The ornamental design for a “spiky bracelet,” as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a spiky bracelet, showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof

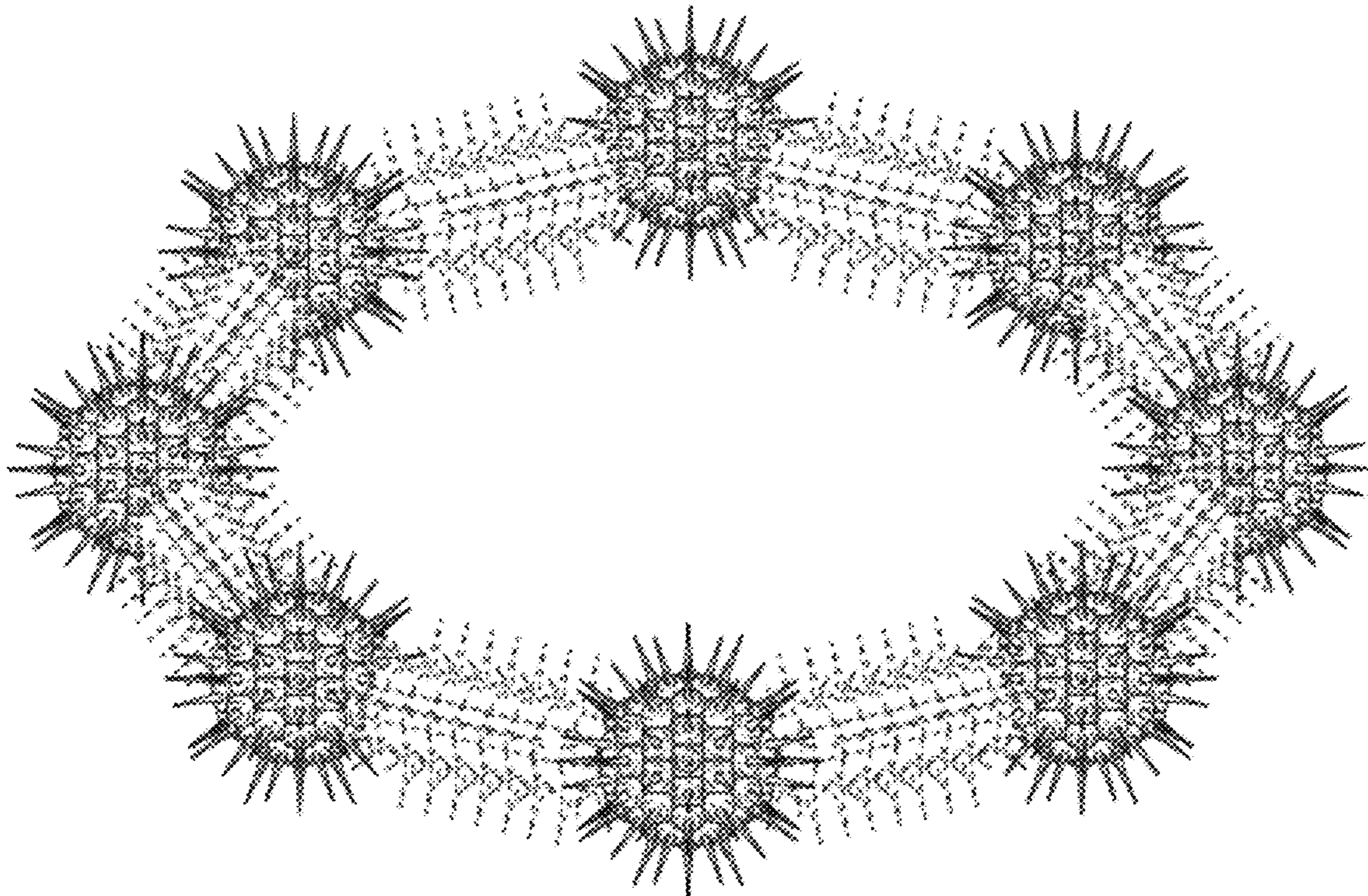
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

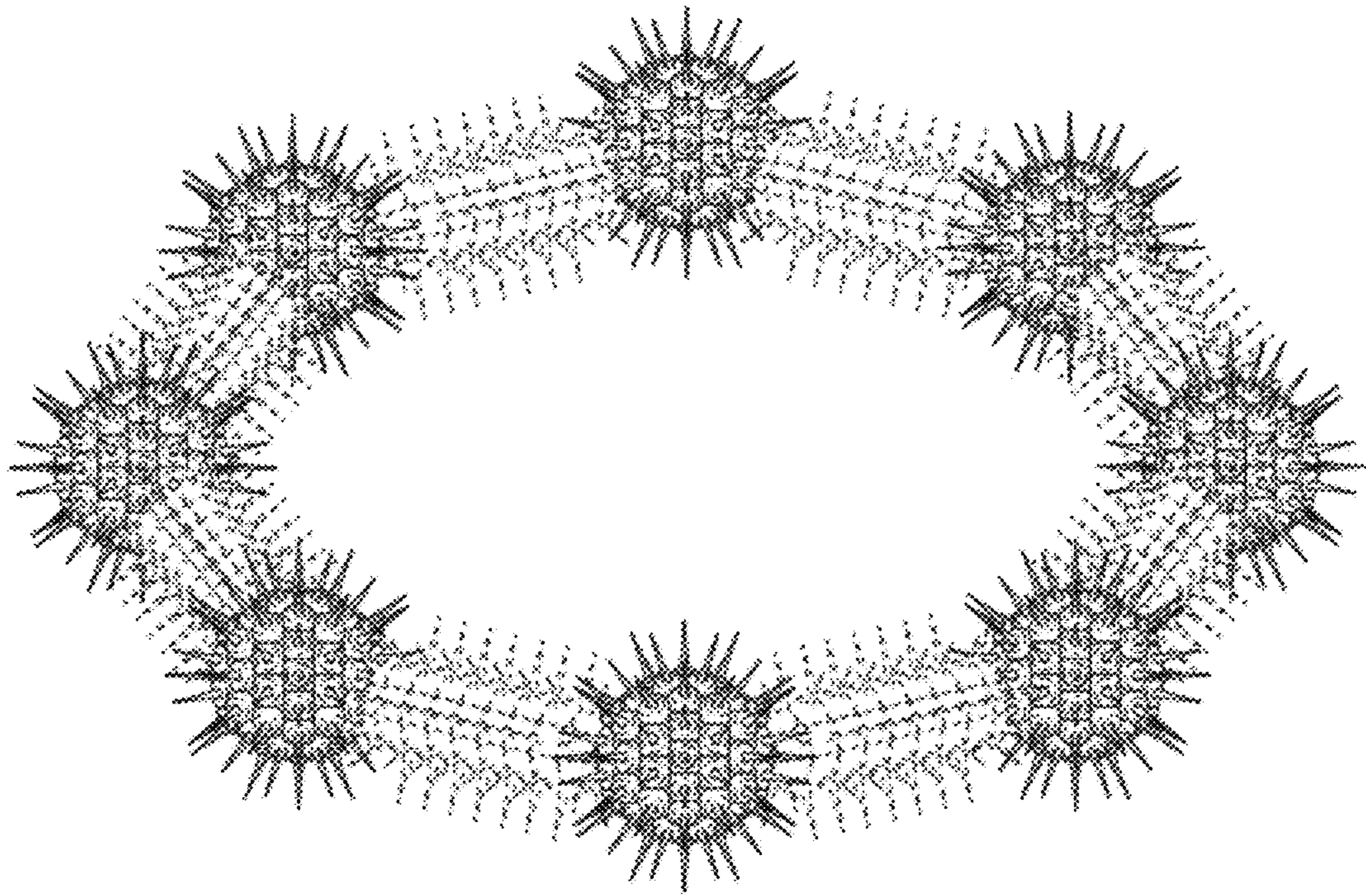

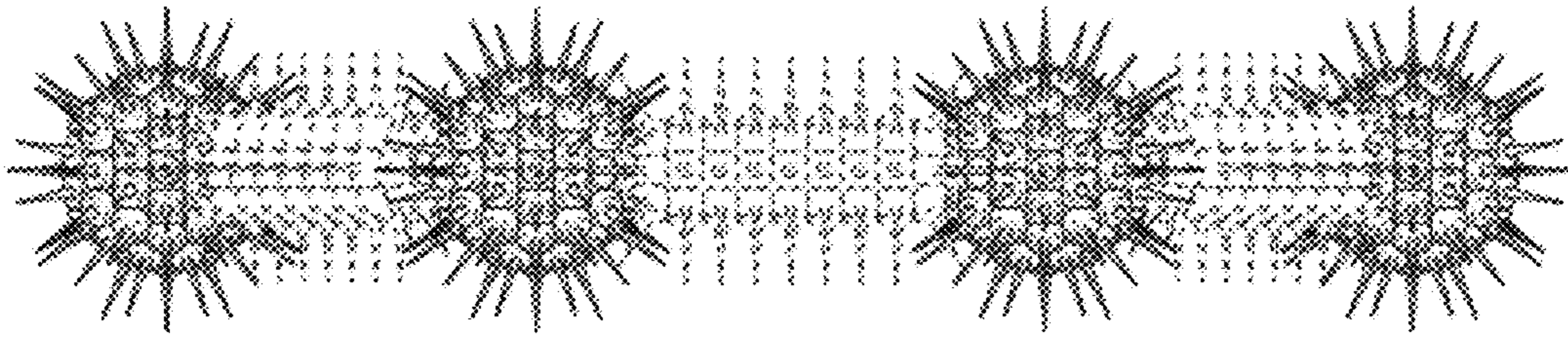

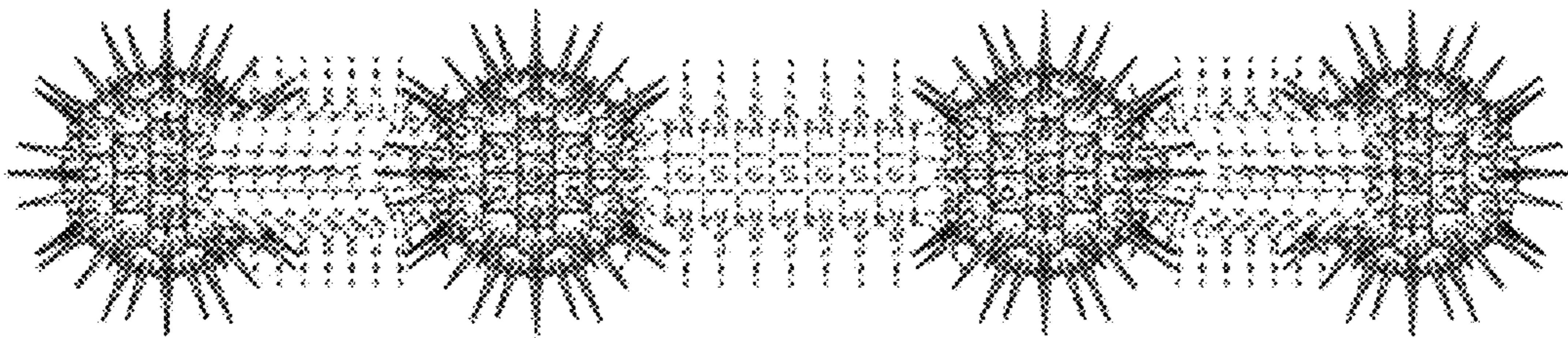

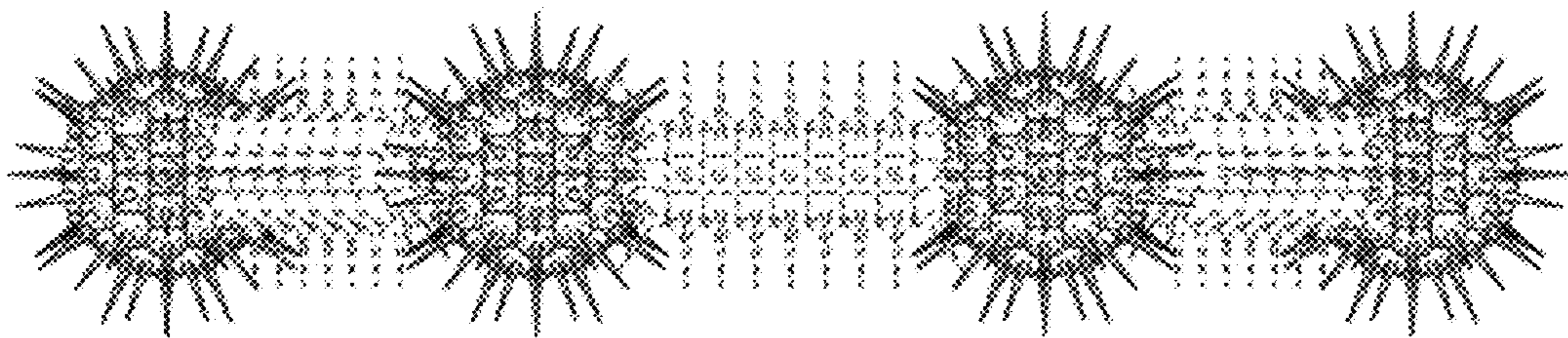

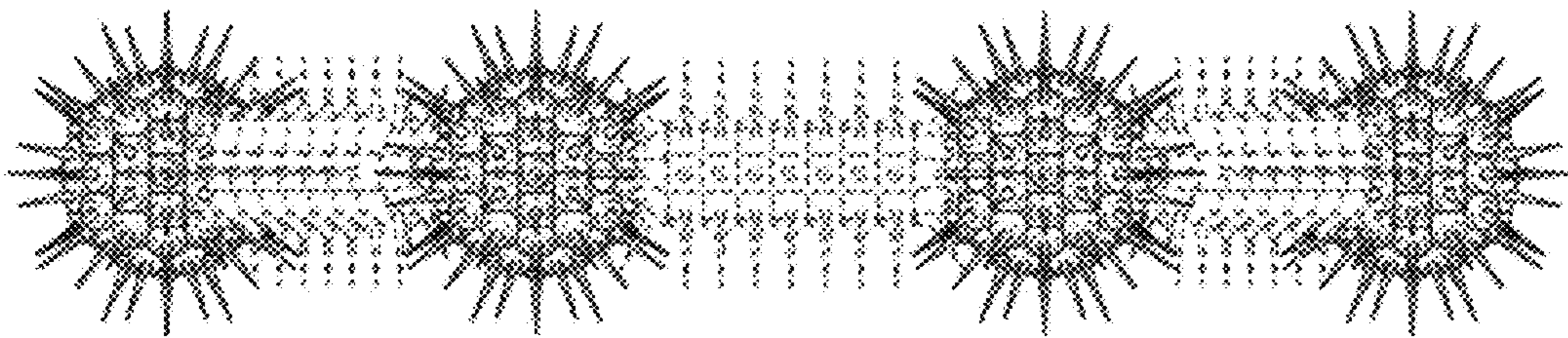

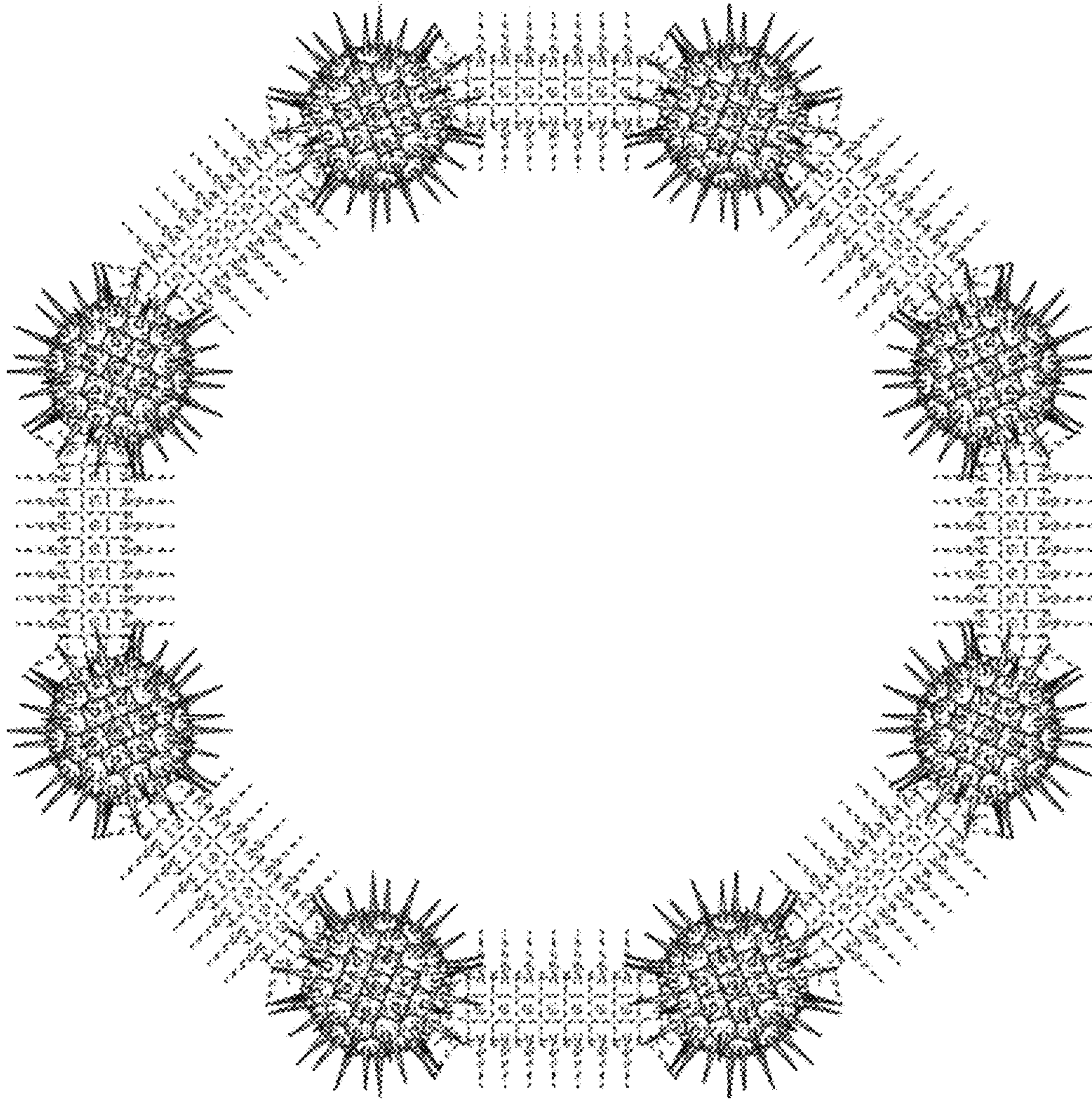

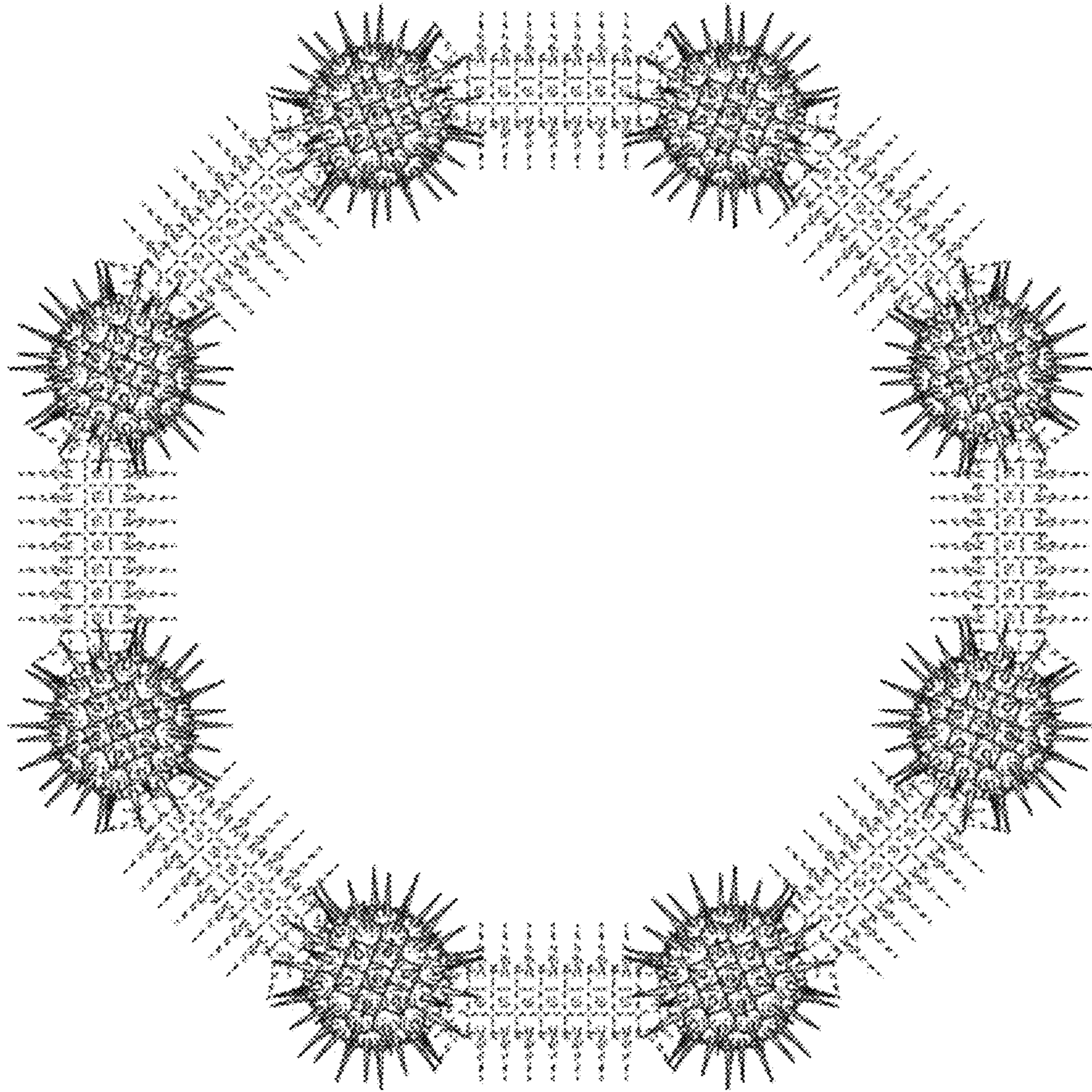
