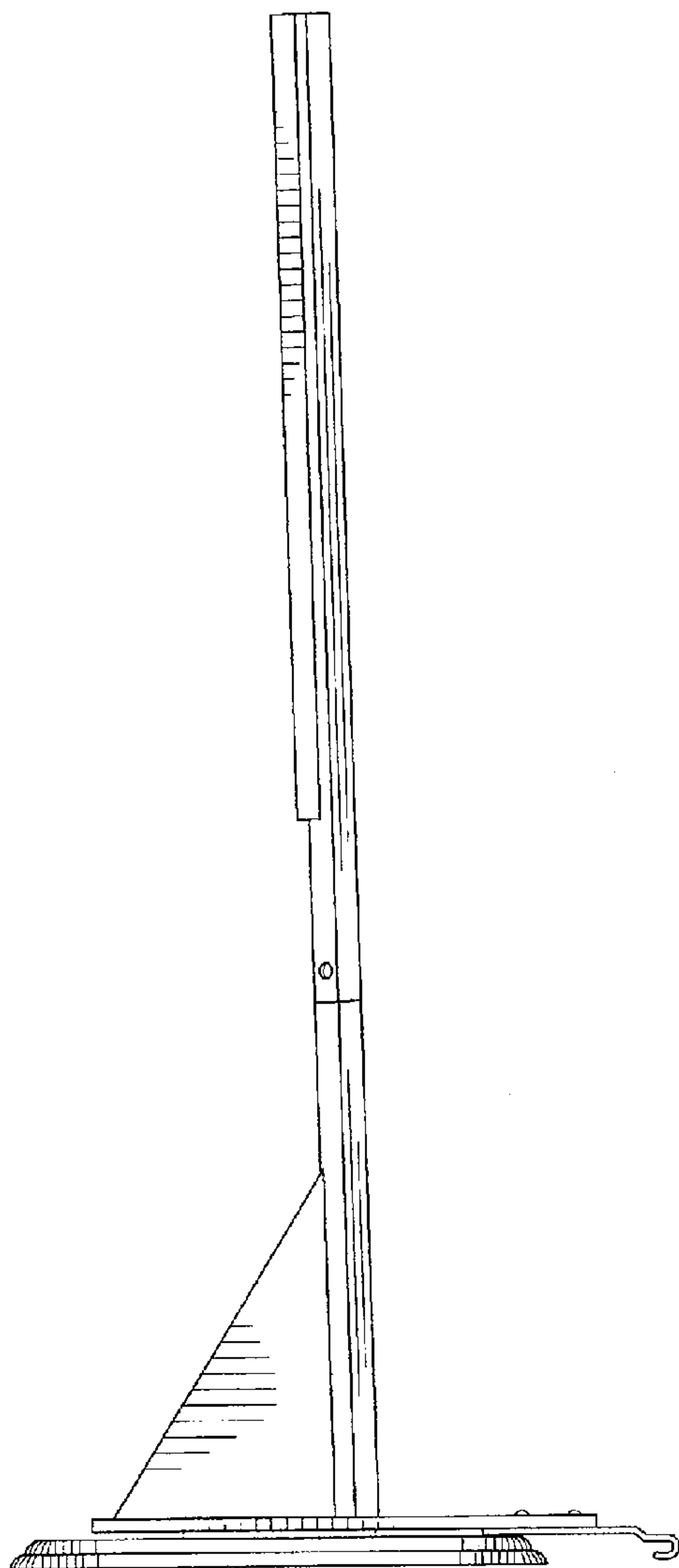

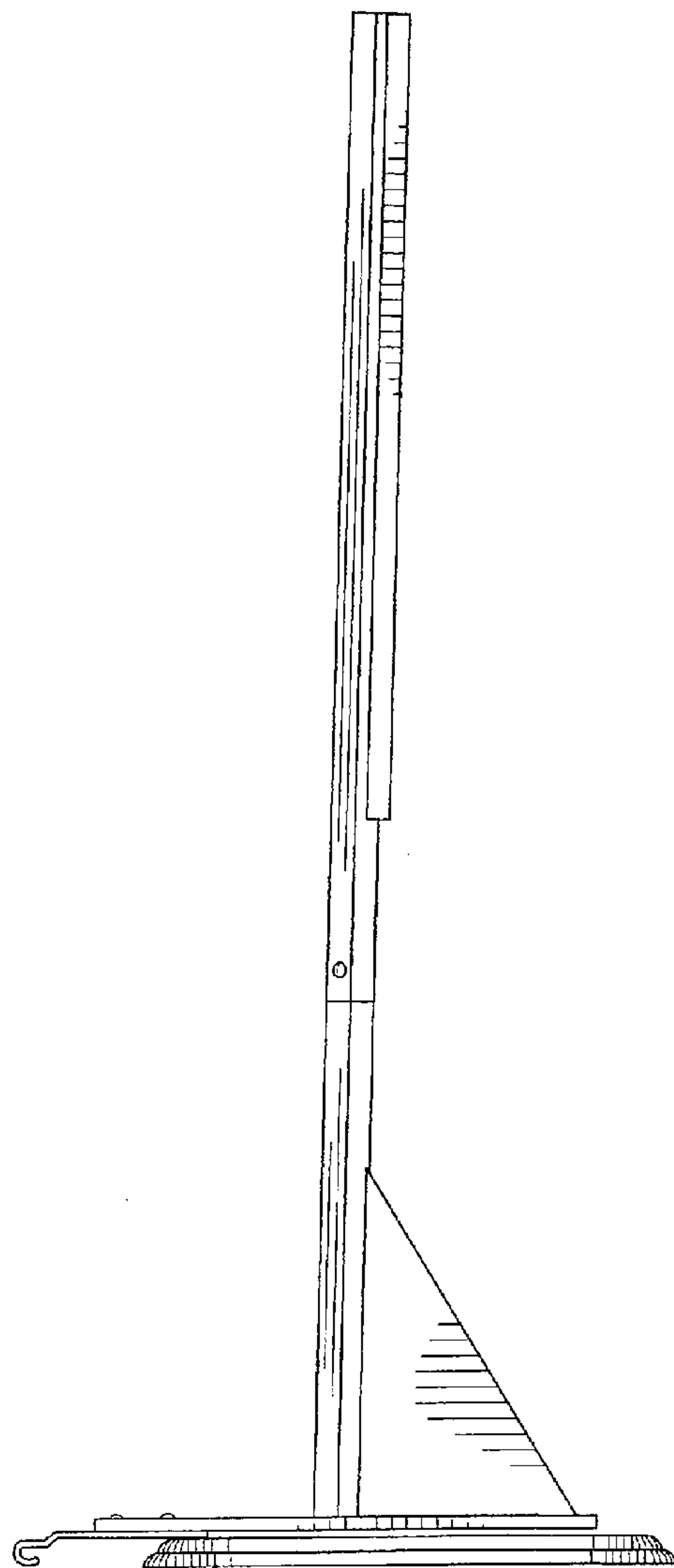

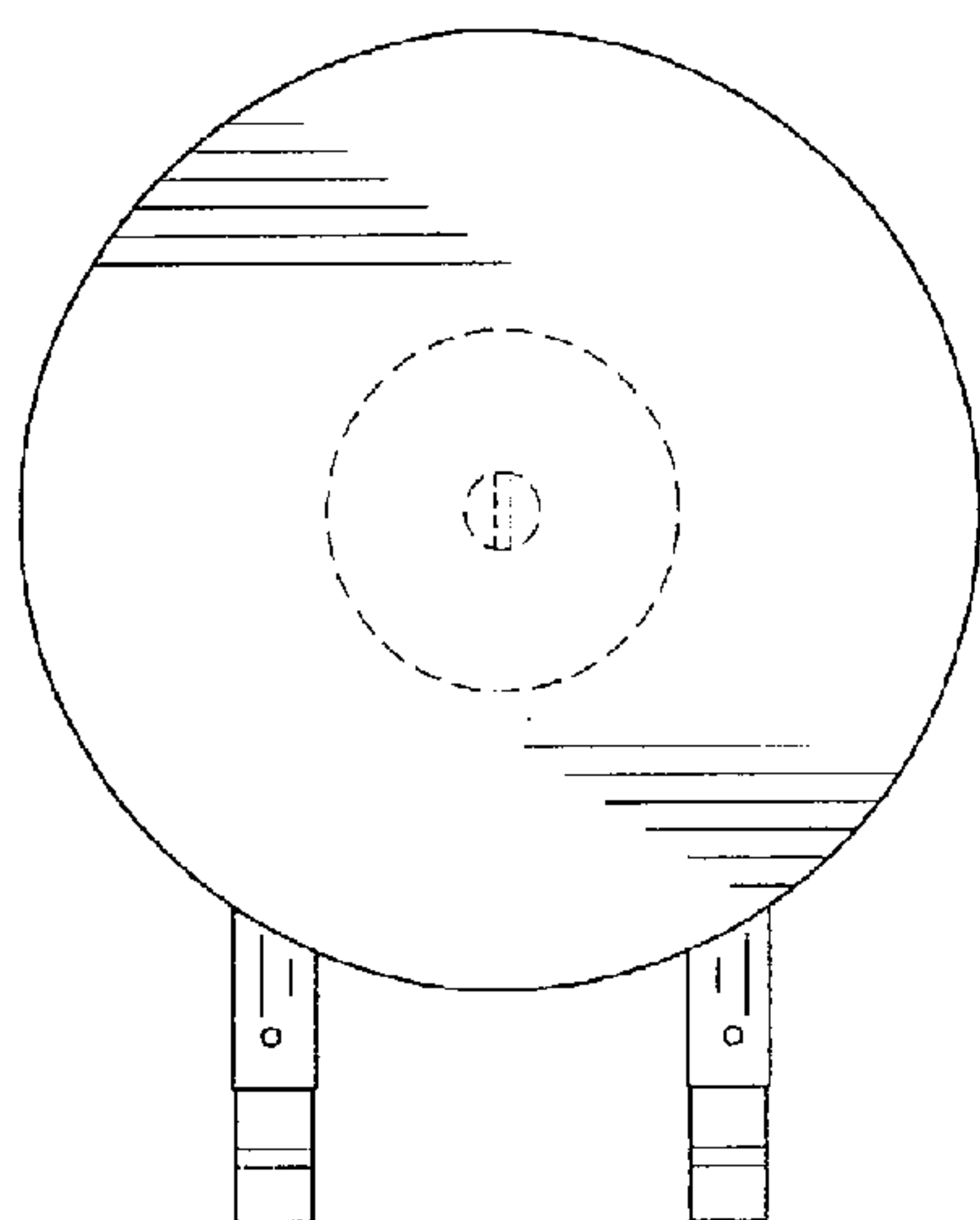

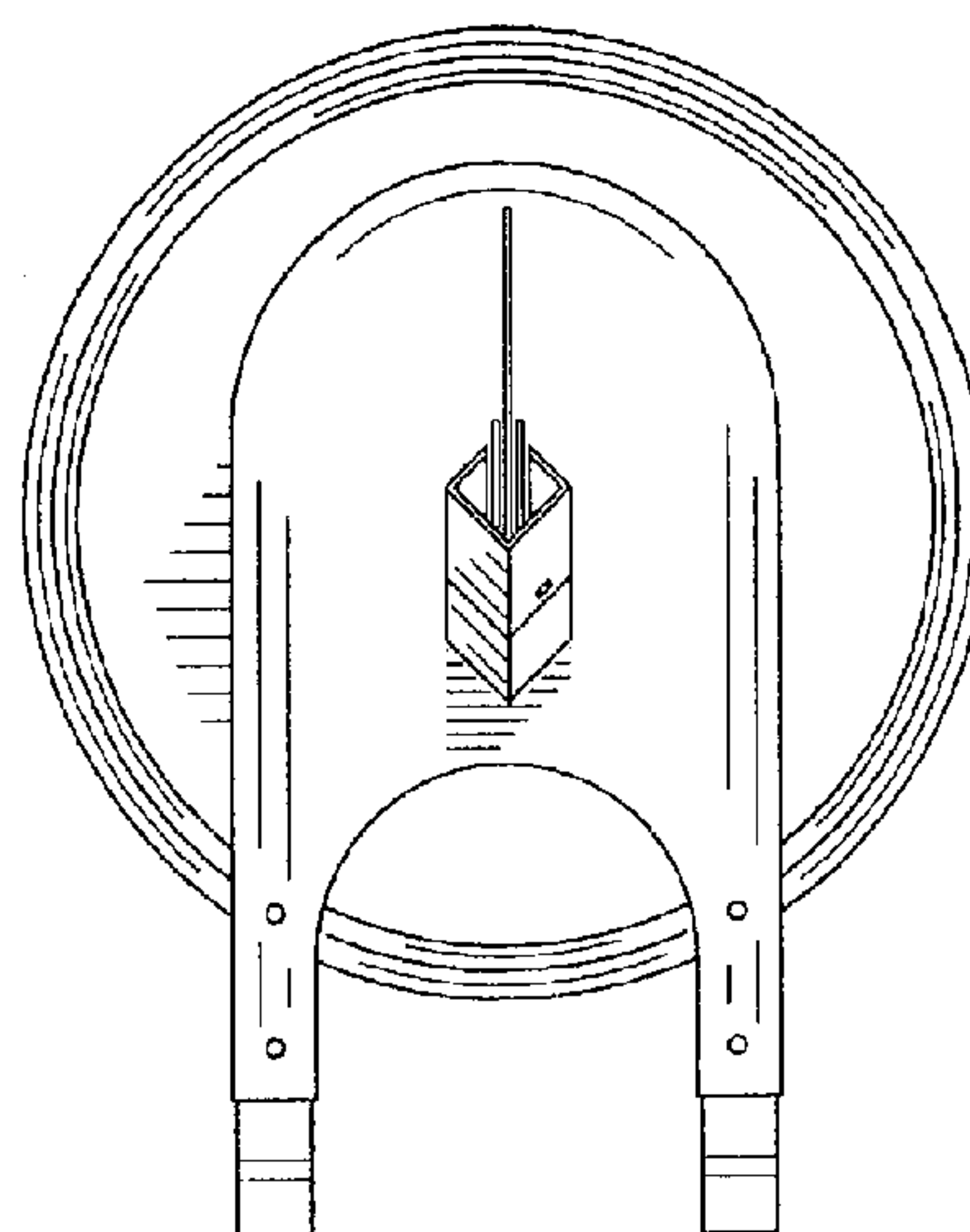

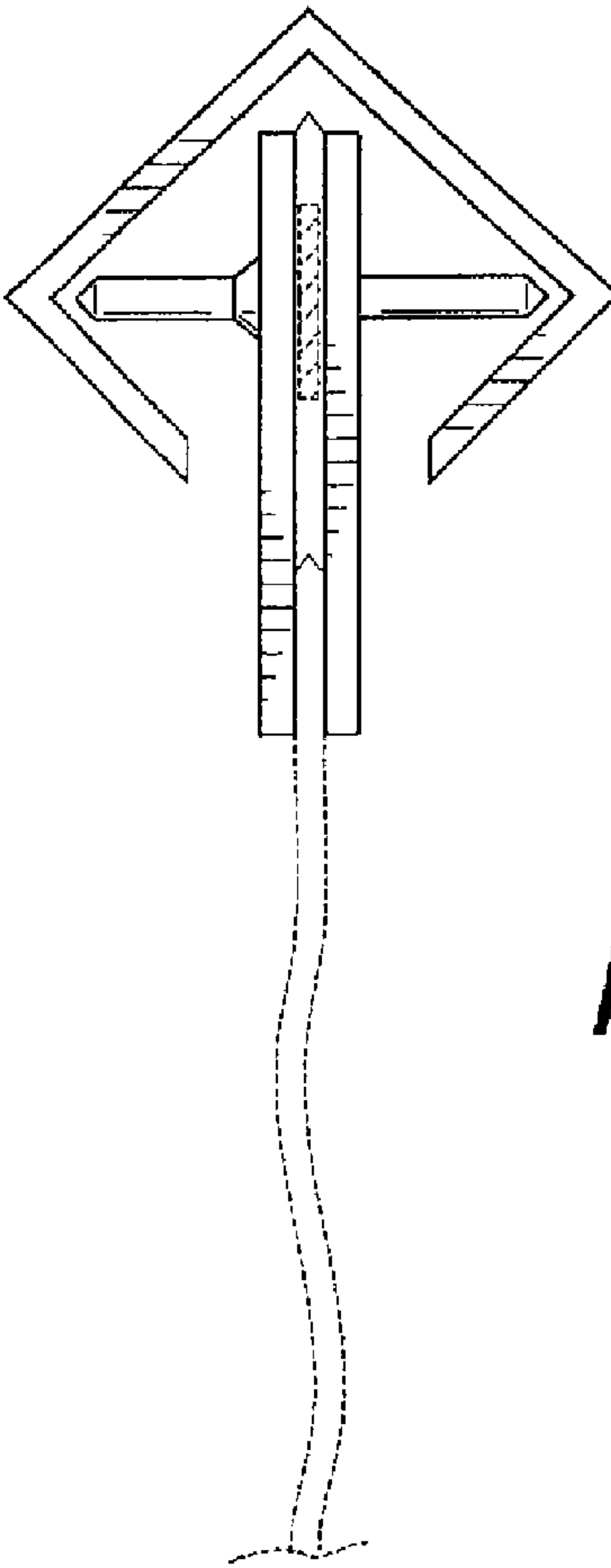

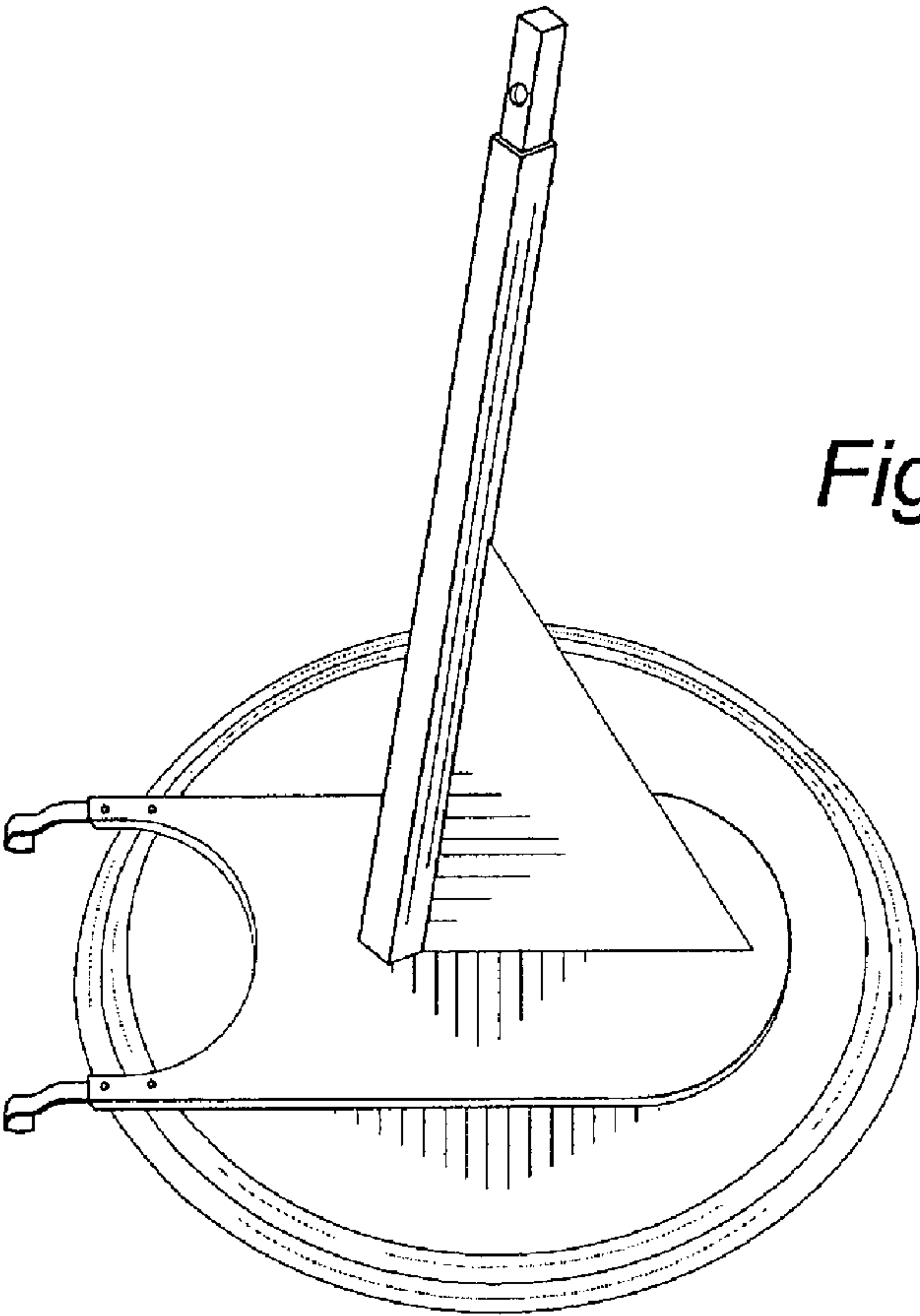
