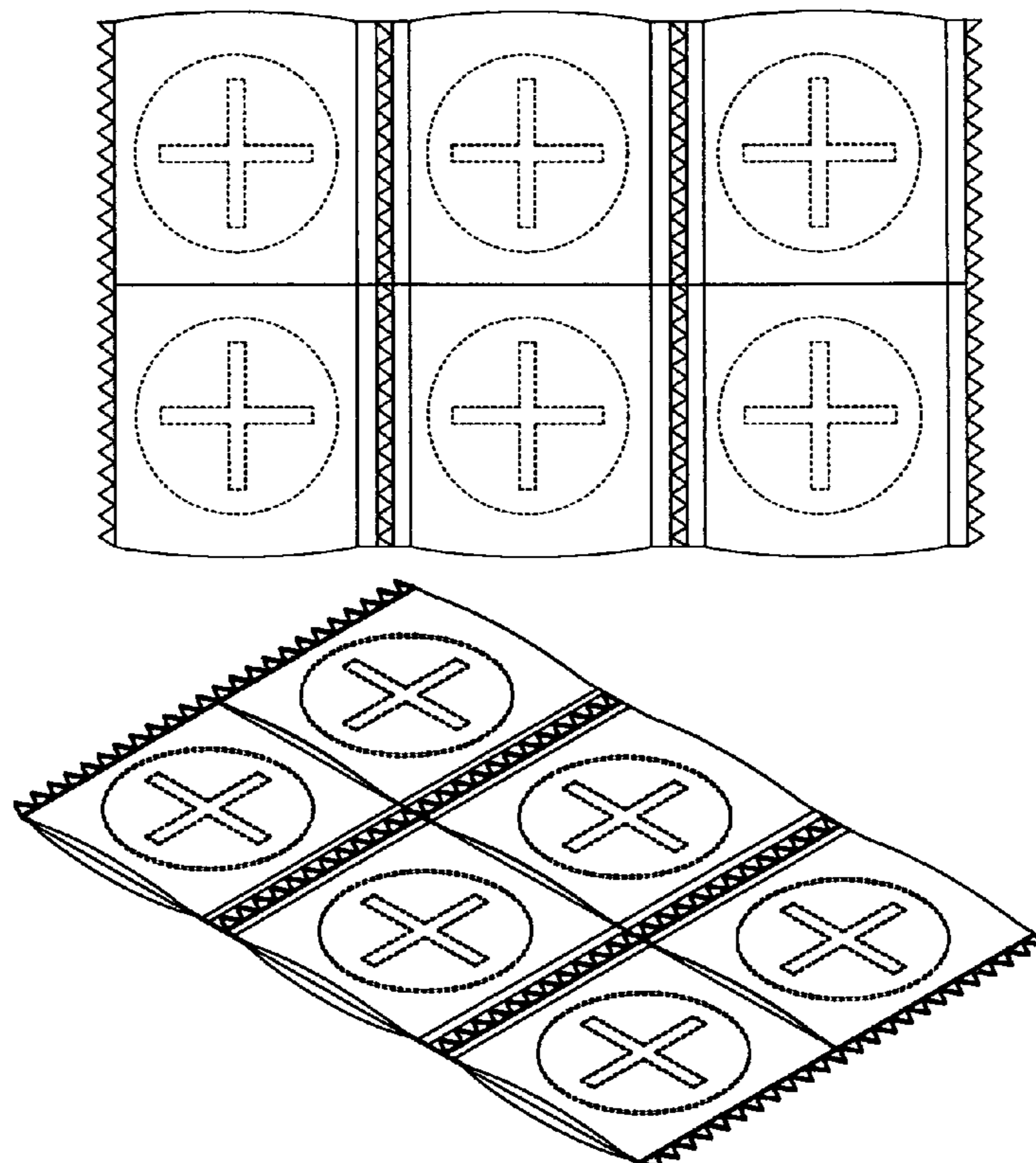
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wrapper for communion wafers, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wrapper for communion wafers showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is top front perspective view thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof. In the drawings, the broken lines in FIGS. 1, 3 and 4 depict portions of the design that form no part of the claim.

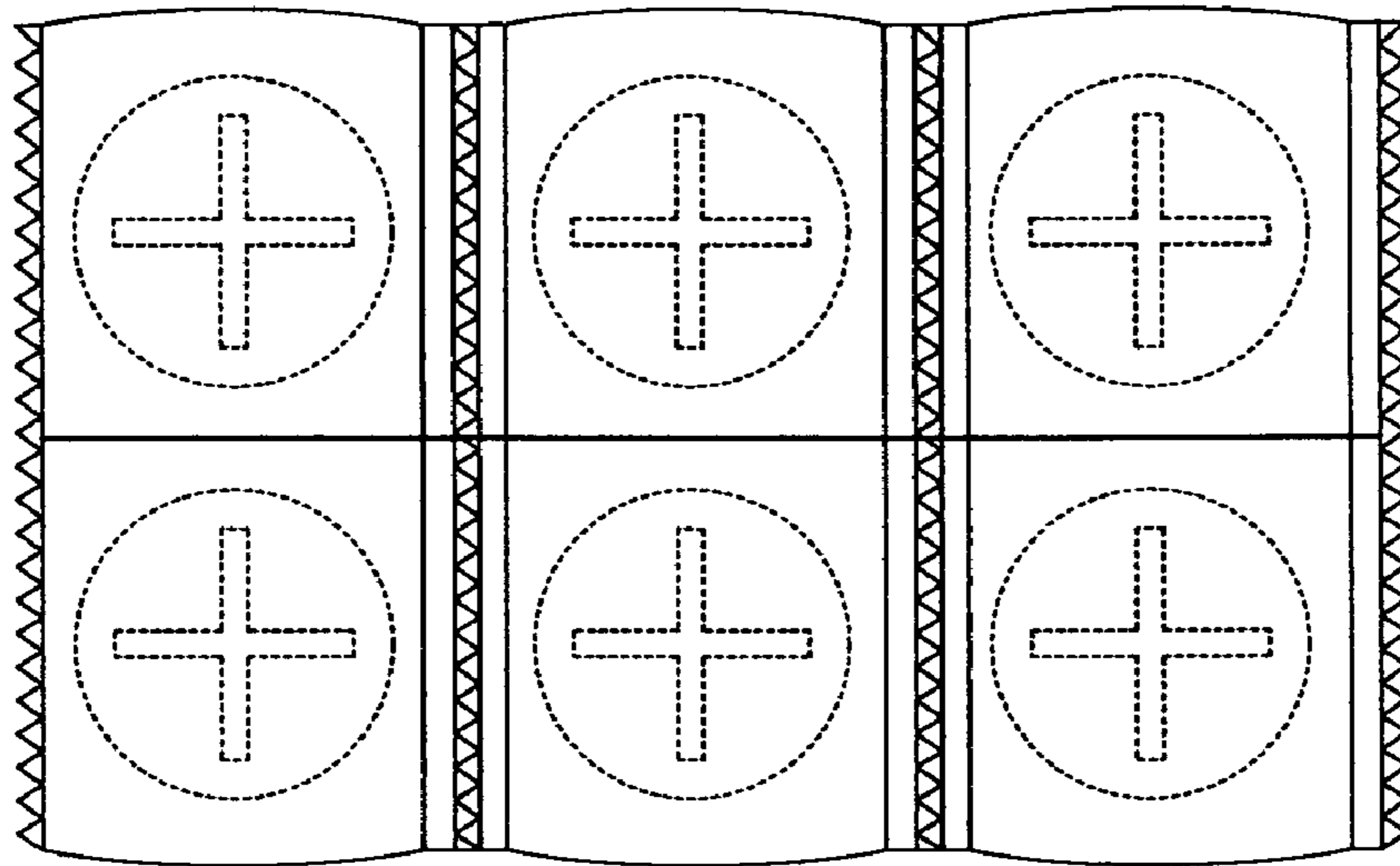

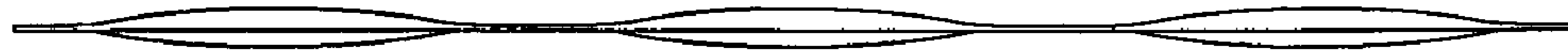

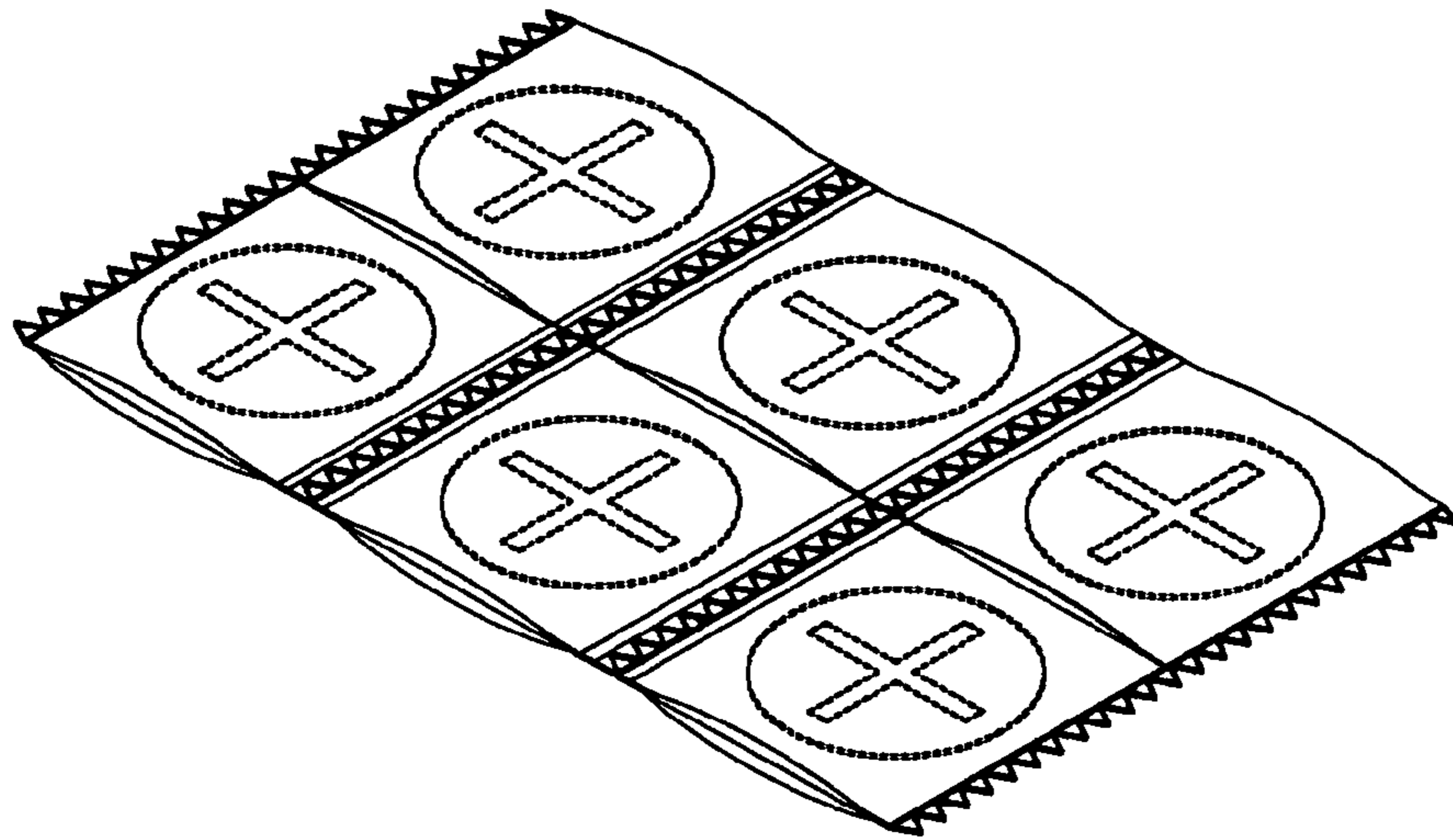

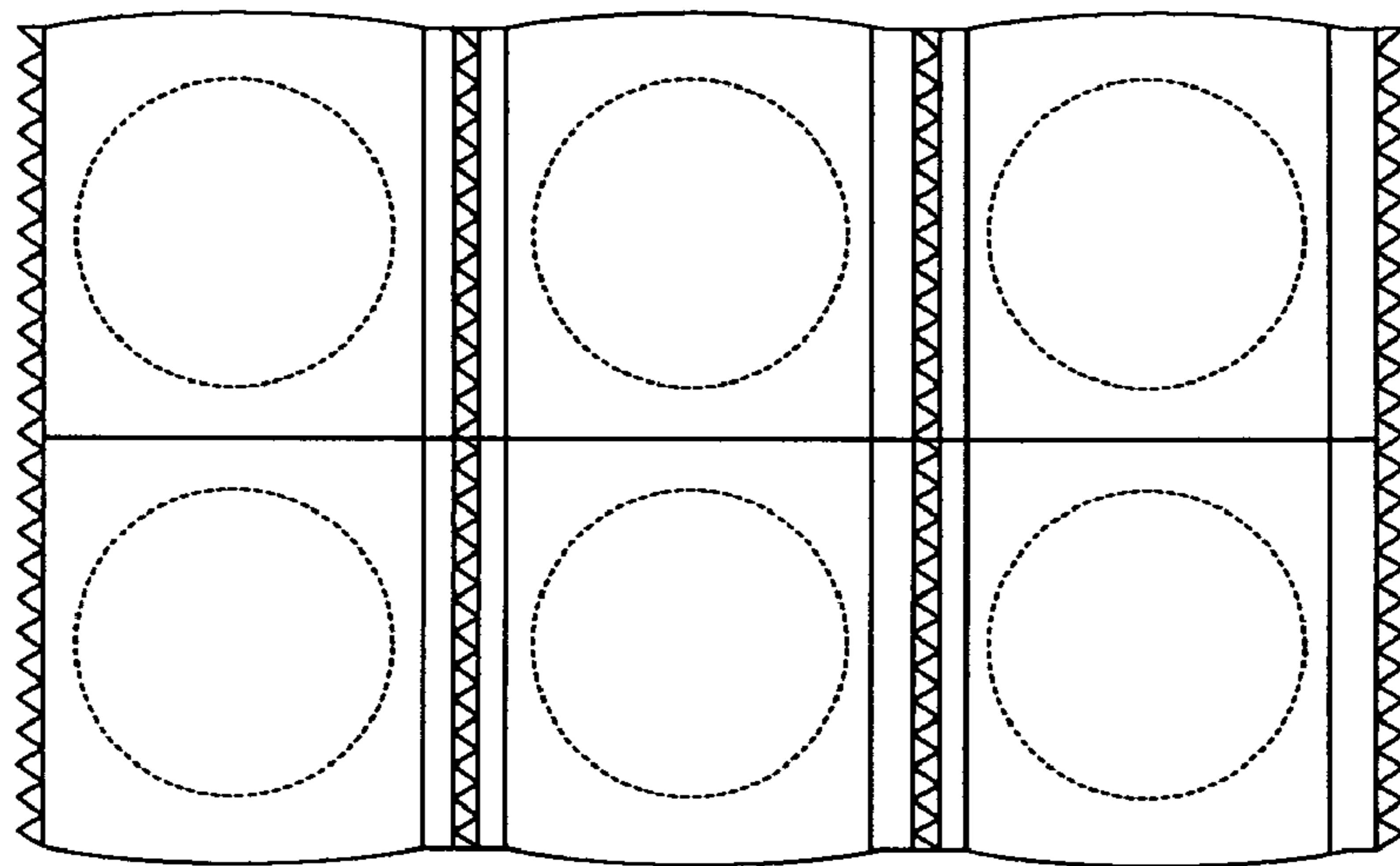
