FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

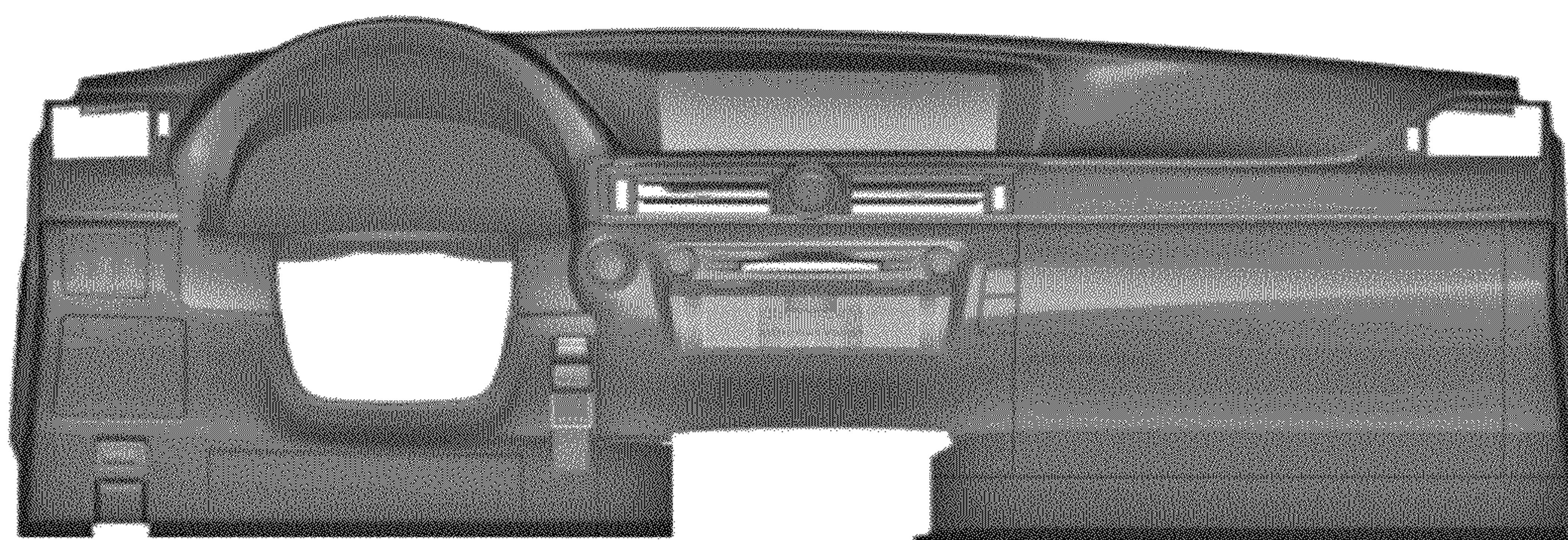
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;

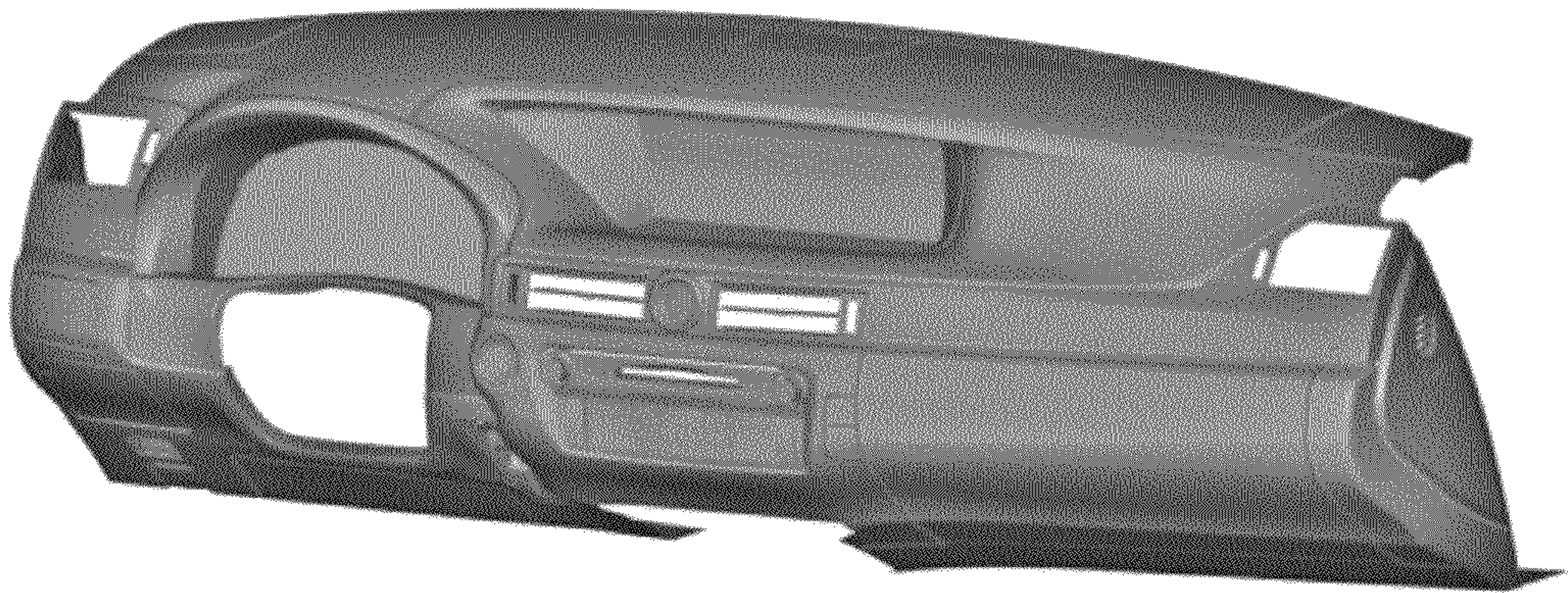

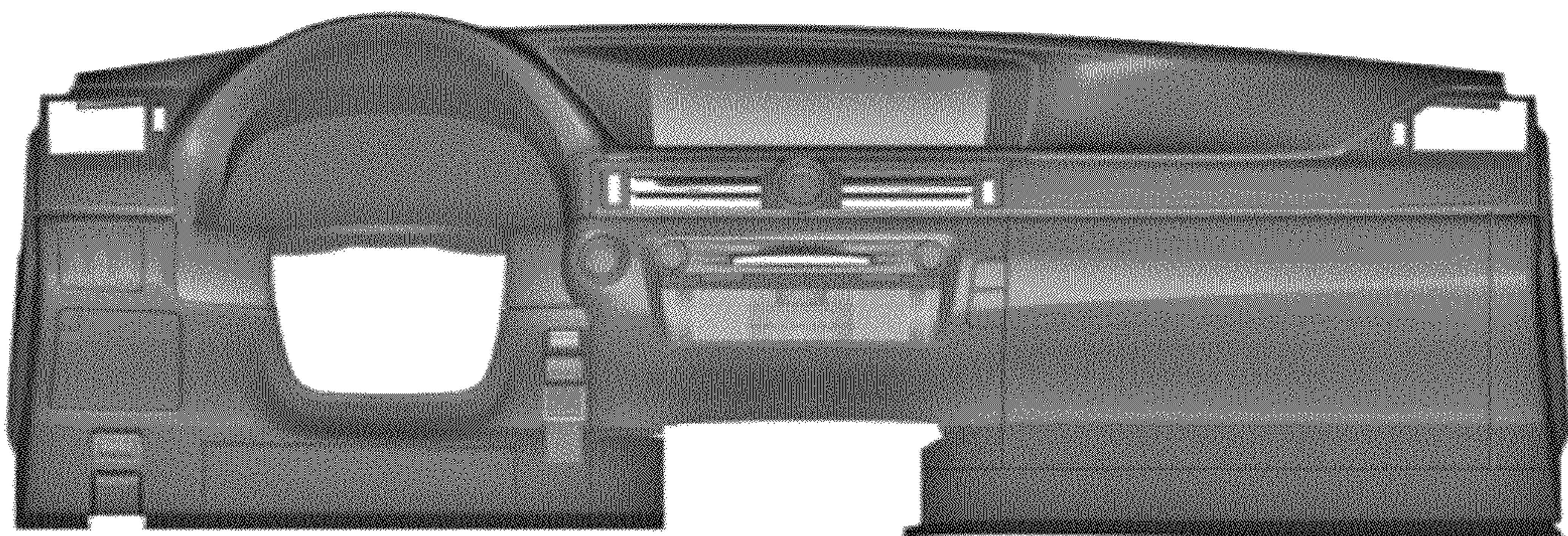

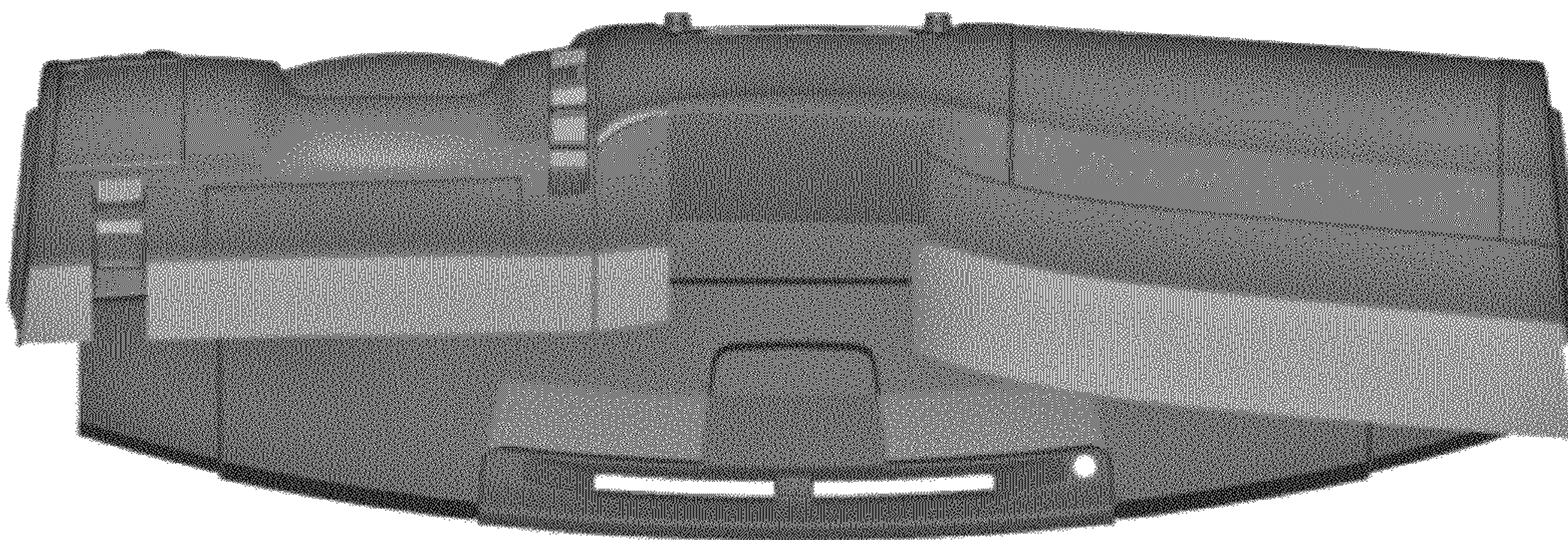

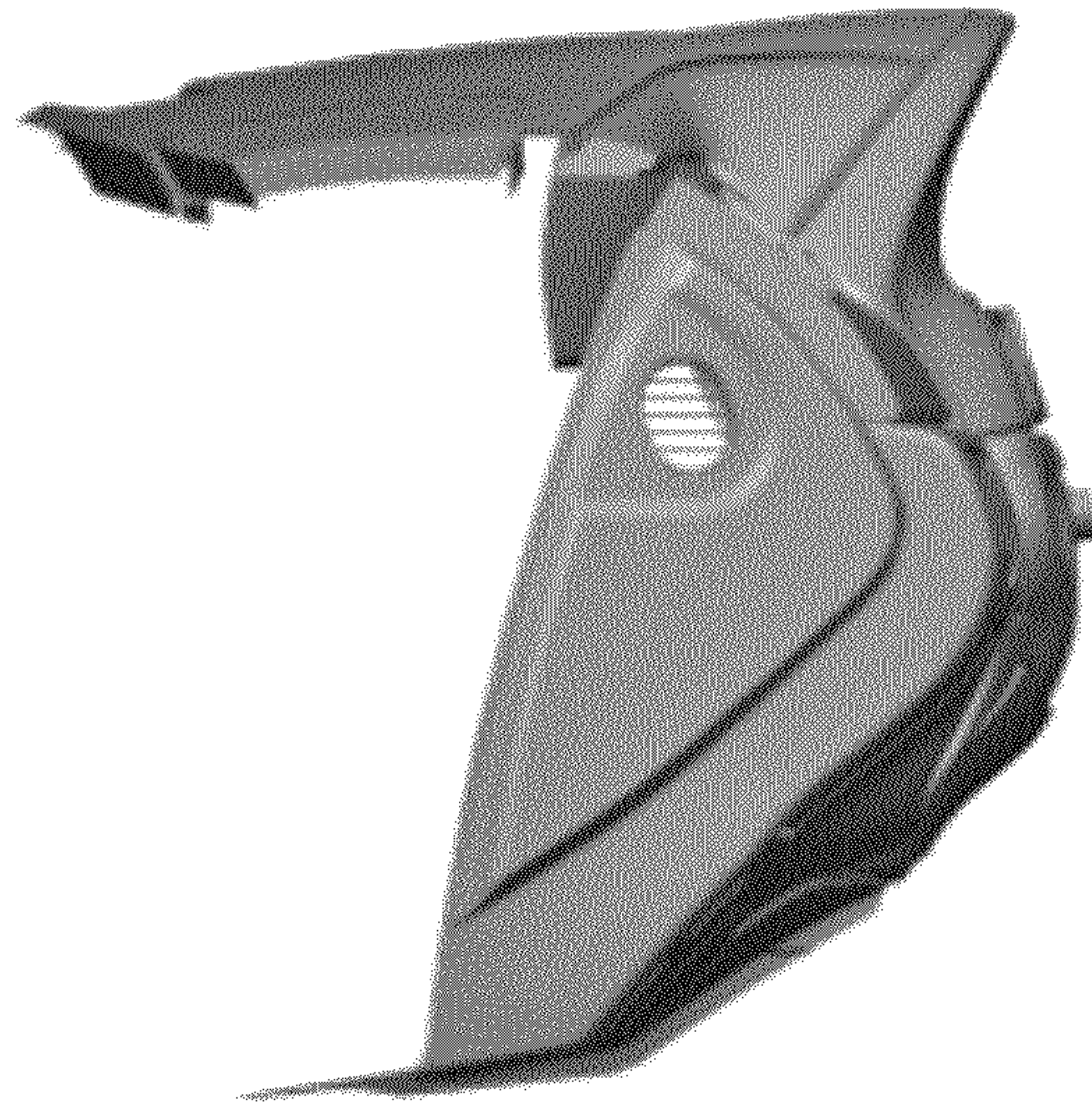

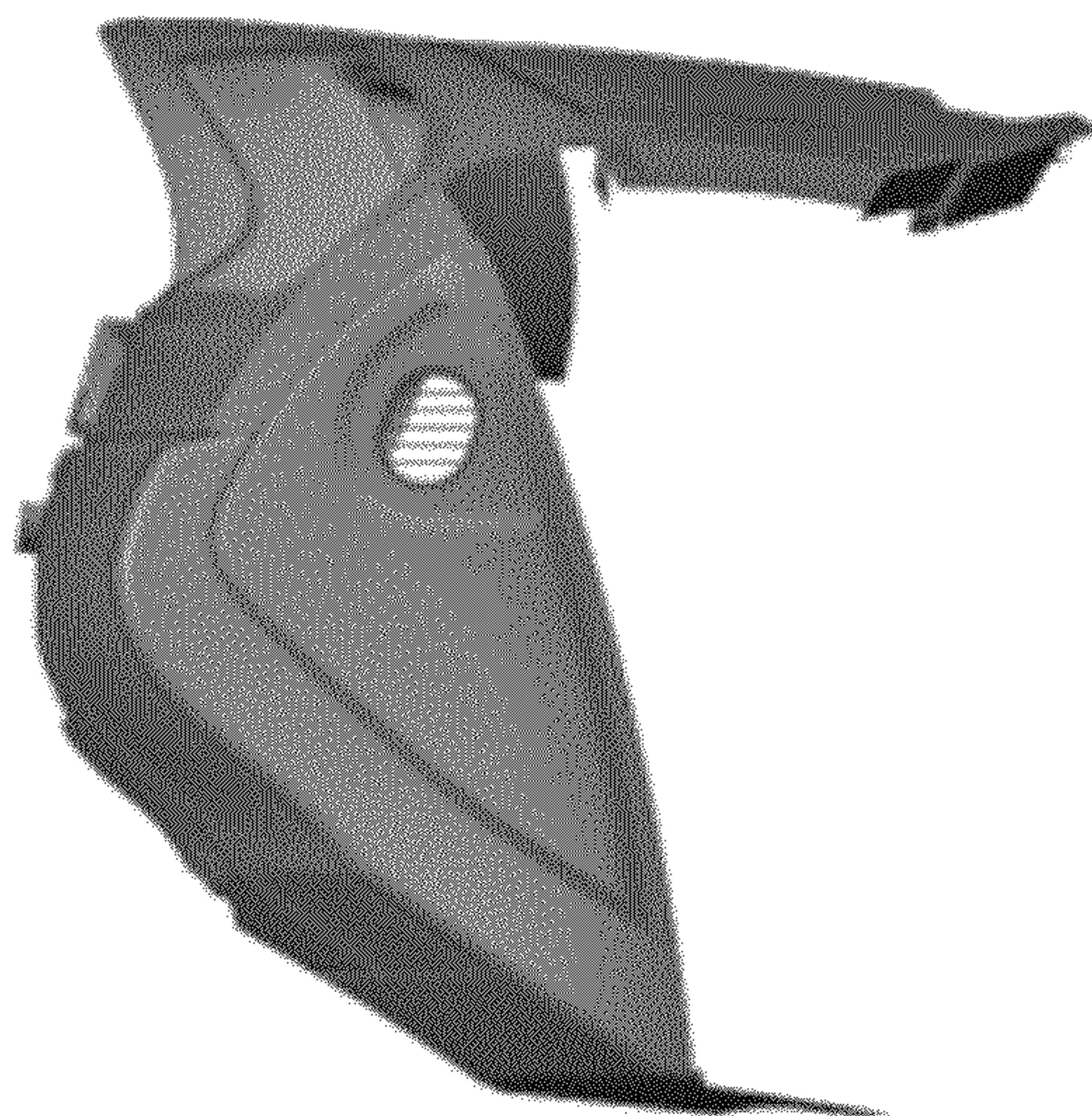
