DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the handbag insert showing my new design in a closed state of appearance, the broken line

showing of a zipper pull tab is for the purpose of illustrating a portion of the article which forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of my new design shown in FIG. 8;

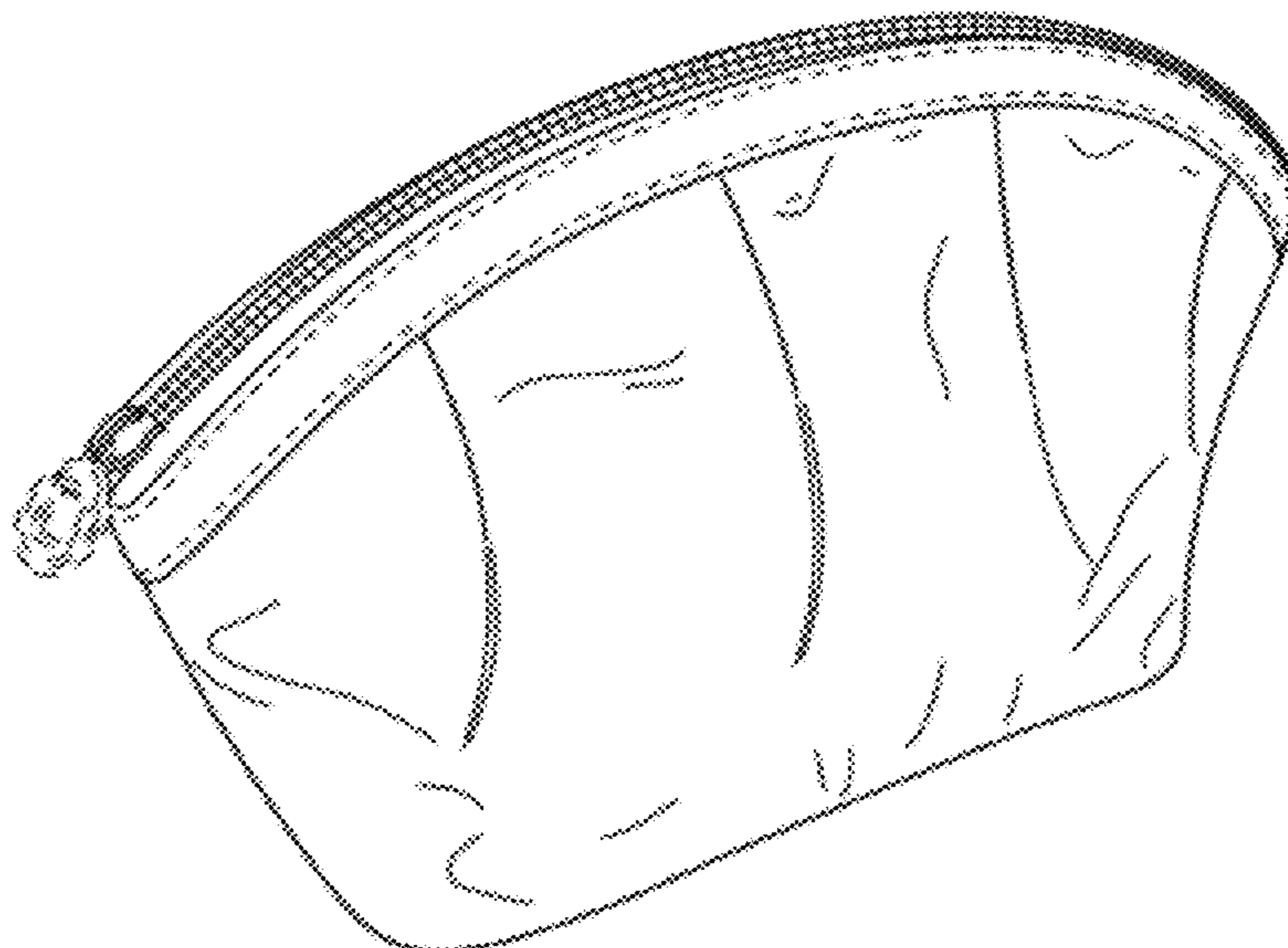

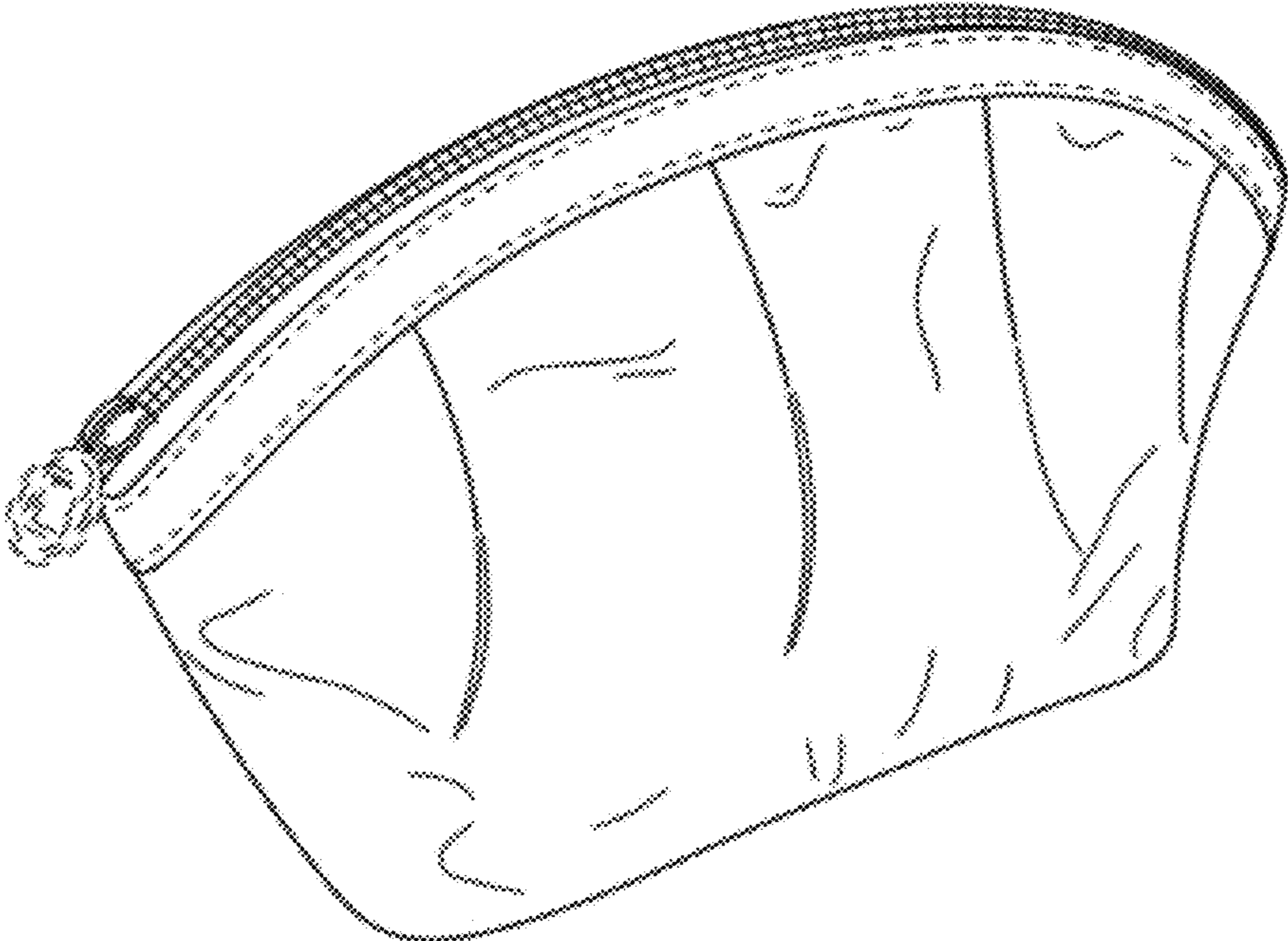

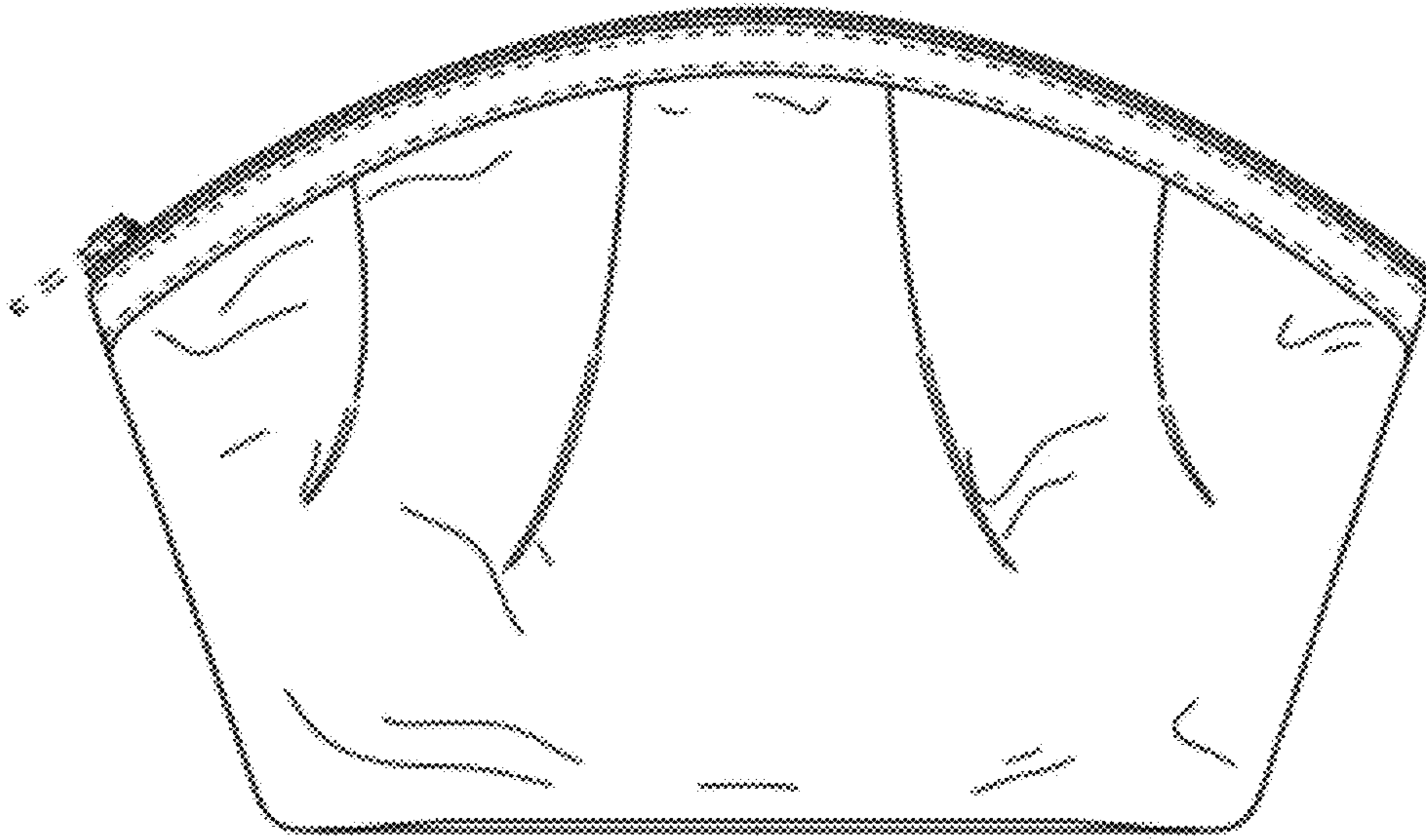

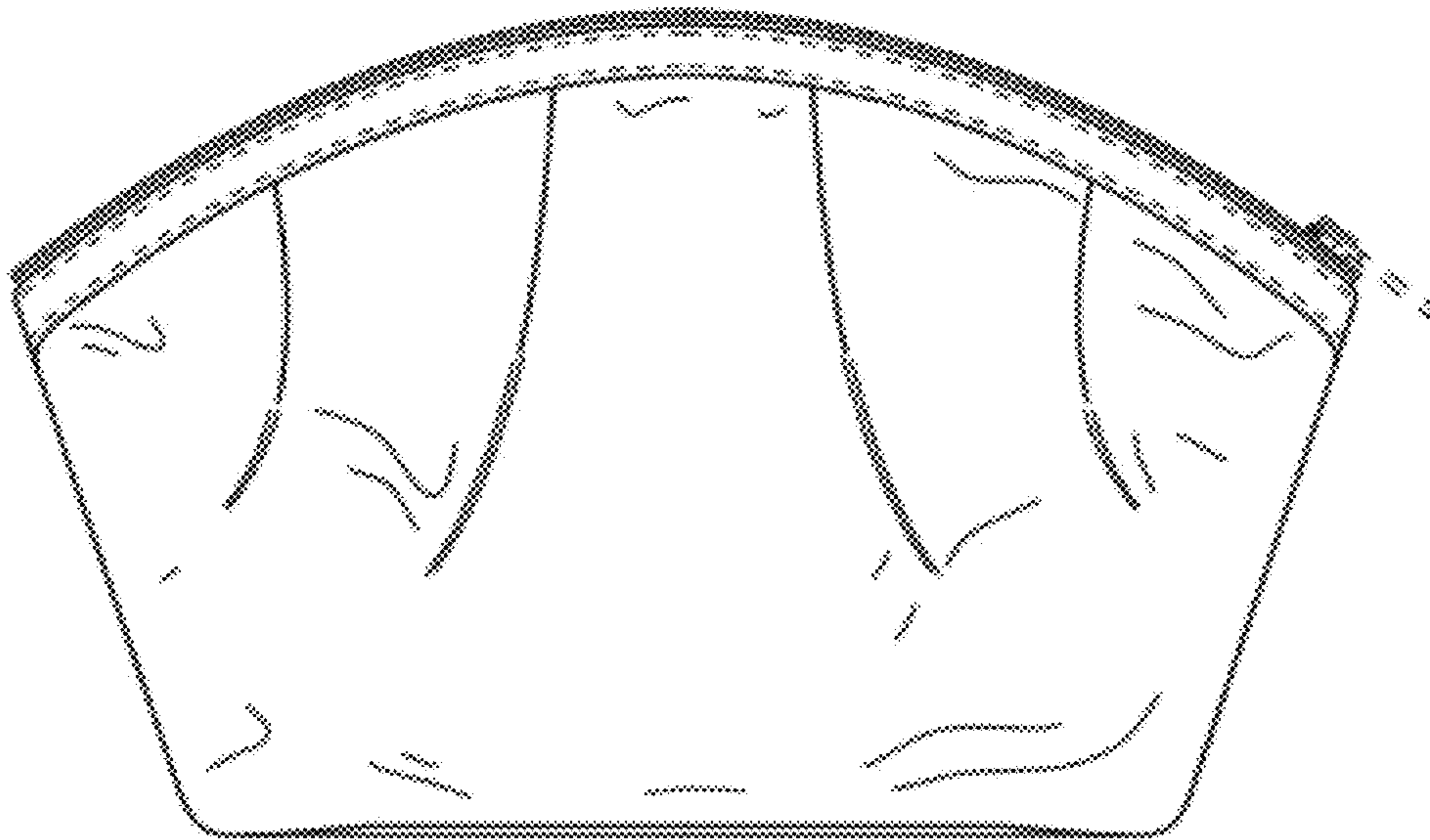

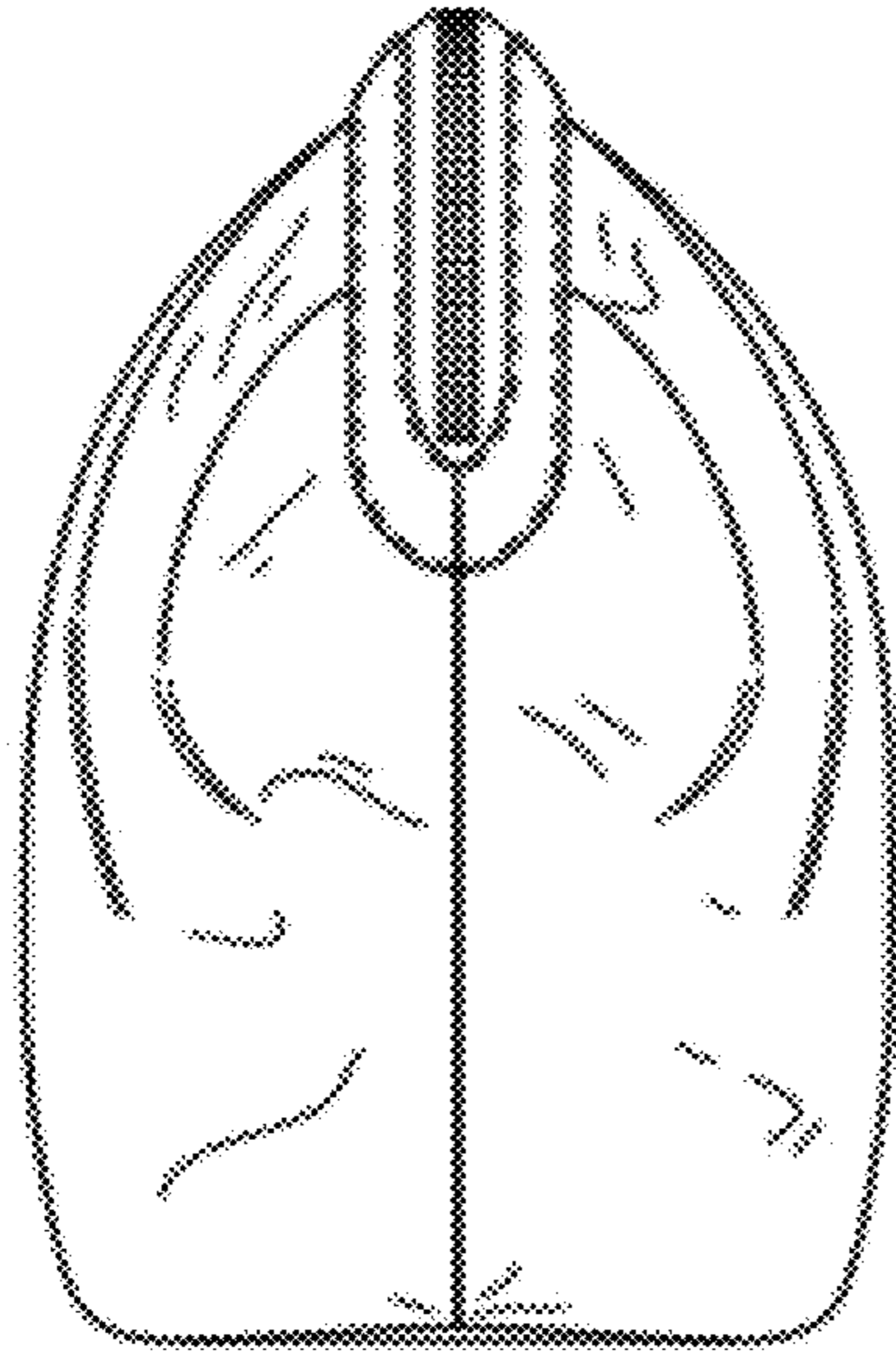

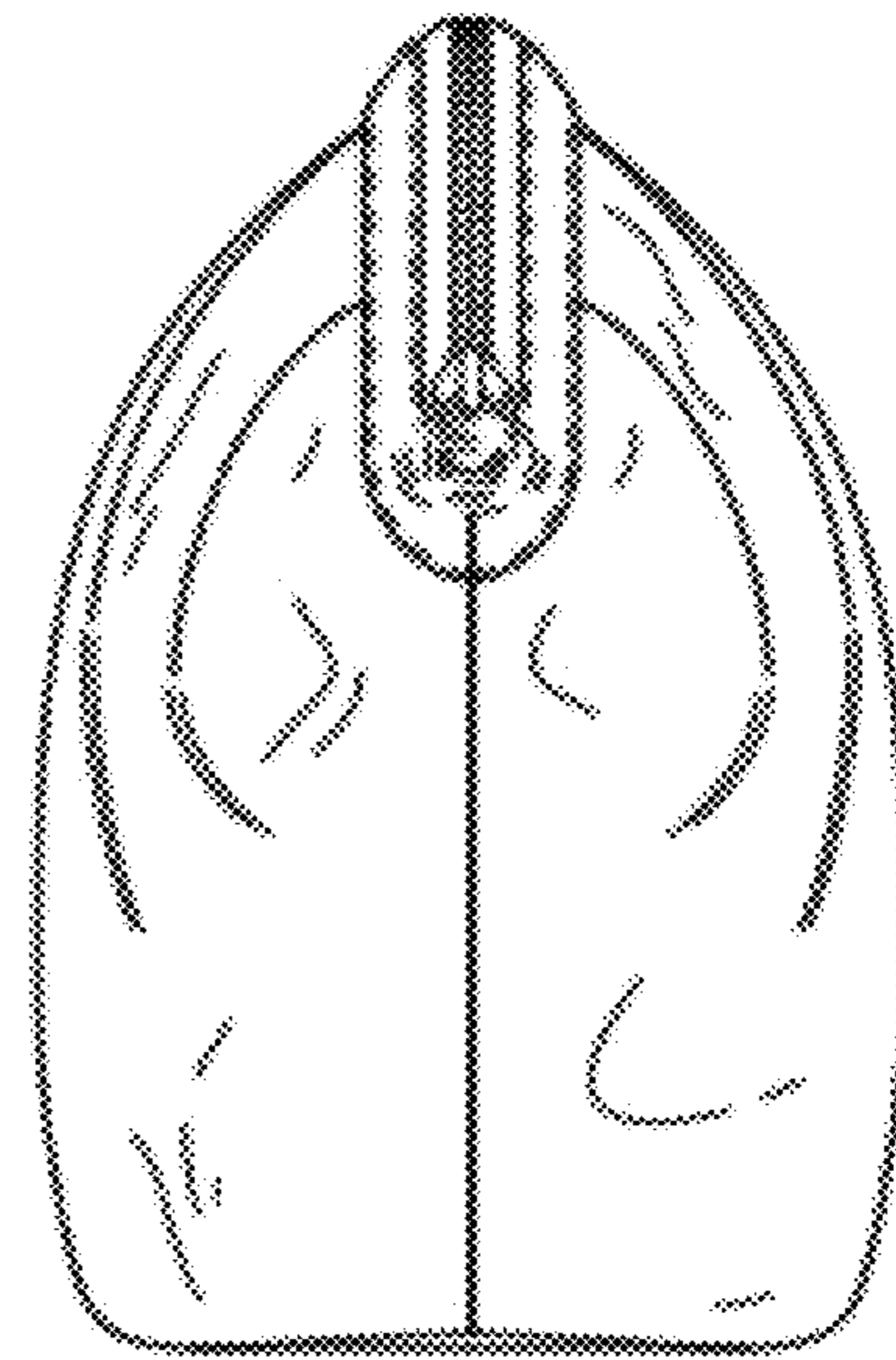

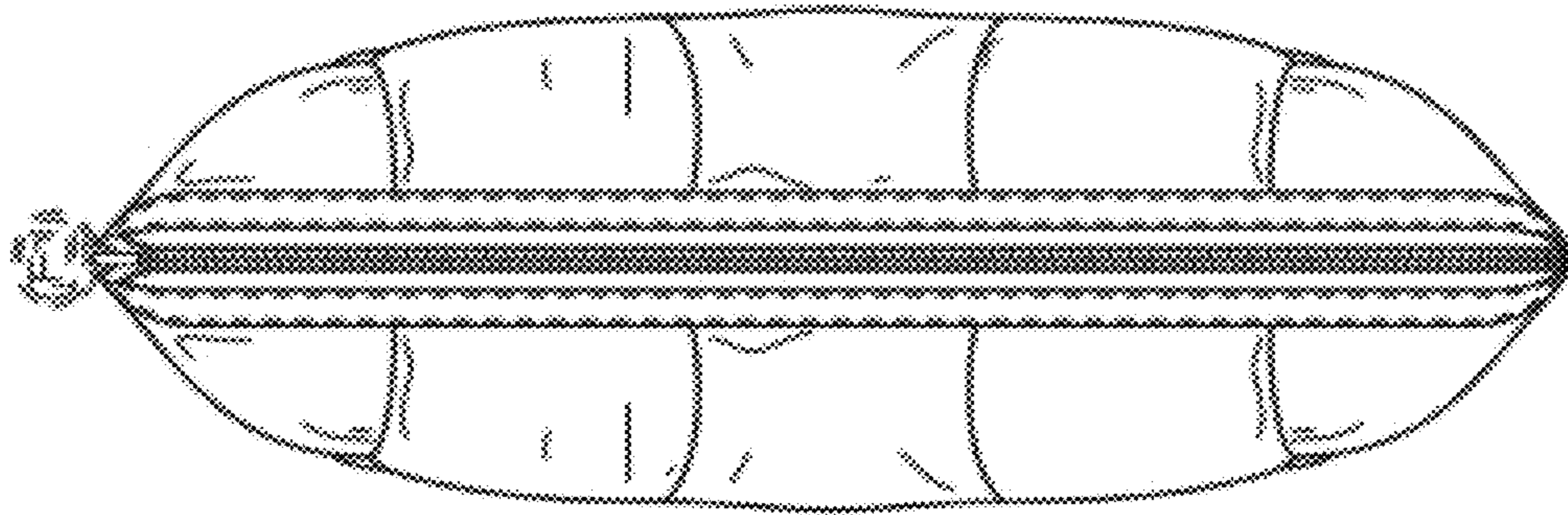

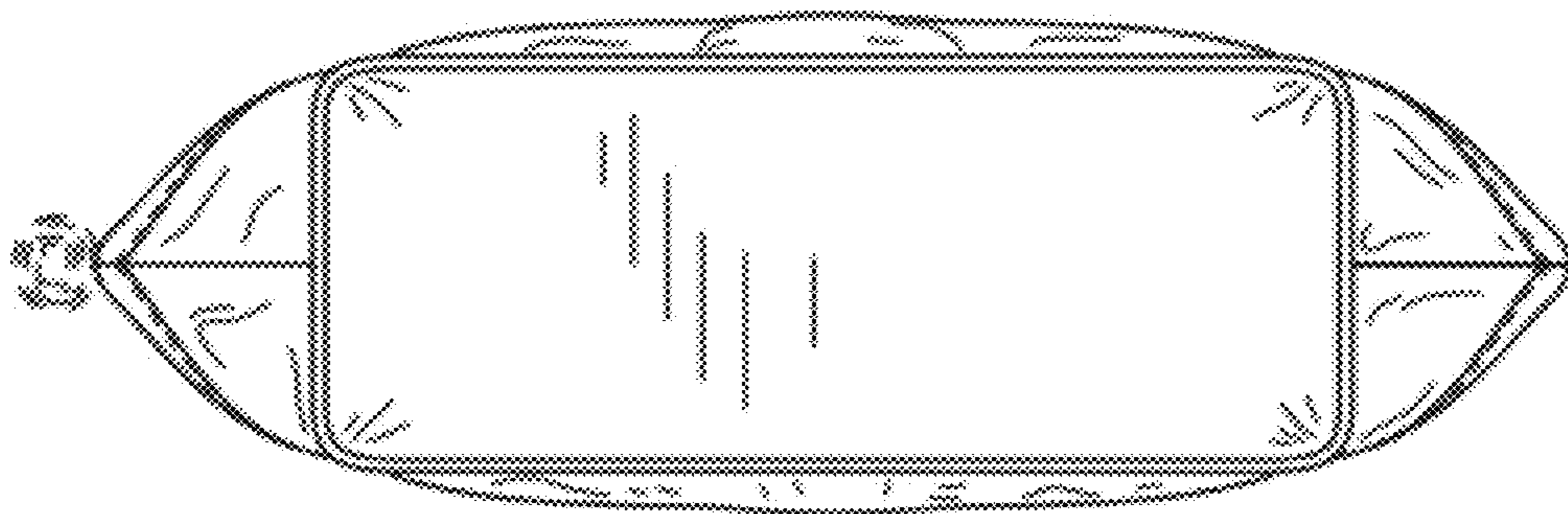

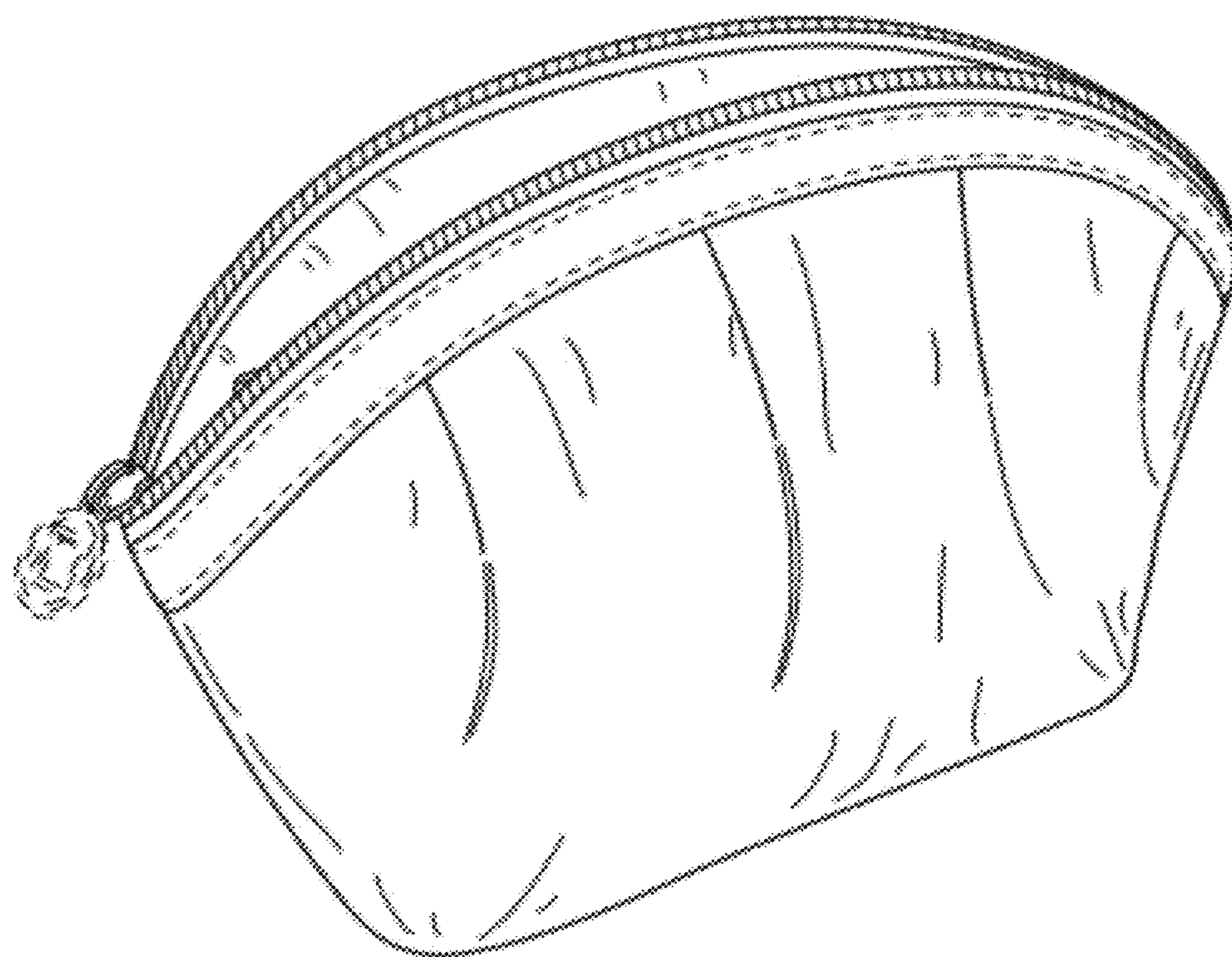

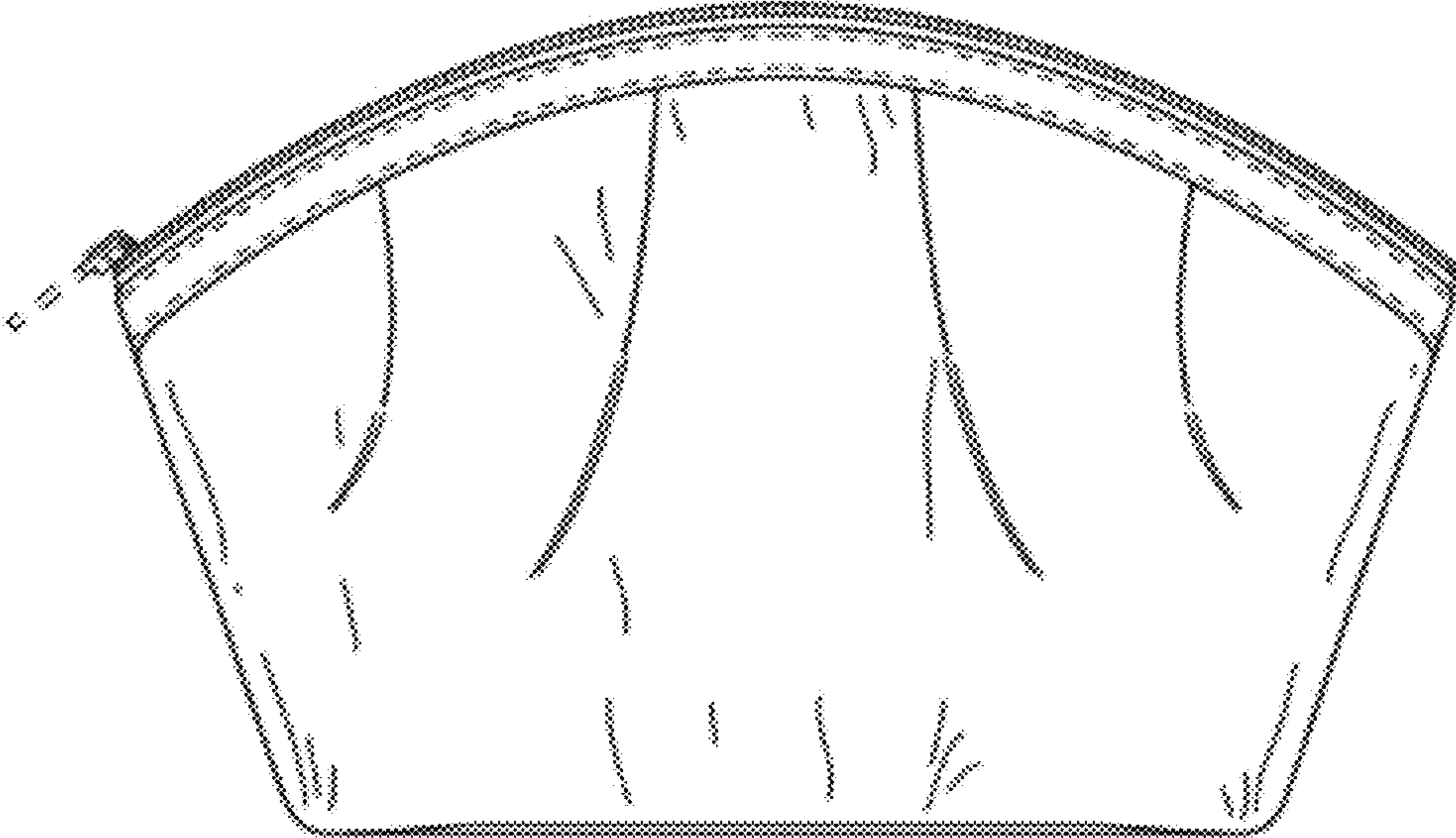

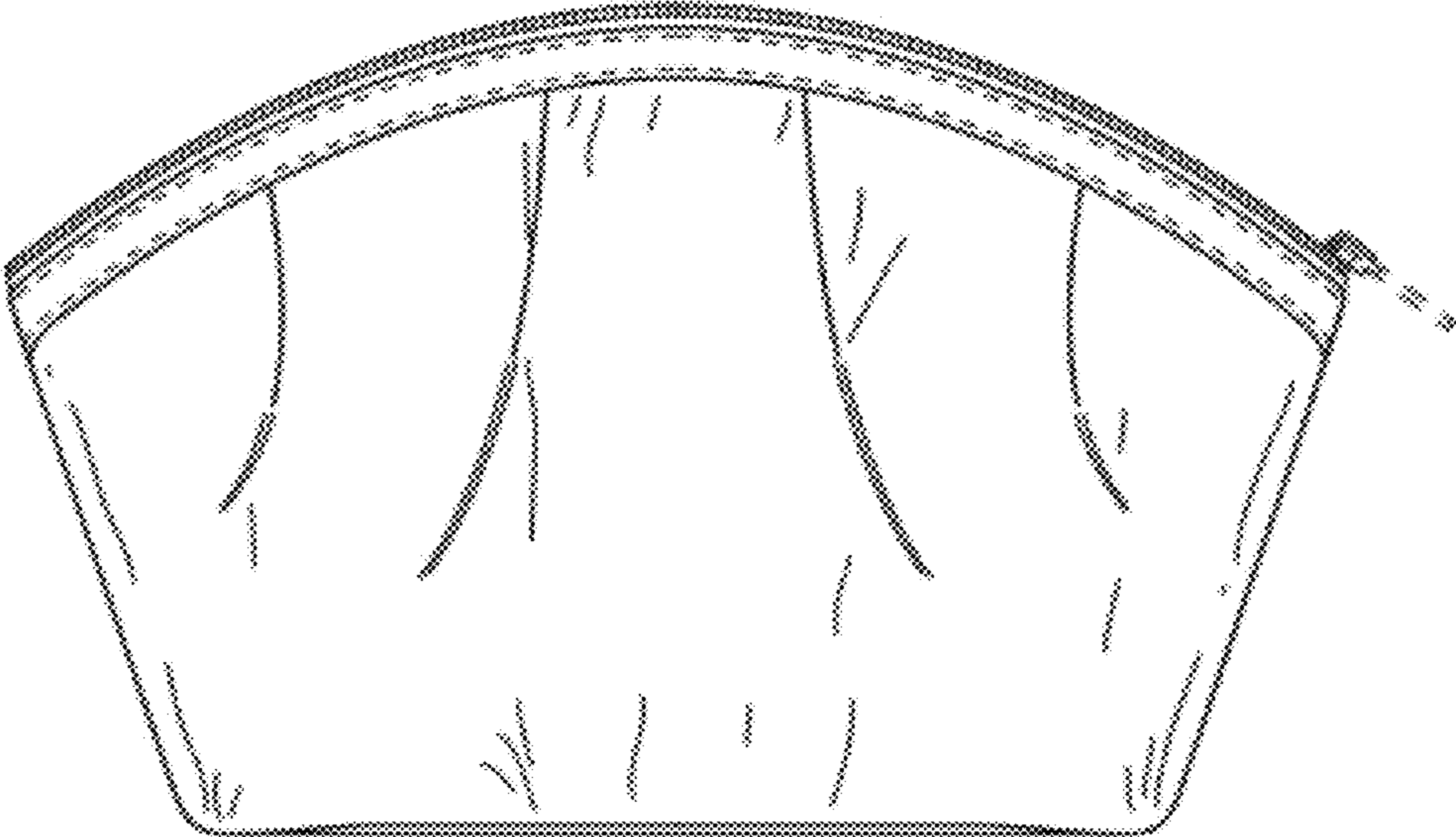

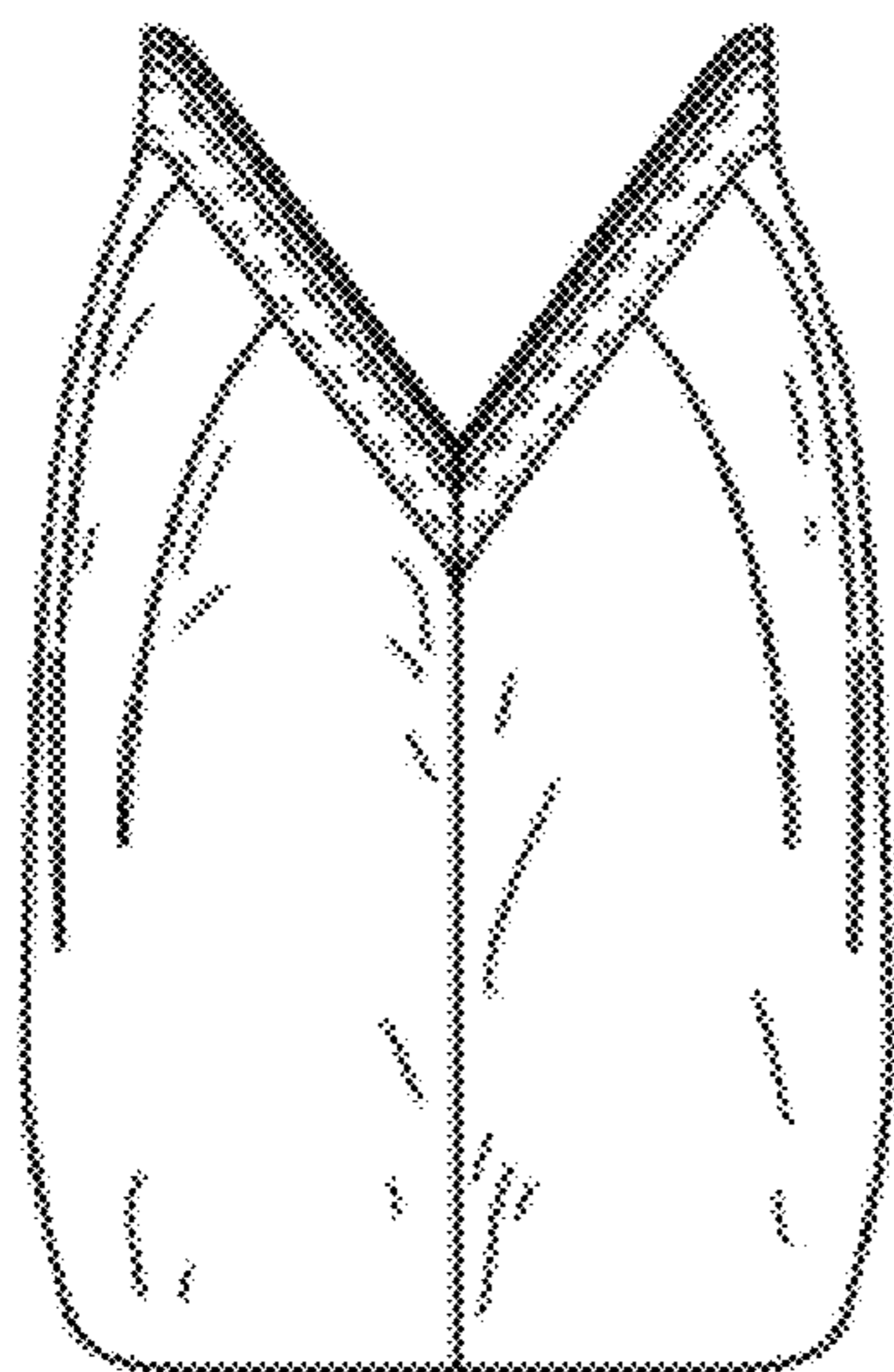

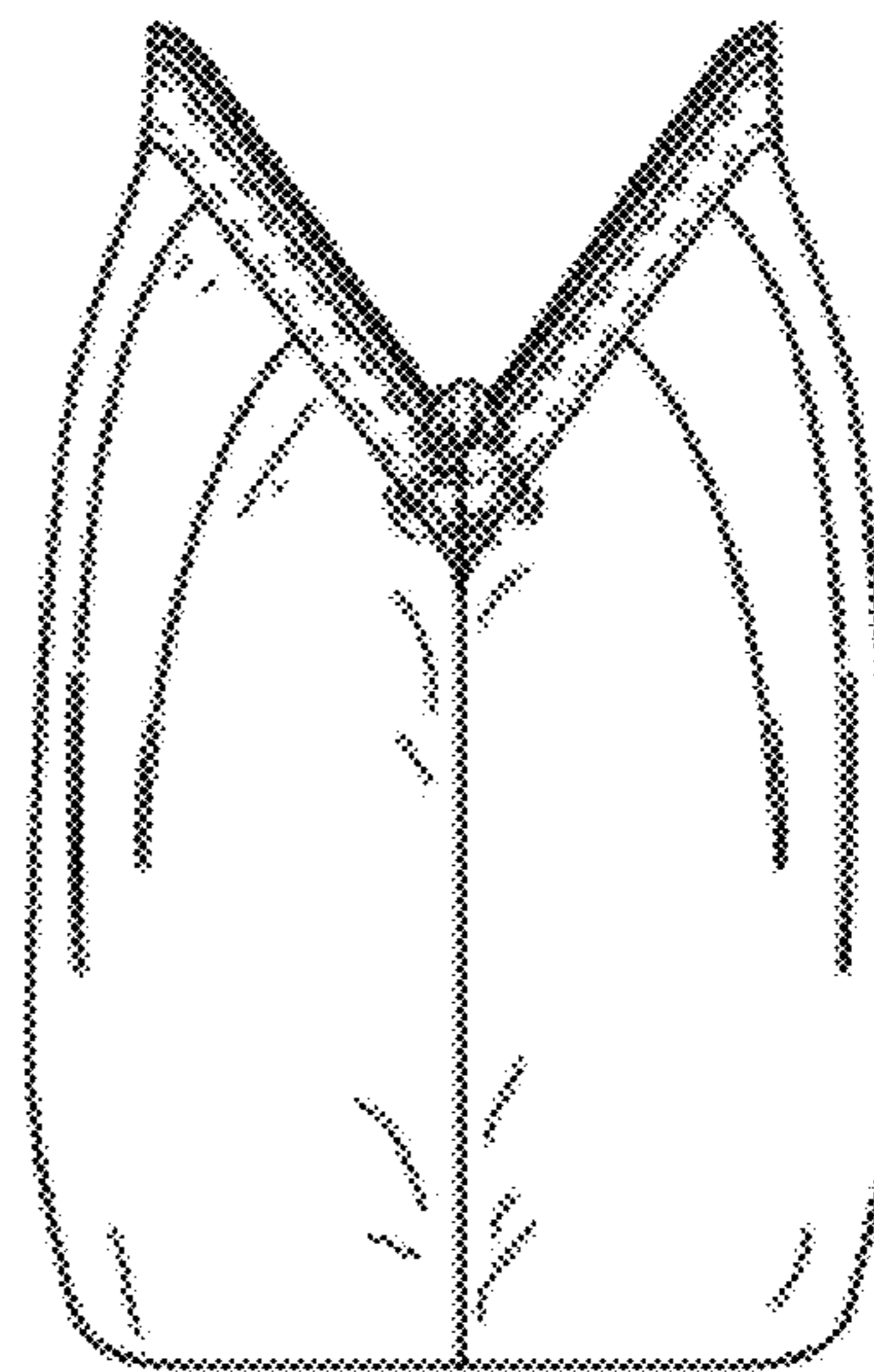

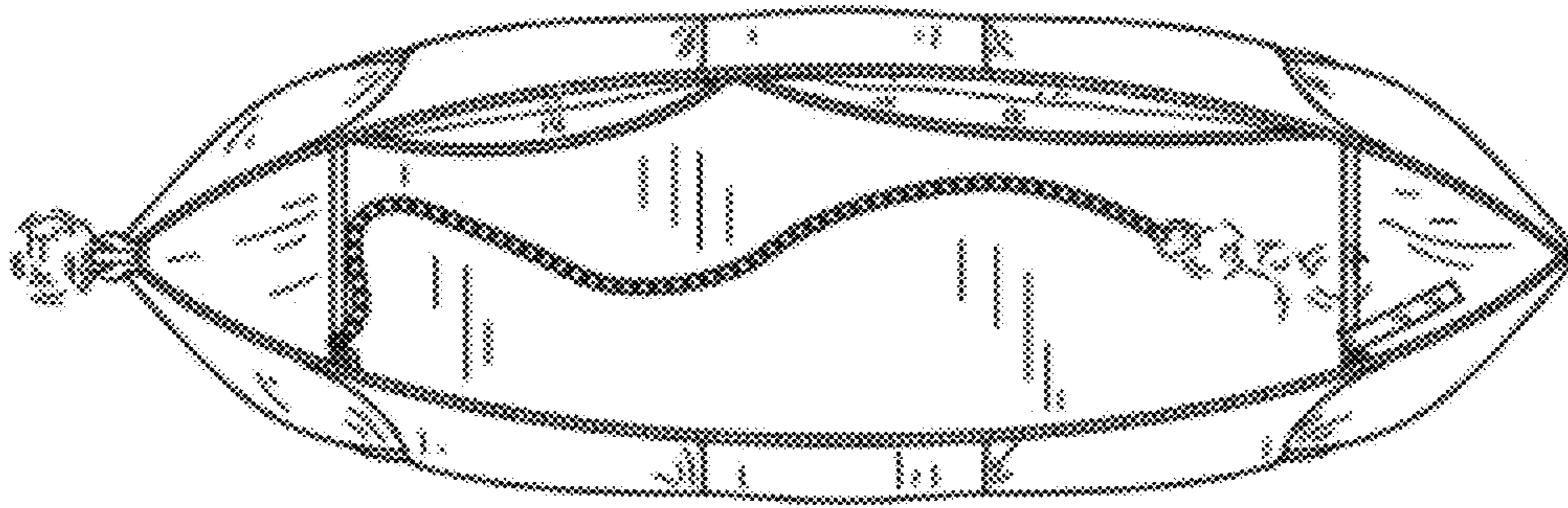

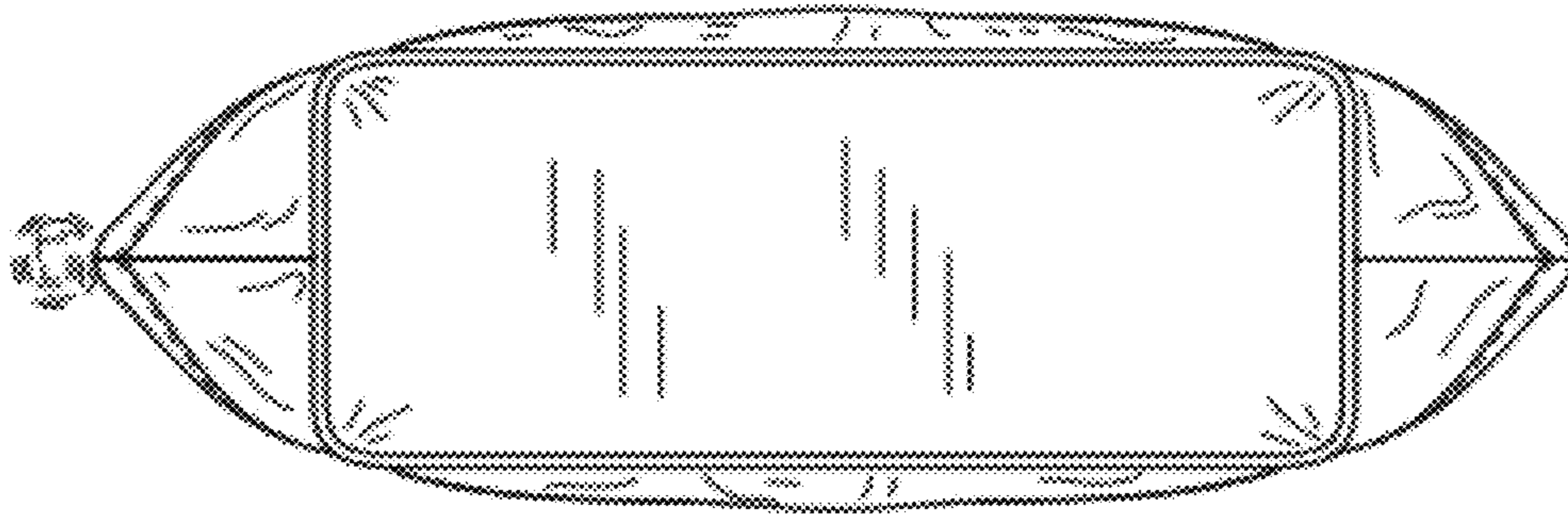

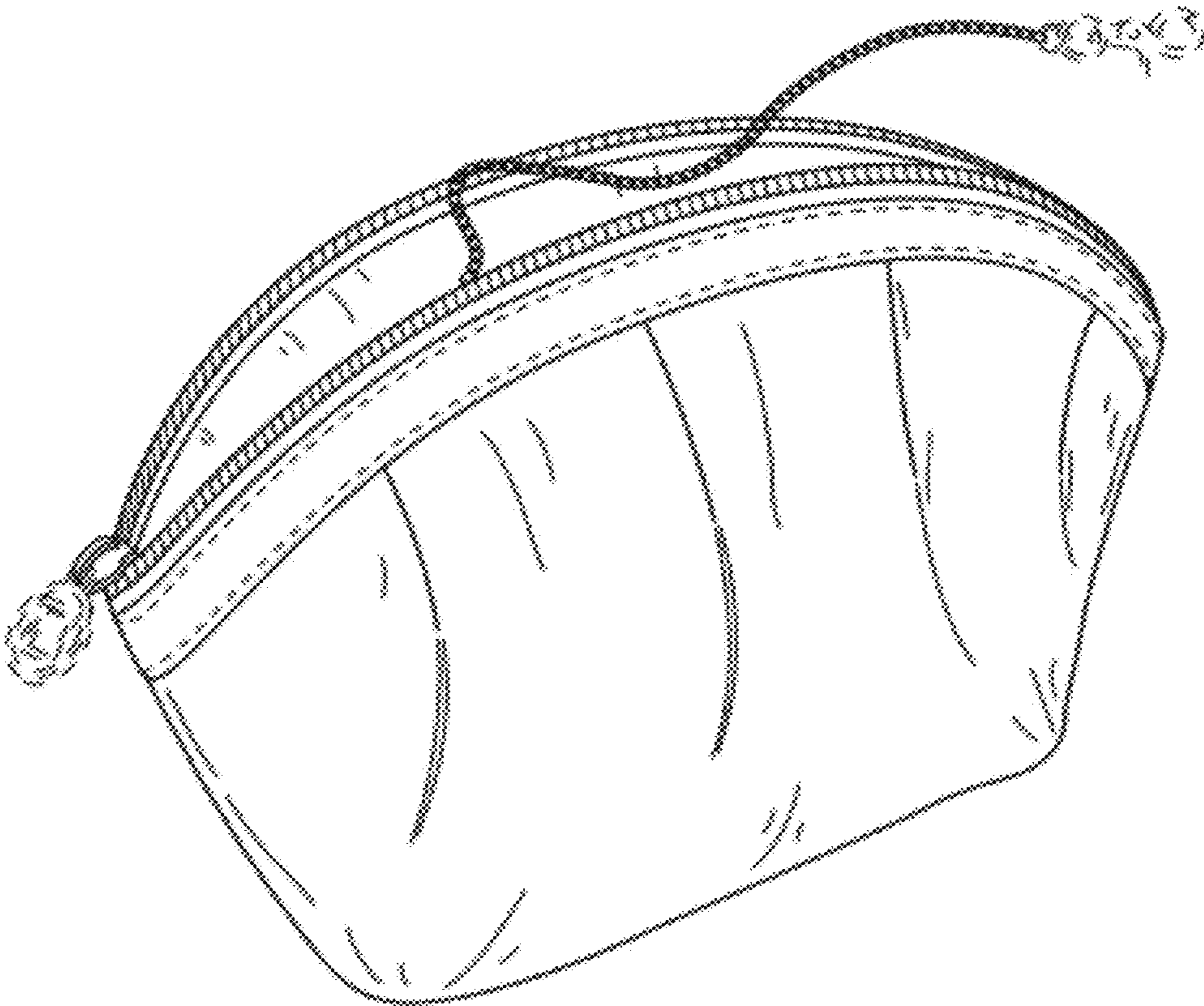

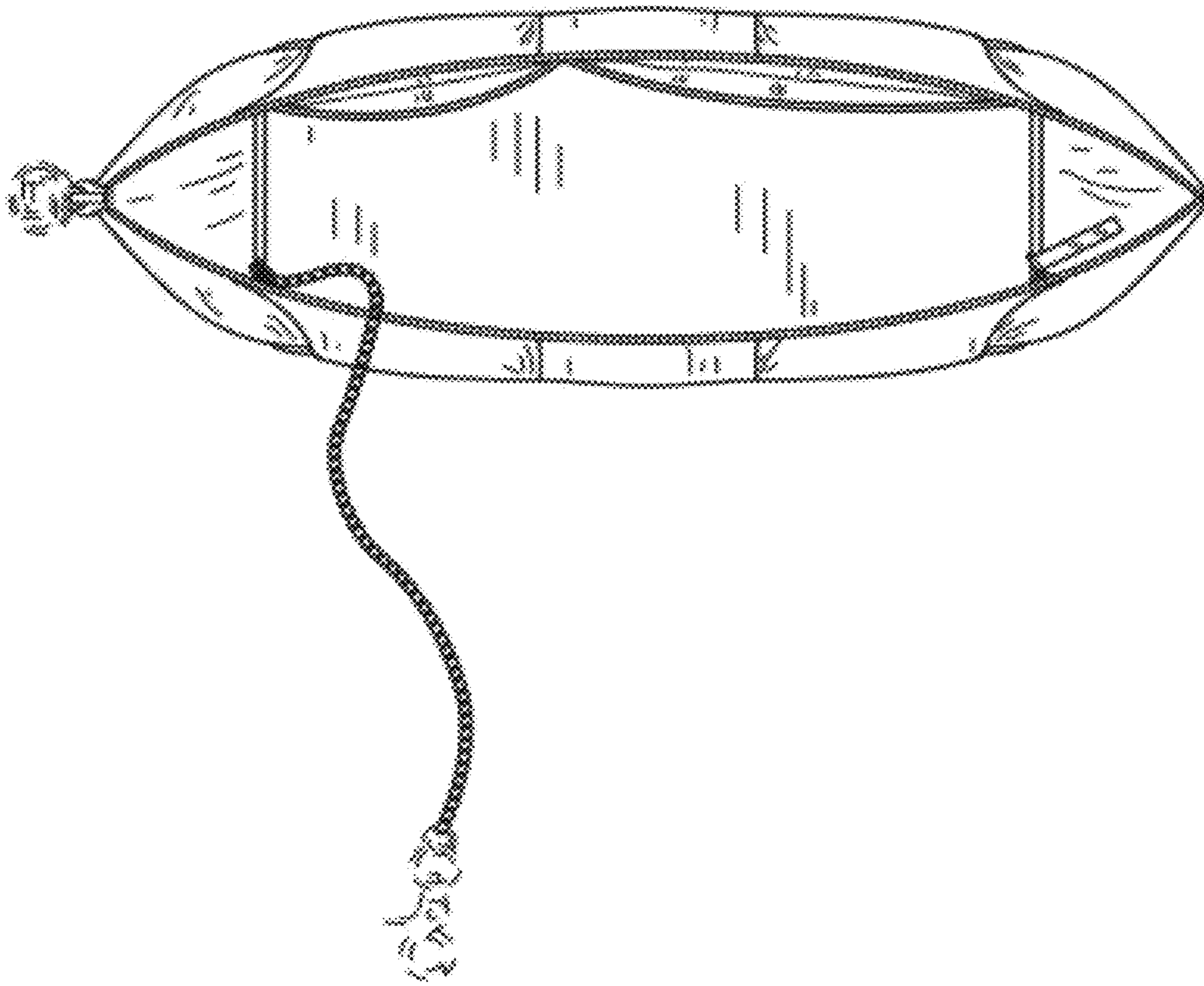
