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FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bookcase showing my new design;

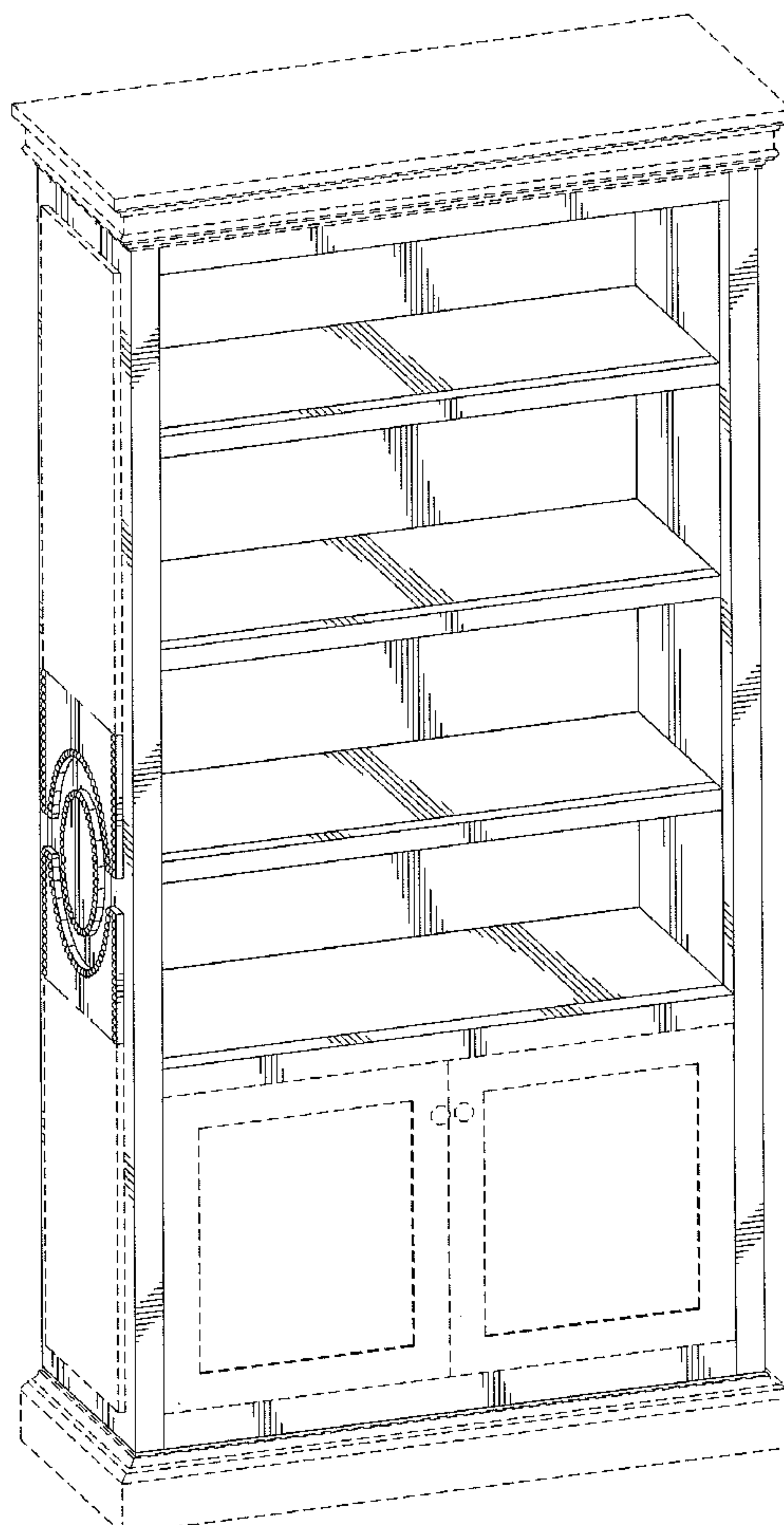
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; and,

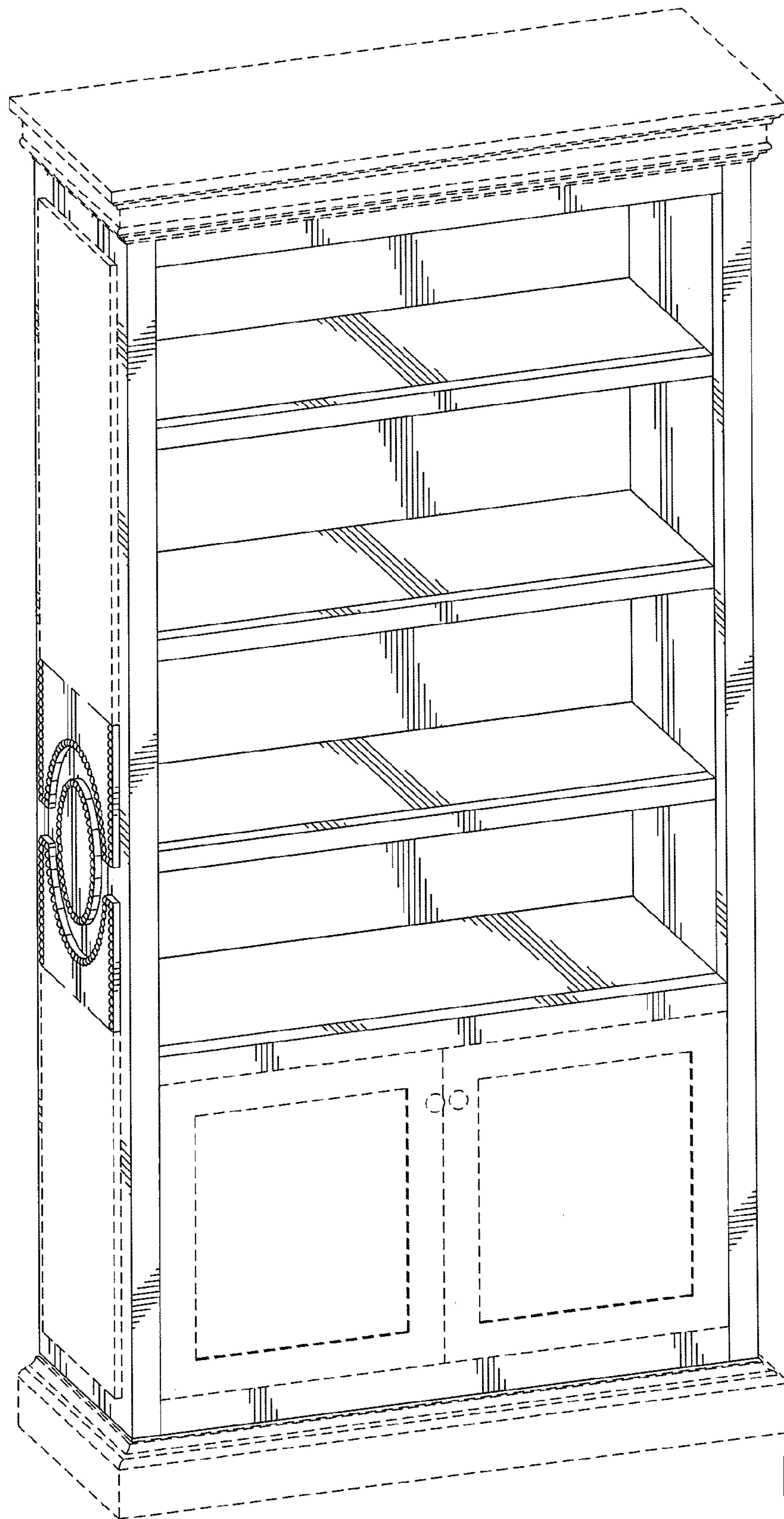

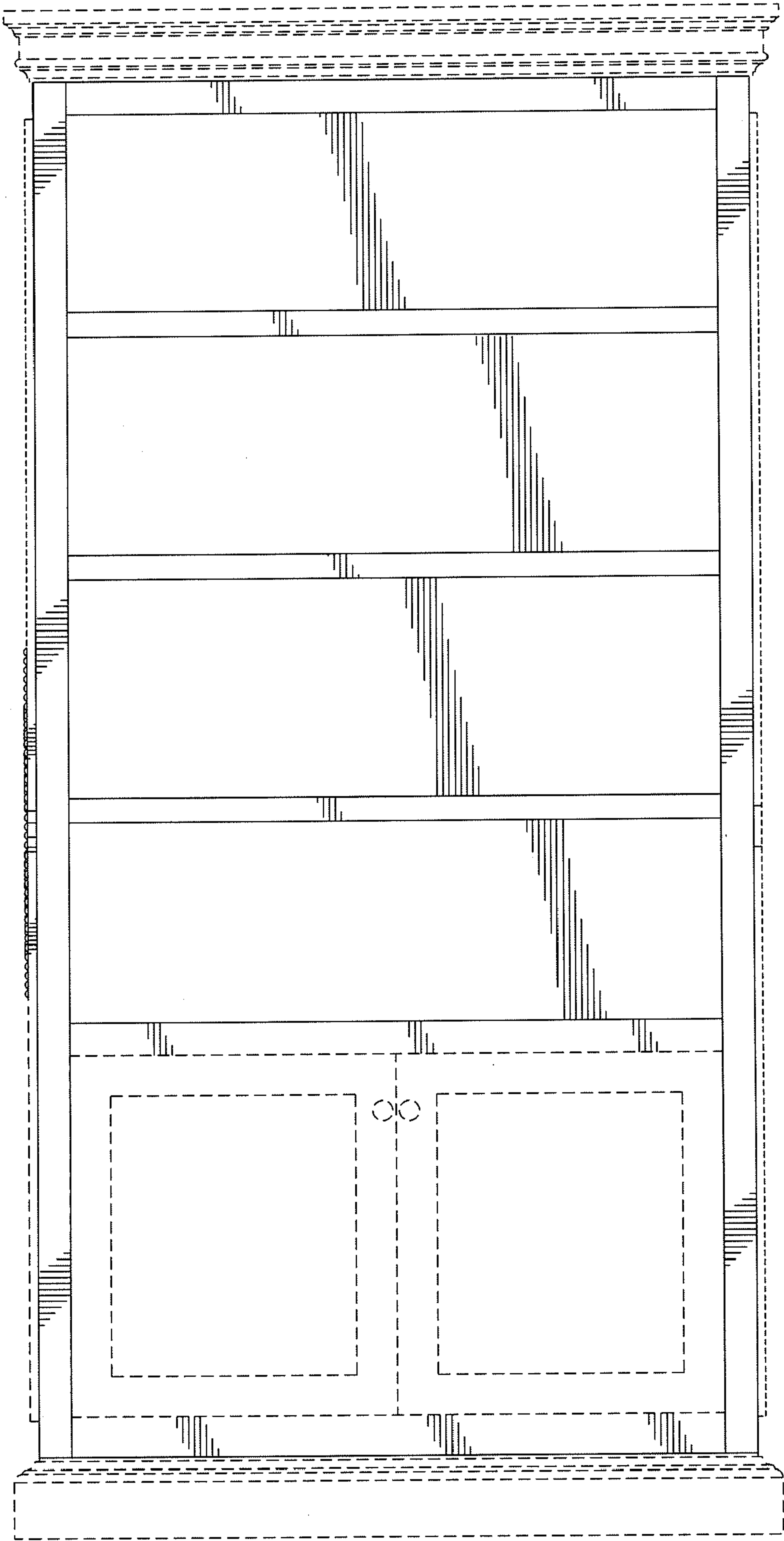

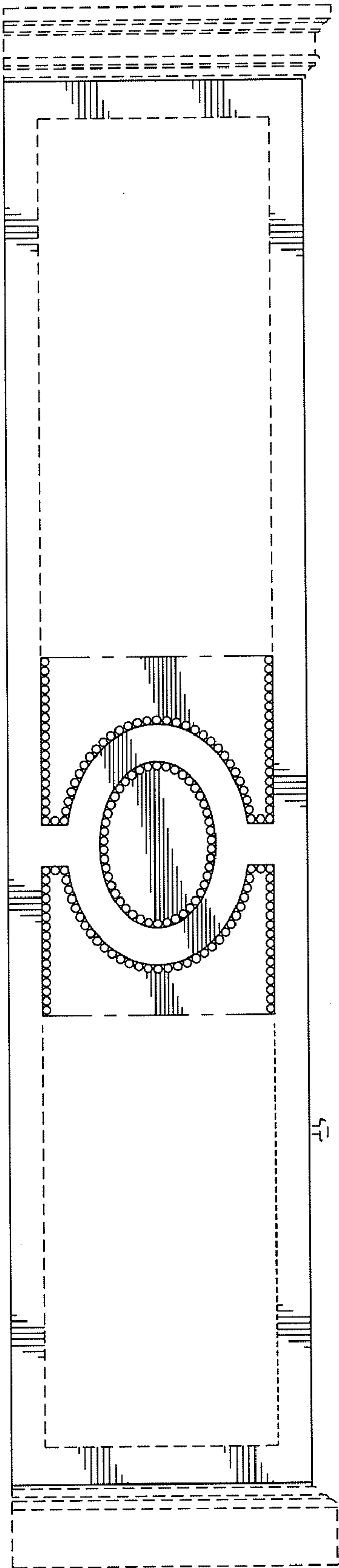
