FIG. 4 is a side view thereof.

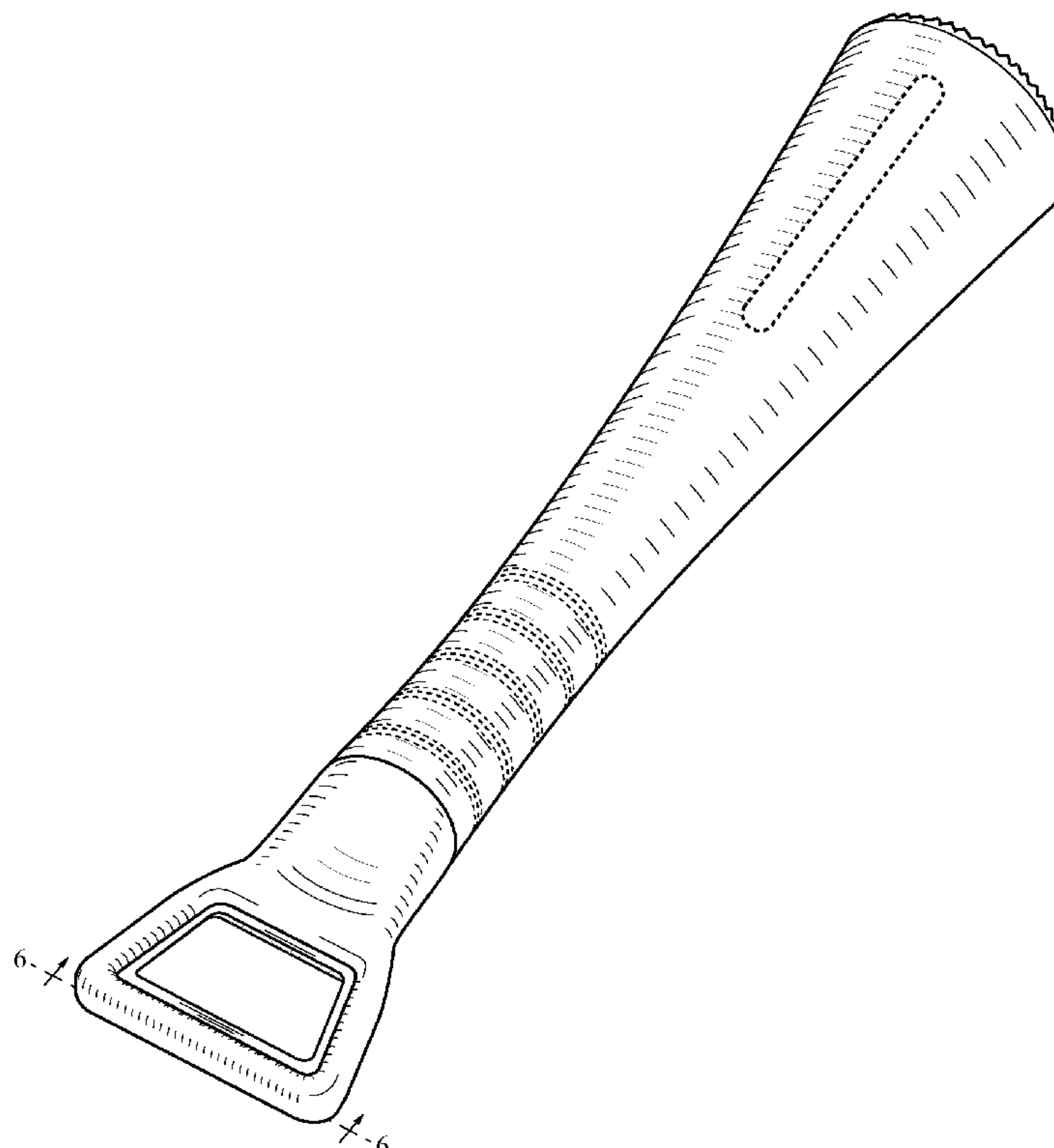
FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof; and,

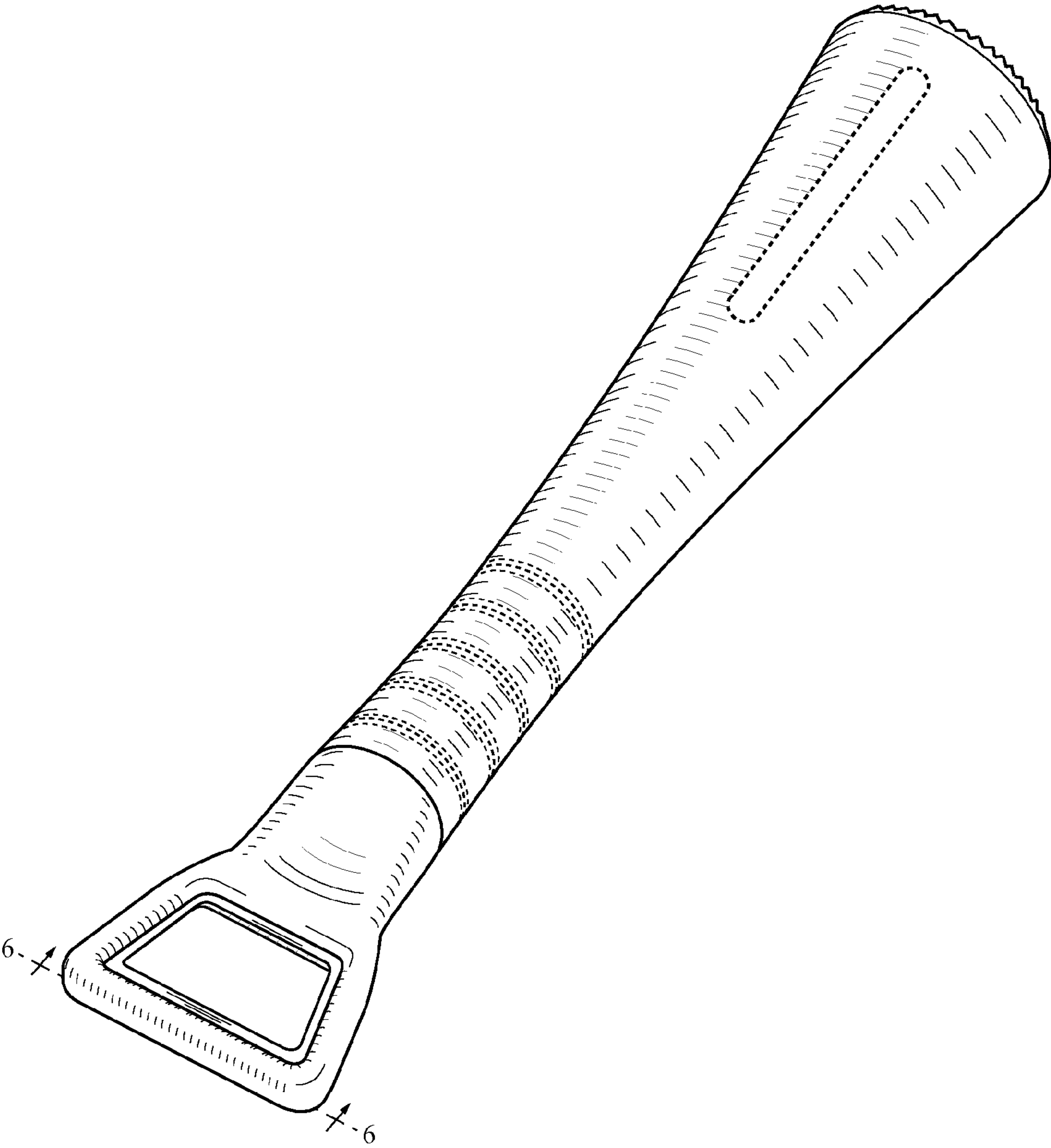

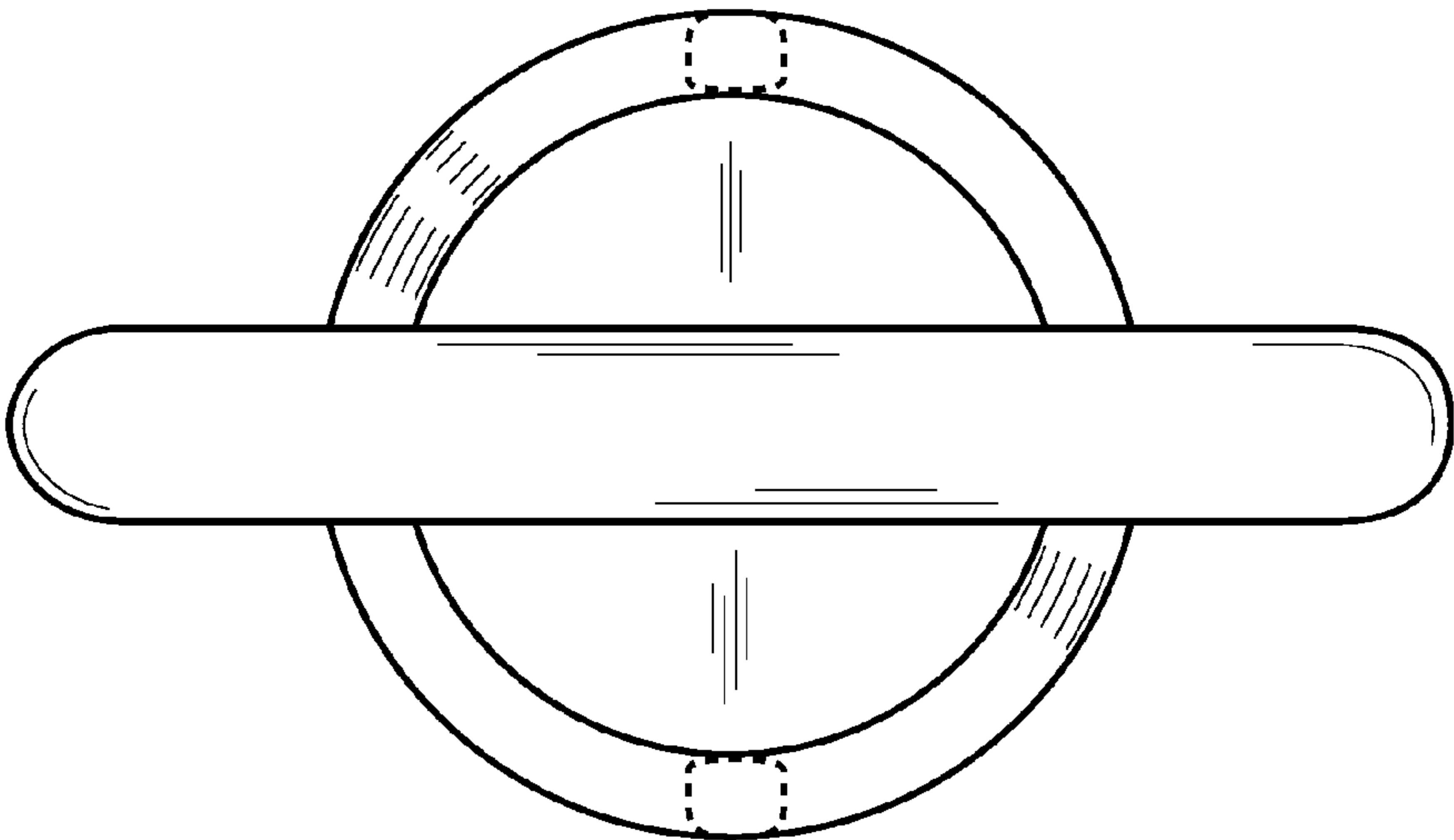

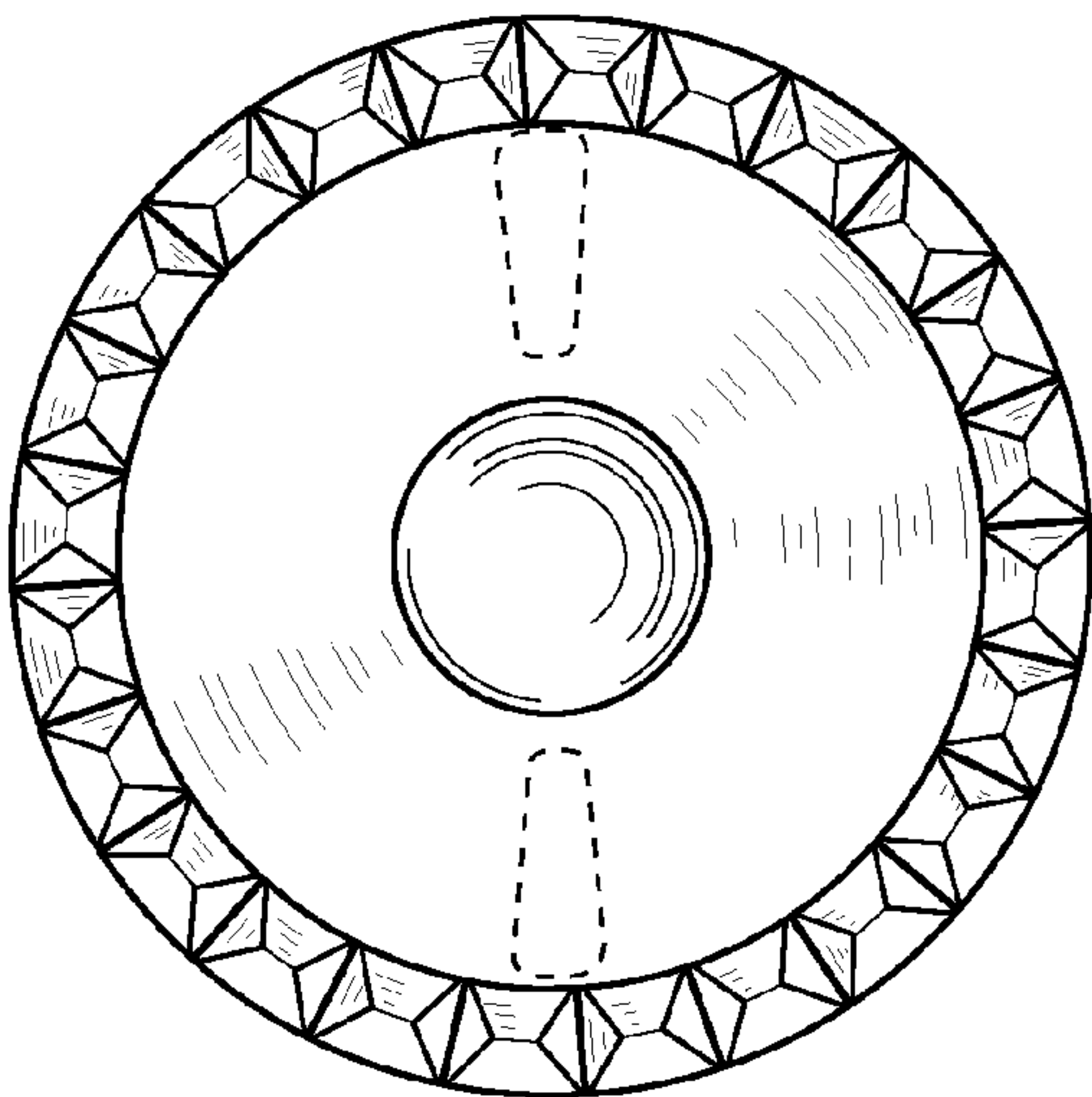

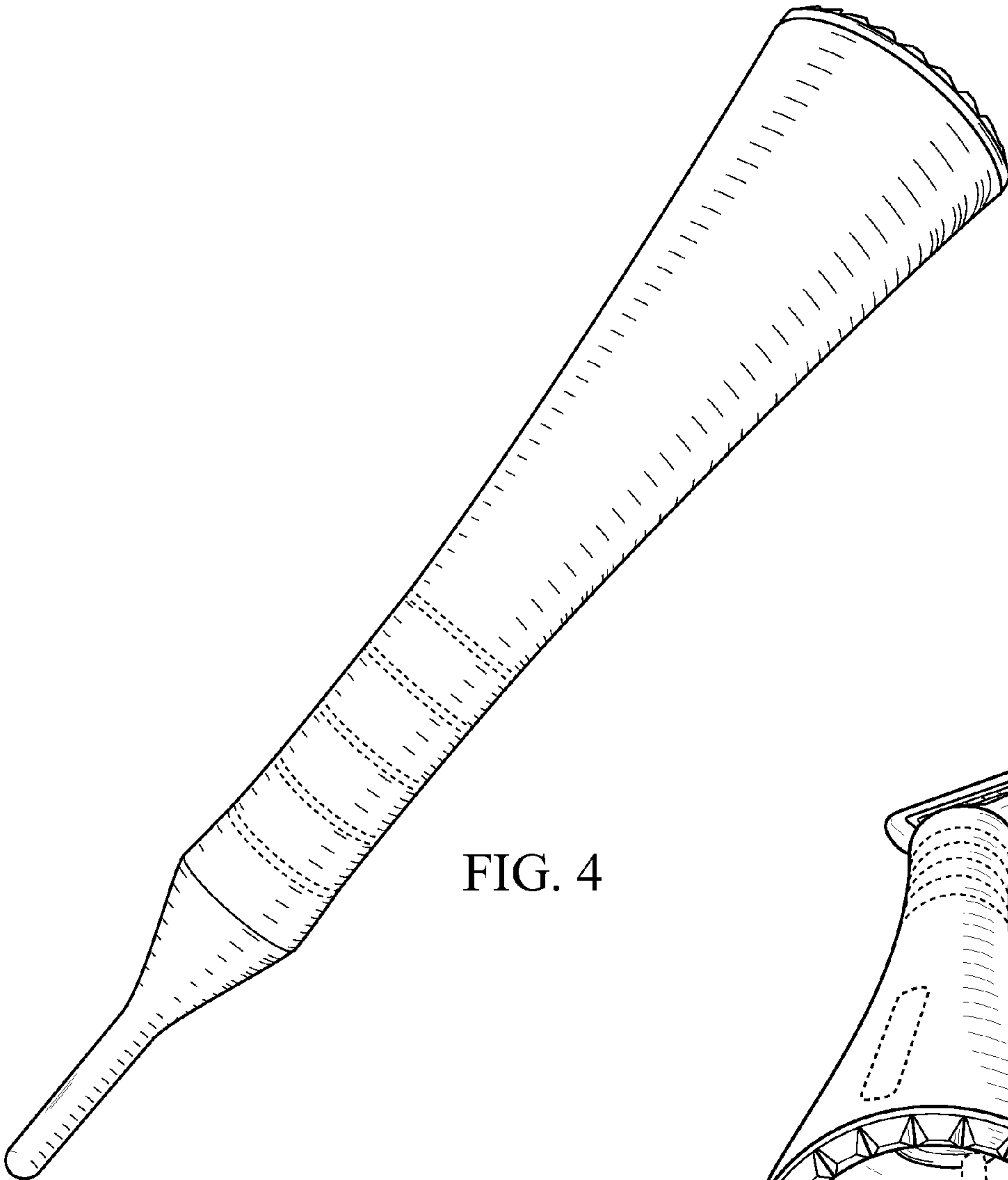

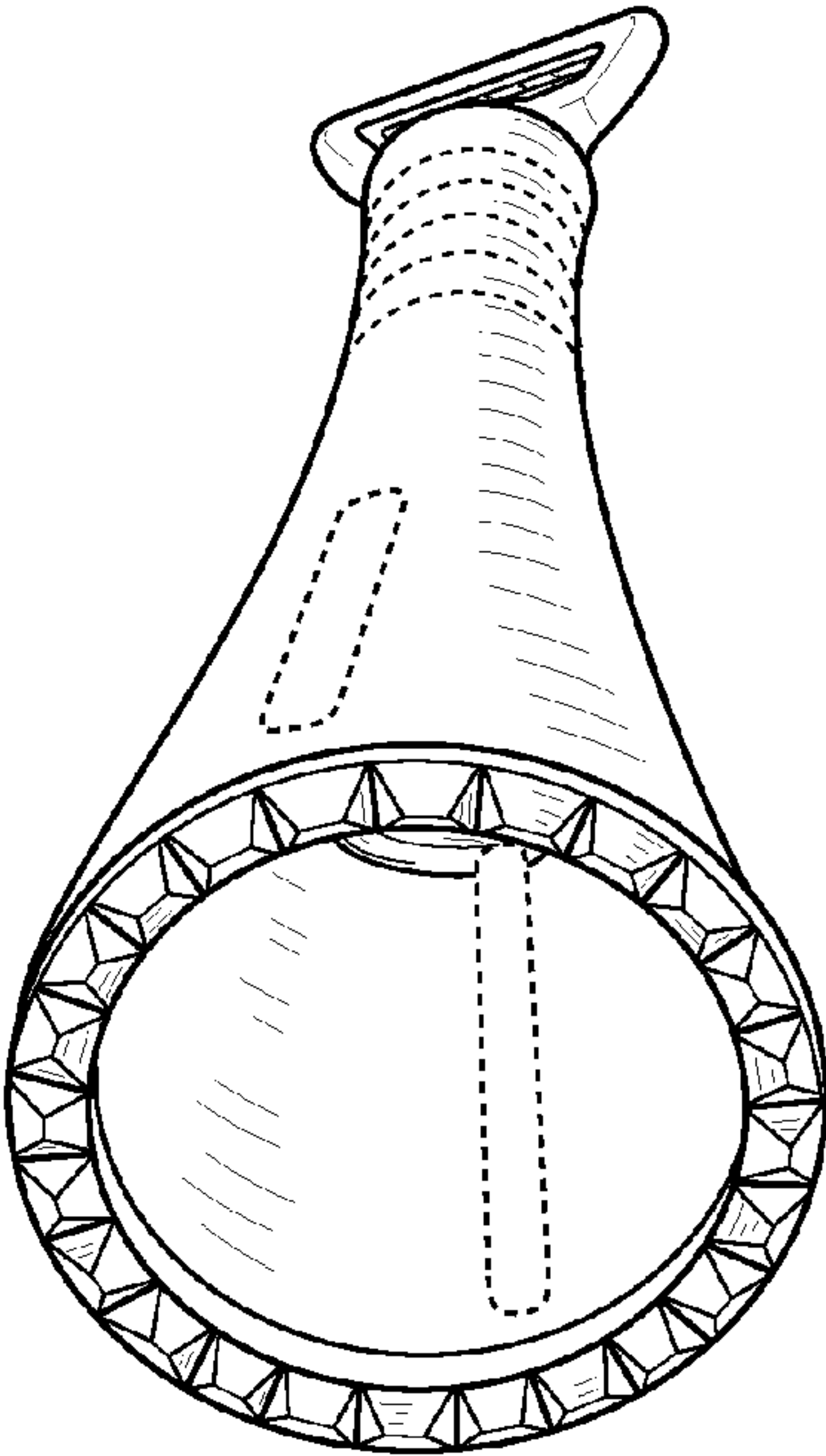

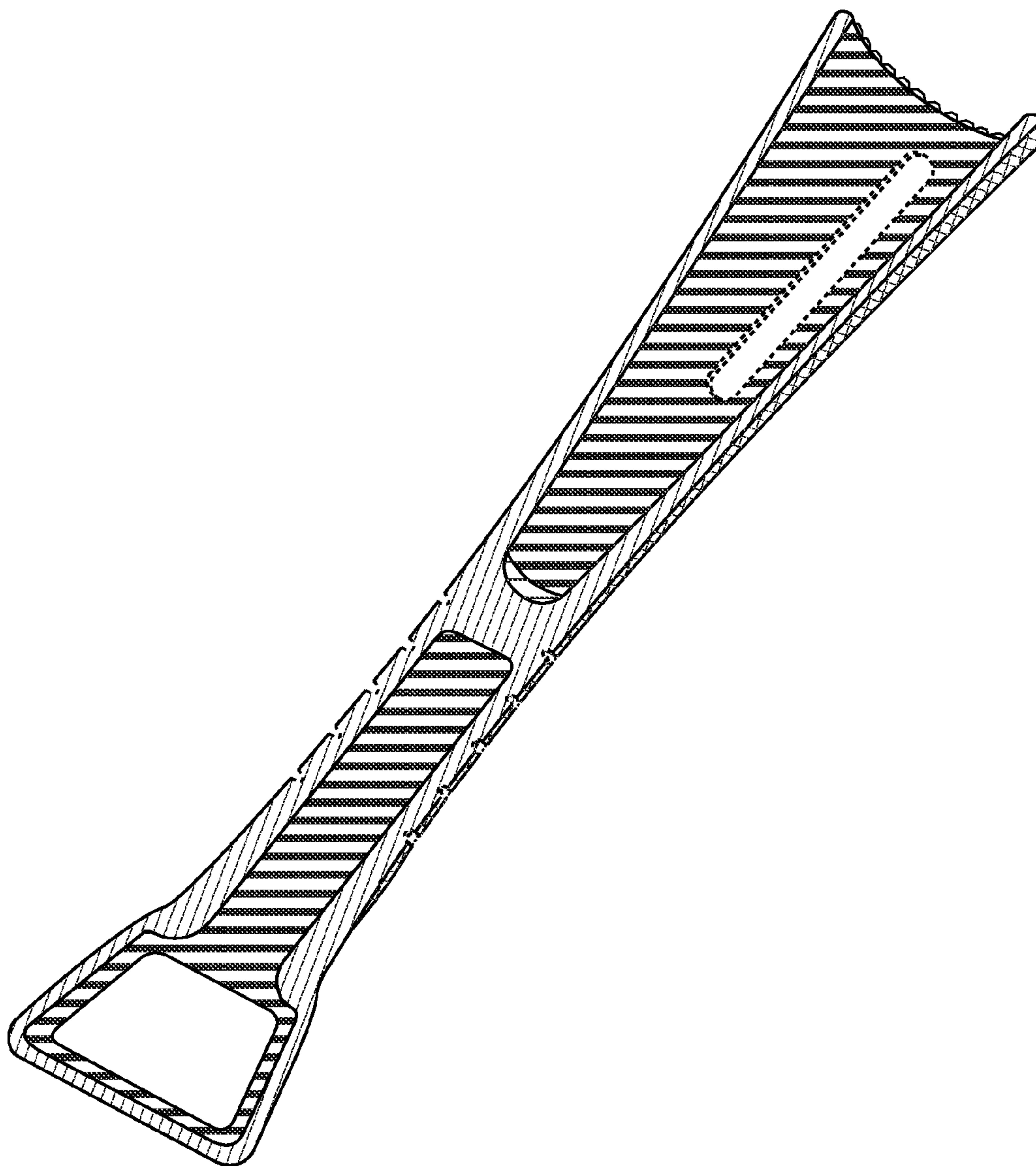
