(57) **CLAIM**

An ornamental design for a shoulder bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the shoulder bag according to a first embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view according to the first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view according to the first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side view according to the first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view according to the first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top view according to the first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view according to the first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 8 a front perspective view of the shoulder bag according to a second embodiment thereof wherein line shading and stippling are used in different areas in the drawing to show the appearance of contrasting surfaces, unlimited by colors and specific materials;

FIG. 9 is a front view according to the second embodiment thereof wherein line shading and stippling are used in different areas in the drawing to show the appearance of contrasting surfaces, unlimited by colors and specific materials;

FIG. 10 is a rear view according to the second embodiment thereof wherein line shading and stippling are used in different areas in the drawing to show the appearance of contrasting surfaces, unlimited by colors and specific materials;

FIG. 11 is a left side view according to the second embodiment thereof wherein line shading and stippling are used in different areas in the drawing to show the appearance of contrasting surfaces, unlimited by colors and specific materials;

FIG. 12 is a right side view according to the second embodiment thereof wherein line shading and stippling are used in different areas in the drawing to show the appearance of contrasting surfaces, unlimited by colors and specific materials;

FIG. 13 is a top view according to the second embodiment thereof wherein line shading and stippling are used in different areas in the drawing to show the appearance of contrasting surfaces, unlimited by colors and specific materials; and,

FIG. 14 is a bottom view according to the second embodiment thereof wherein line shading and stippling are used in different areas in the drawing to show the appearance of contrasting surfaces, unlimited by colors and specific materials.

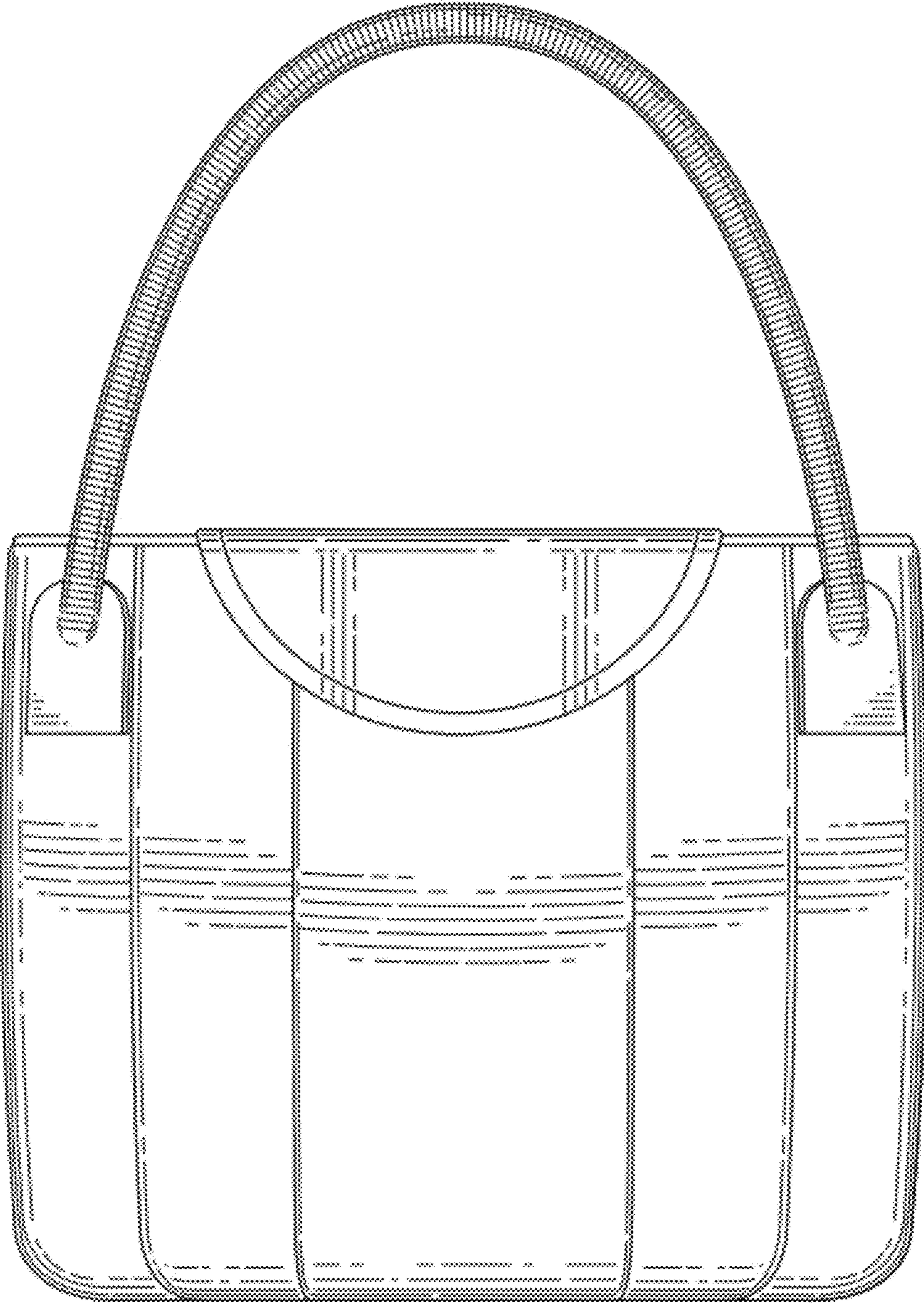

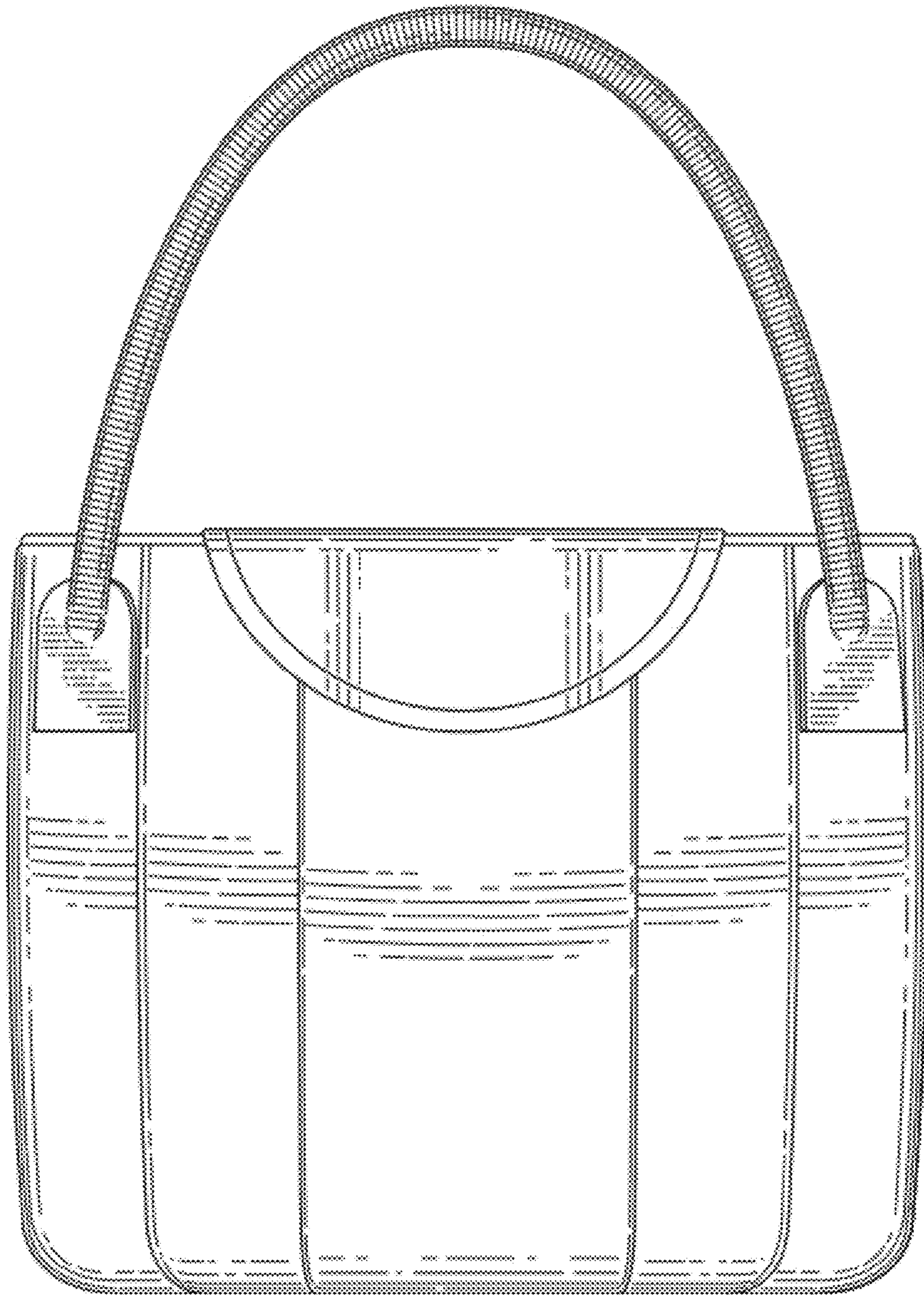

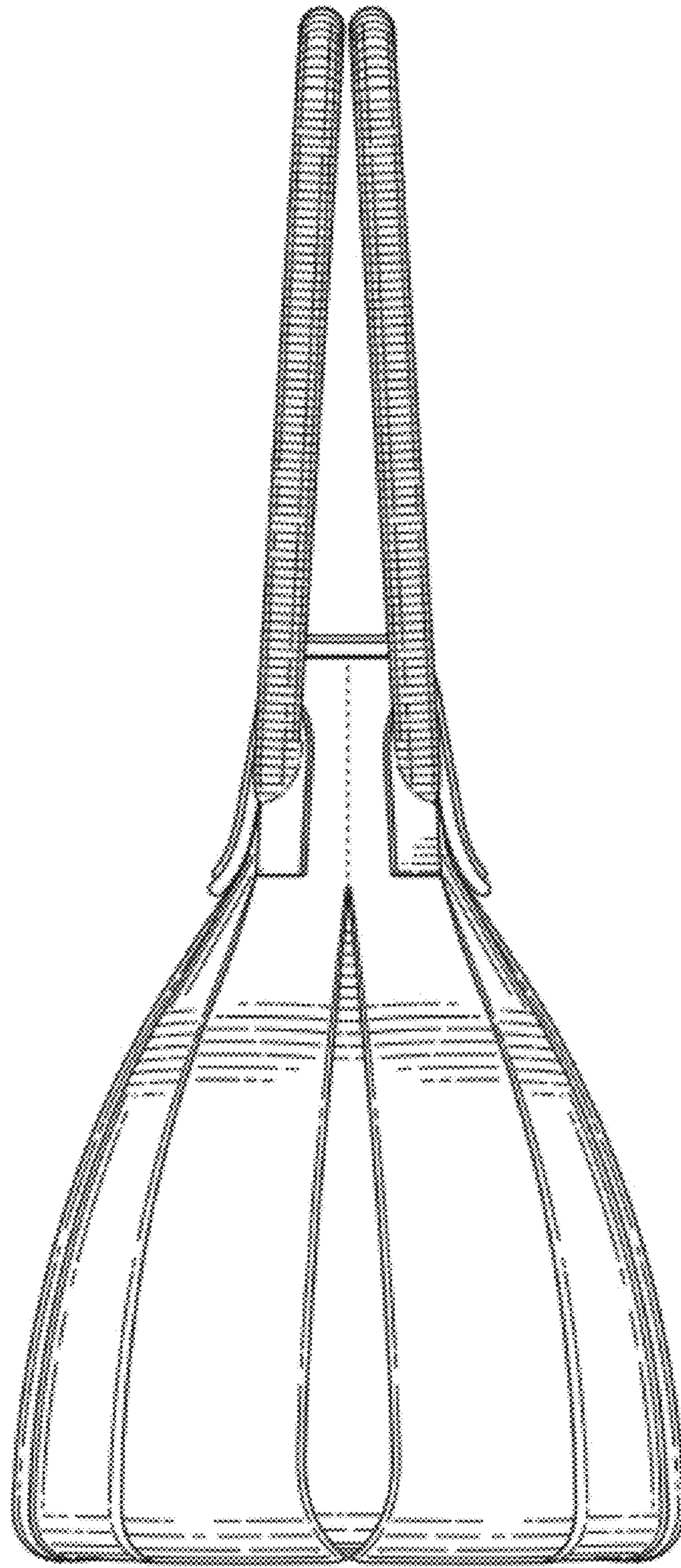

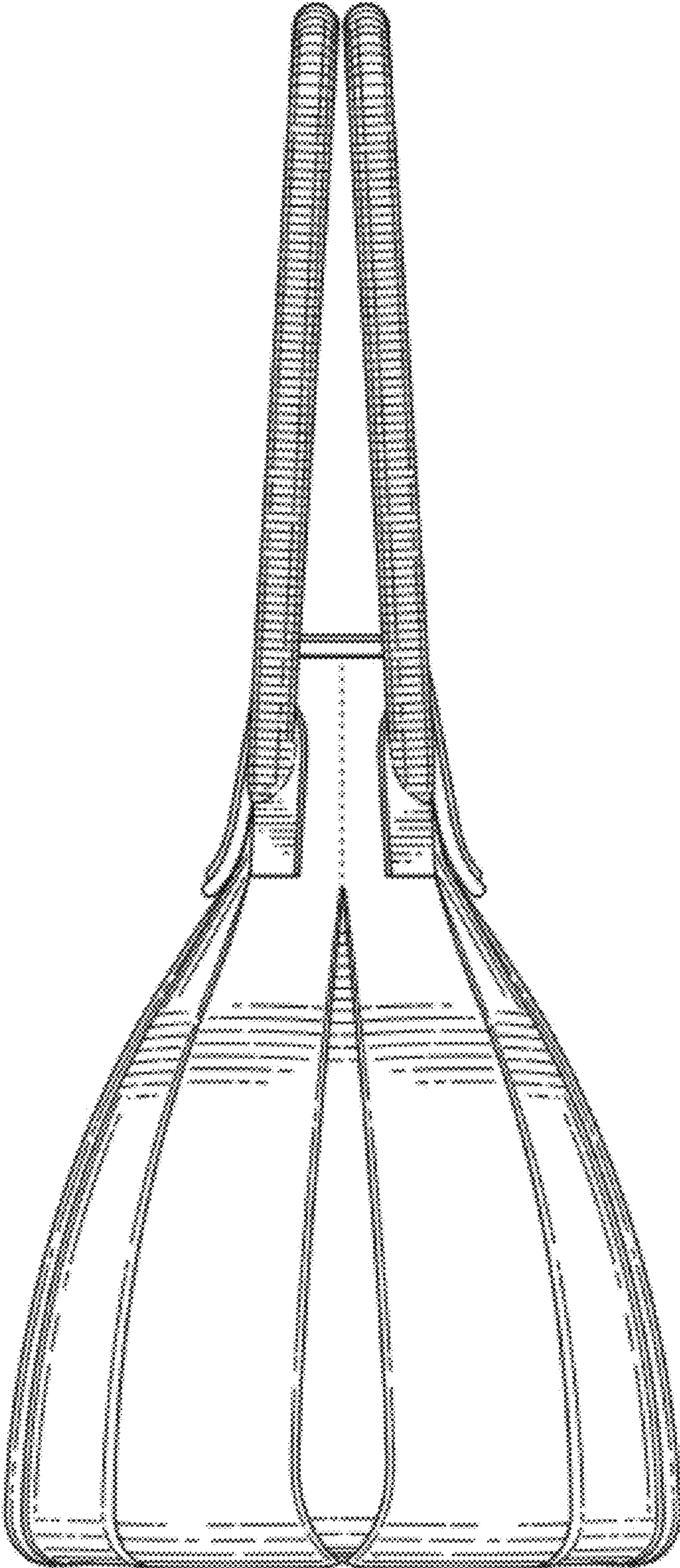

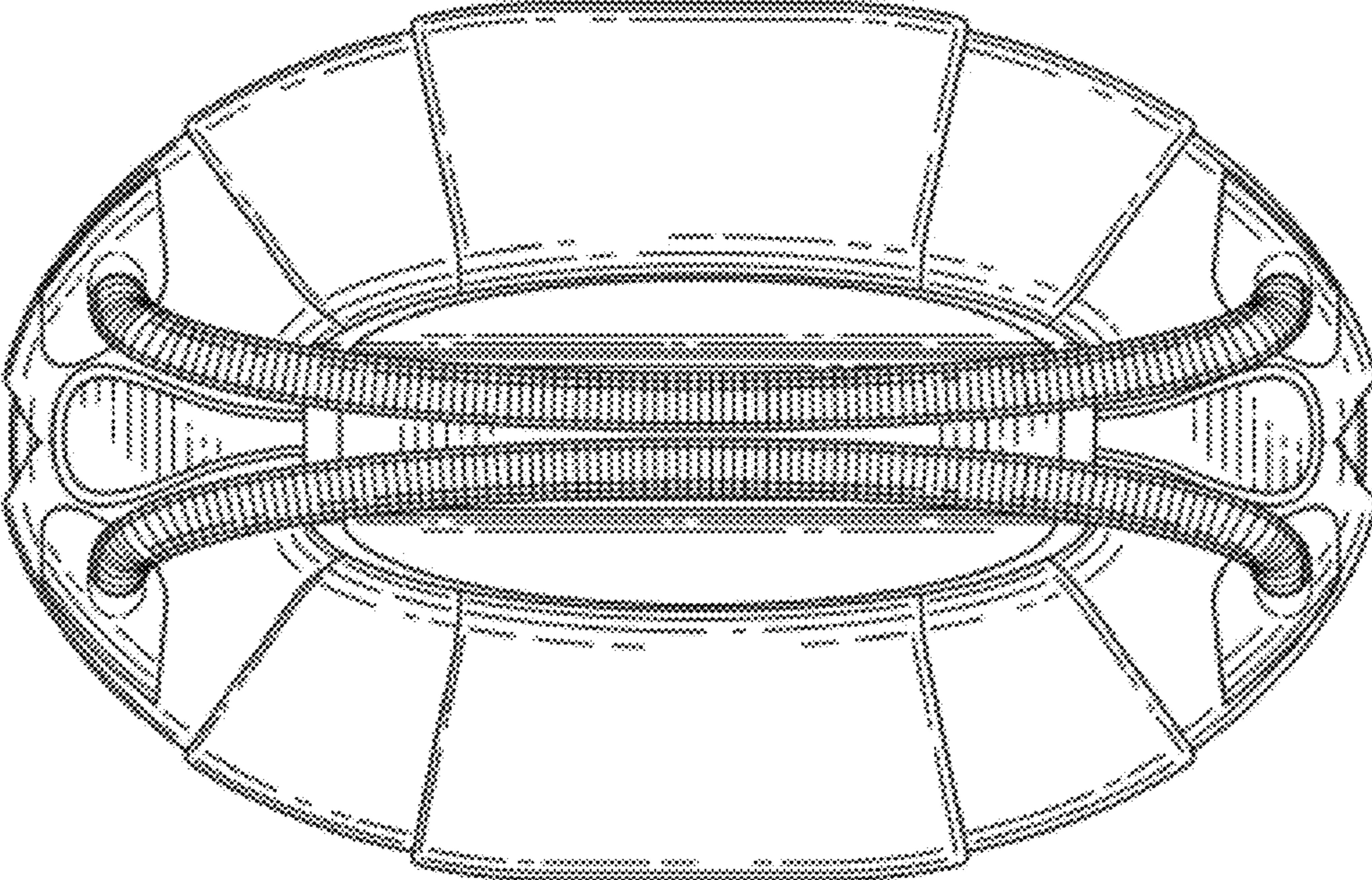

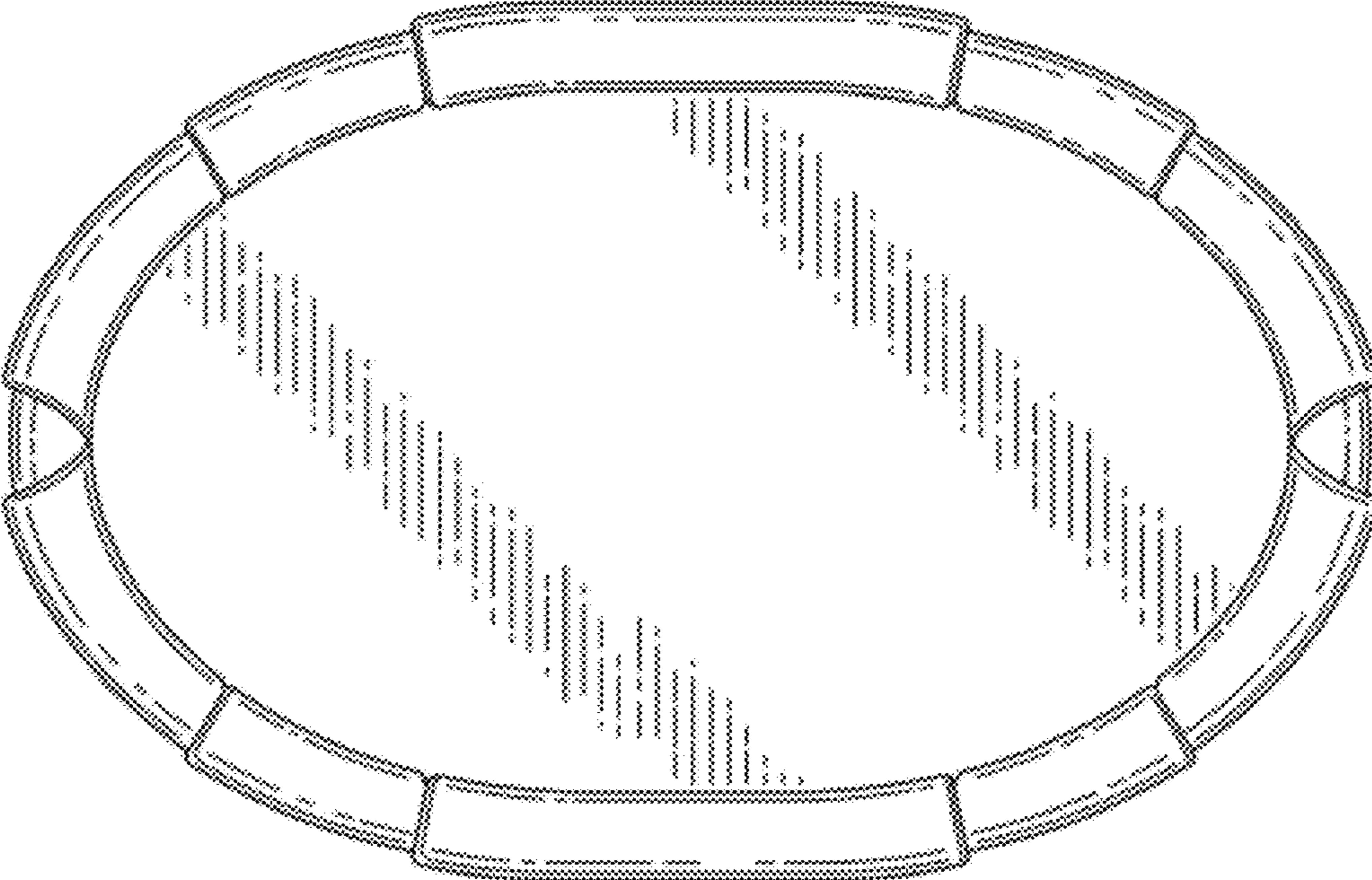

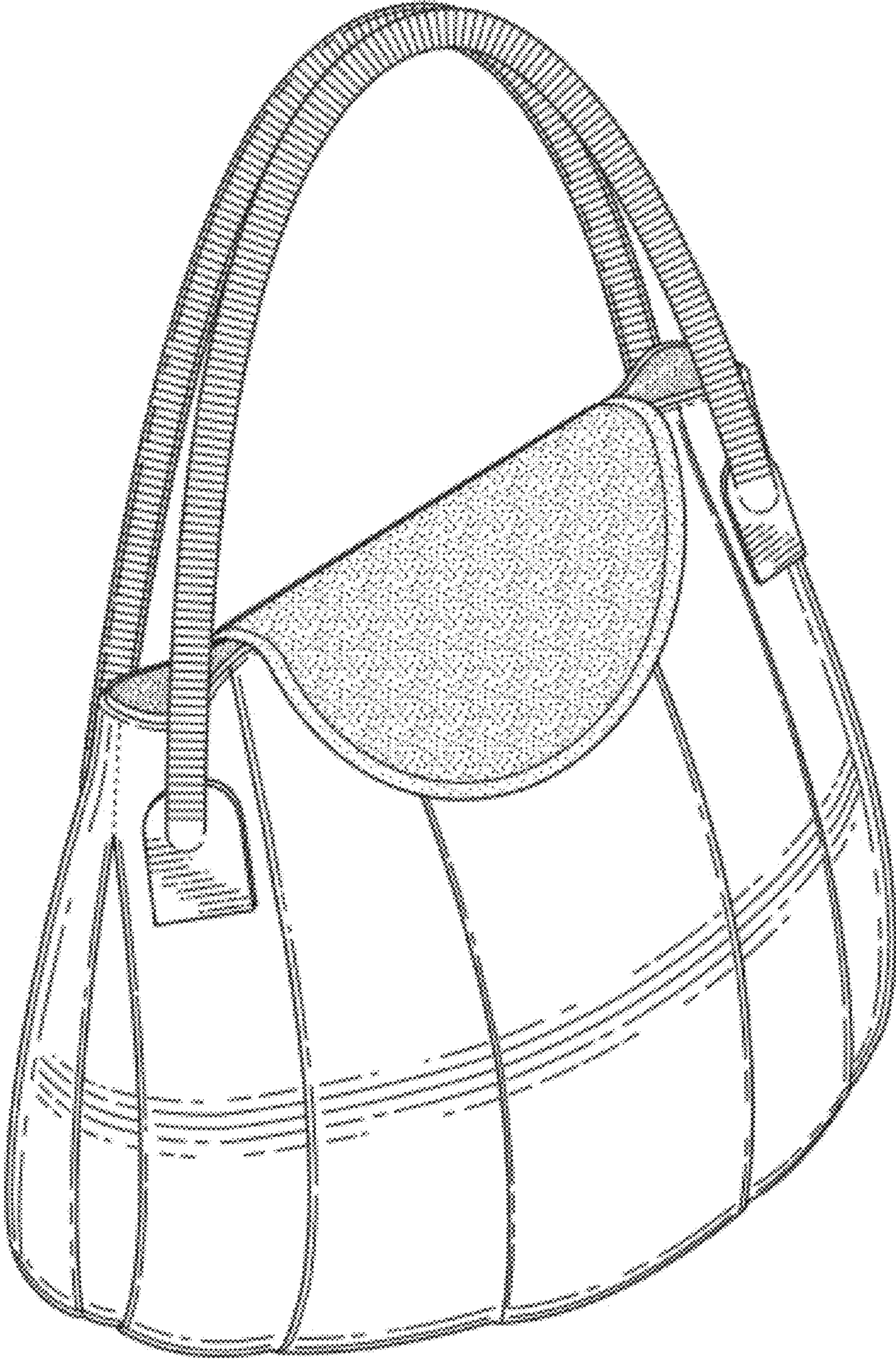

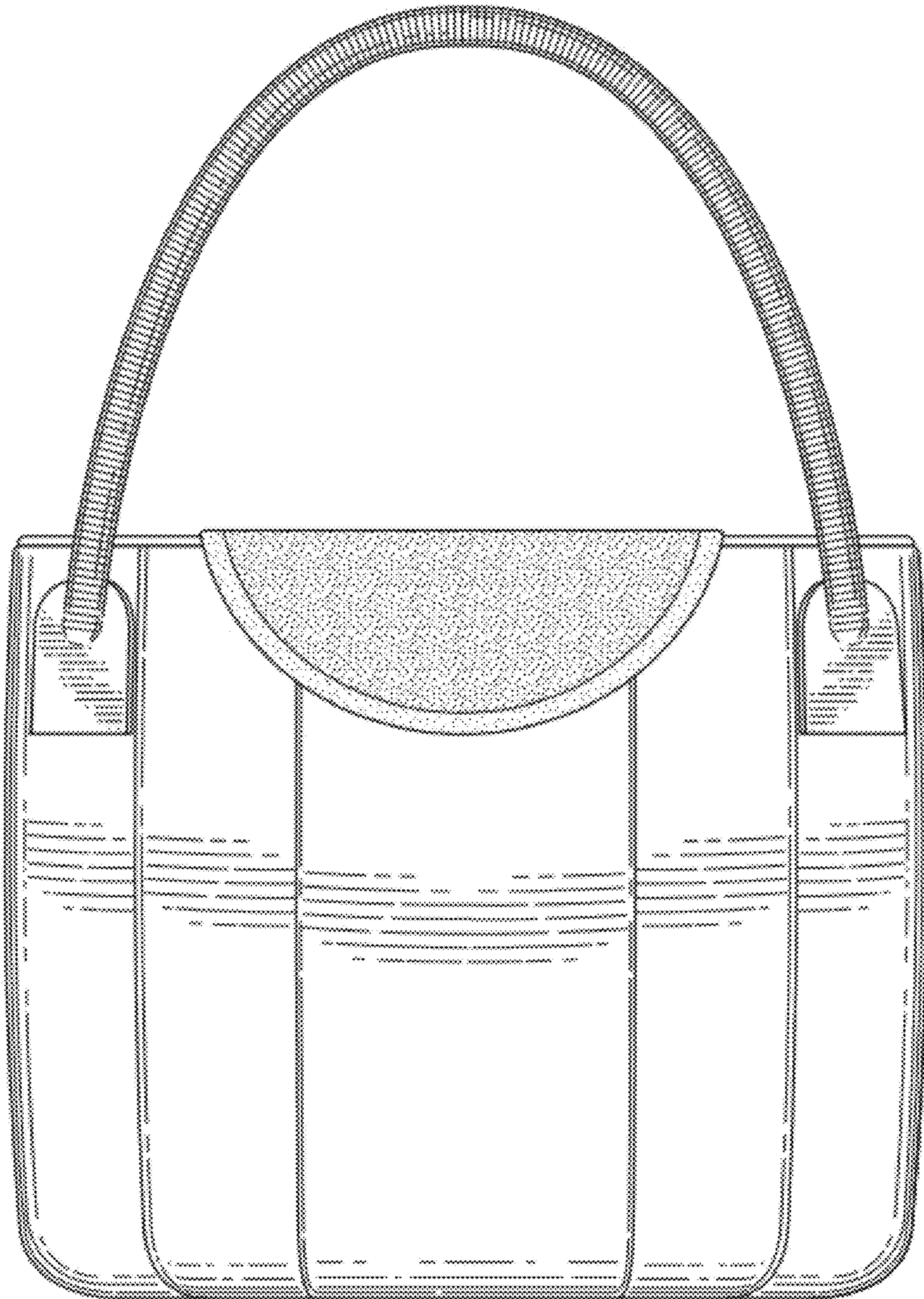

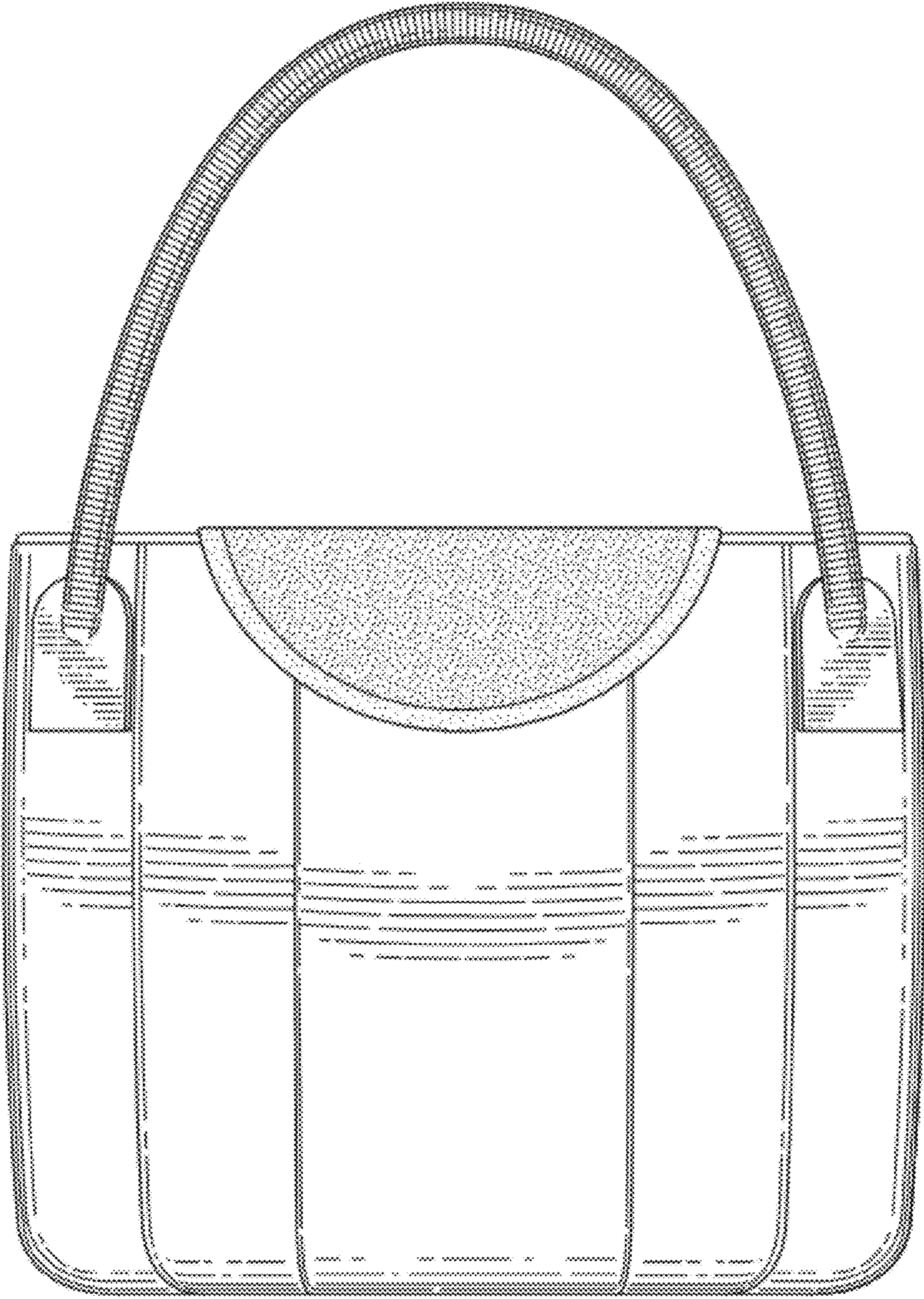

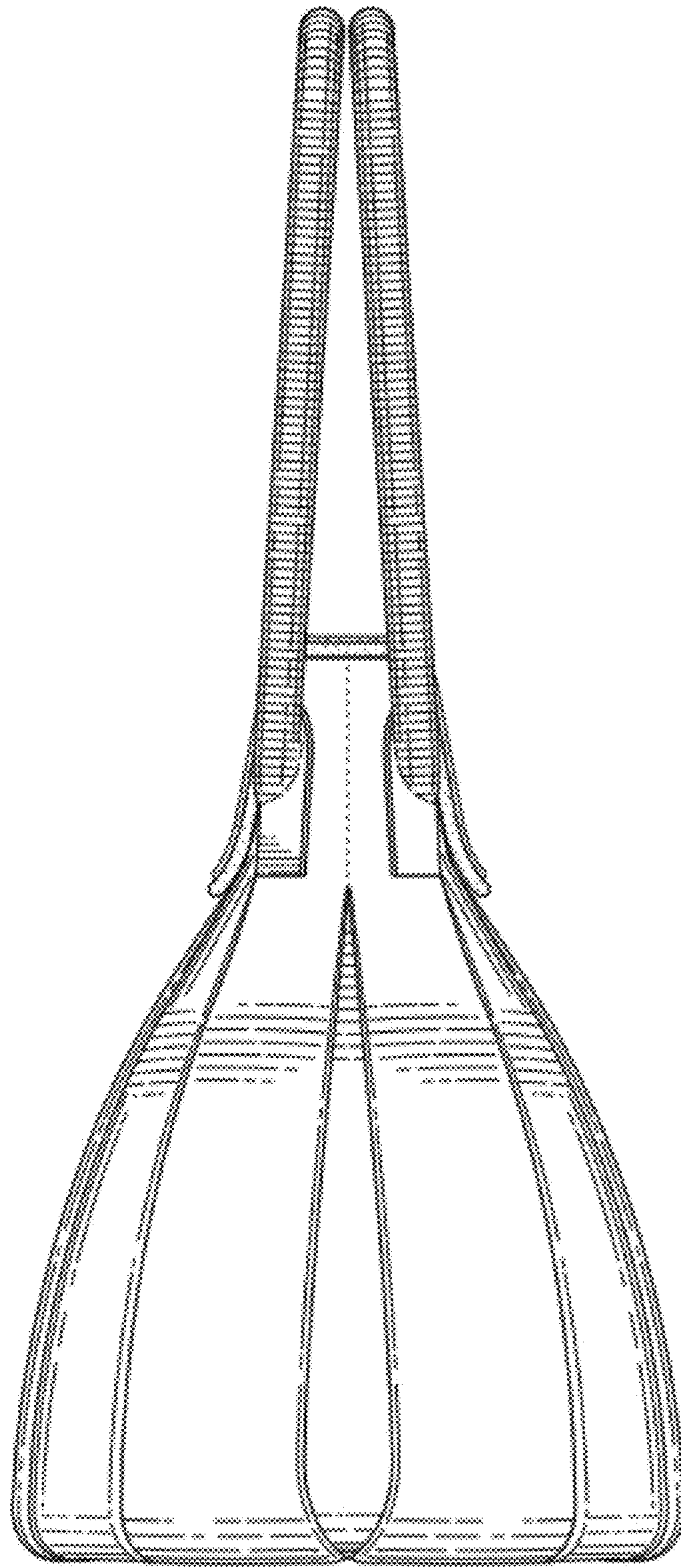

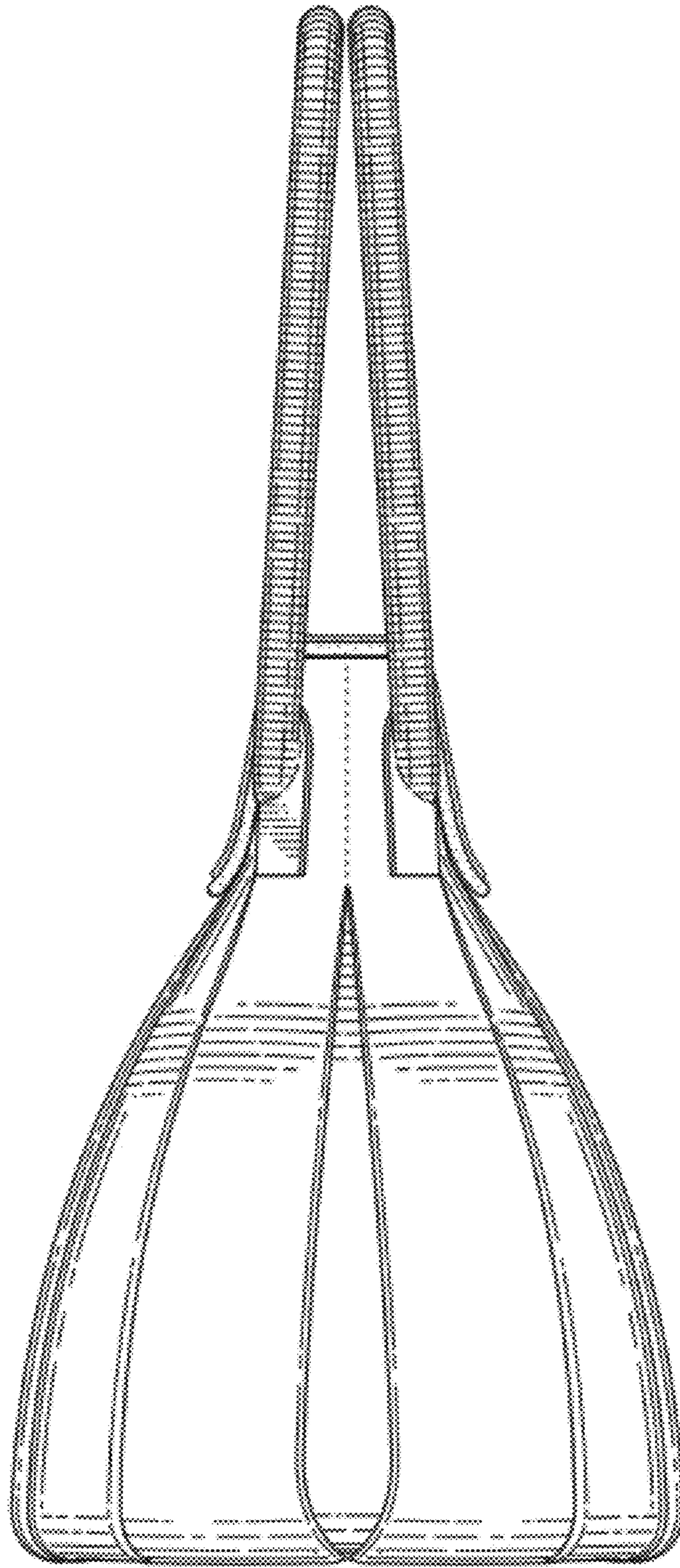

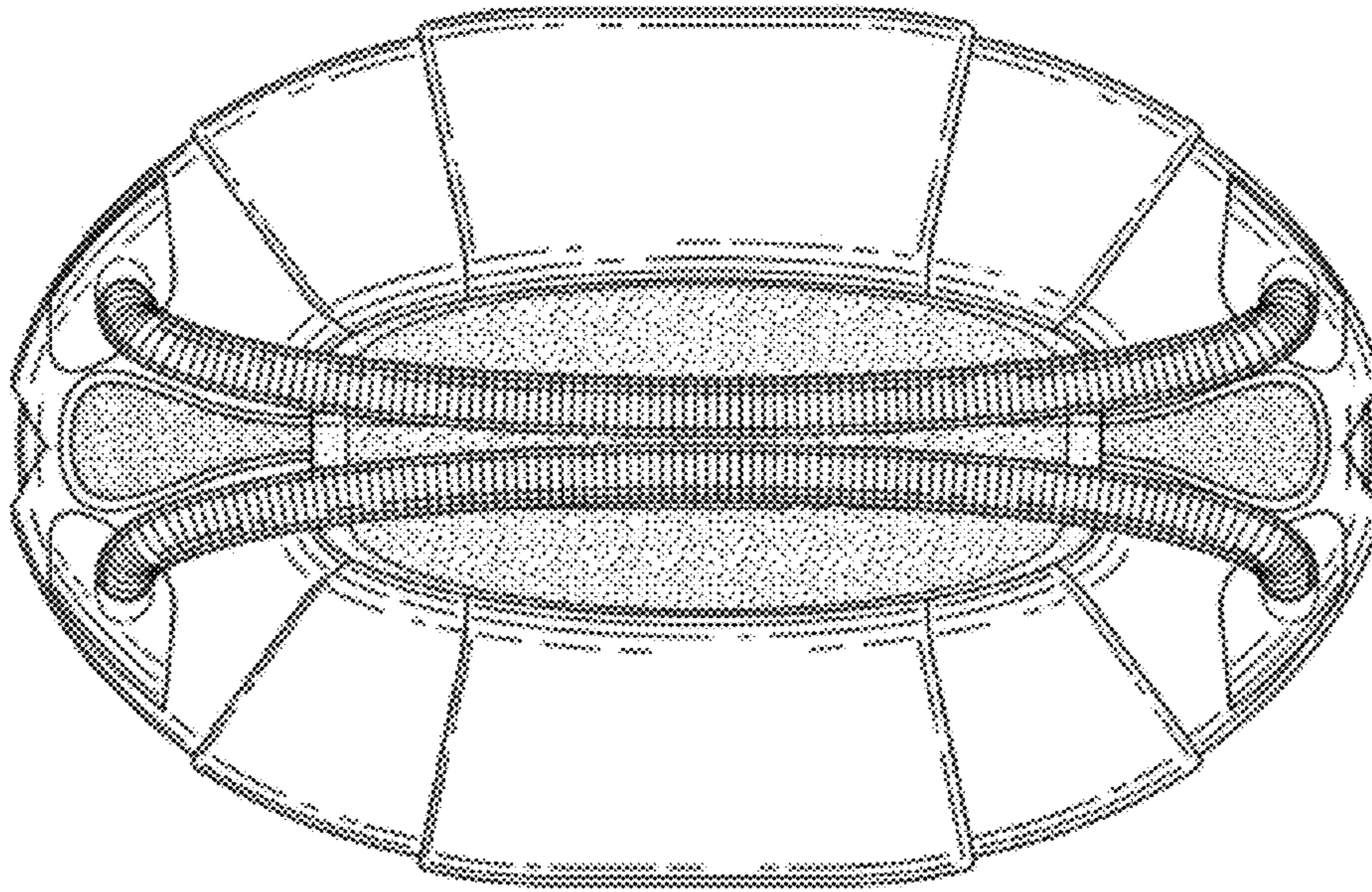

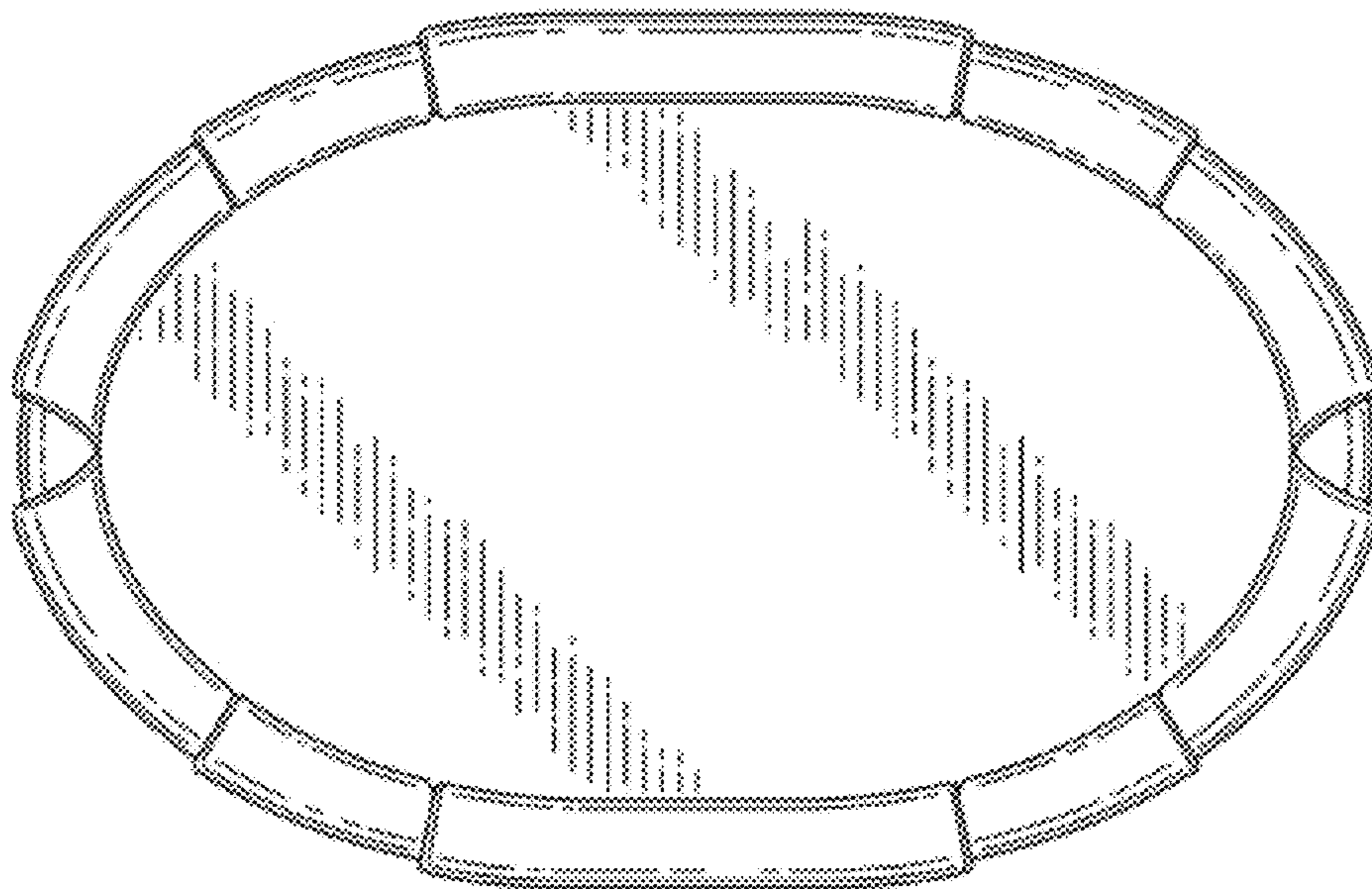
