The ornamental design for an laminate panel, as shown and described.

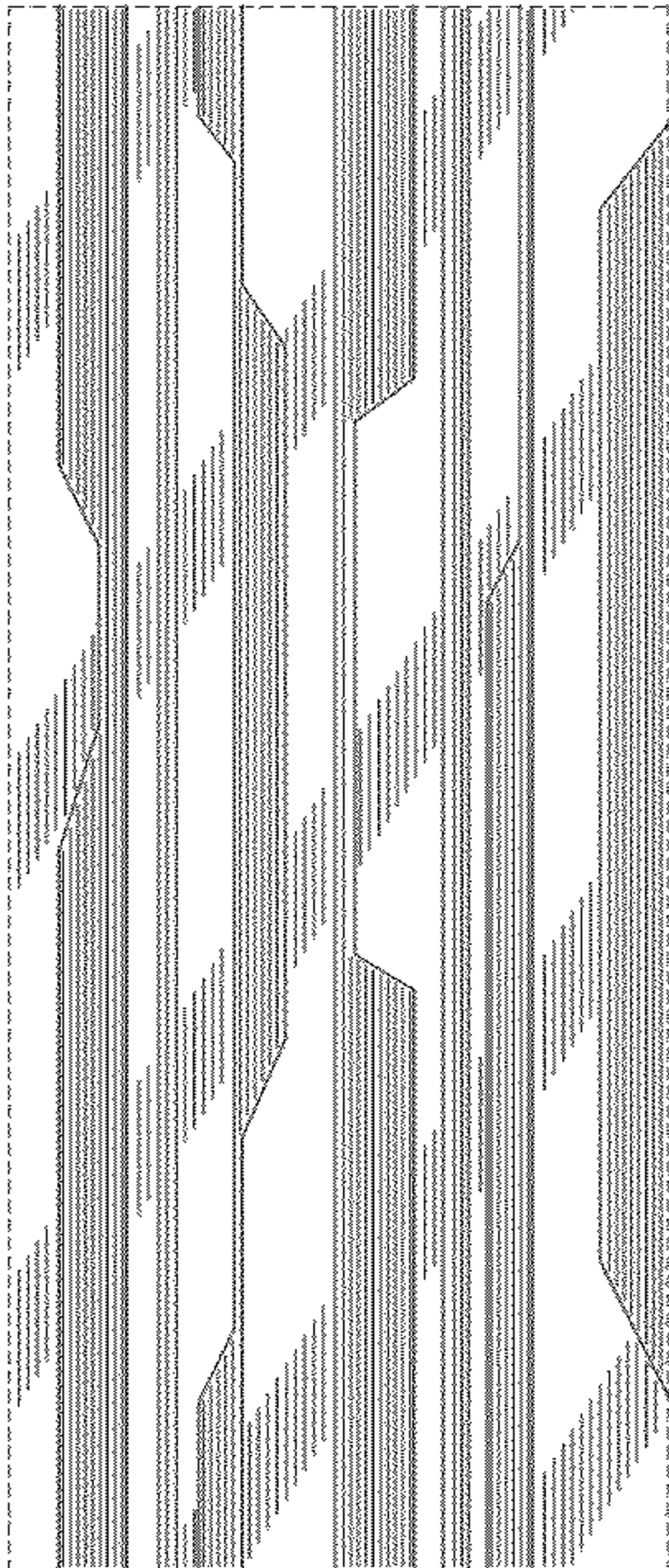
DESCRIPTION

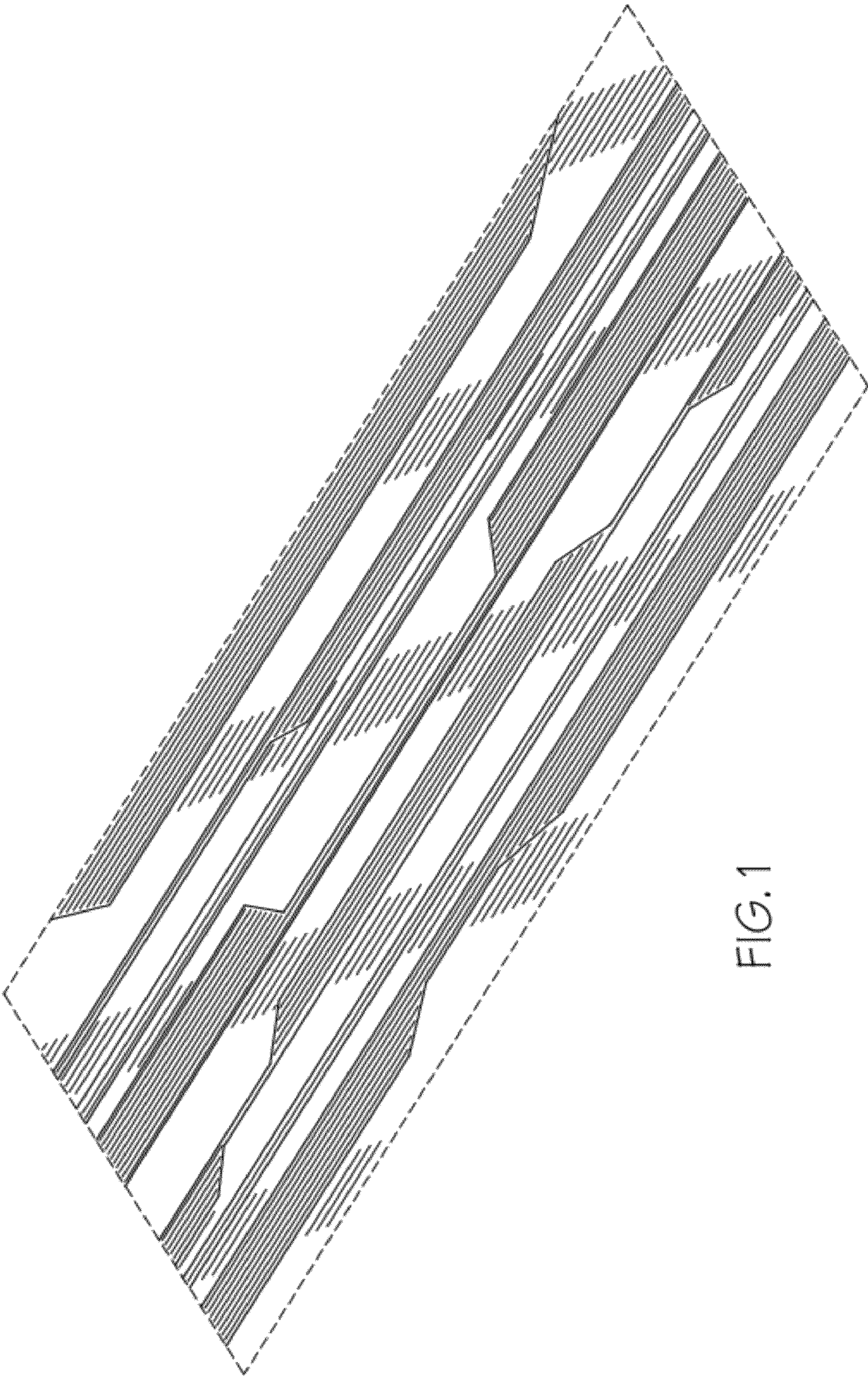

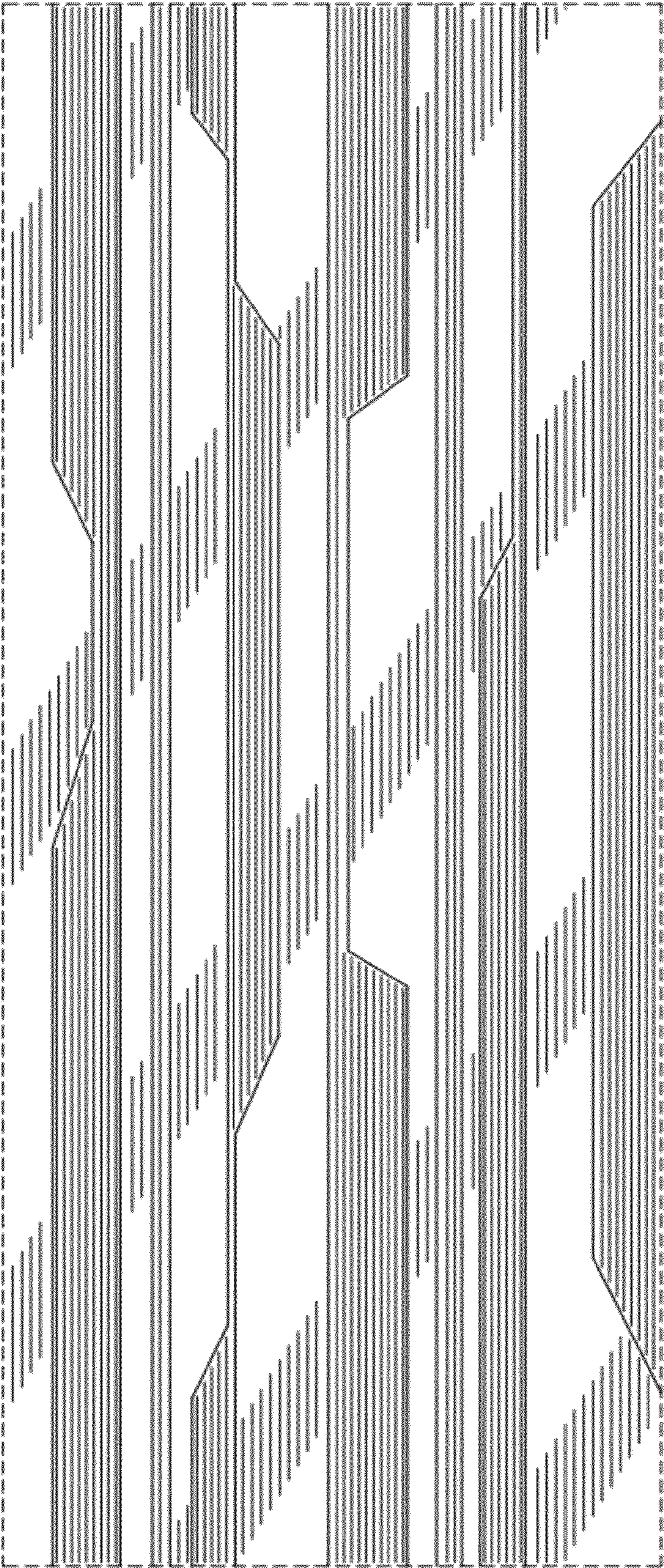
