FIG. 4 is a front view of the traction device for a prosthetic running foot of FIG. 1;

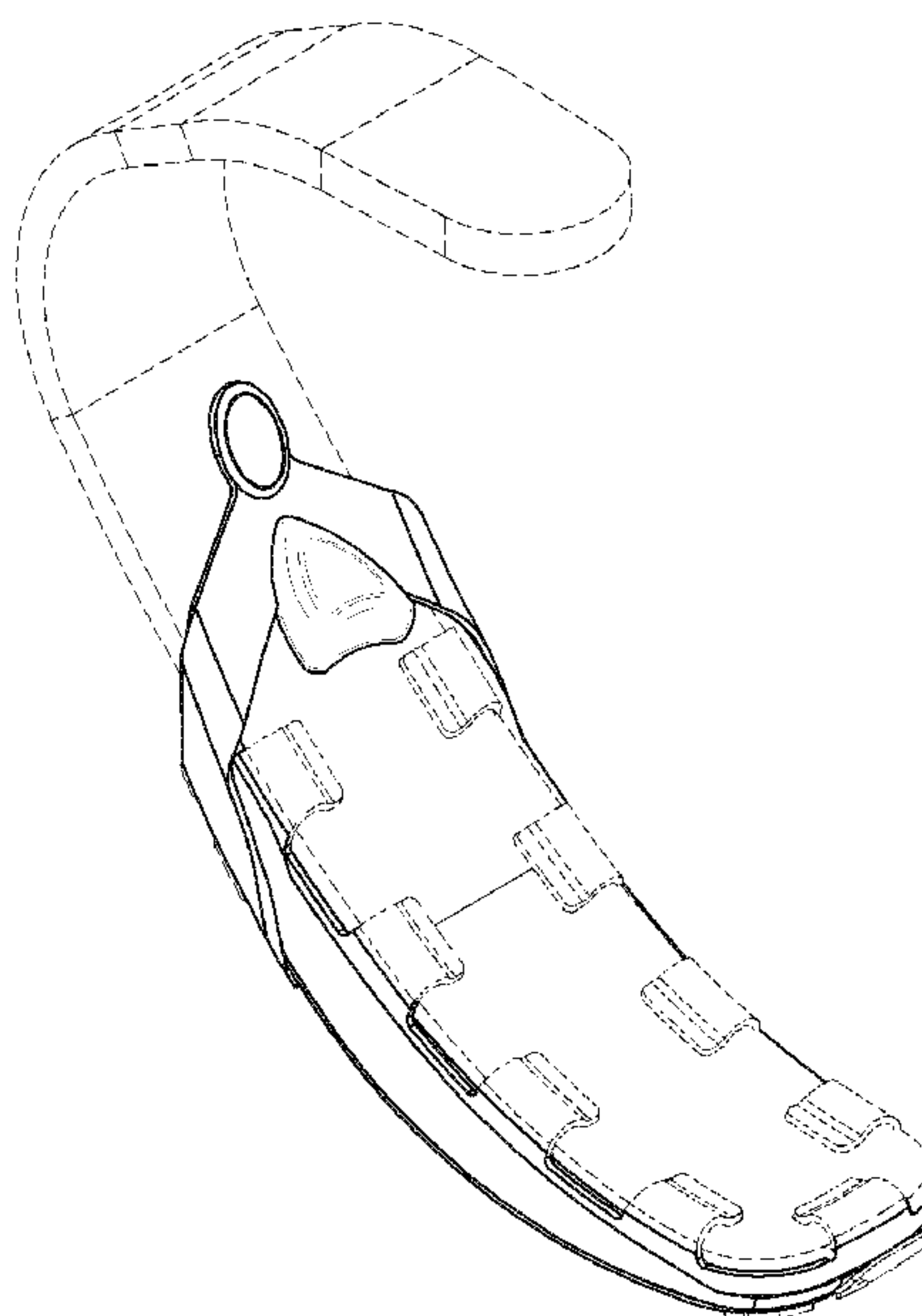
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the traction device for a prosthetic running foot of FIG. 1;

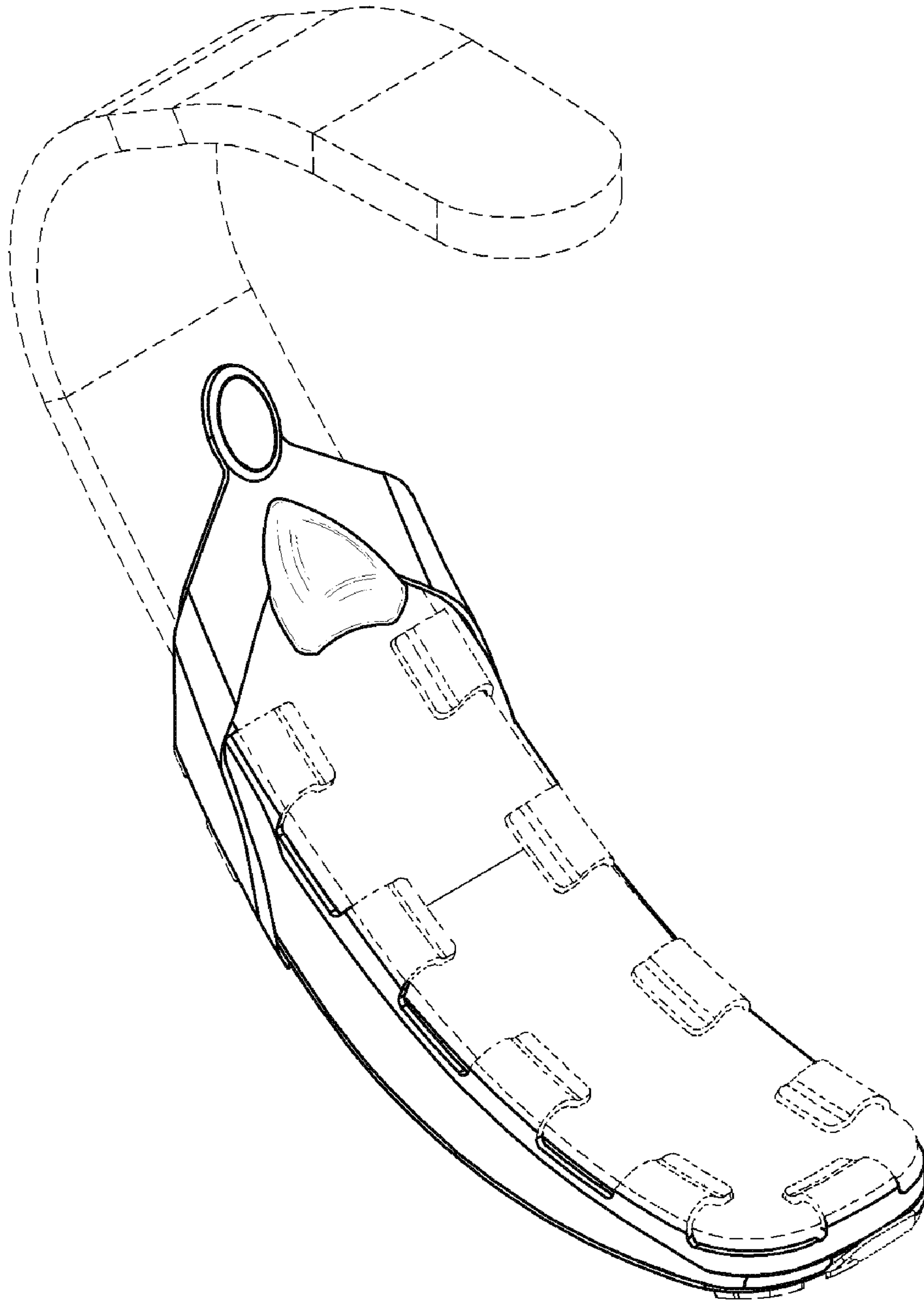

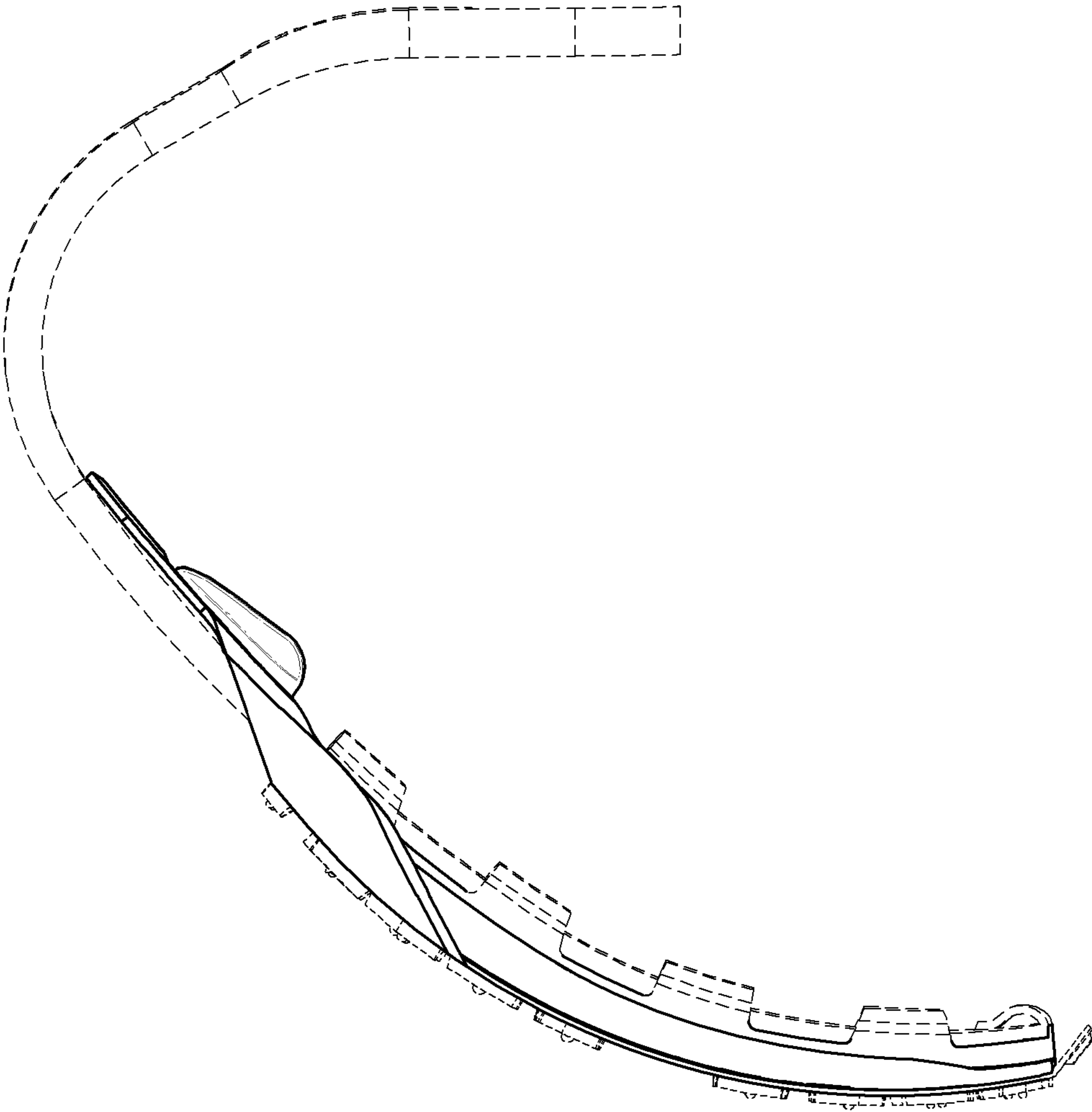

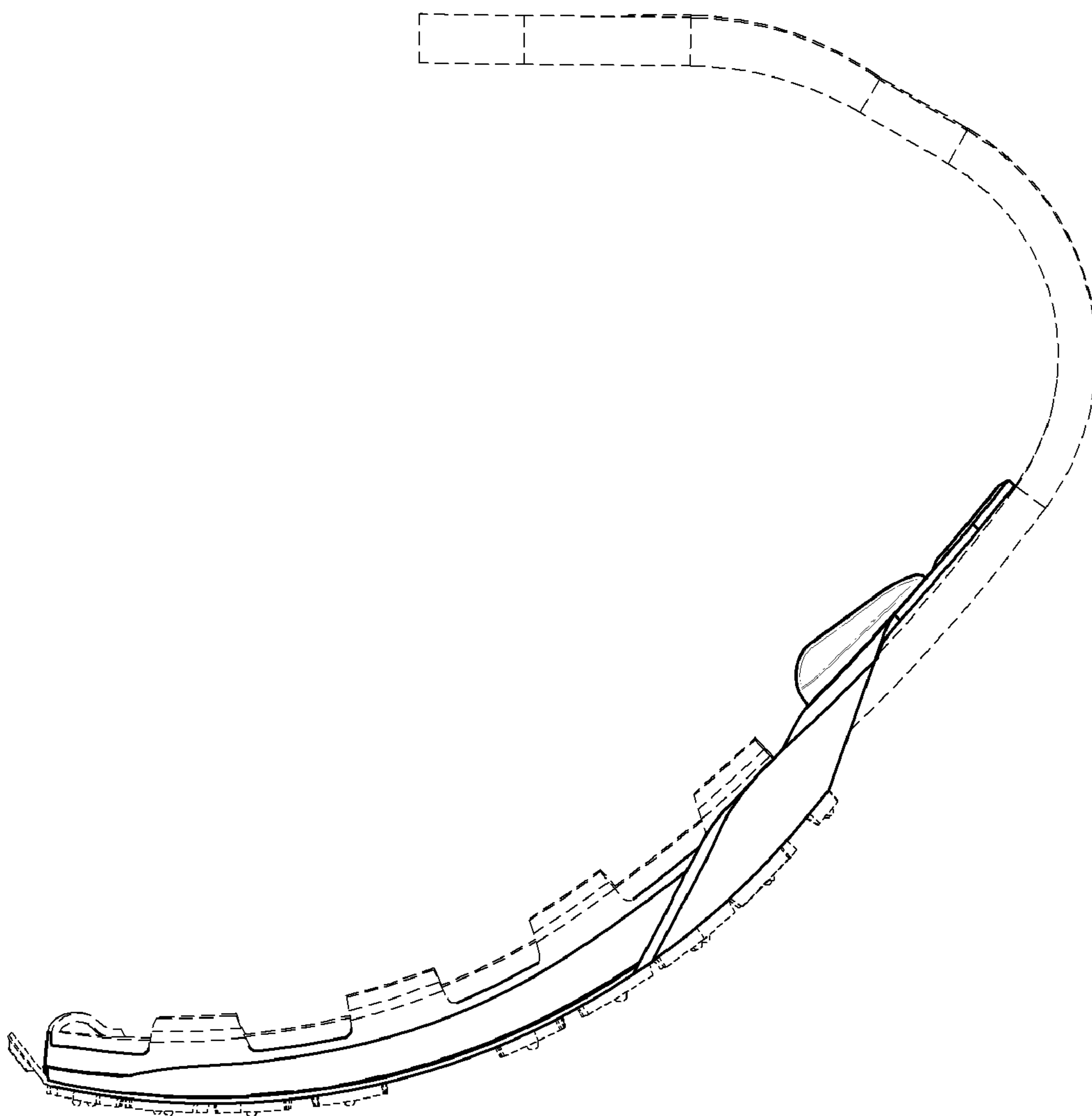

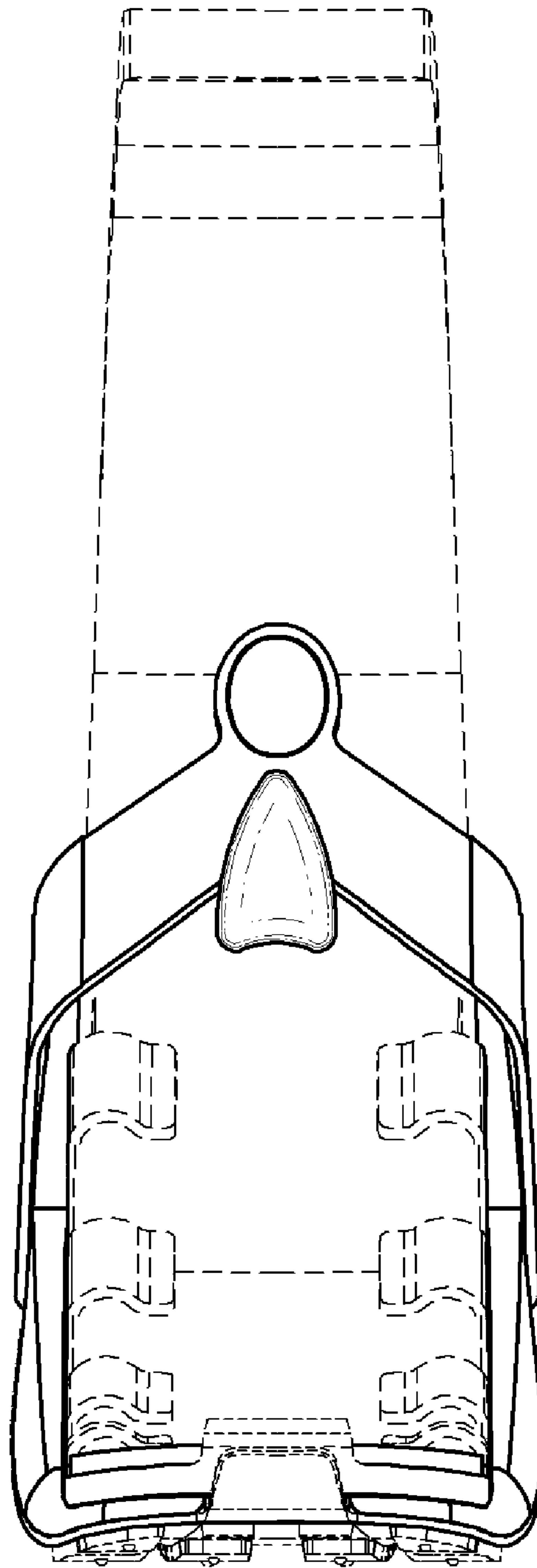

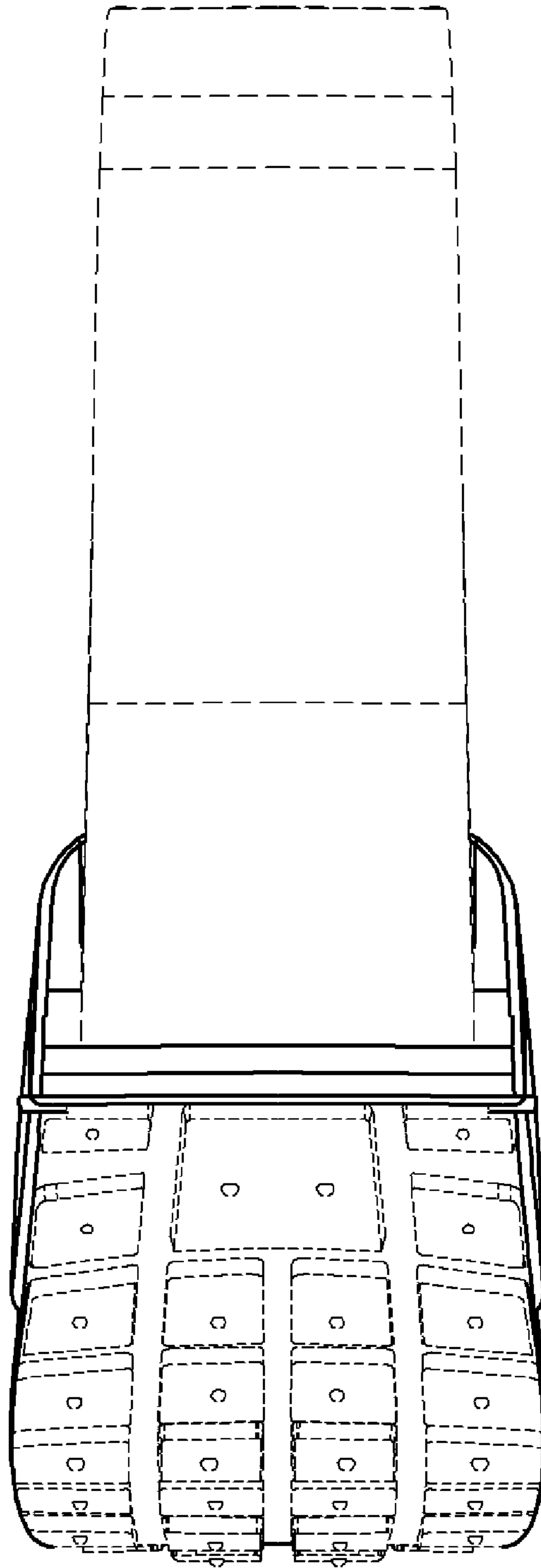

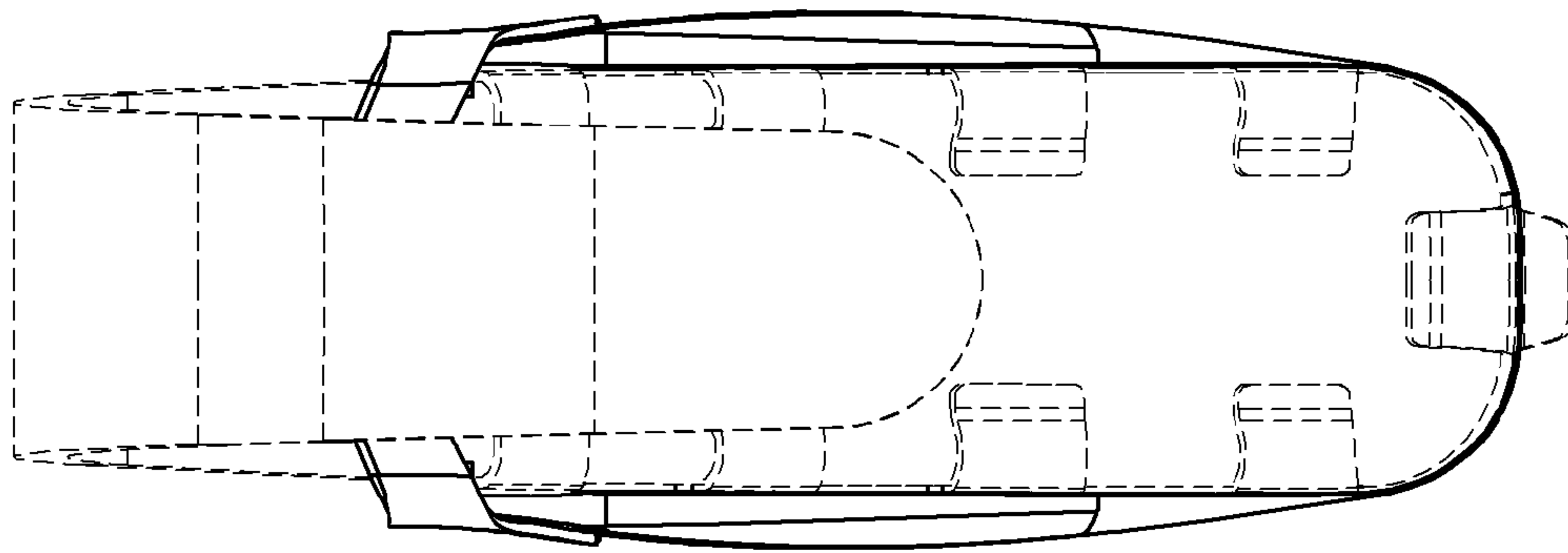

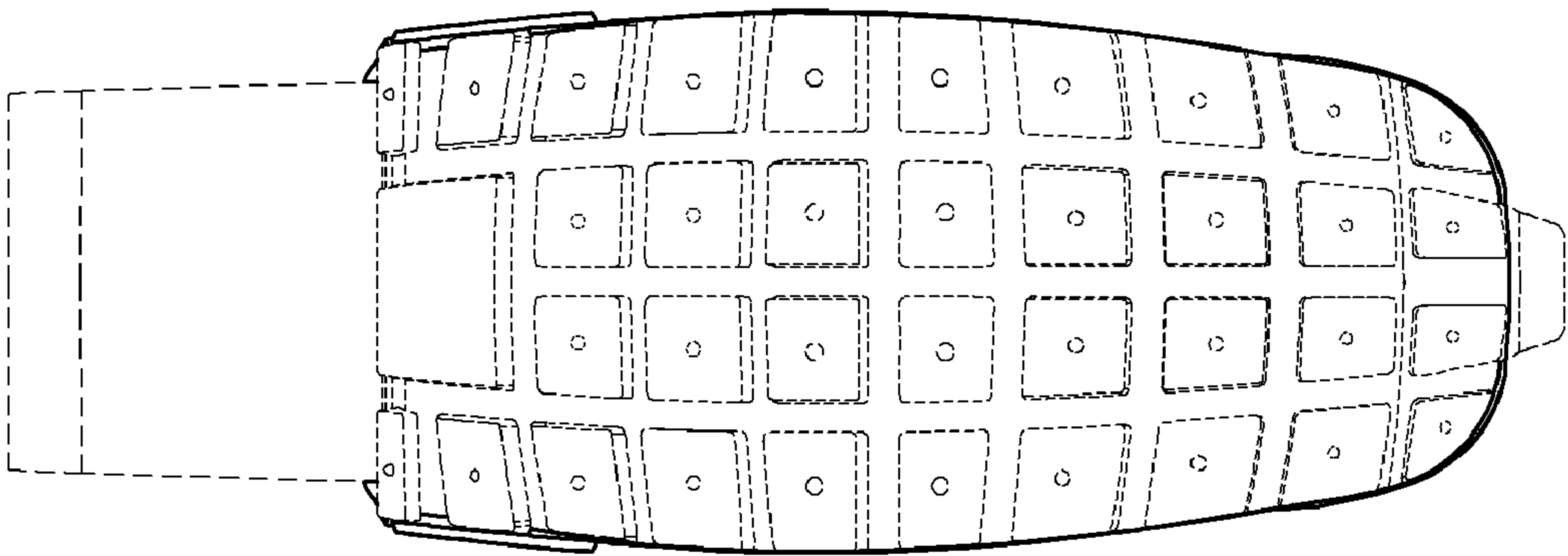
