FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the absorption liner for shoes;


FIG. 9 is another perspective view of the absorption liner design for shoes;


FIG. 10 is yet another perspective view of the absorption liner design for shoes; and,


FIG. 11 is another perspective view of the absorption liner design for shoes.












FIG. 7 FIG. 8


